The ornamental design for an archi-scrench, as shown and described.

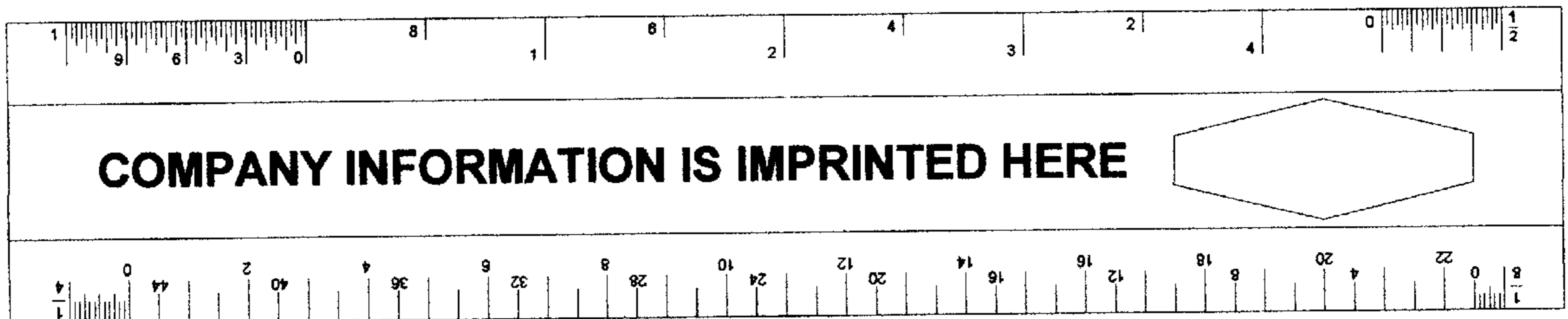
DESCRIPTION

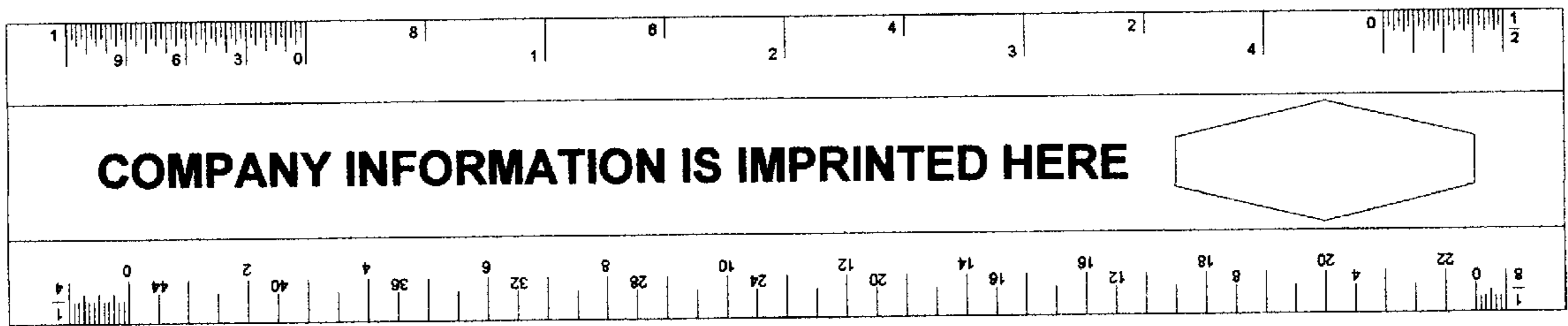

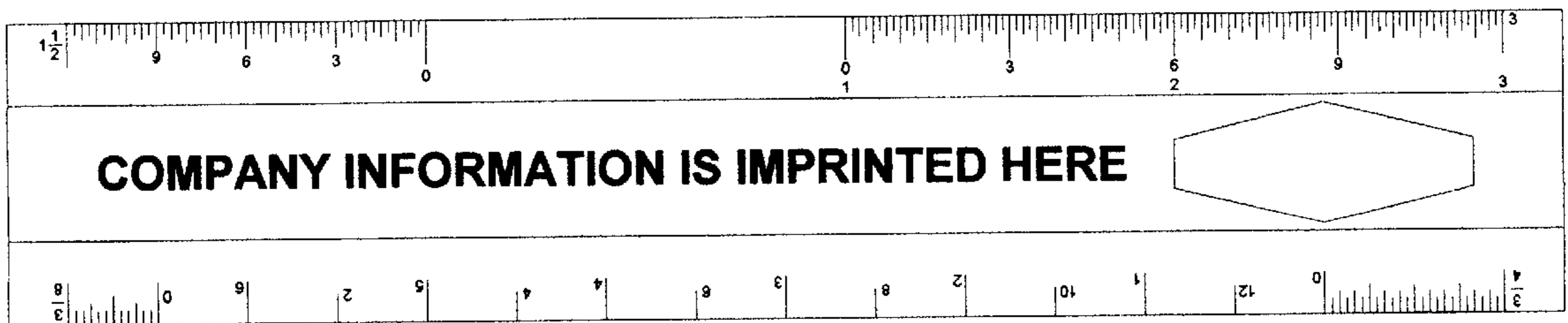

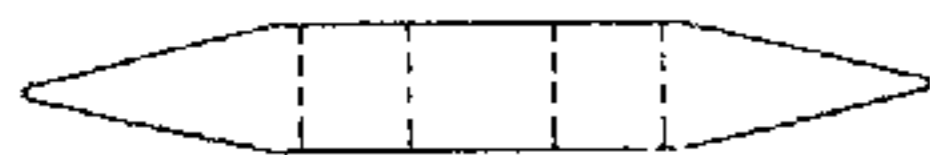
