(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a liquid splash shield for foraminal brewing structure, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a liquid splash shield for foraminal brewing structure positioned on a broken line representation of a brewing structure as an example of the environment in which the shield is used;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof, a right side elevational view being a mirror image thereof.

The broken line representation of an element shown in FIGS. 1, 2, 4–6 are provided for illustrative purposes only and form no portion of the claimed design.

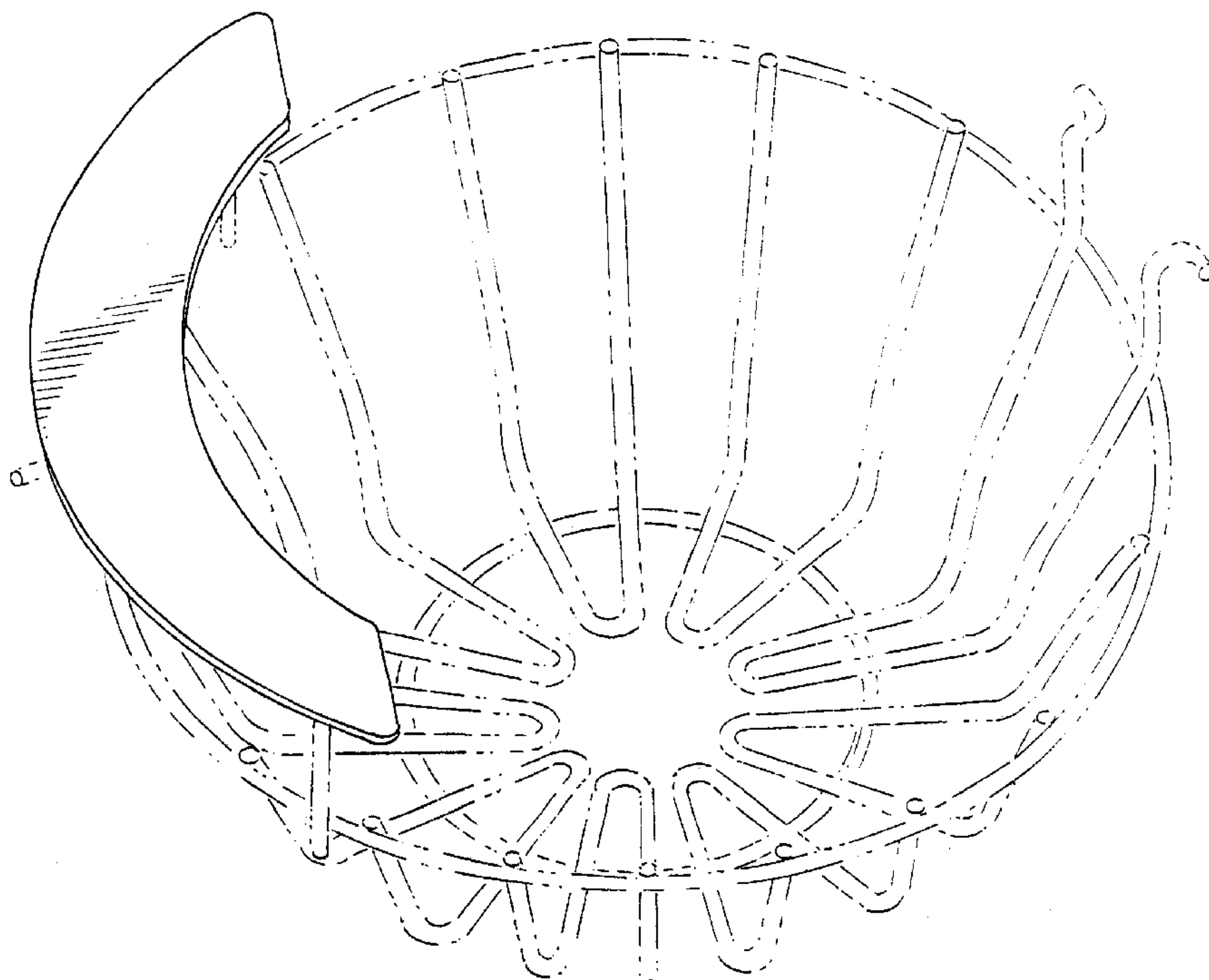

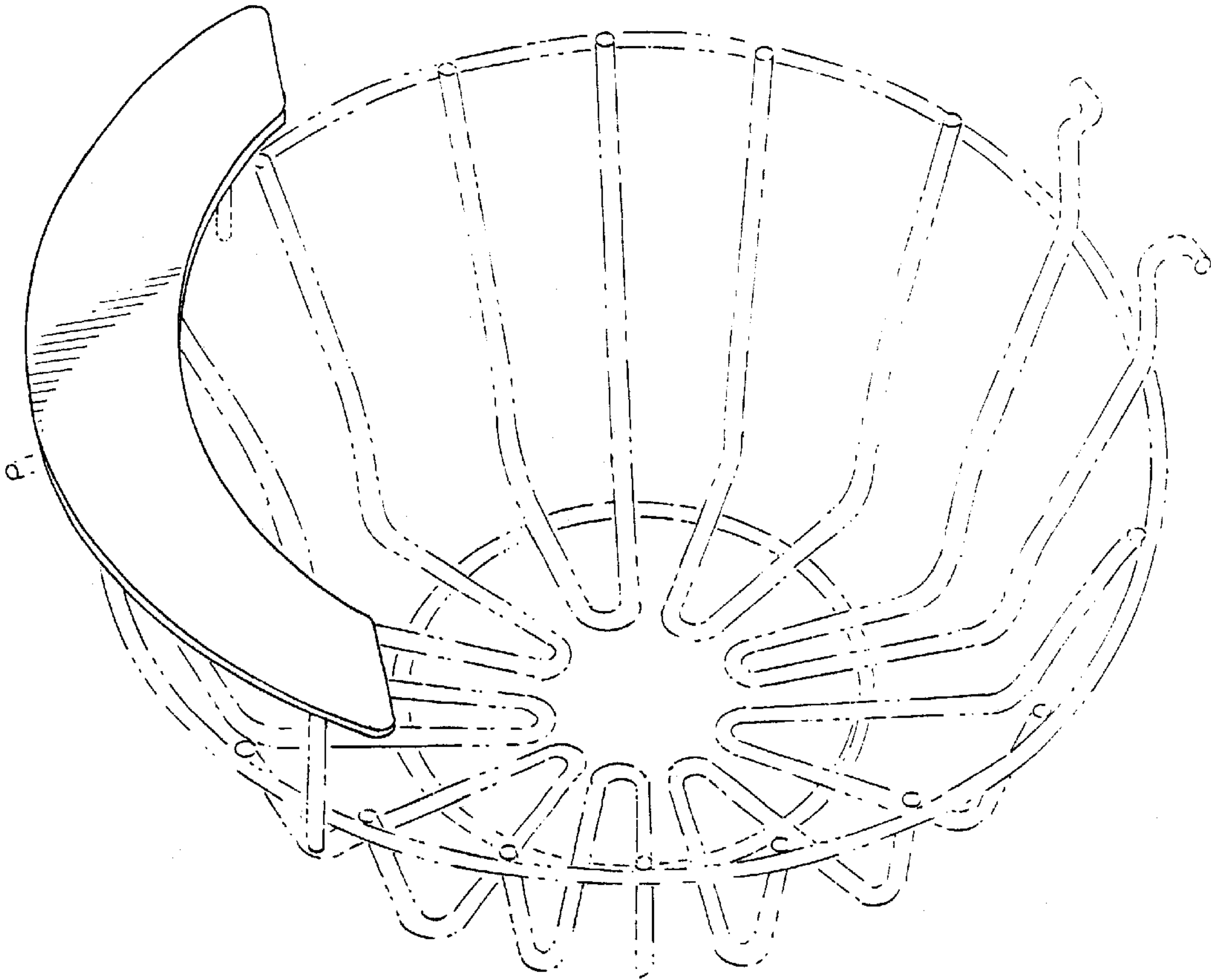

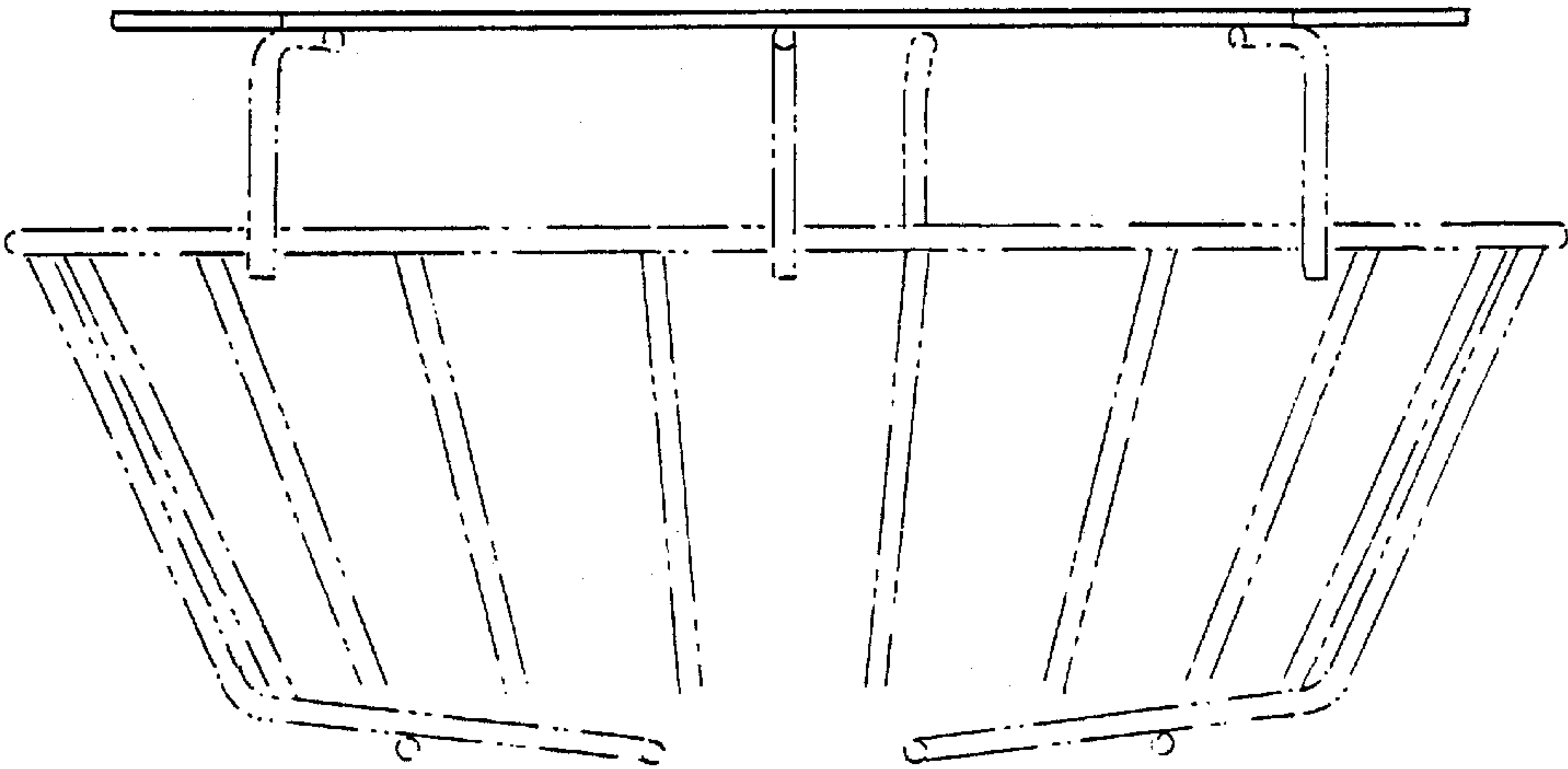

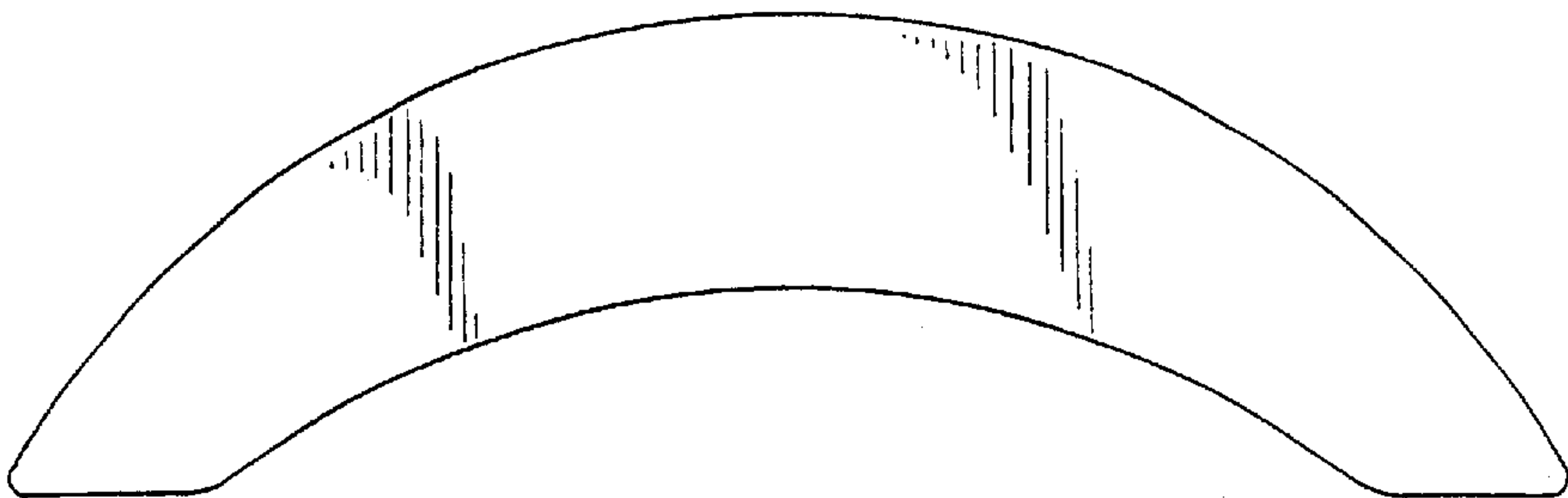

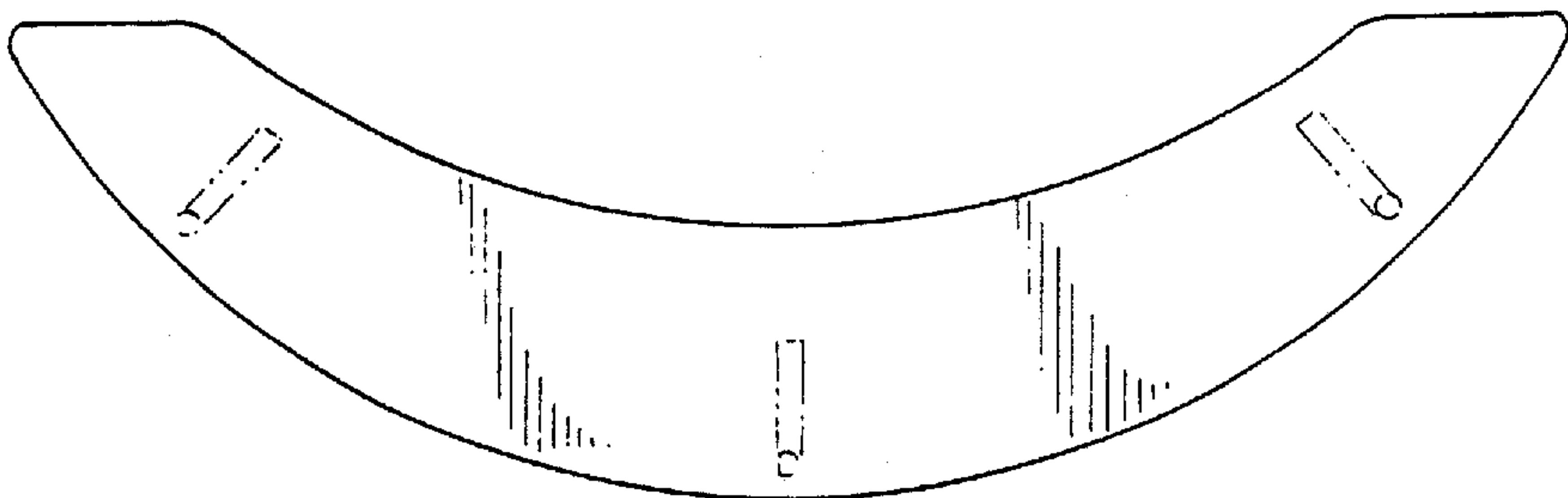

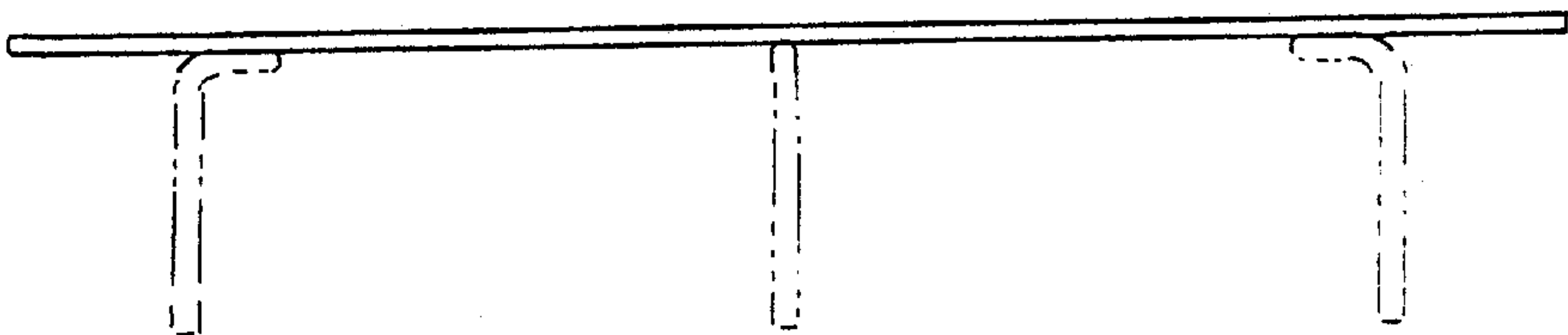
