FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the first embodiment of the instant invention;

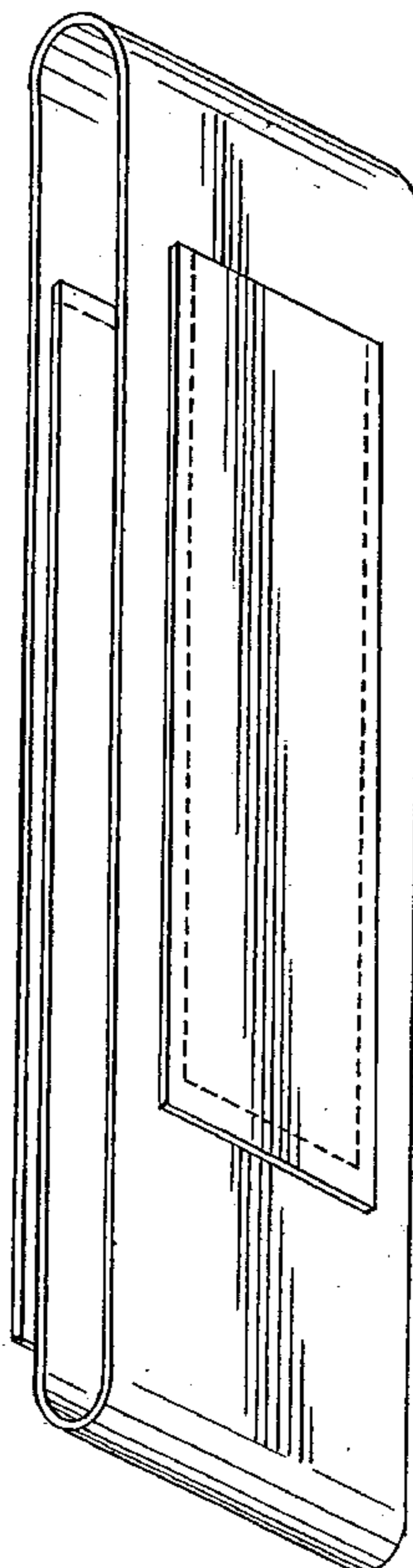
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the first embodiment of the instant invention;

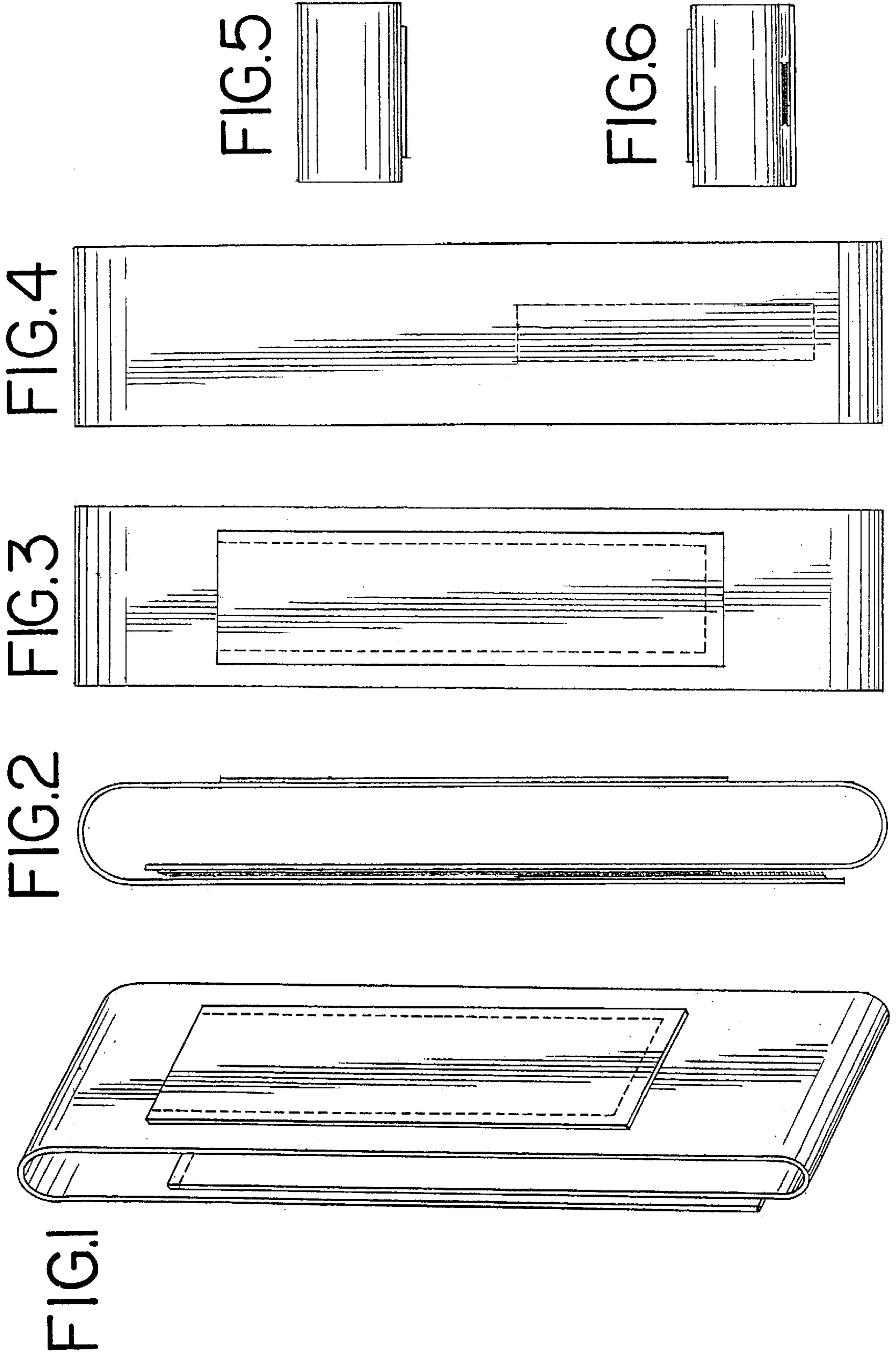
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the second embodiment of the instant invention, the rear is the same as FIG. 4;

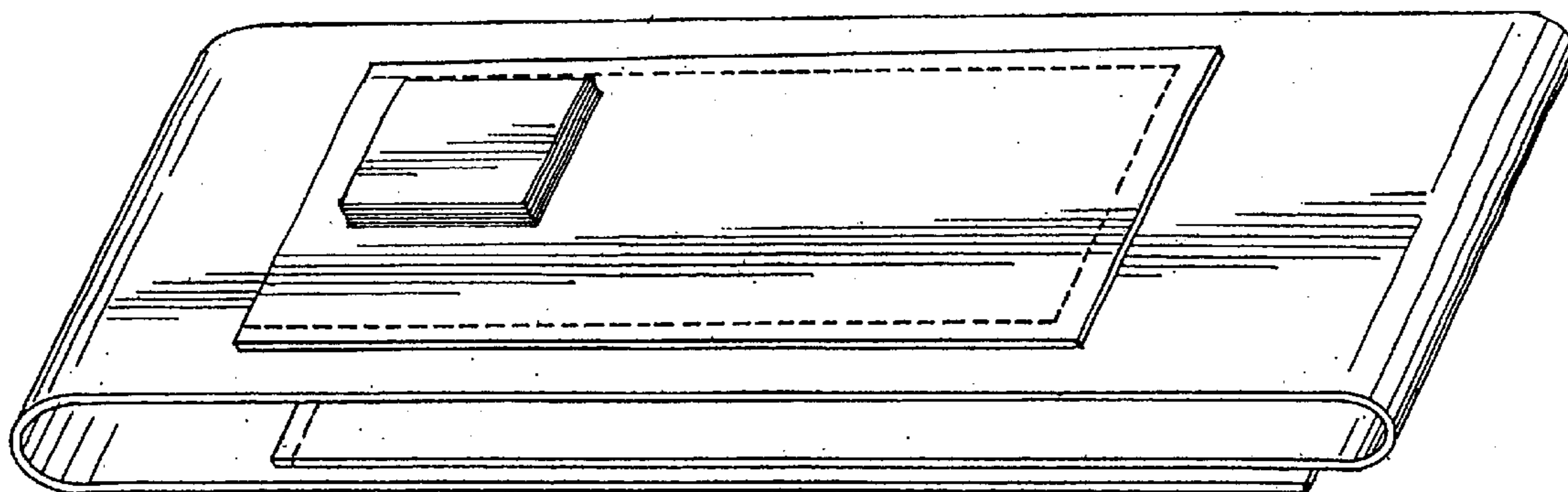

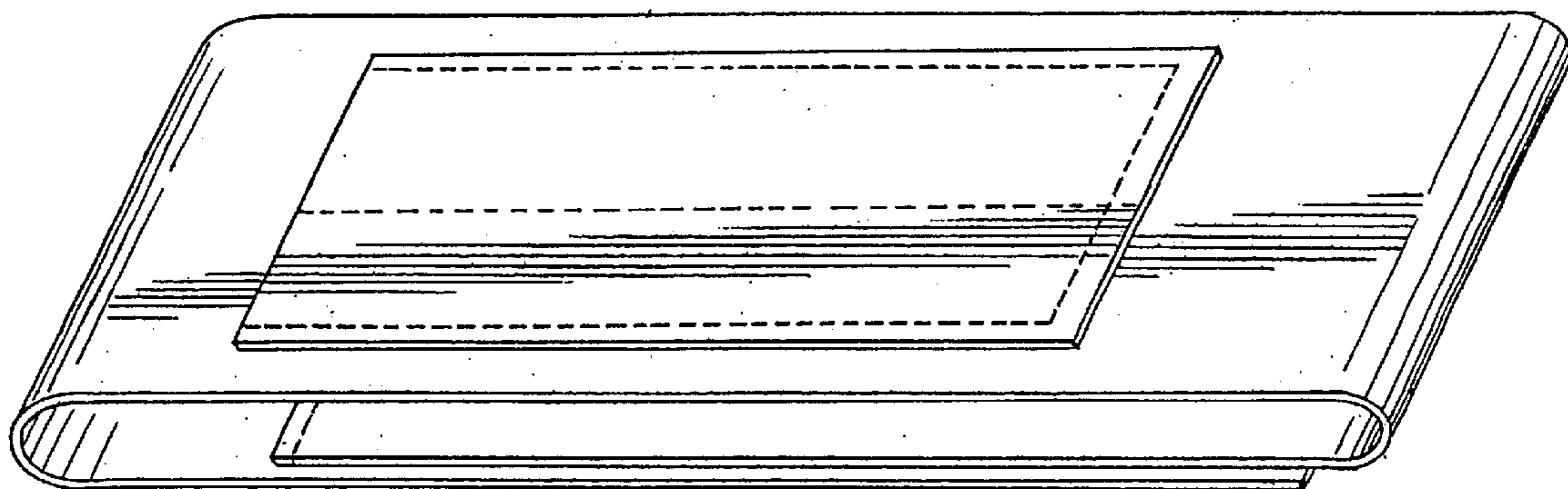

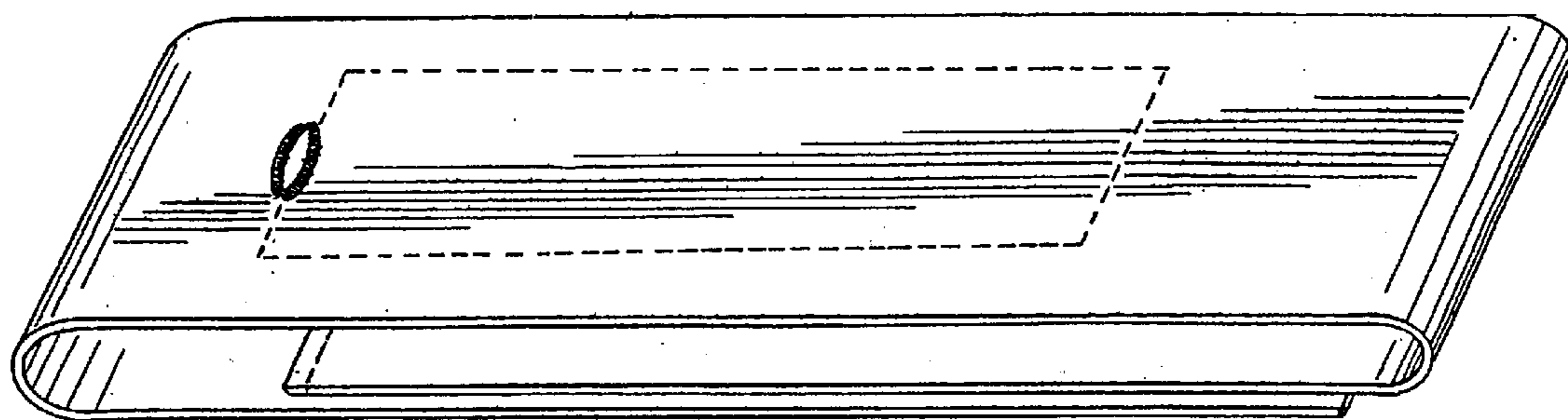
