showing our new design.

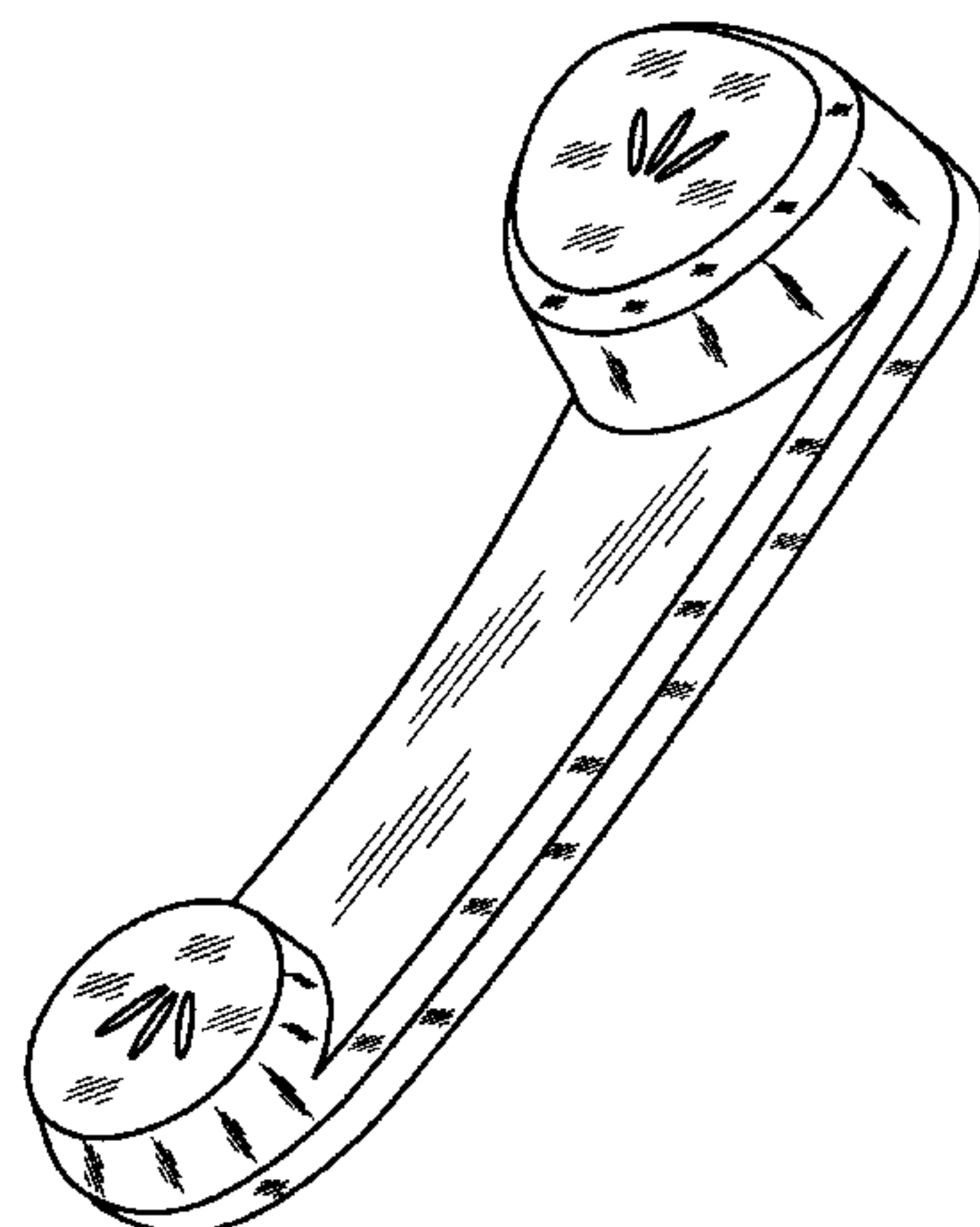
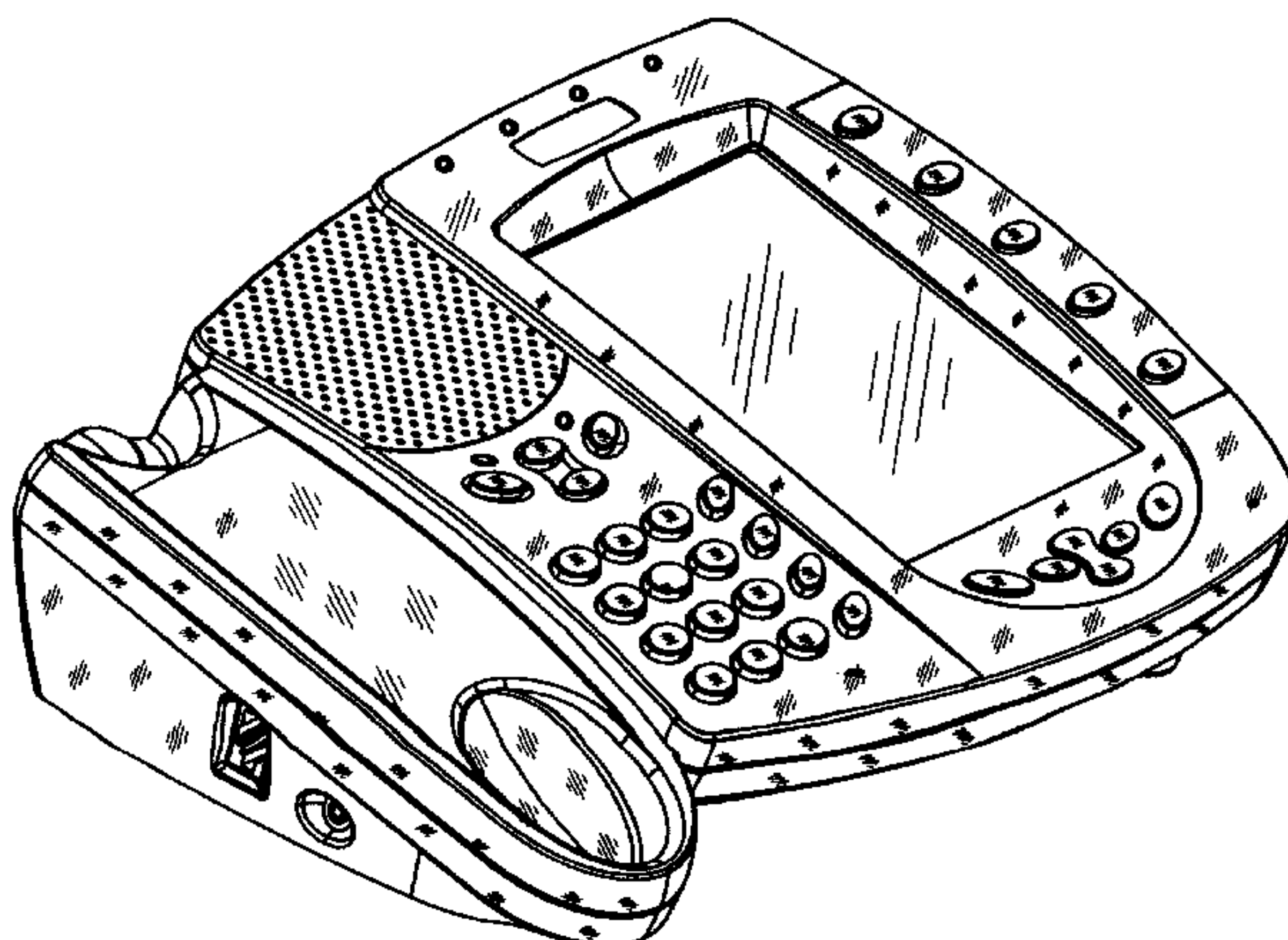
FIG. 10 is a perspective view from the right of a telephone

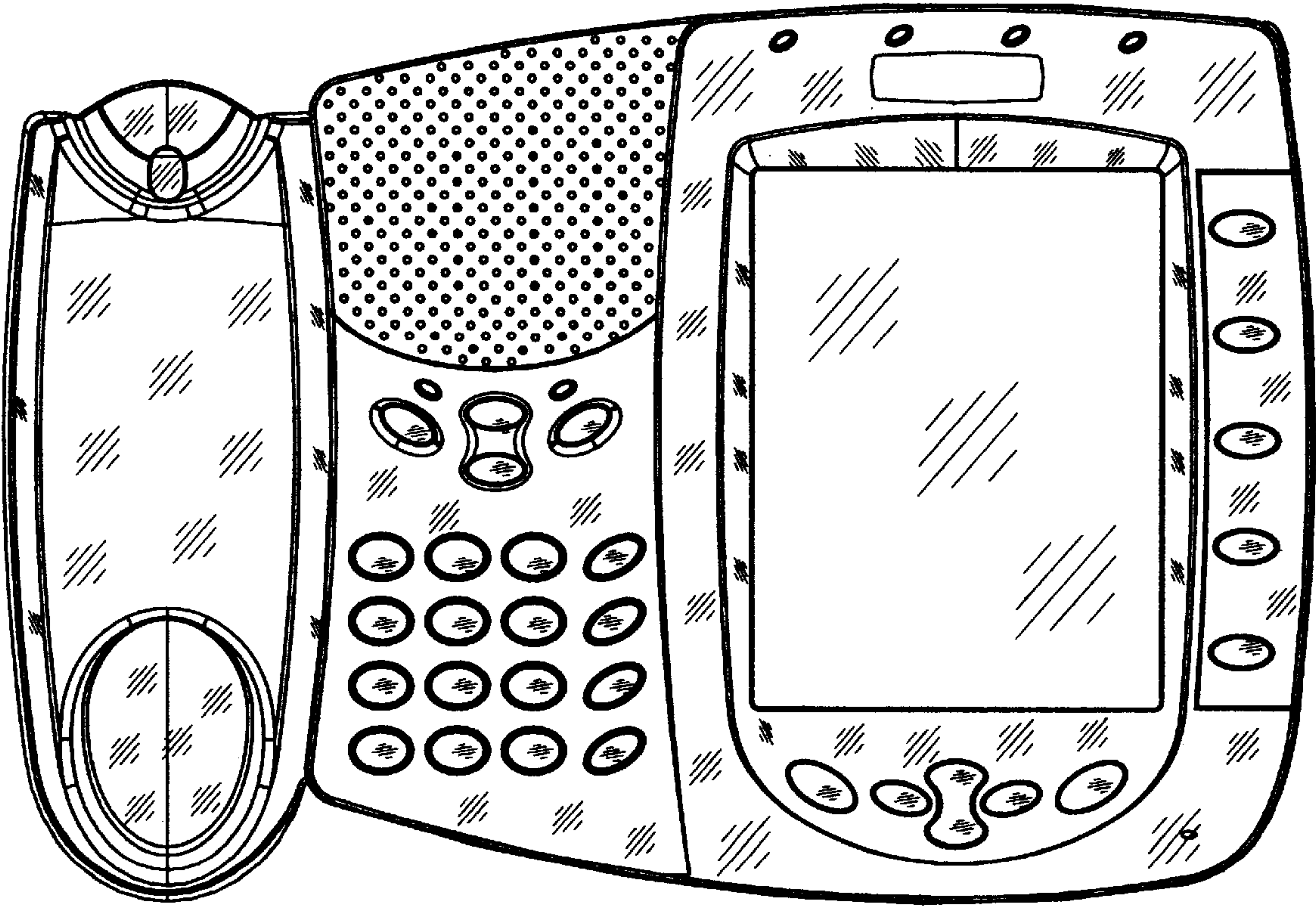

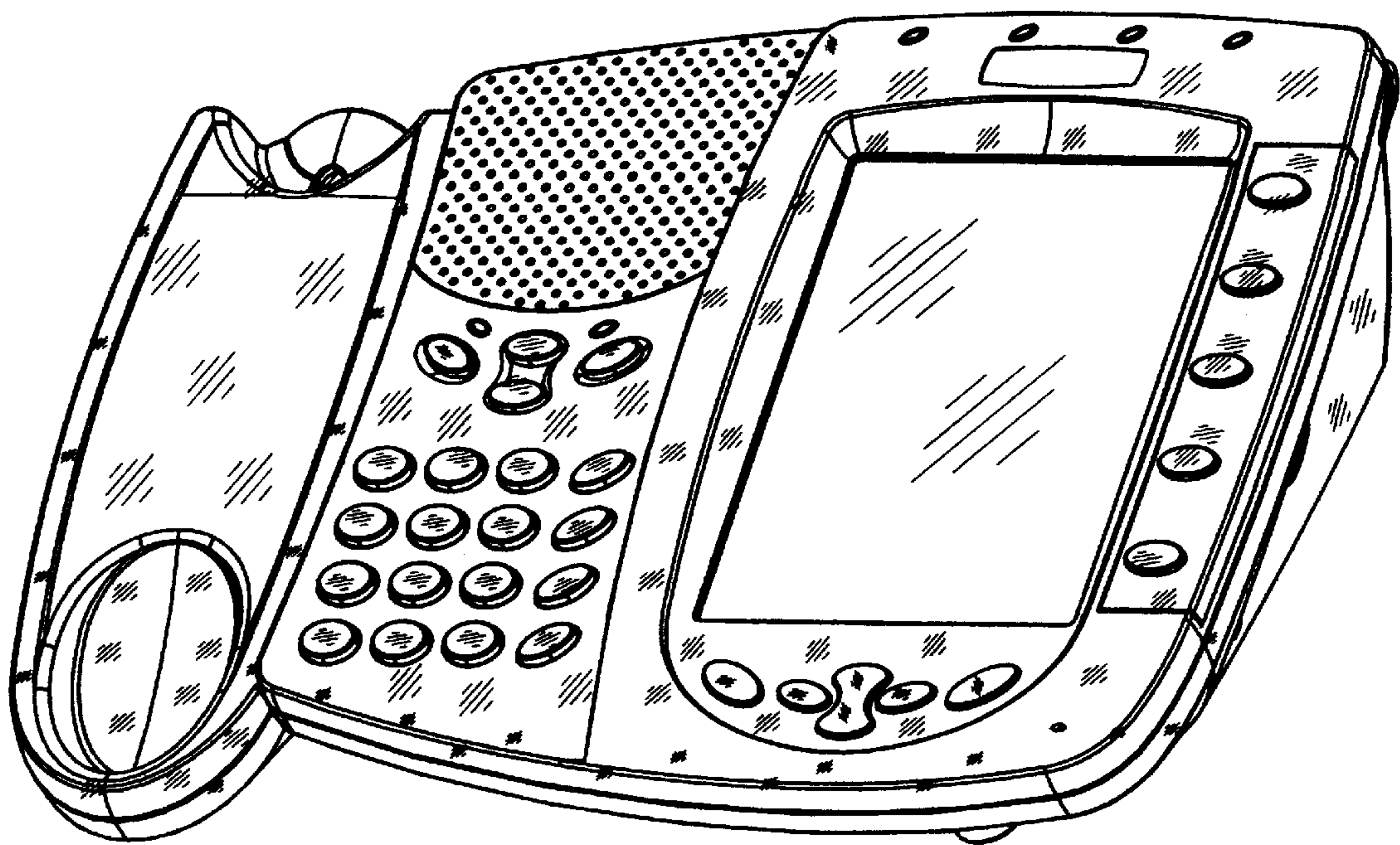

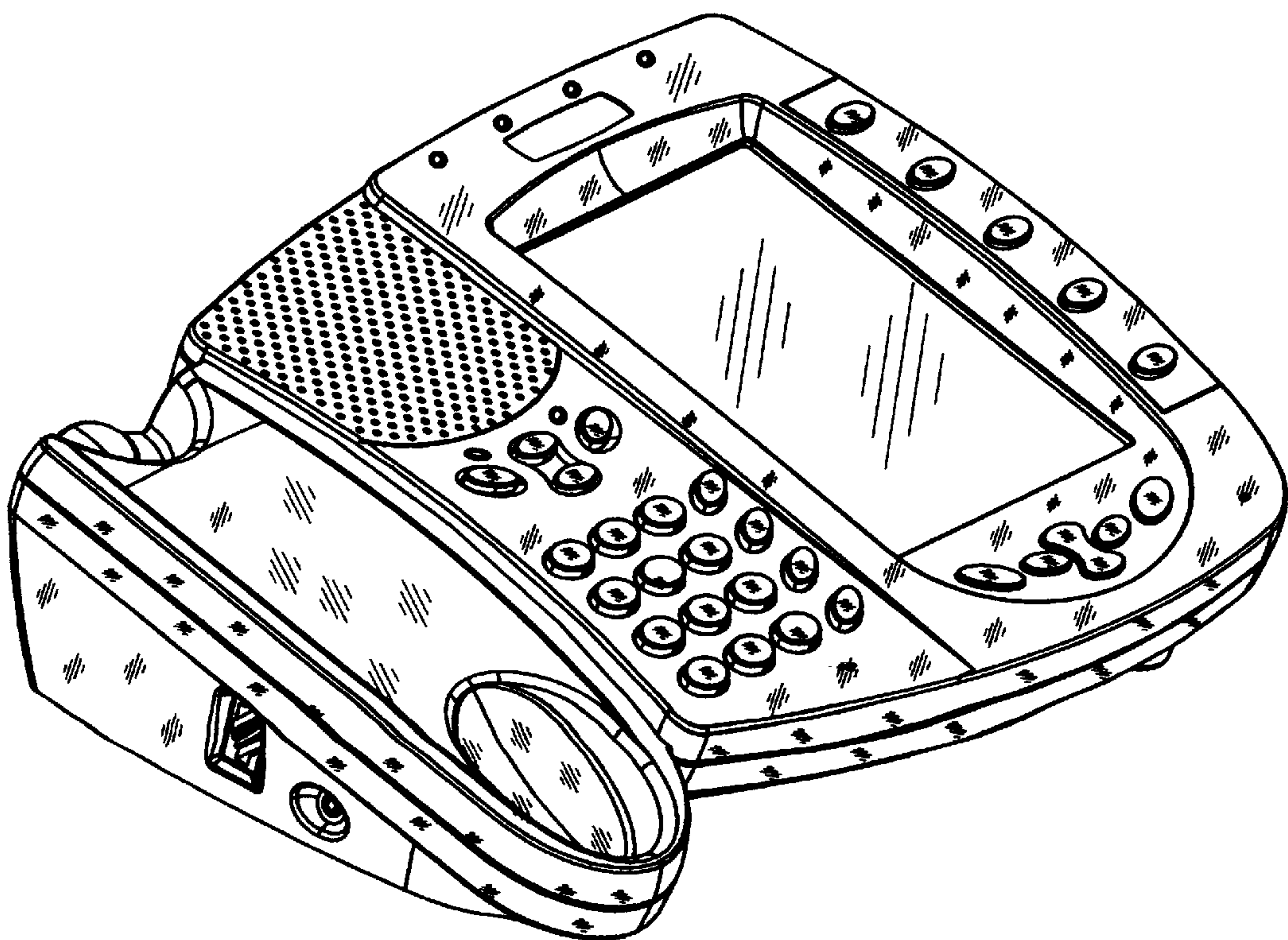

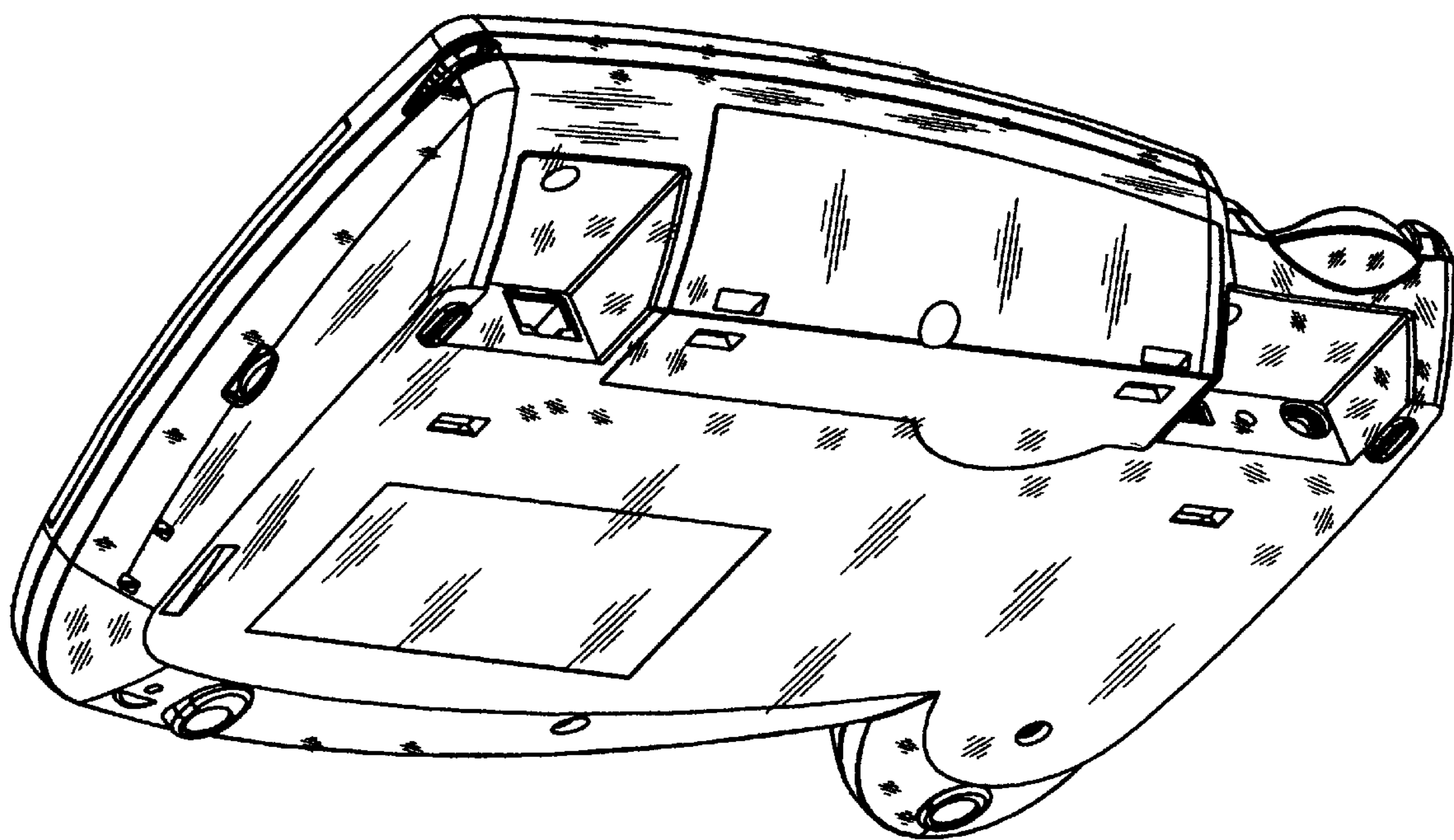

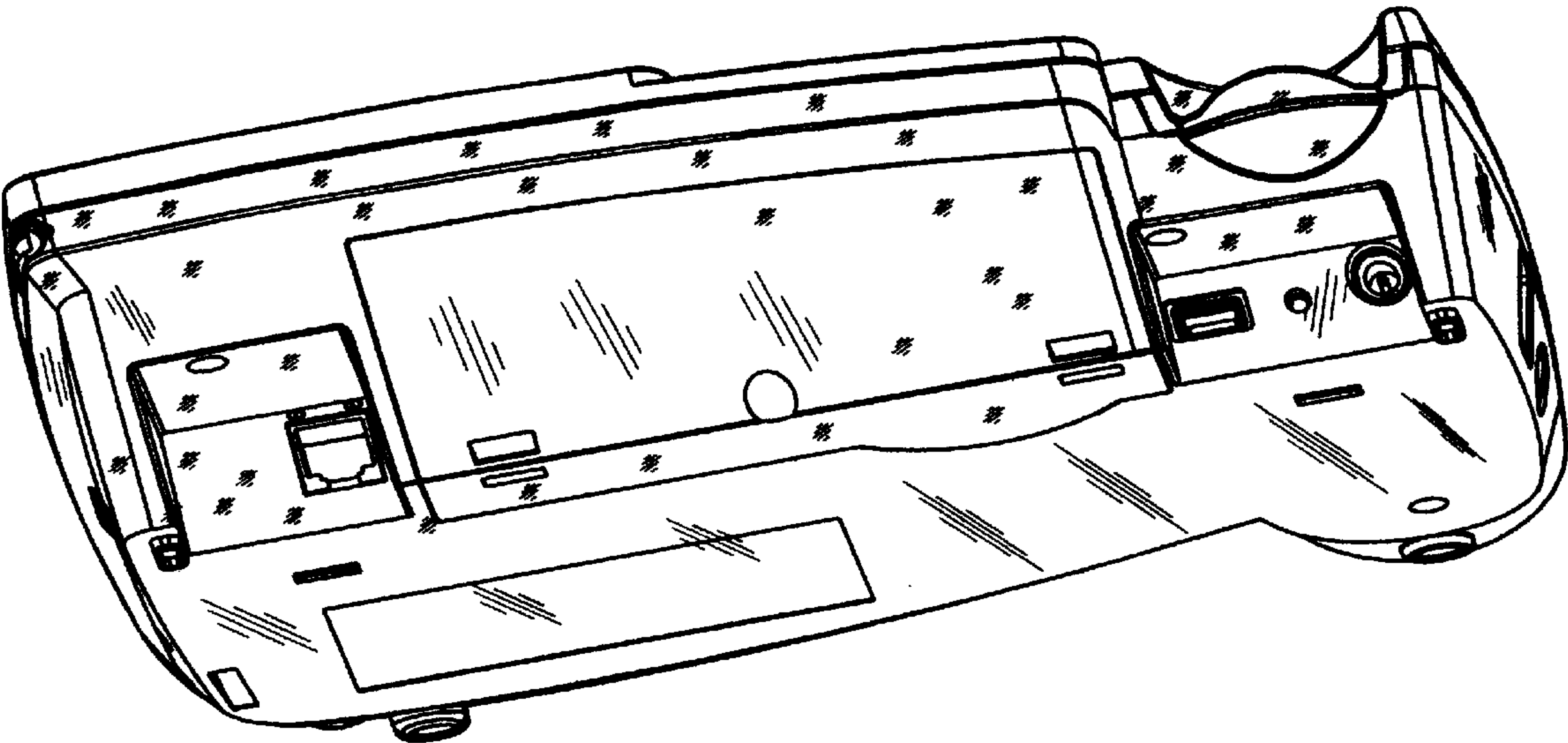

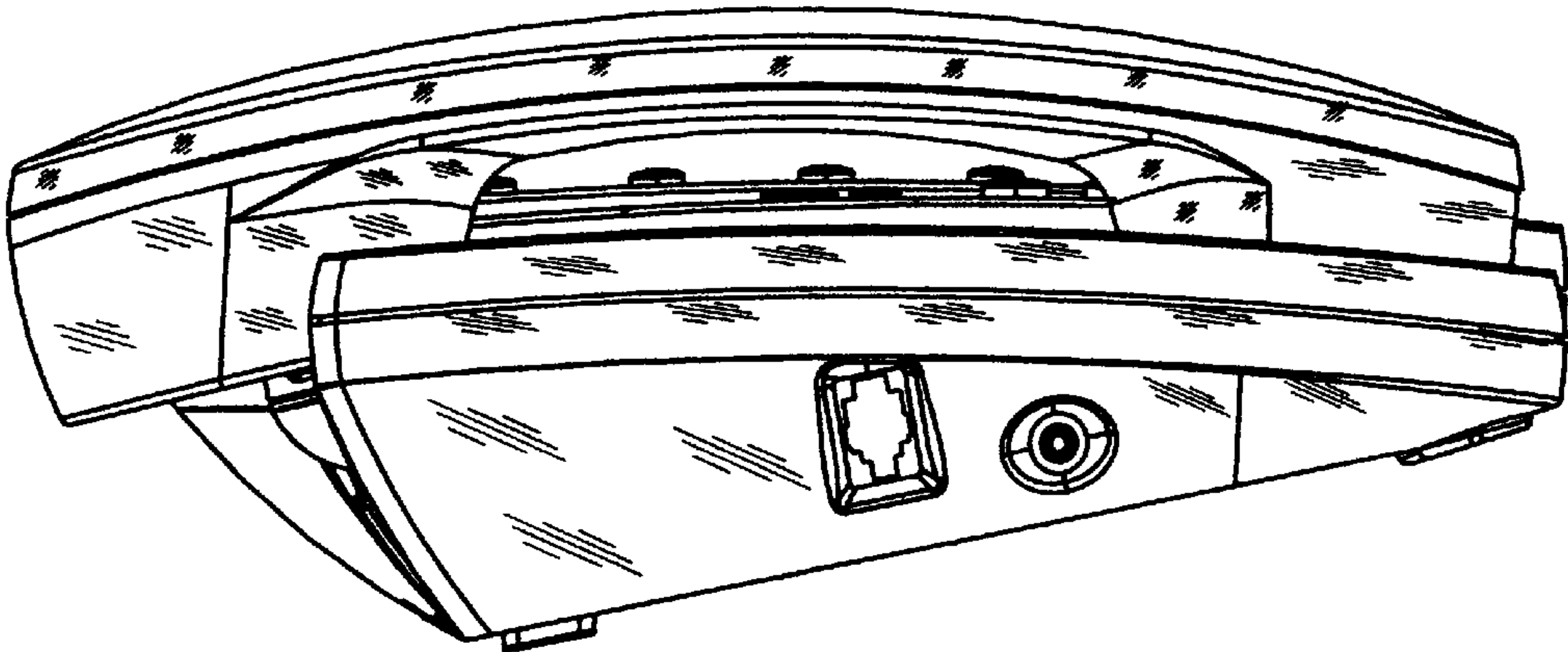

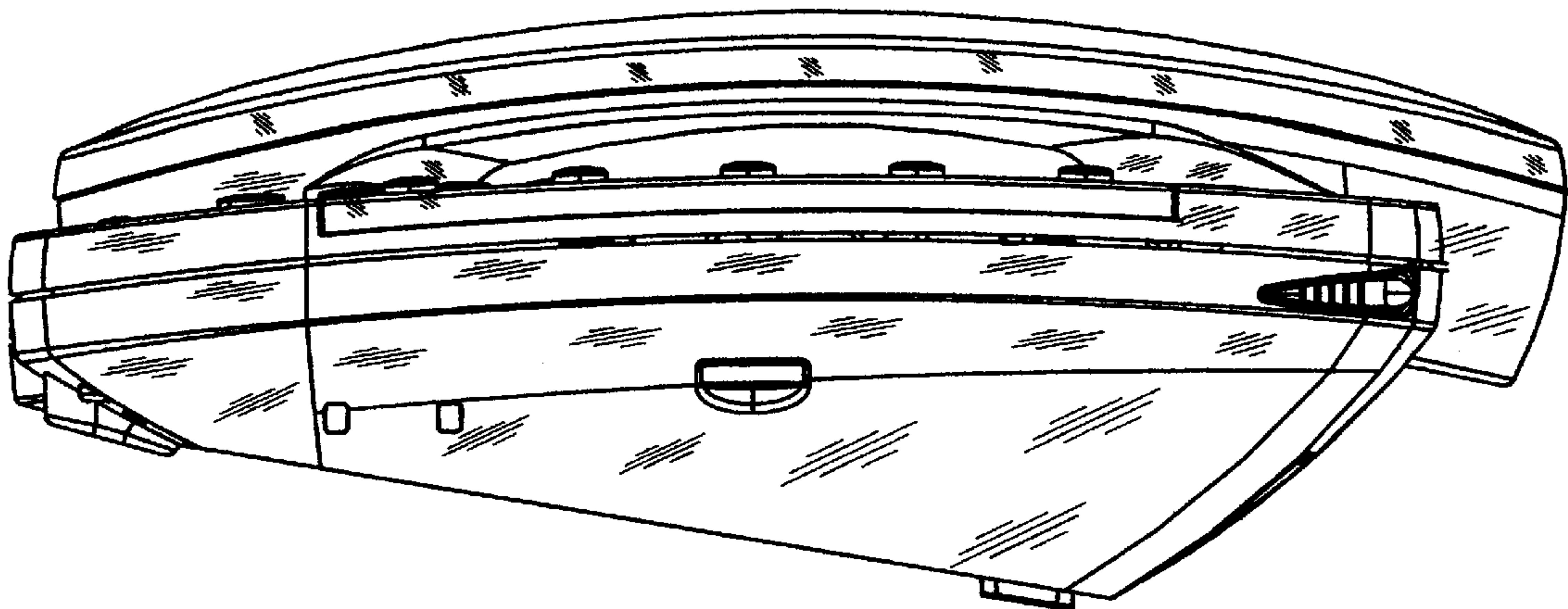

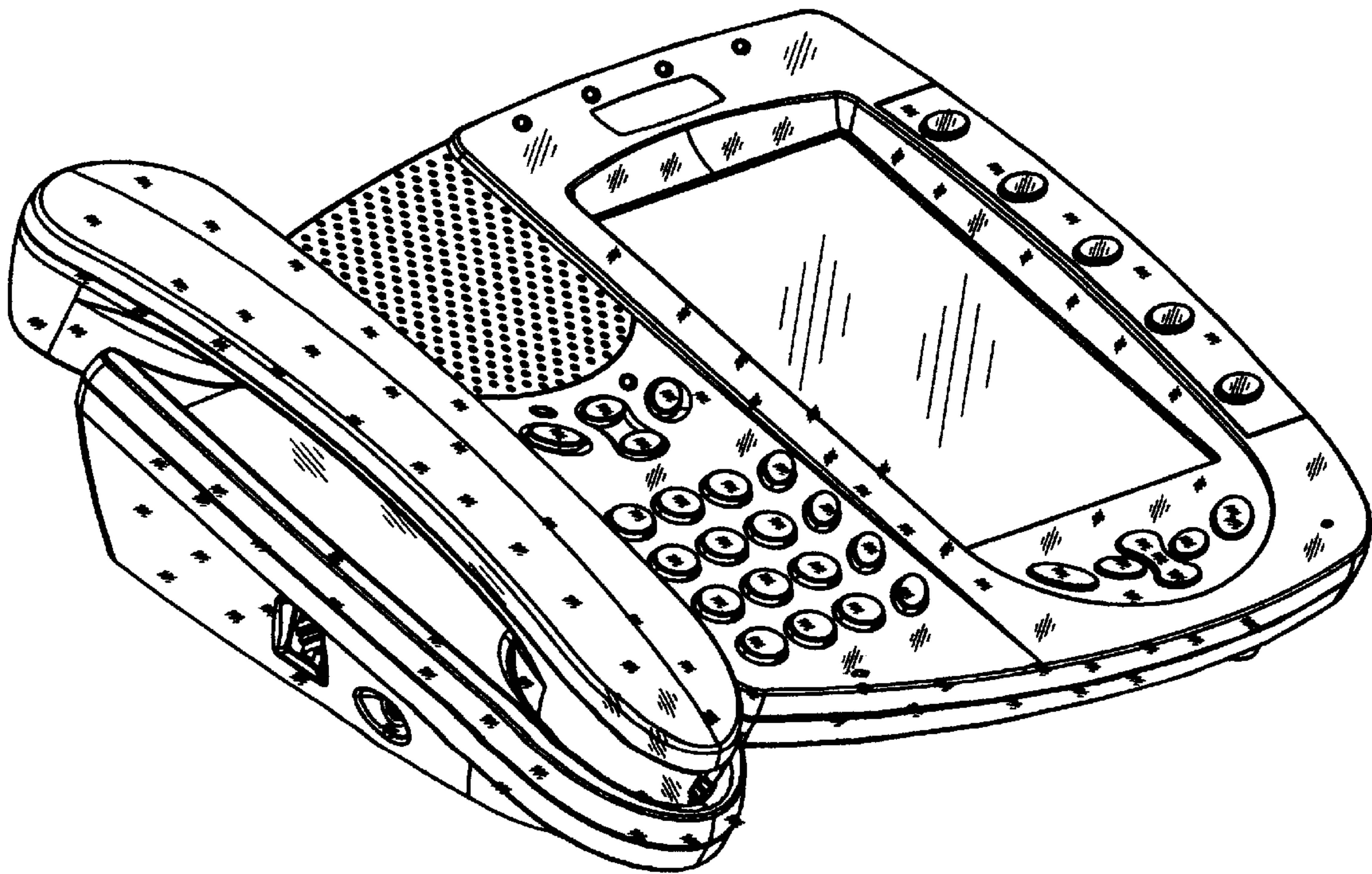

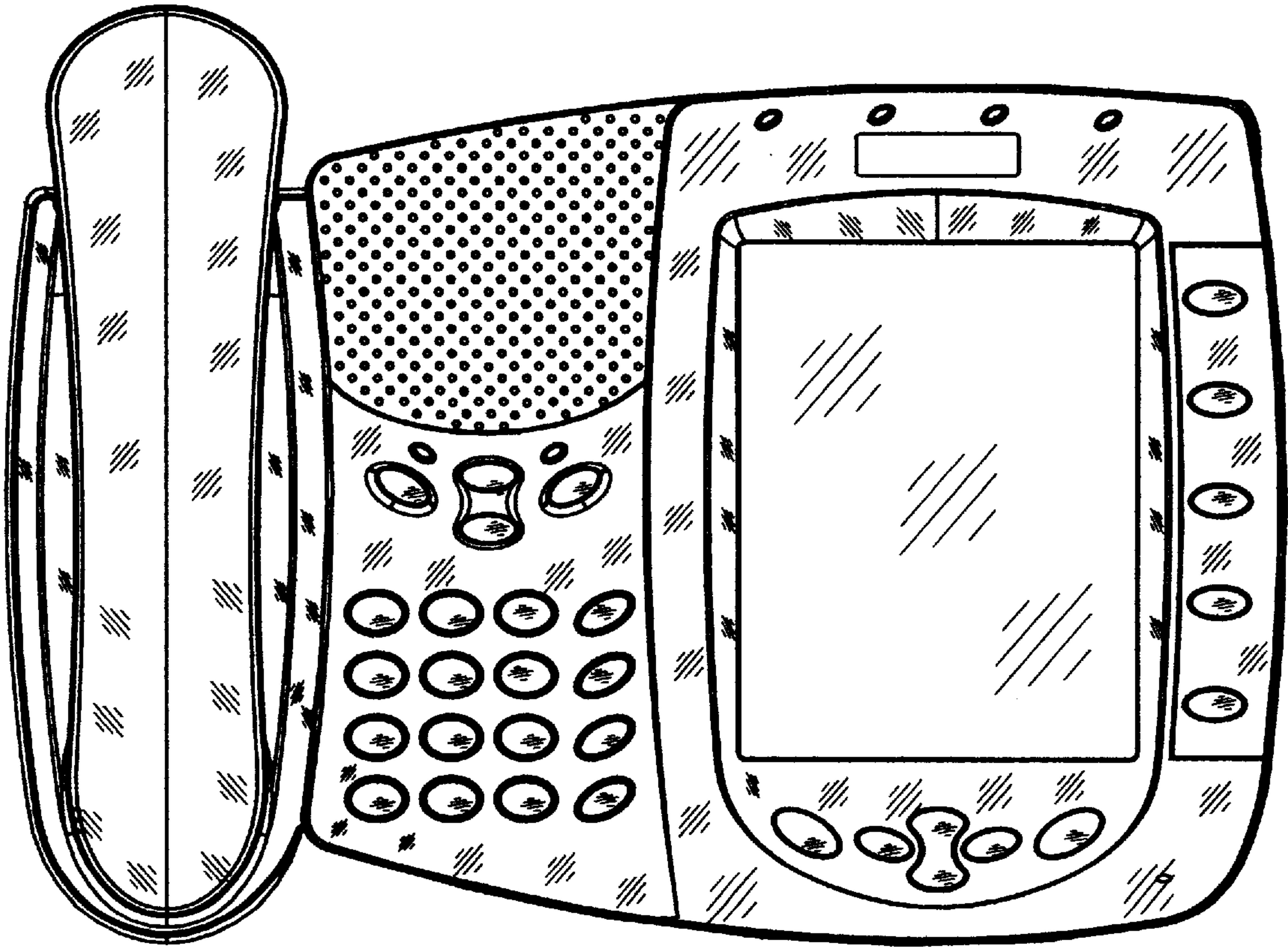

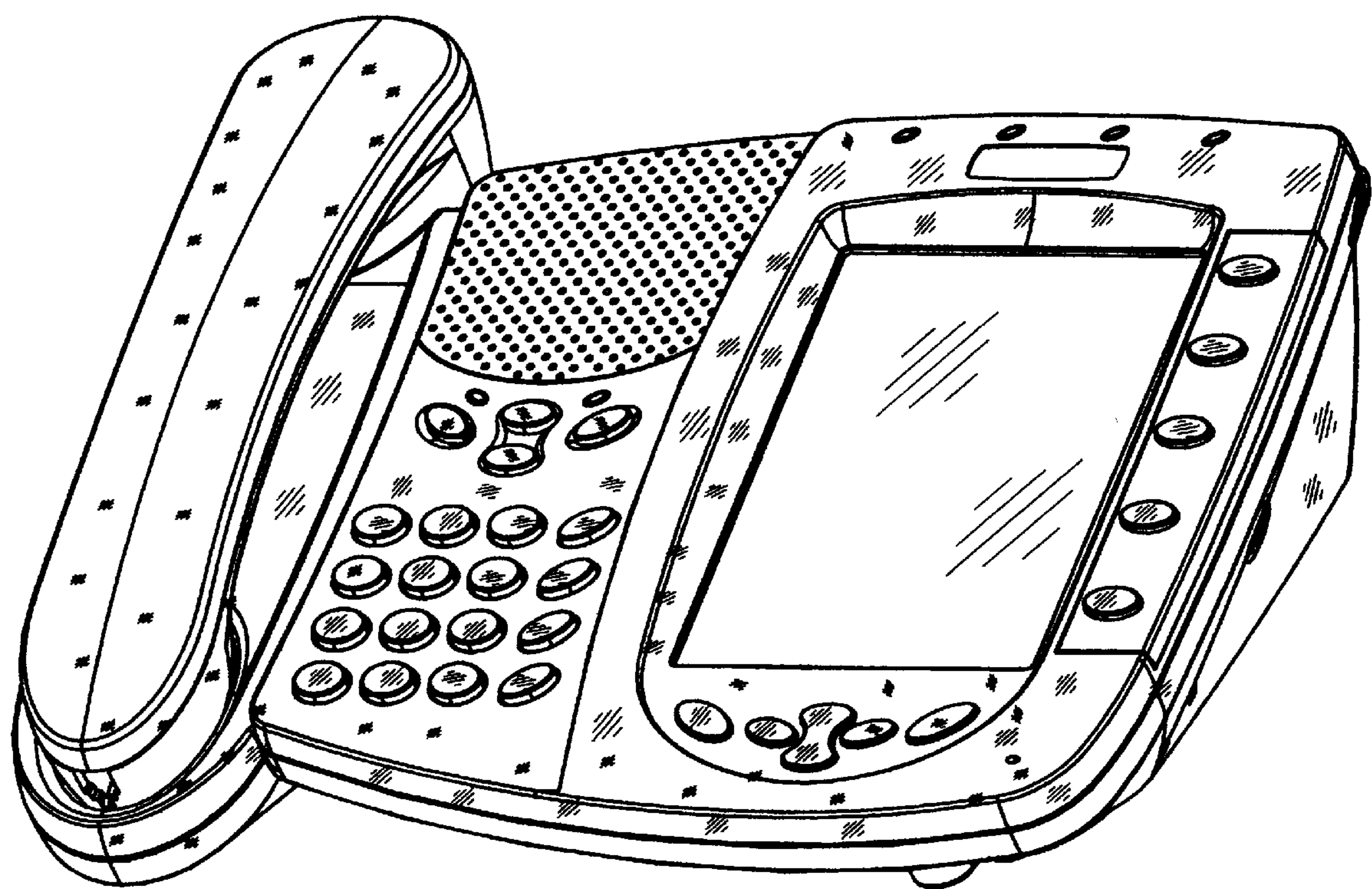

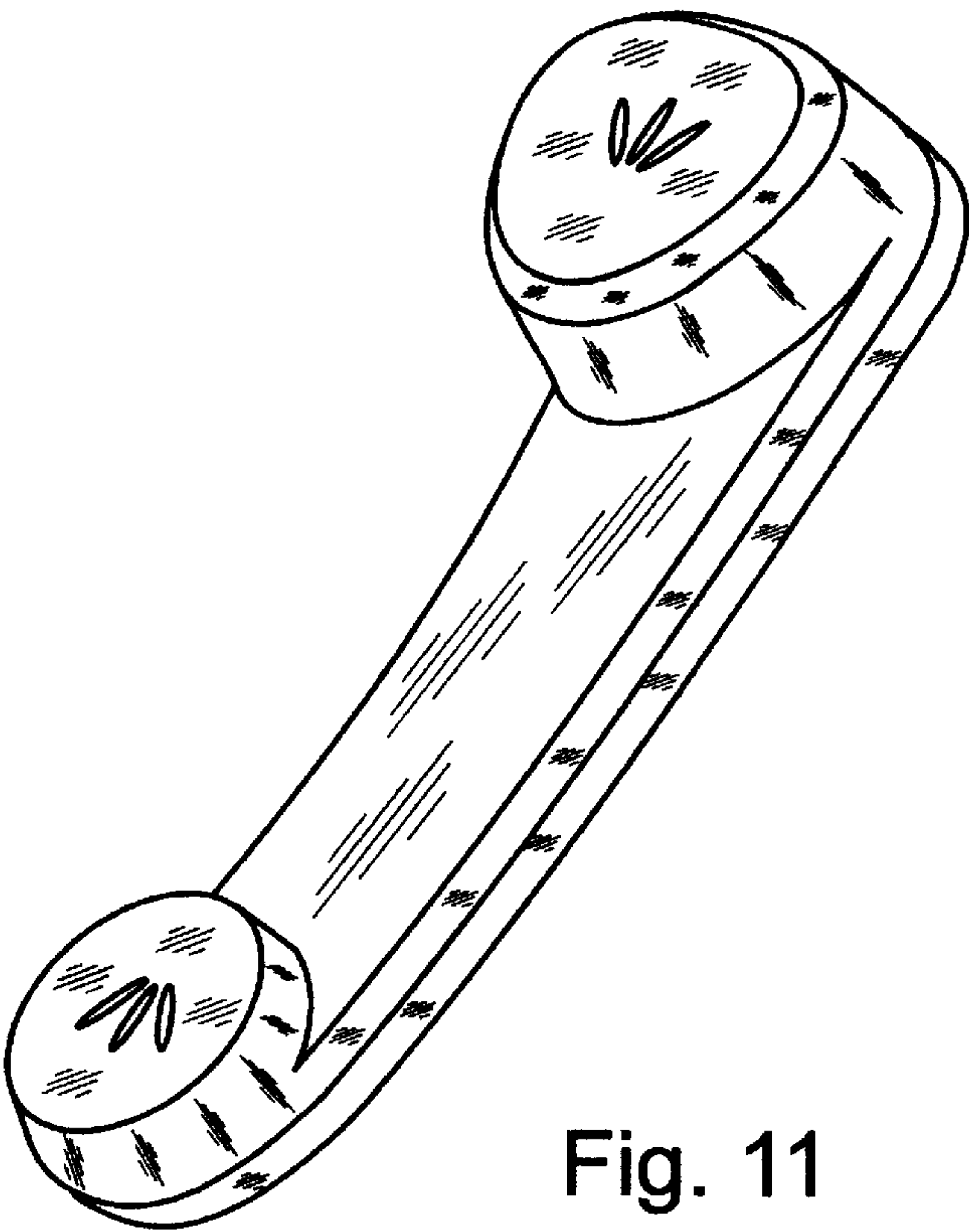

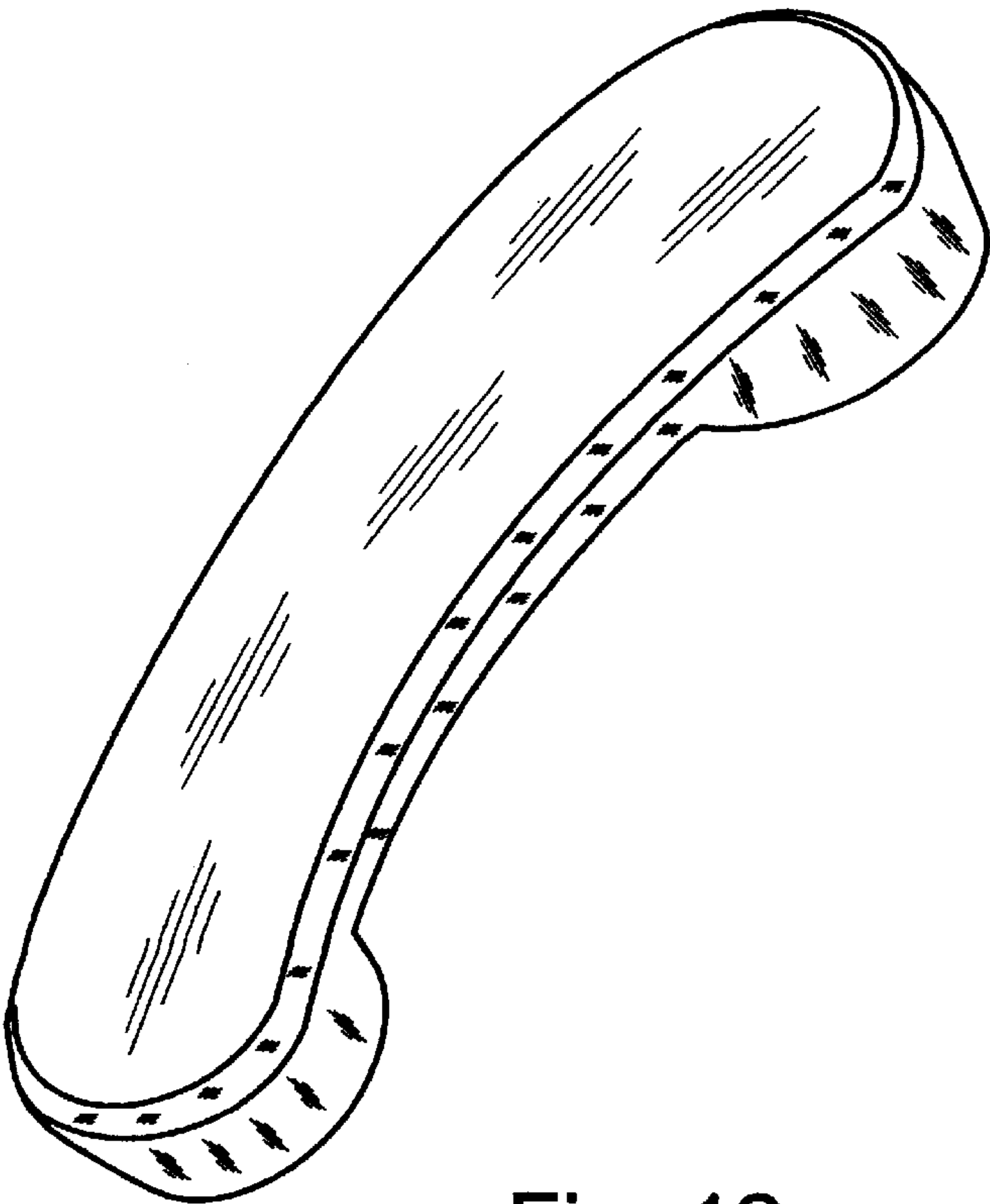
