DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side view of a shoe showing my design; FIG. 2 is a right side view of the shoe shown in FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a top view of the shoe shown in FIGS. 1–2; FIG. 4 is a rear view of the shoe shown in FIGS. 1–3; and, FIG. 5 is a front view of the shoe shown in FIGS. 1–4.
