The ornamental design for a transition for mount for track lighting fixture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view for a transition for a mount for track lighting fixture showing my new design;

FIG. 15 is a top plan view thereof;

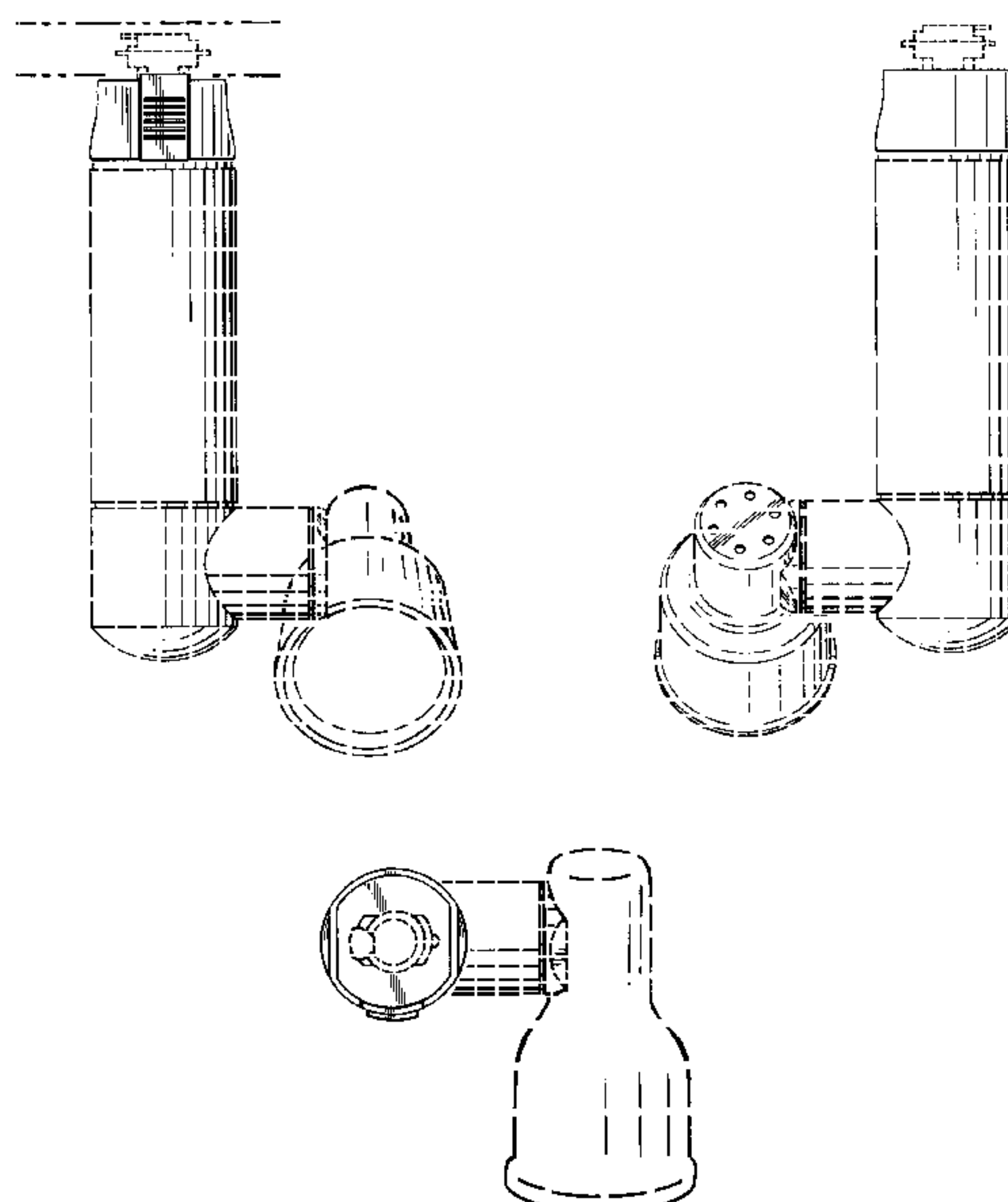
FIG. 16 is a bottom plan view thereof;

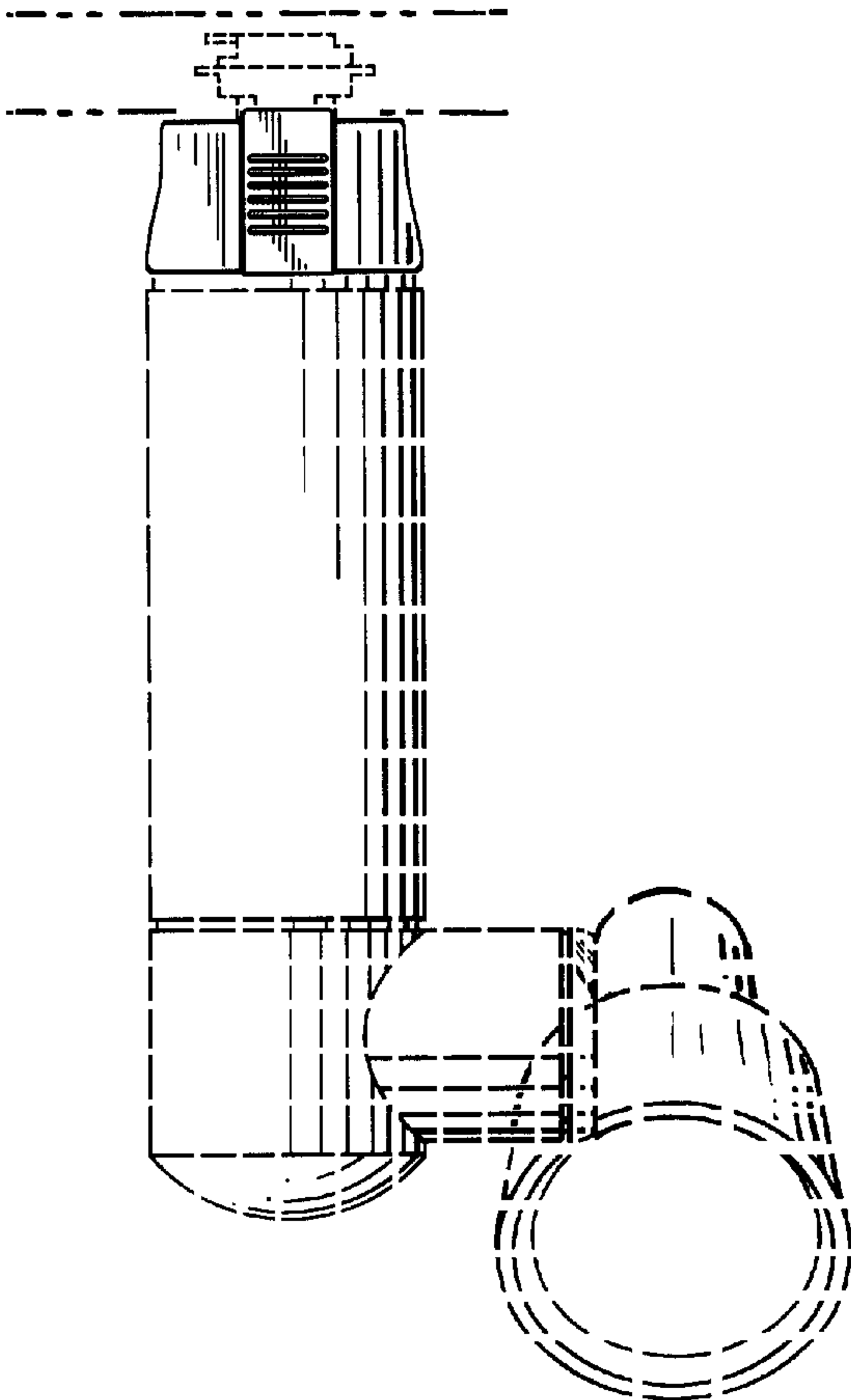

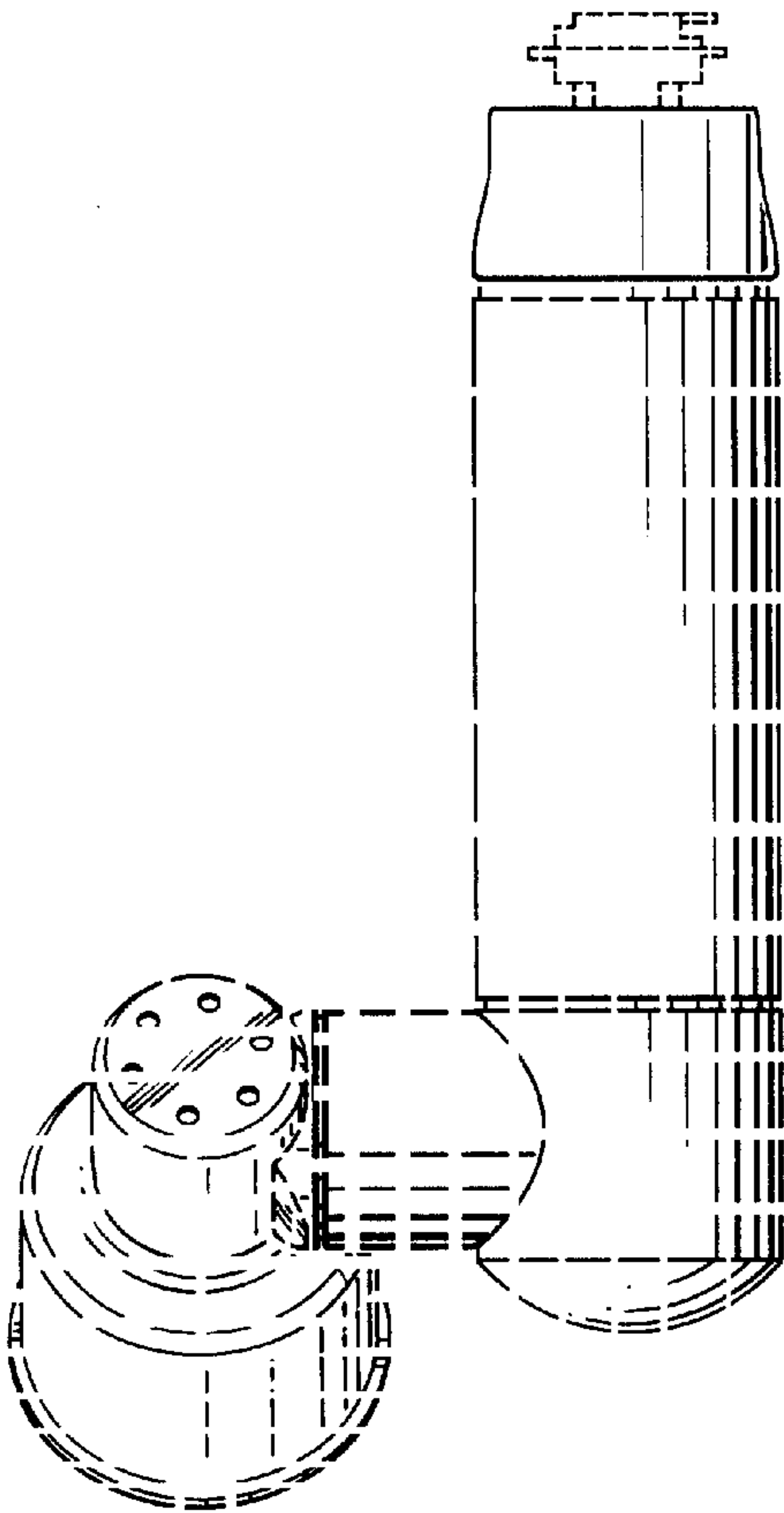

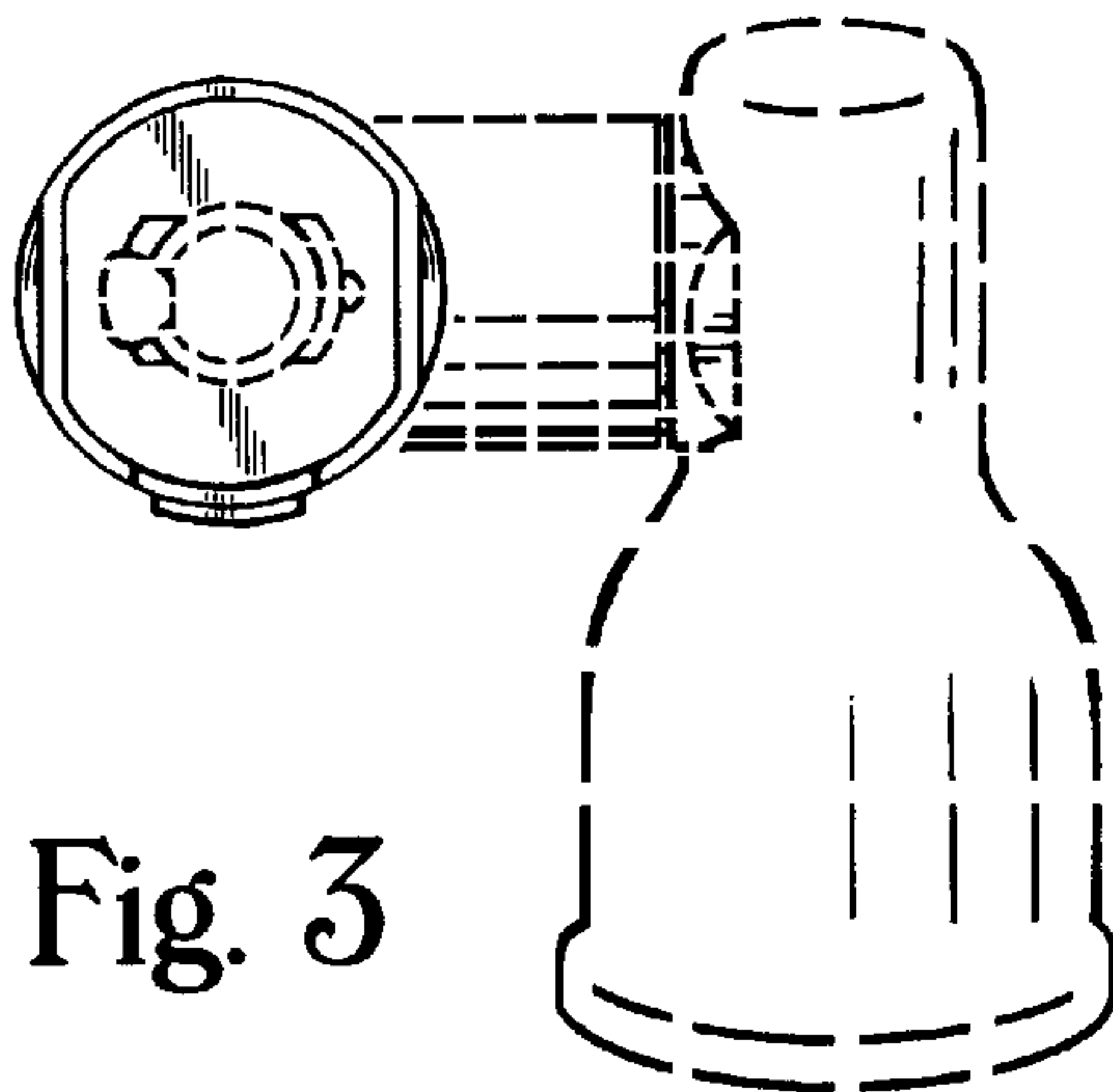

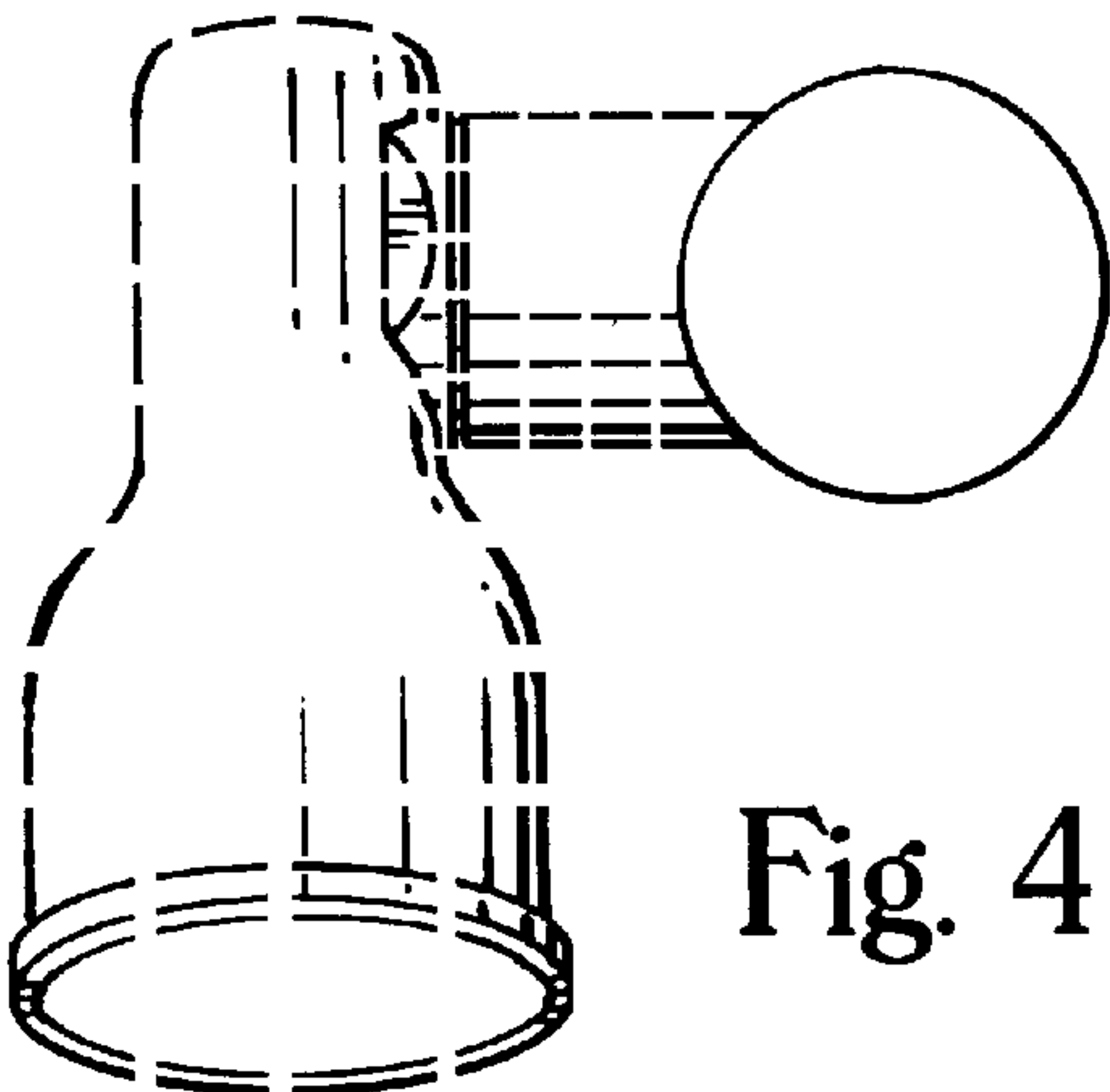

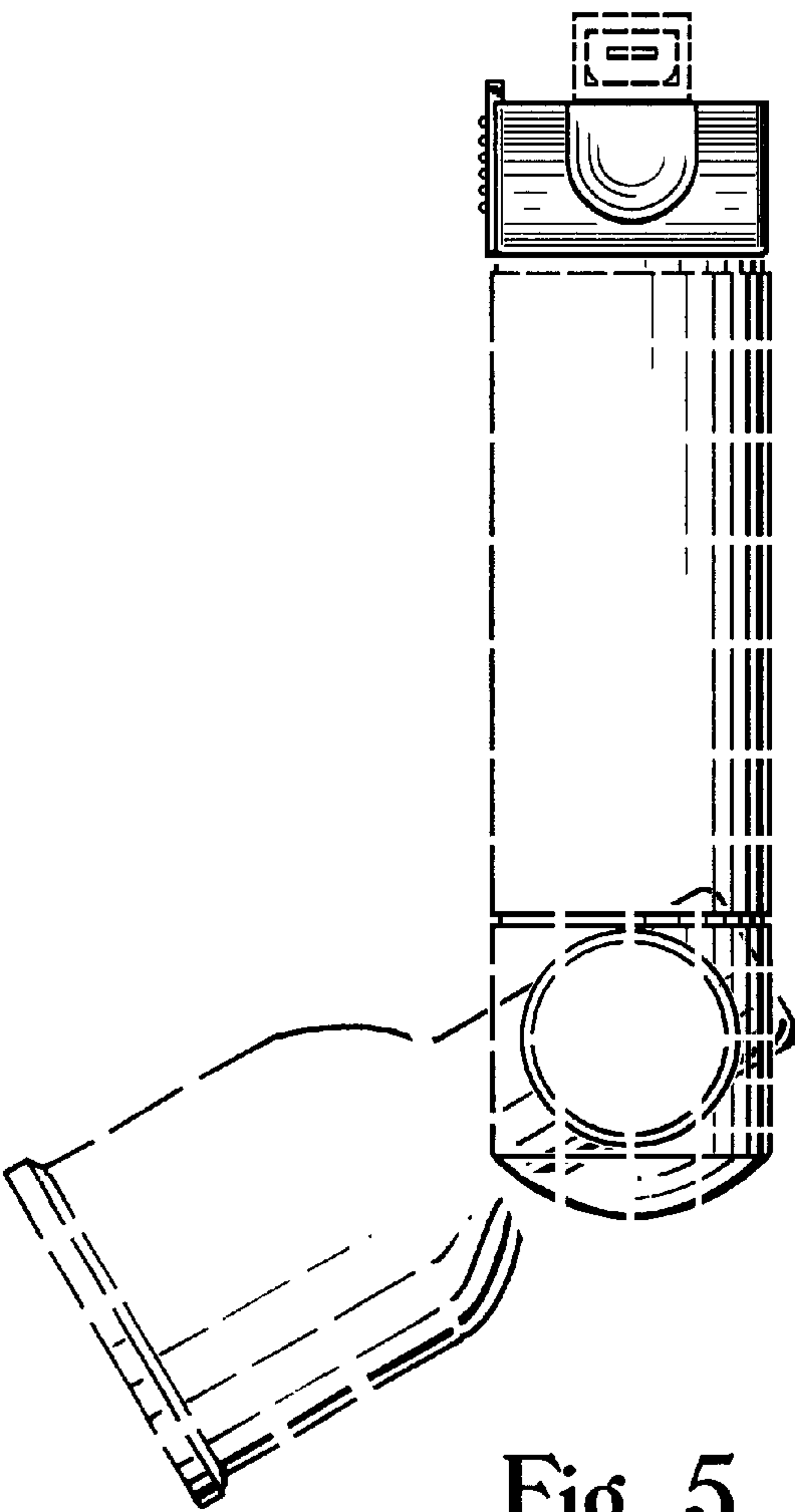

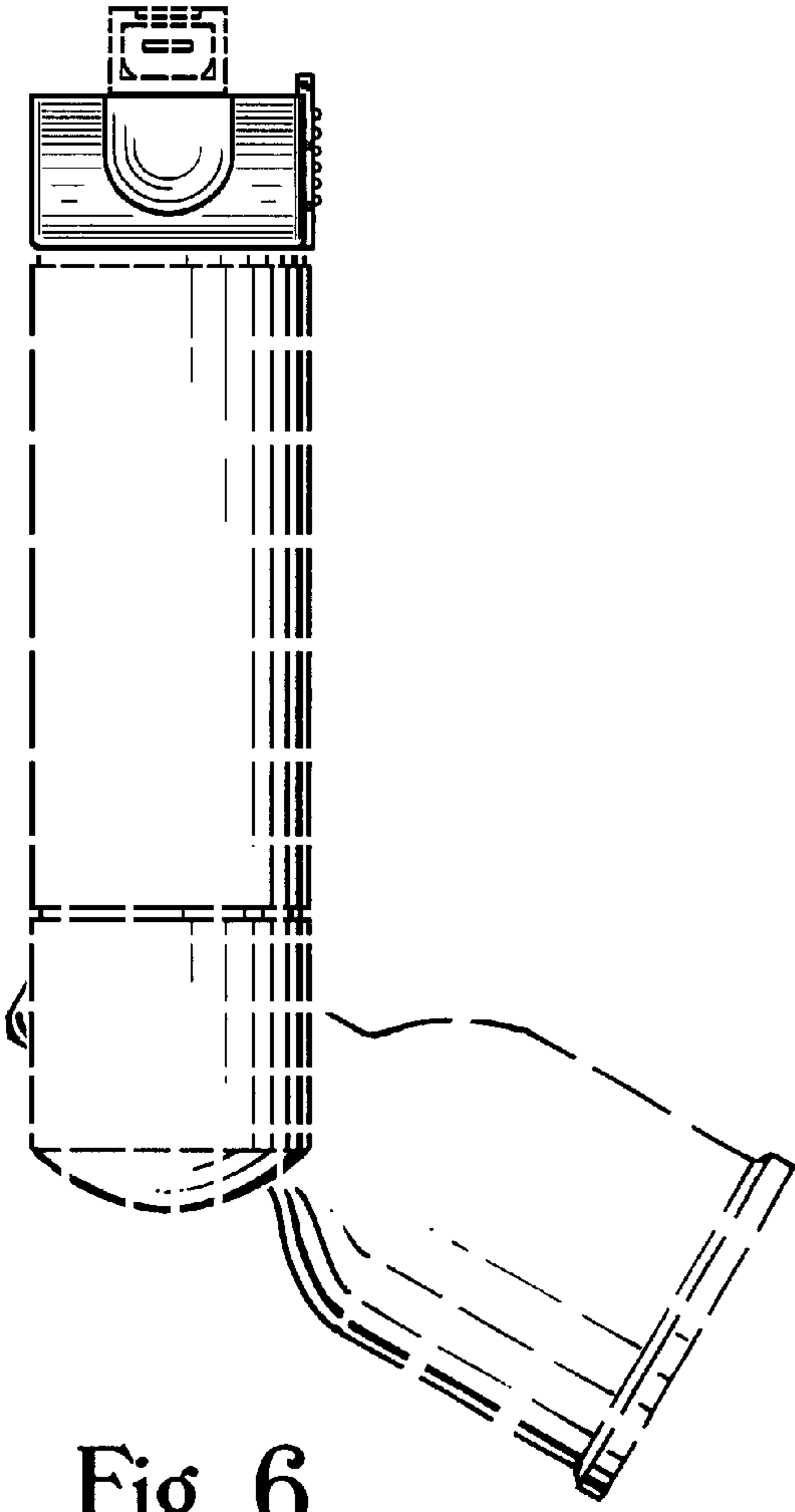

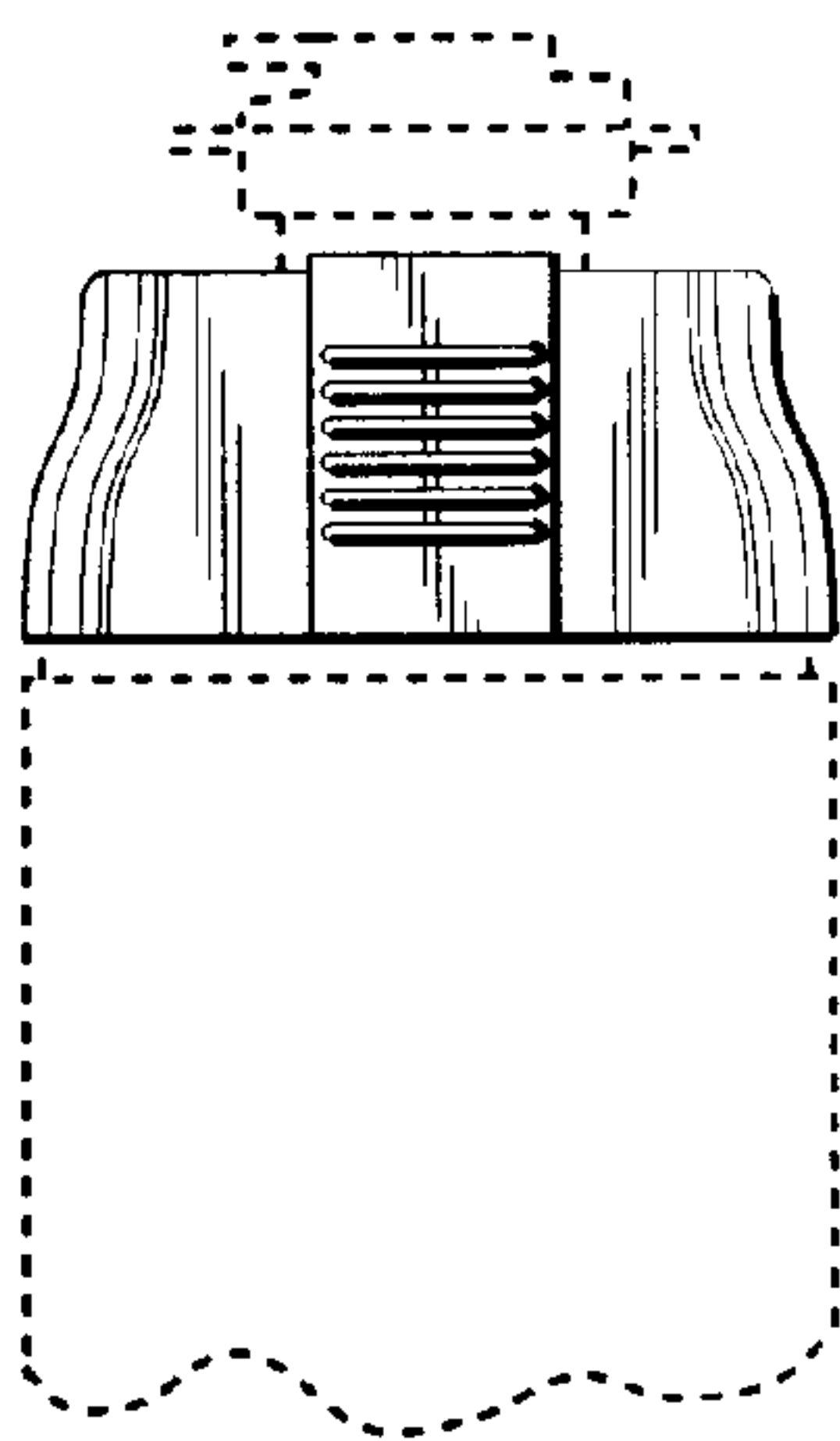

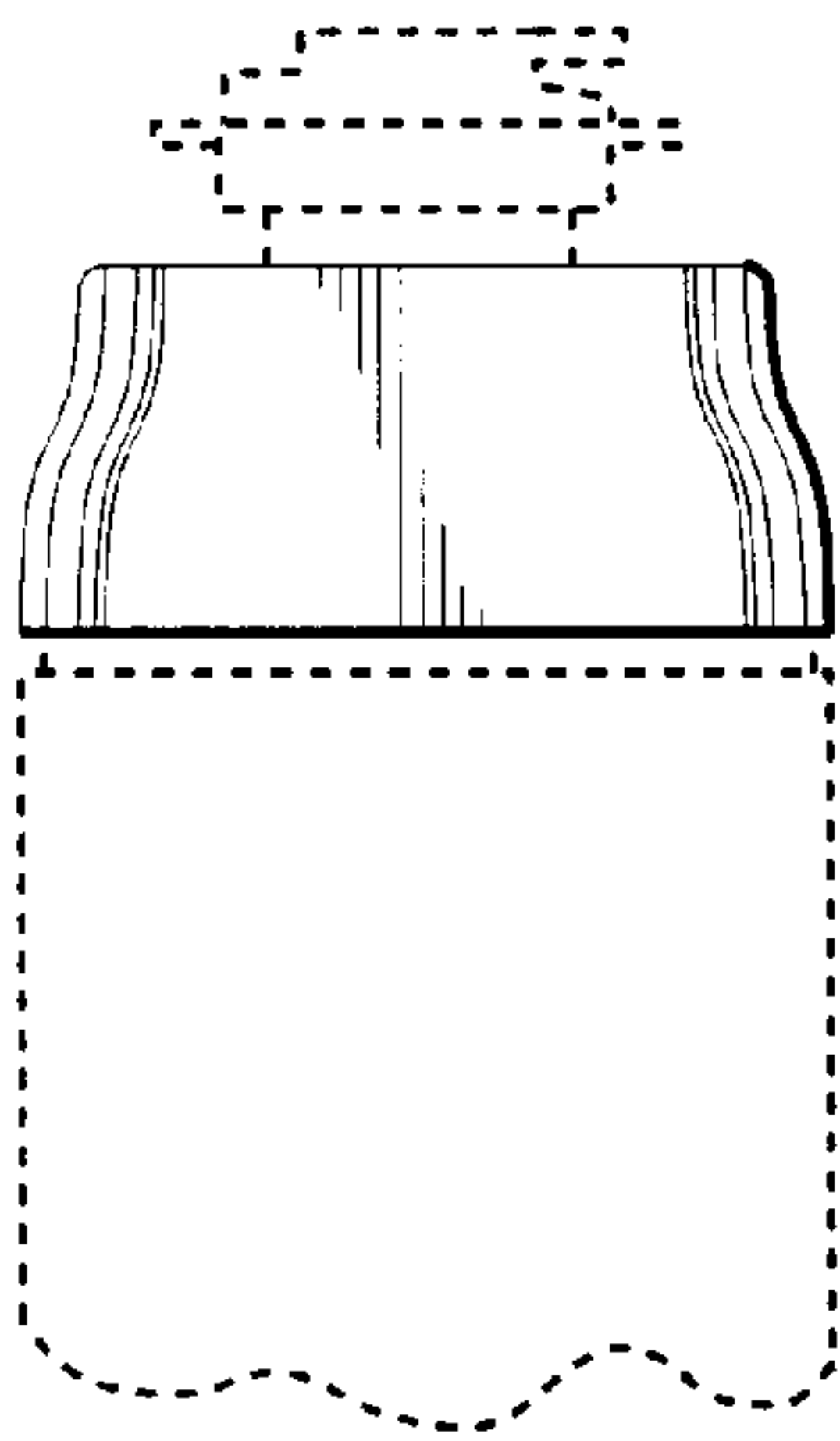

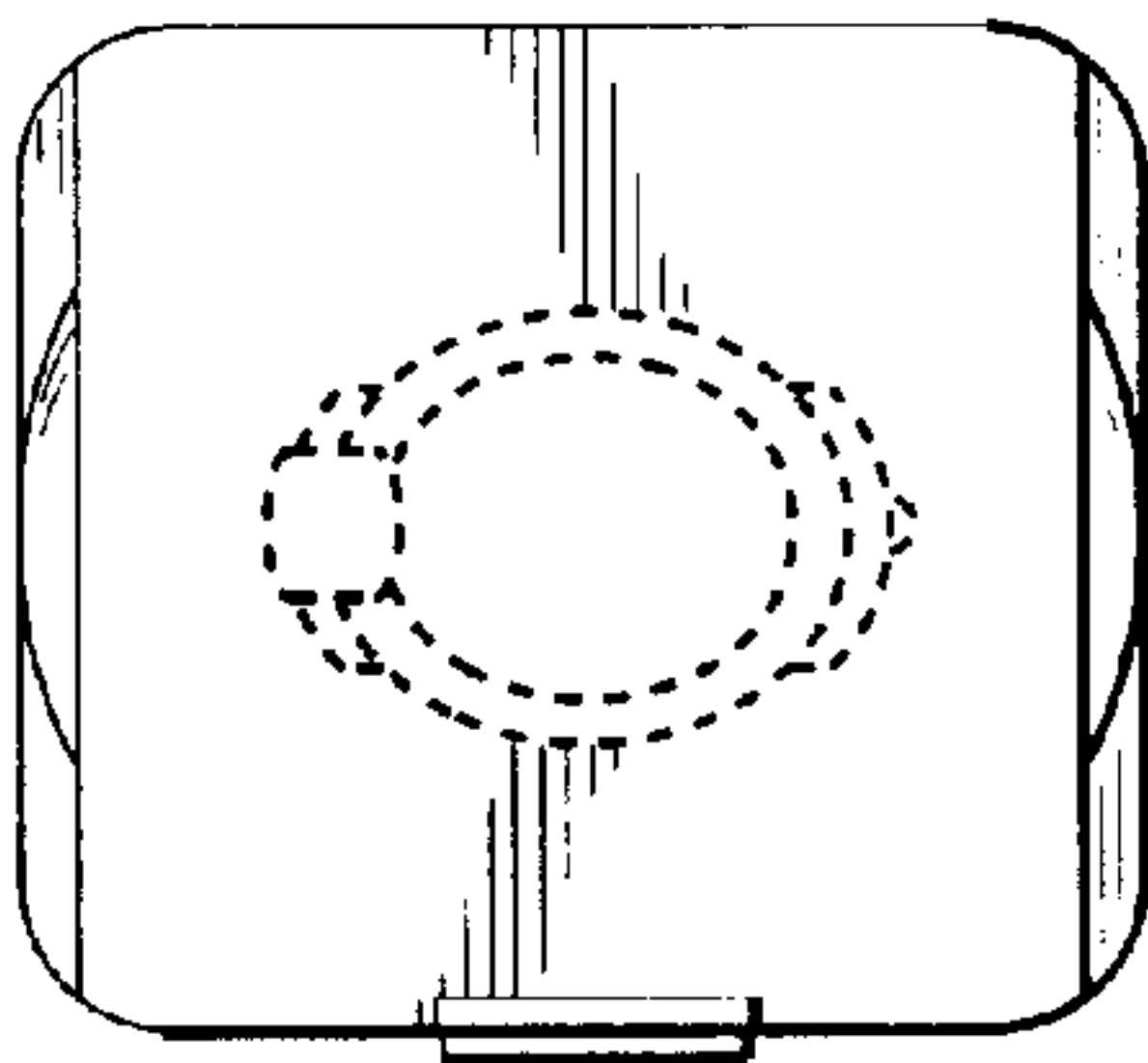

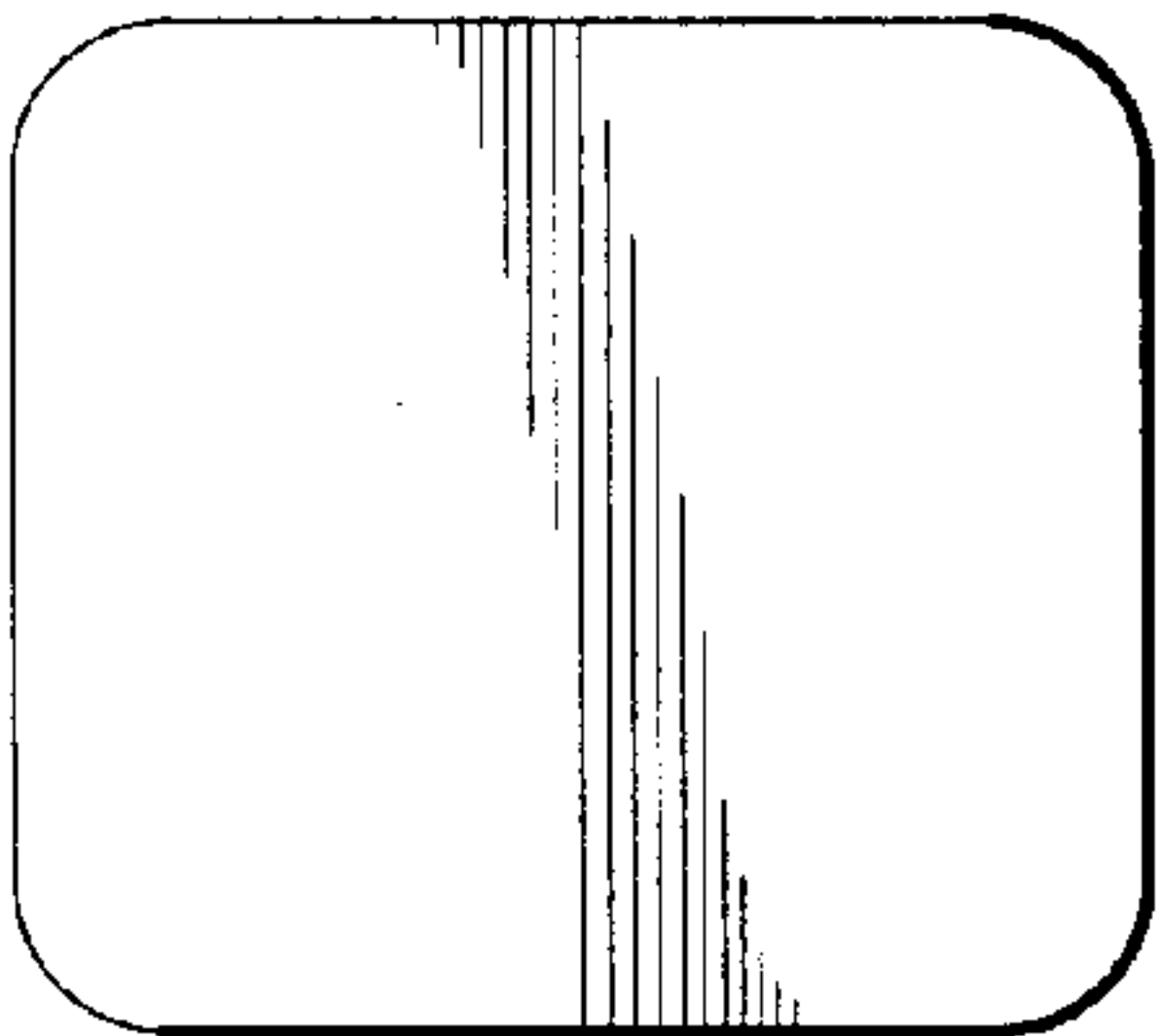

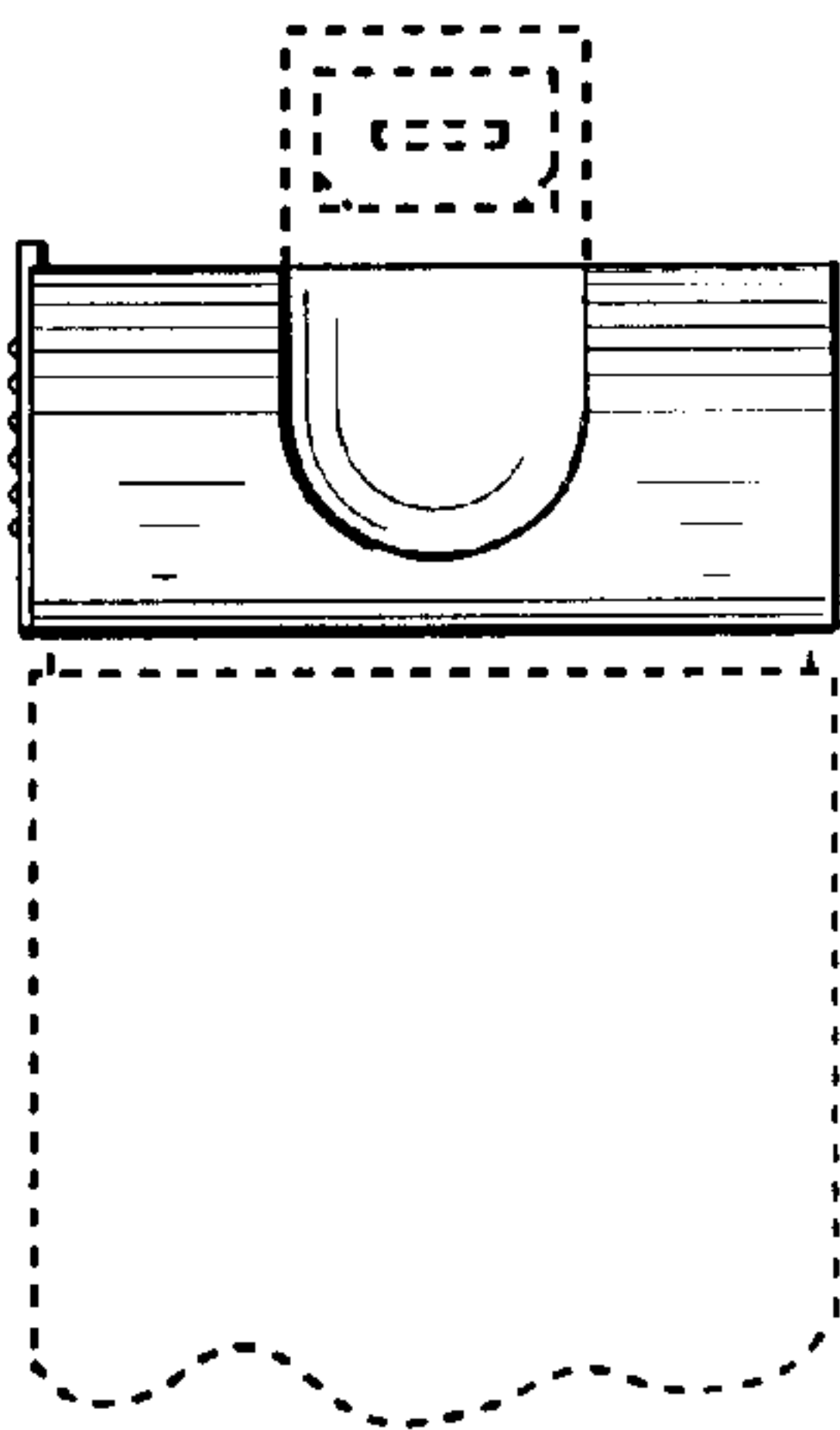

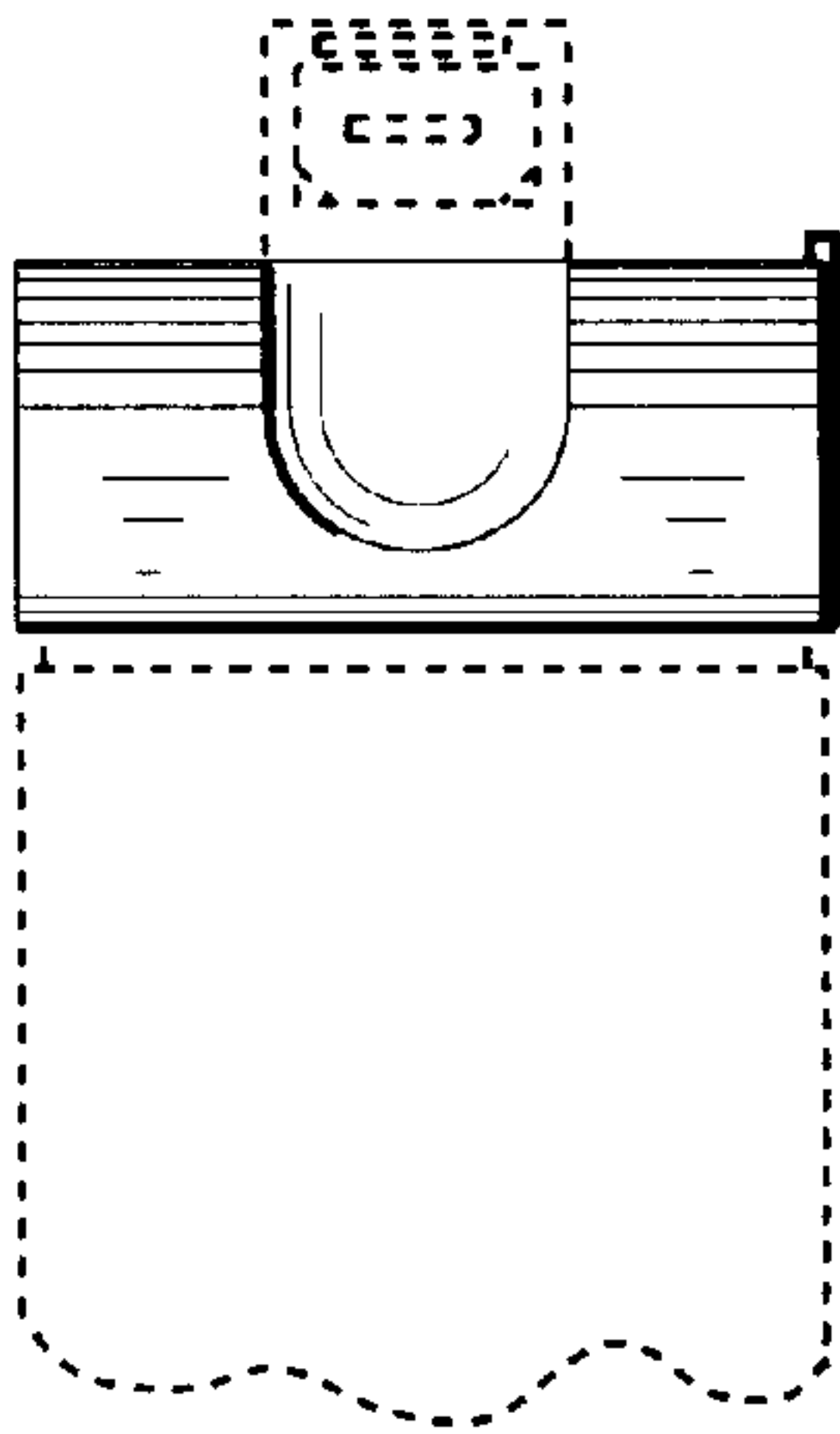

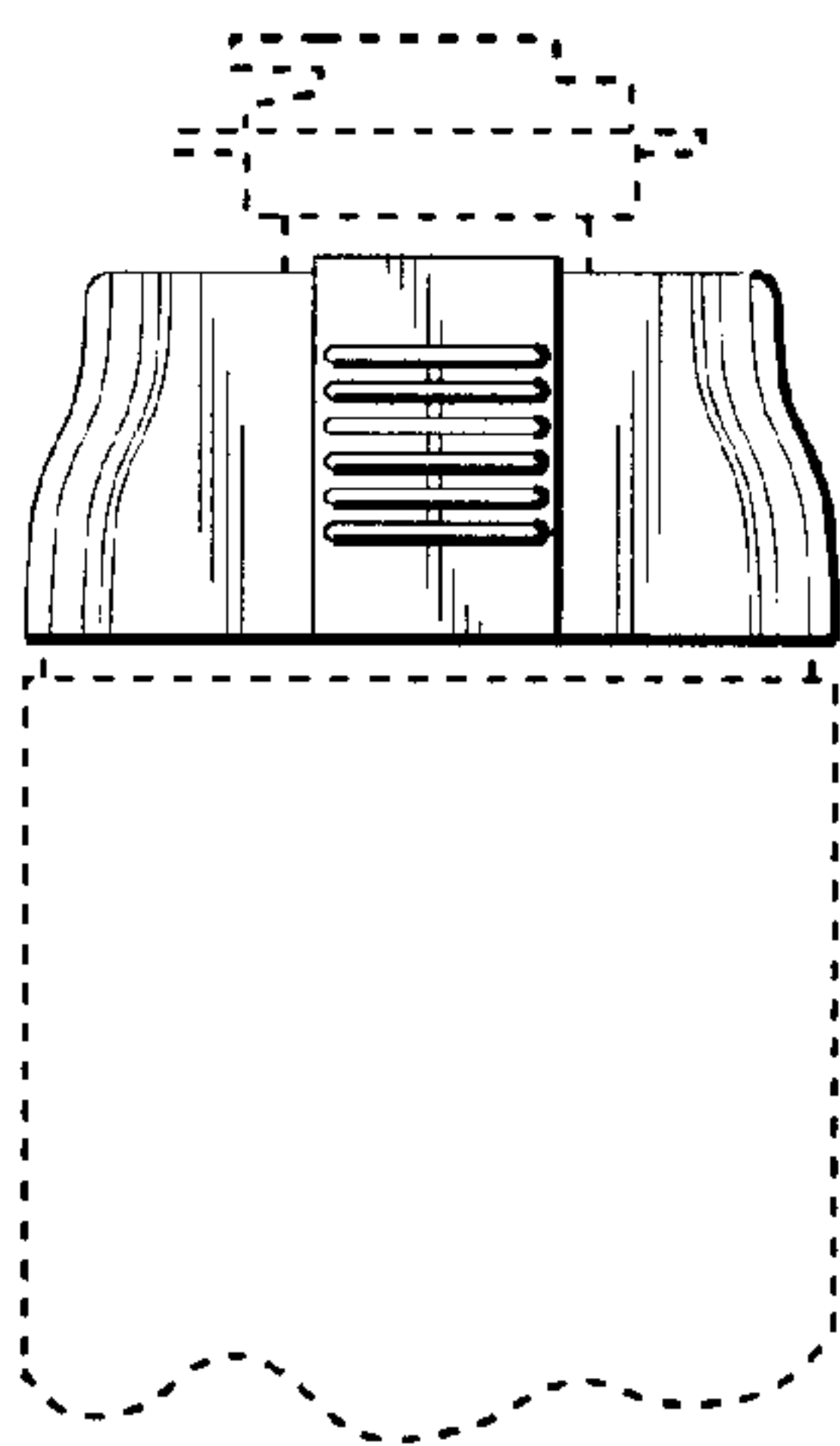

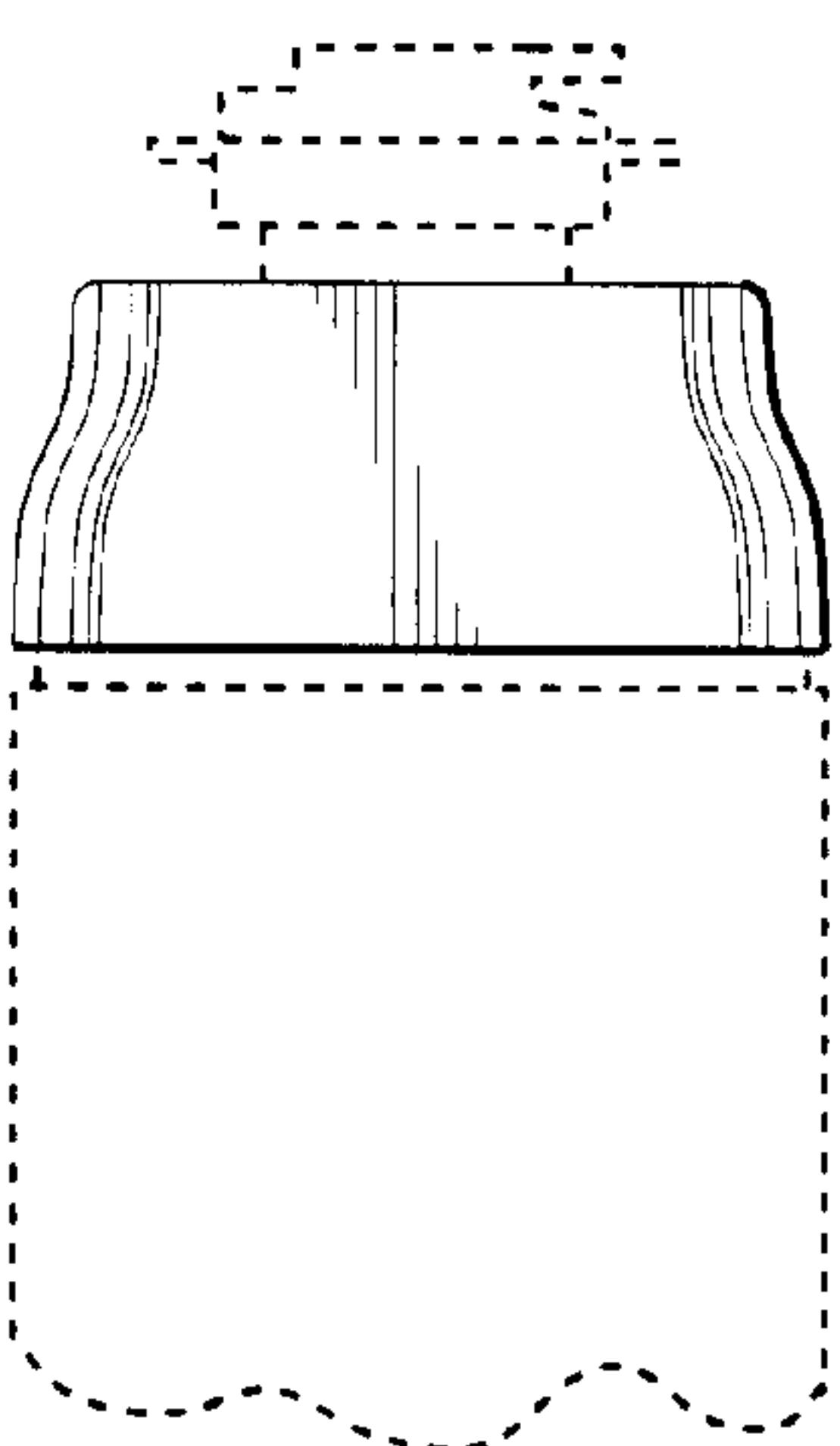

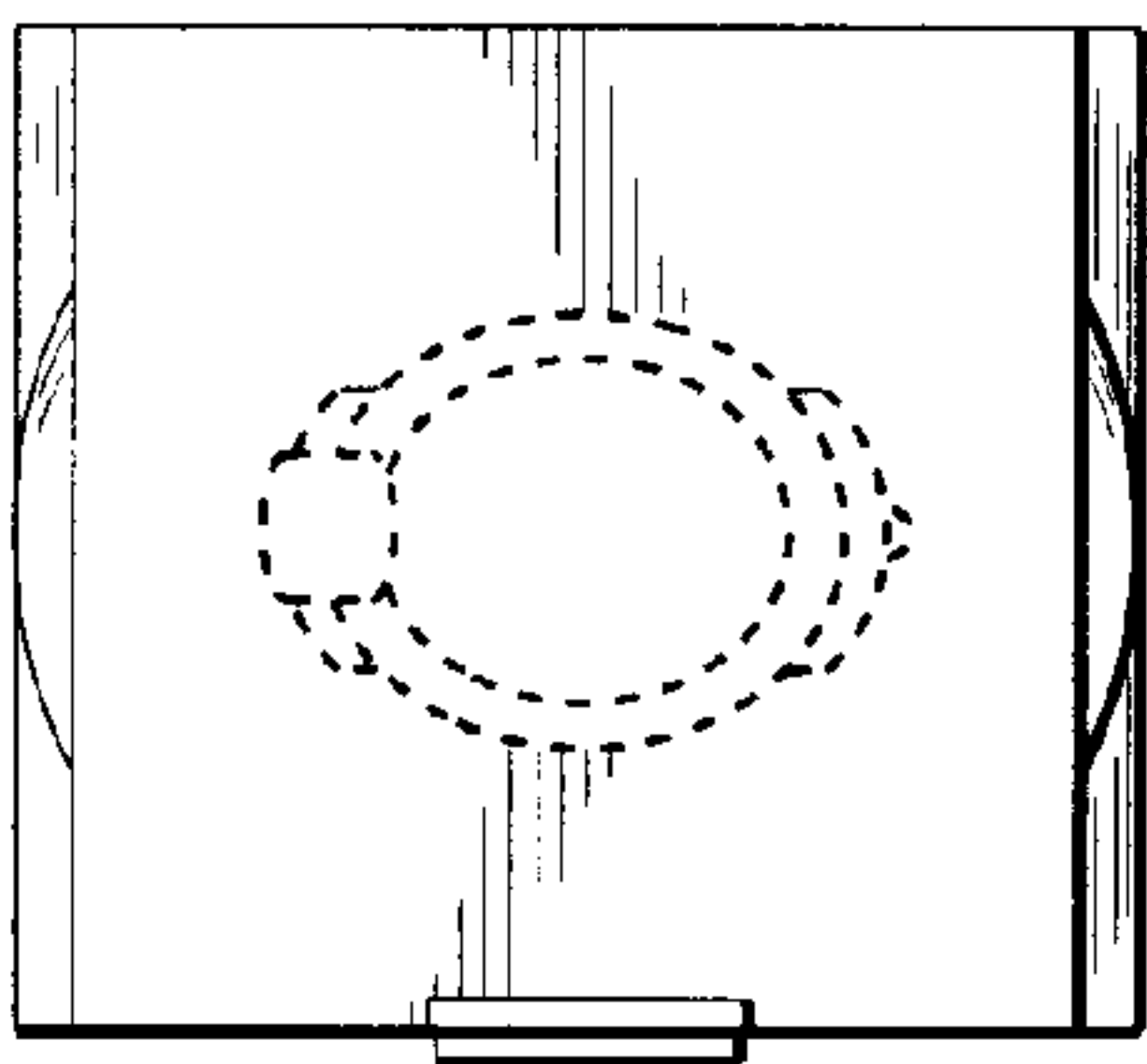

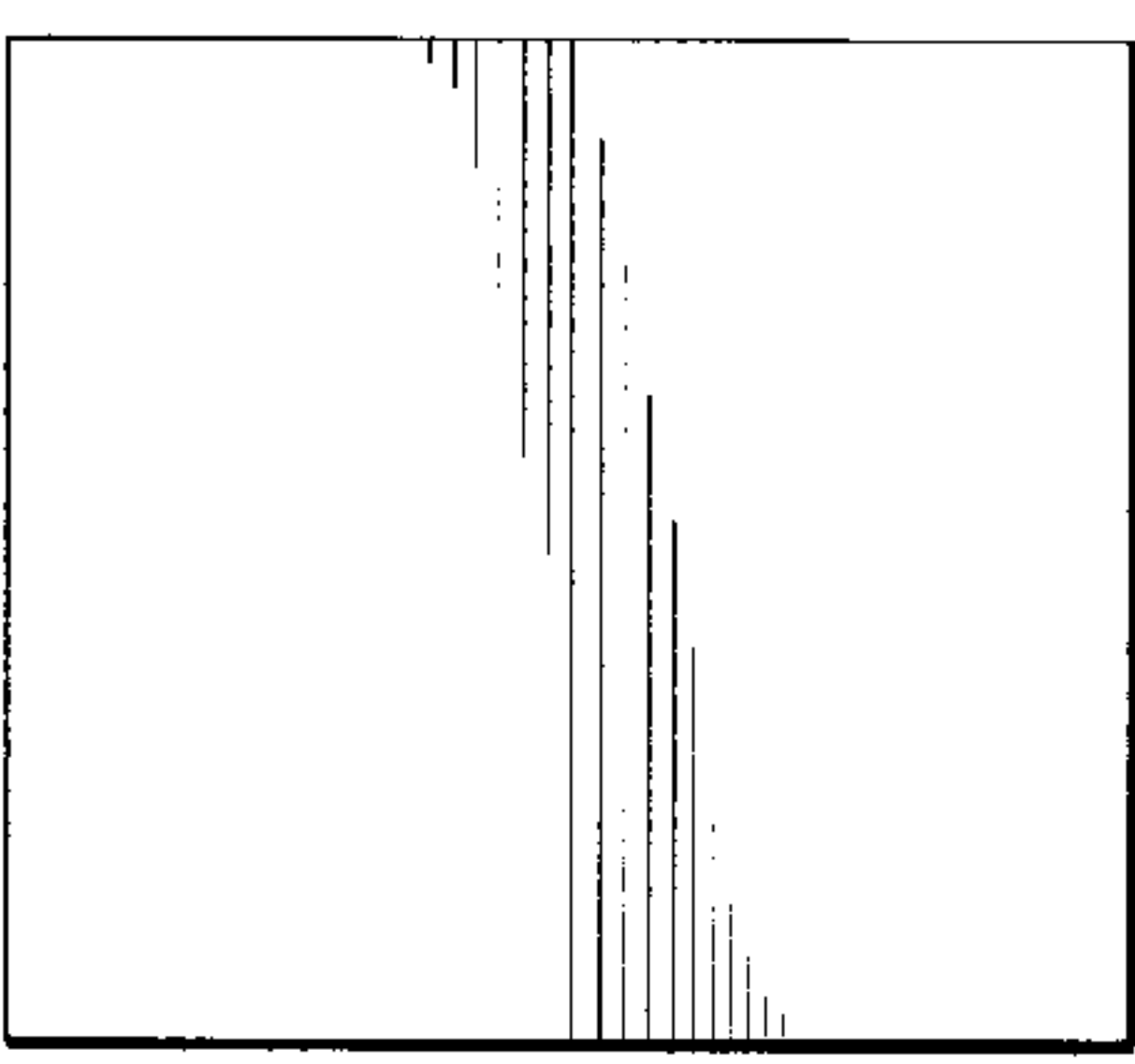

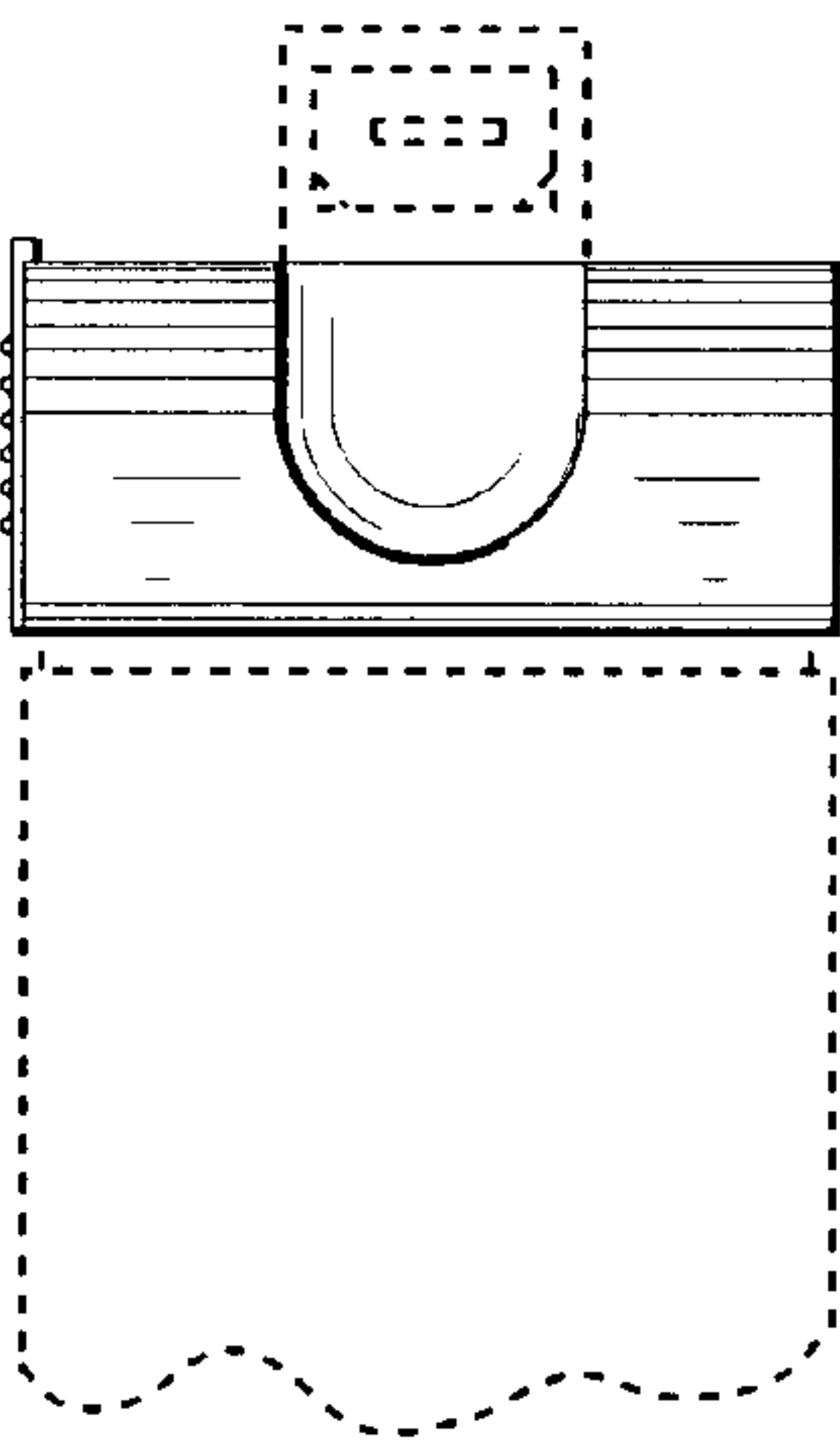
