(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an article of furniture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the article of furniture according to a preferred embodiment.

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the article of furniture.

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of the article of furniture.

FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view of the article of furniture.

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the article of furniture; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the article of furniture.

The broken line disclosure is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

Jagged broken lines and brackets show indeterminate length.

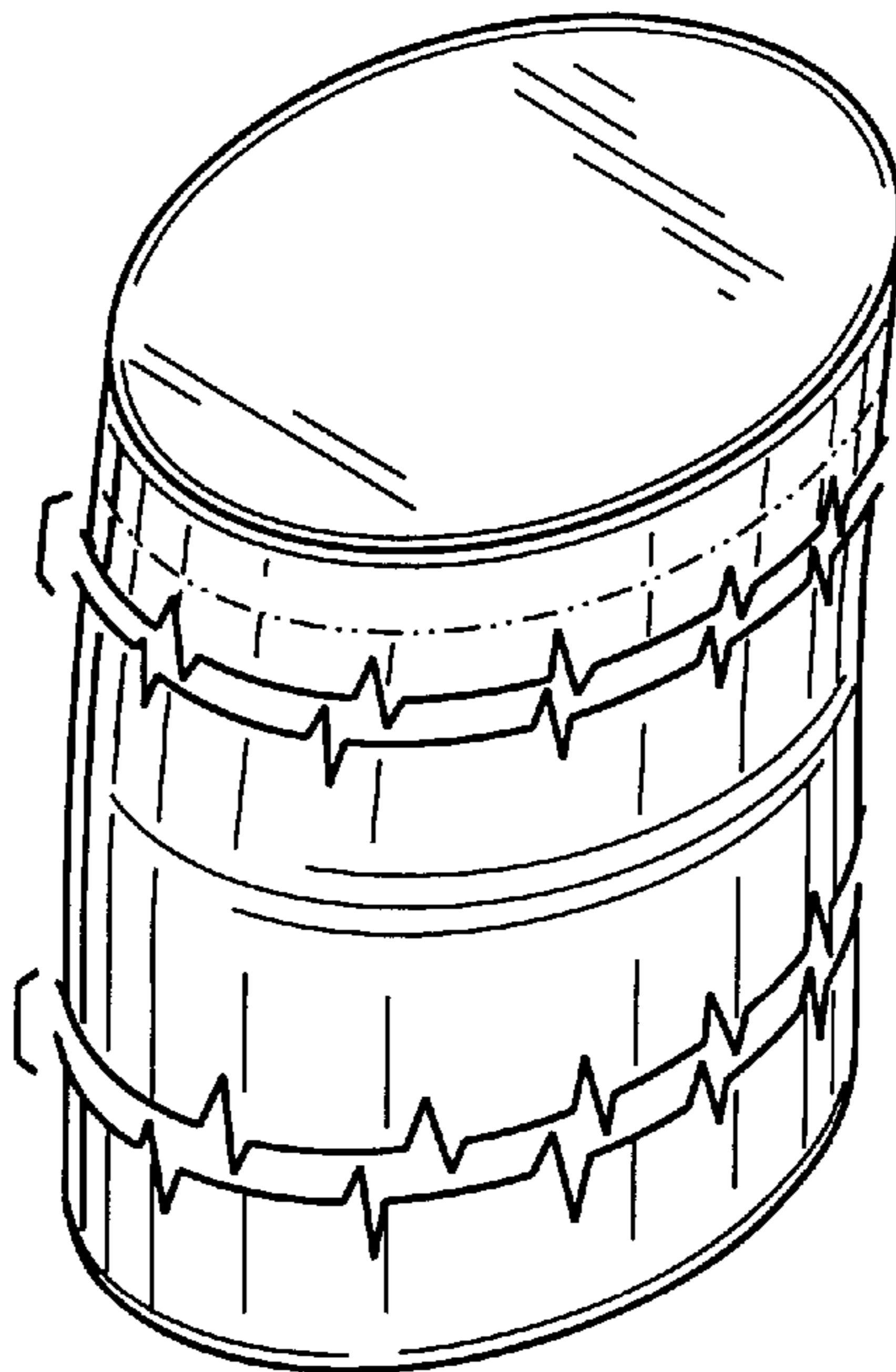

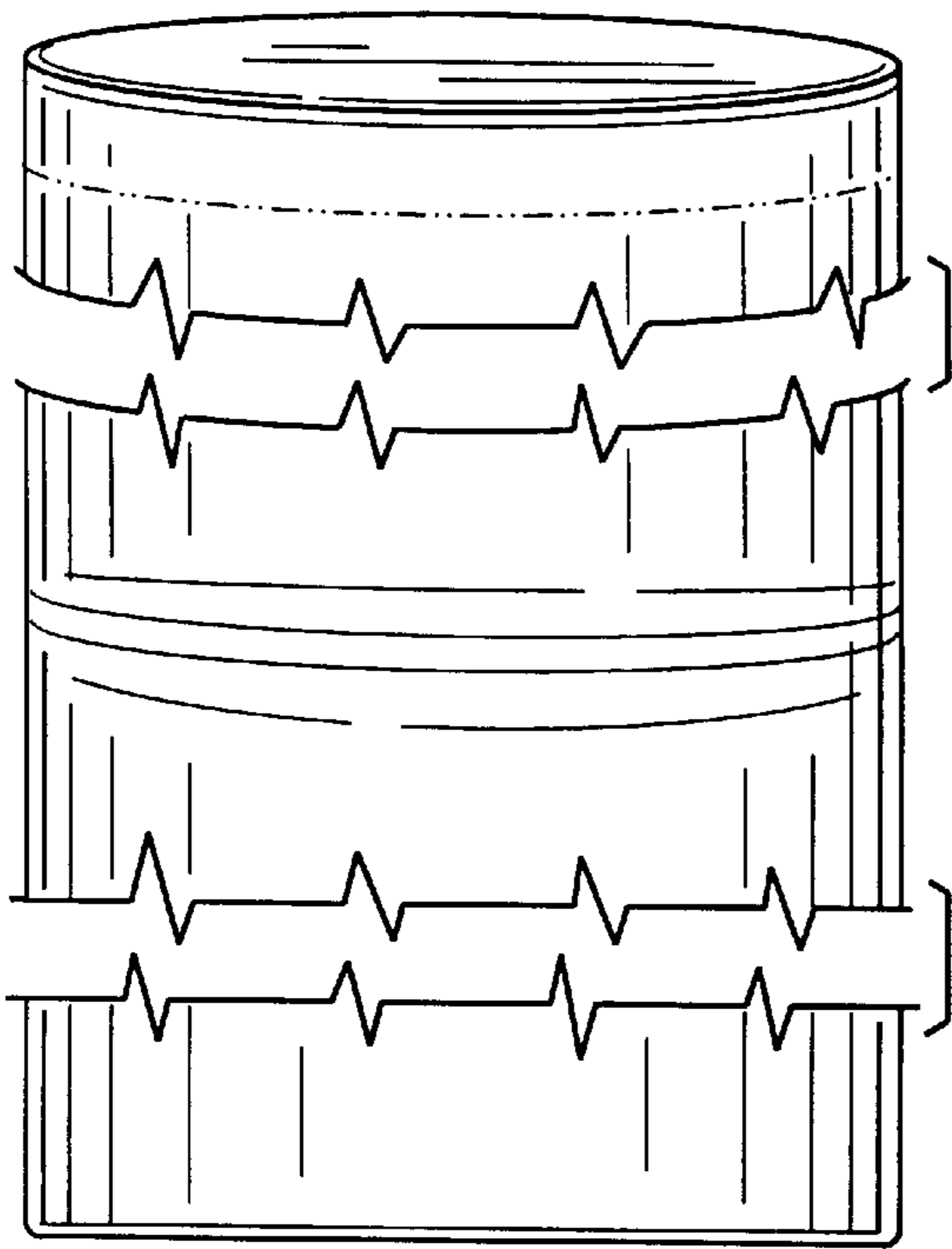
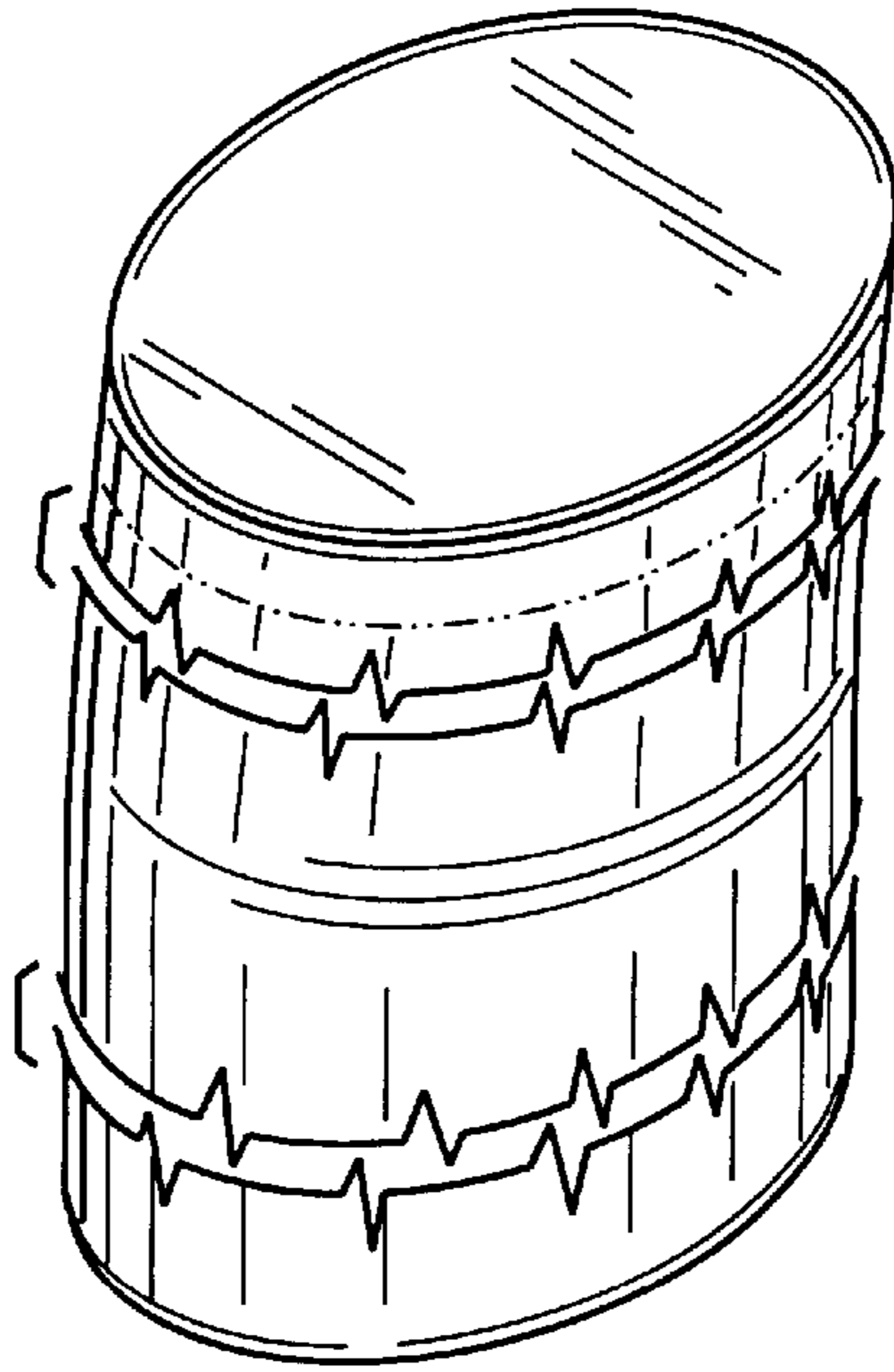

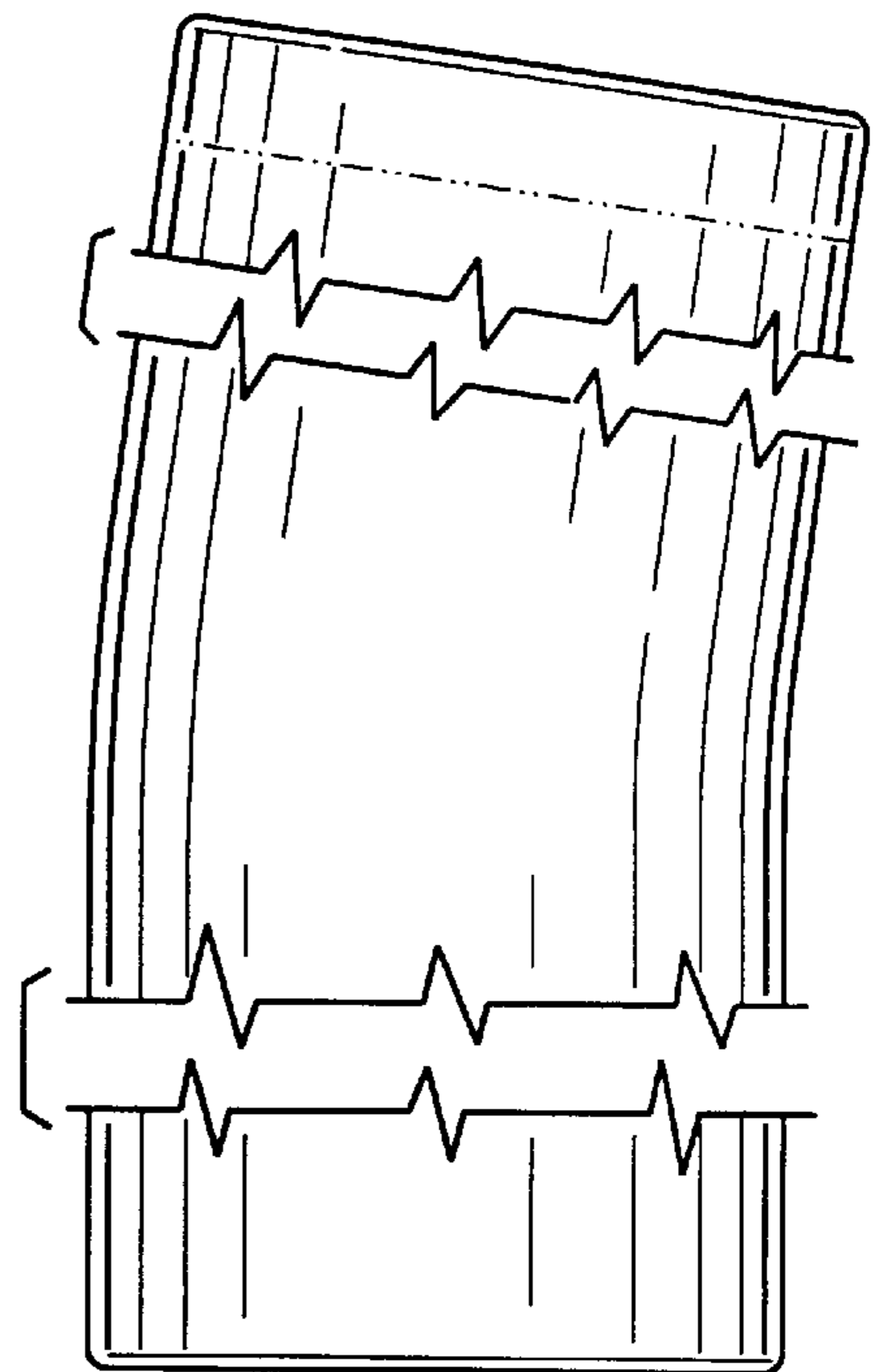

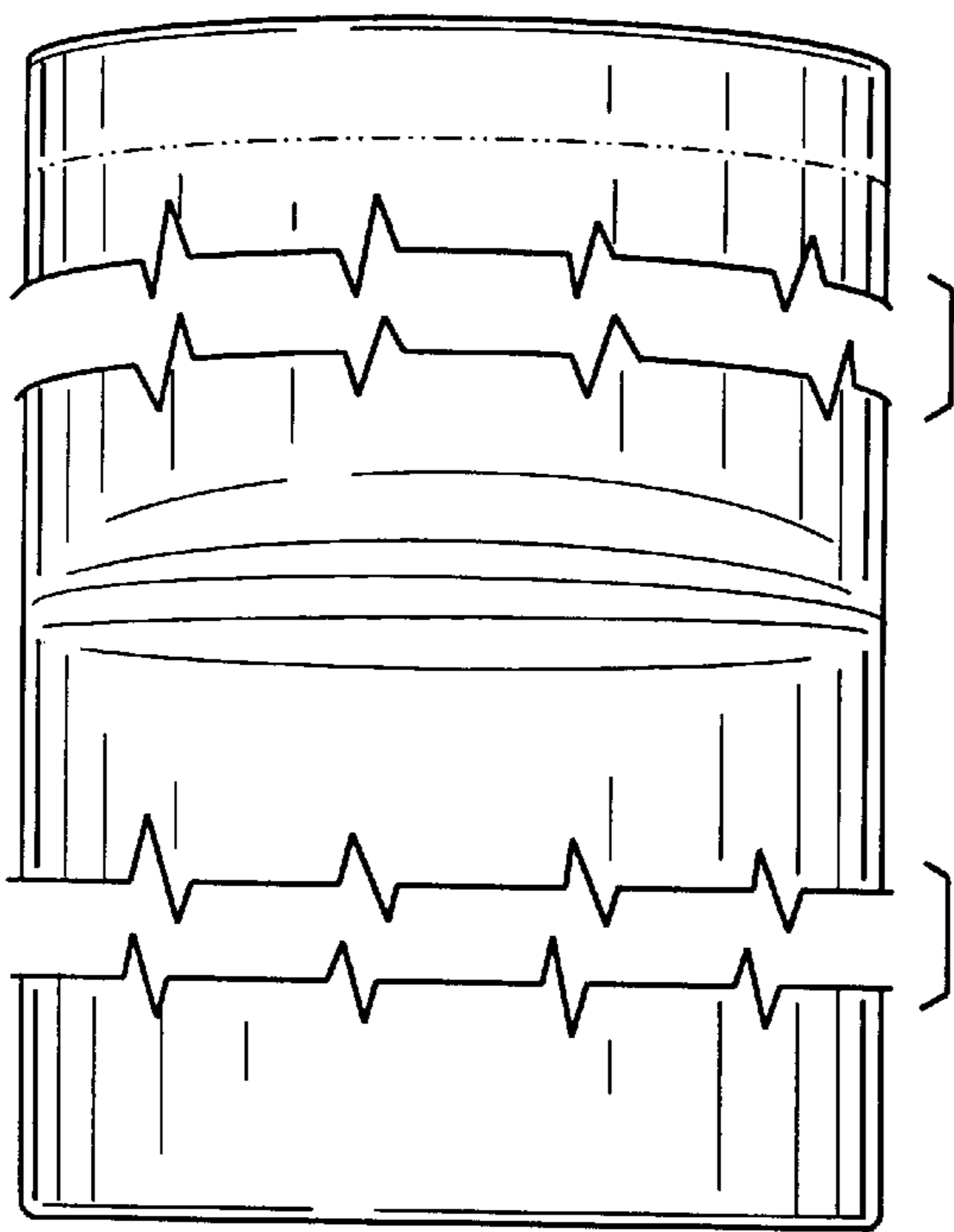

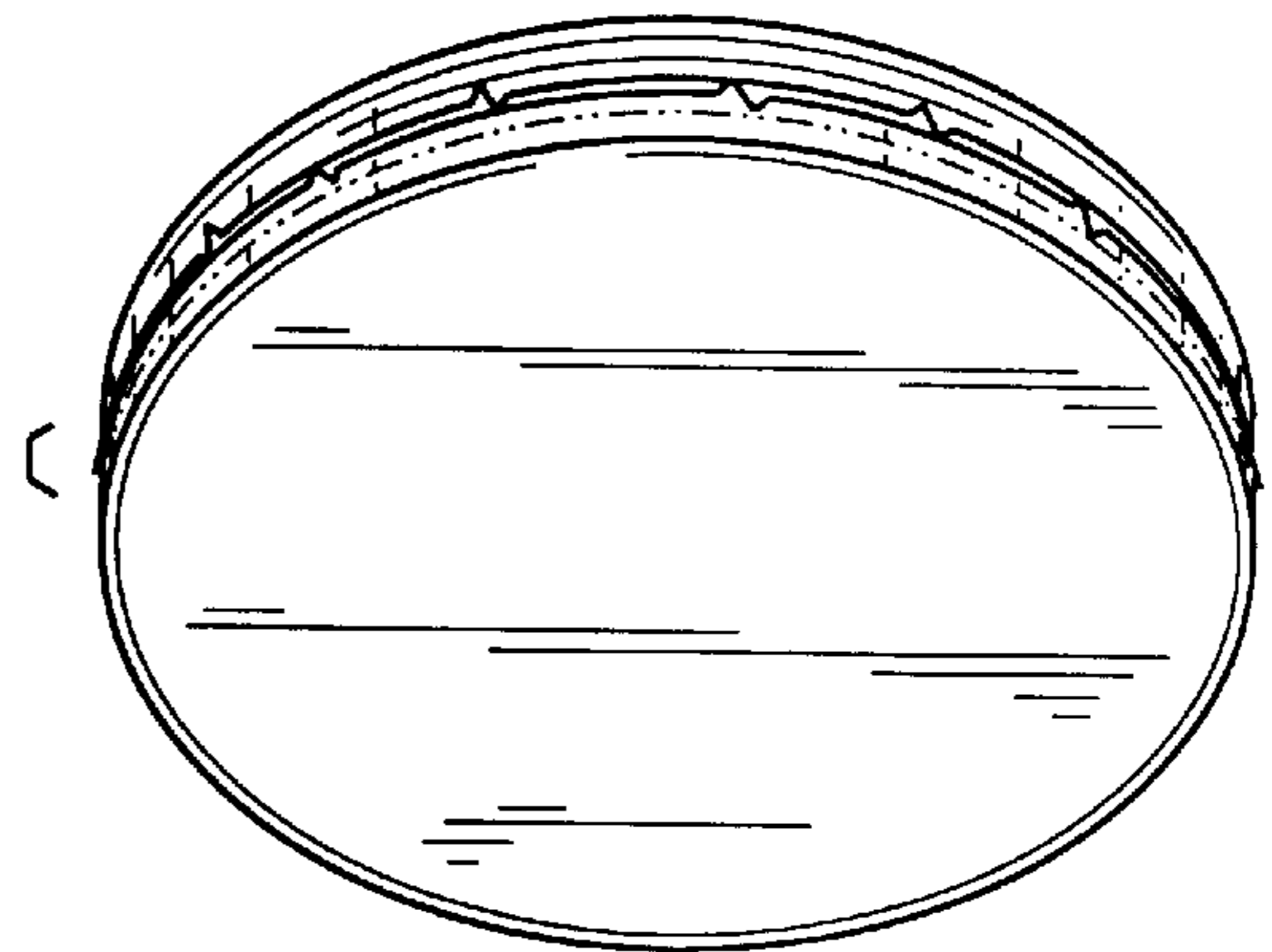

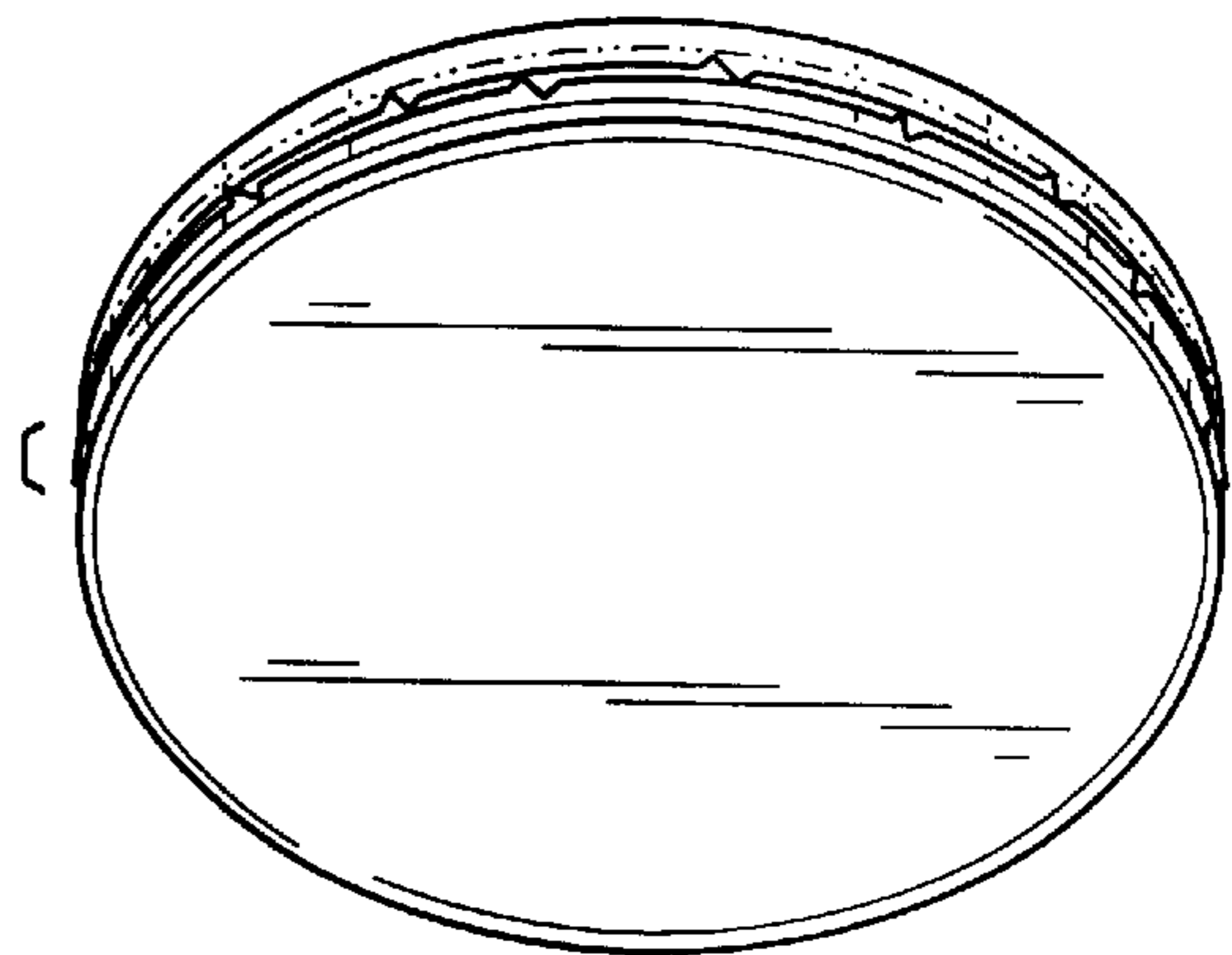
