FIG. 10 is a rear side elevation view thereof;

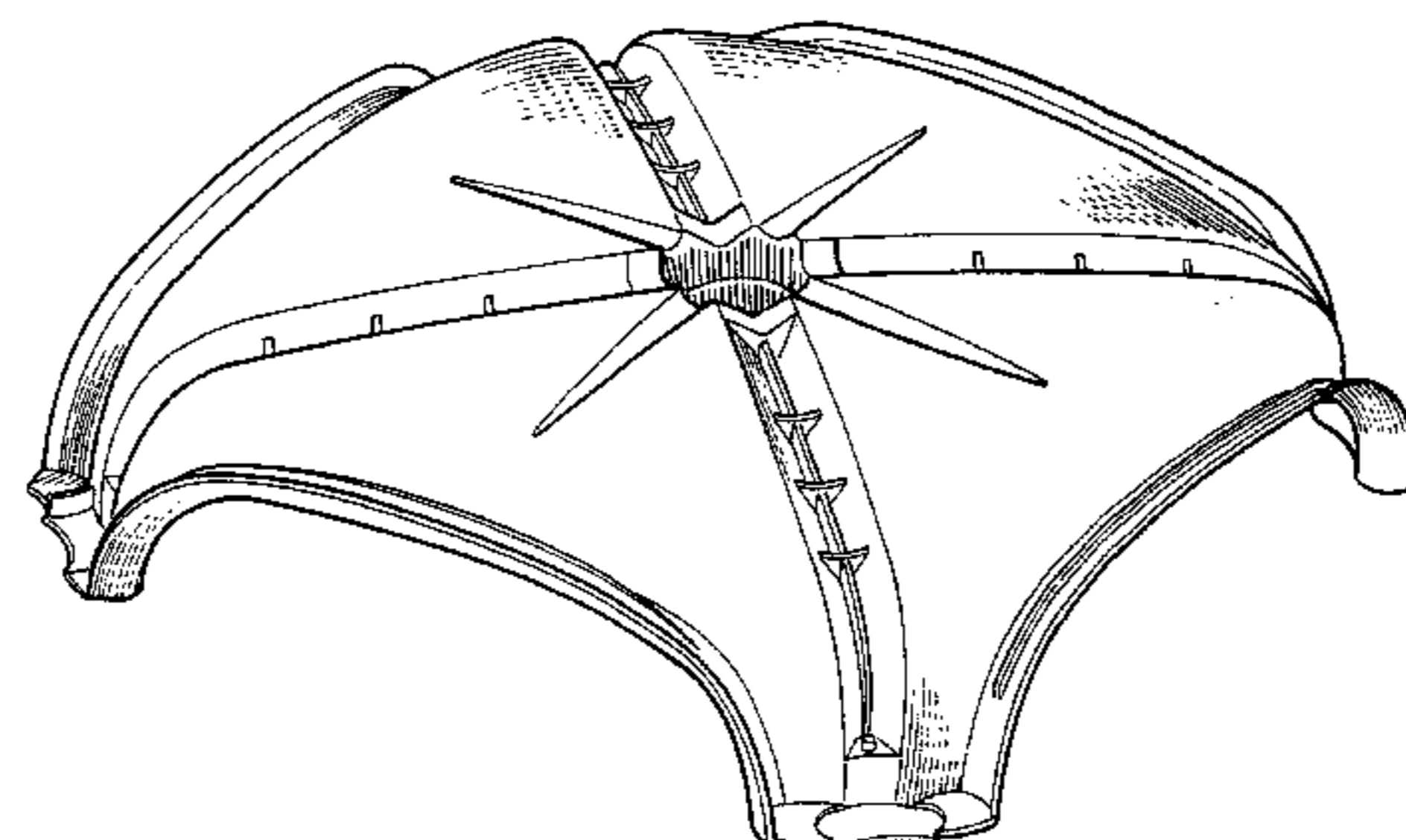
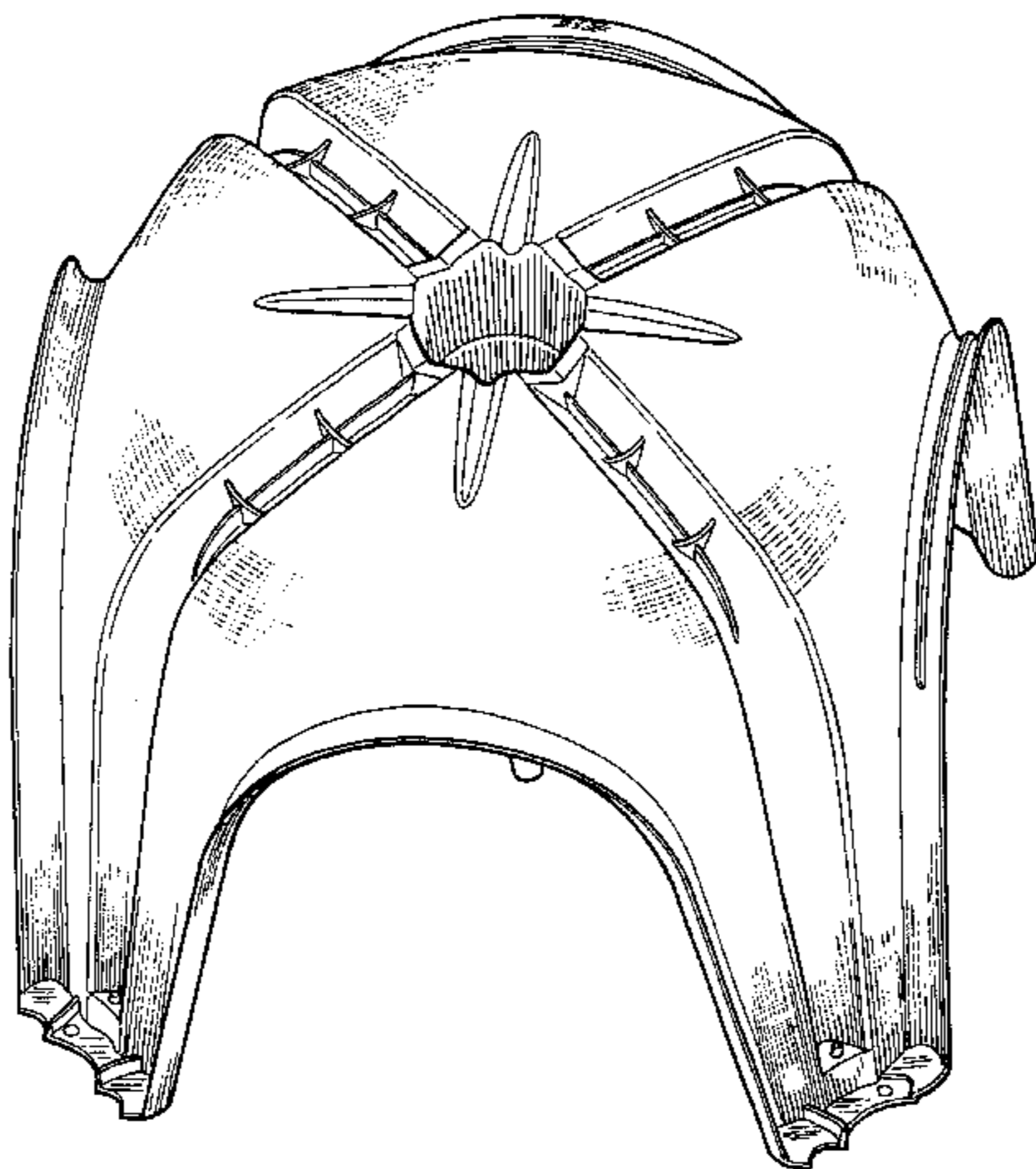
FIG. 11 is a right side elevation view thereof;

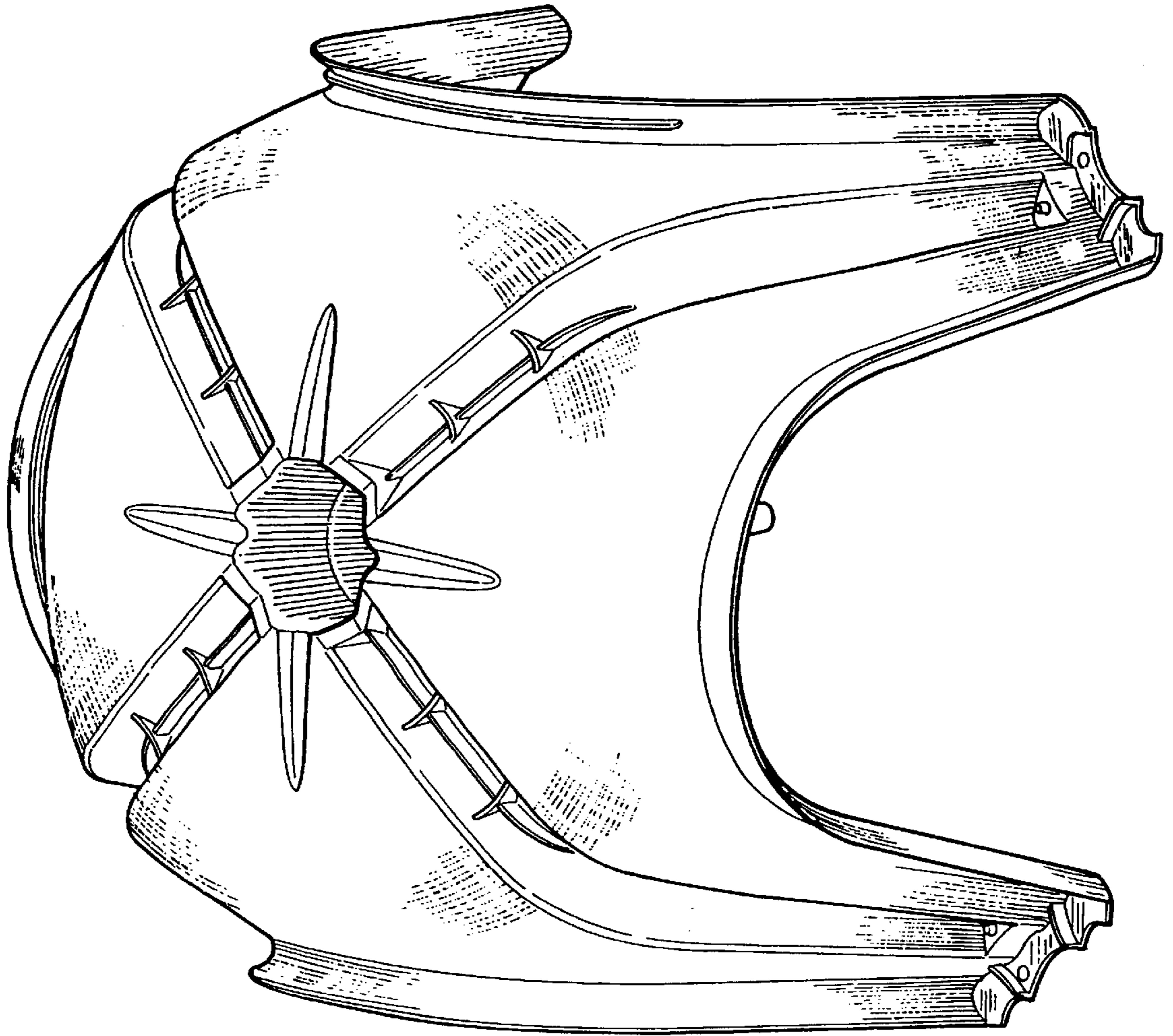

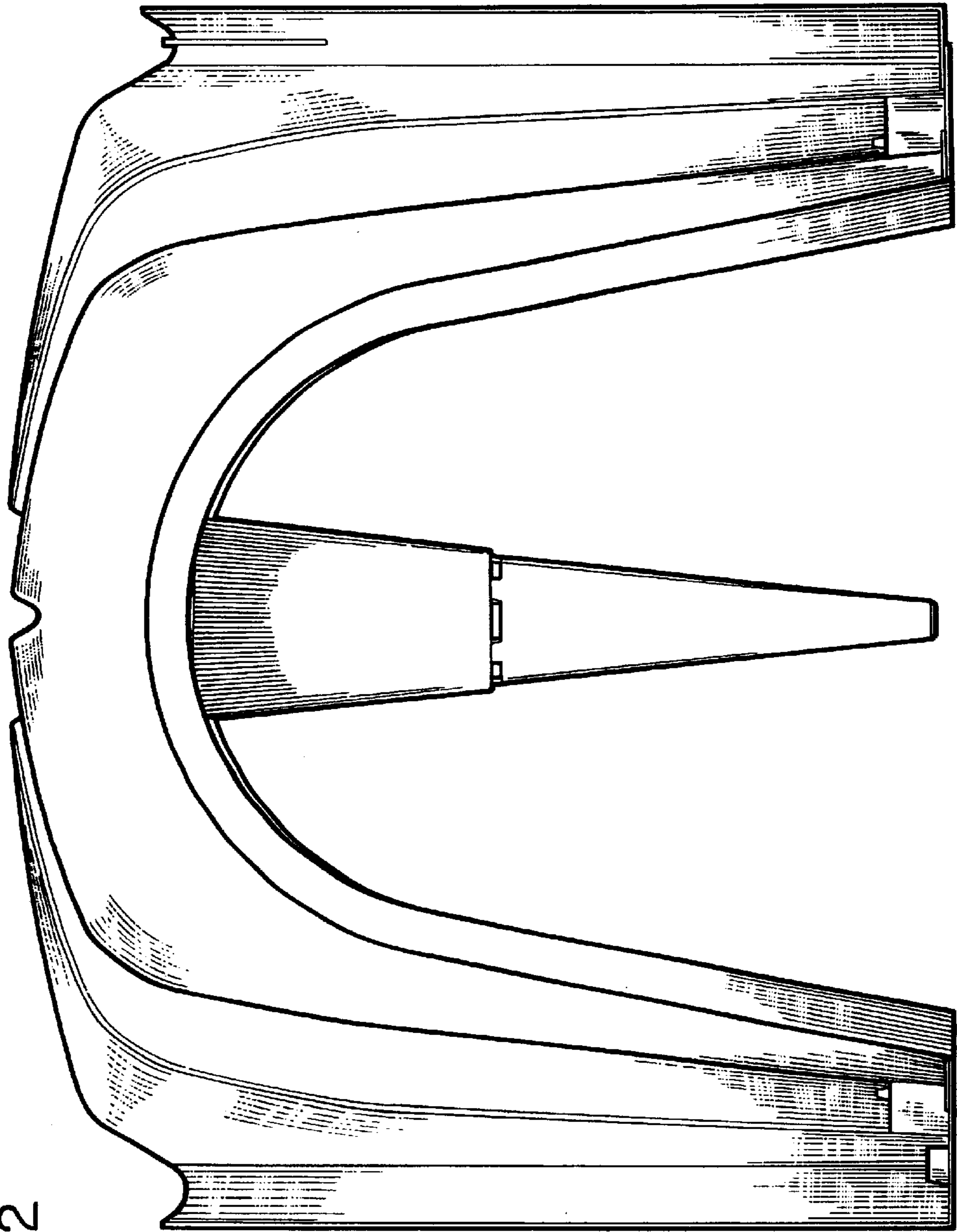

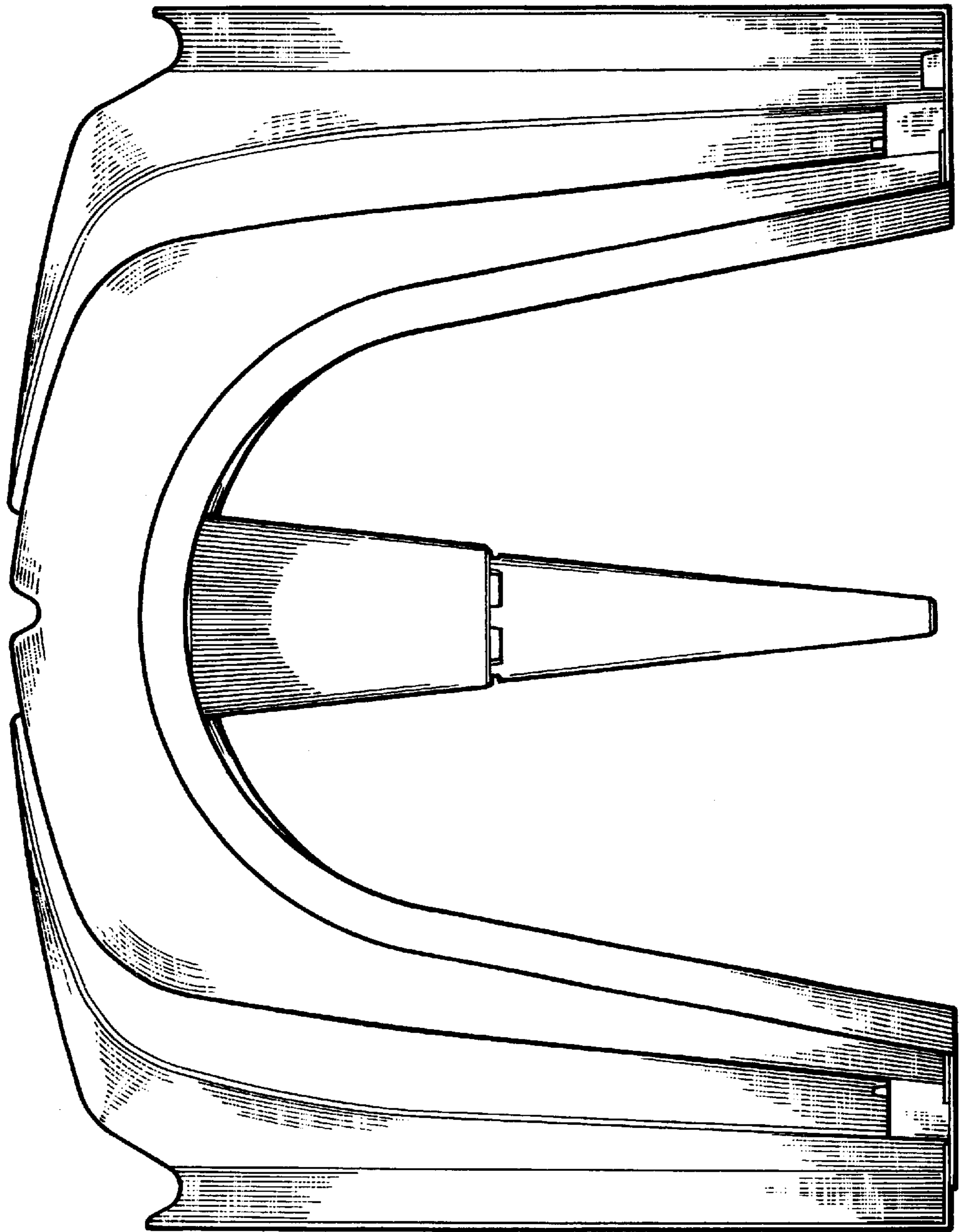

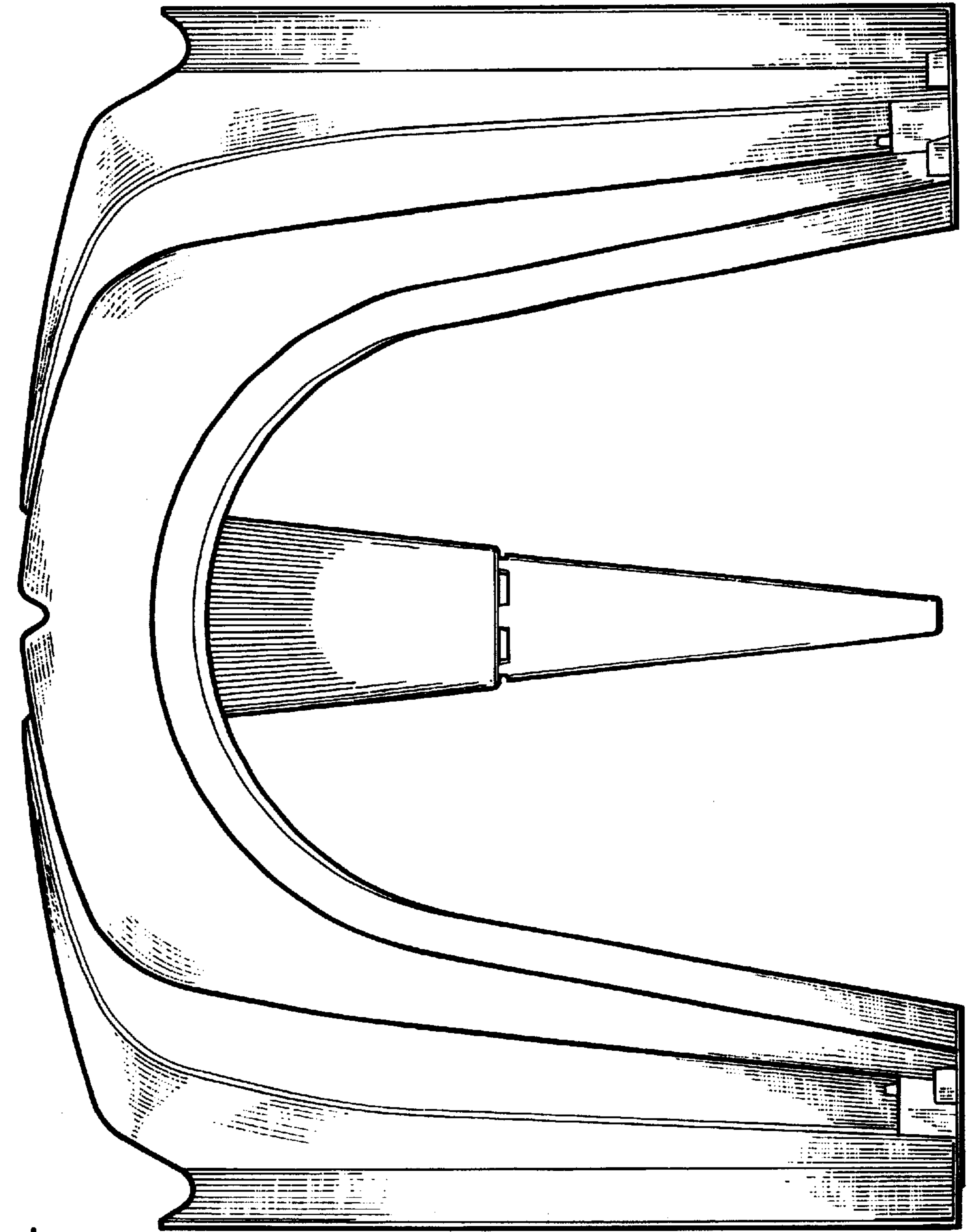

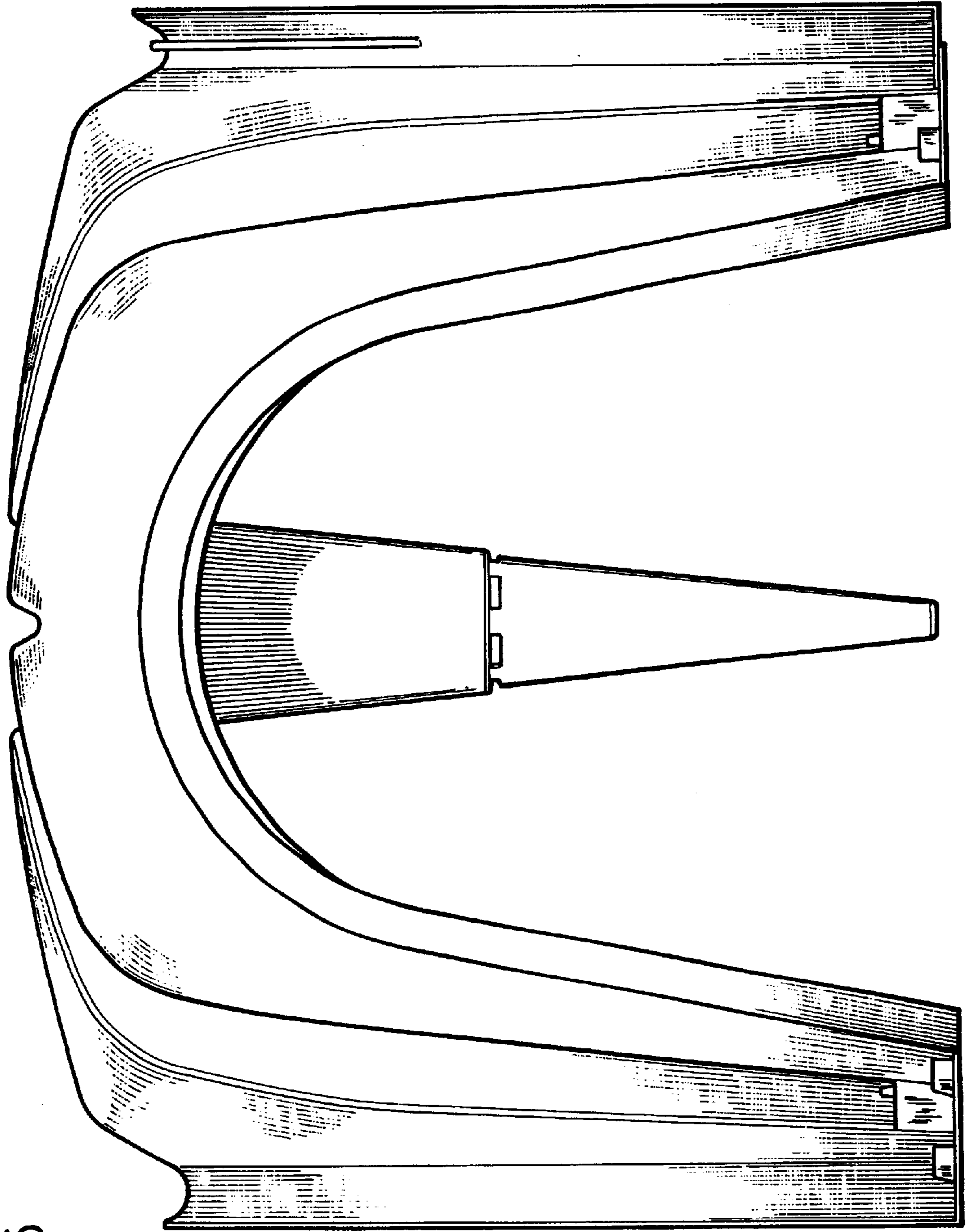

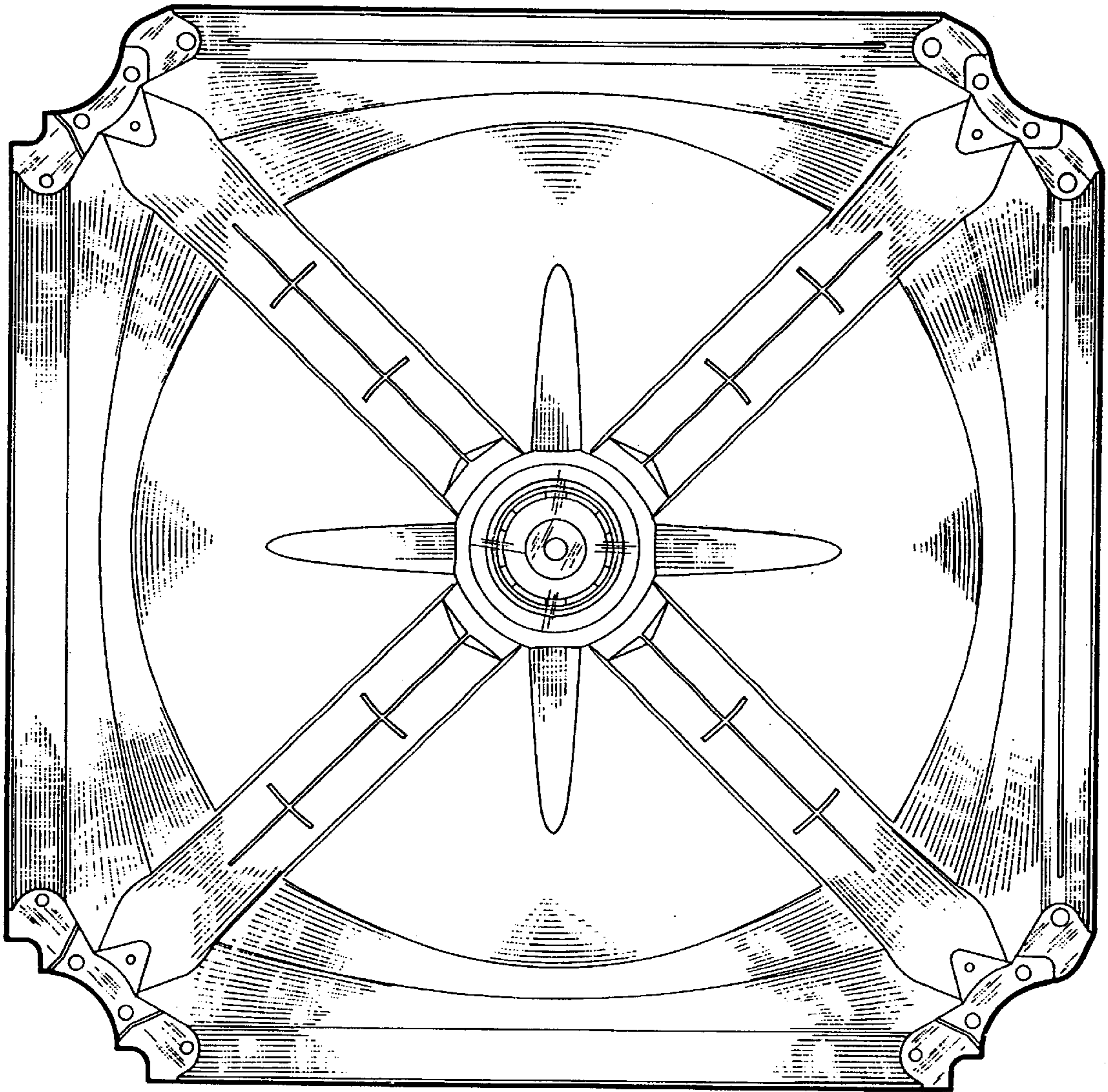
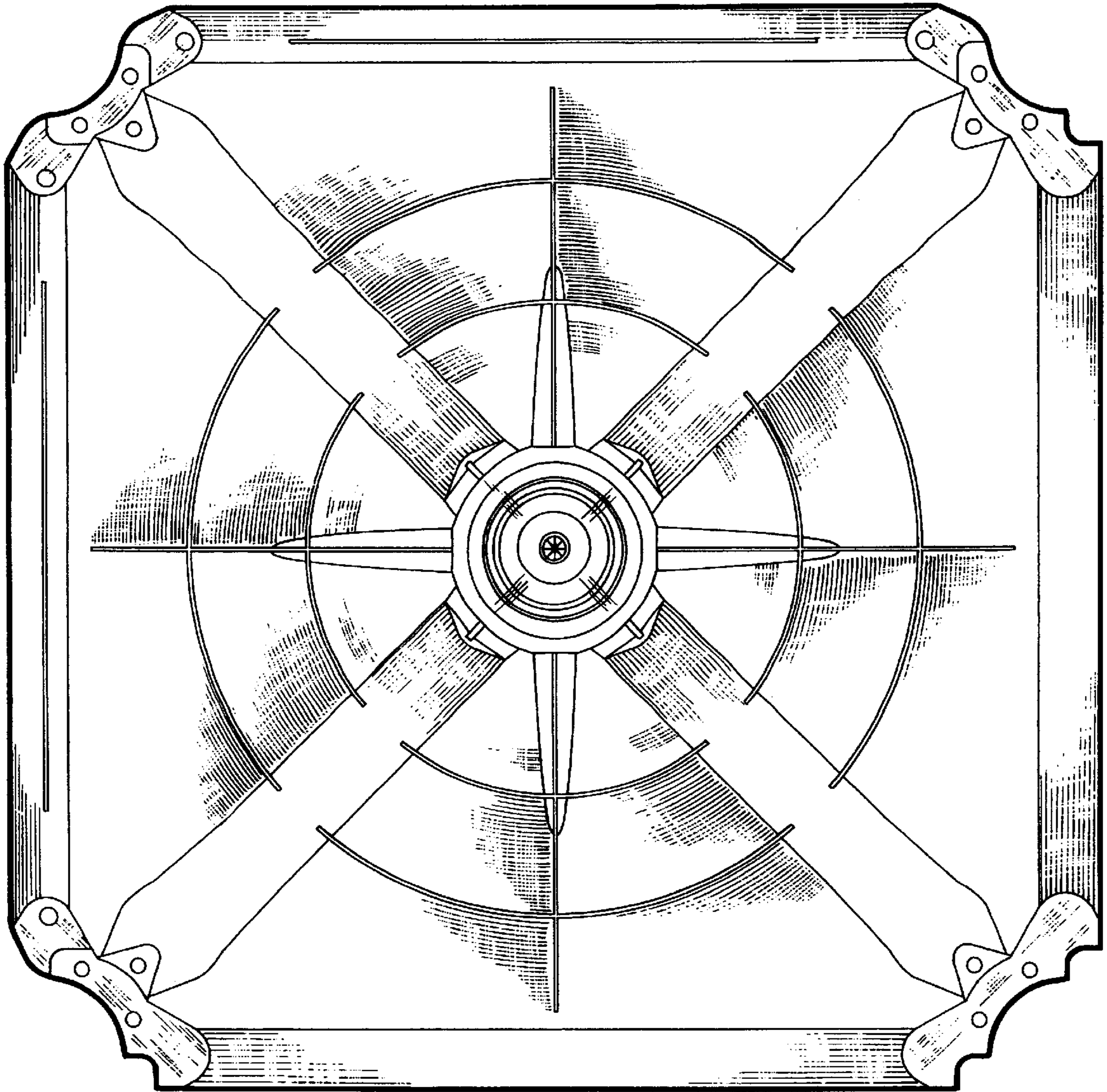

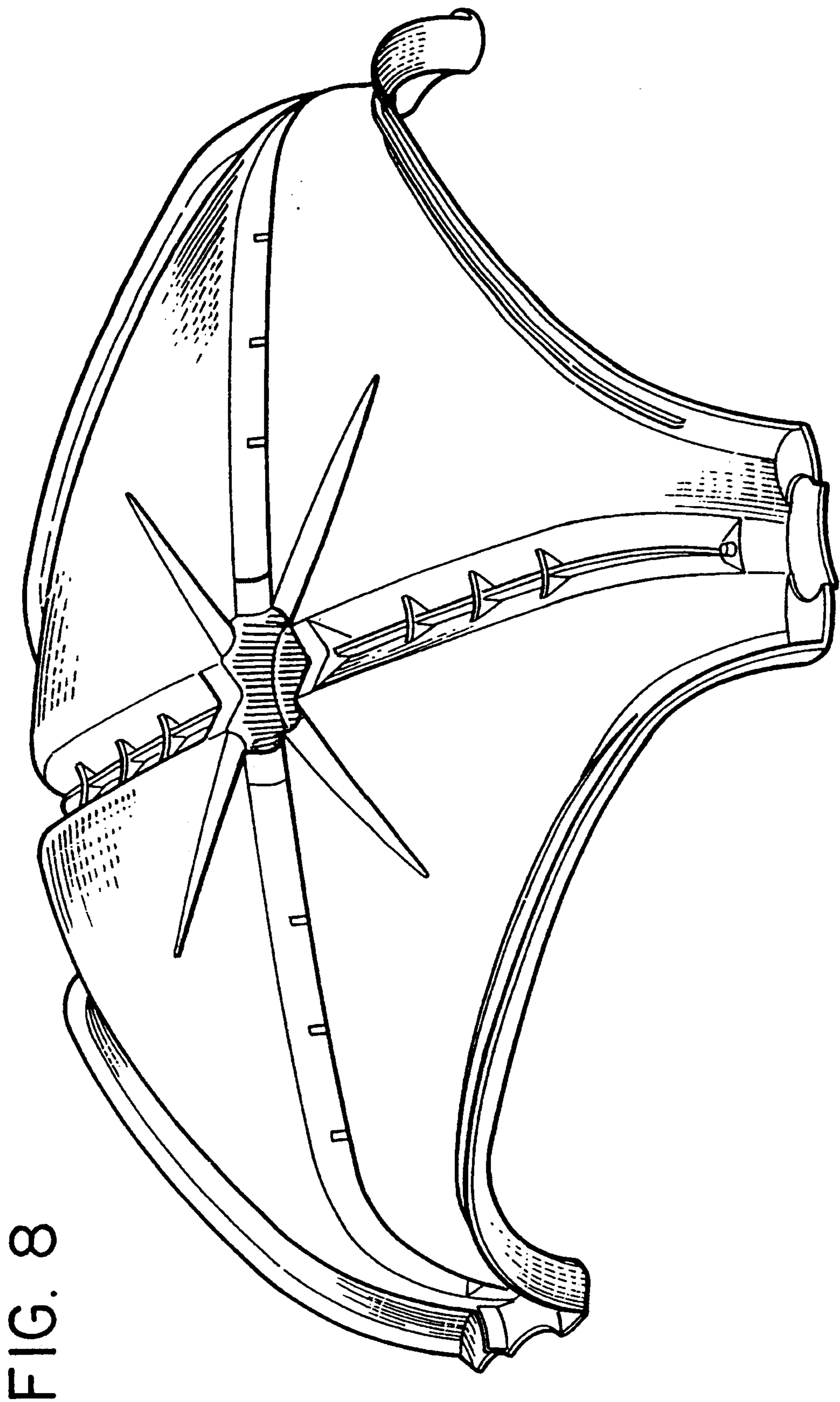

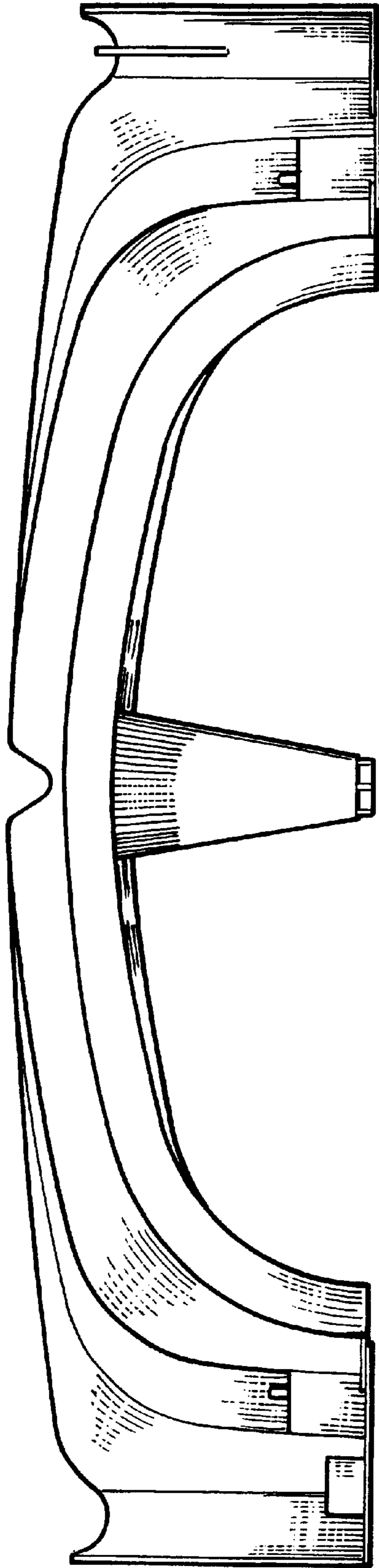

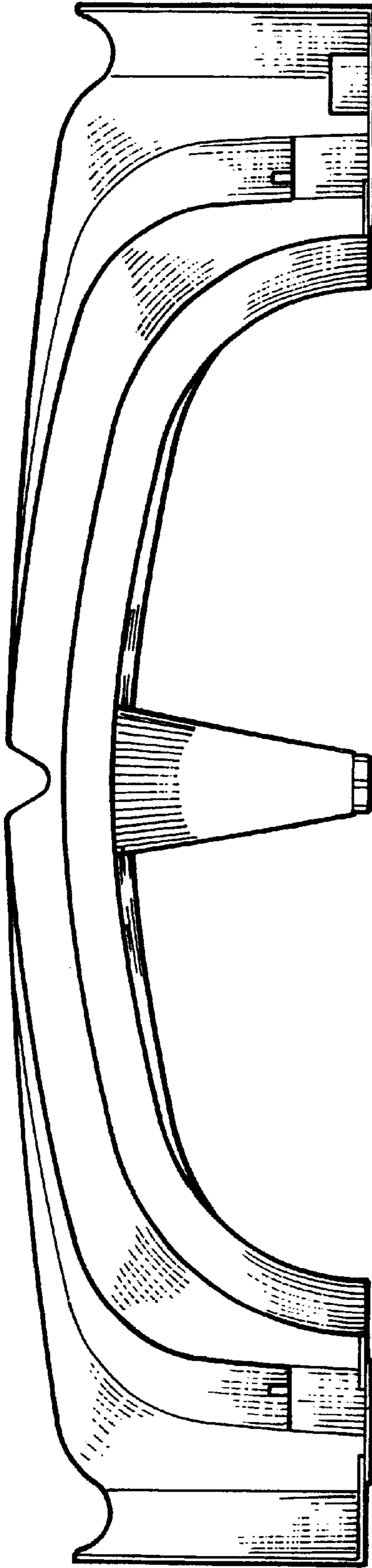

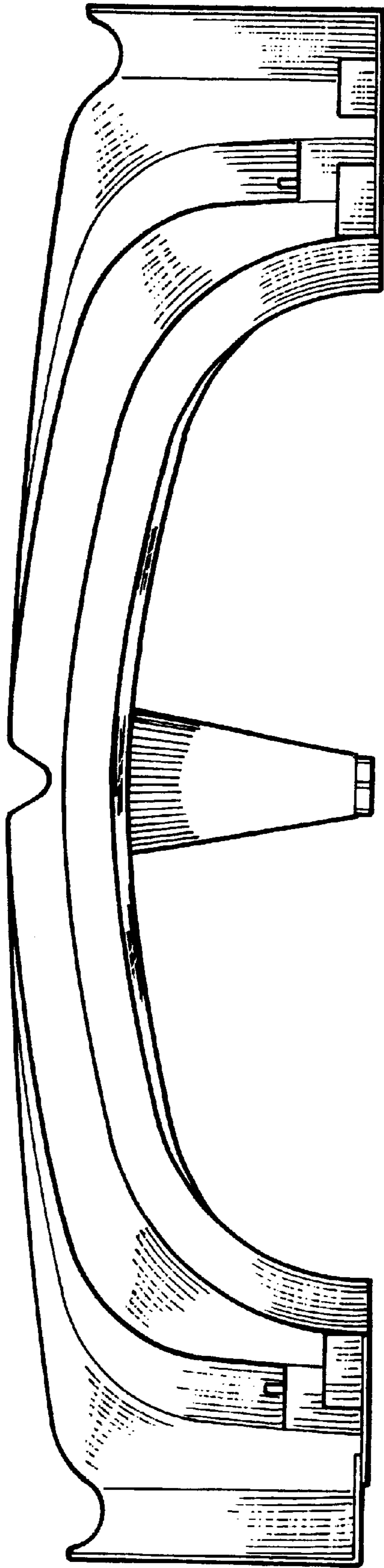

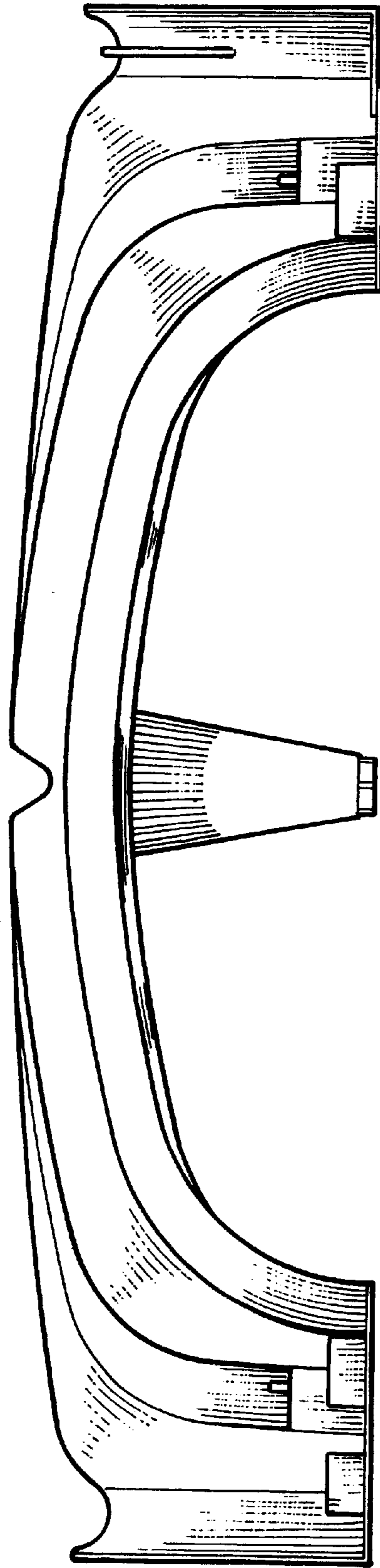

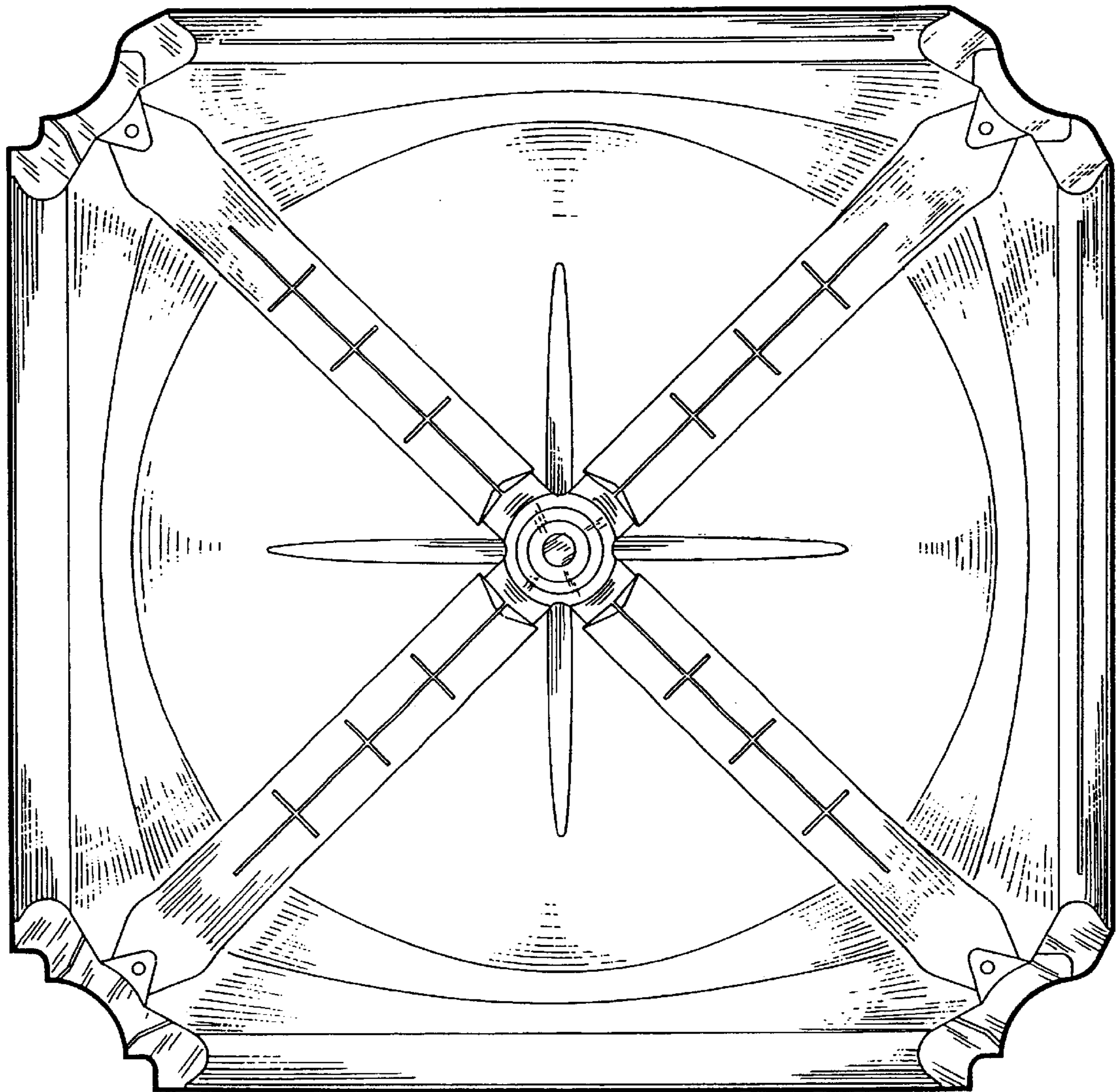
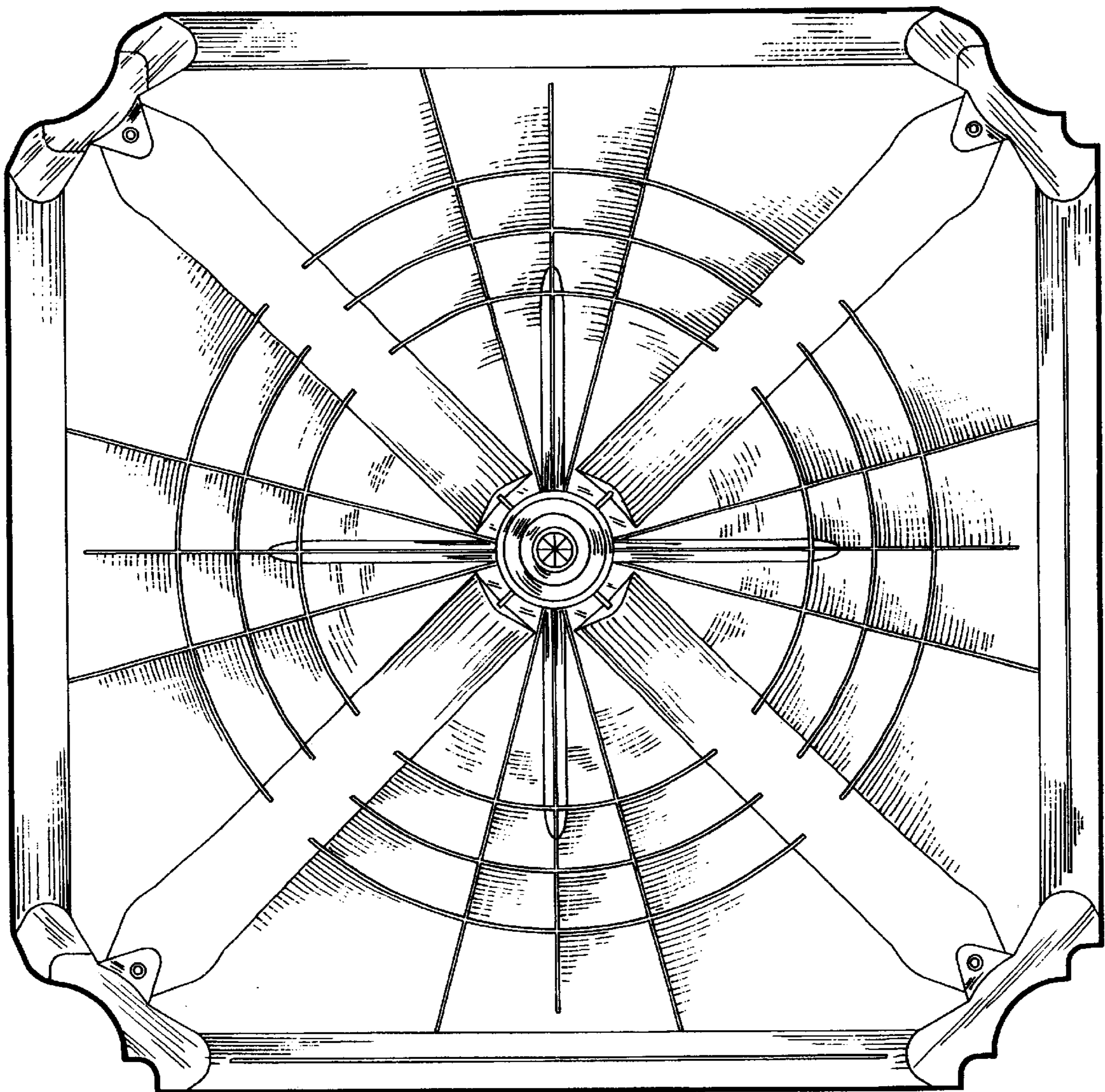

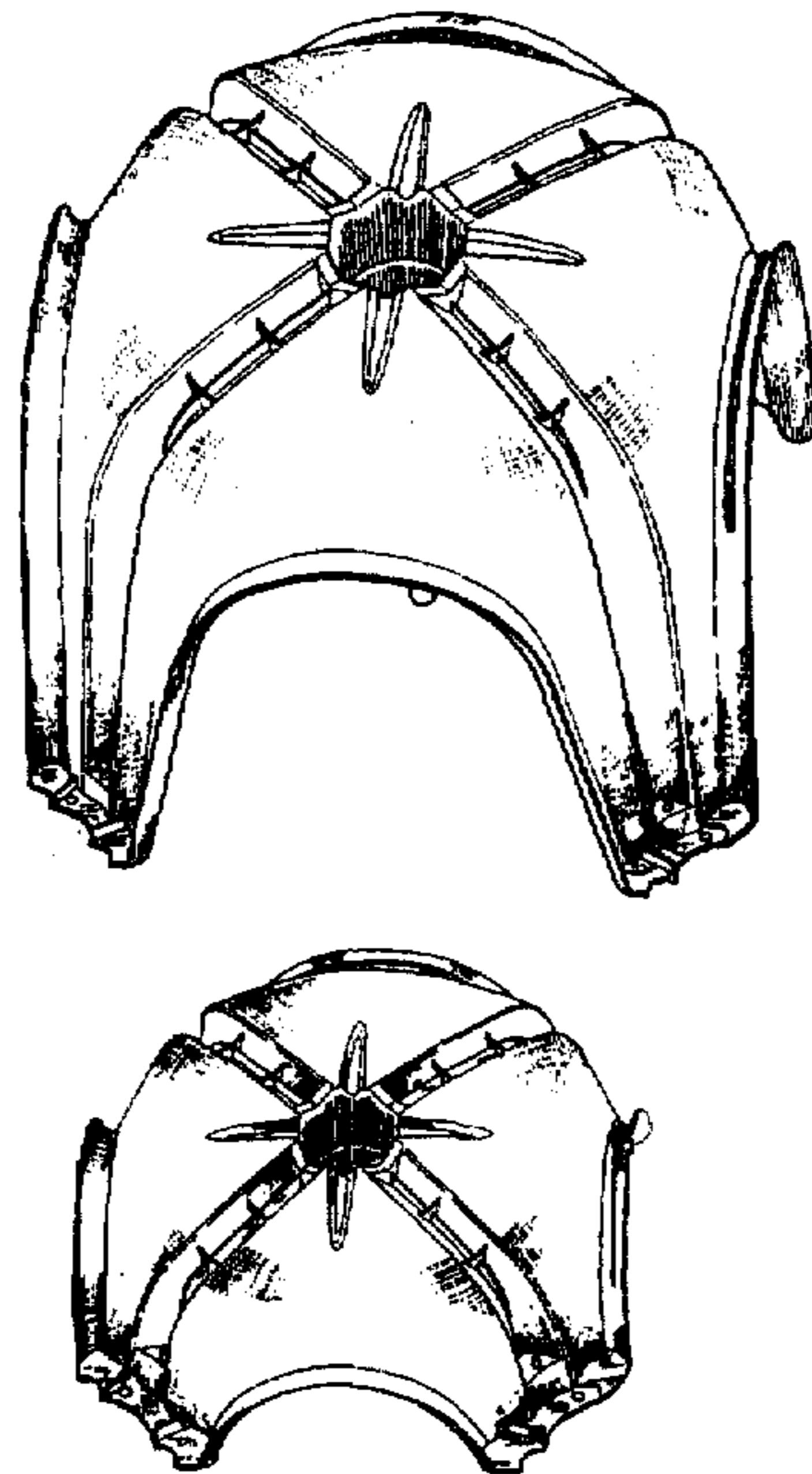
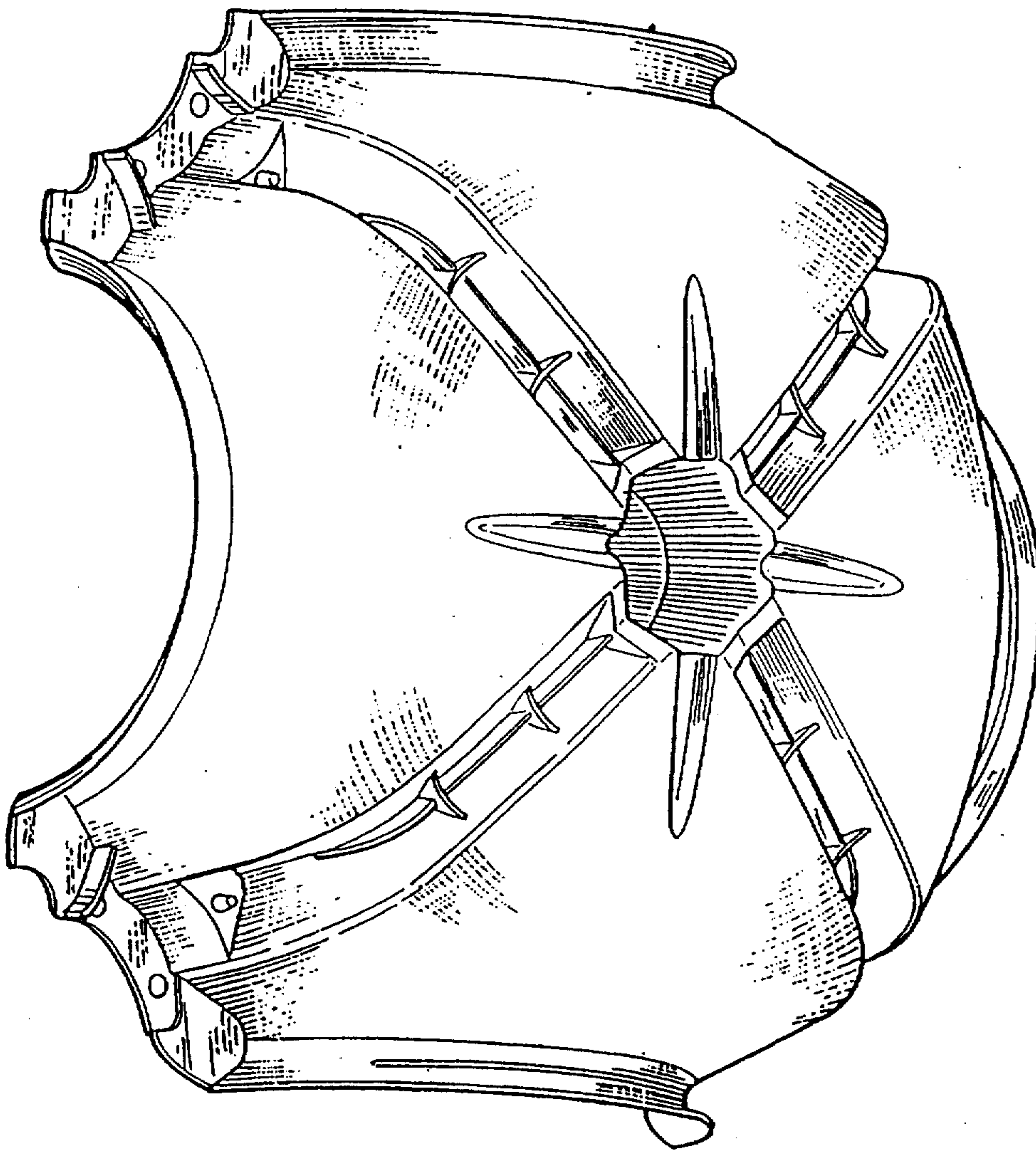

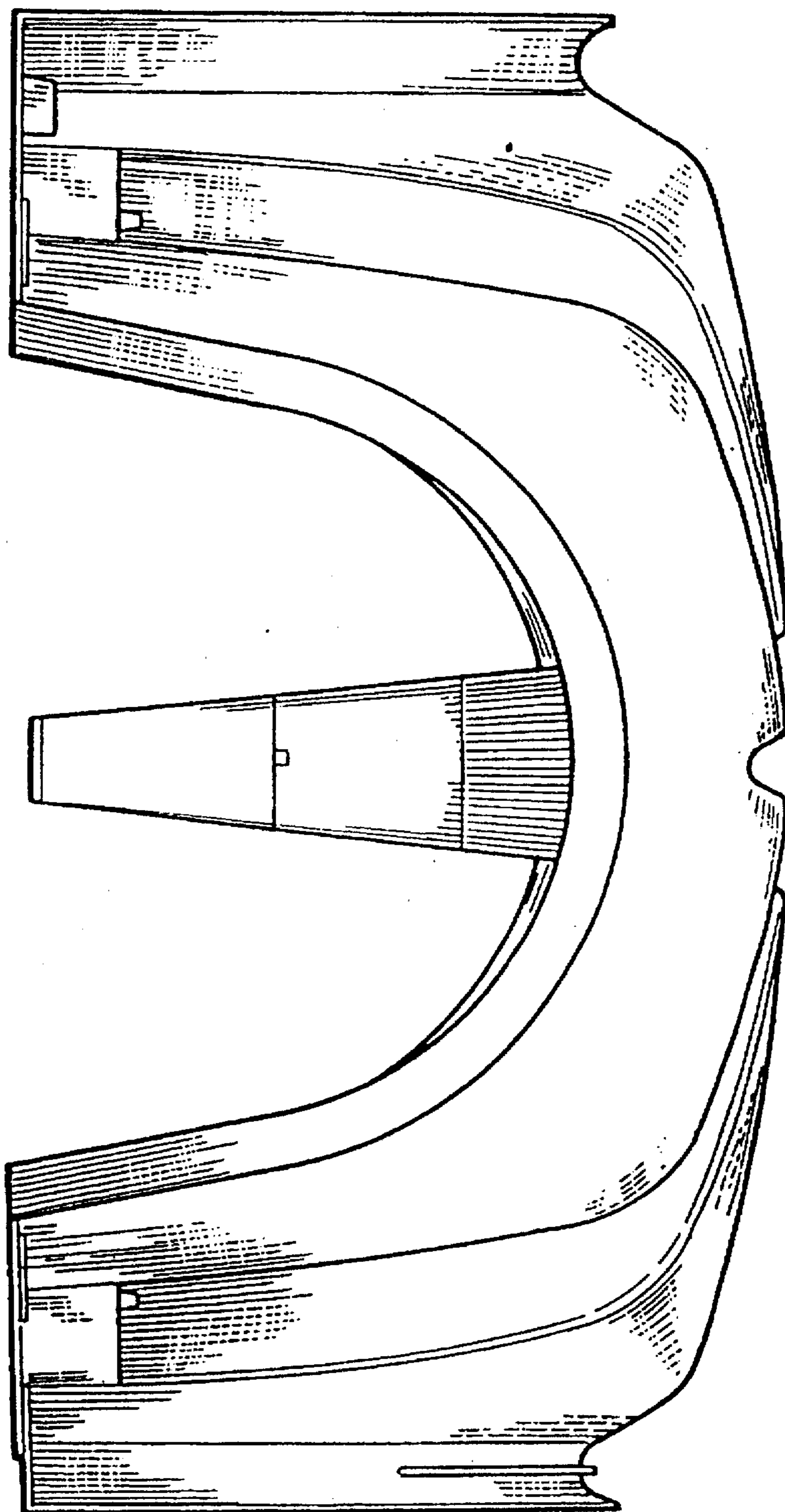

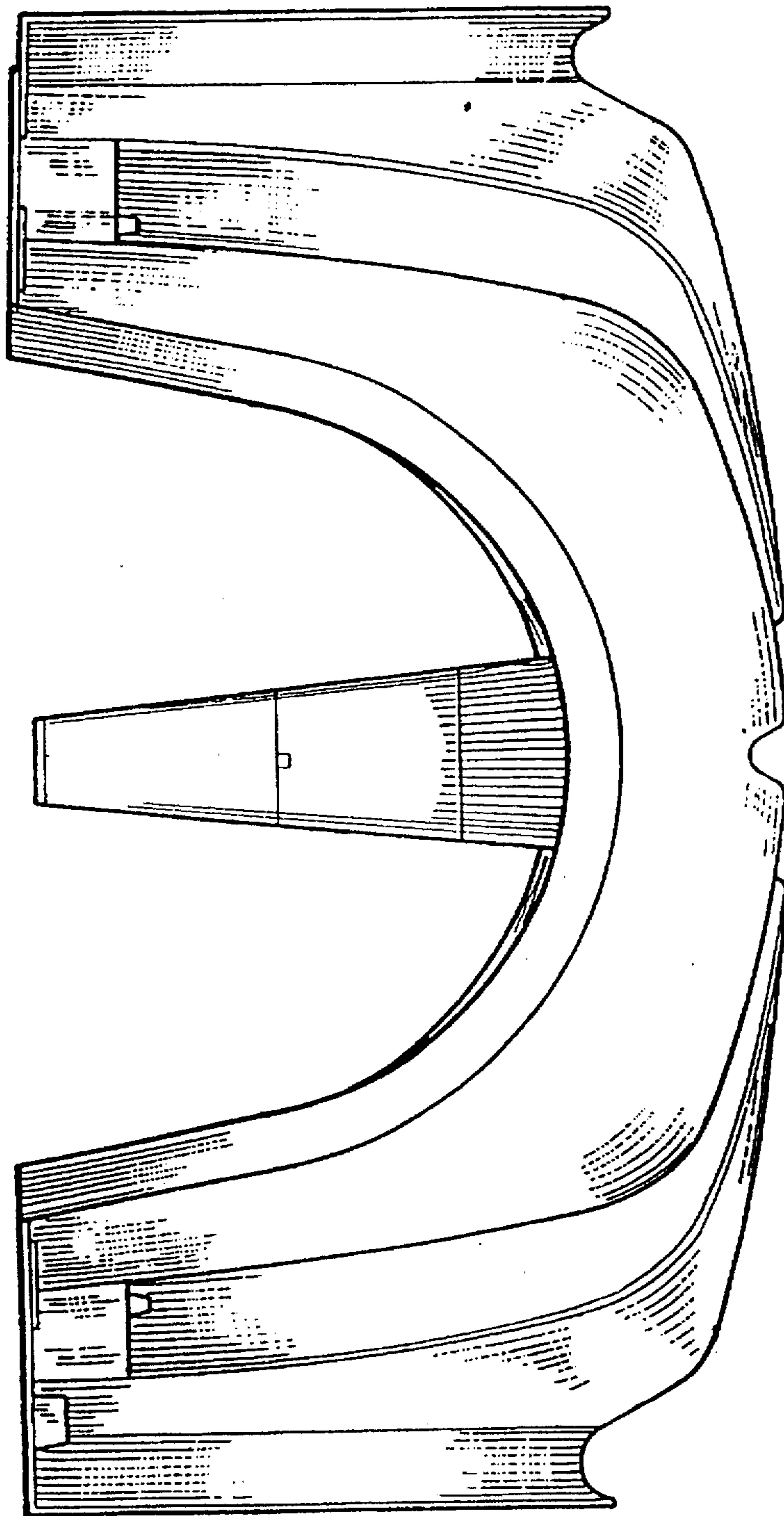

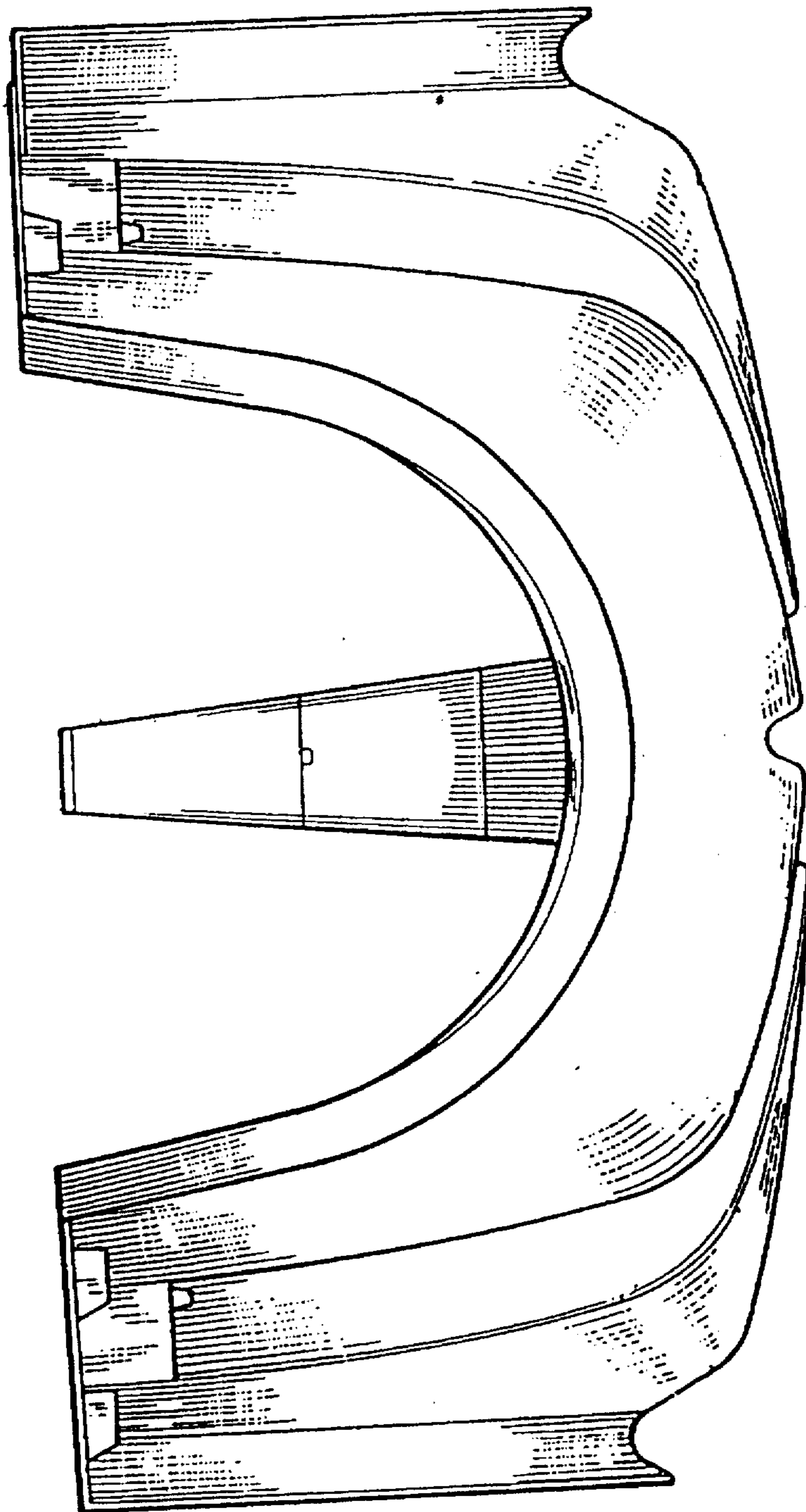

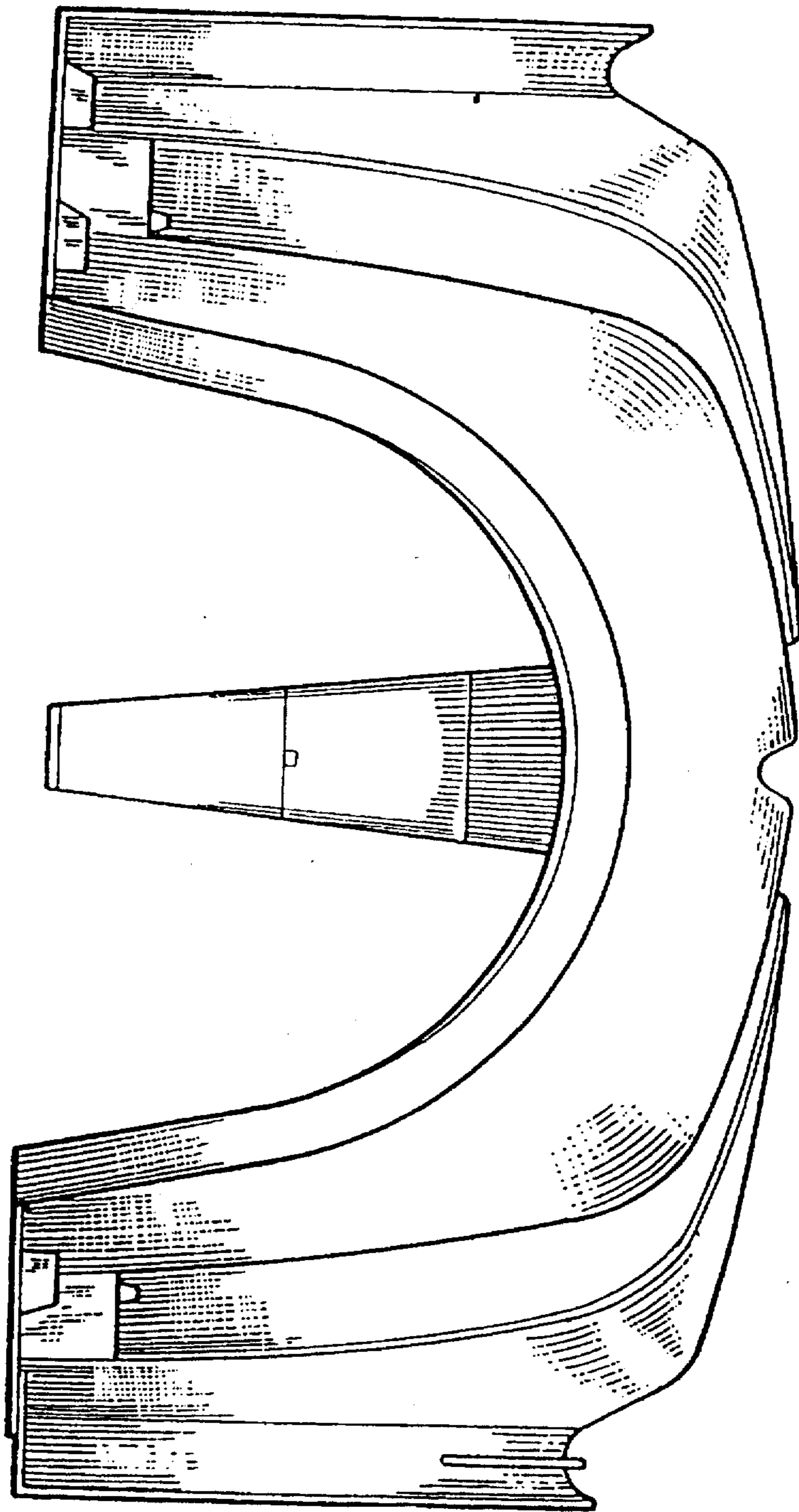

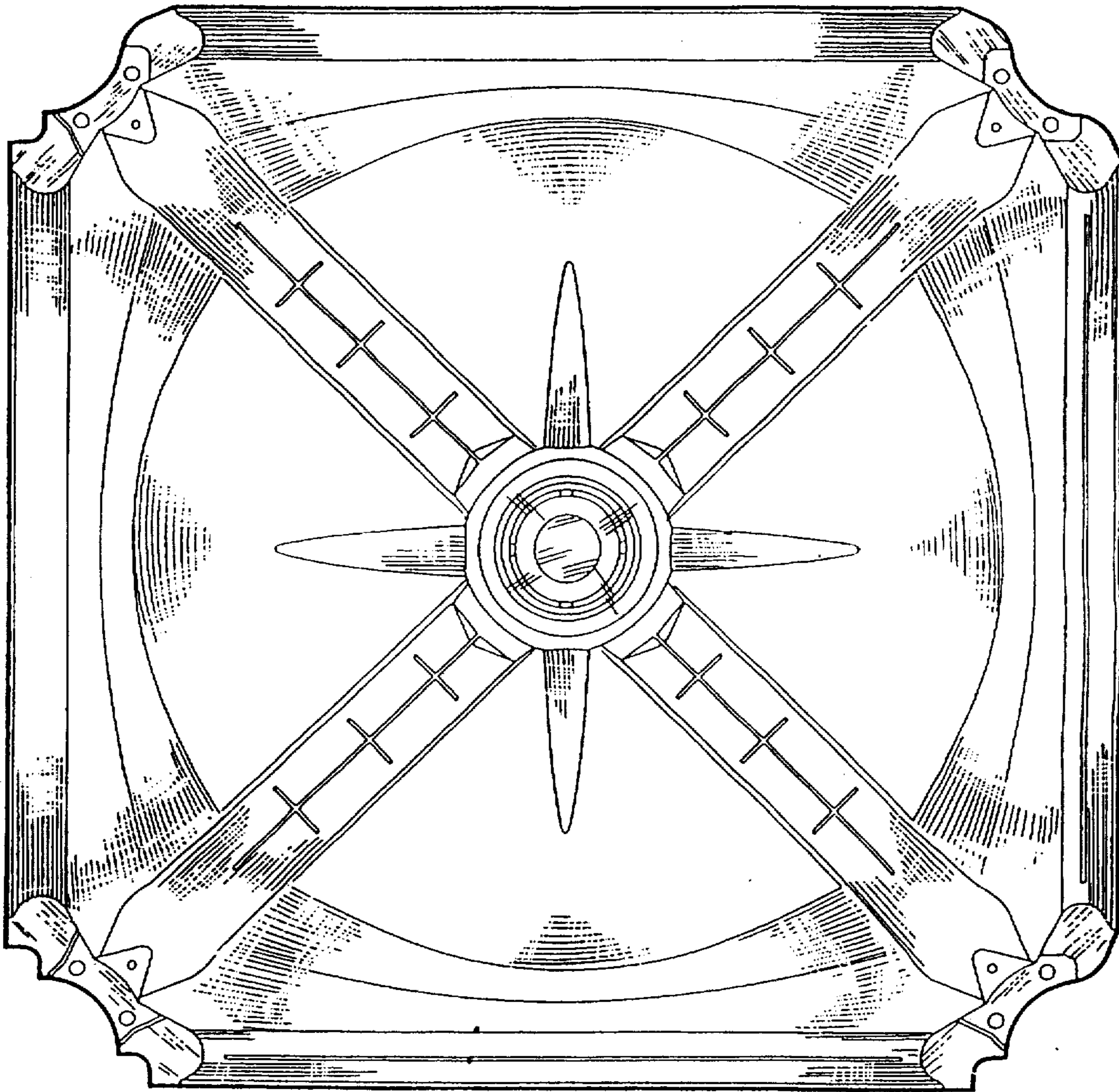

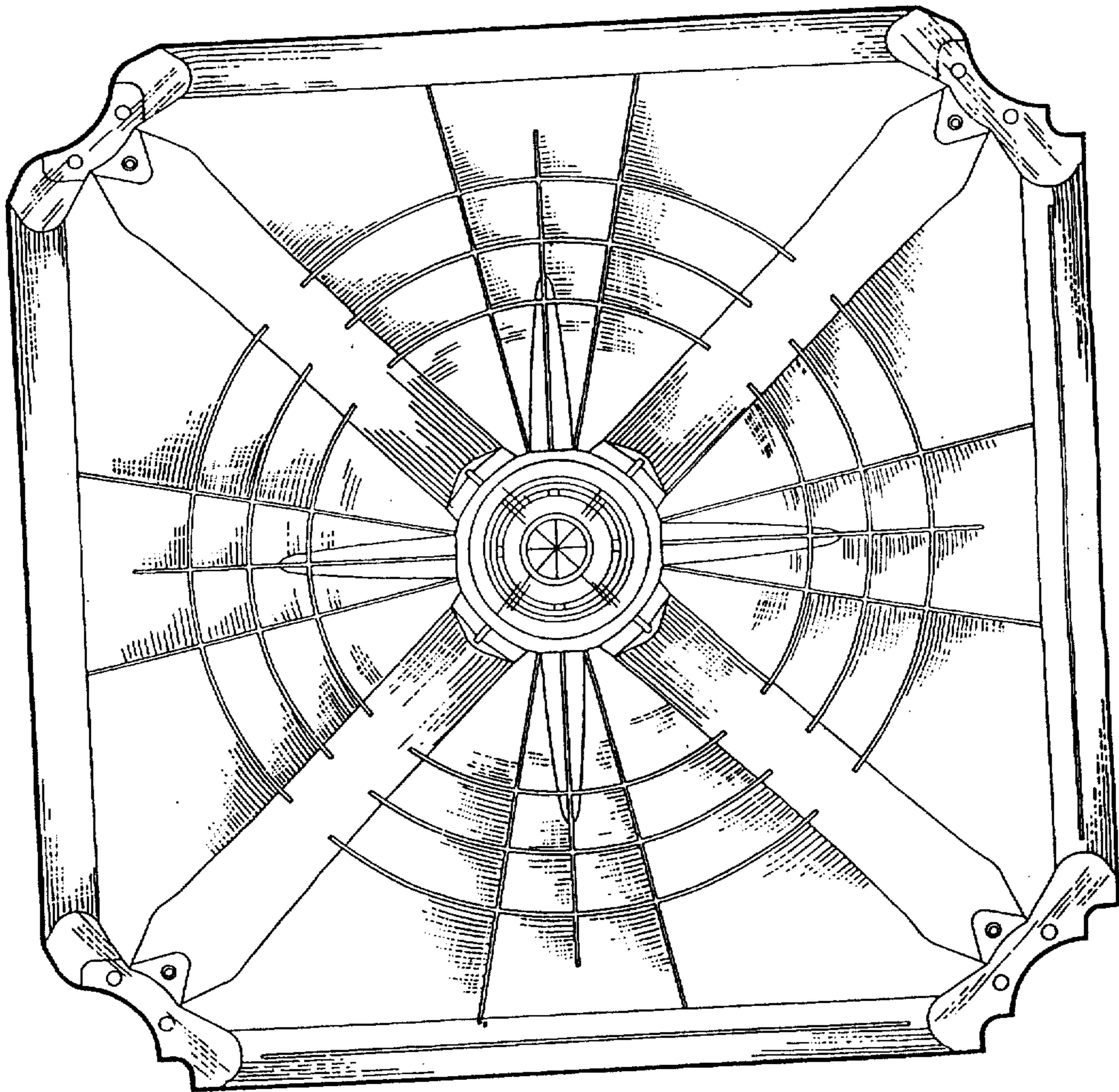
