The ornamental design for a pattern for a flat-surfaced three-dimensional appearing plastic matrix surfacing material, as shown and described.

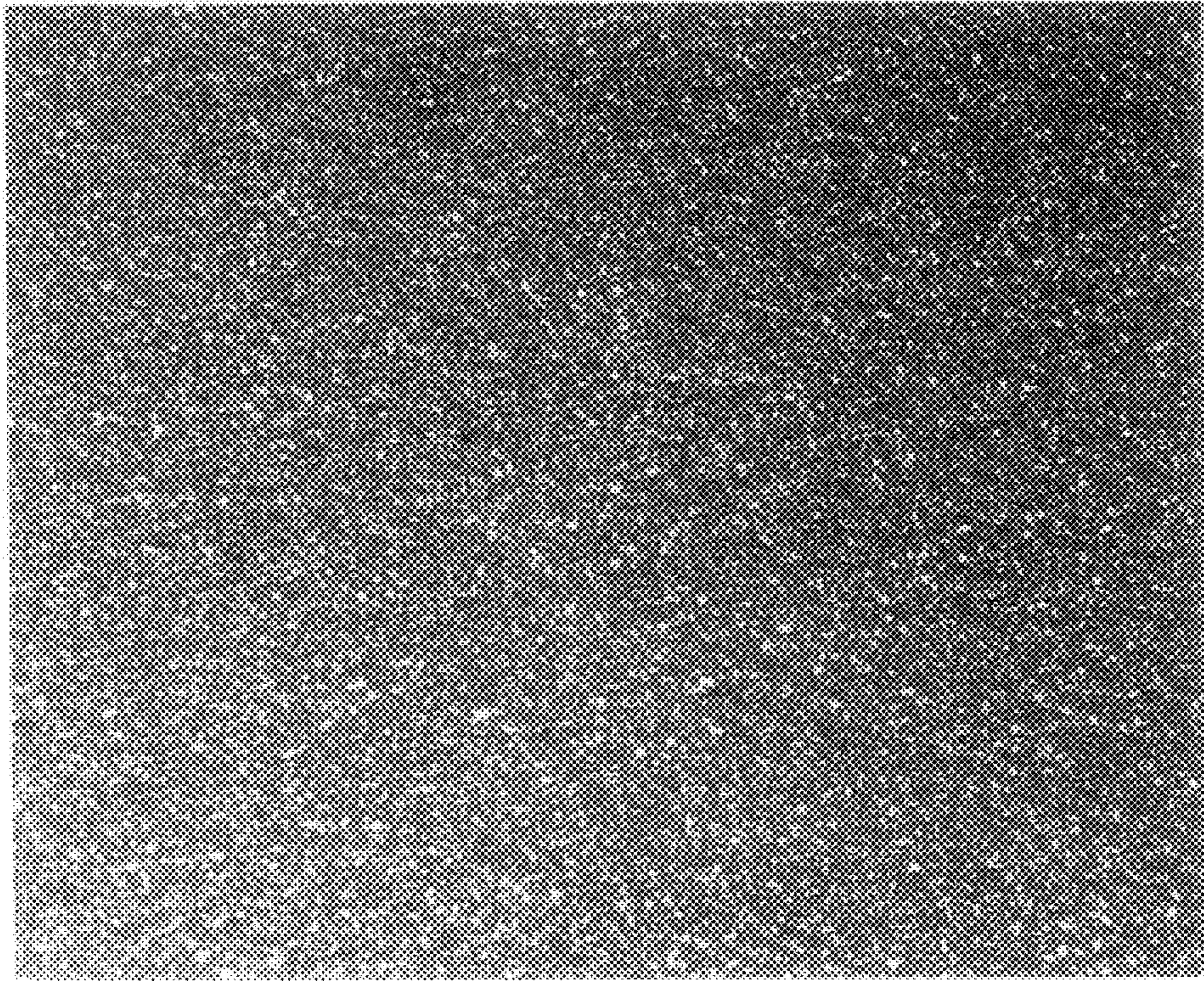

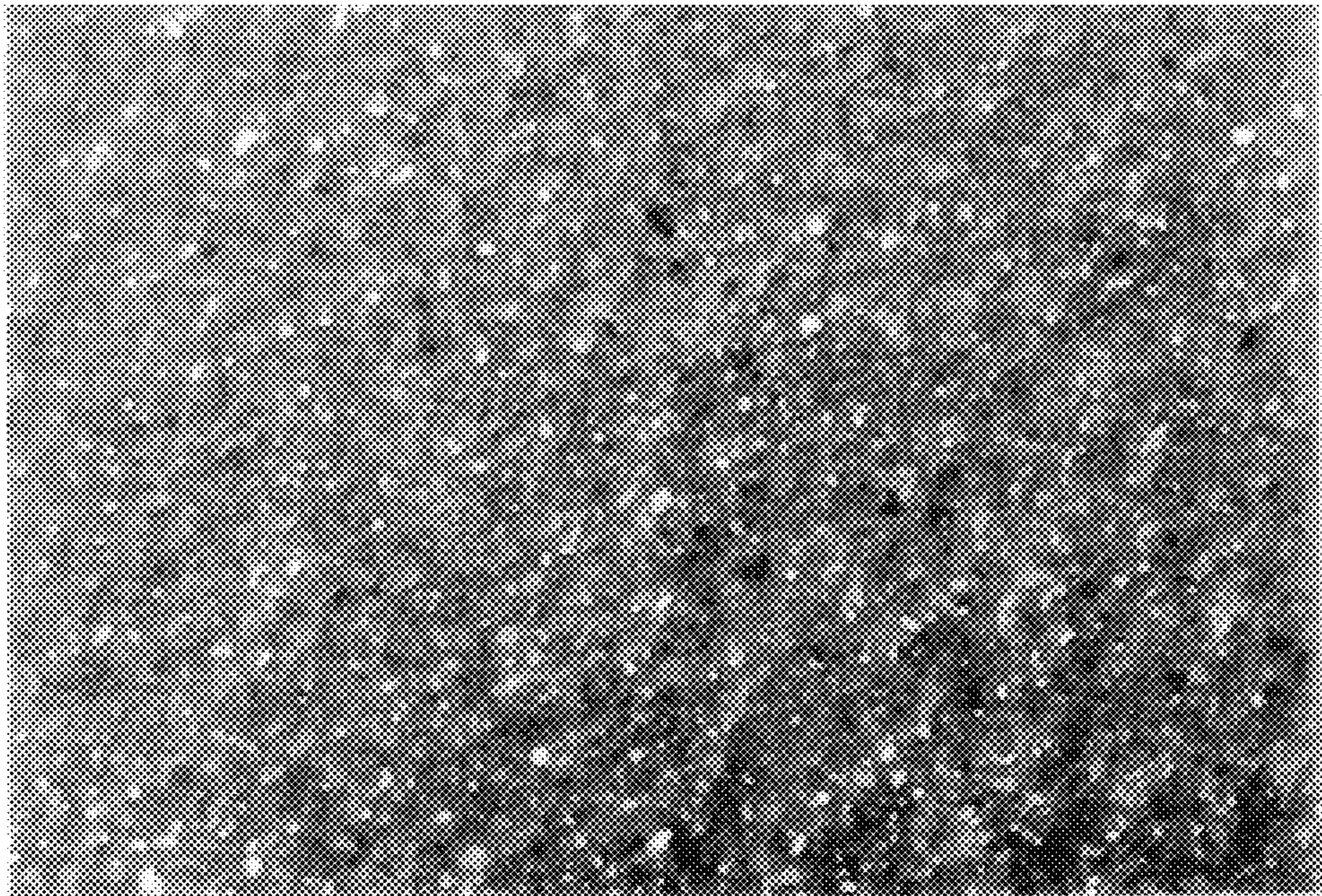

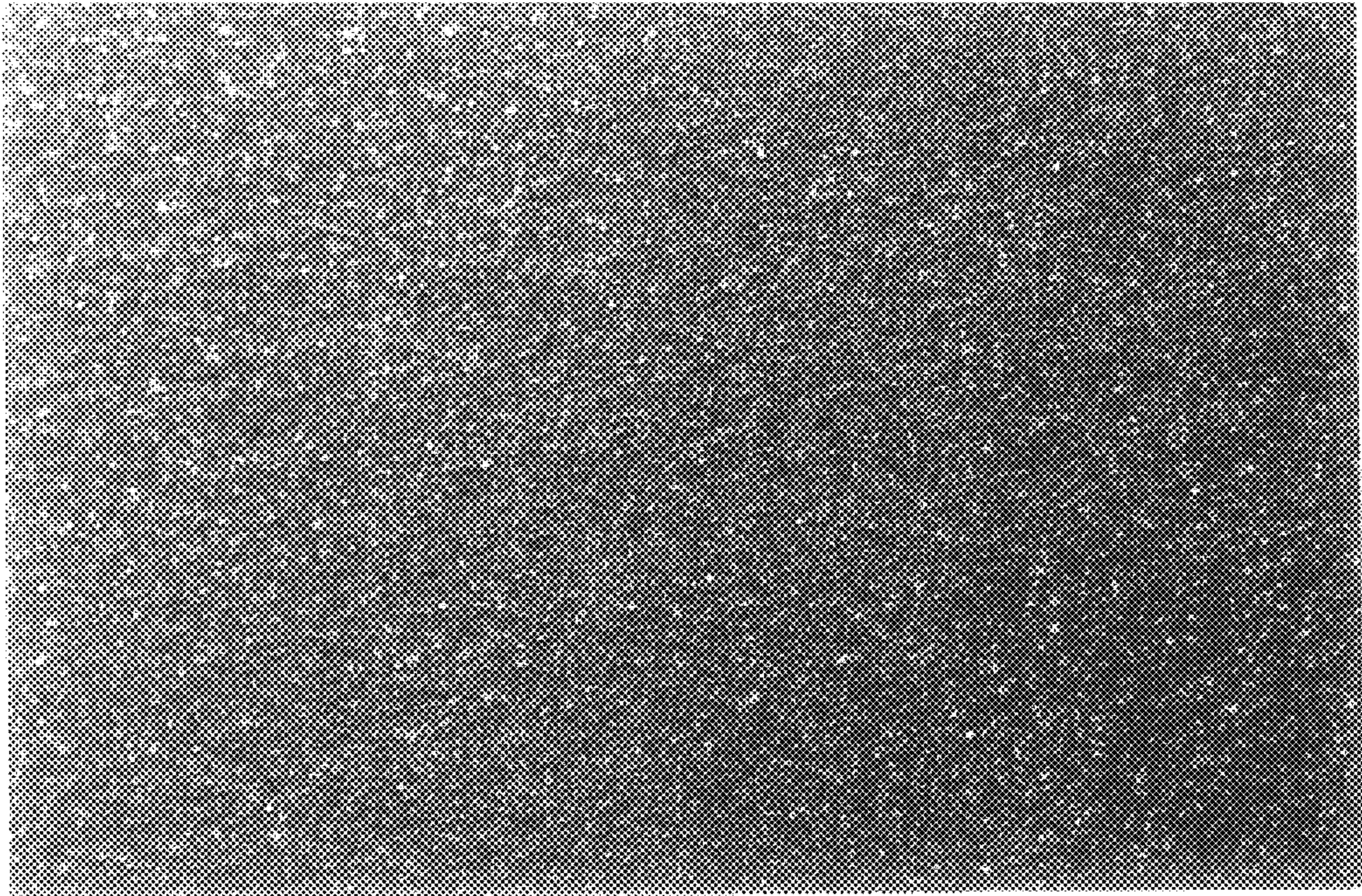
