(57) **CLAIM**

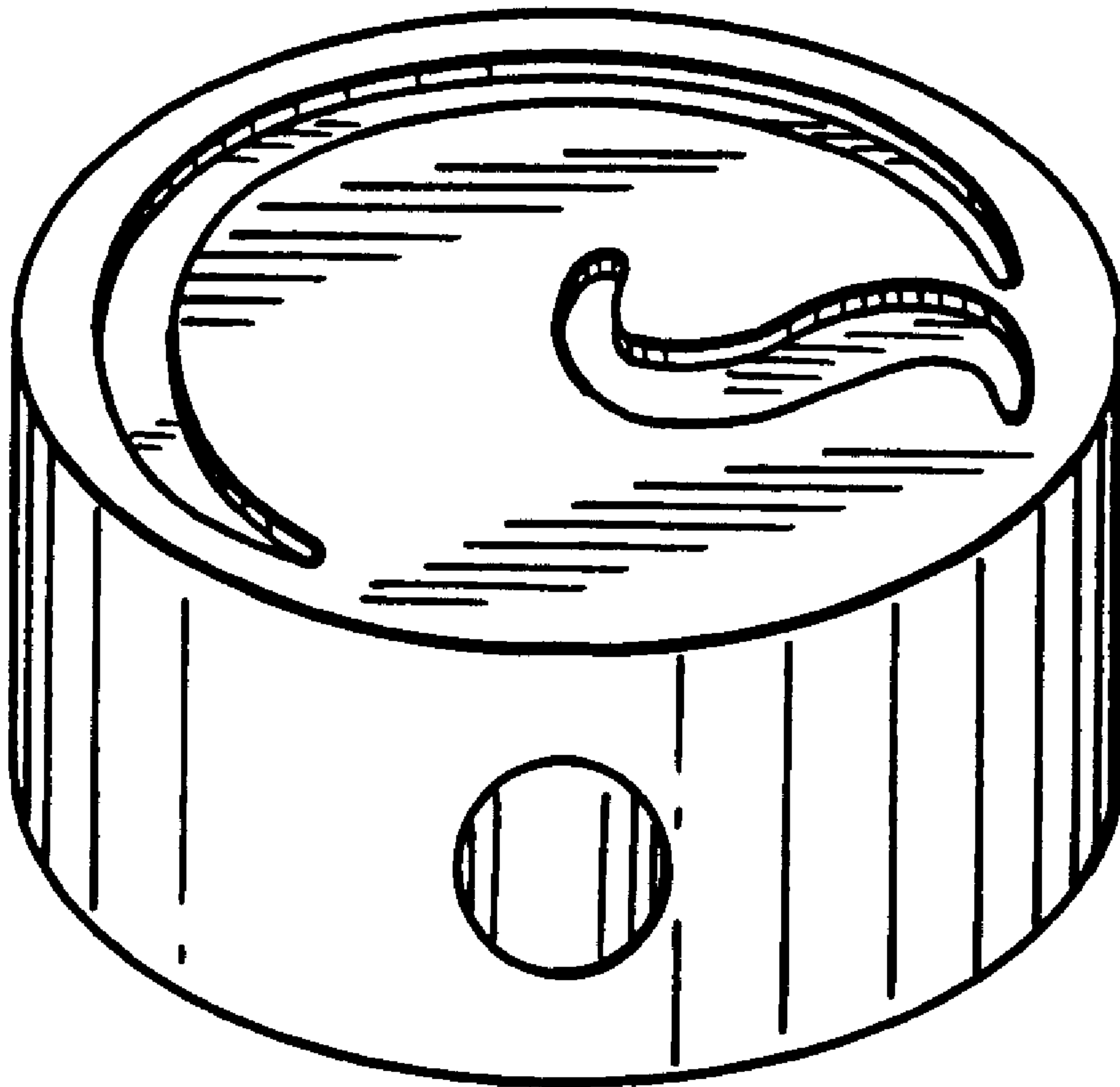
The ornamental design for an ornament for a necklace, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a front plan view of the design with broken lines depicting an example environment related to the design;

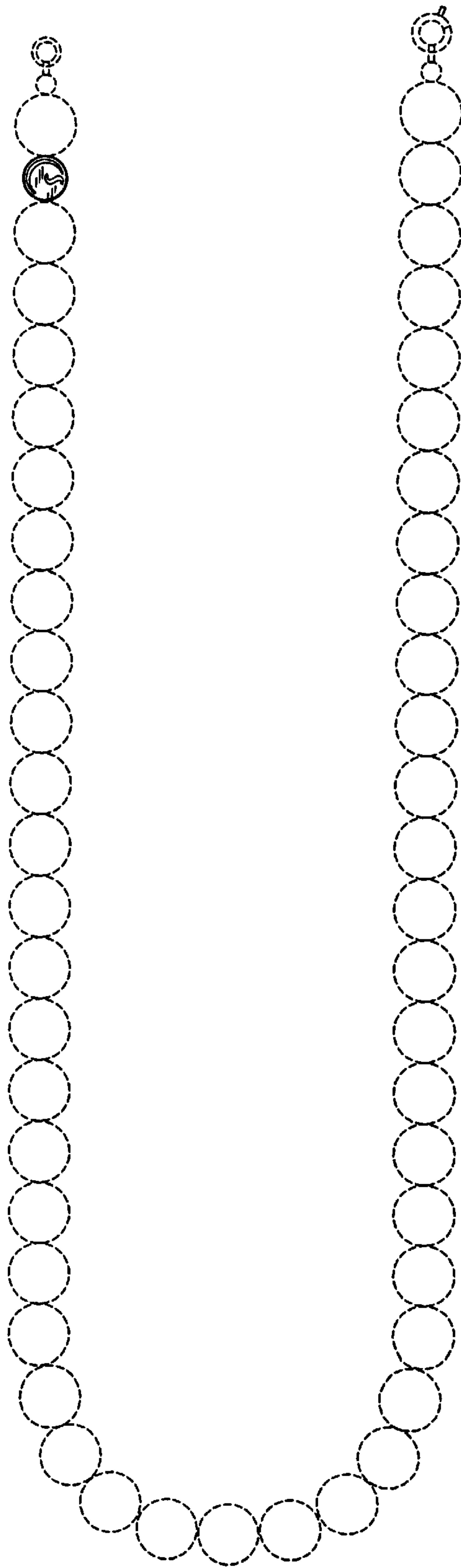

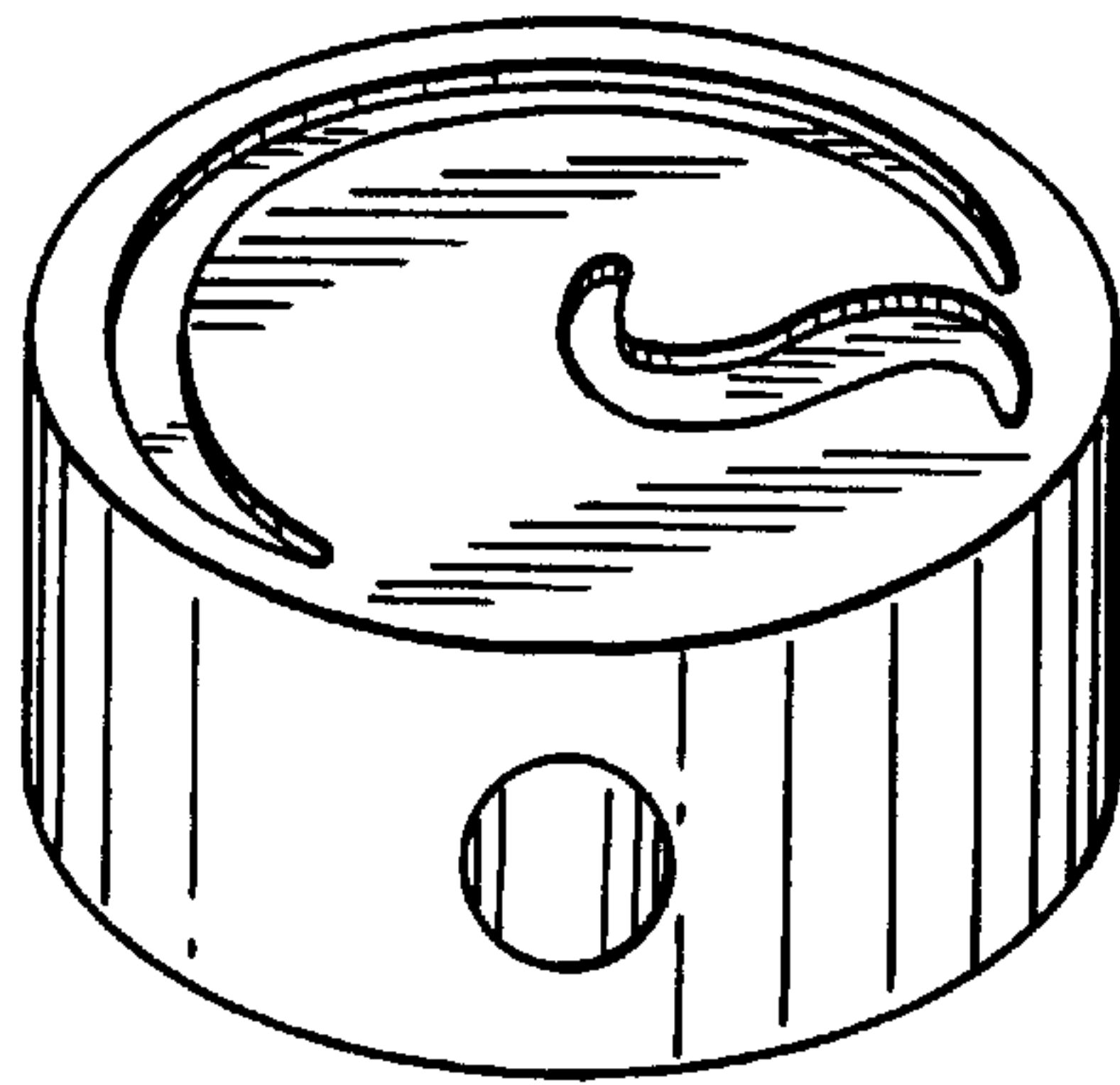

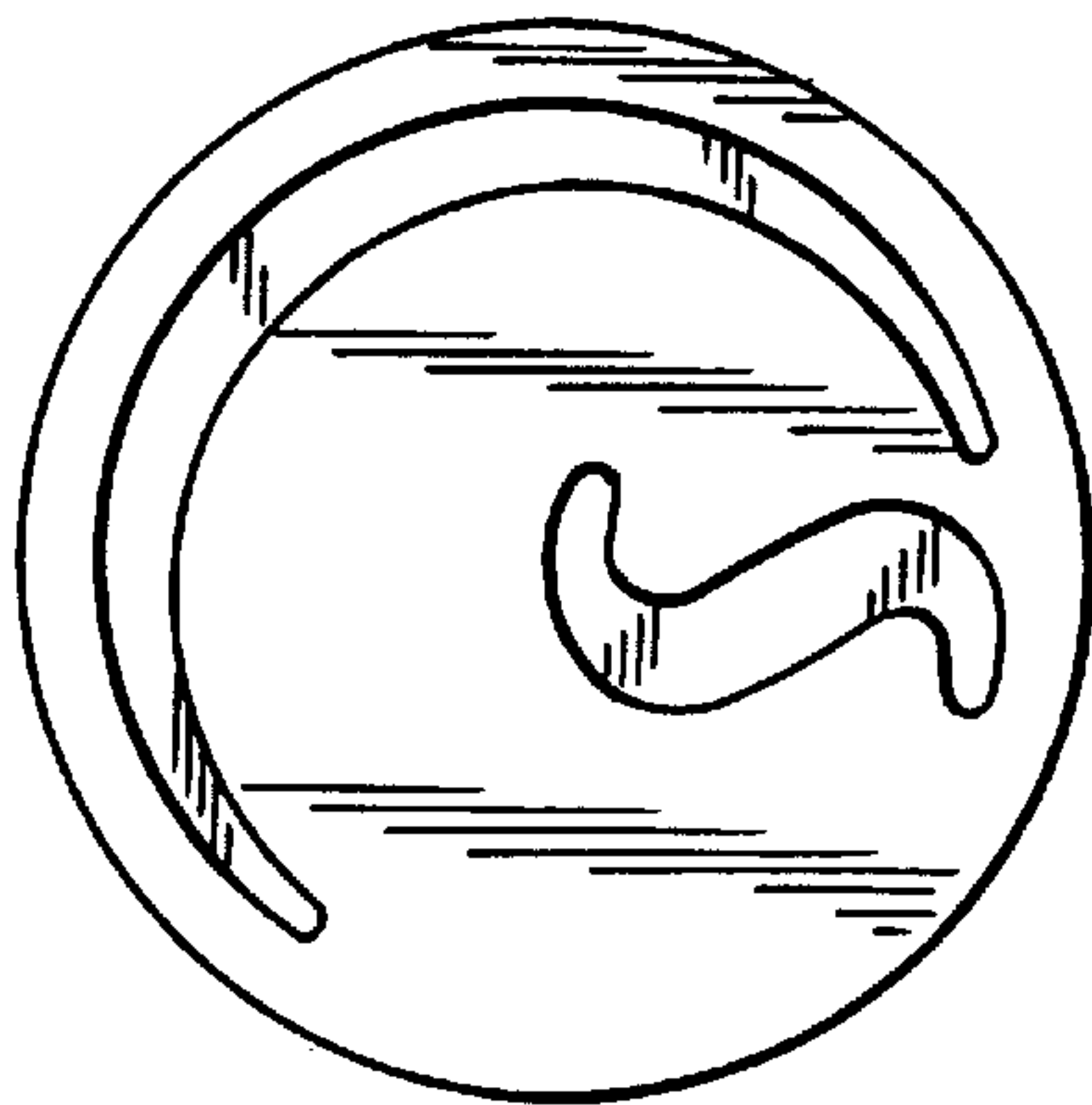

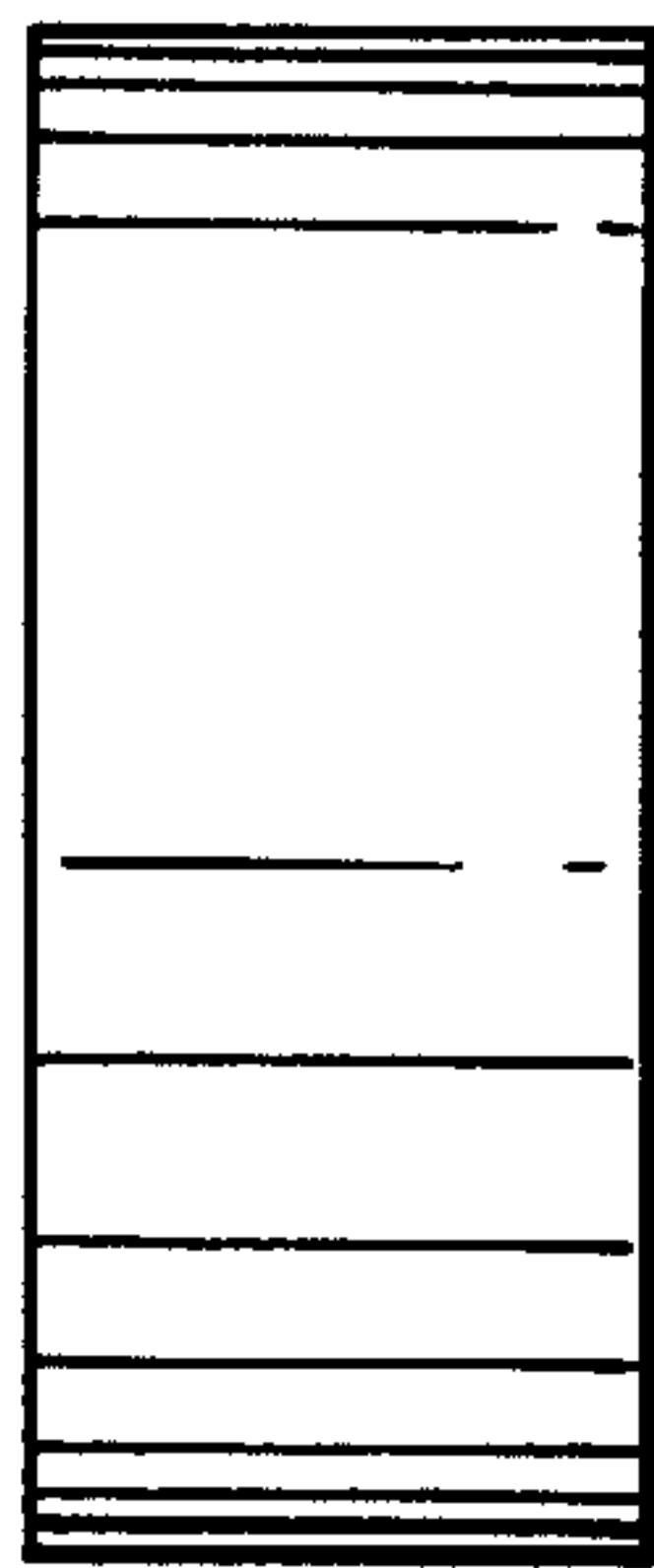

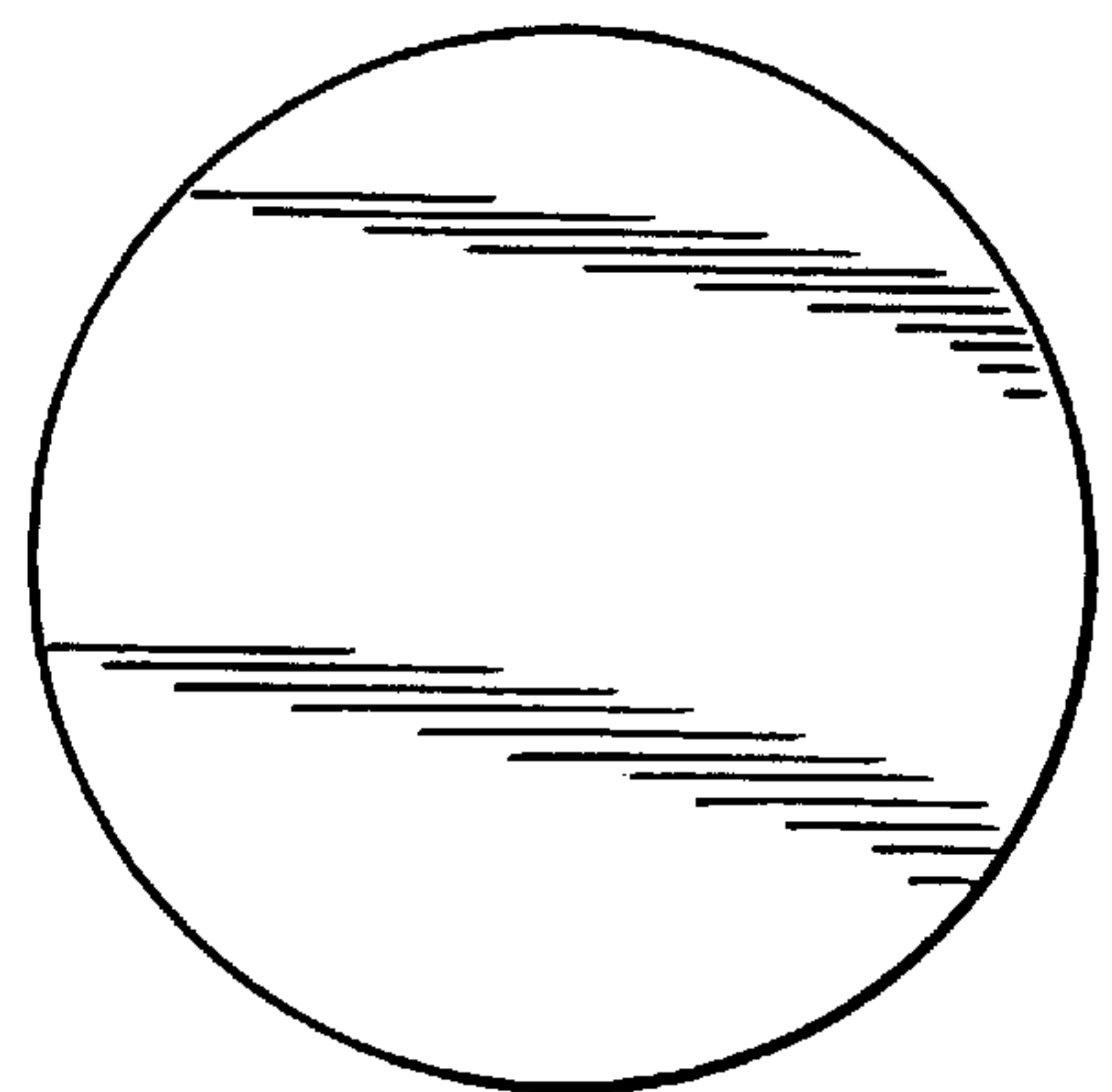

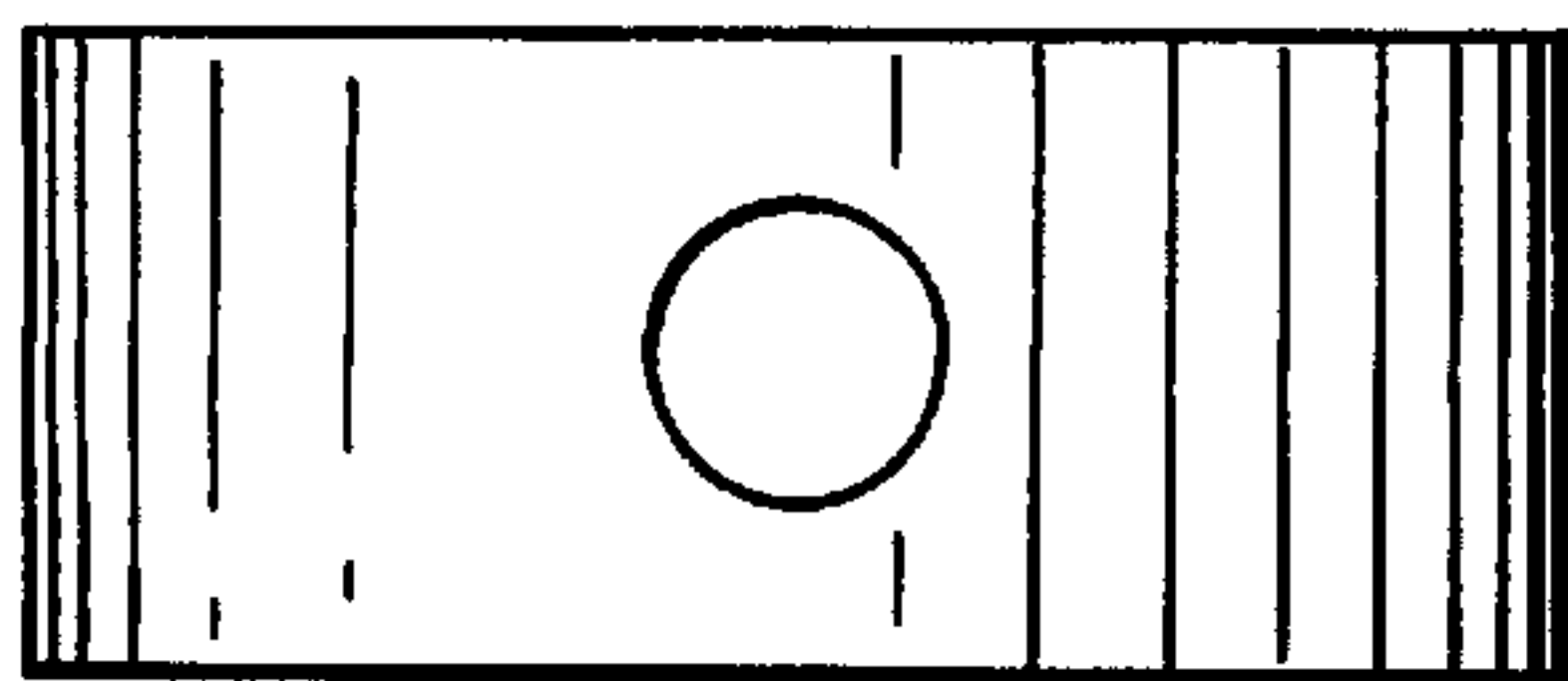
