CLAIM (57)

The ornamental design for the combined ceiling fan and light fixture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the combined ceiling fan and light fixture in accordance with my design taken along line 1—1 in FIG. 2;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the combined ceiling fan and light fixture in accordance with my design; and,

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view on a reduced scale of the combined ceiling fan and light fixture in accordance with my design taken along line 3—3 in FIGS. 2.

The front and rear, left and right side elevational views are symmetrical.
