The ornamental design for the combined ceiling fan and light fixture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view from below of the combined ceiling fan and light fixture in accordance with my design;


FIG. 2 is a front view of the combined ceiling fan and light fixture in accordance with my design;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the combined ceiling fan and light fixture taken along lines 3—3 in FIG. 2 in accordance with my design shown separately for clarify of illustration; and,




The front and rear, left and right elevational views are symmetrical.




