(57) **CLAIM**

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

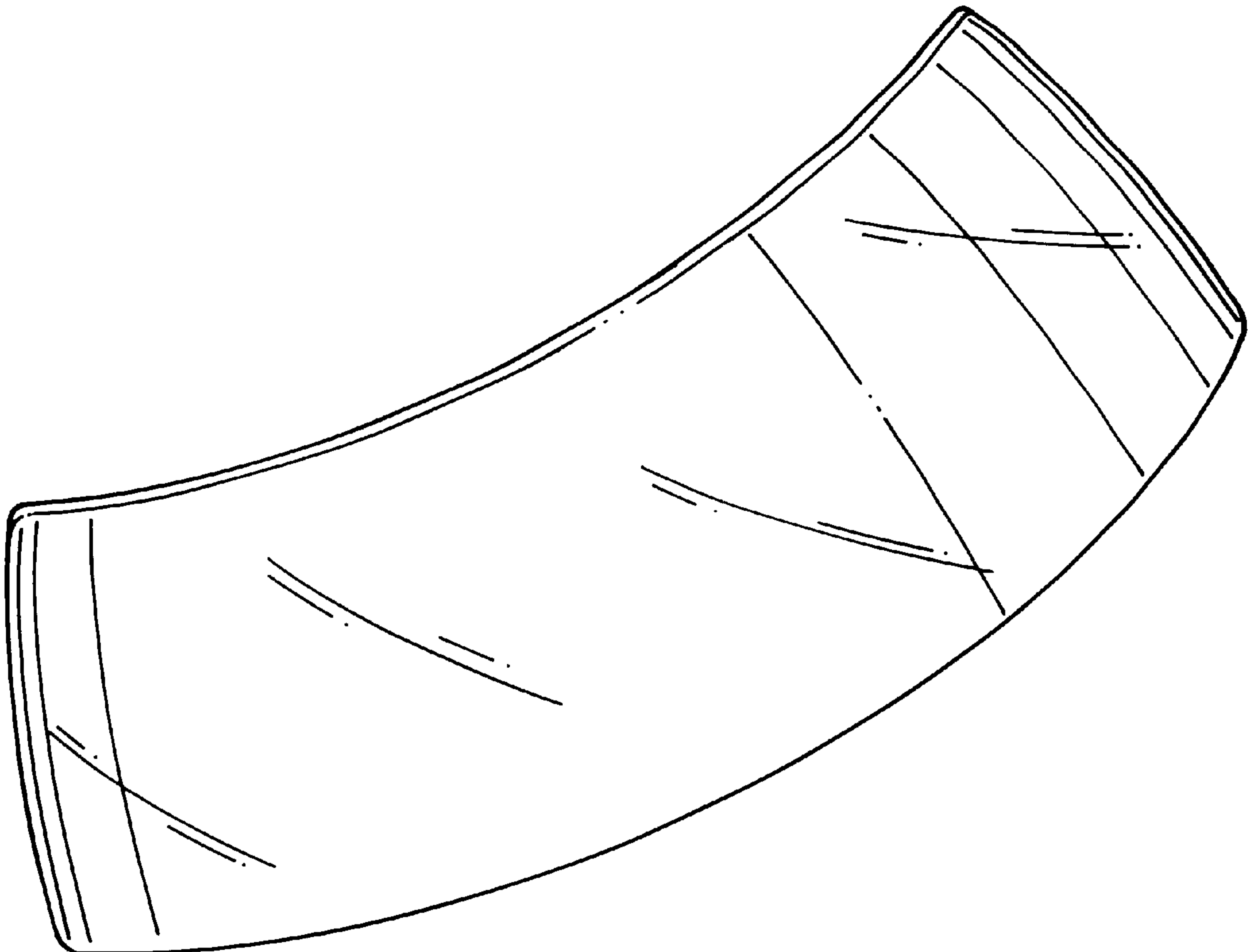
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

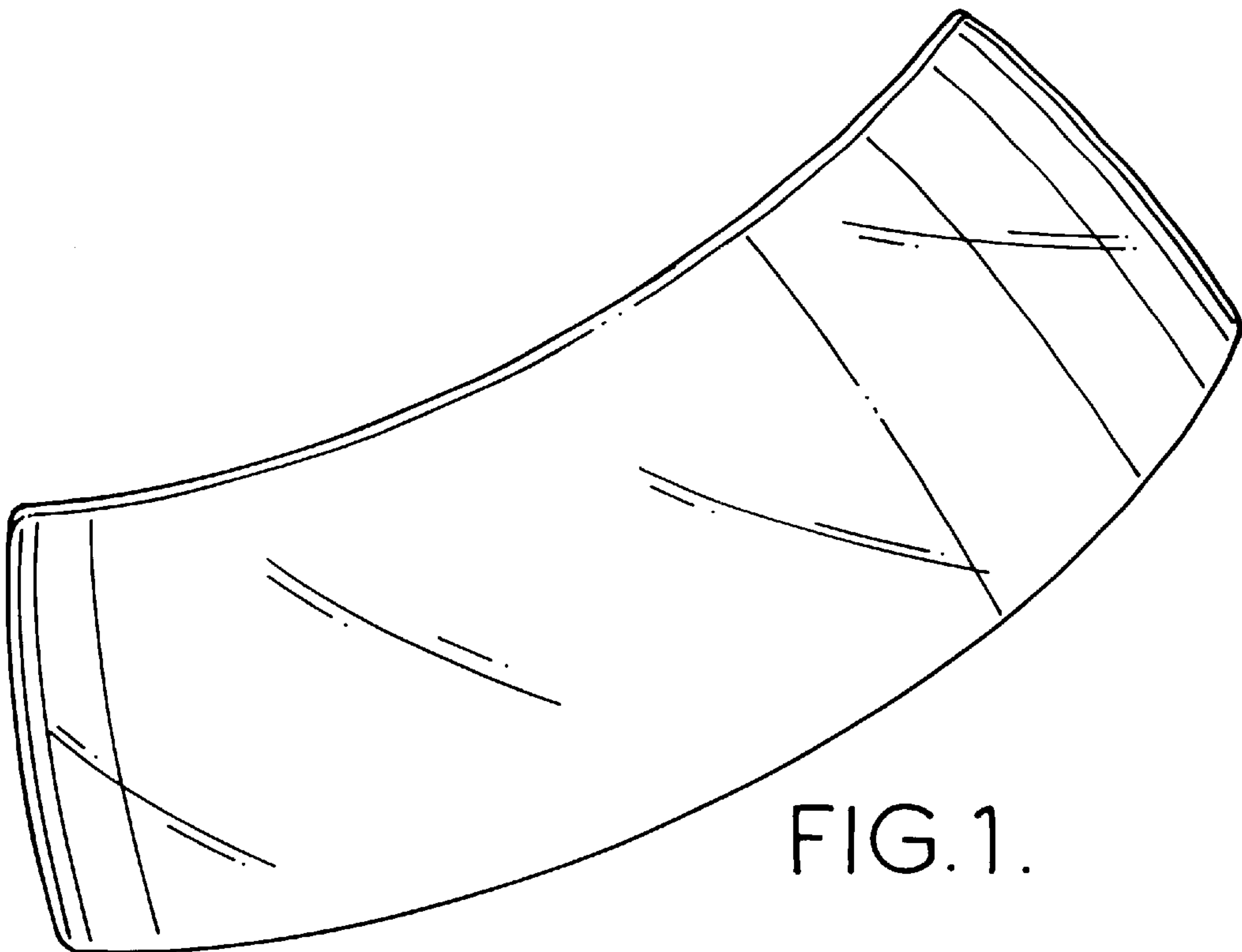

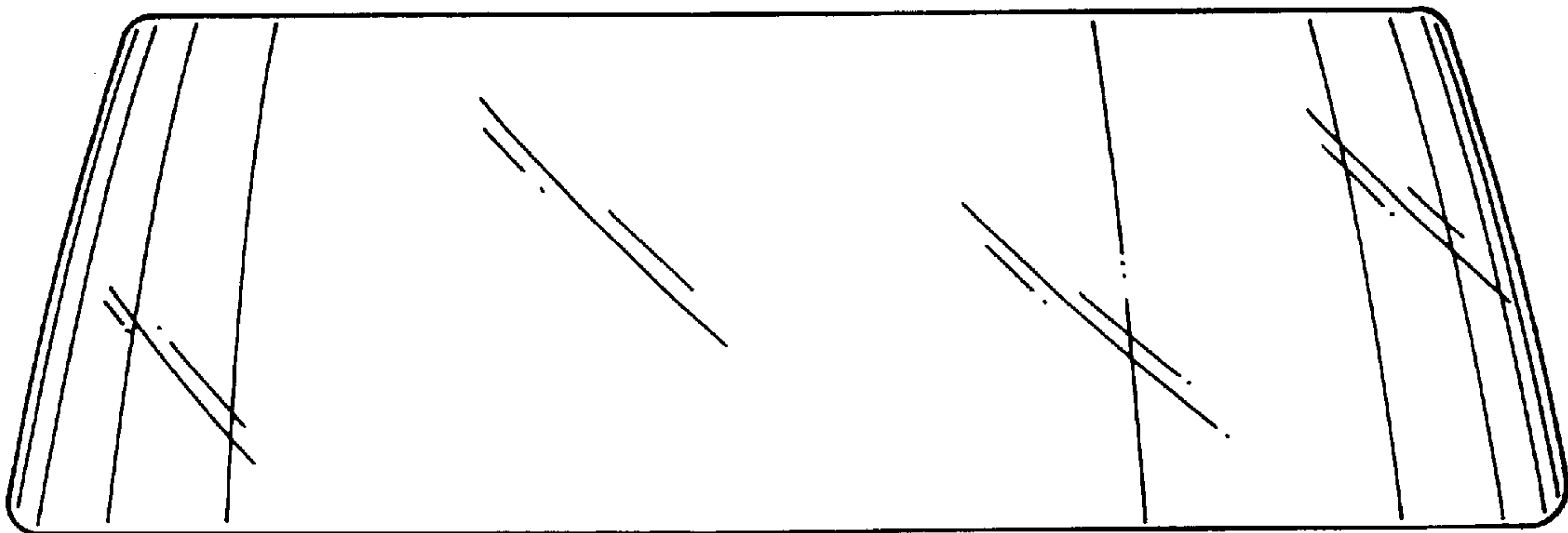

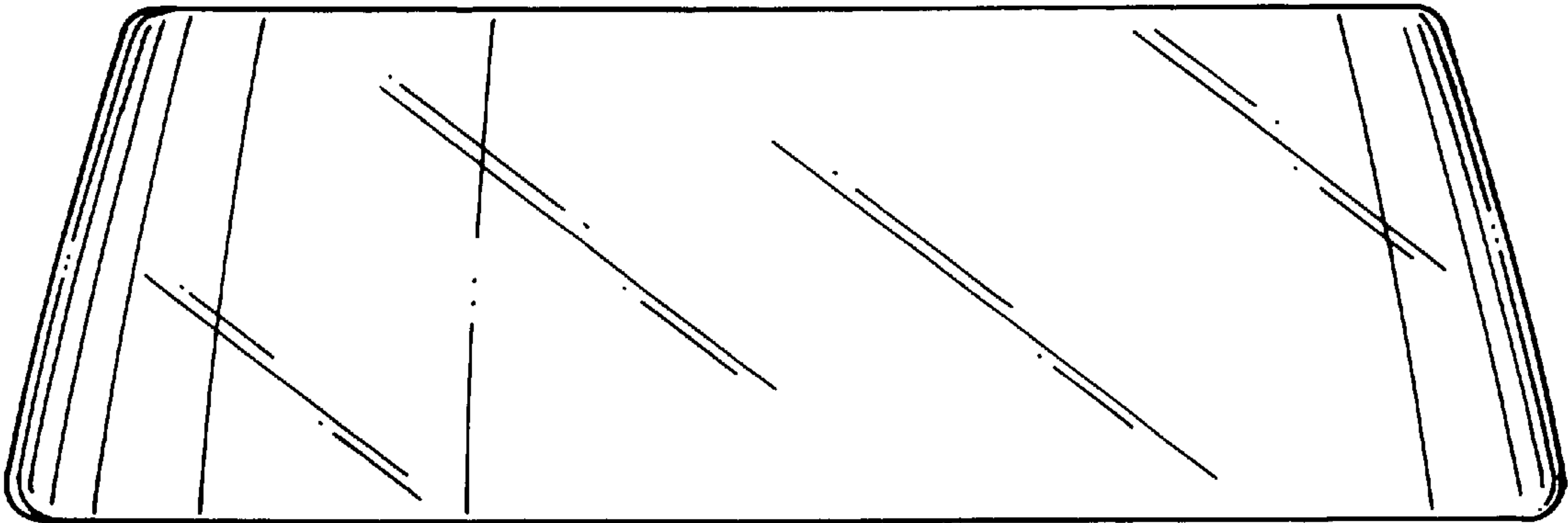

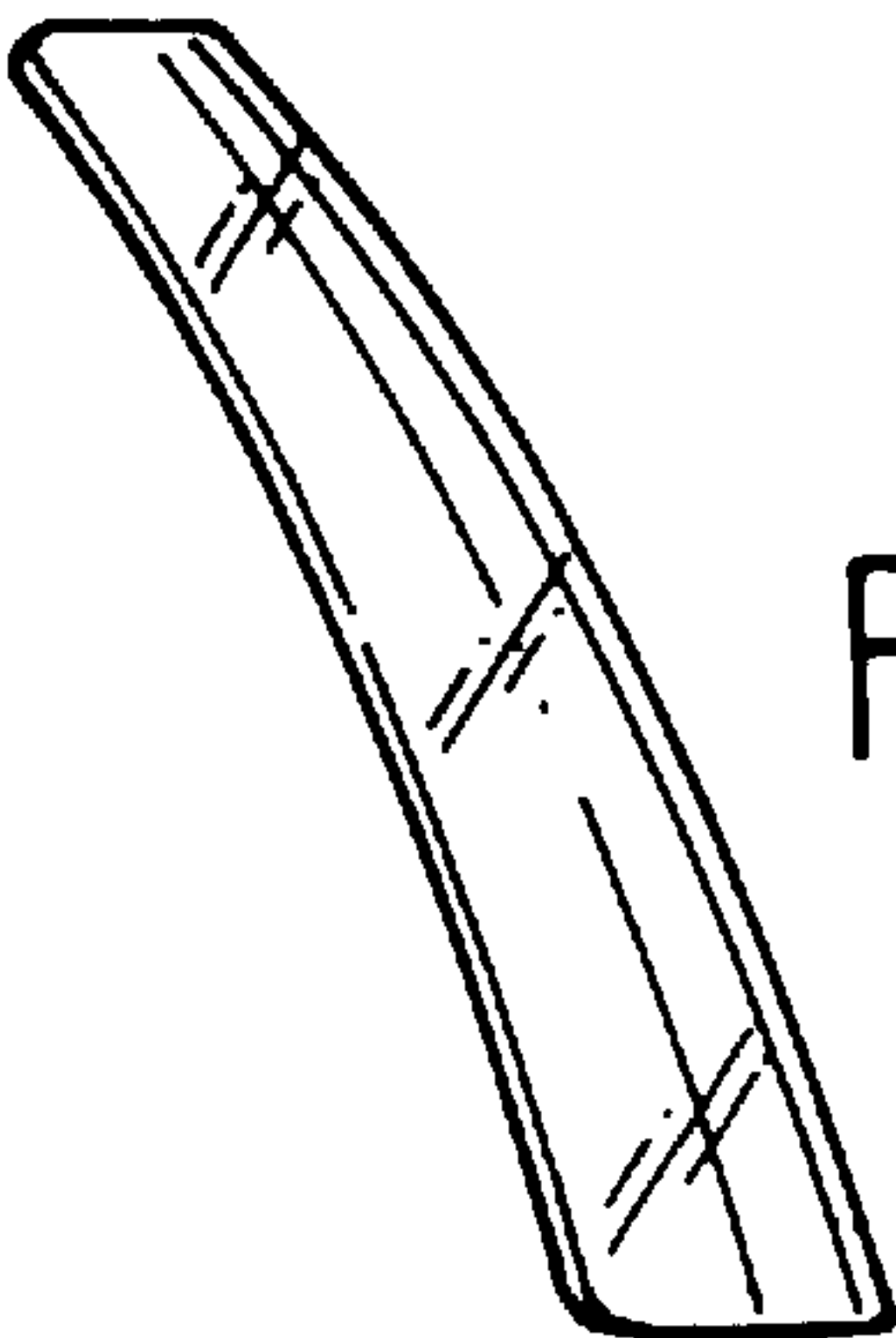

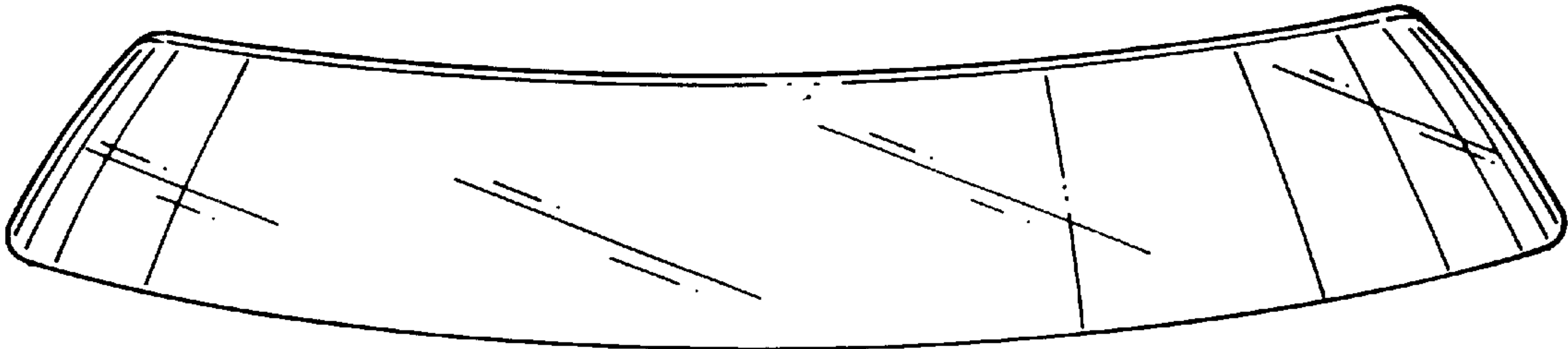
