FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the design shown in FIG. 5;

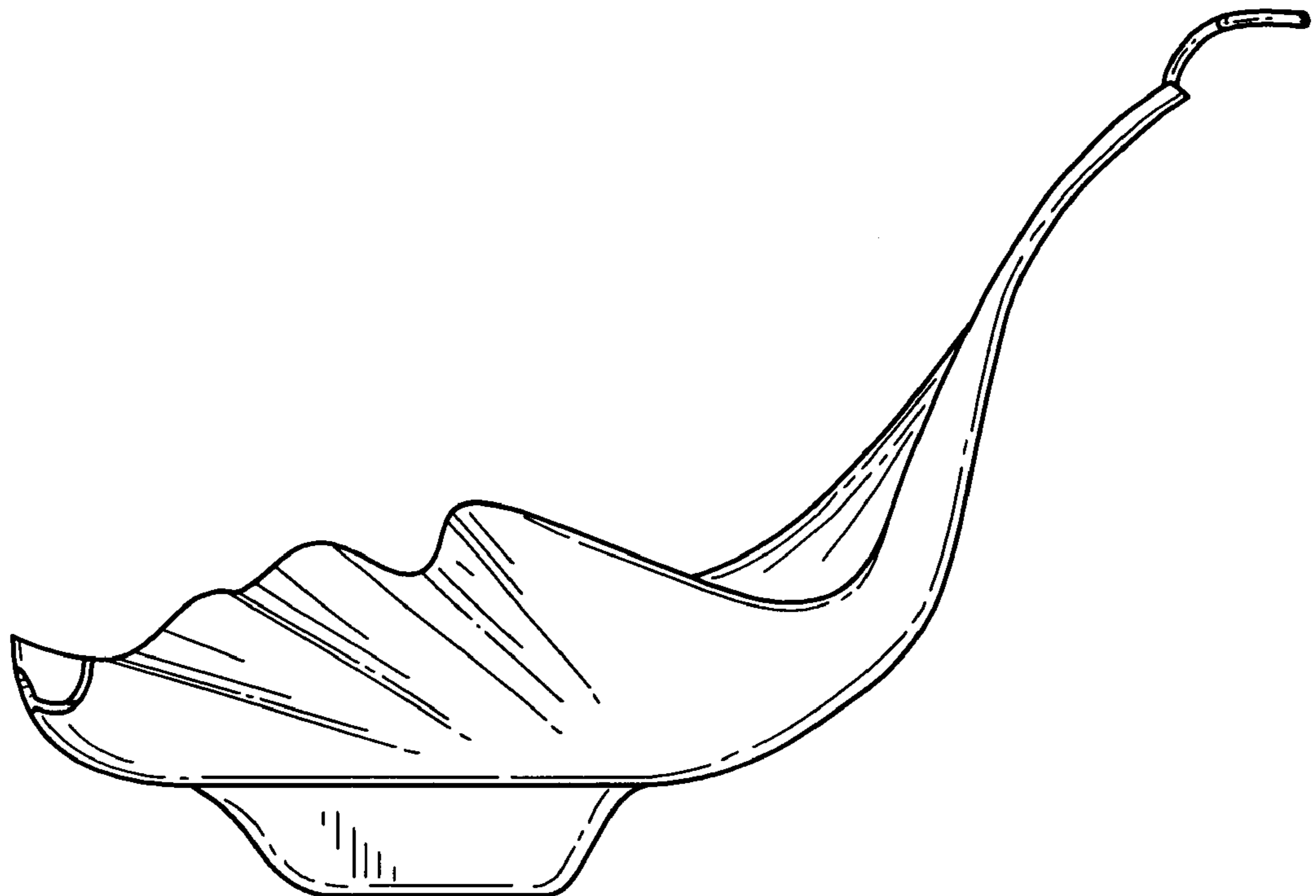
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the design shown in FIG. 1; and,

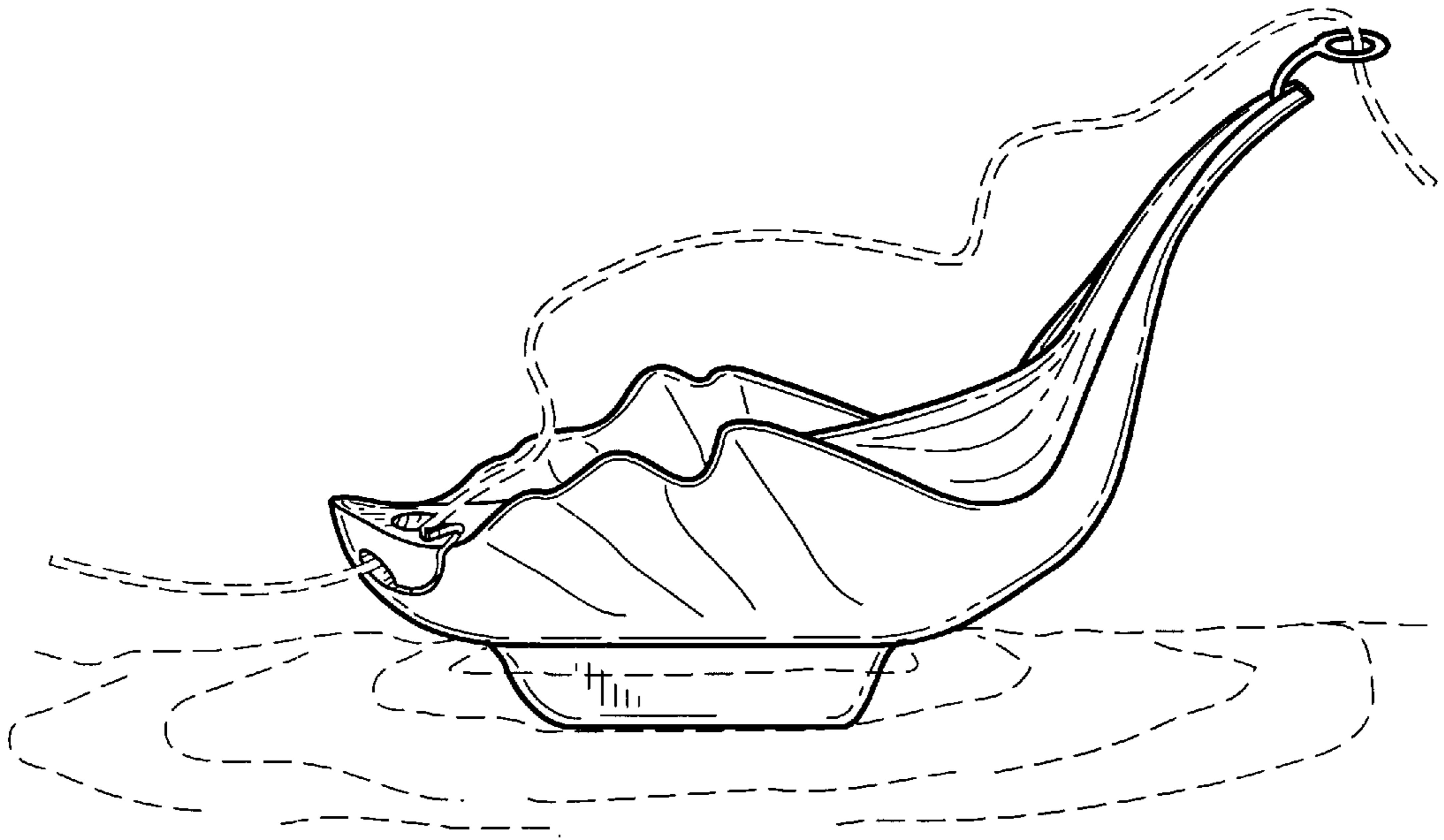

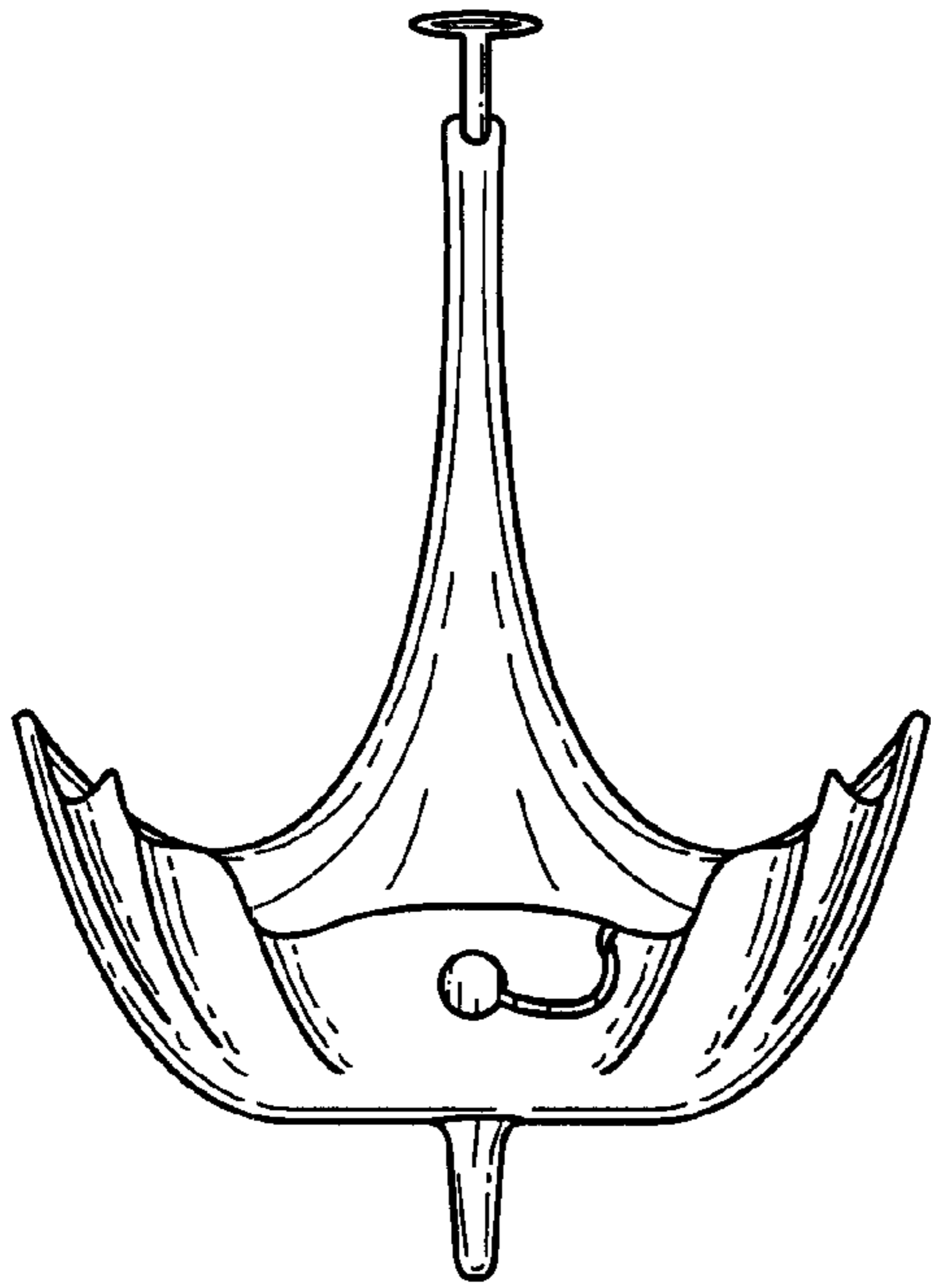

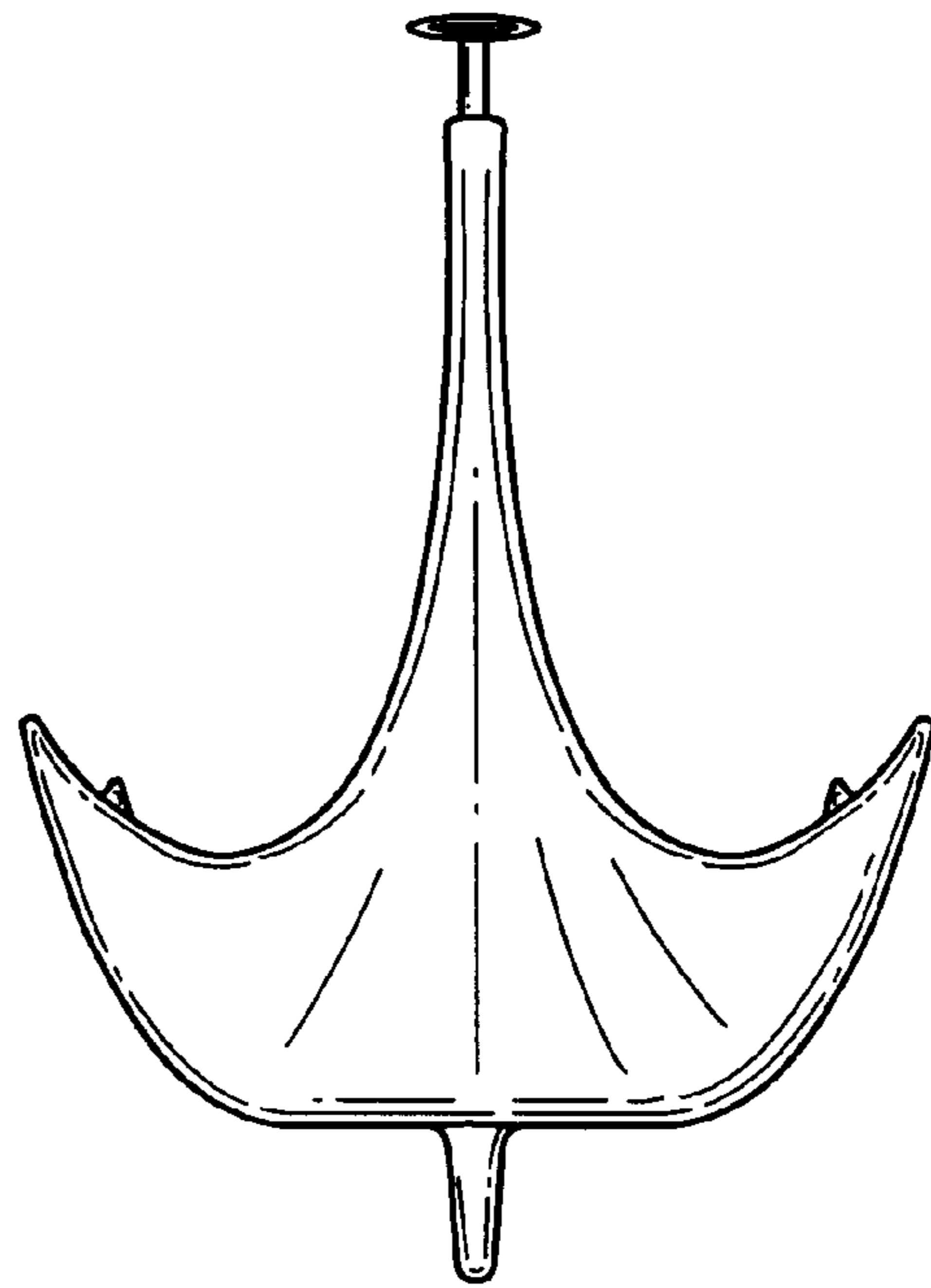

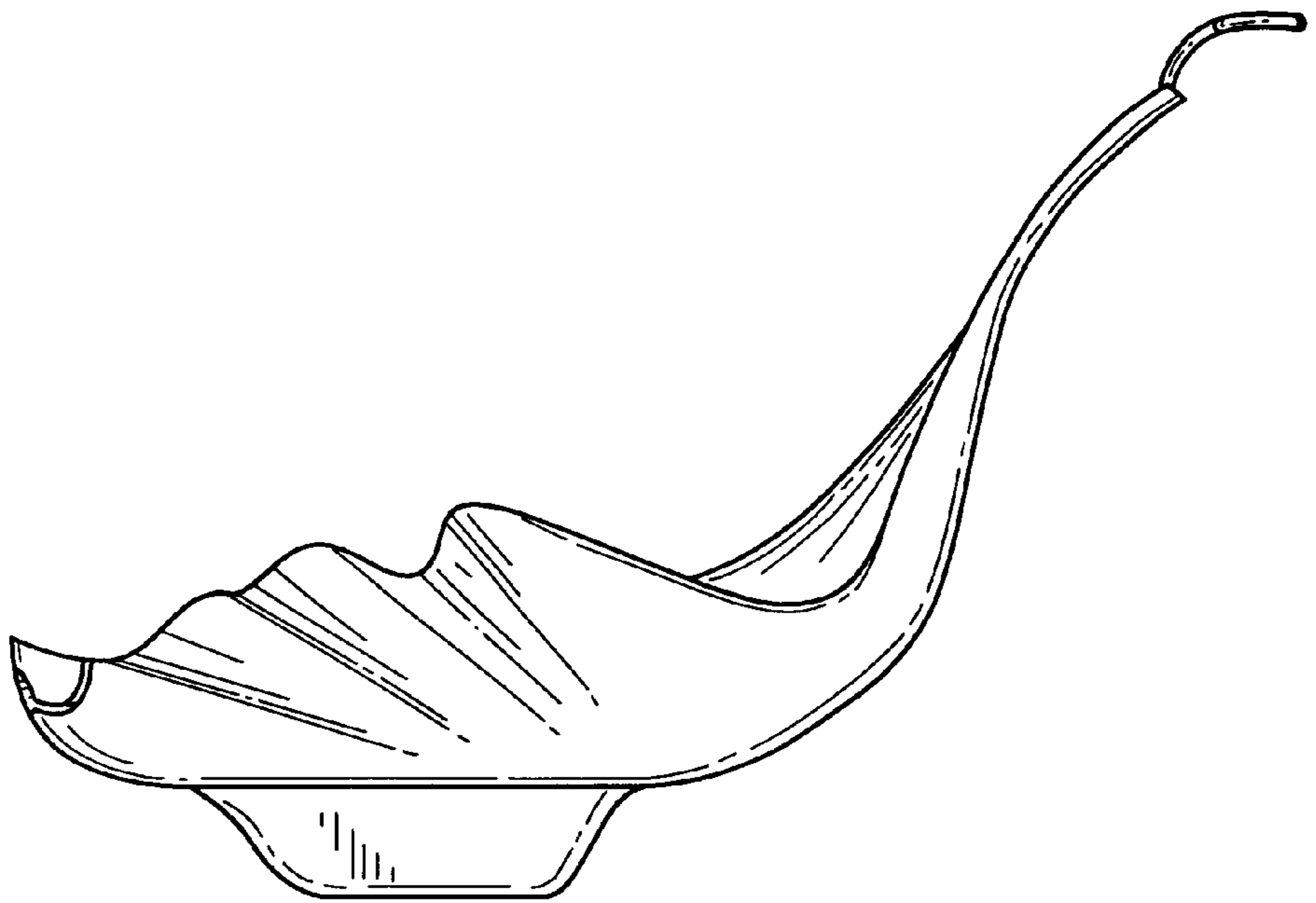

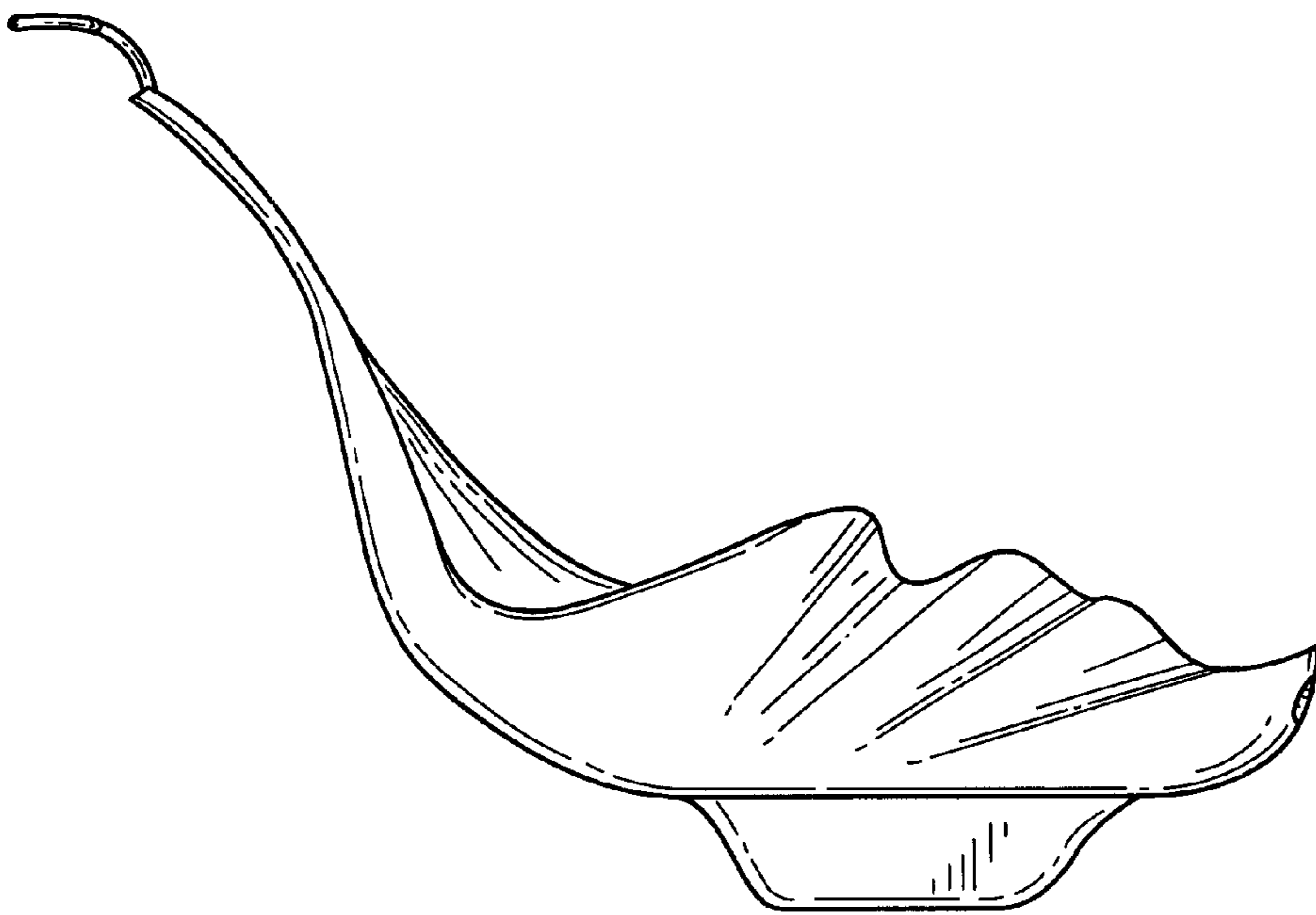

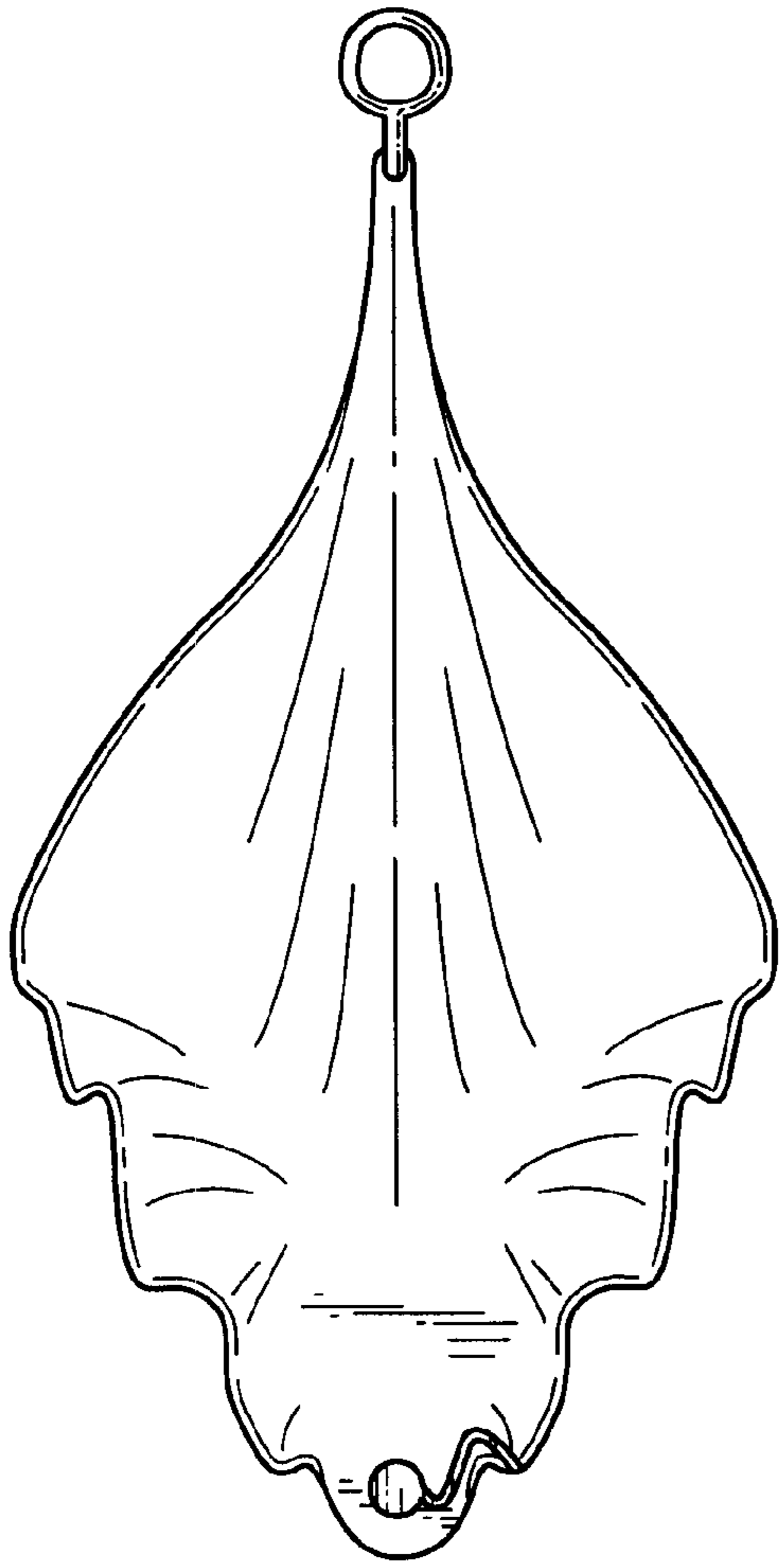

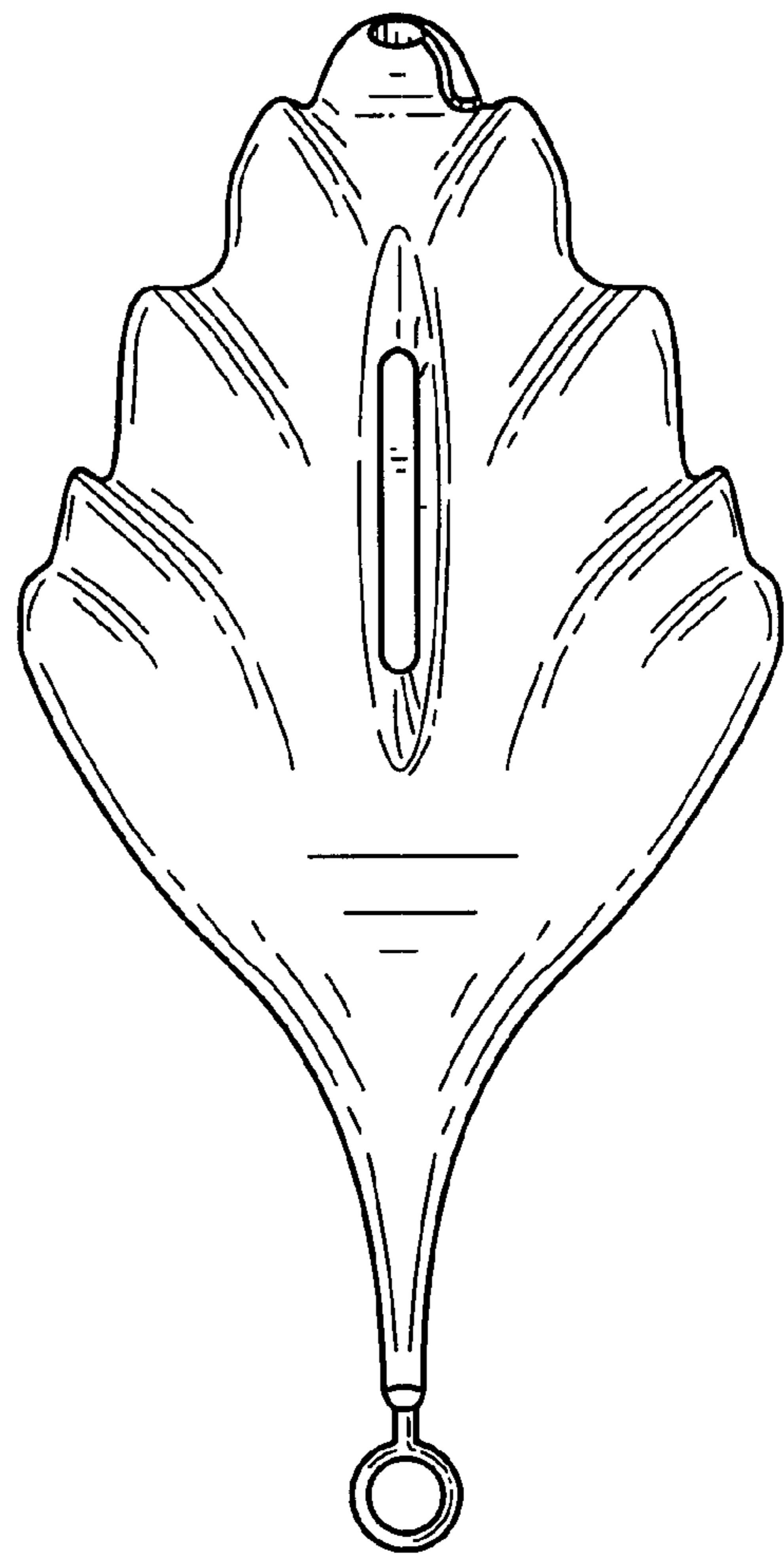
