FIG. 5 is a rear elevation view thereof;

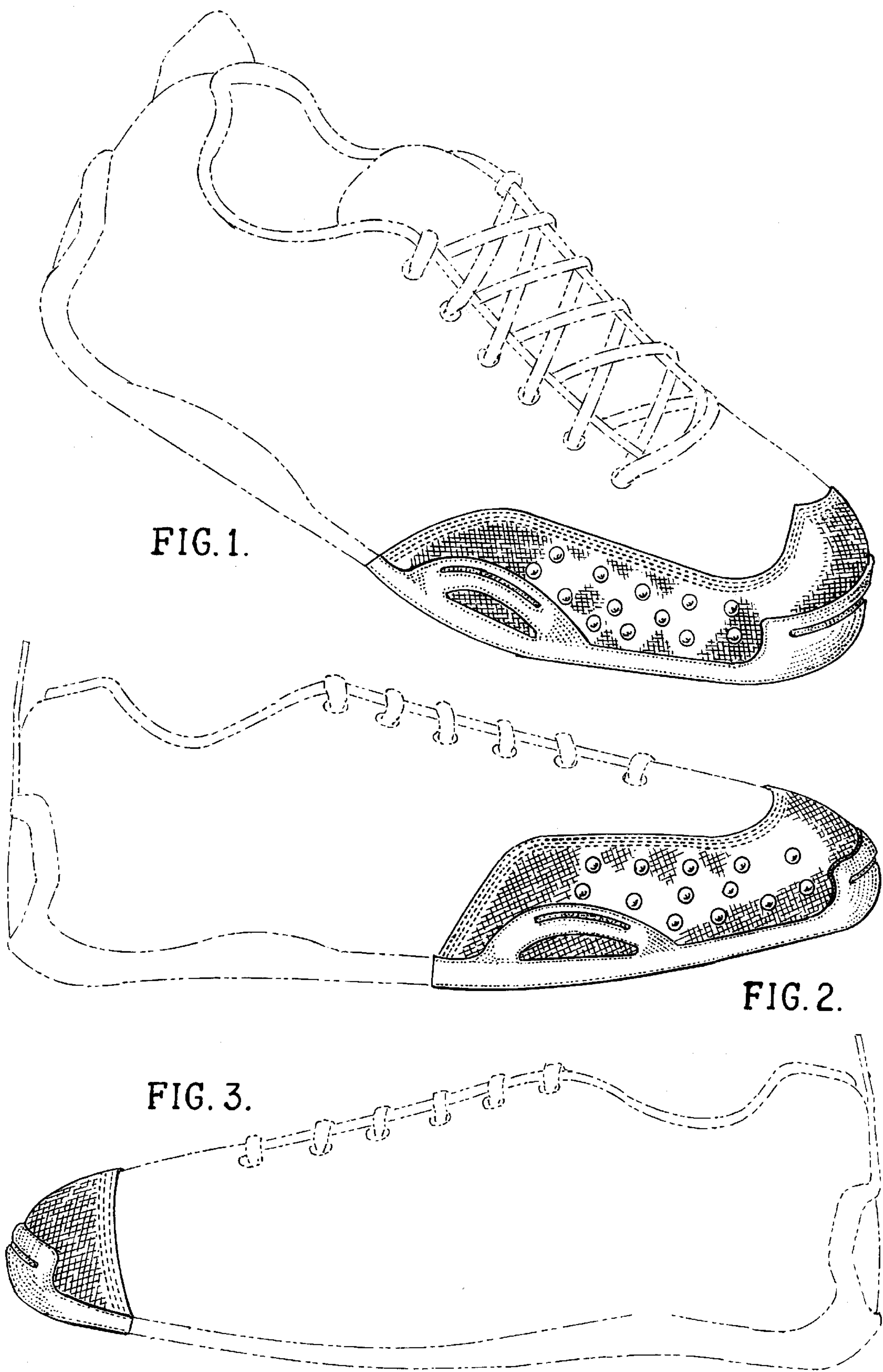
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,

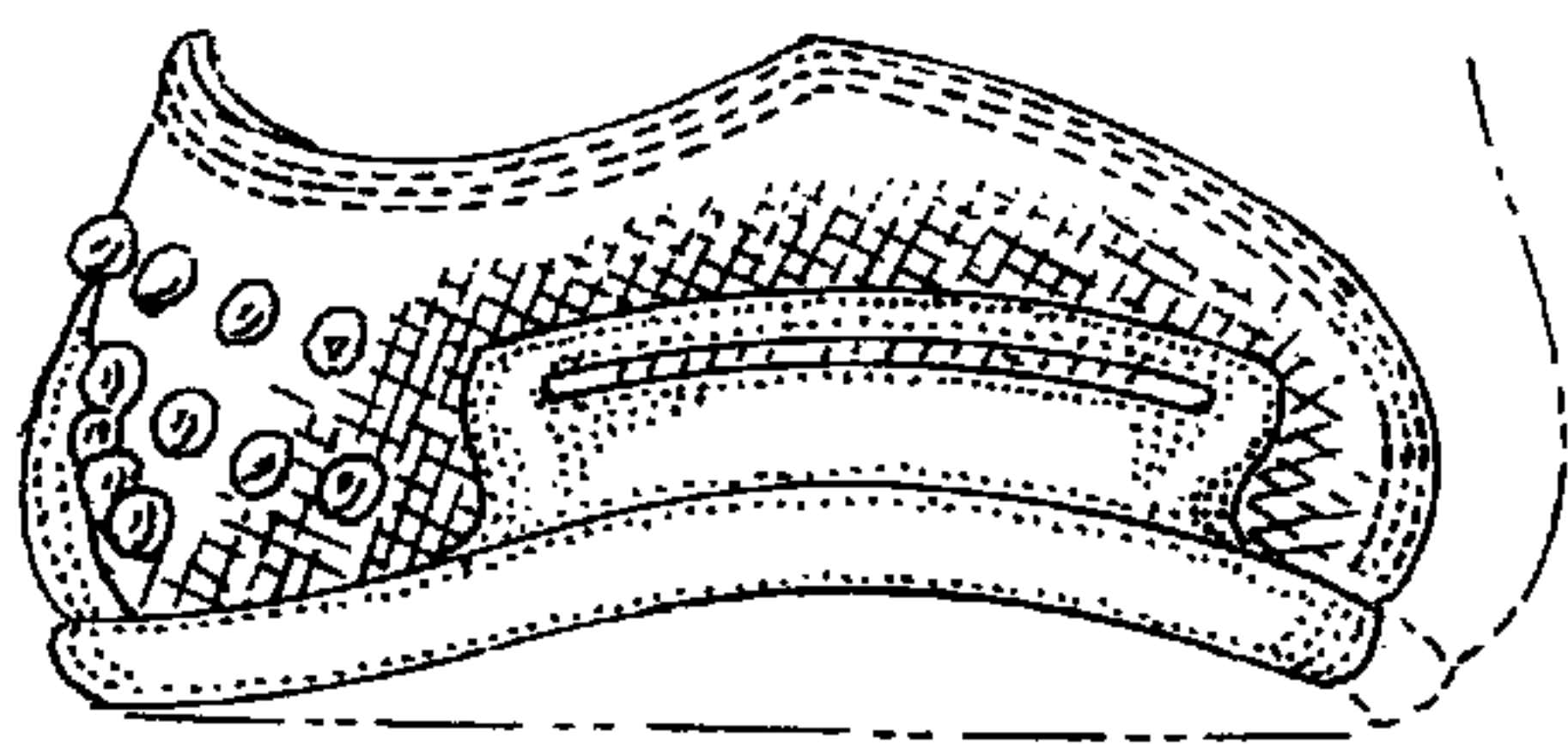

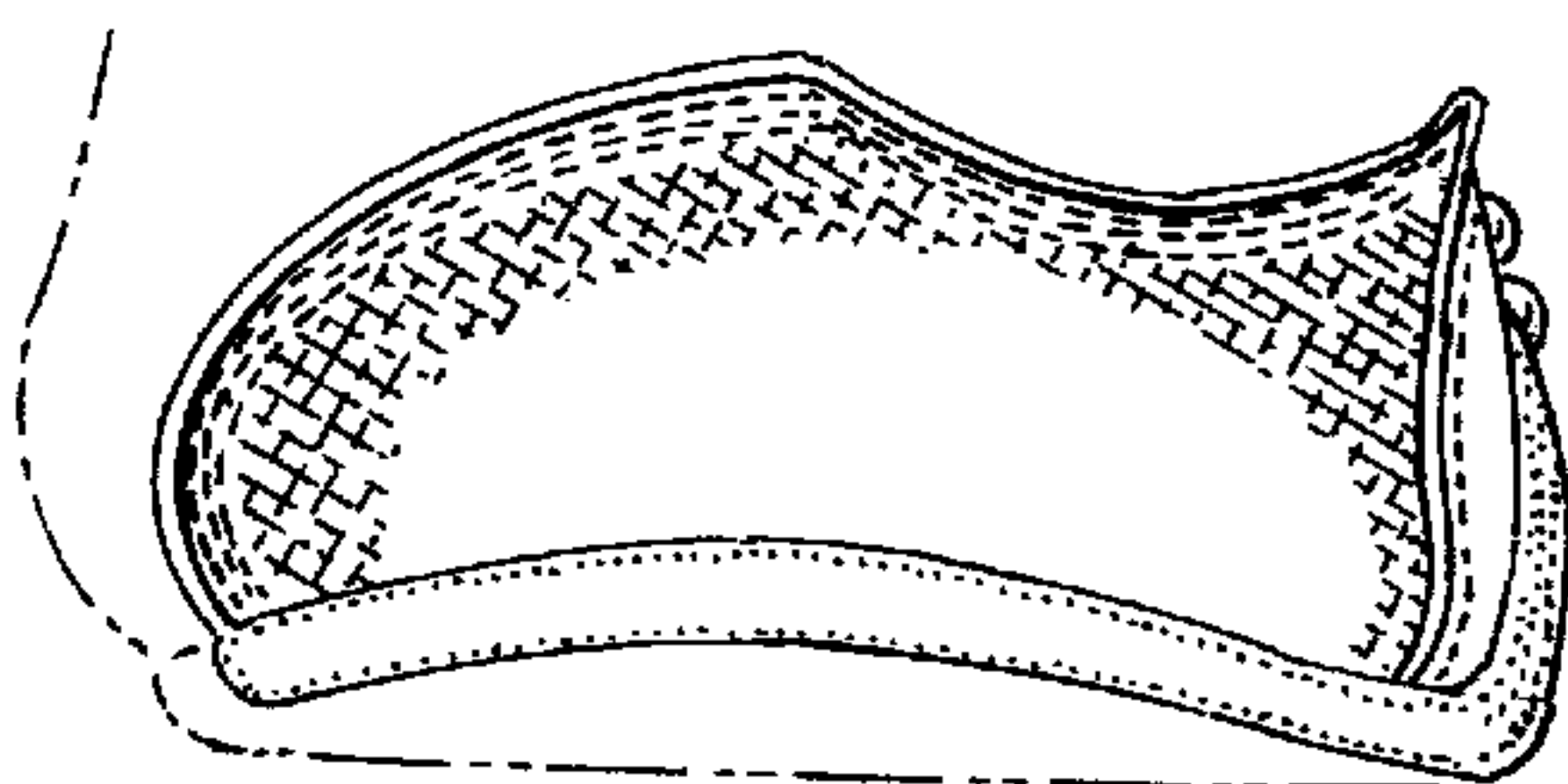

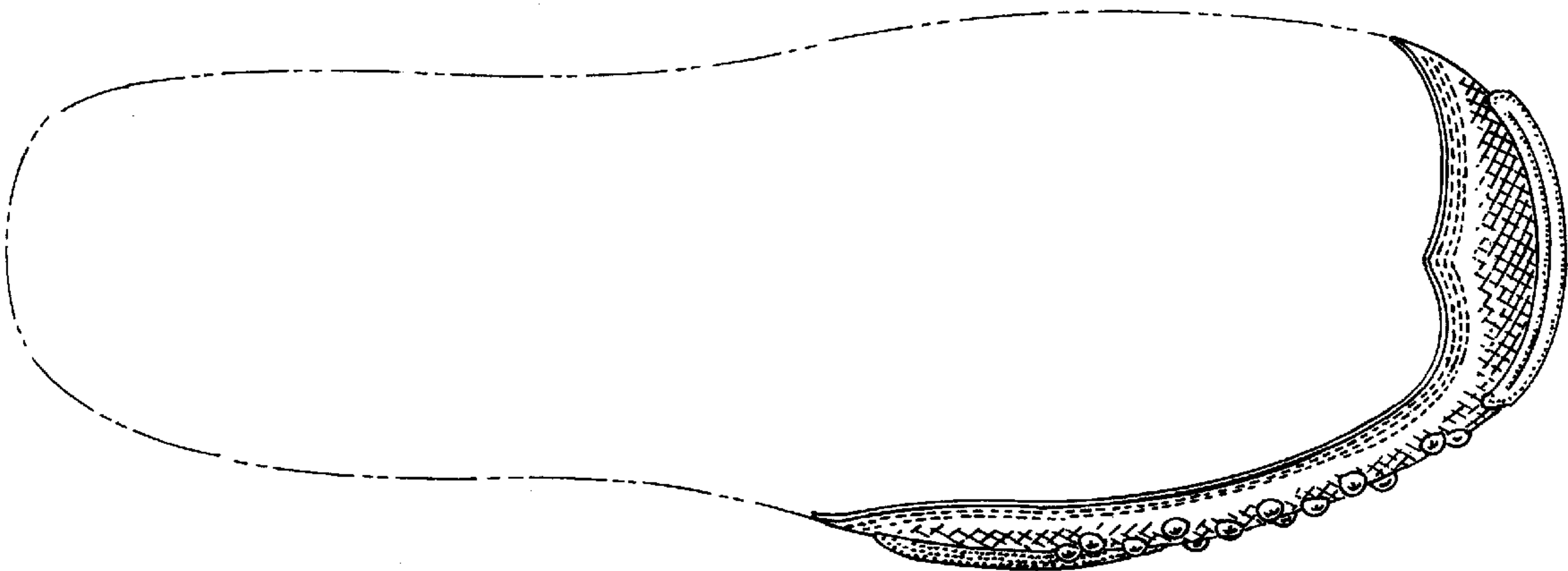

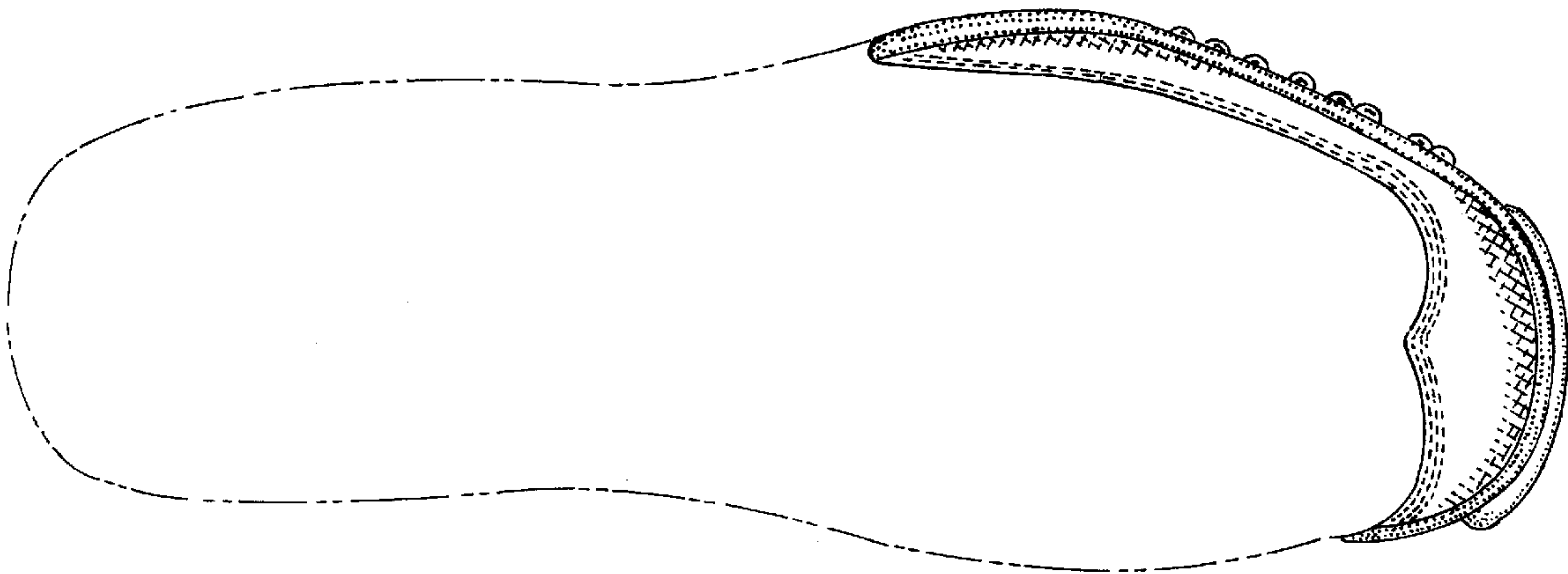
