The ornamental design for a swim fin having shortened blade, as shown and described herein.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1. Is a perspective view of my swim fin having

shortened blade, and the broken lines being for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 2. Is a front view thereof;

FIG. 3. Is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 4. Is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6. Is a top view thereof;

FIG. 8. Is a top perspective view of an second embodiment of my swim fin having shortened blade,;

FIG. 11. Is a right side elevational view of the FIG. 8 embodiment;

FIG. 12. Is a left side elevational view of the FIG. 8 embodiment;

FIG. 14. Is a bottom view of the FIG. 8 embodiment.
