FIG. 1 is a front, top perspective view of a game box, all other side views being a mirror image;

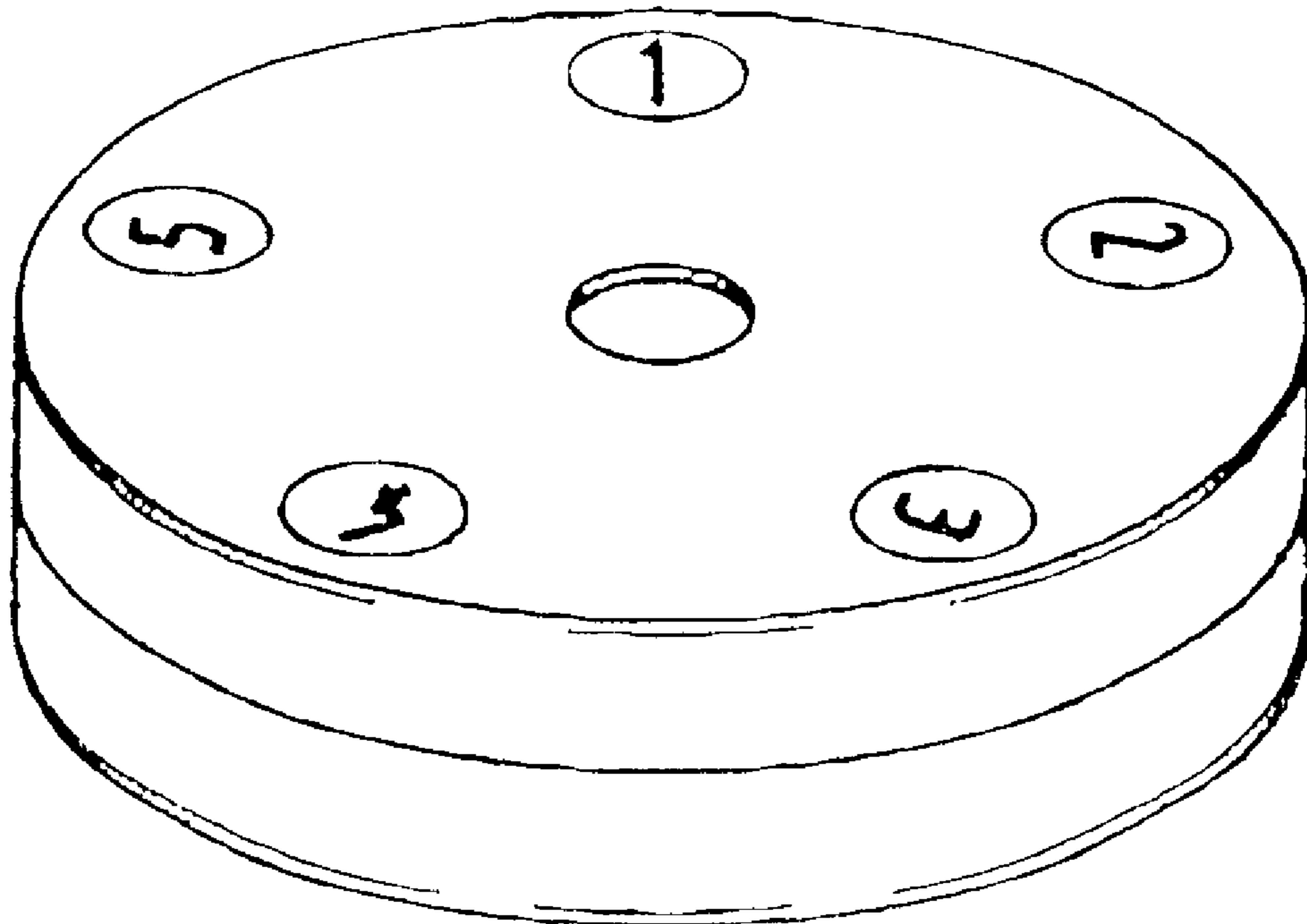
FIG. 2 is a front, top perspective view of an alternate embodiment of FIG. 1, all other side views being a mirror image;

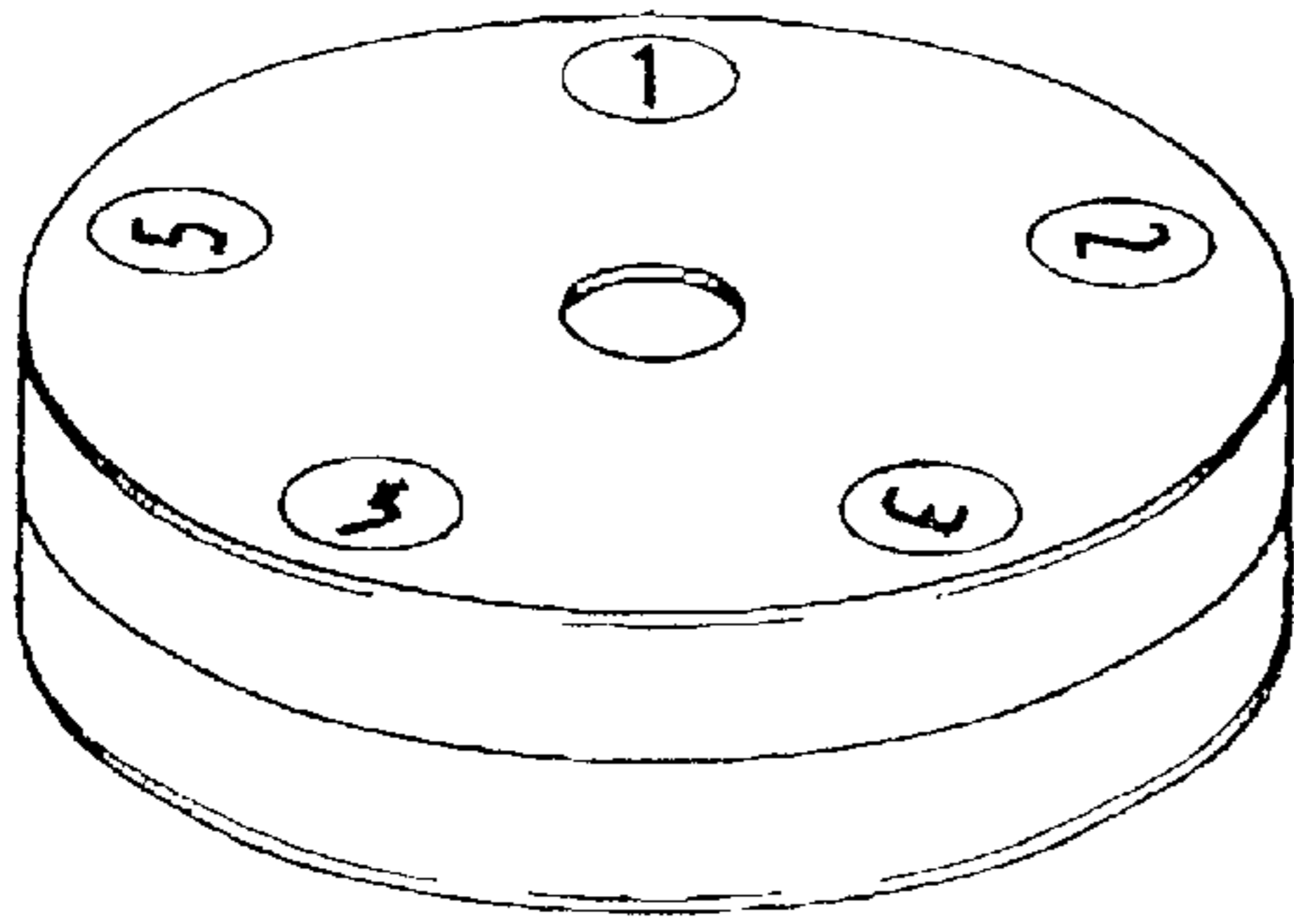

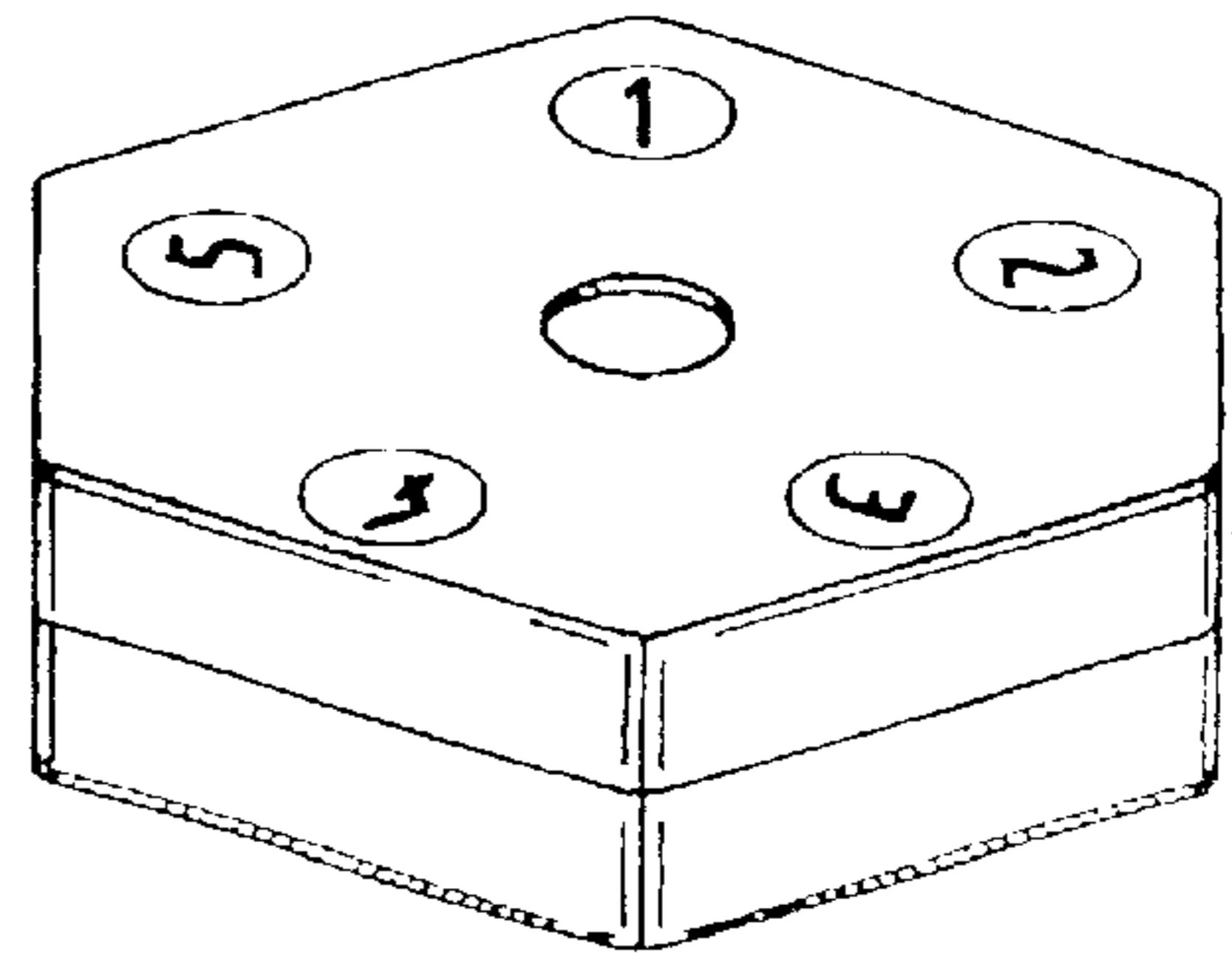

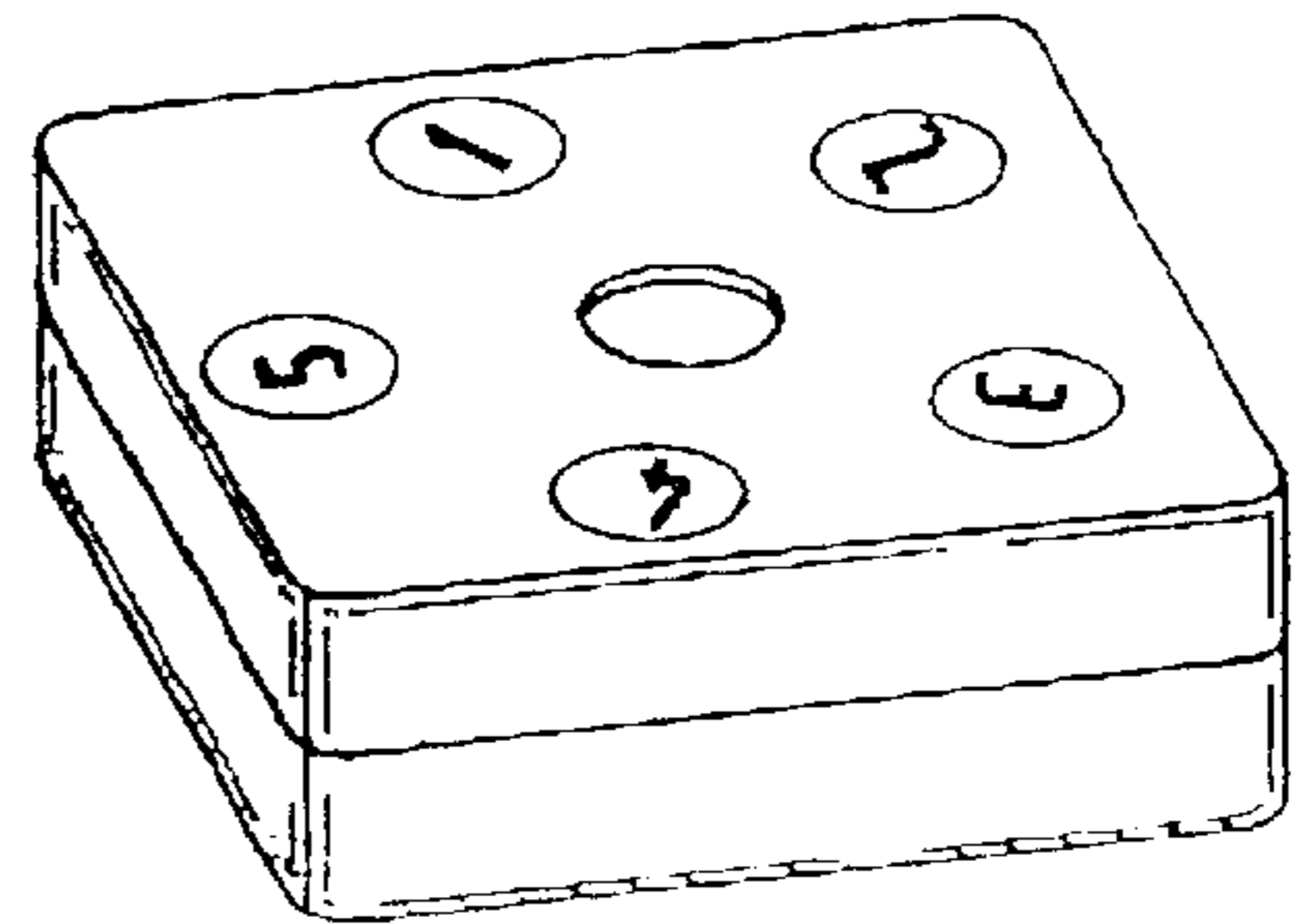

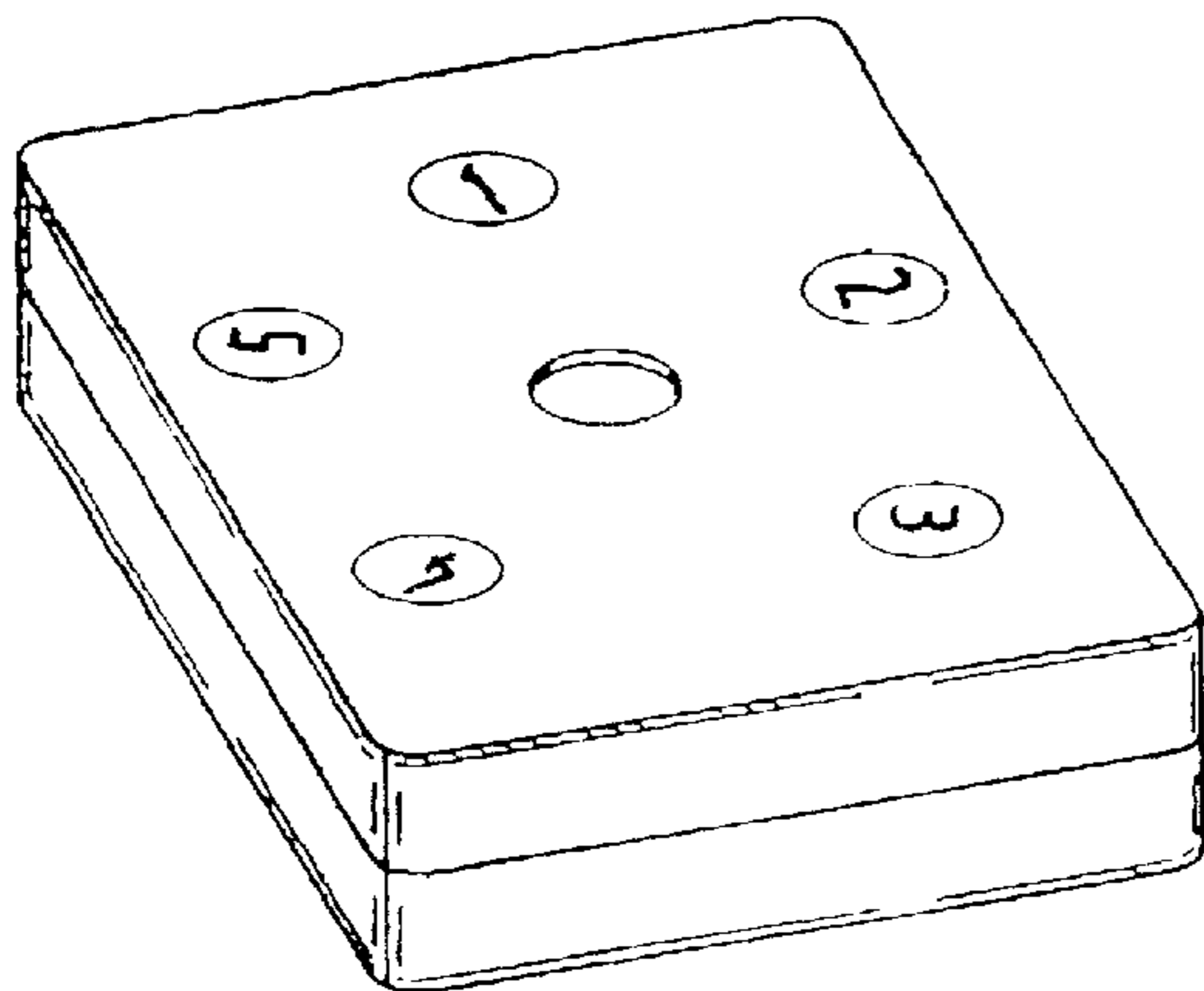
