DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tire tread showing our new
design, it being understood that the pattern repeats uni-
formly throughout the circumference of the tread;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side
elevational view being identical thereto;

FIG. 4 is an enlarged fragmentary perspective view;

FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the
tire tread;

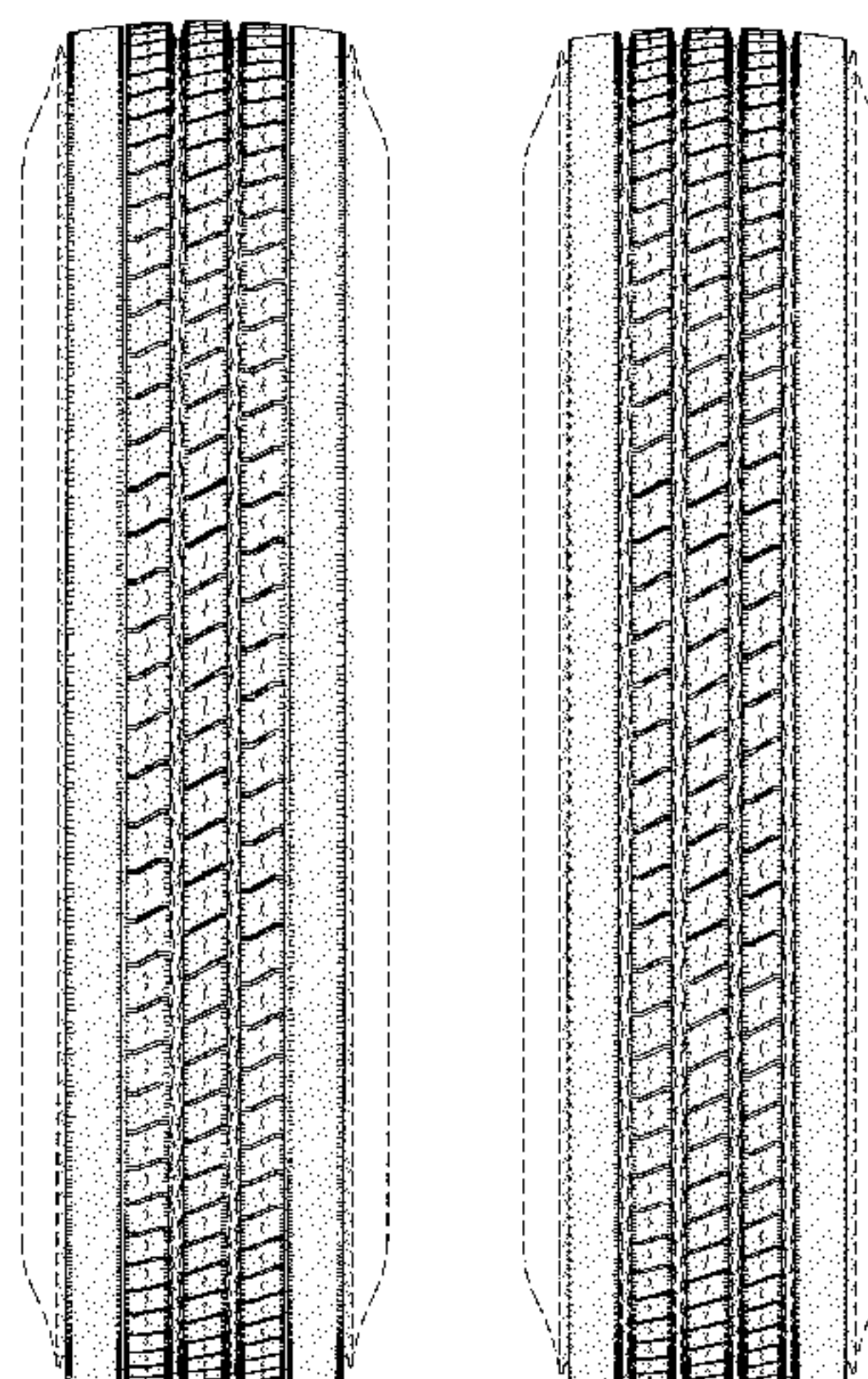
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of the tread in FIG. 5;

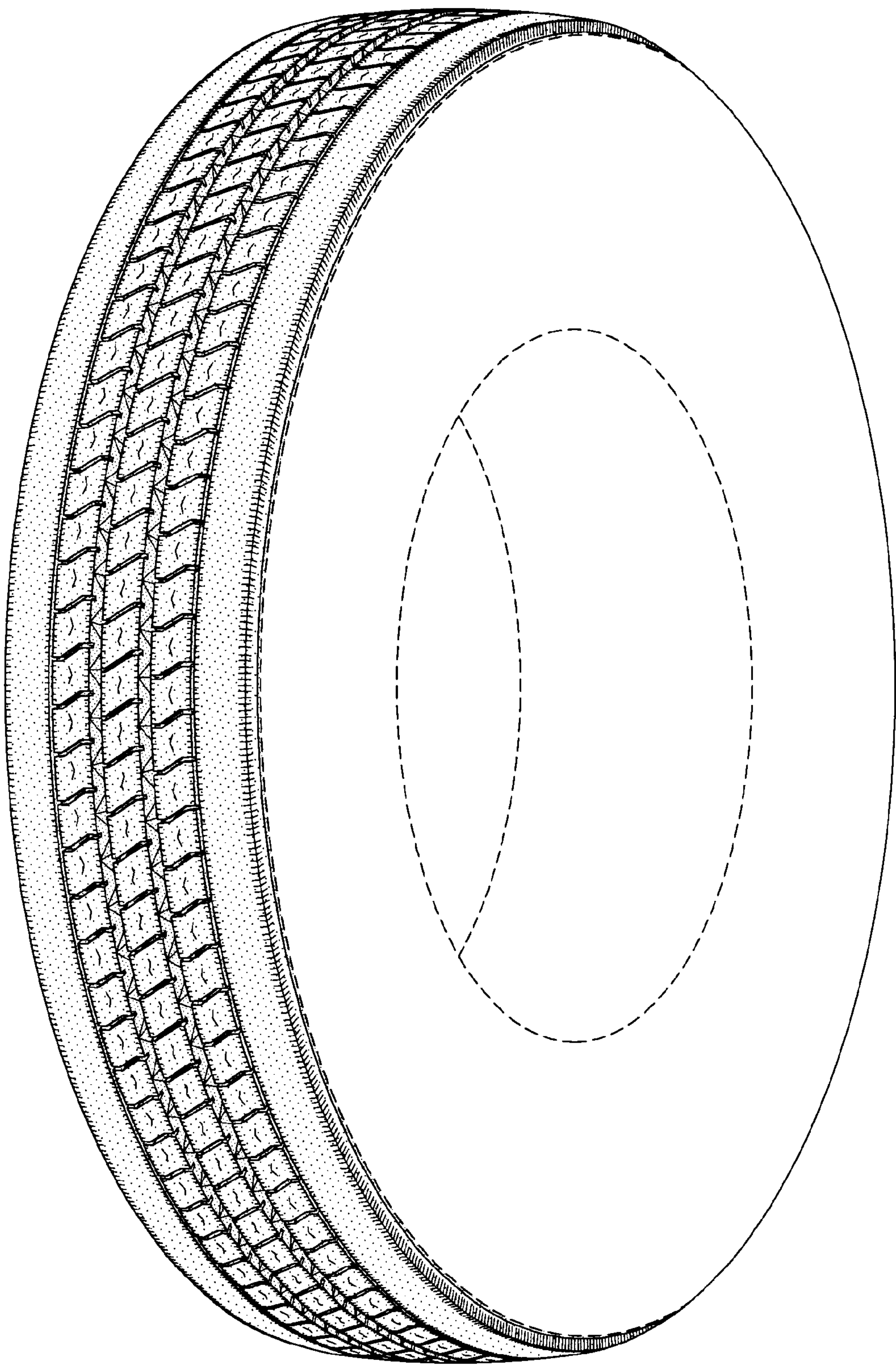

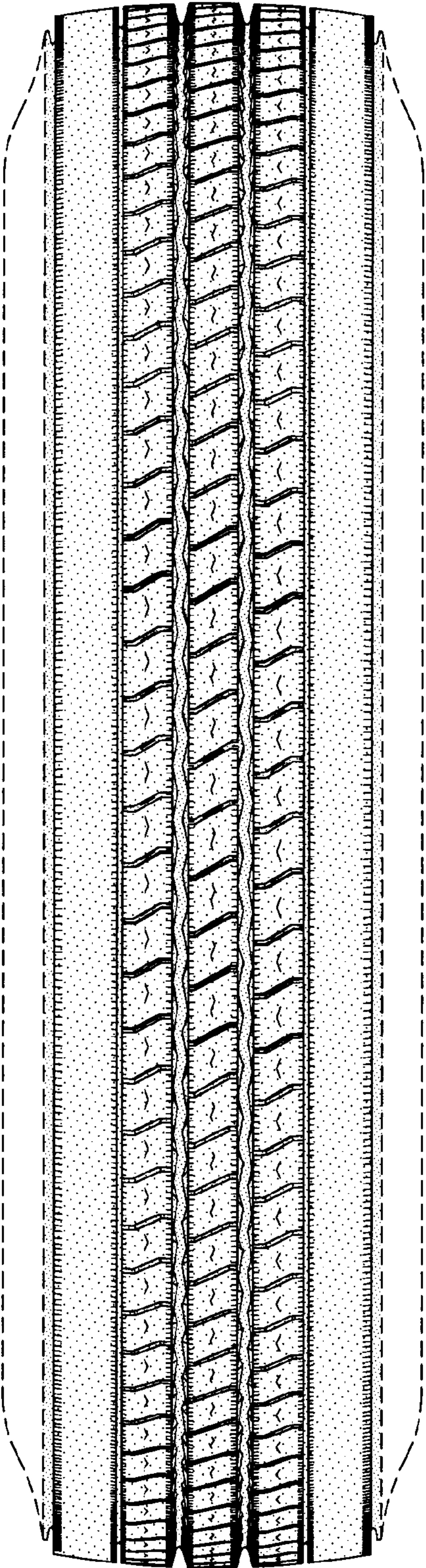

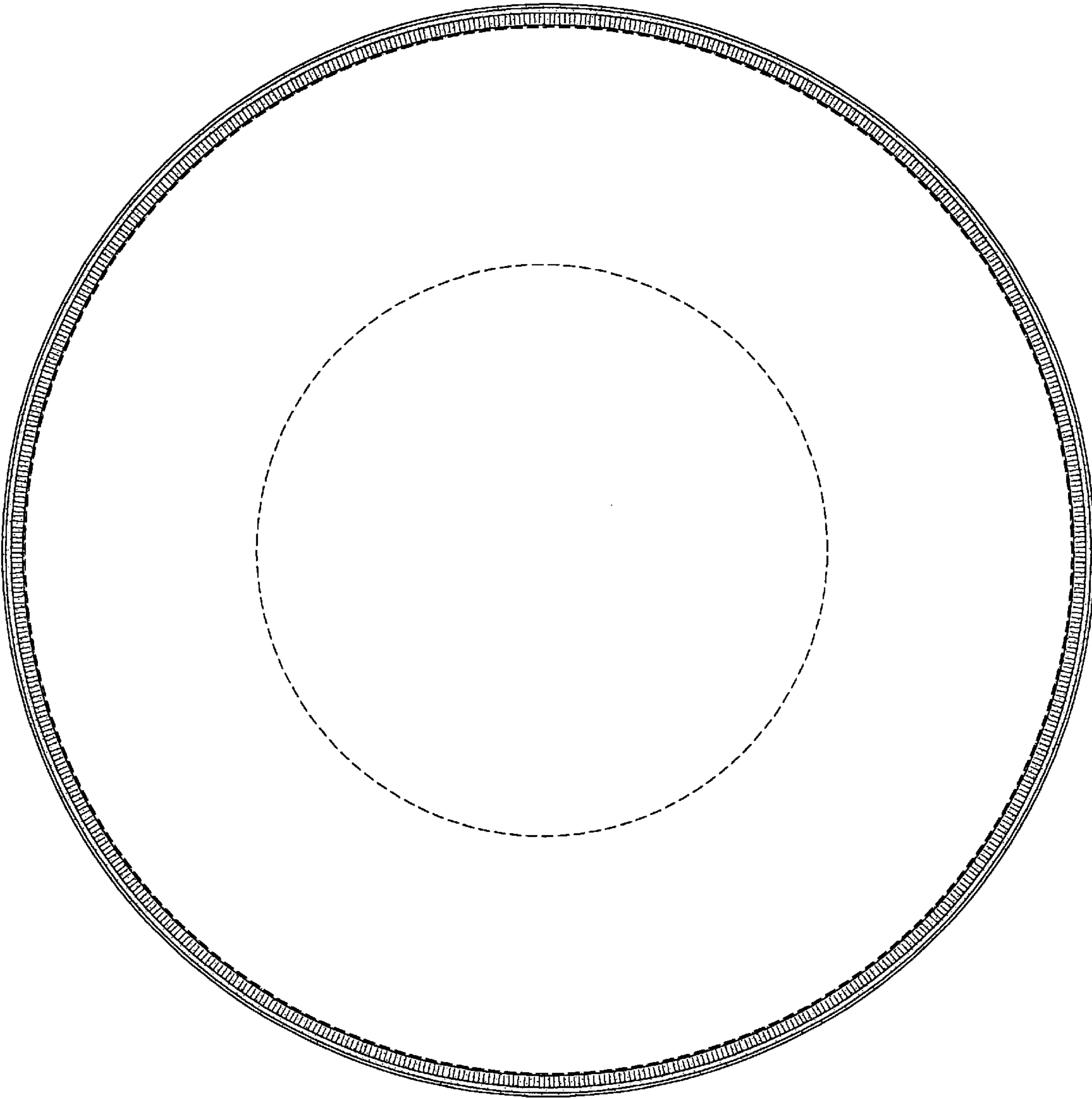

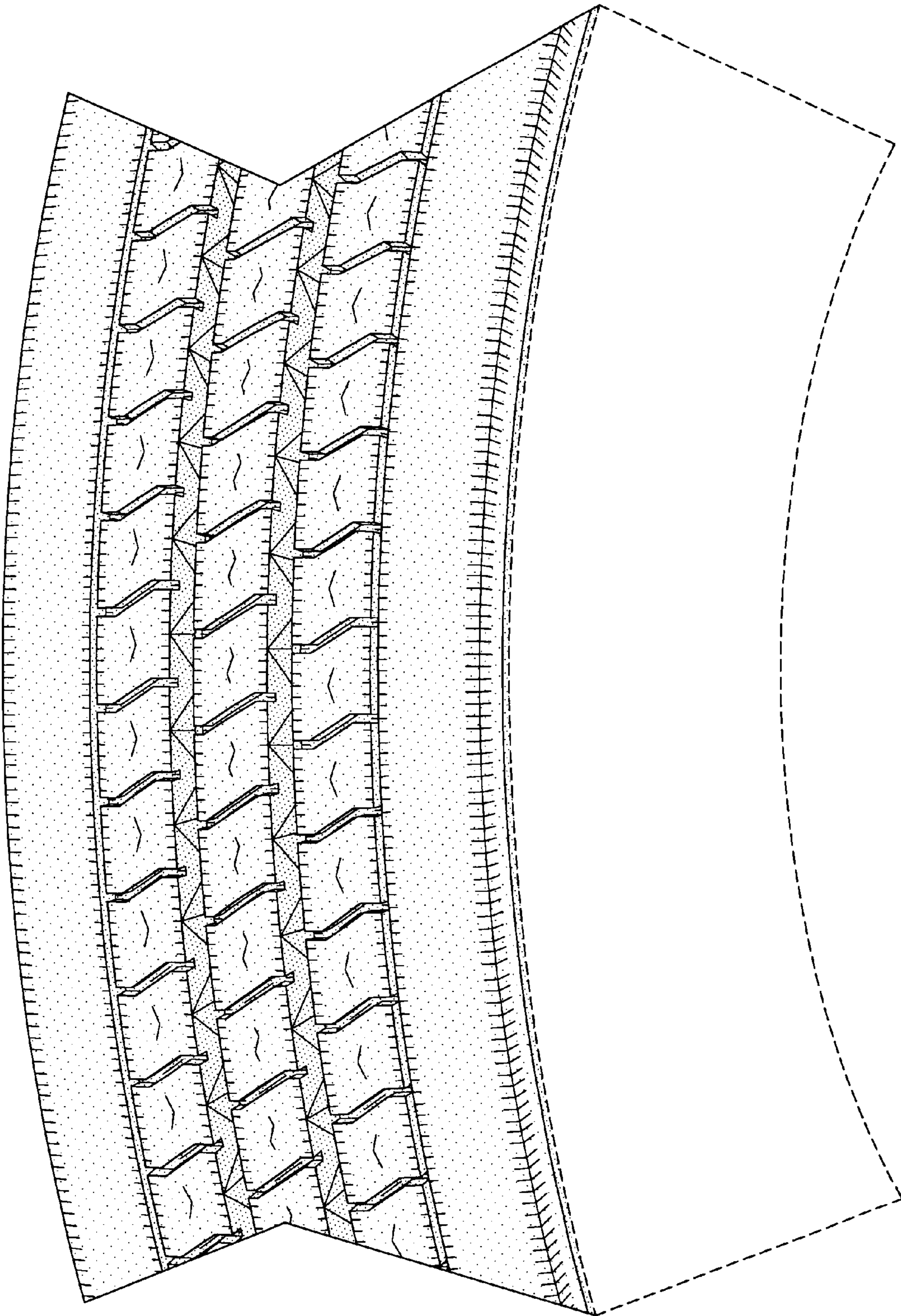

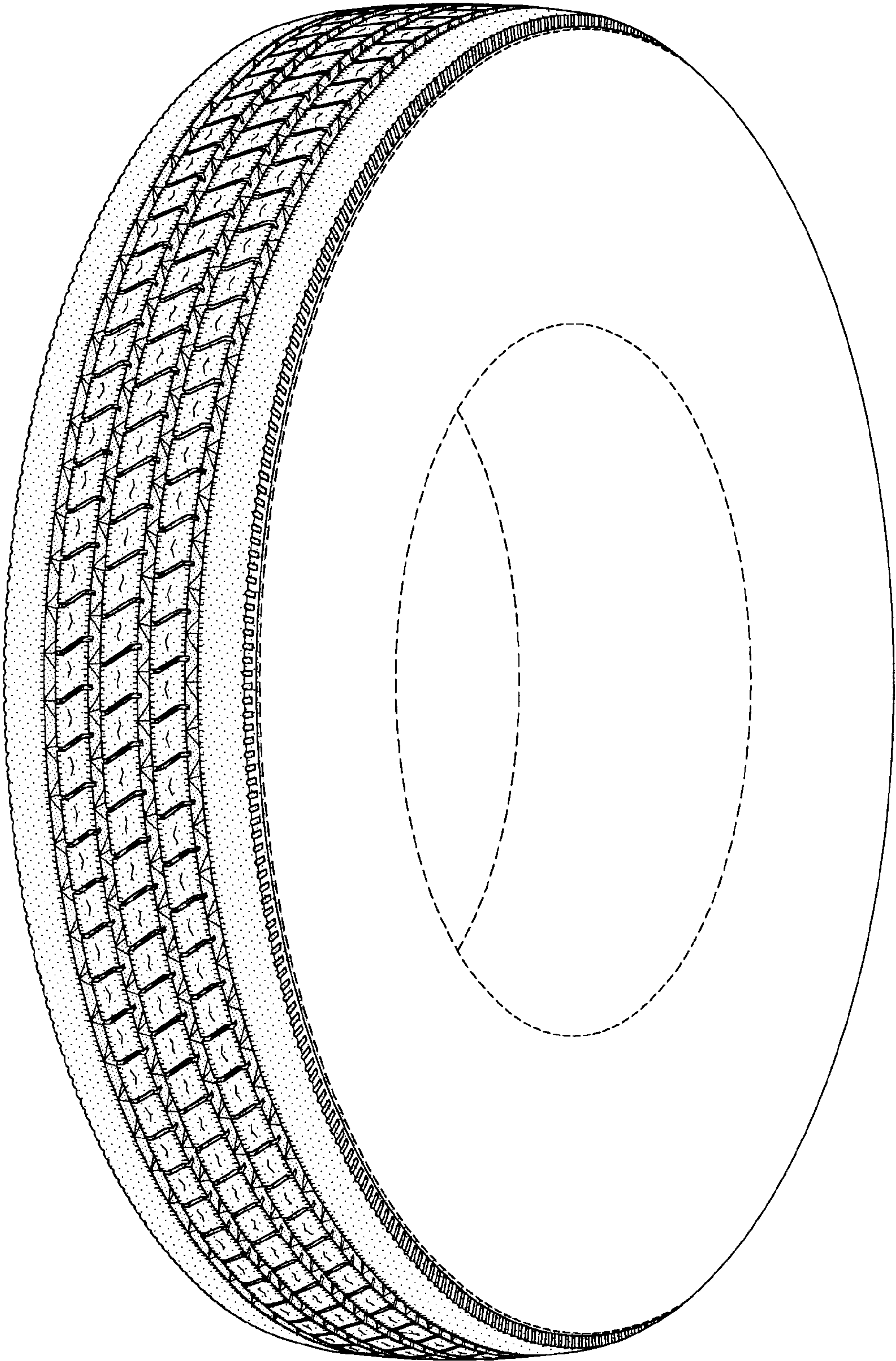

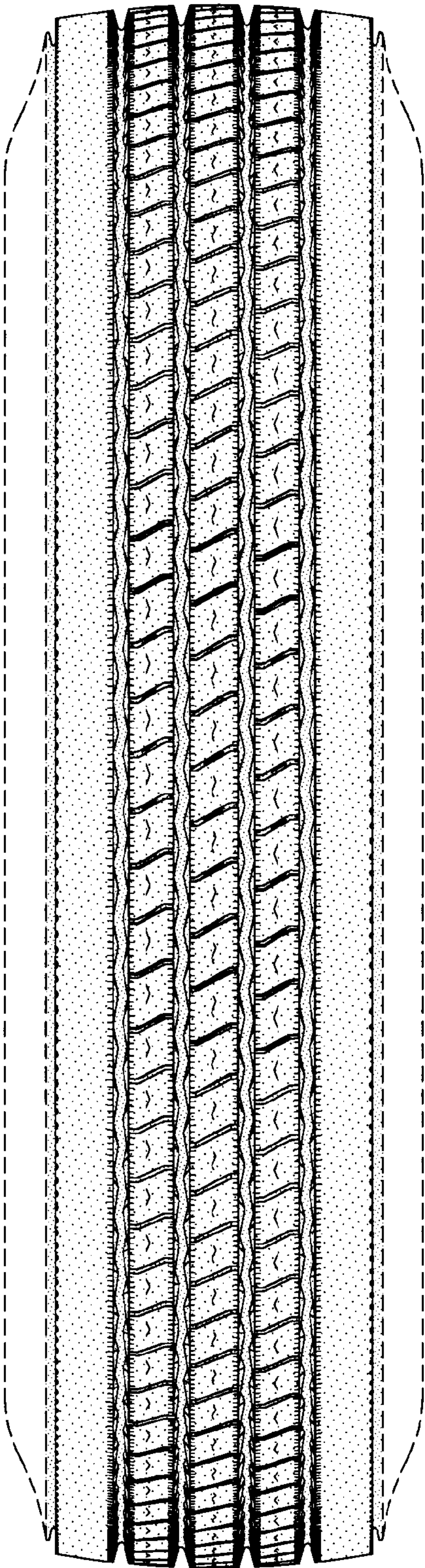

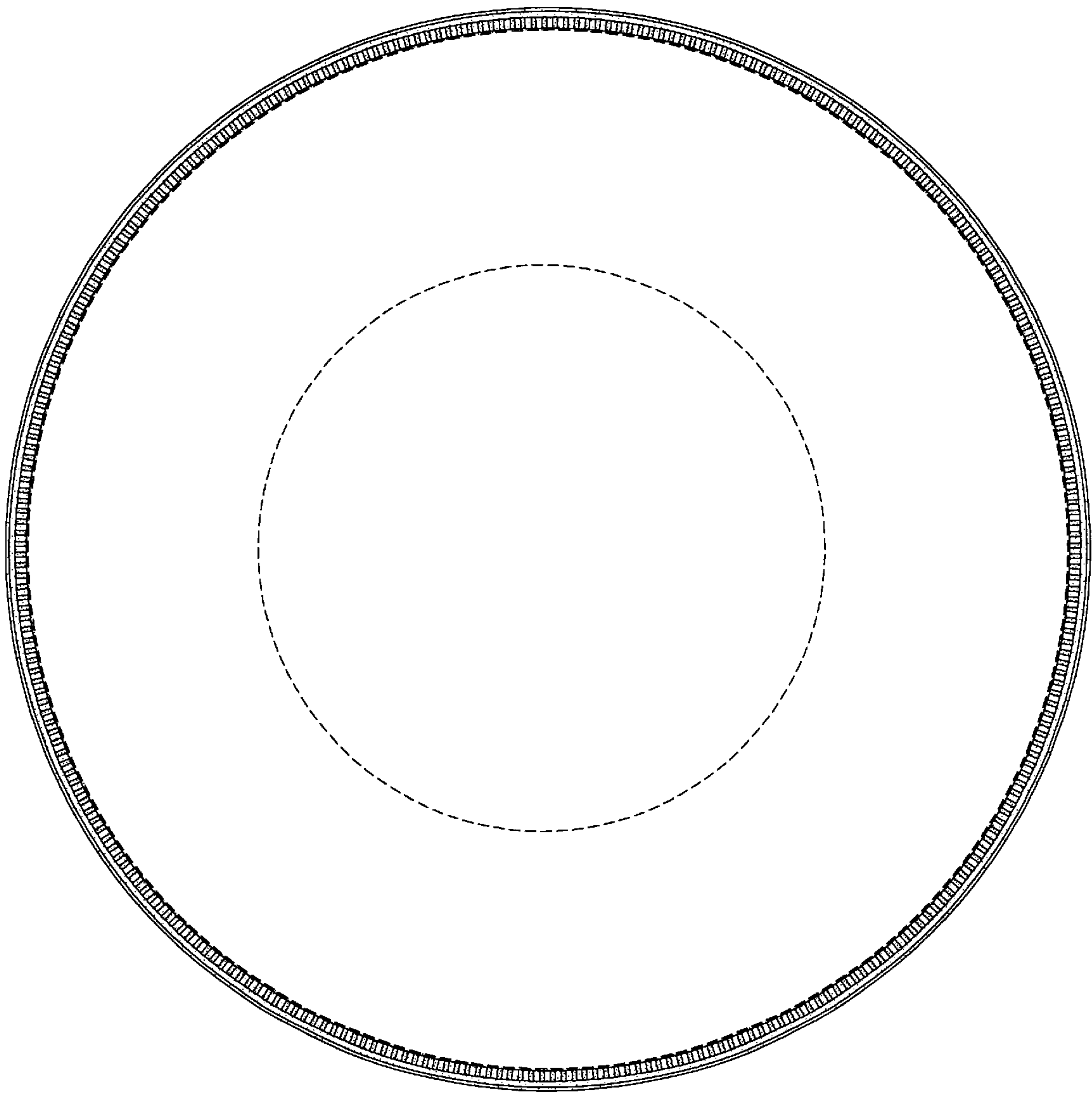

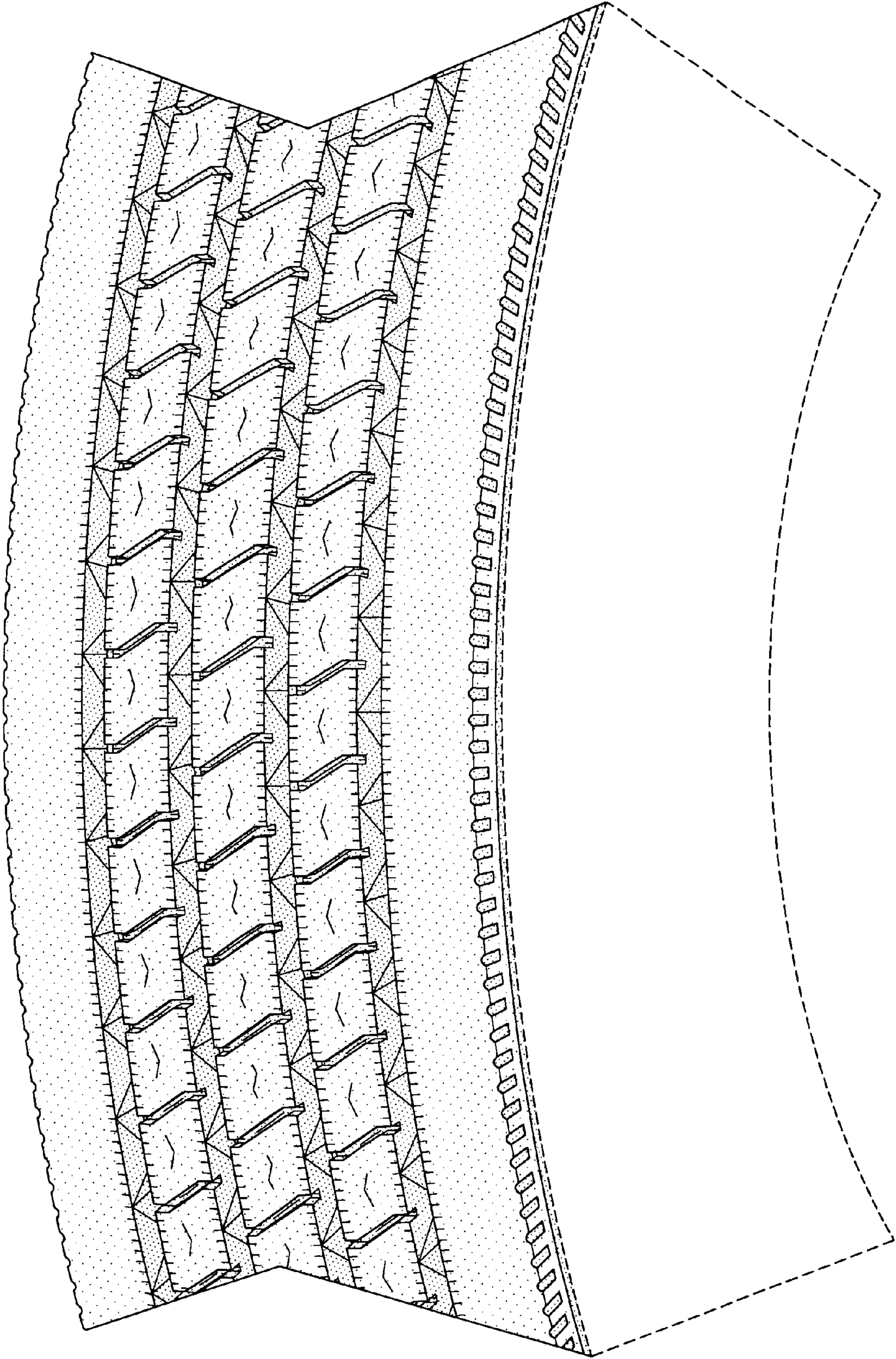
