(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a zipper pull, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the zipper pull embodying my new design.

FIG. 2 is a front view of the zipper pull shown in FIG. 1, the rear view being a mirror image thereof.

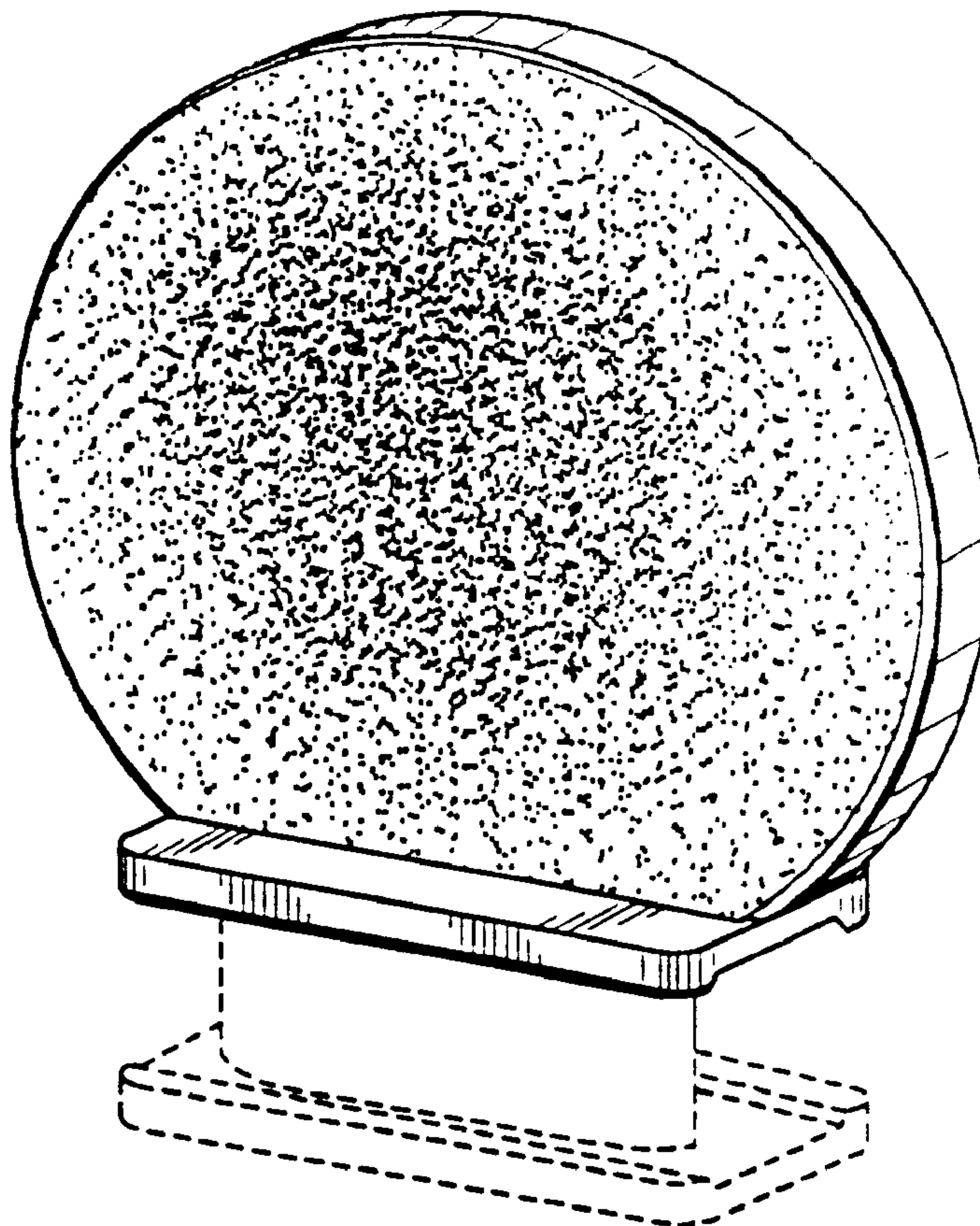
FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a cross sectional view along line 6—6 of FIG. 2. The portions of the zipper pull shown in dashed lines show environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design.

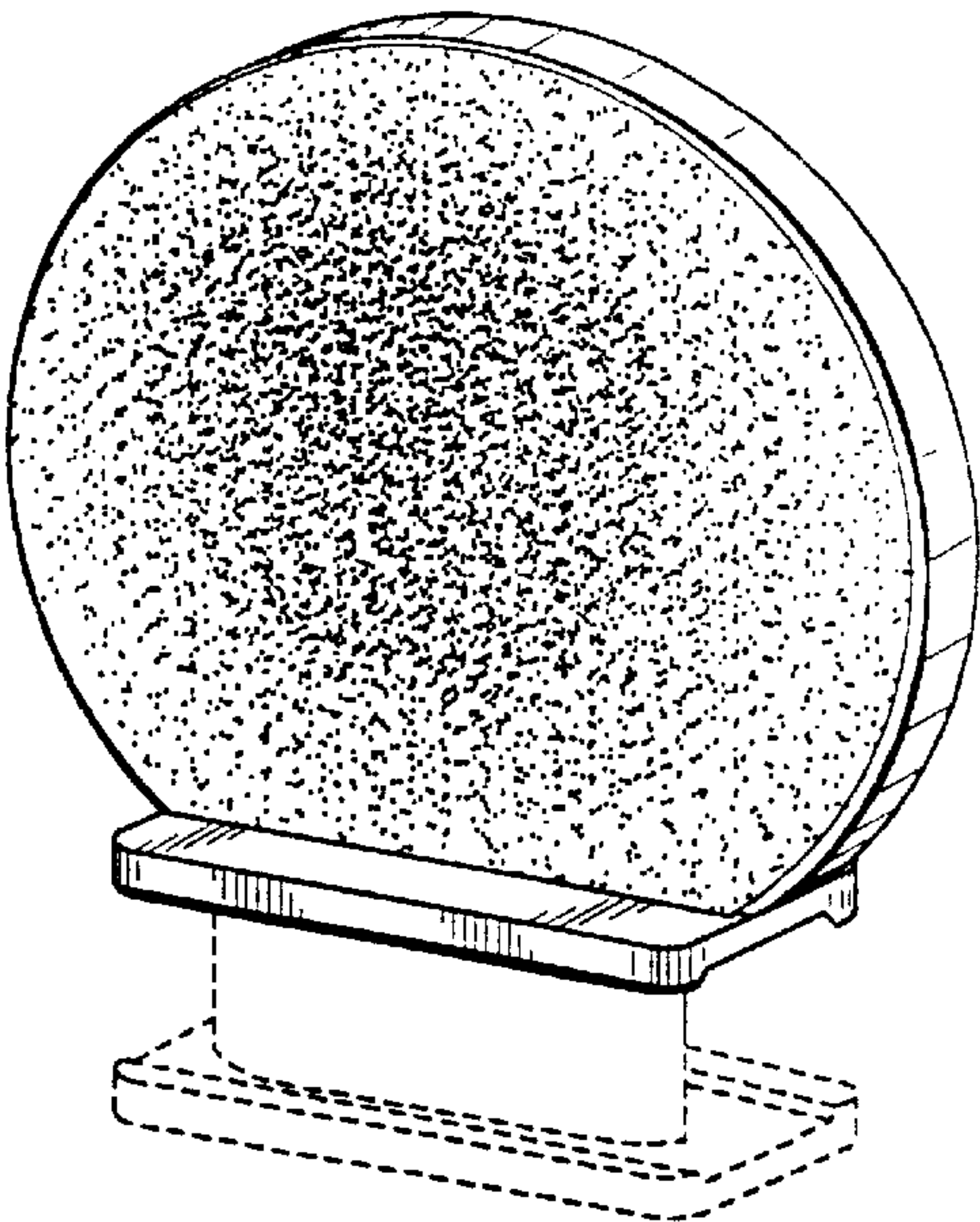

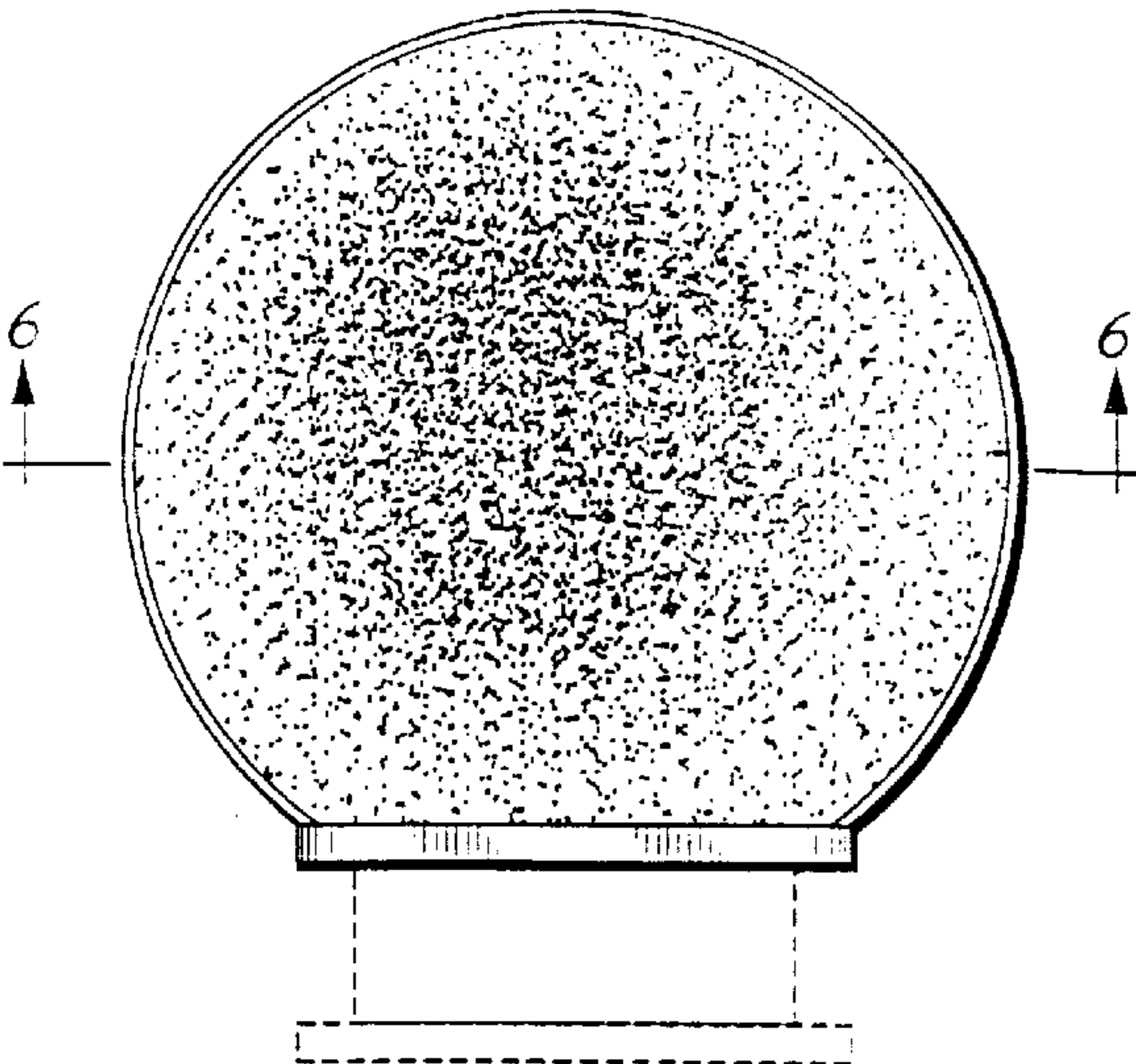

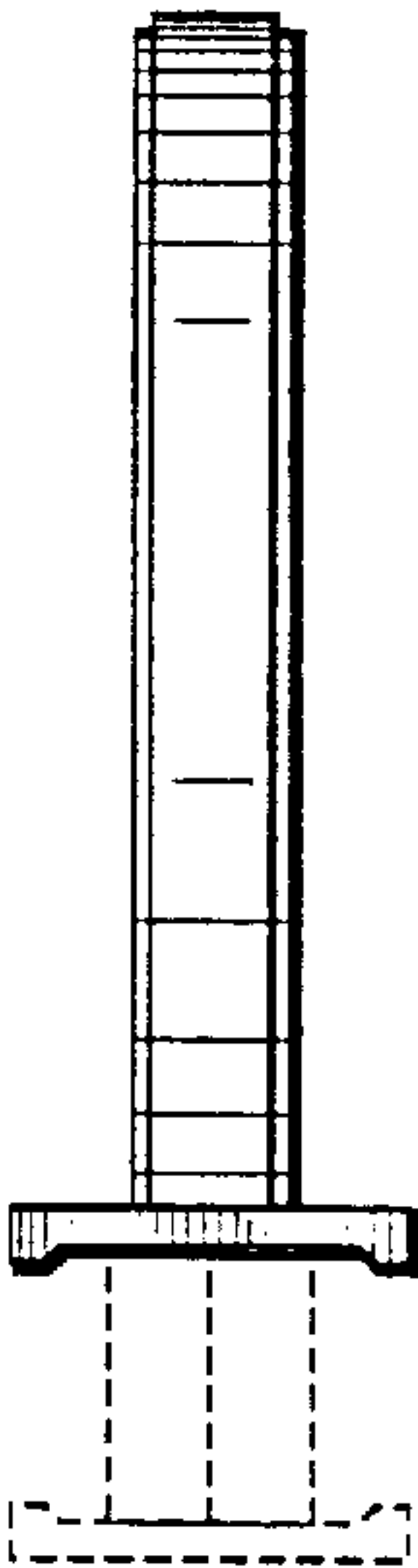

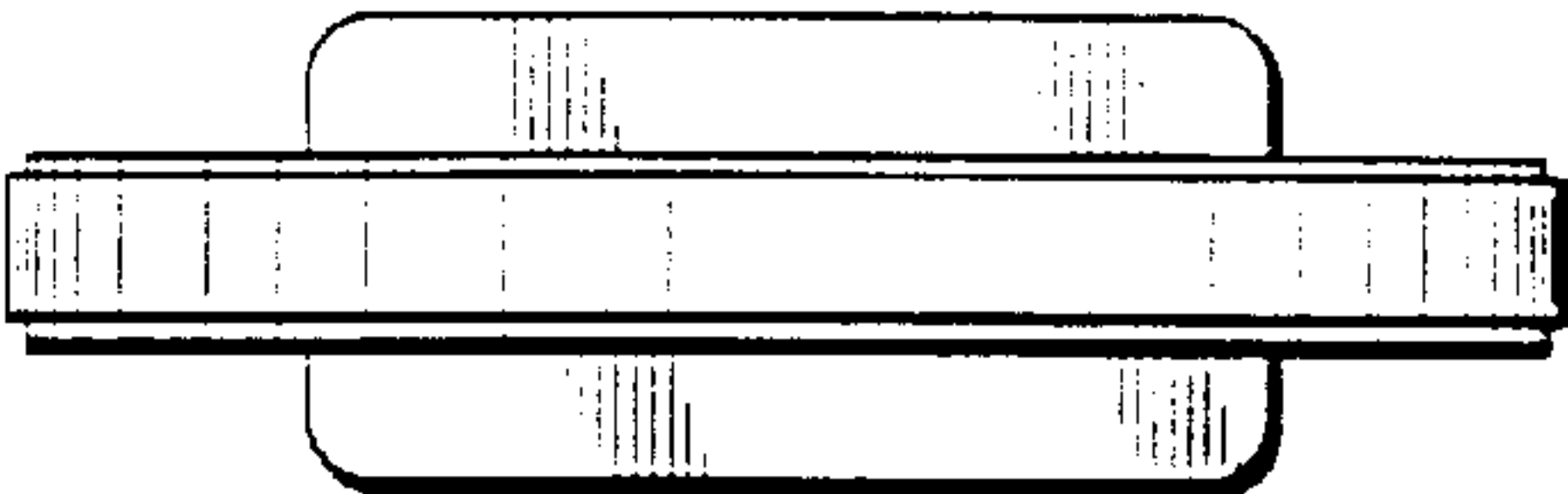

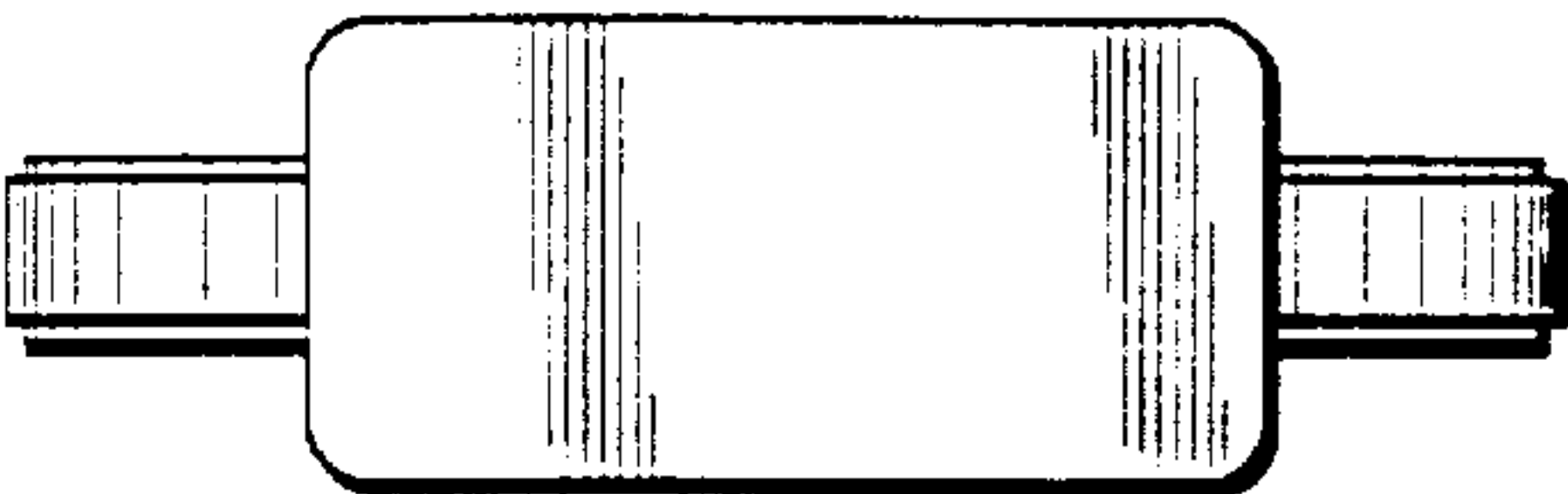
