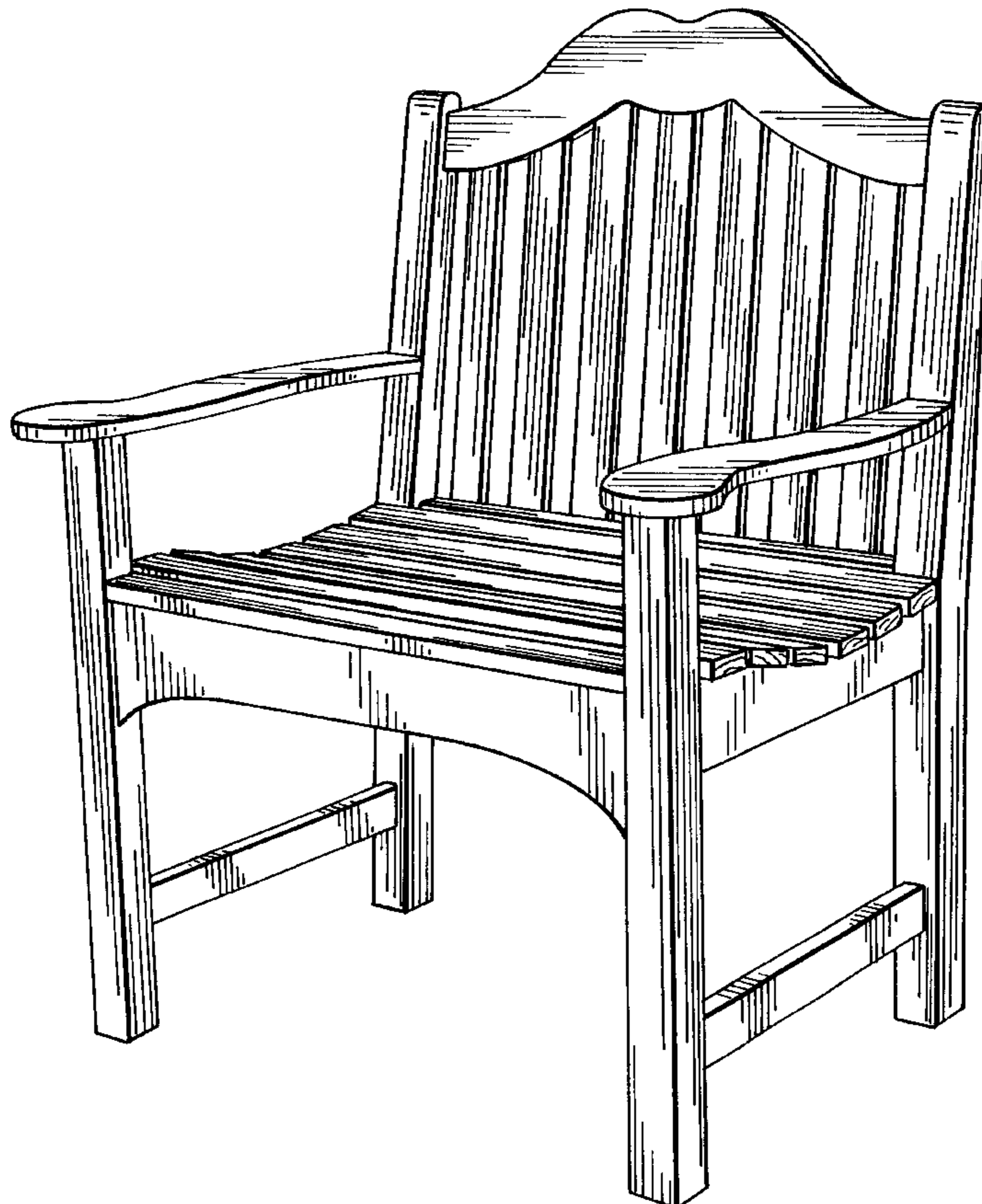
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an armchair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an armchair, showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a right elevational view thereof, the left elevational view being a mirror image;
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
 FIGS. 2–5 have been shown on a reduced scale with respect to FIG. 1.

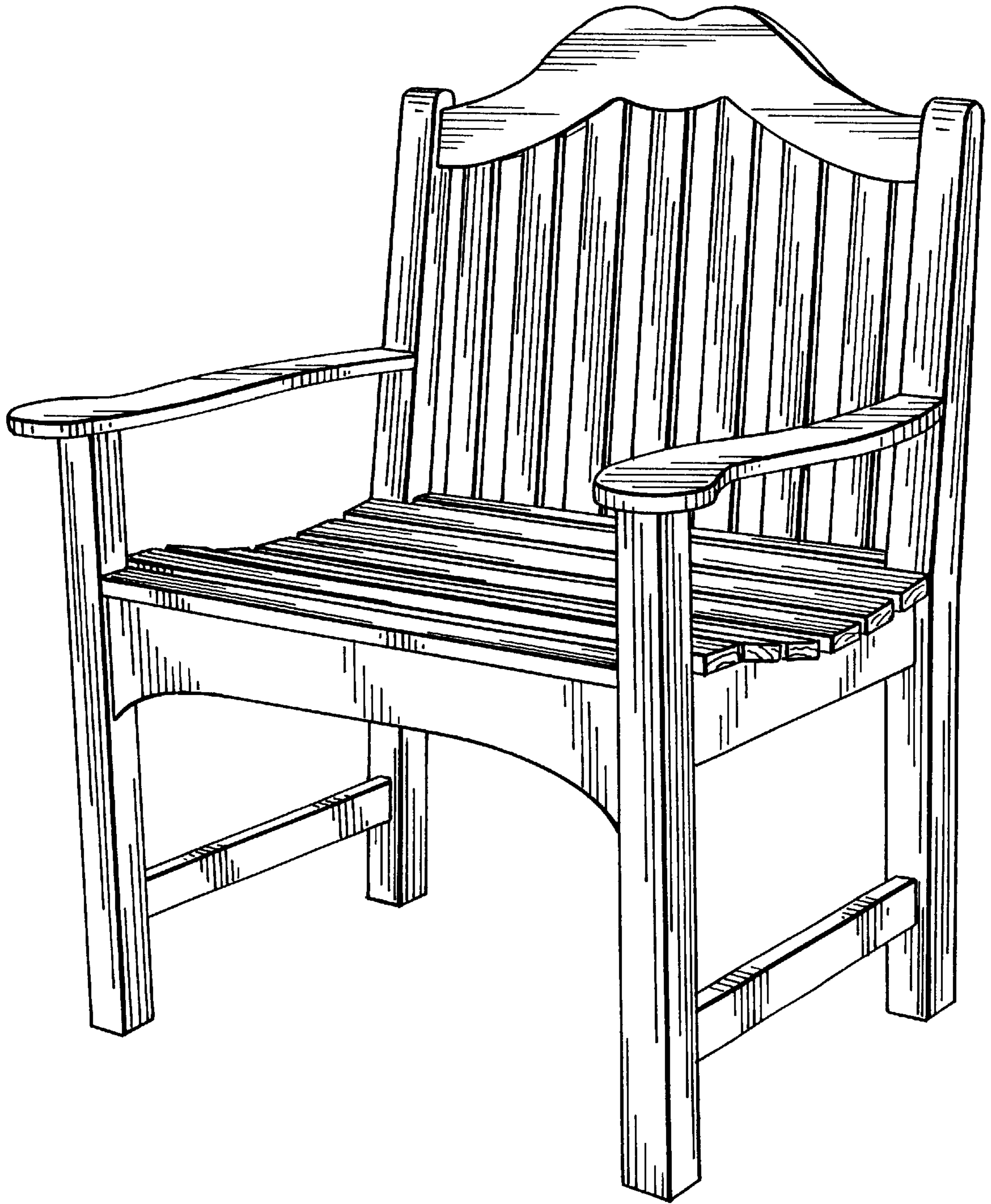

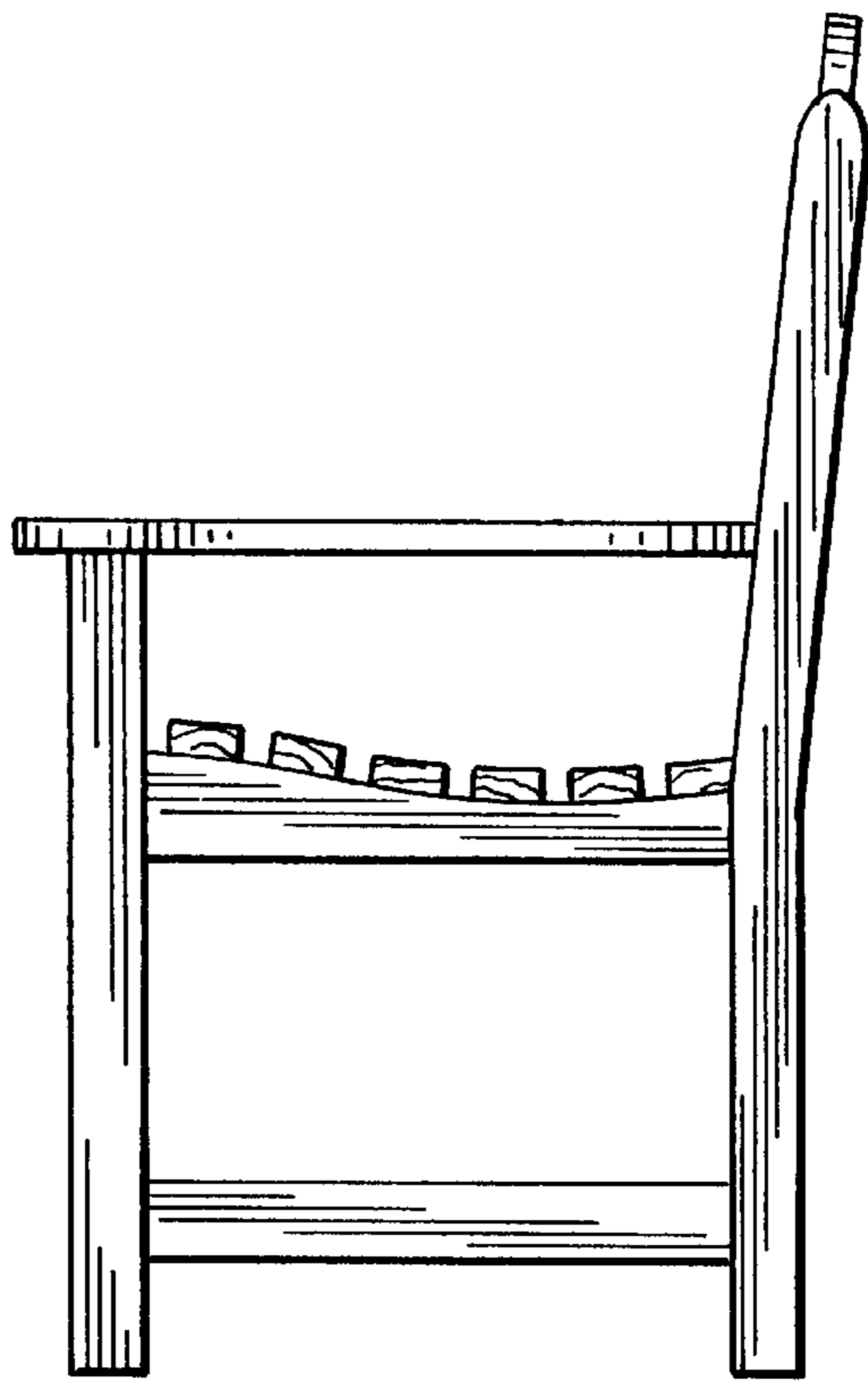
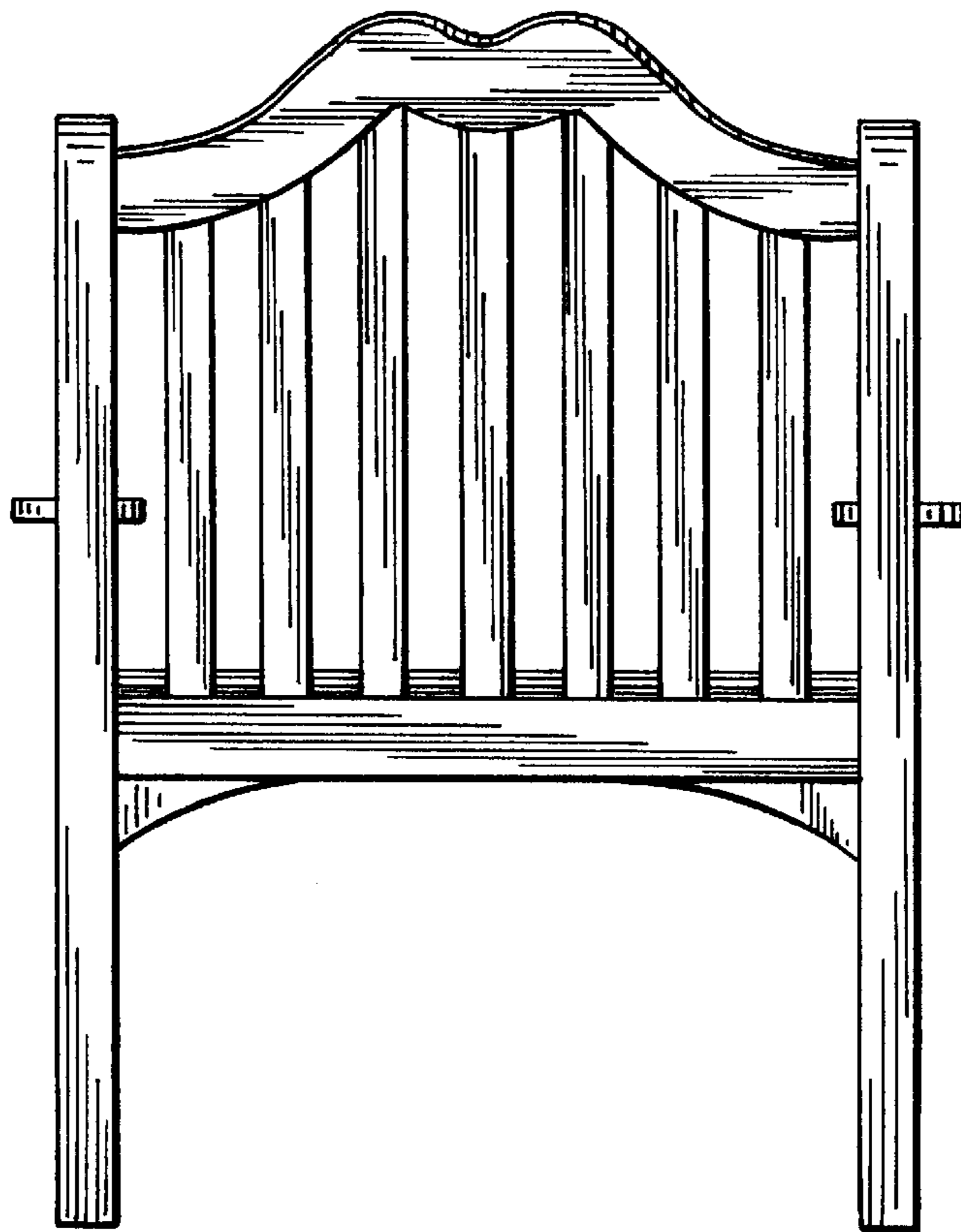

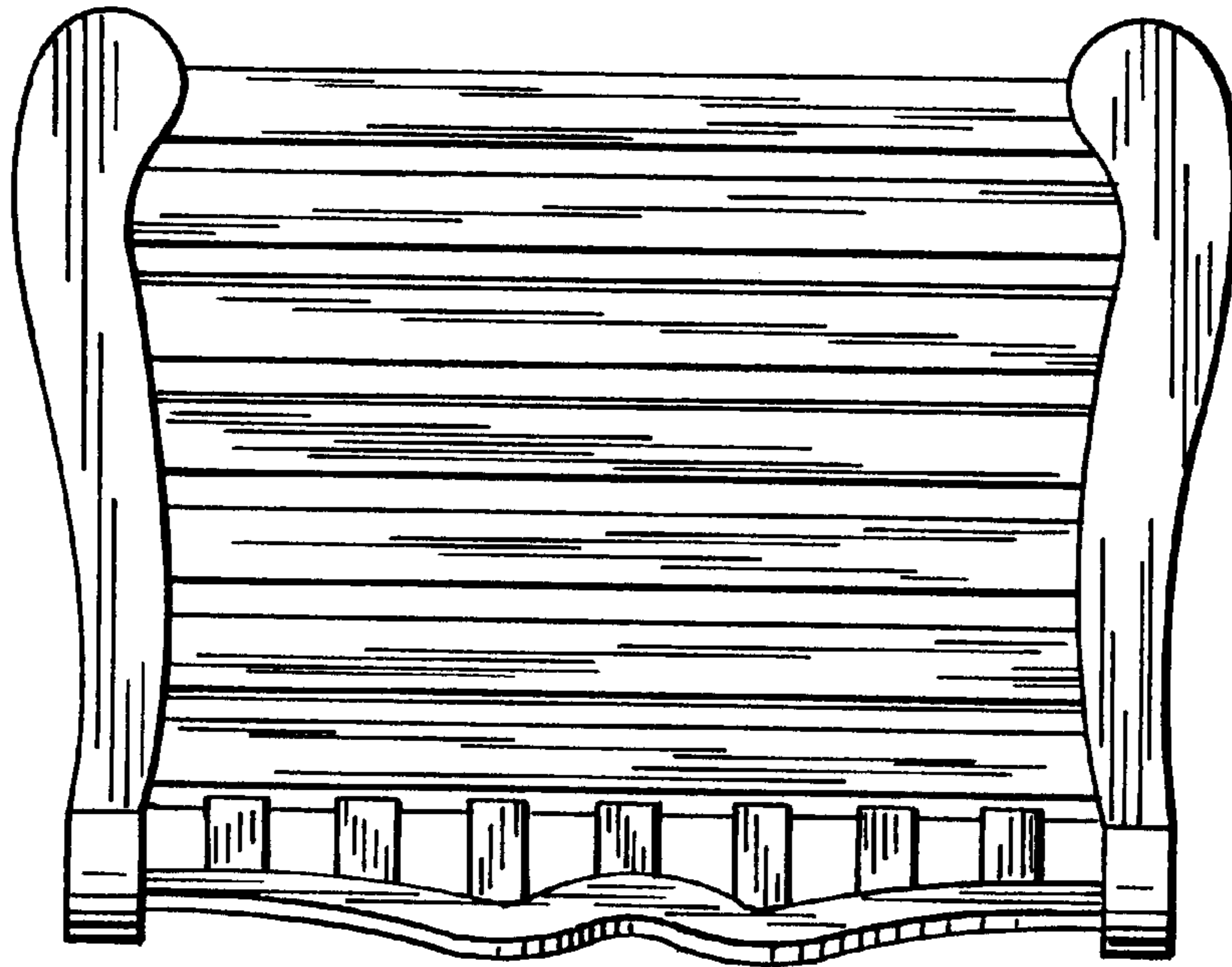

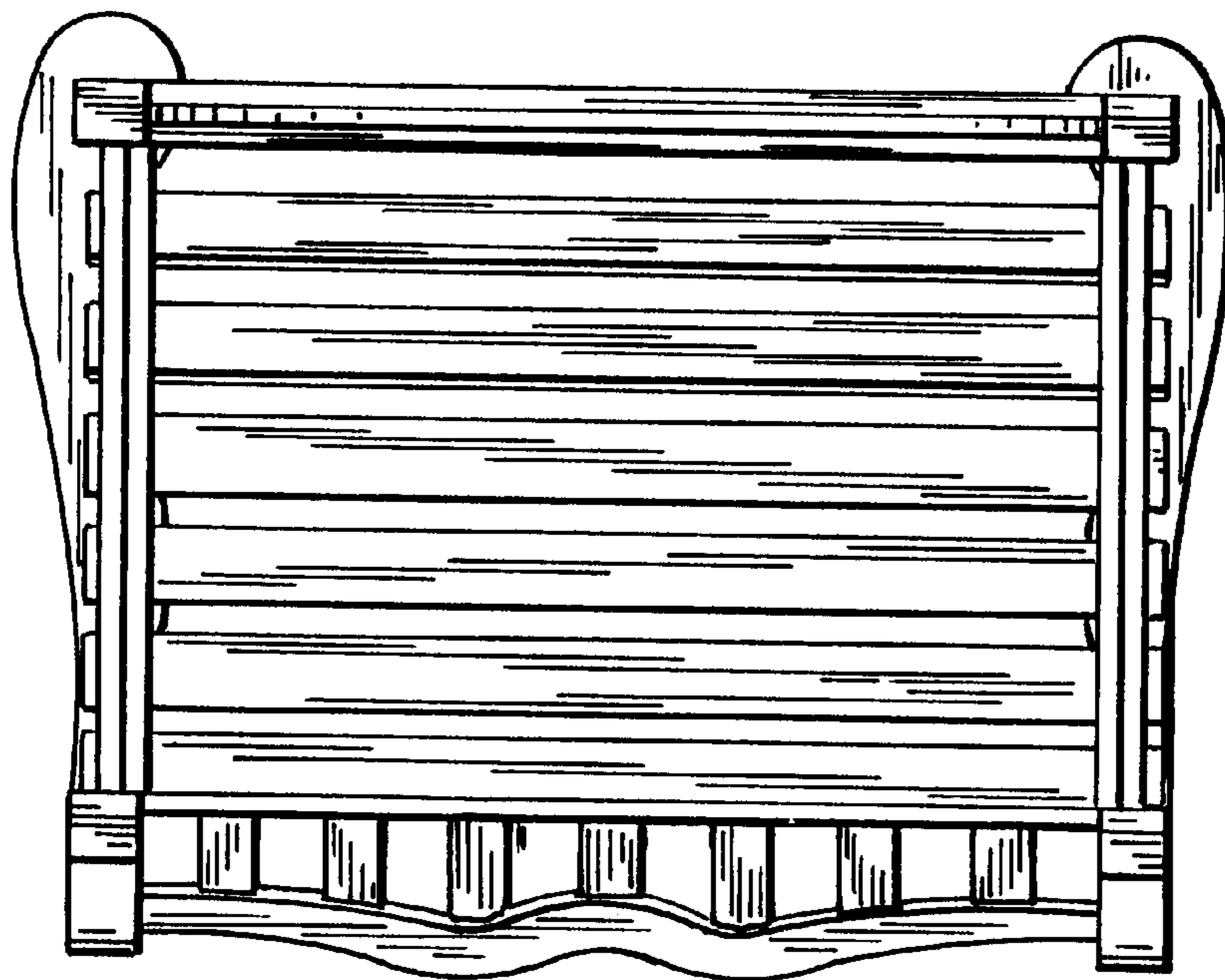
