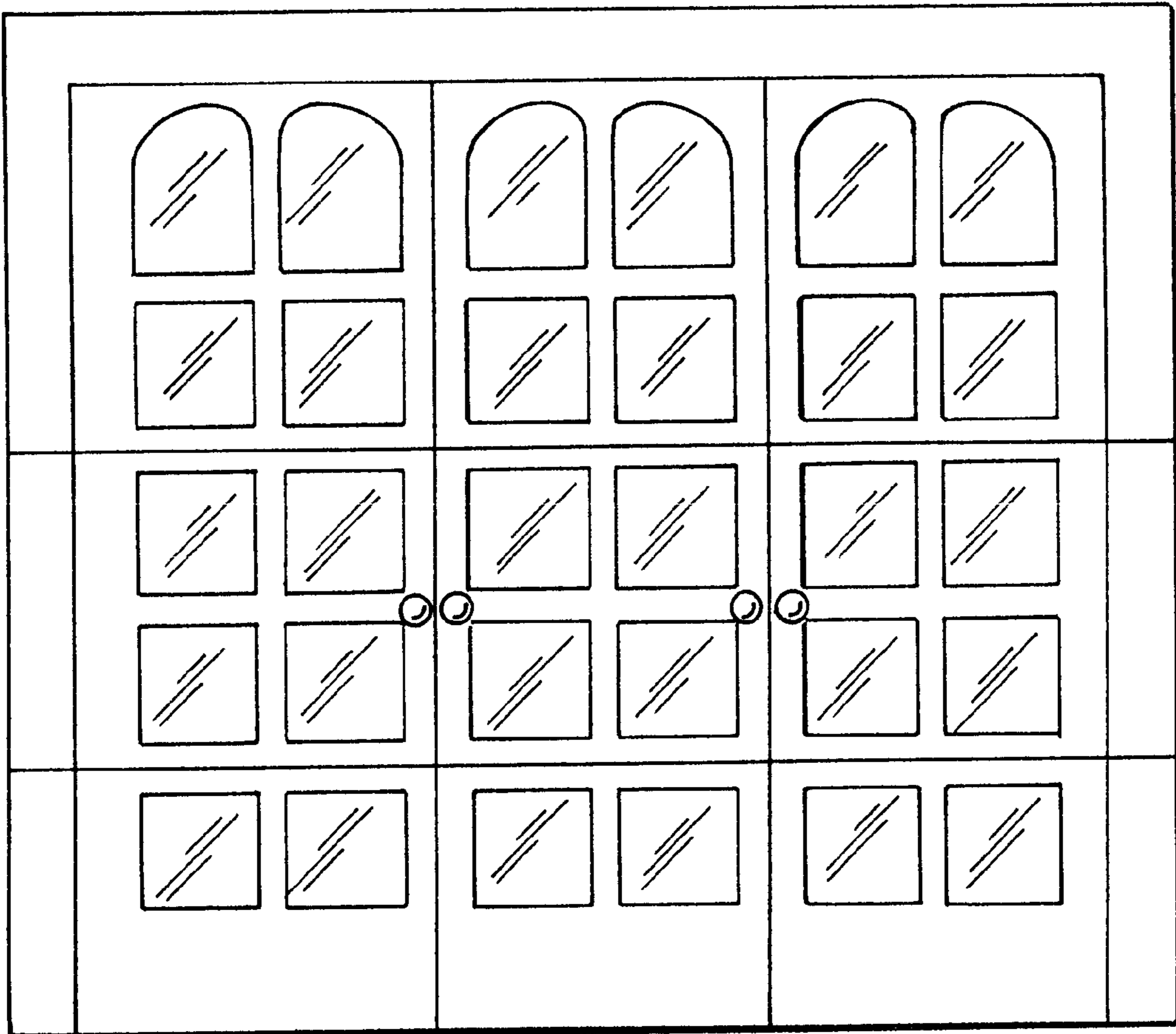
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a faux french garage door, showing my new design;

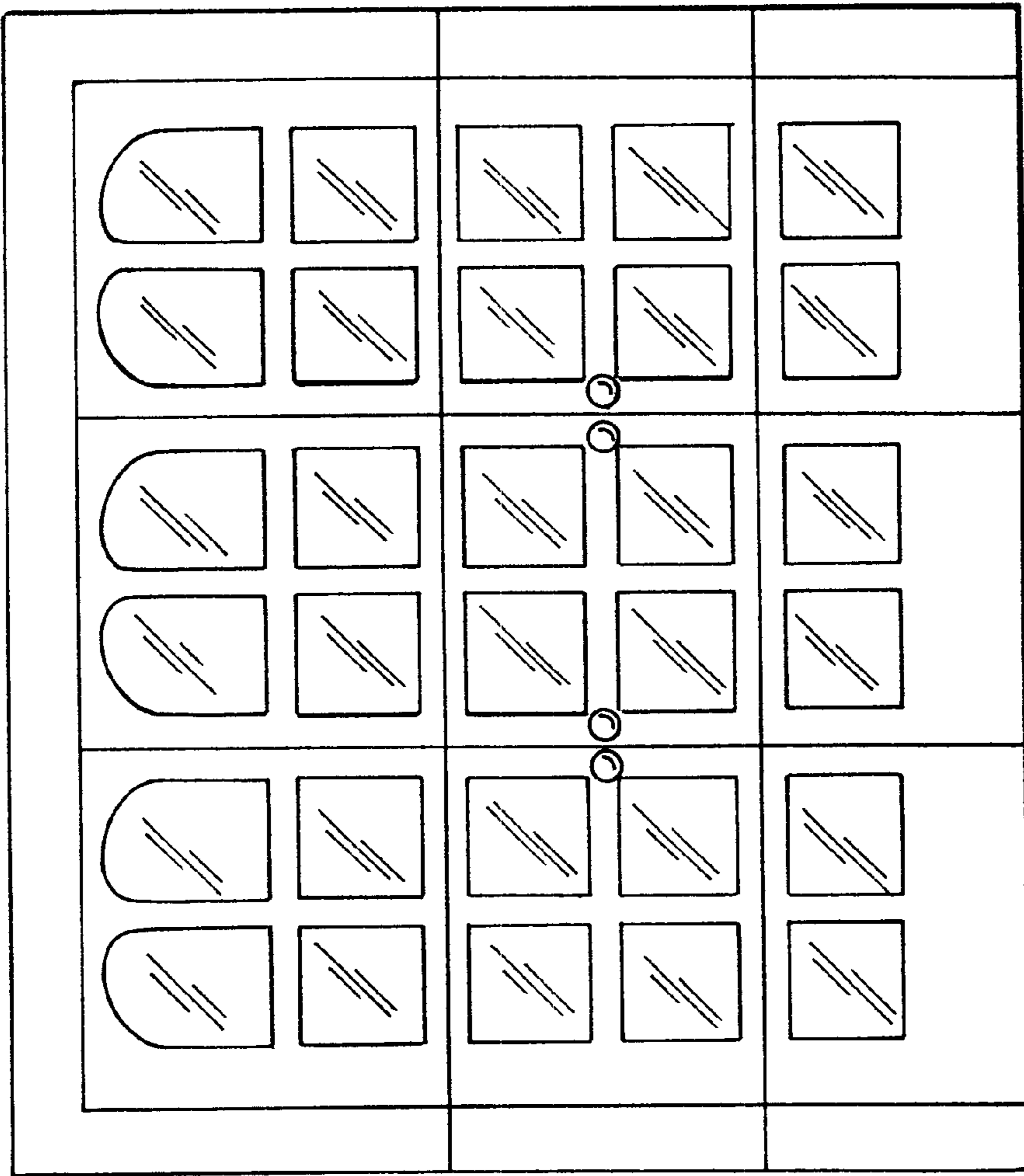

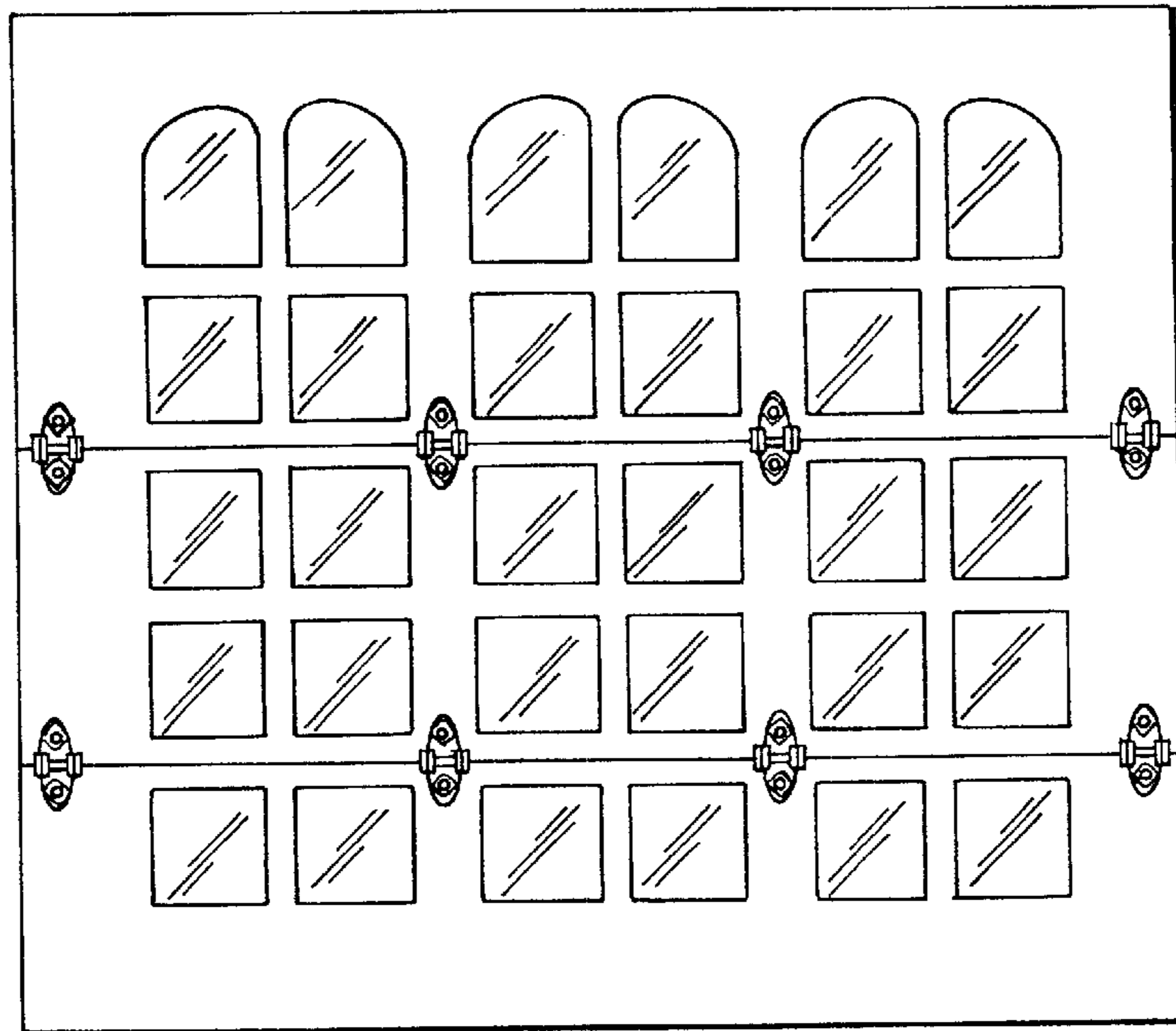

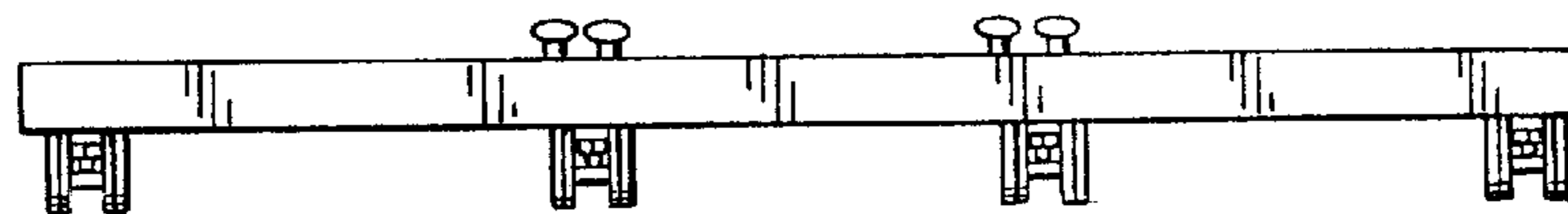
