(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bottle holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bottle holder showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the new design.

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view taken from the right side of FIG. 2.

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the new design.

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view taken from the left side of FIG. 2.

FIG. 6 is an elevational view taken from the top of FIG. 3; and,

FIG. 7 is a side elevational view similar to FIG. 3, but showing the bottle holder in an open position from which a bottle can be removed.

The broken lines showing of interior structure are for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

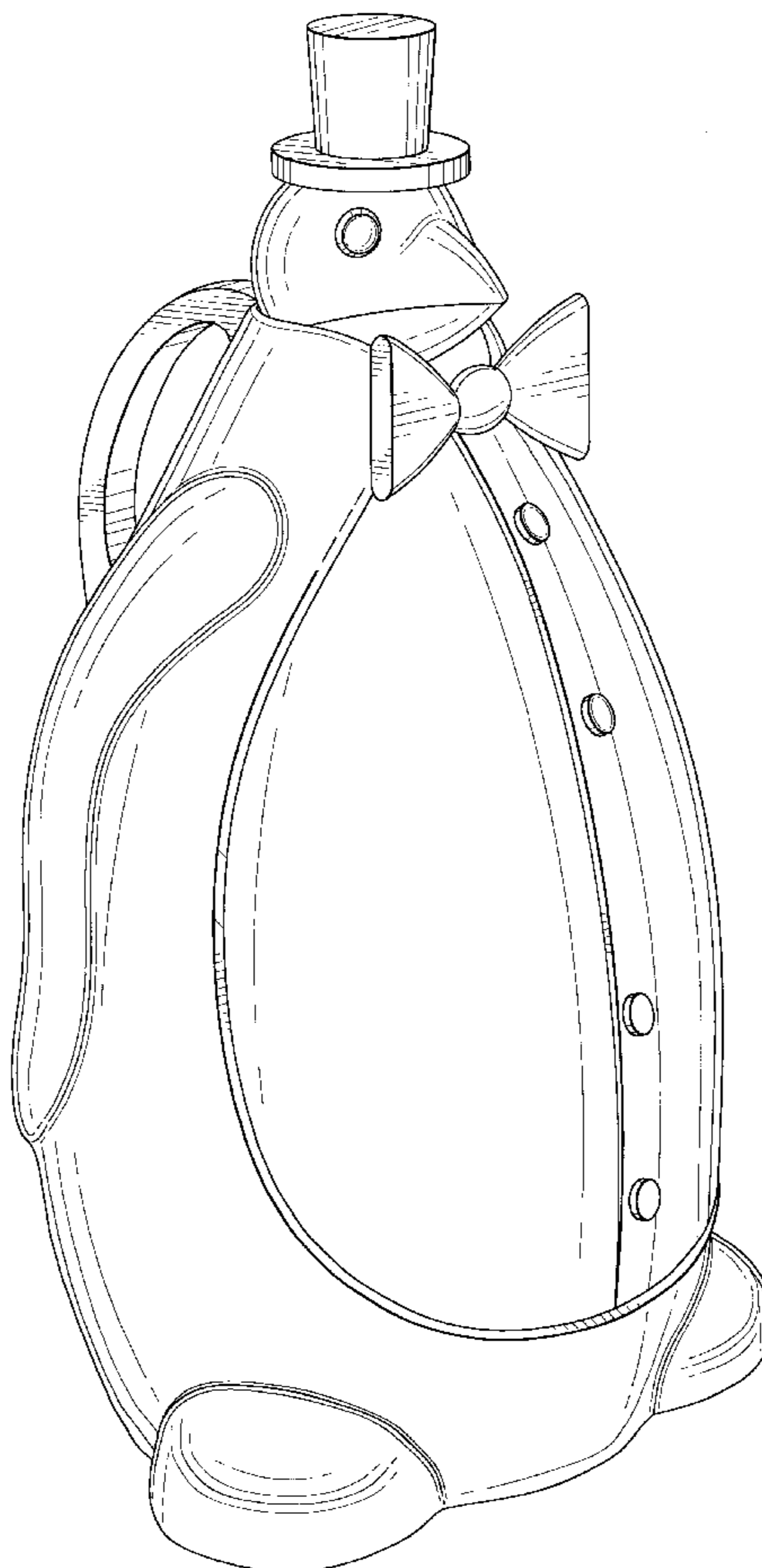

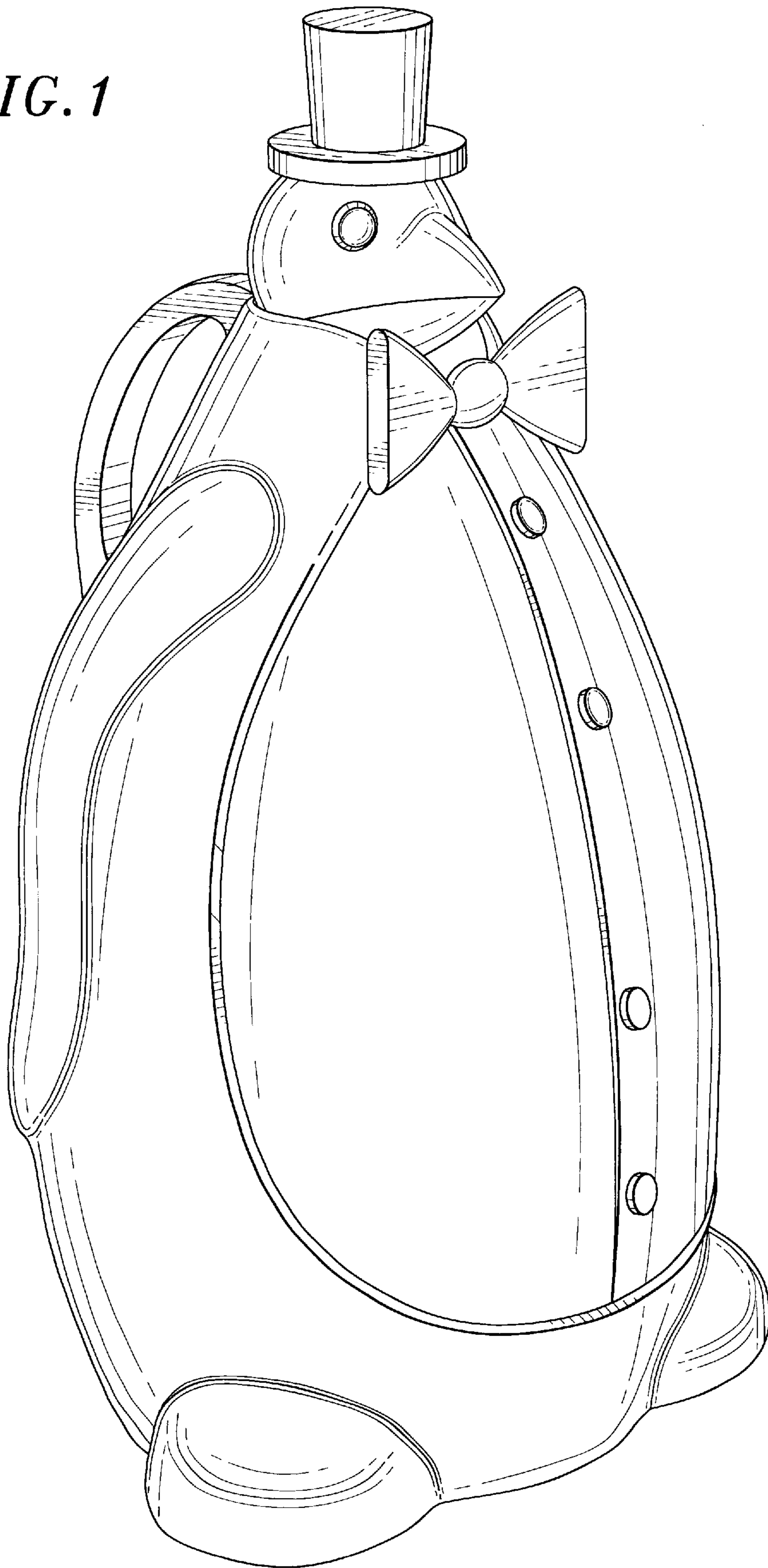

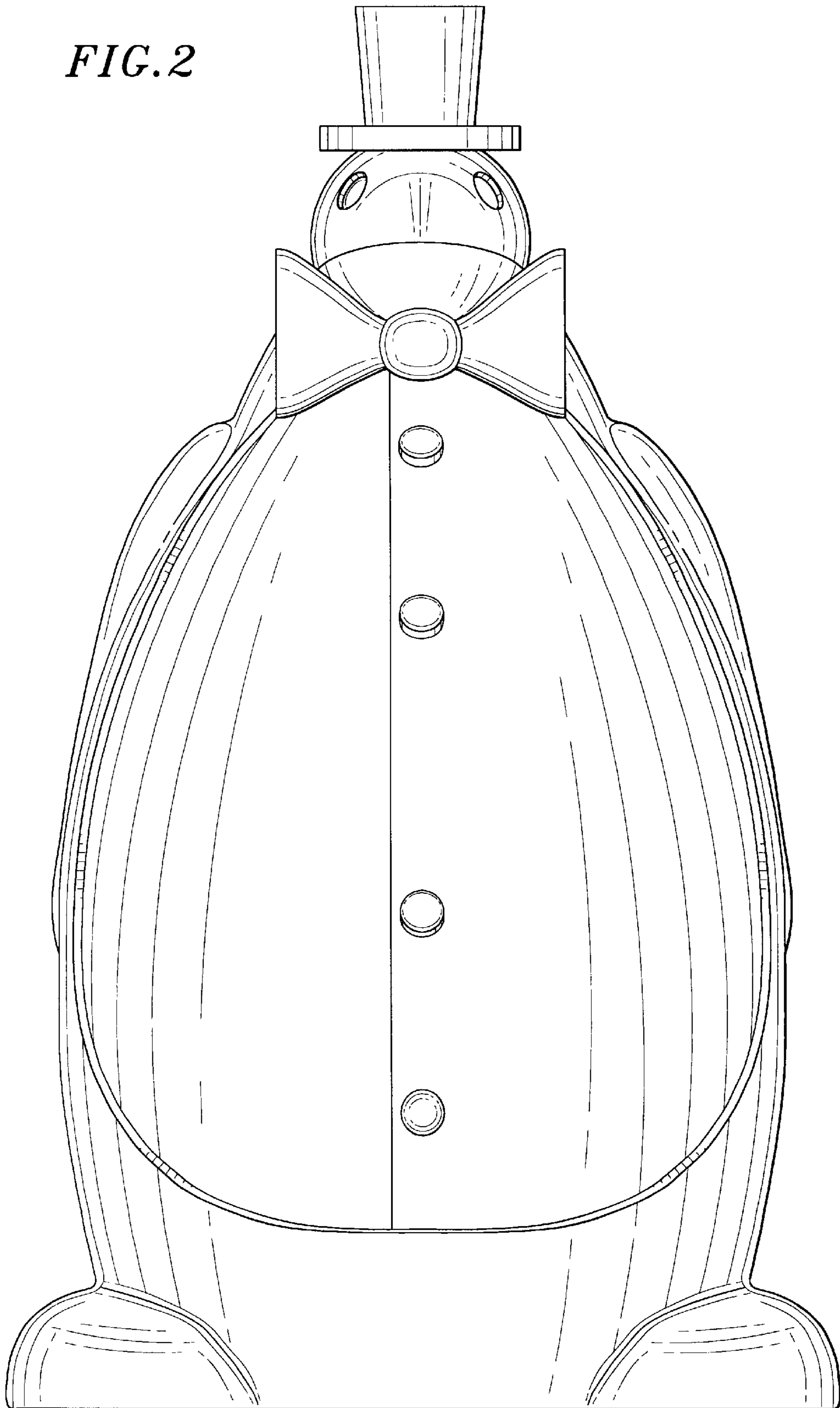

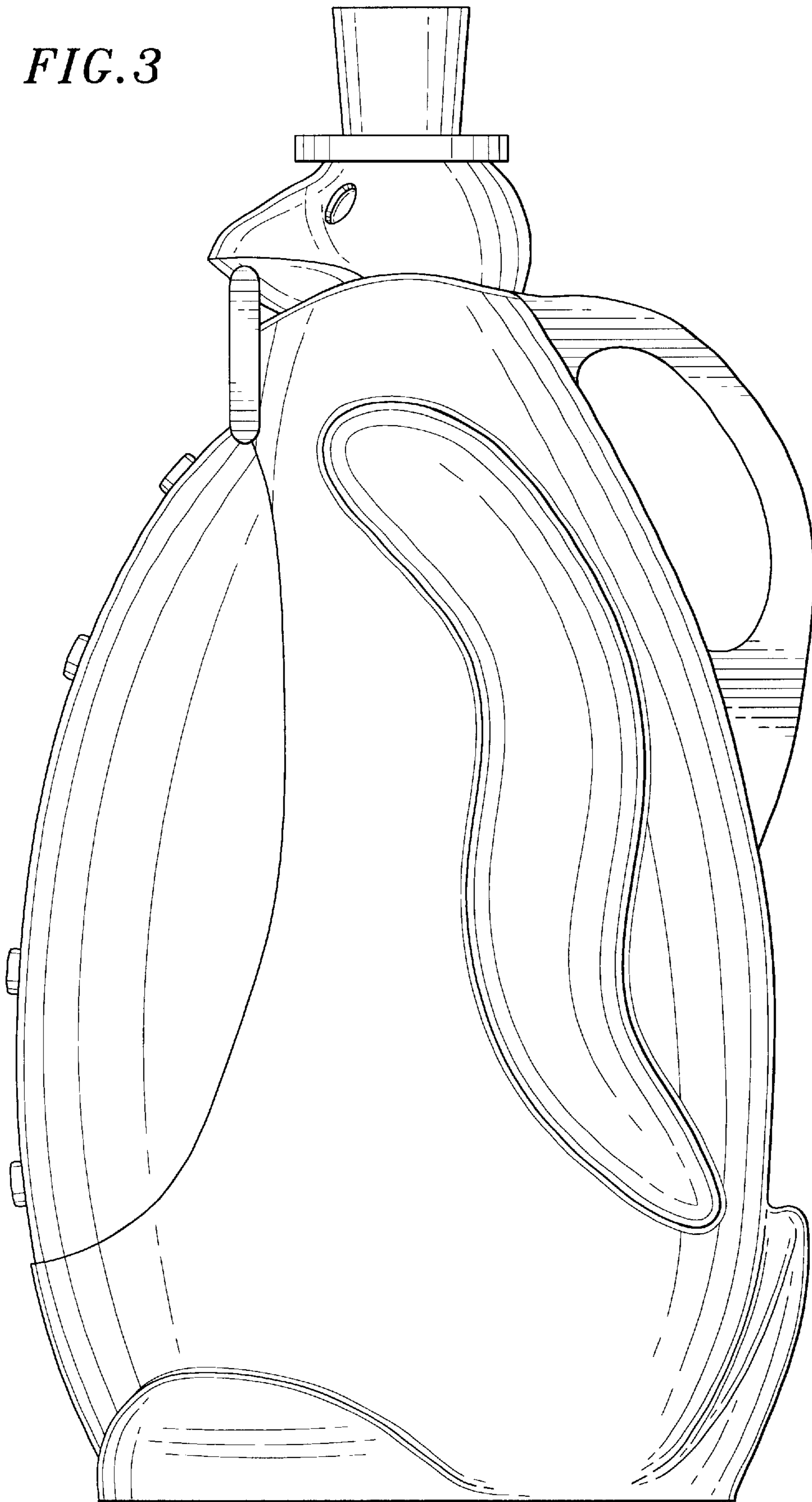

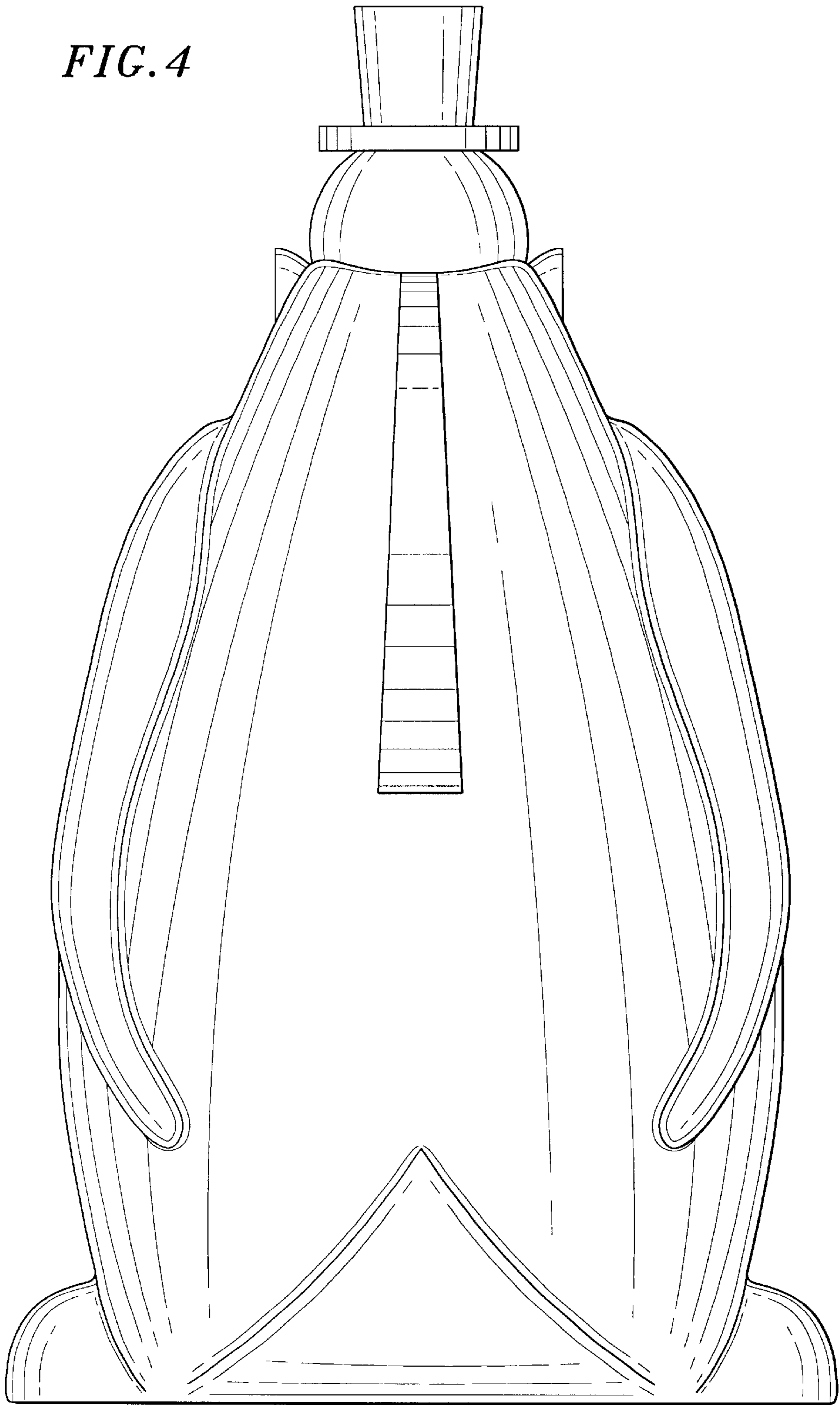

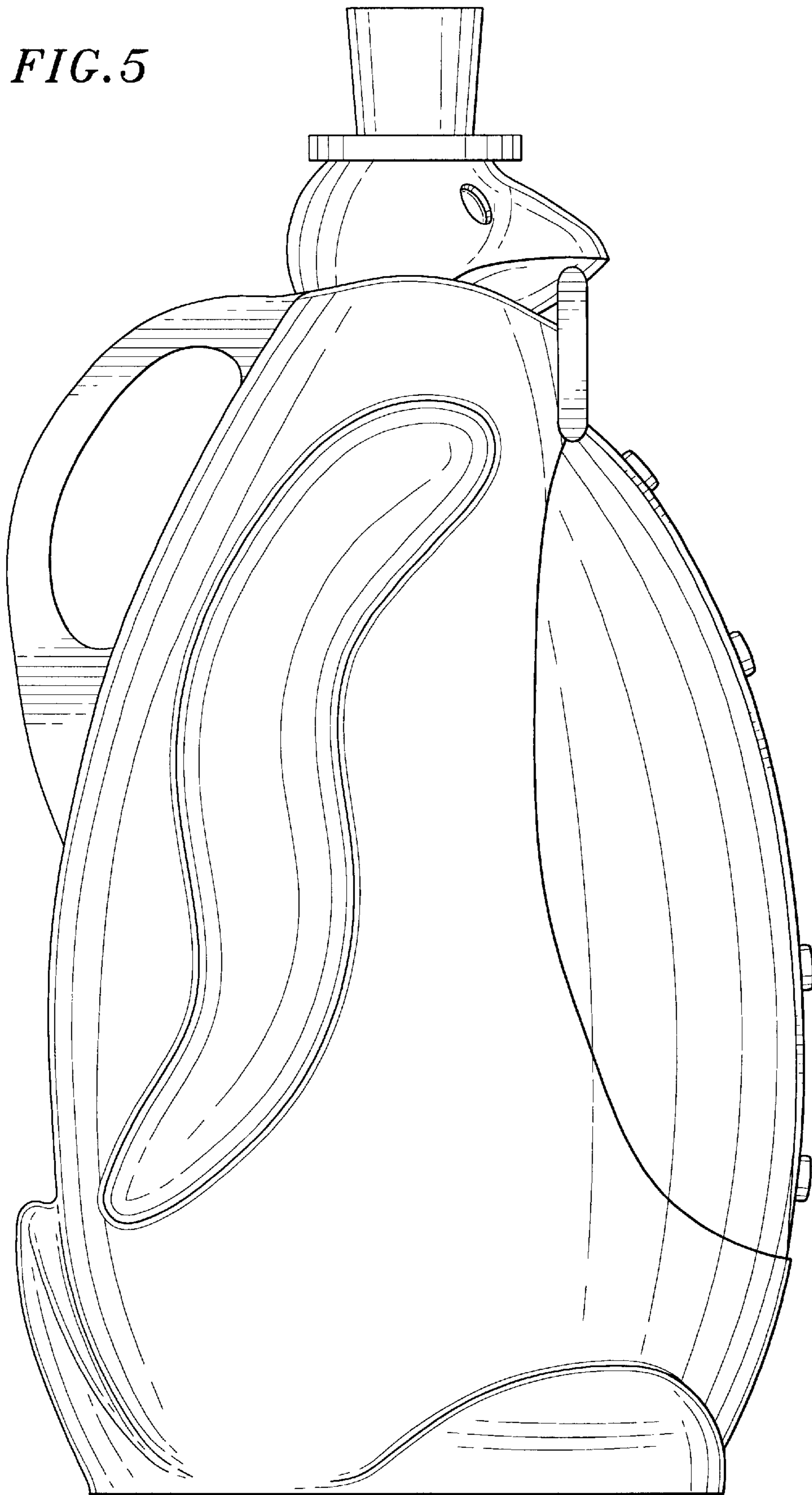

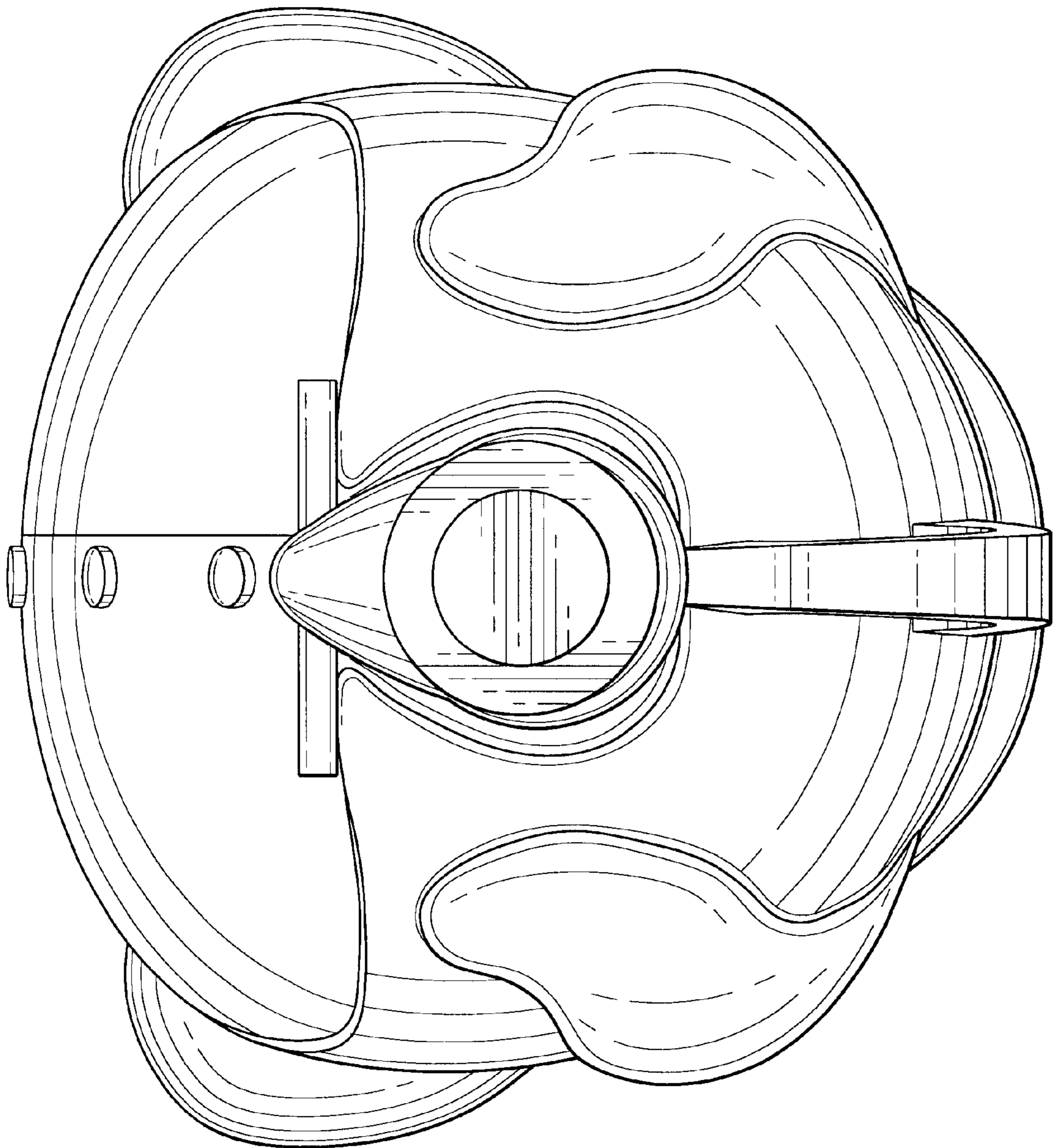
