The ornamental design for a sign, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the sign of the first embodiment;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the sign, it being understood that the opposite side not shown is a substantial mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side view of the sign, it being understood that the opposite side not shown is a substantial mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top view of the sign;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the sign;

FIG. 6 is a front perspective view of the sign of the second embodiment;

FIG. 7 is a front view of the sign of the second embodiment, it being understood that the opposite side not shown is a substantial mirror image thereof;

FIG. 8 is a left side view of the sign of the second embodiment, it being understood that the opposite side not shown is a substantial mirror image thereof;

FIG. 9 is a top view of the sign of the second embodiment;

FIG. 10 is a bottom view of the sign of the second embodiment;

FIG. 11 is a front perspective view of the sign of the third embodiment;

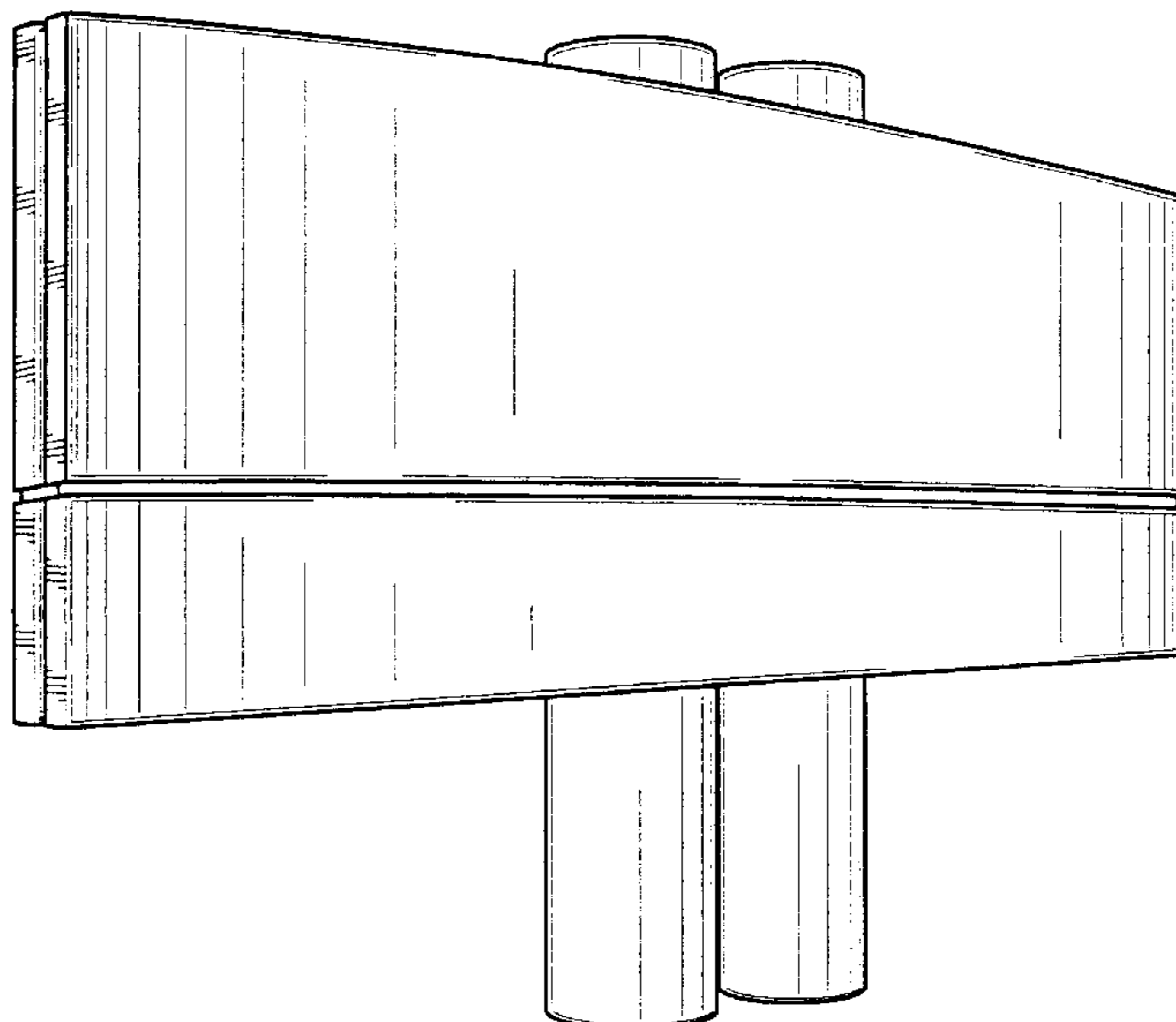
FIG. 12 is a front view of the sign of the third embodiment, it being understood that the opposite side not shown is a substantial mirror image thereof;

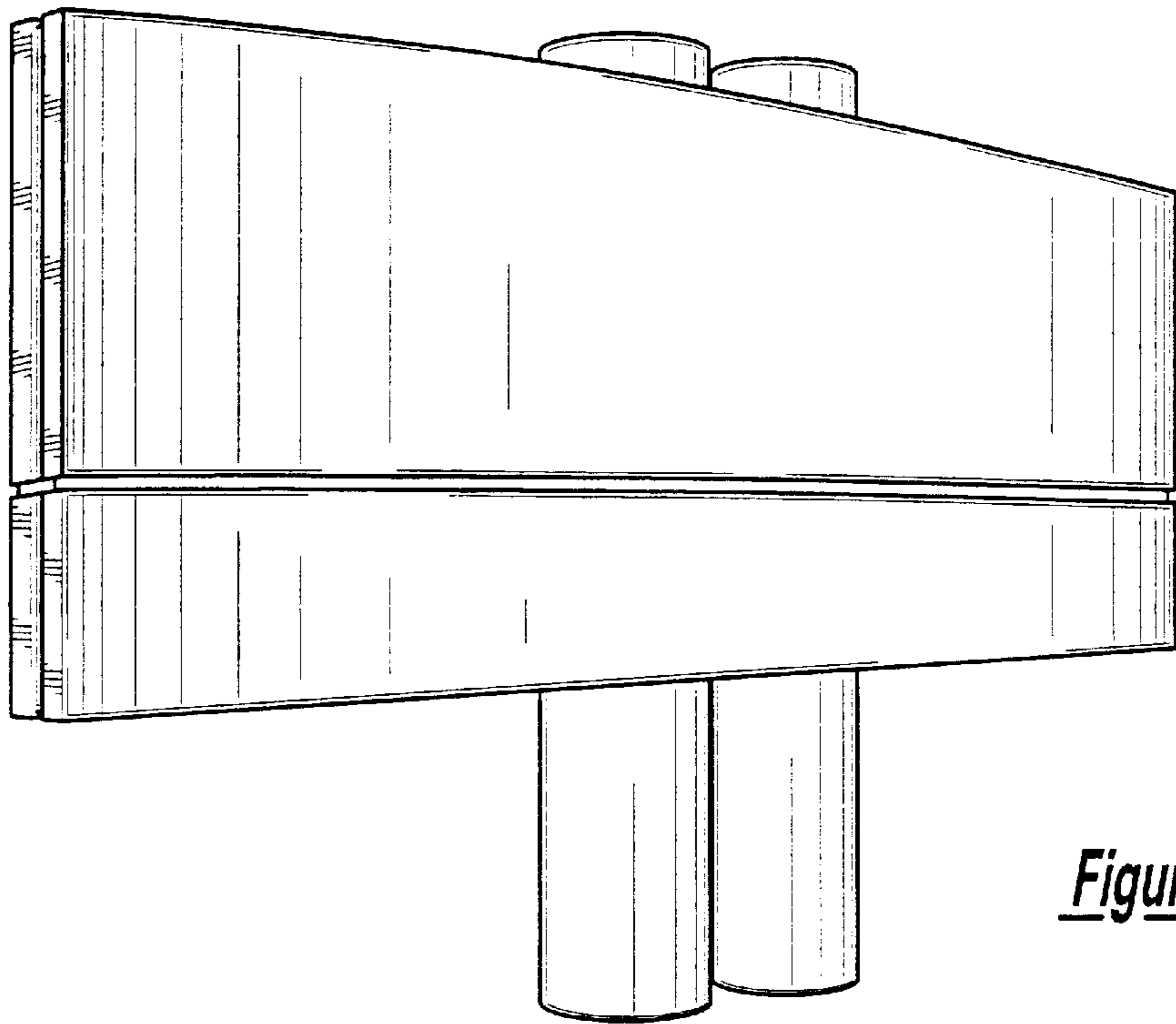

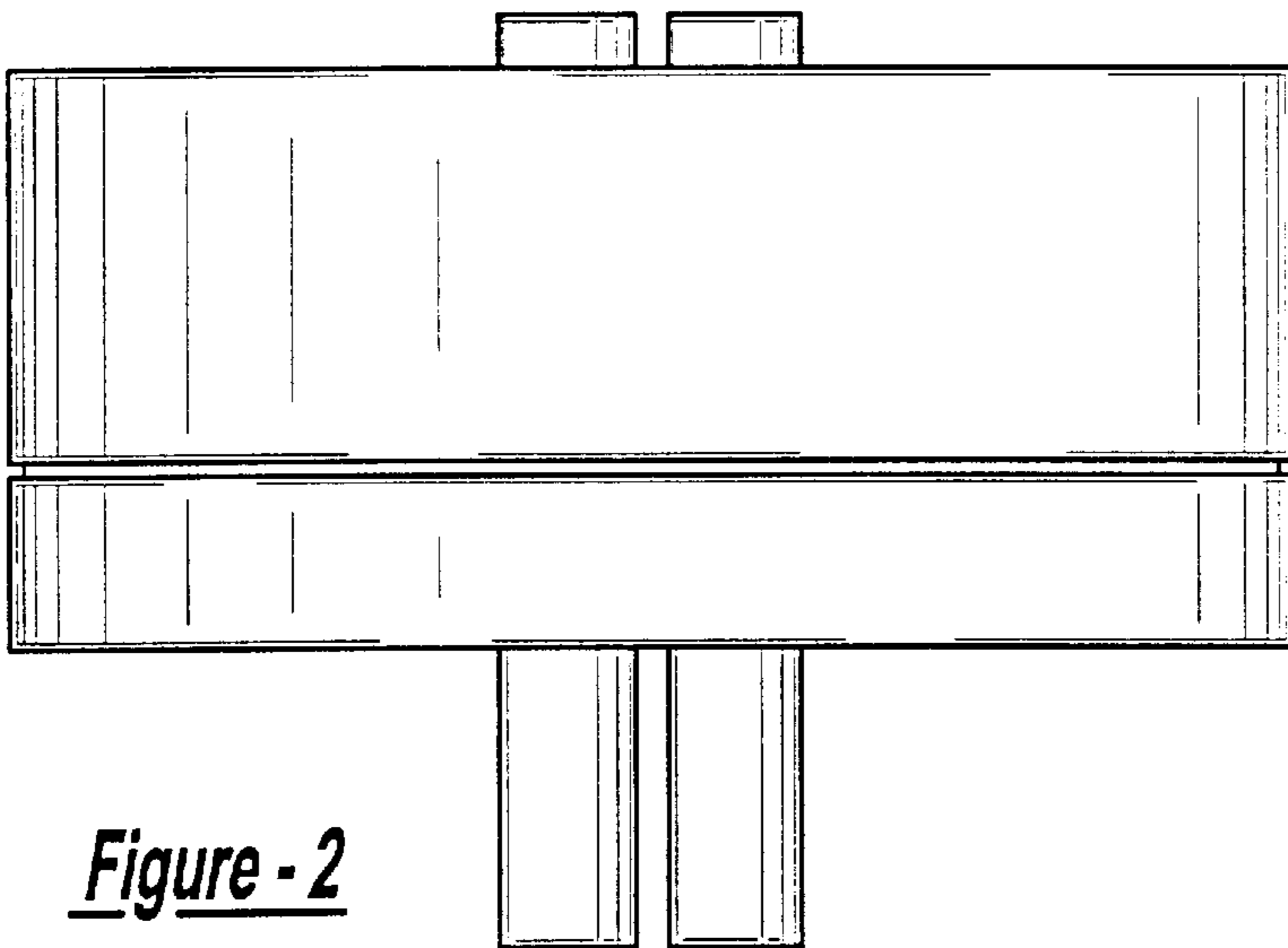

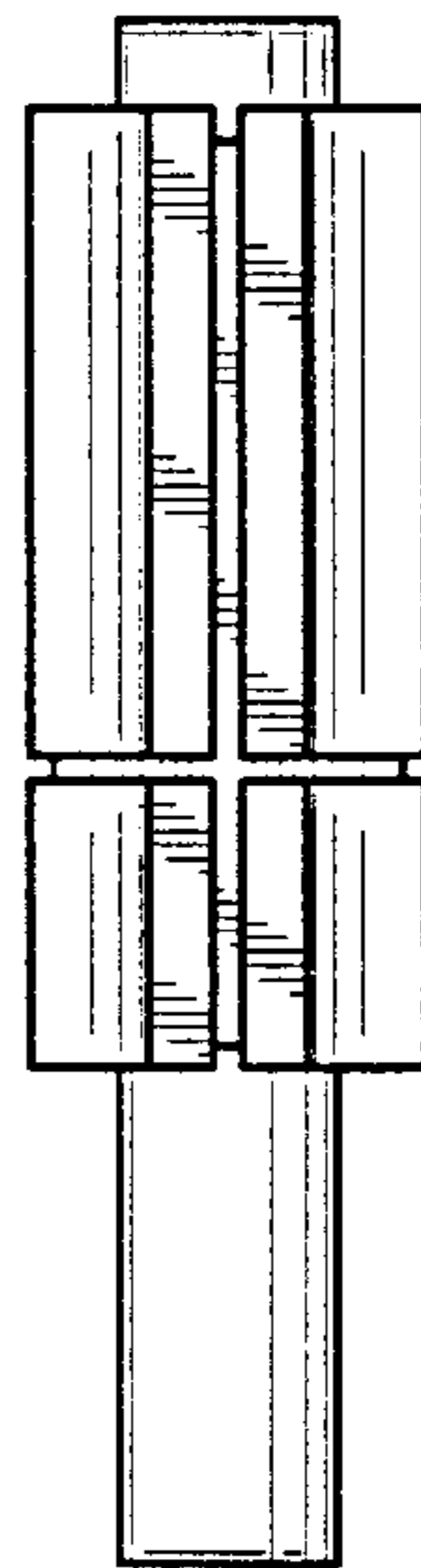

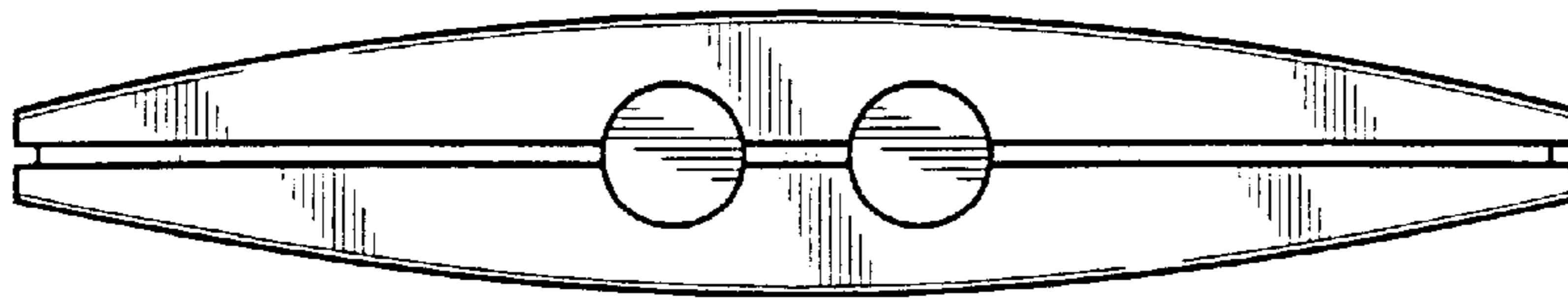

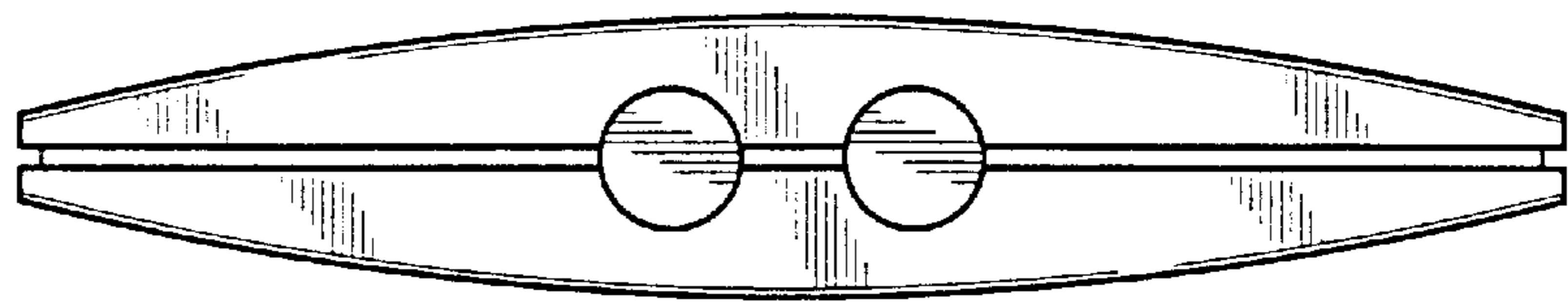

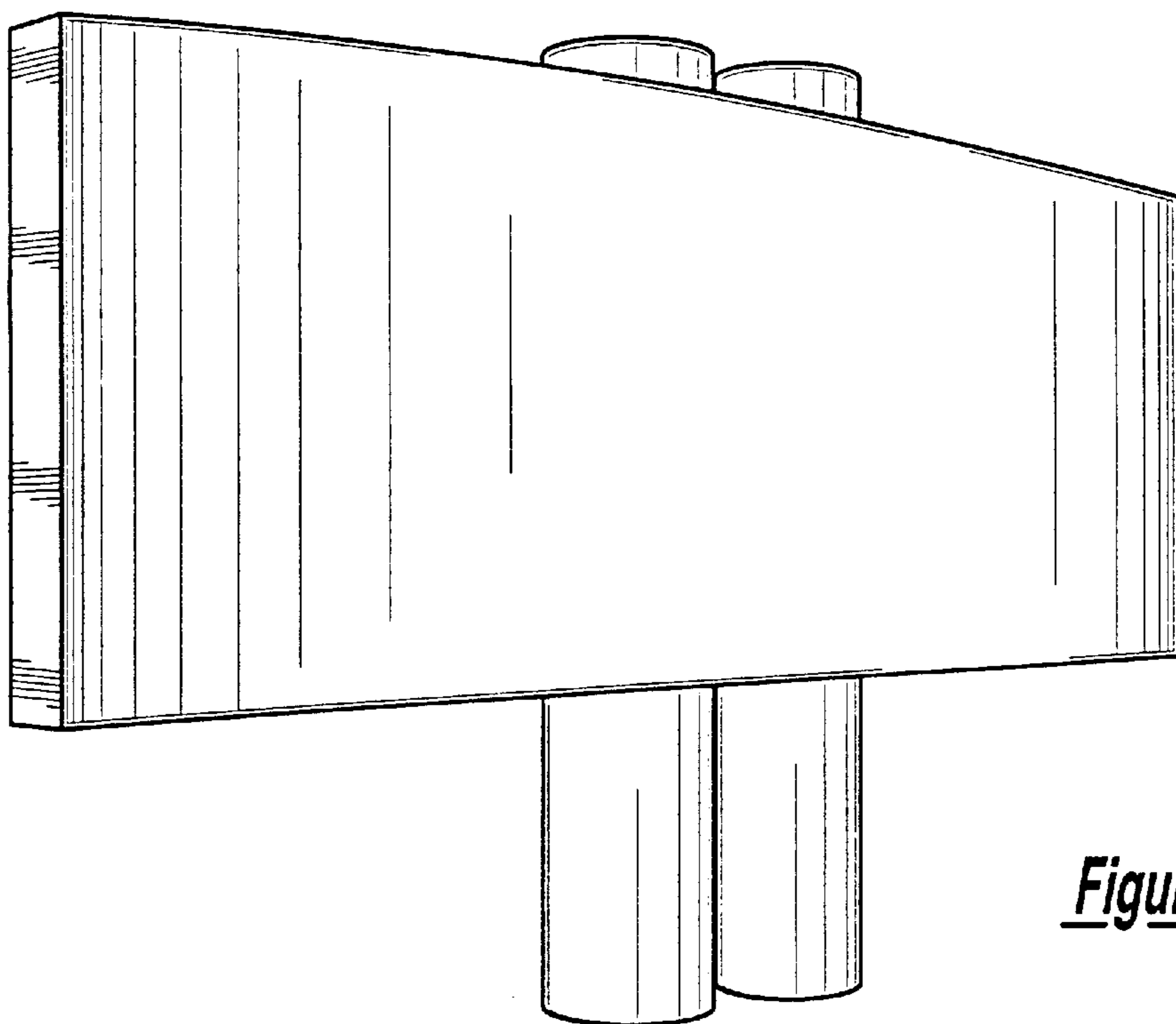

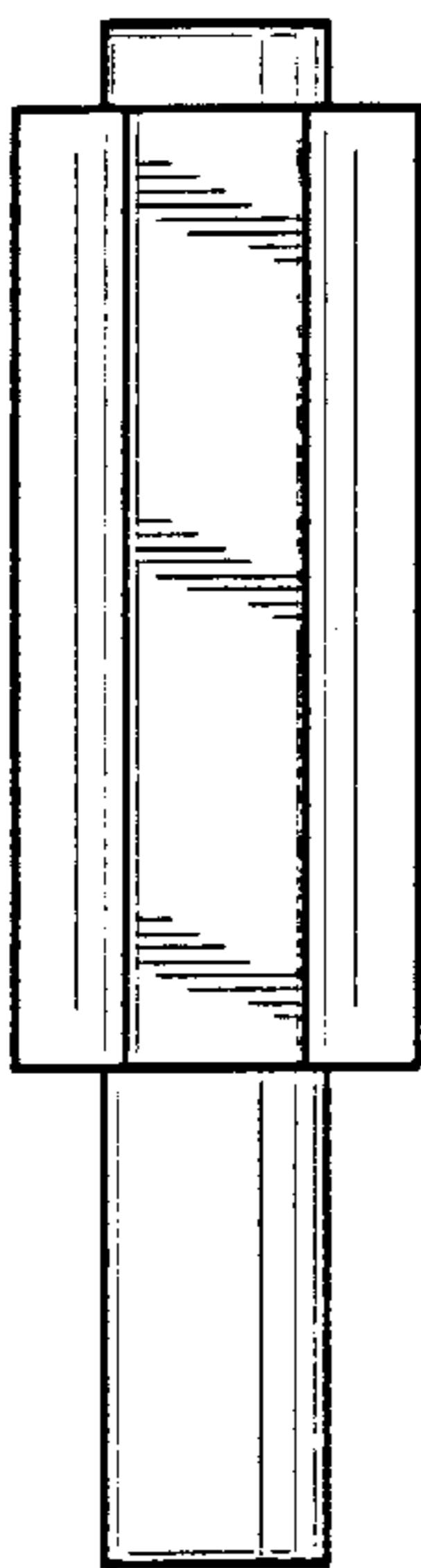
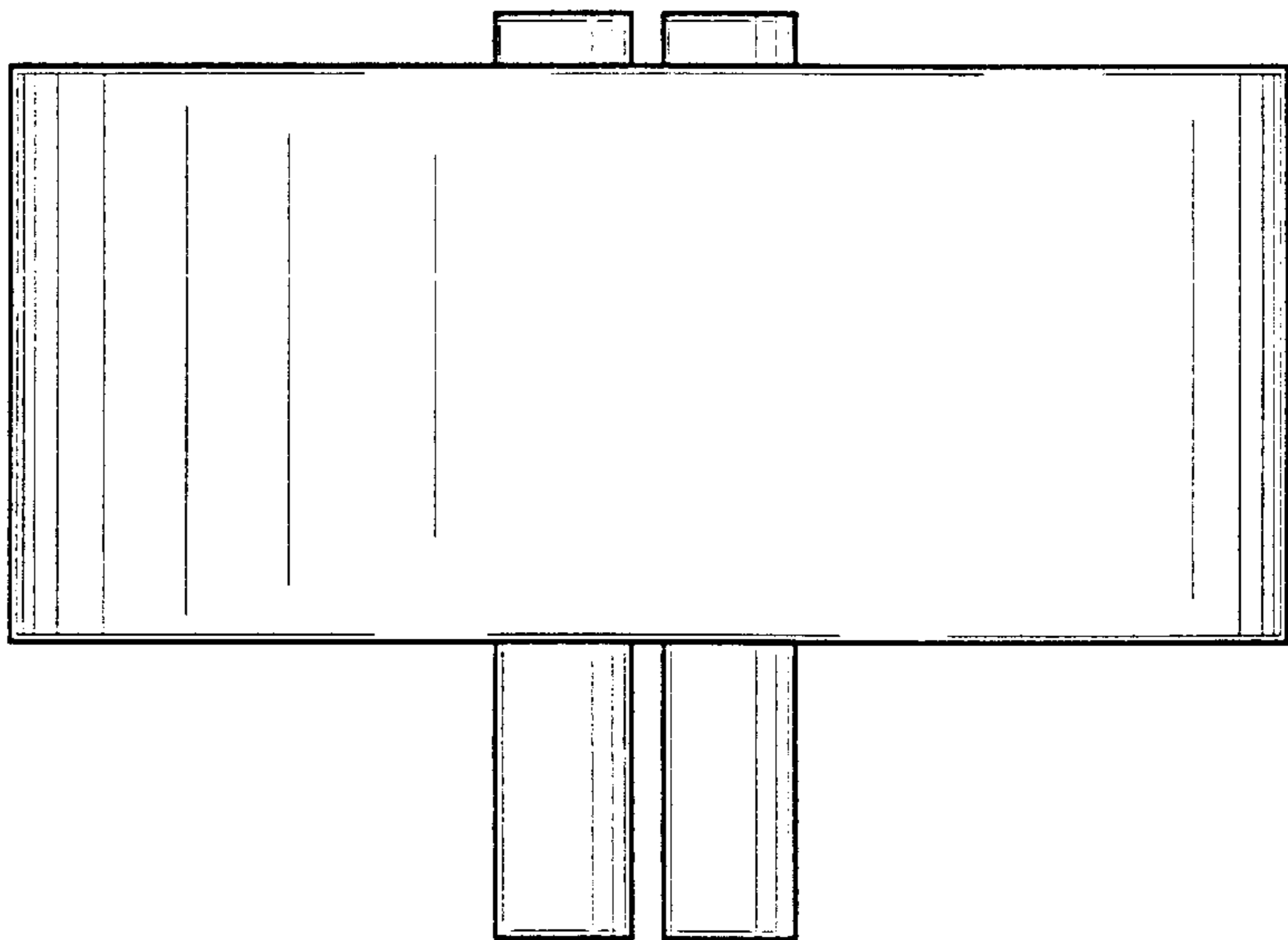

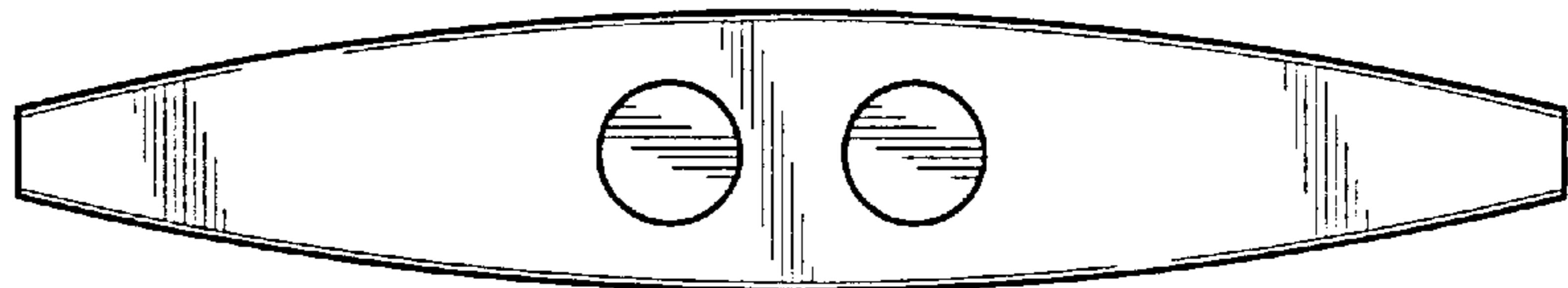

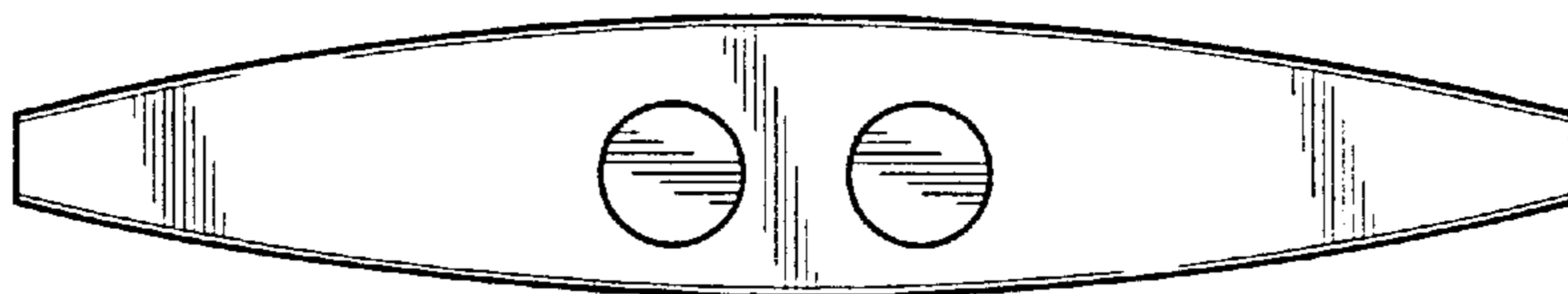

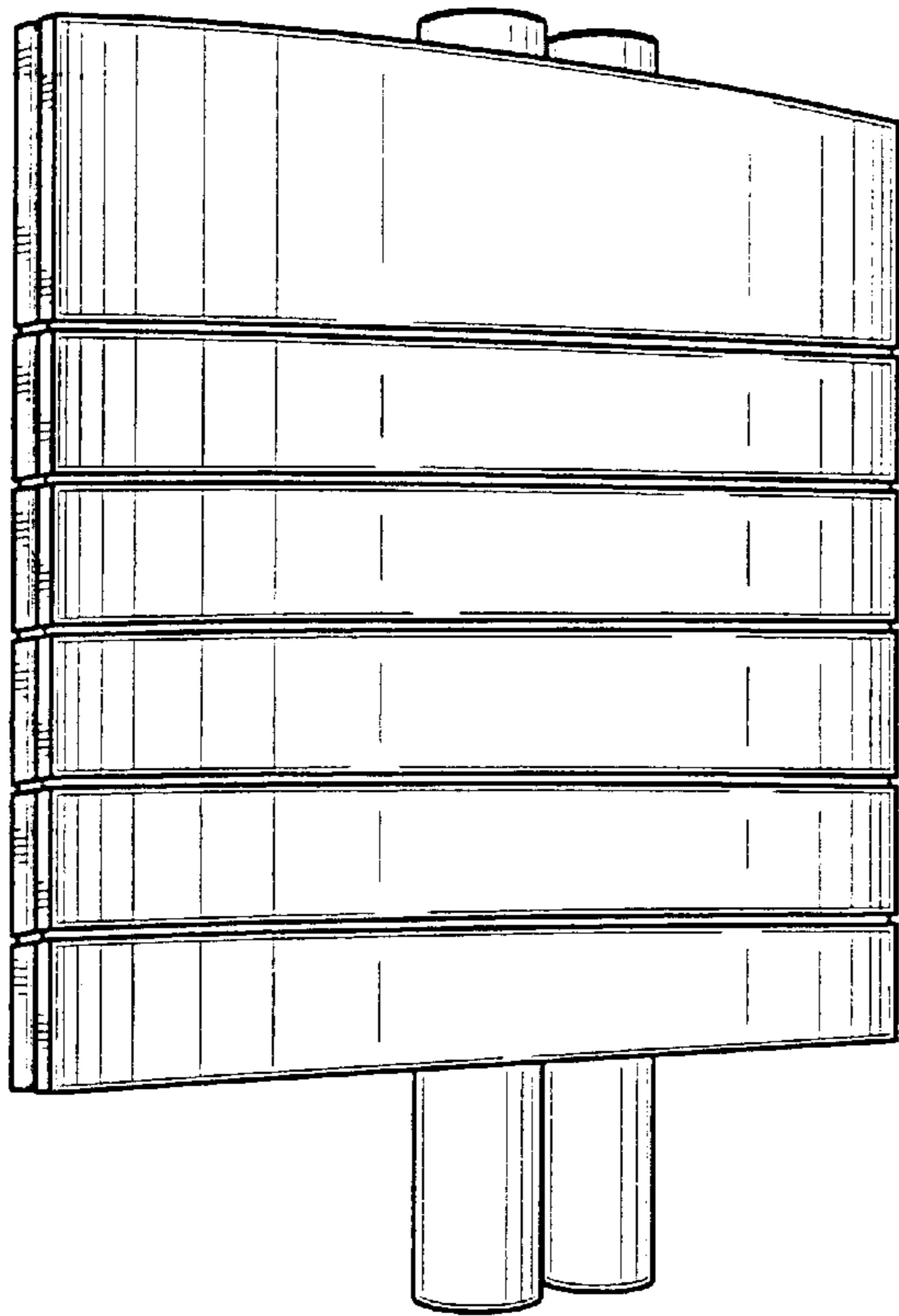
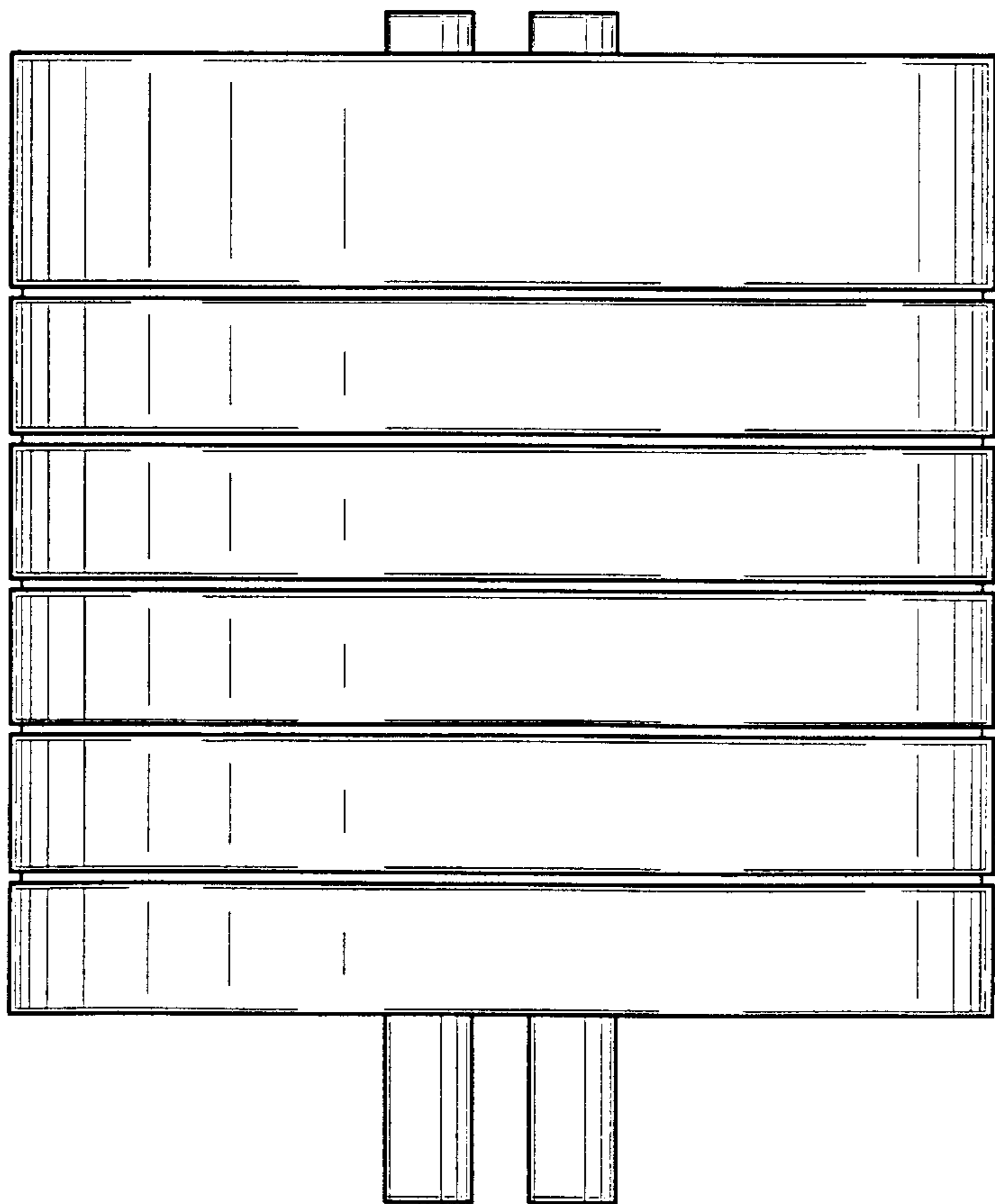

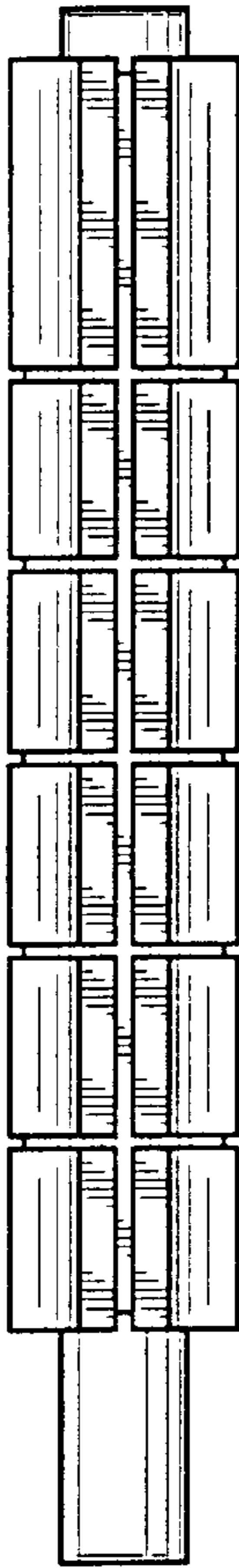

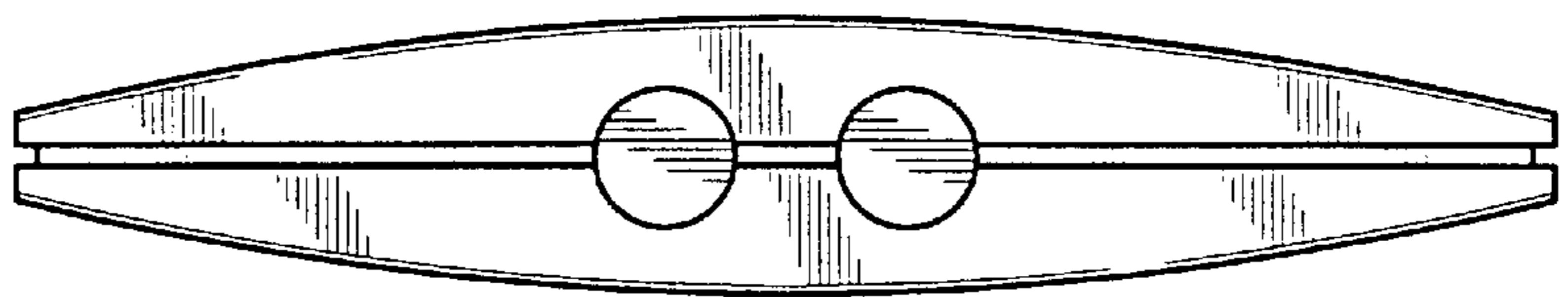

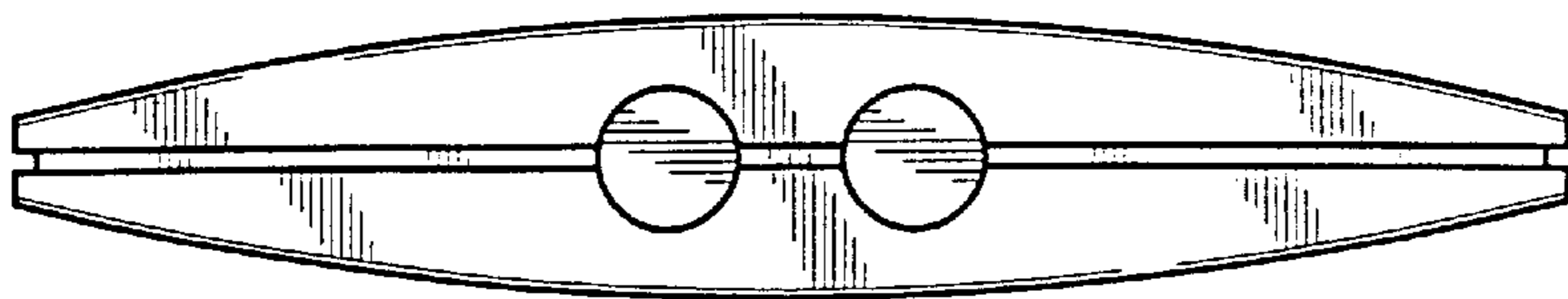
