FIG. 4 is a reduced rear elevation thereof;

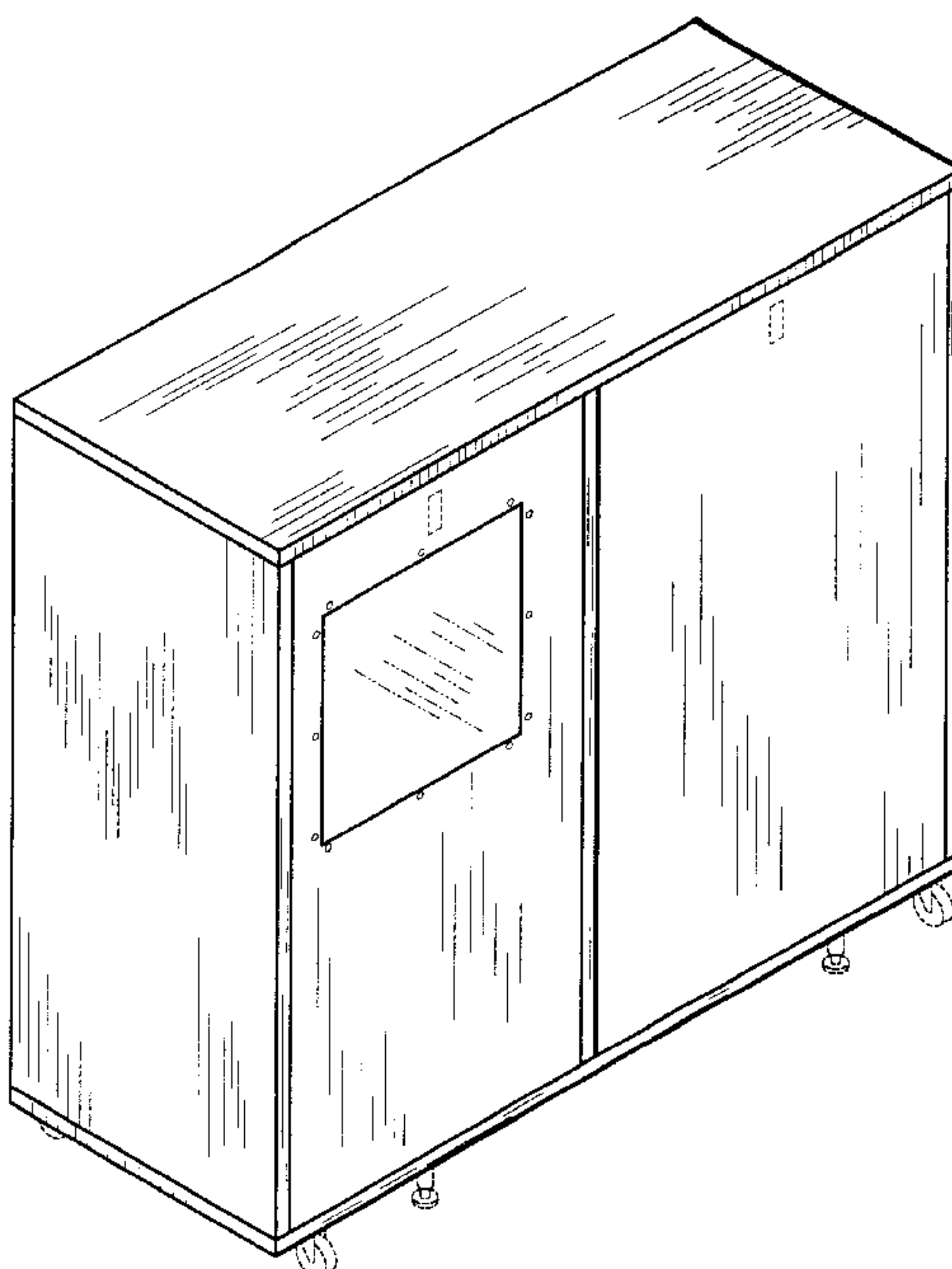
FIG. 5 is a reduced left end elevation thereof;

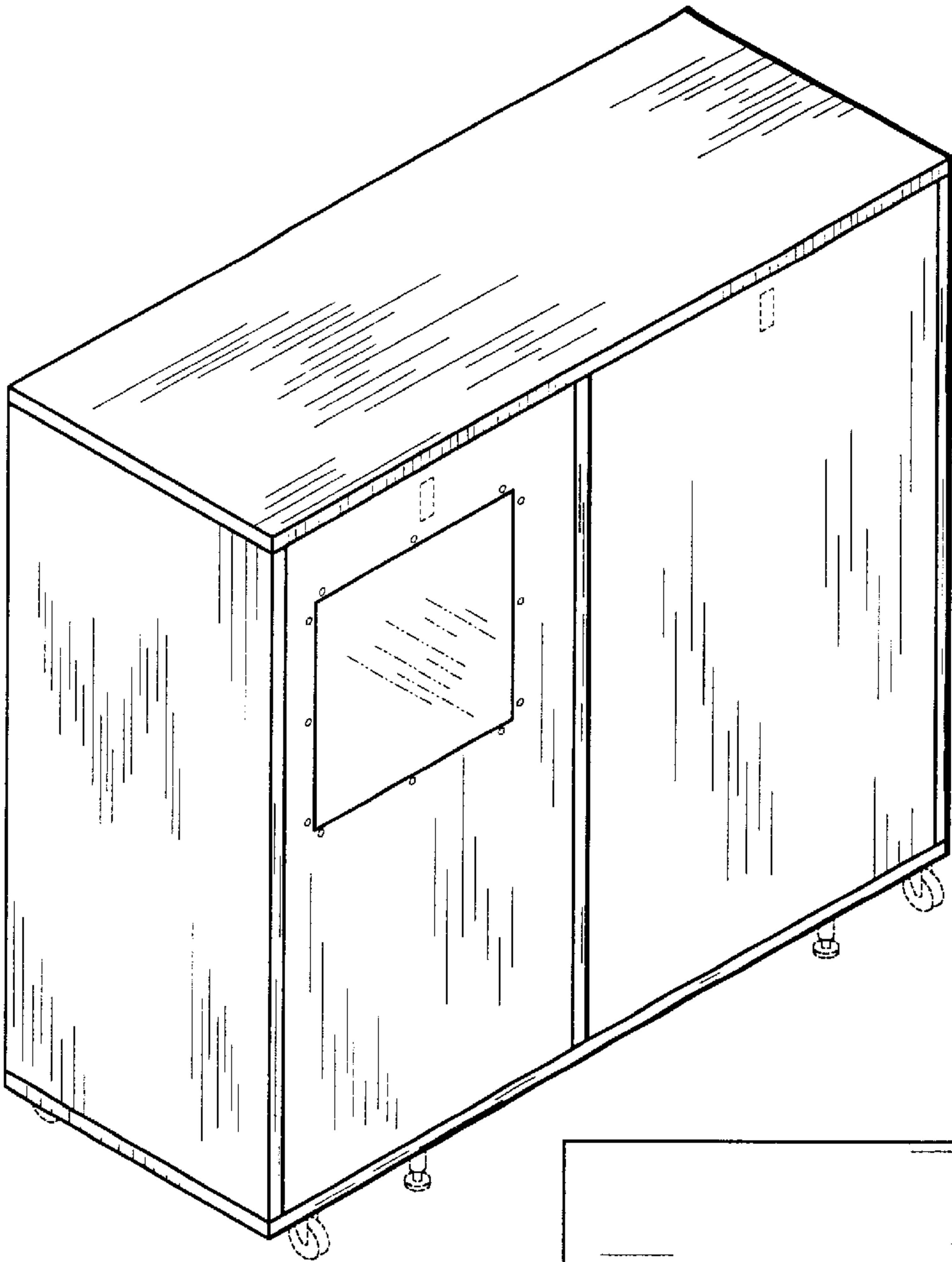

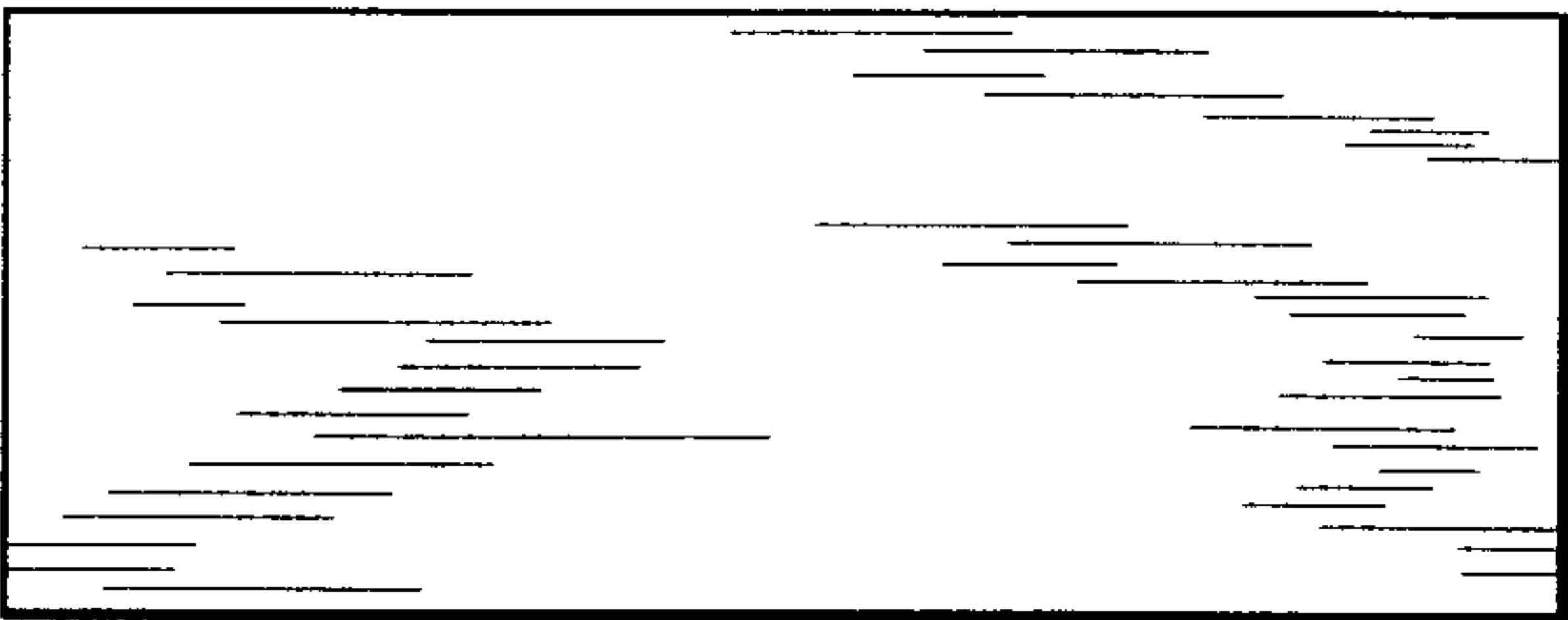

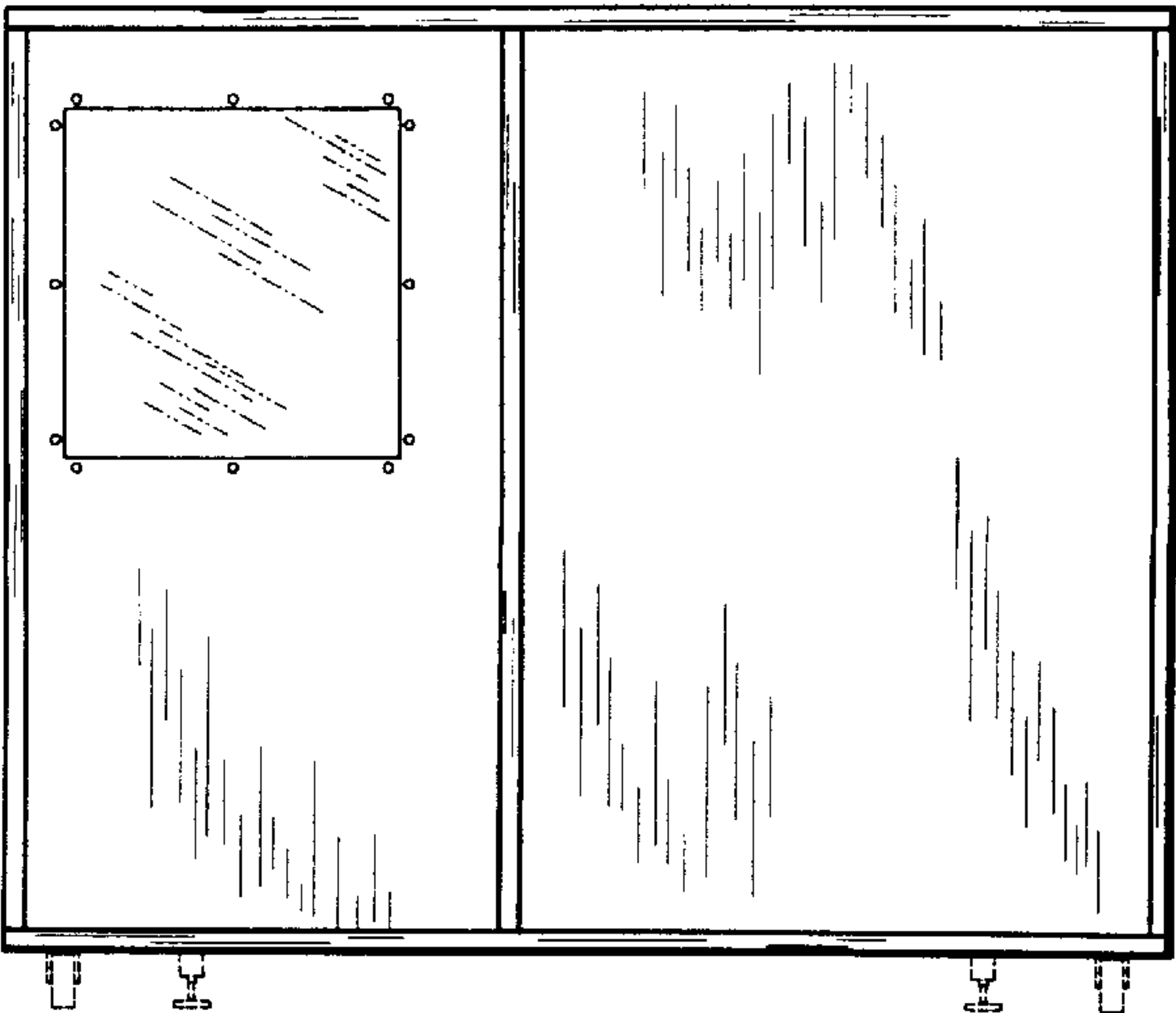

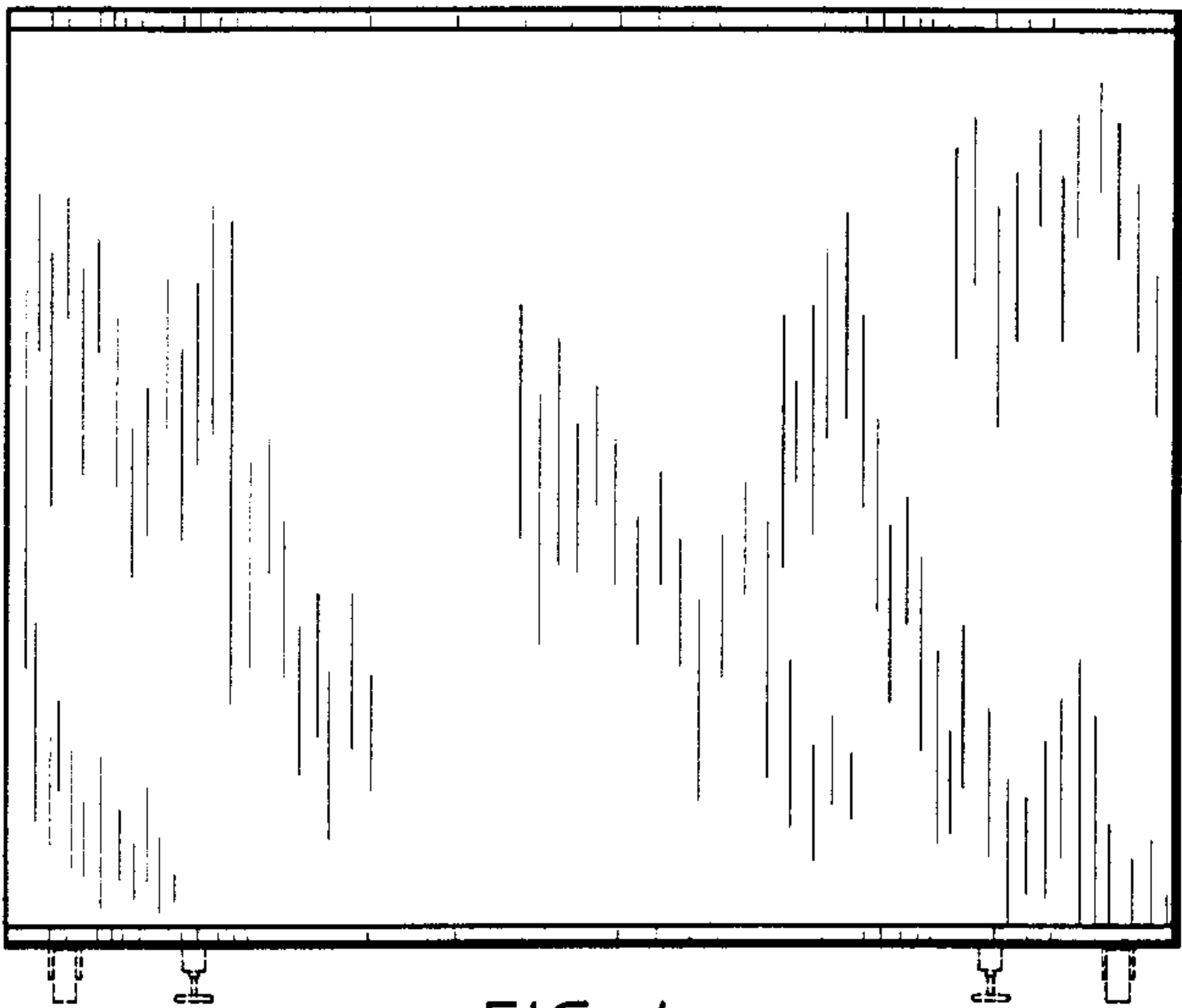

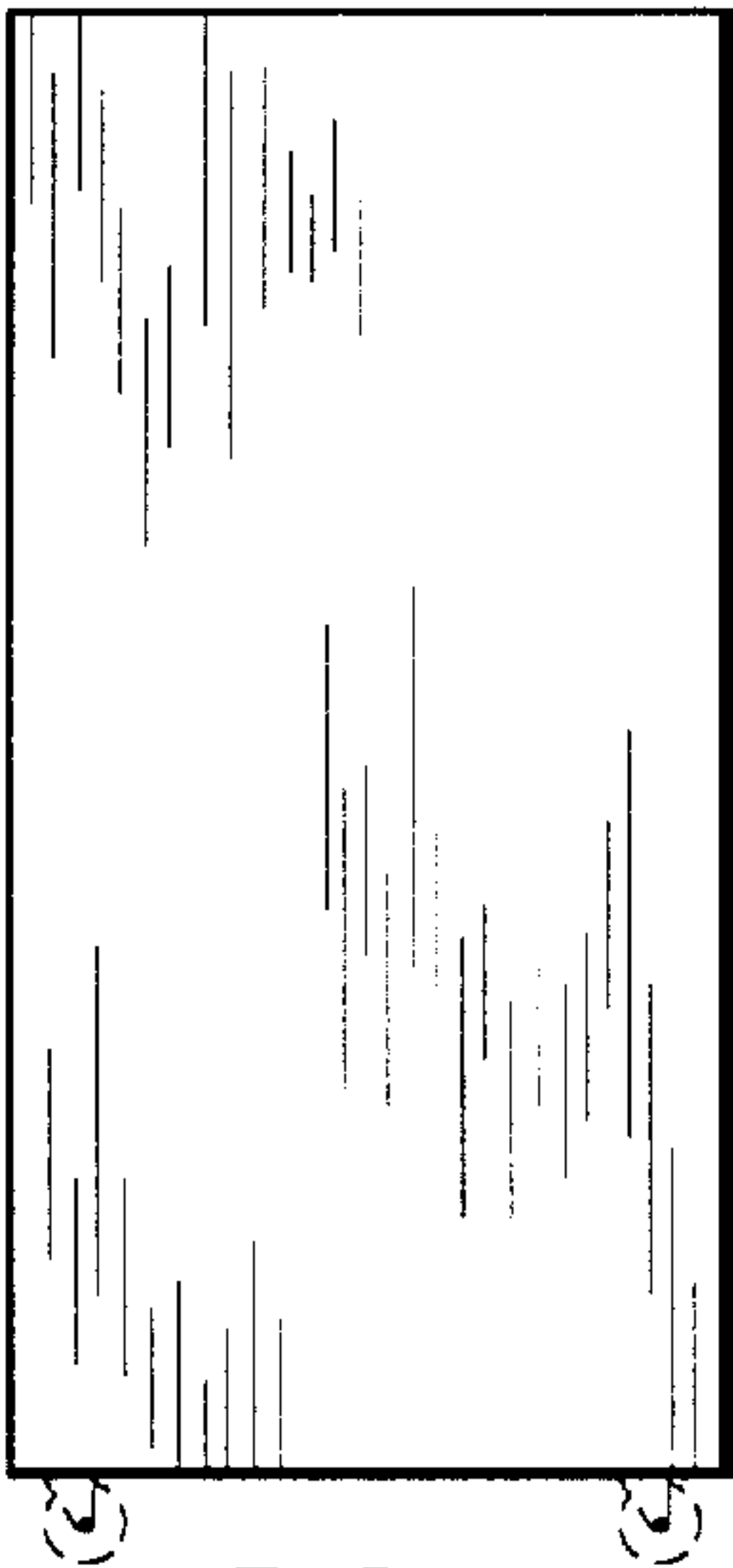

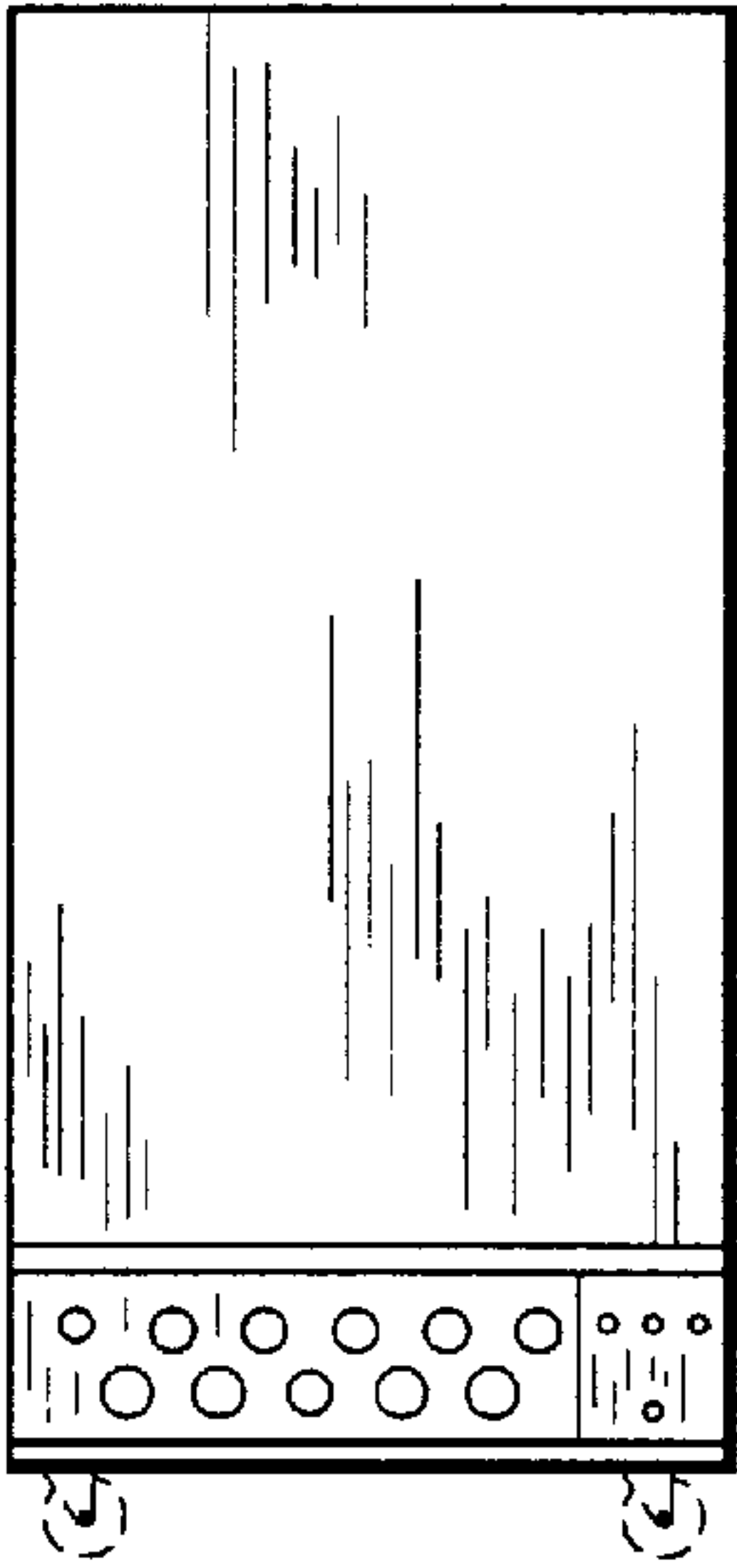

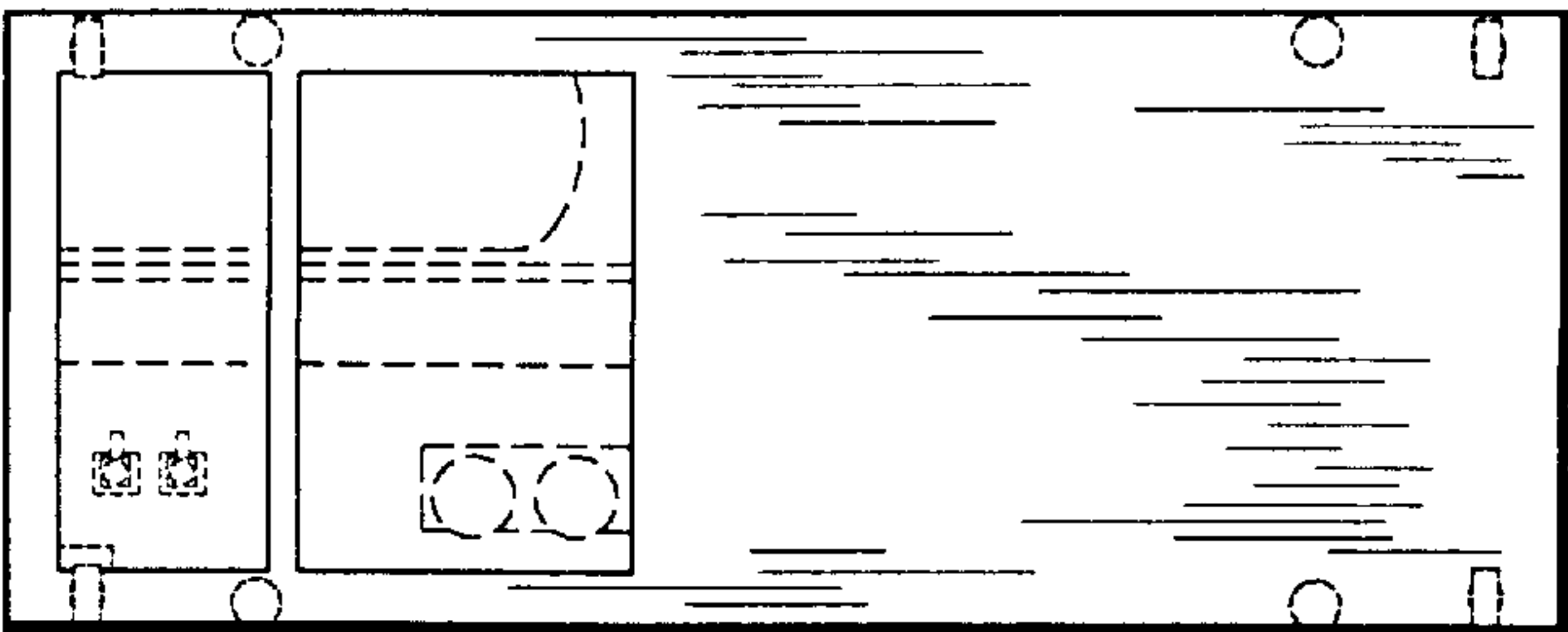
