(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an ornamental surface pattern for a casino card game, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the ornamental surface pattern for a casino card game, shown without color for ease of illustration.

FIG. 2: is an enlarged fragmentary color view of the ornamental surface pattern depicting the dealer space.

FIG. 3: is an enlarged fragmentary color view of the ornamental surface pattern depicting the first player space.

FIG. 4: is an enlarged fragmentary color view of the ornamental surface pattern depicting the second player space.

FIG. 5: is an enlarged fragmentary color view of the ornamental surface pattern depicting the third player space.

FIG. 6: is an enlarged fragmentary color view of the ornamental surface pattern depicting the fourth player space.

FIG. 7: is an enlarged fragmentary color view of the ornamental surface pattern depicting the fifth player space.

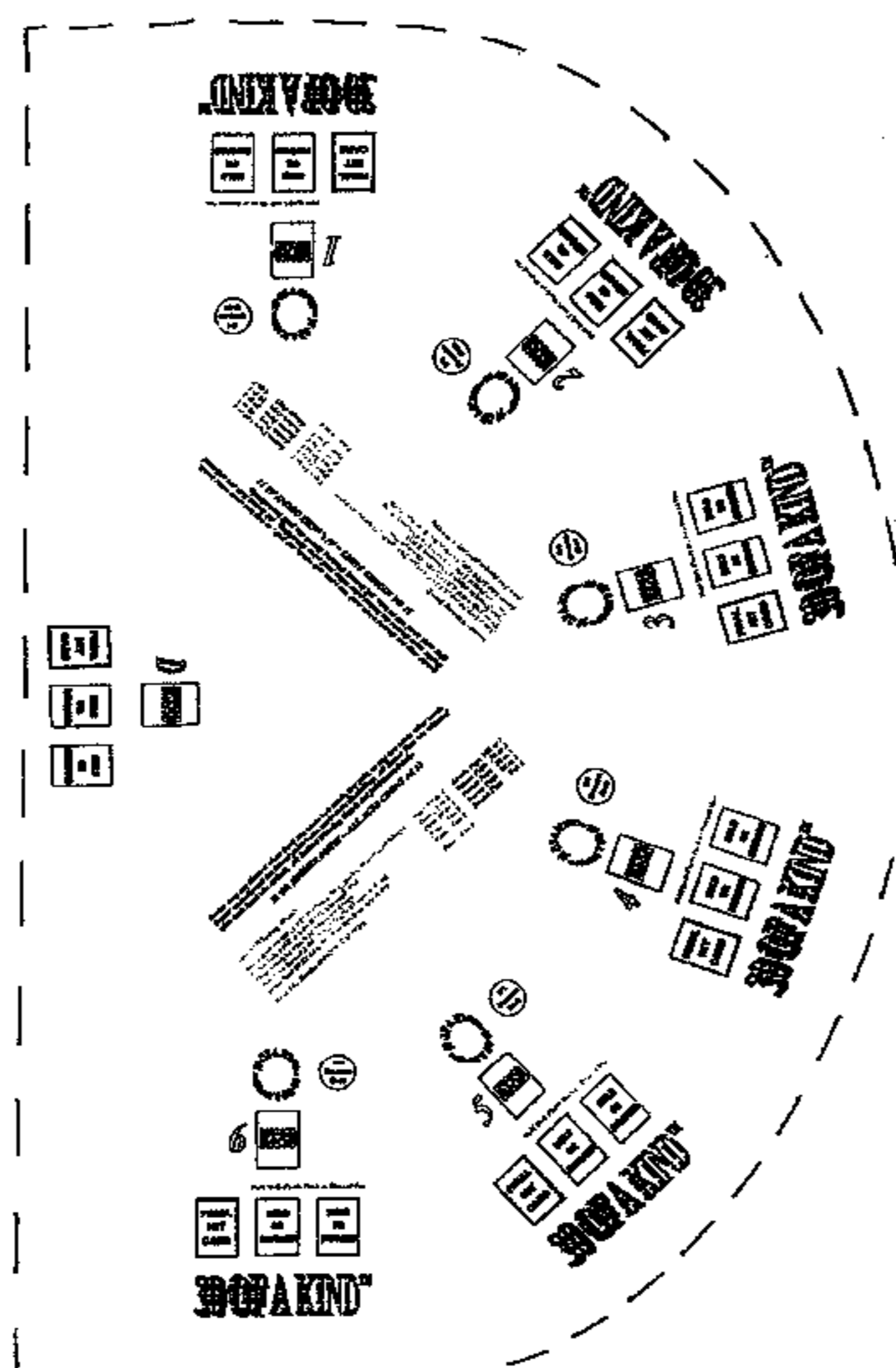
FIG. 8: is an enlarged fragmentary color view of the ornamental surface pattern depicting the sixth player space.

FIG. 9: is an enlarged fragmentary color view of the ornamental surface pattern depicting one of the two identical sets of table rules; and,

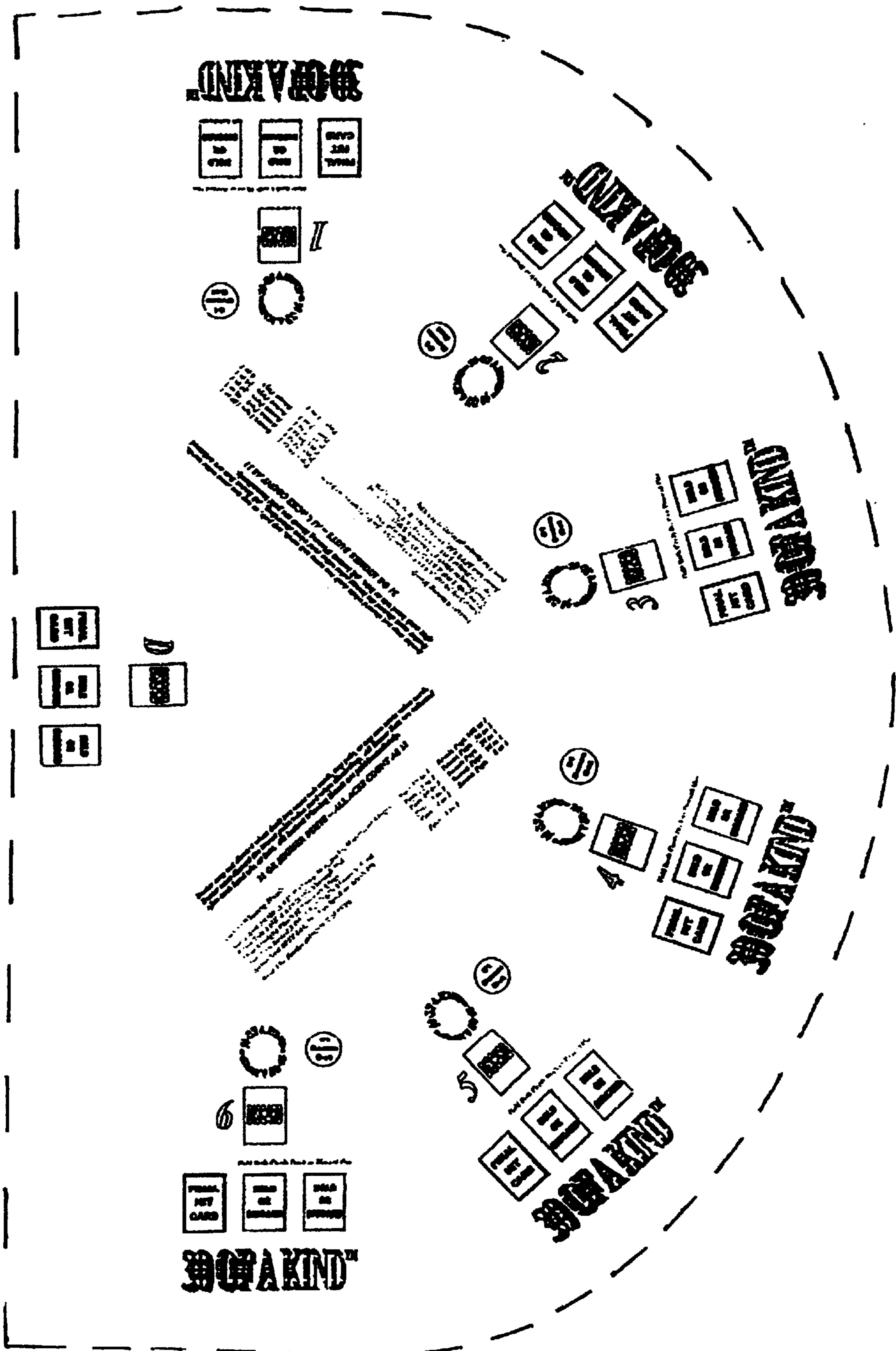

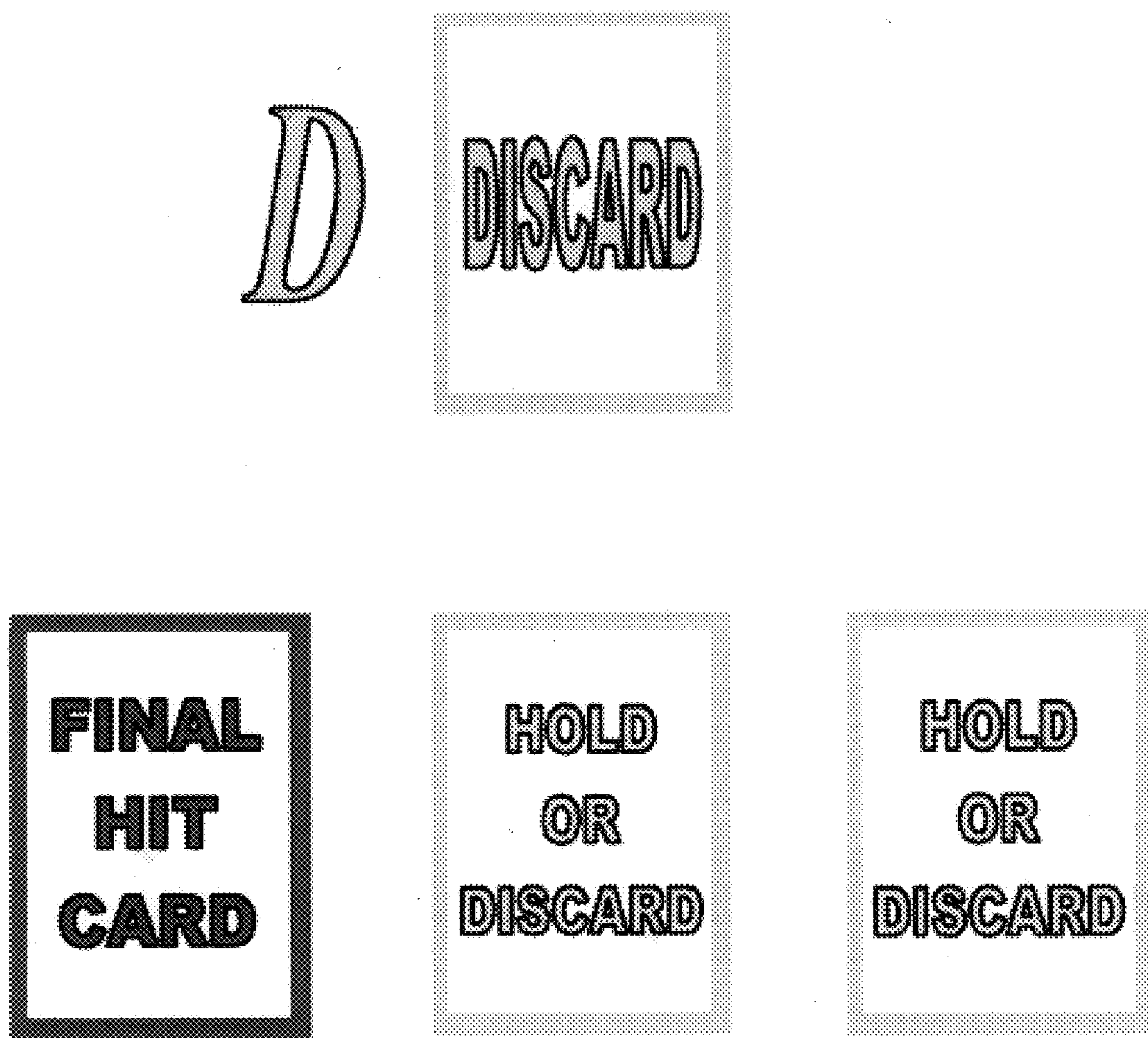

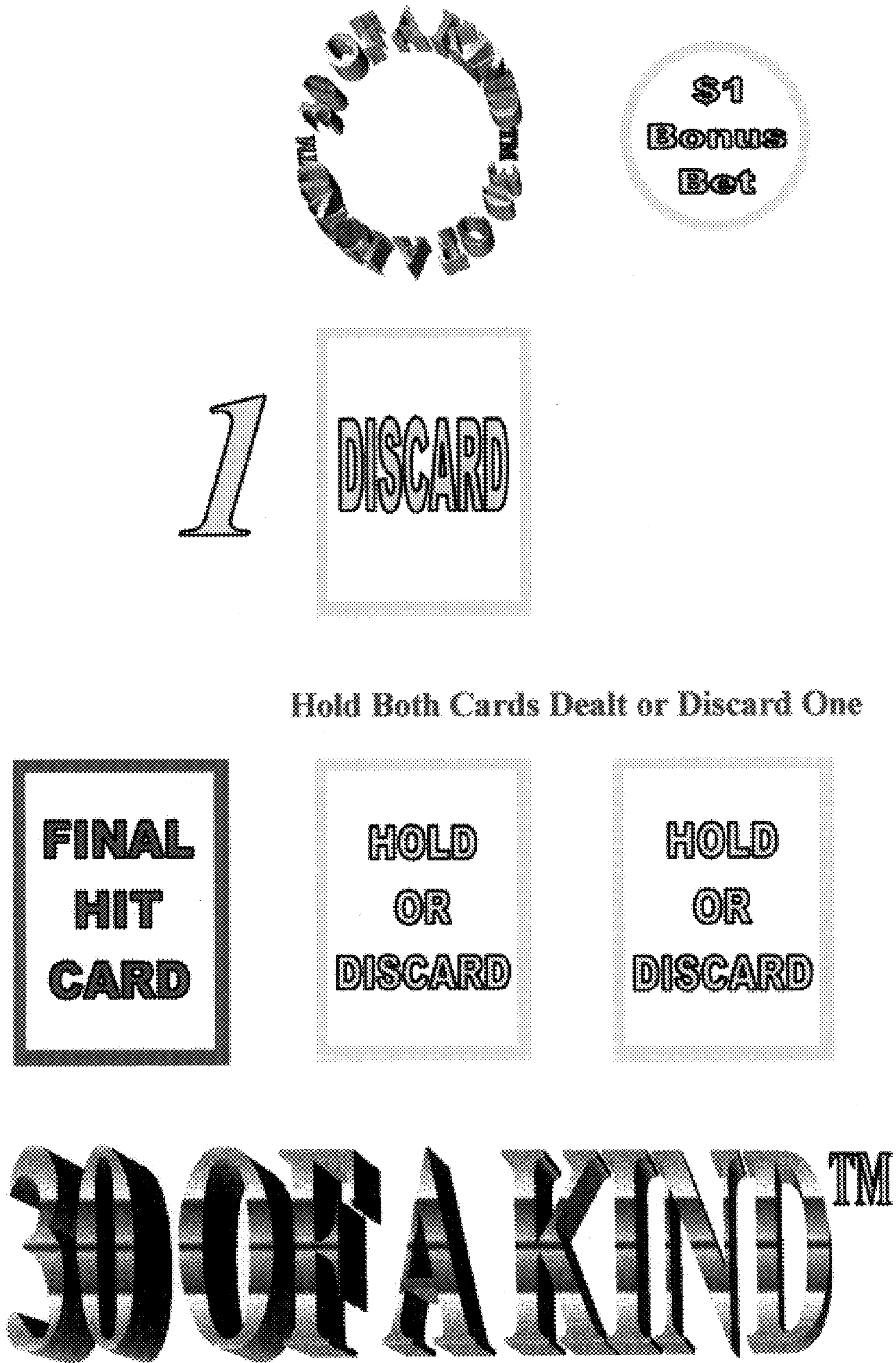

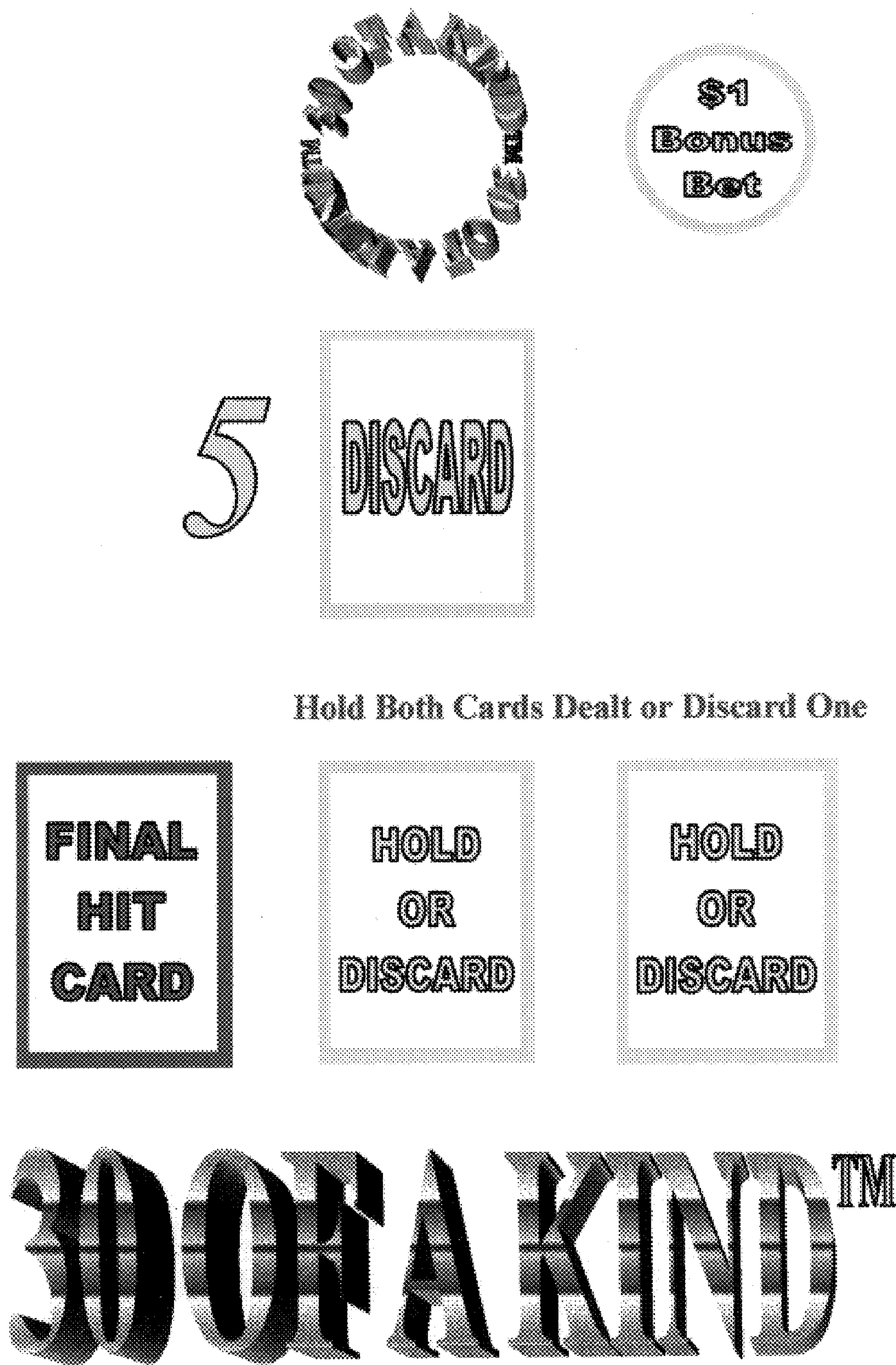

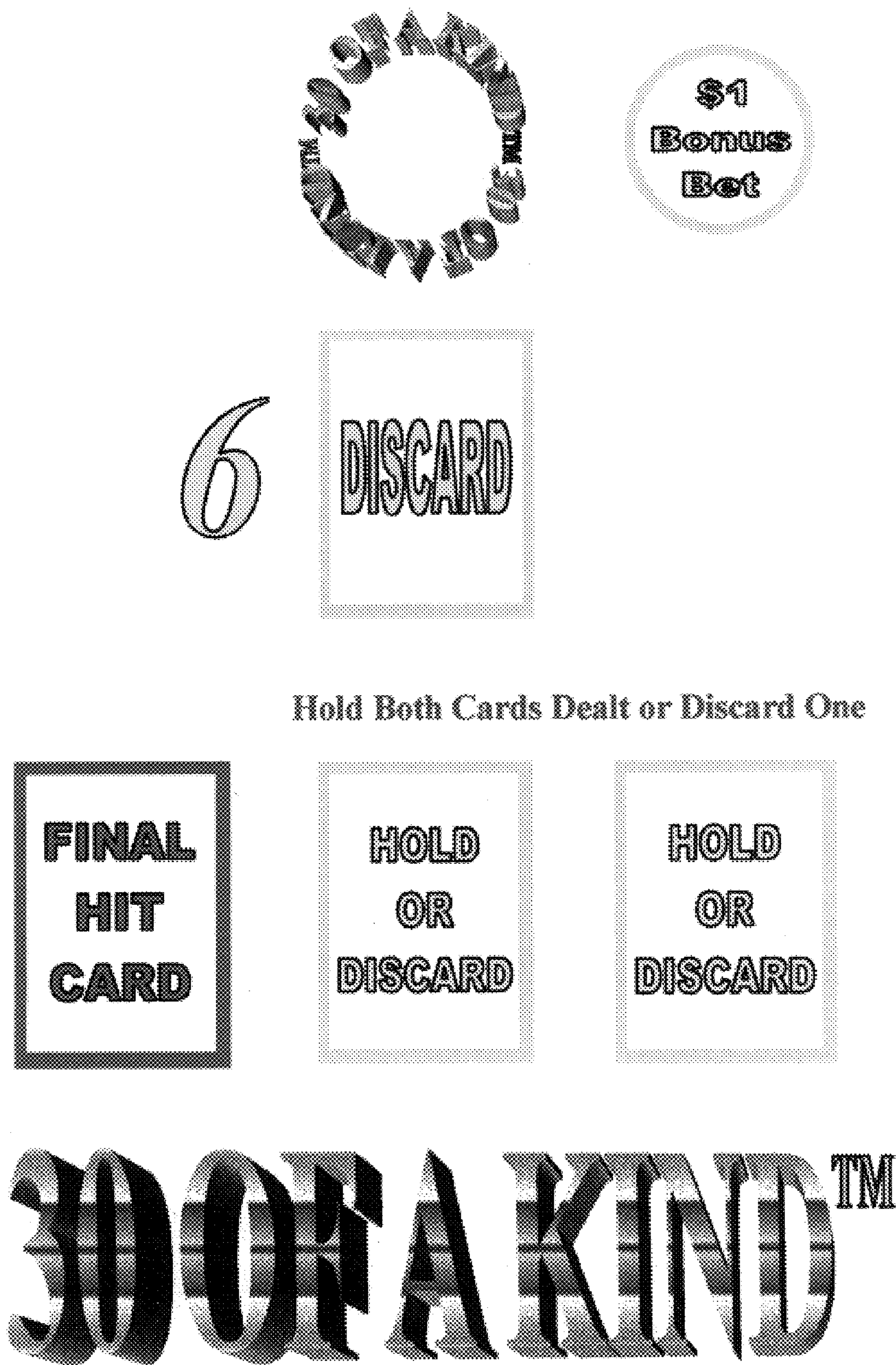
