The ornamental design for a console, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a console showing my new design;

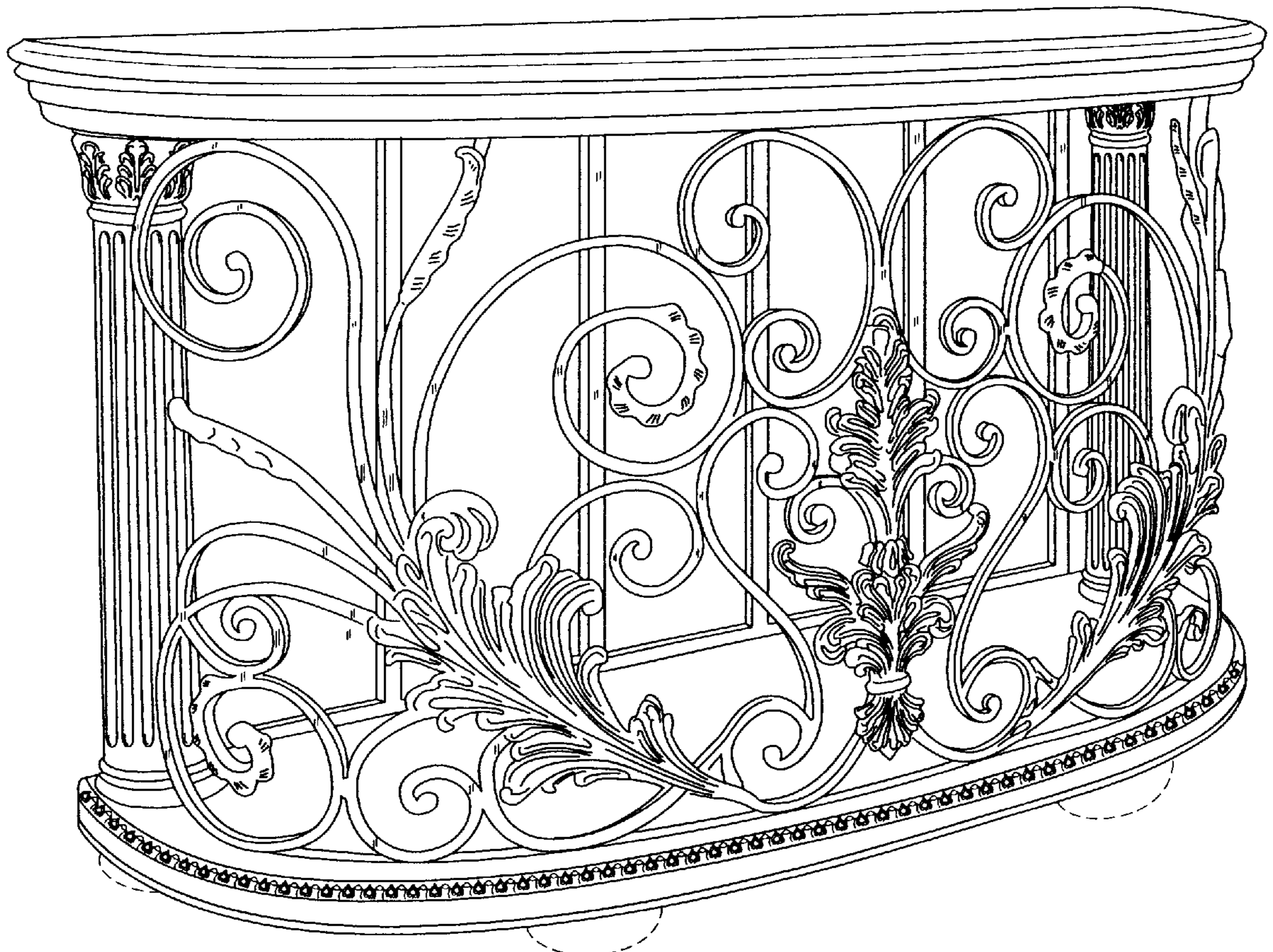
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

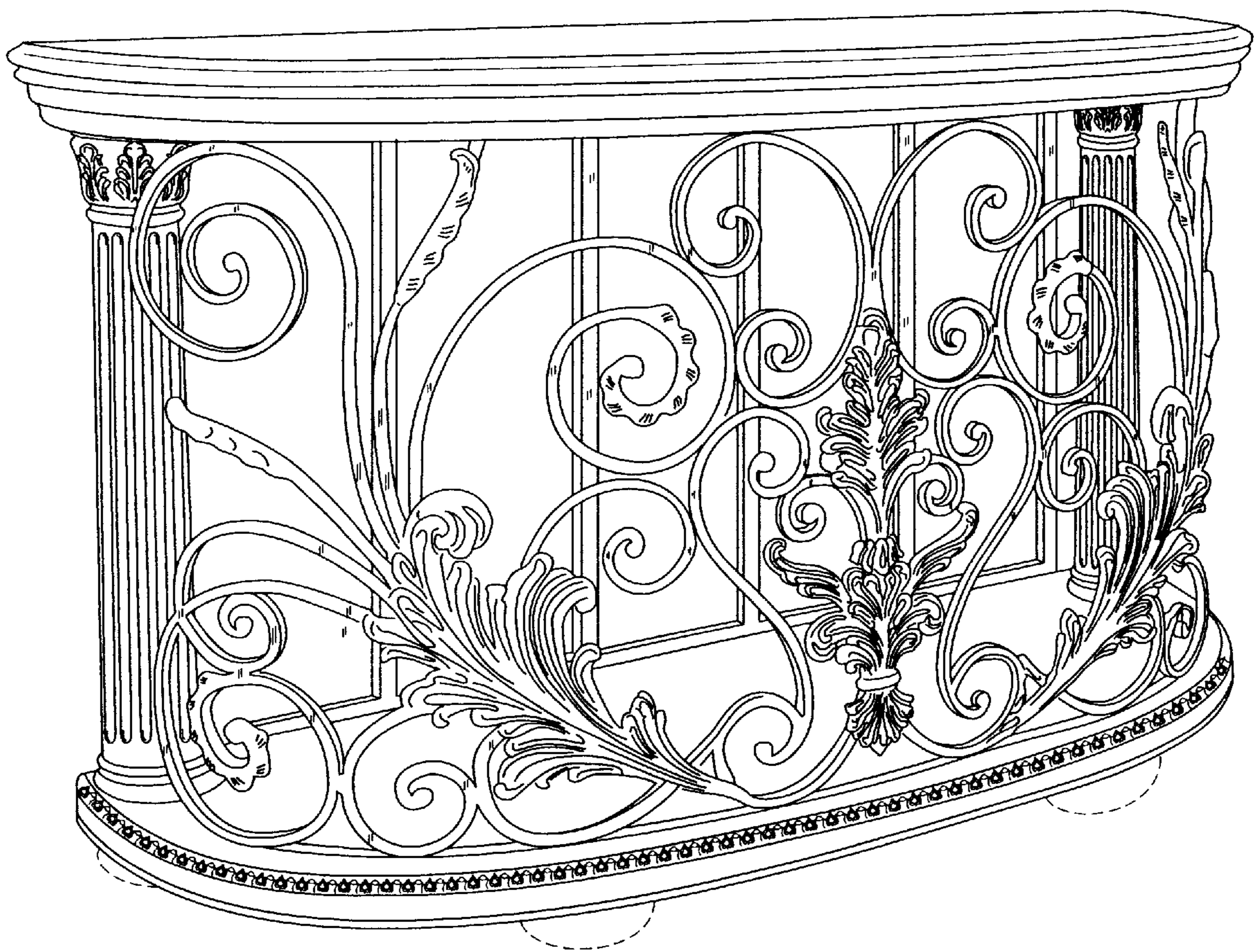

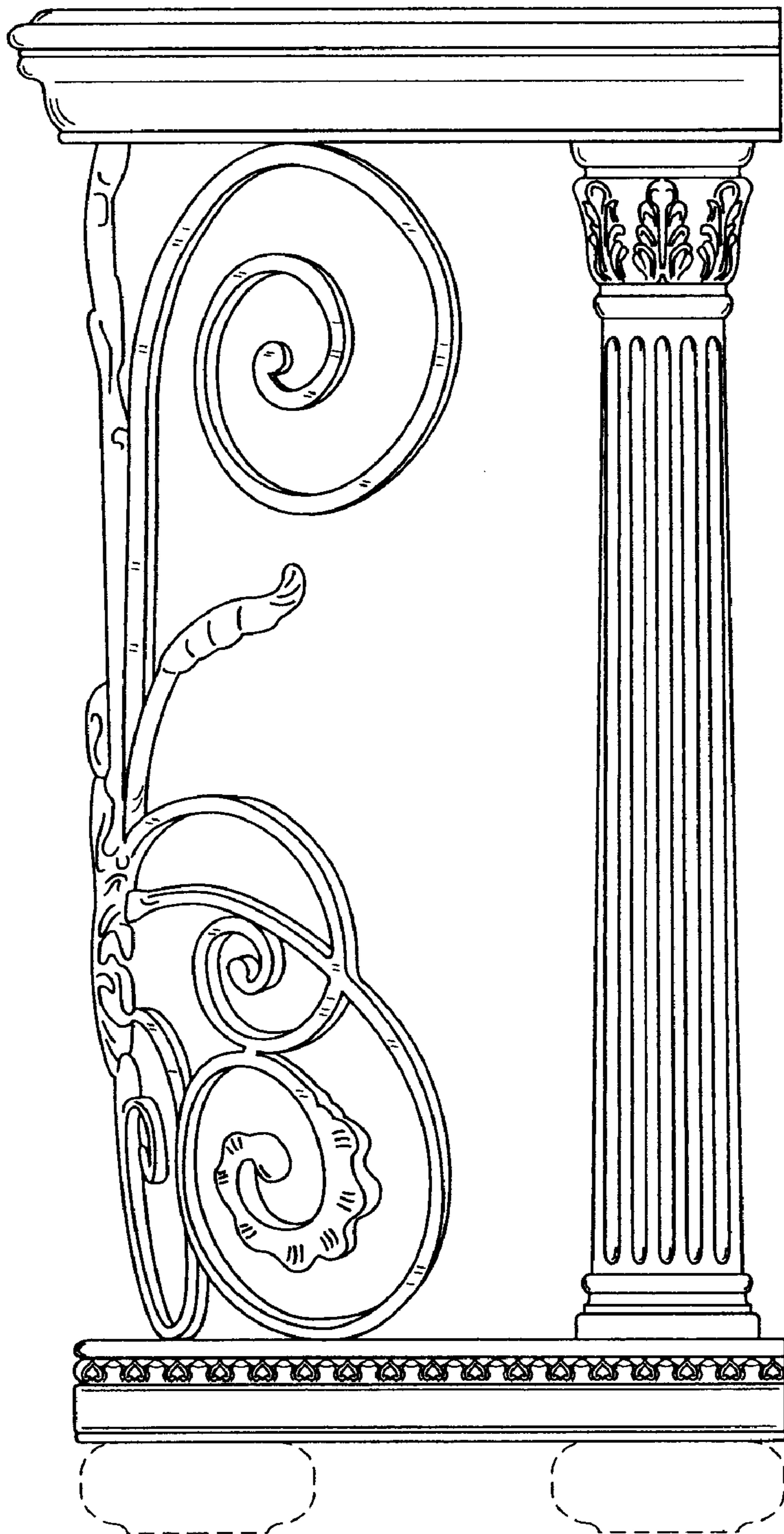

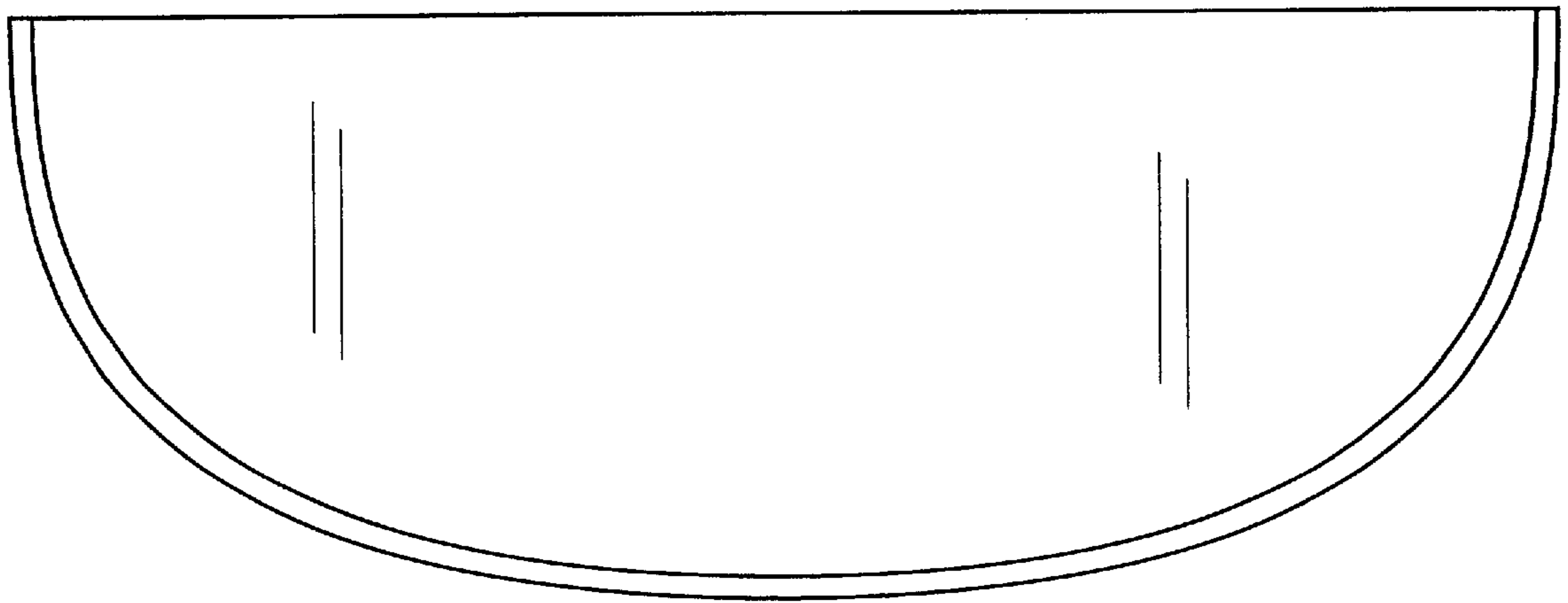
