(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an antiperspirant and/or deodorant product having a marbled appearance, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an antiperspirant and/or deodorant product showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the antiperspirant and/or deodorant product of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the antiperspirant and/or deodorant product of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a side elevation view of the antiperspirant and/or deodorant product of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view of the antiperspirant and/or deodorant product of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a side elevation view of the antiperspirant and/or deodorant product of FIG. 1, from the side opposite that in FIG. 4;

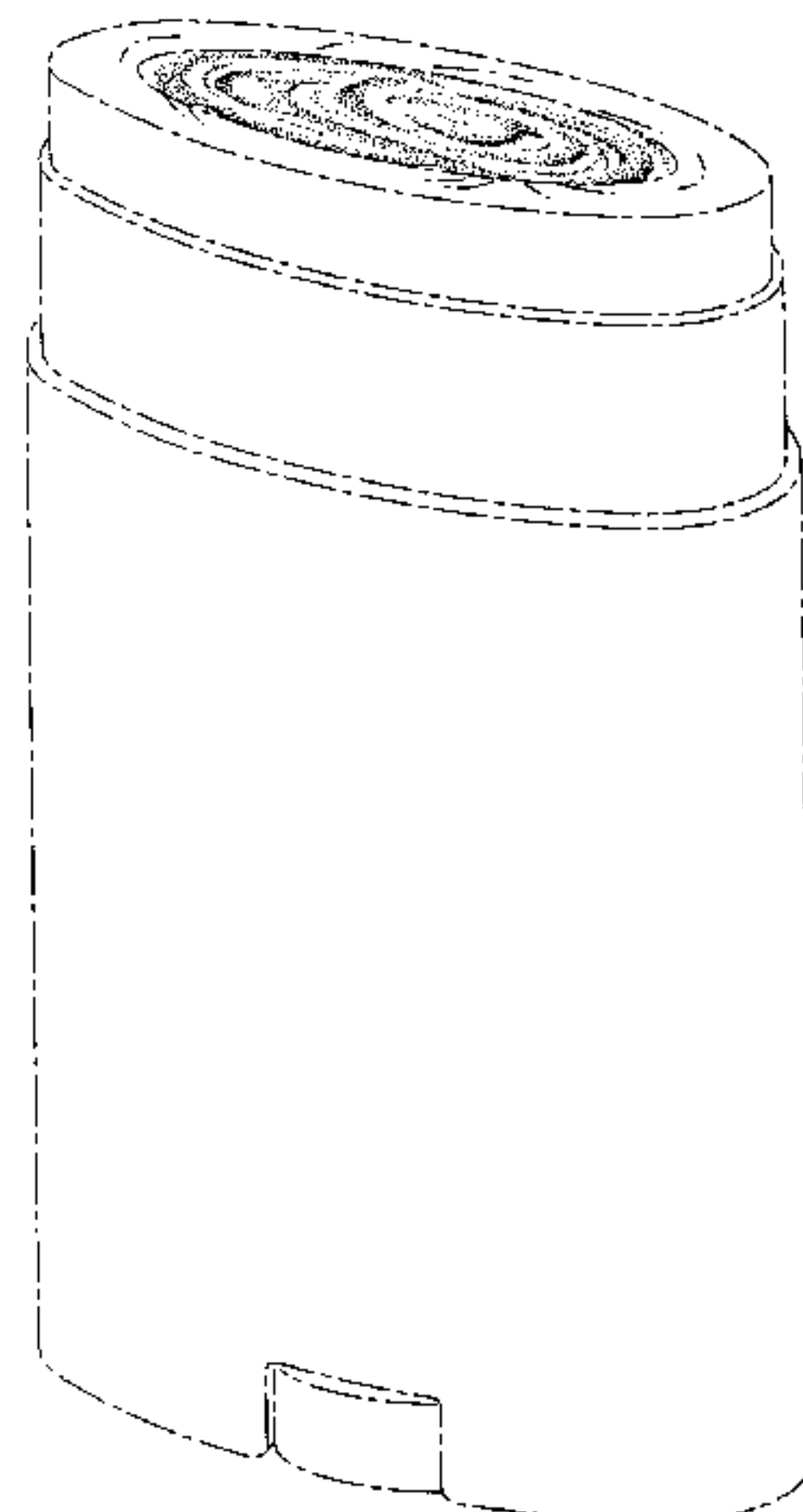
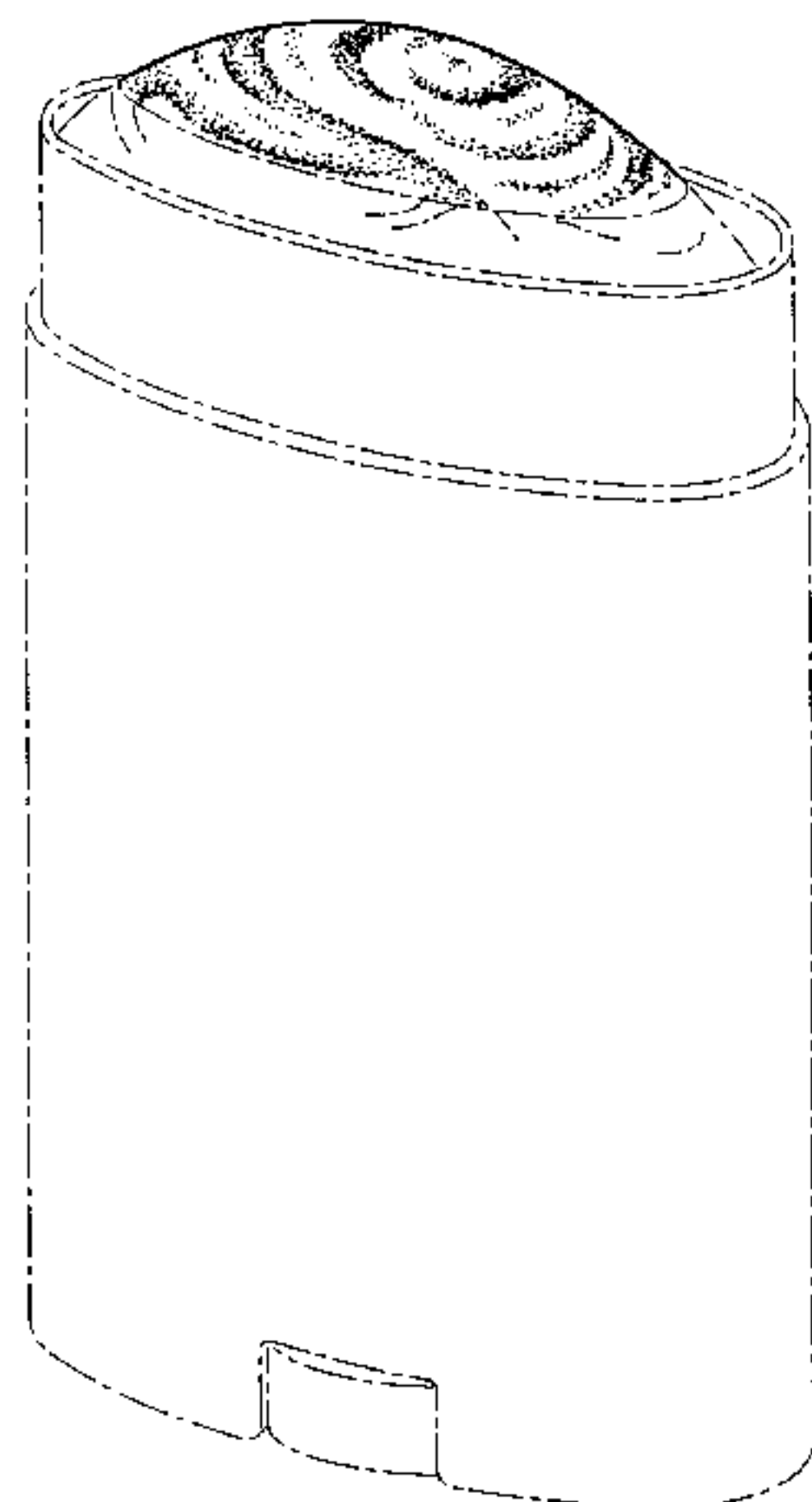
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the antiperspirant and/or deodorant product; and,

FIG. 8 is a top plan view of the antiperspirant and/or deodorant product of FIG. 7.

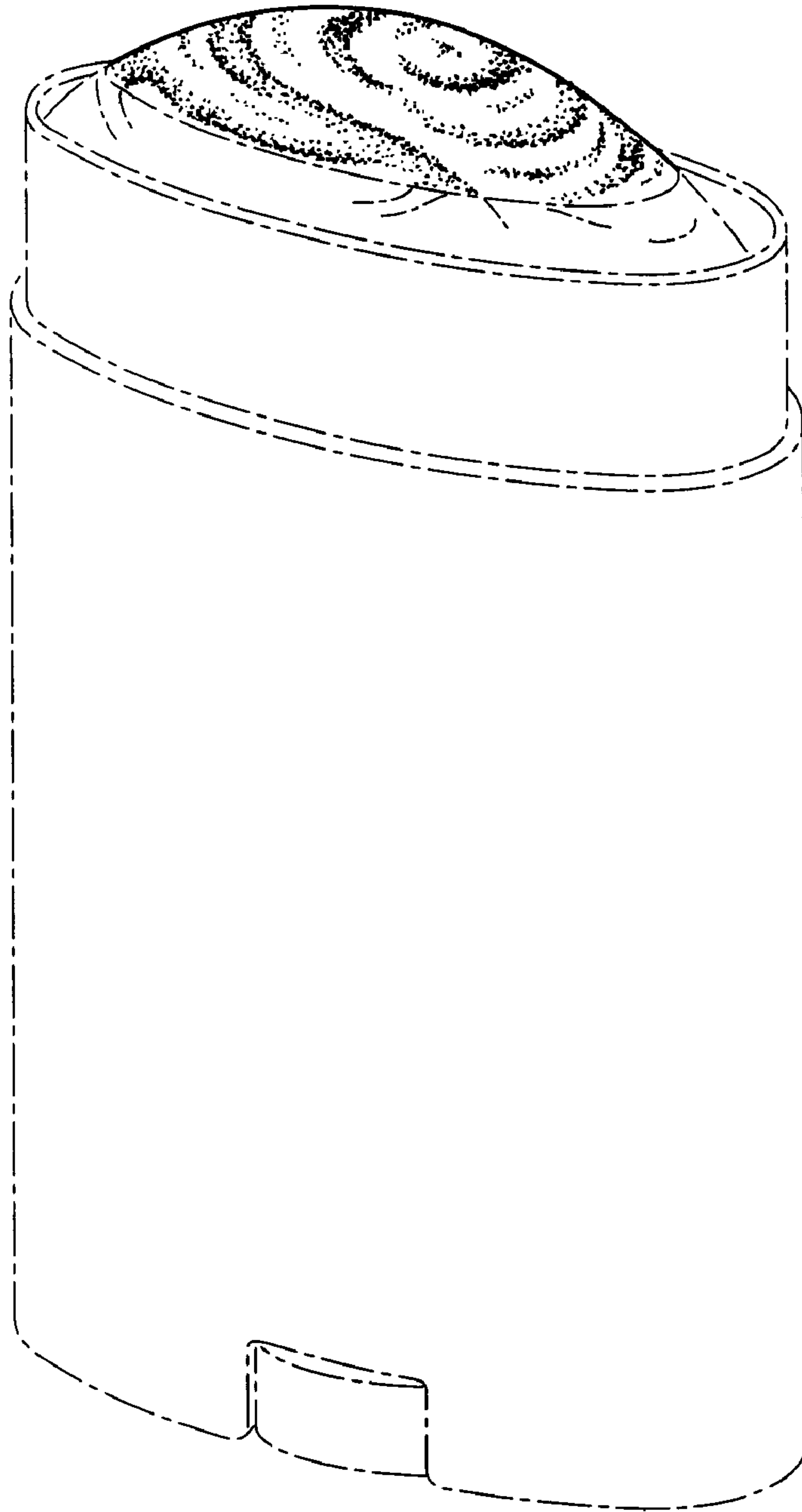

The stippling represents a surface having a color that contrasts with the color of the surface that does not include stippling.

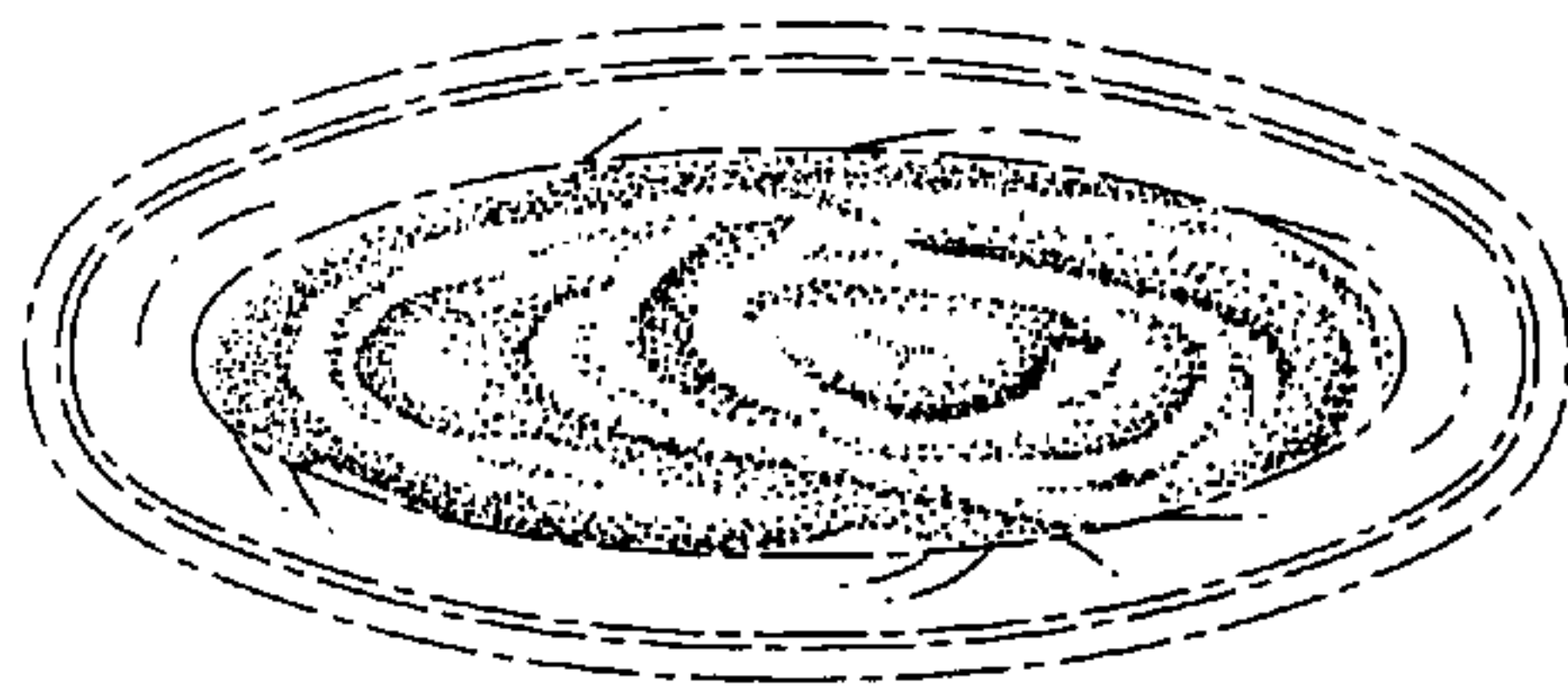

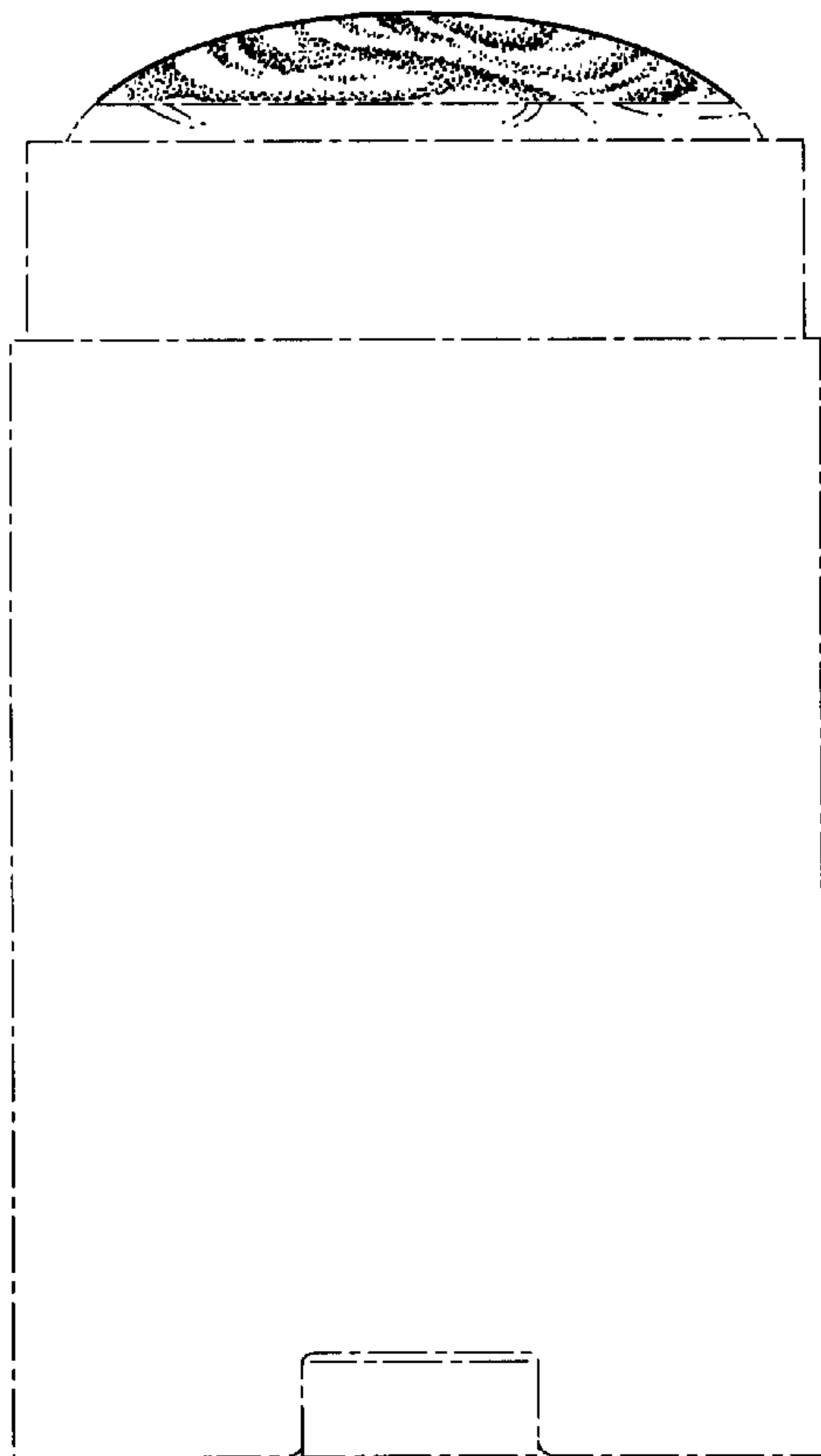

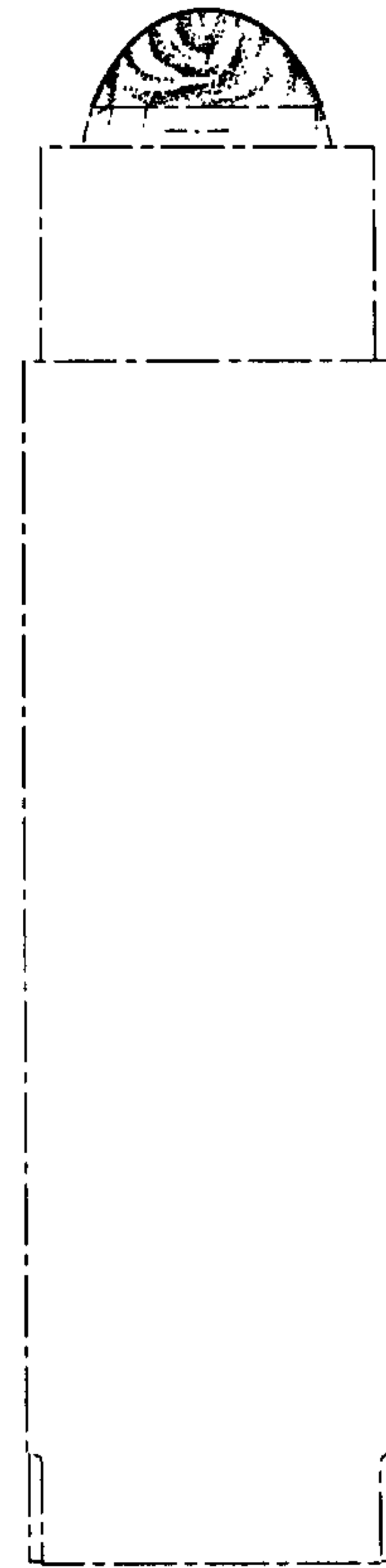

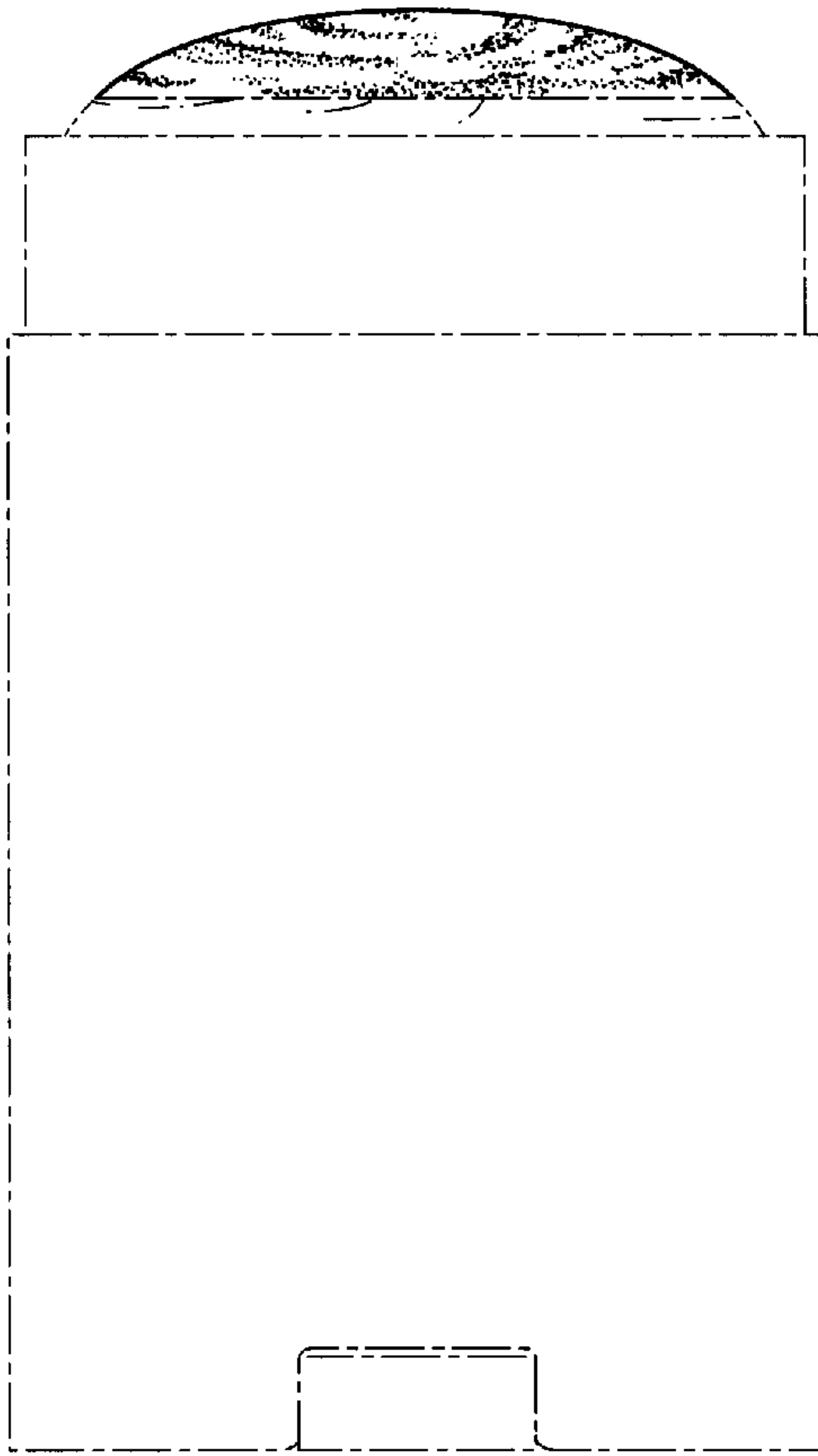

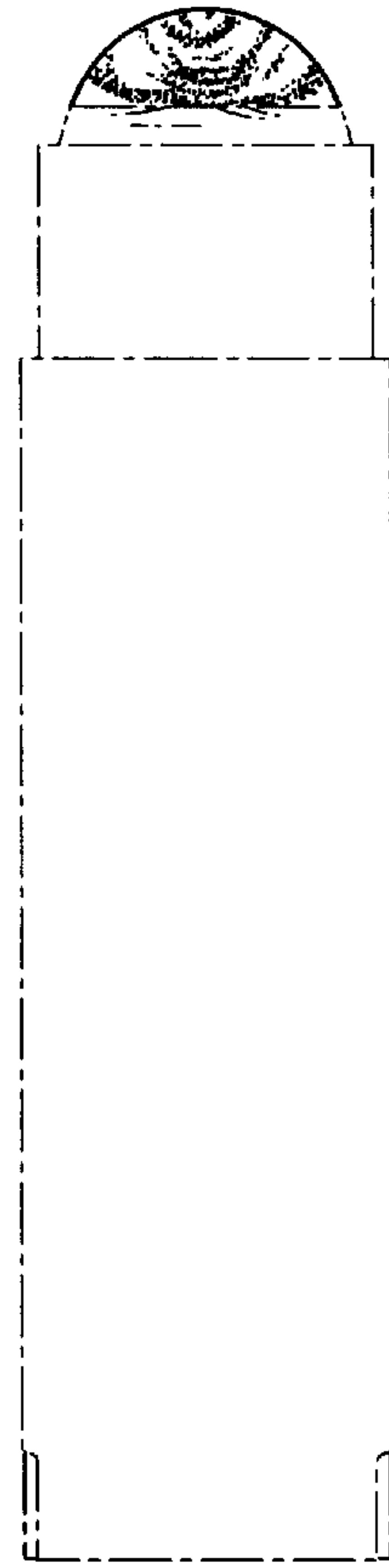

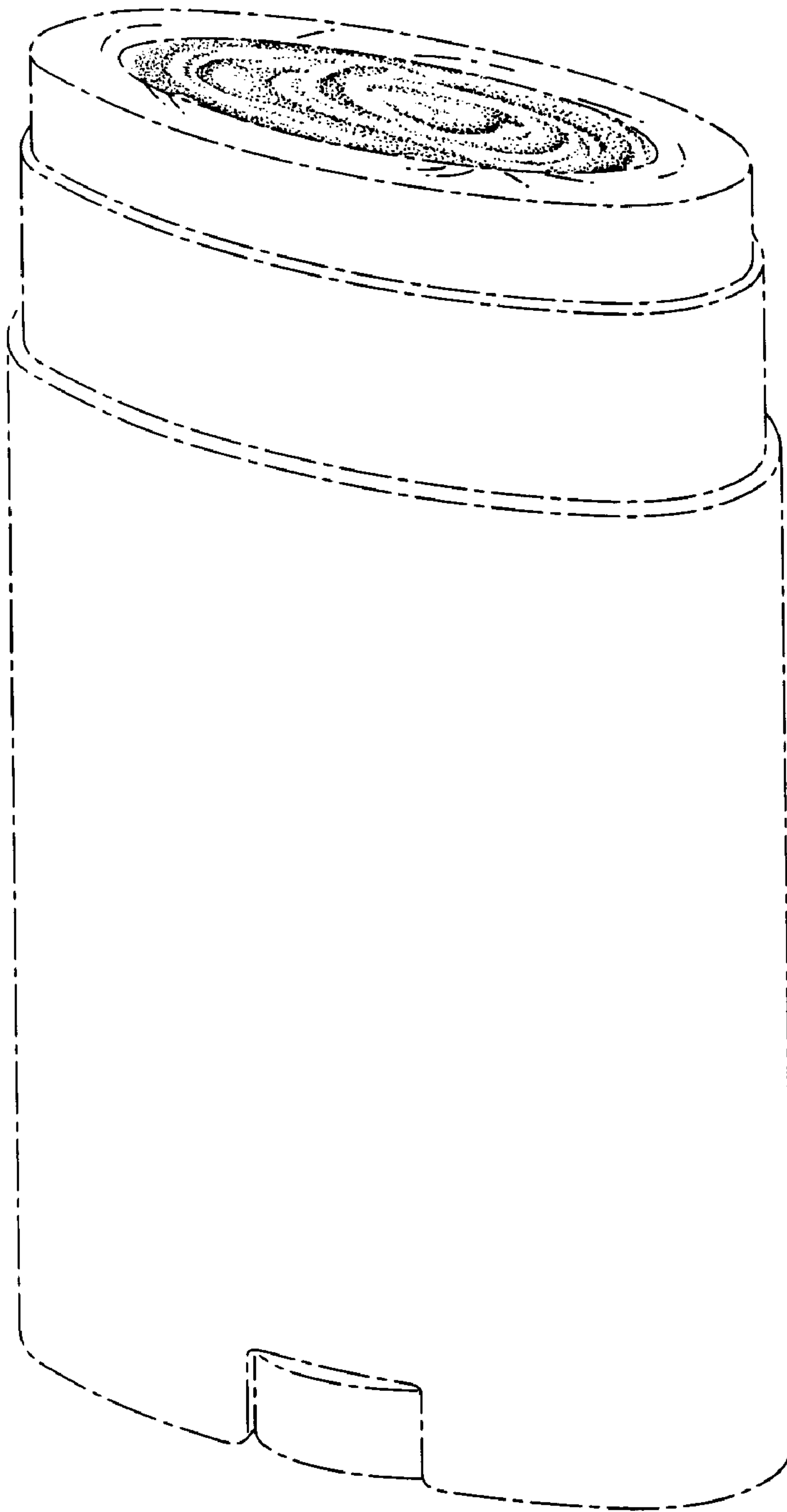
