(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a support for portable telephones or similar devices, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of my invention, which comprises a support for portable telephones or similar devices.

FIG. 2 is a side view of my support for portable telephones or similar devices shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of my support for portable telephones or similar devices shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a first bottom perspective view of my support for portable telephones or similar devices shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a back view of my support for portable telephones or similar devices shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a second bottom perspective view of my support for portable telephones or similar devices shown in FIG. 1.

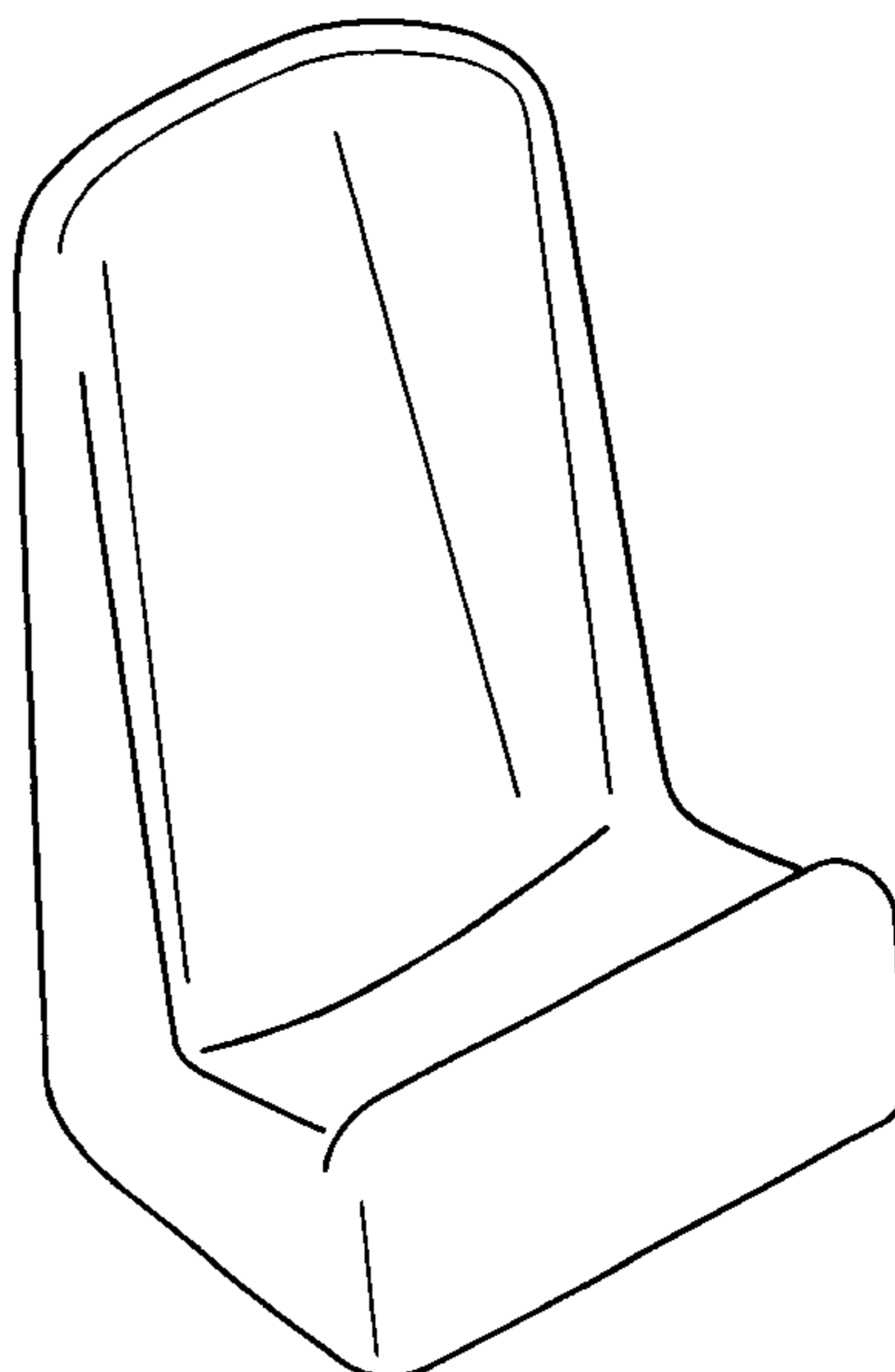
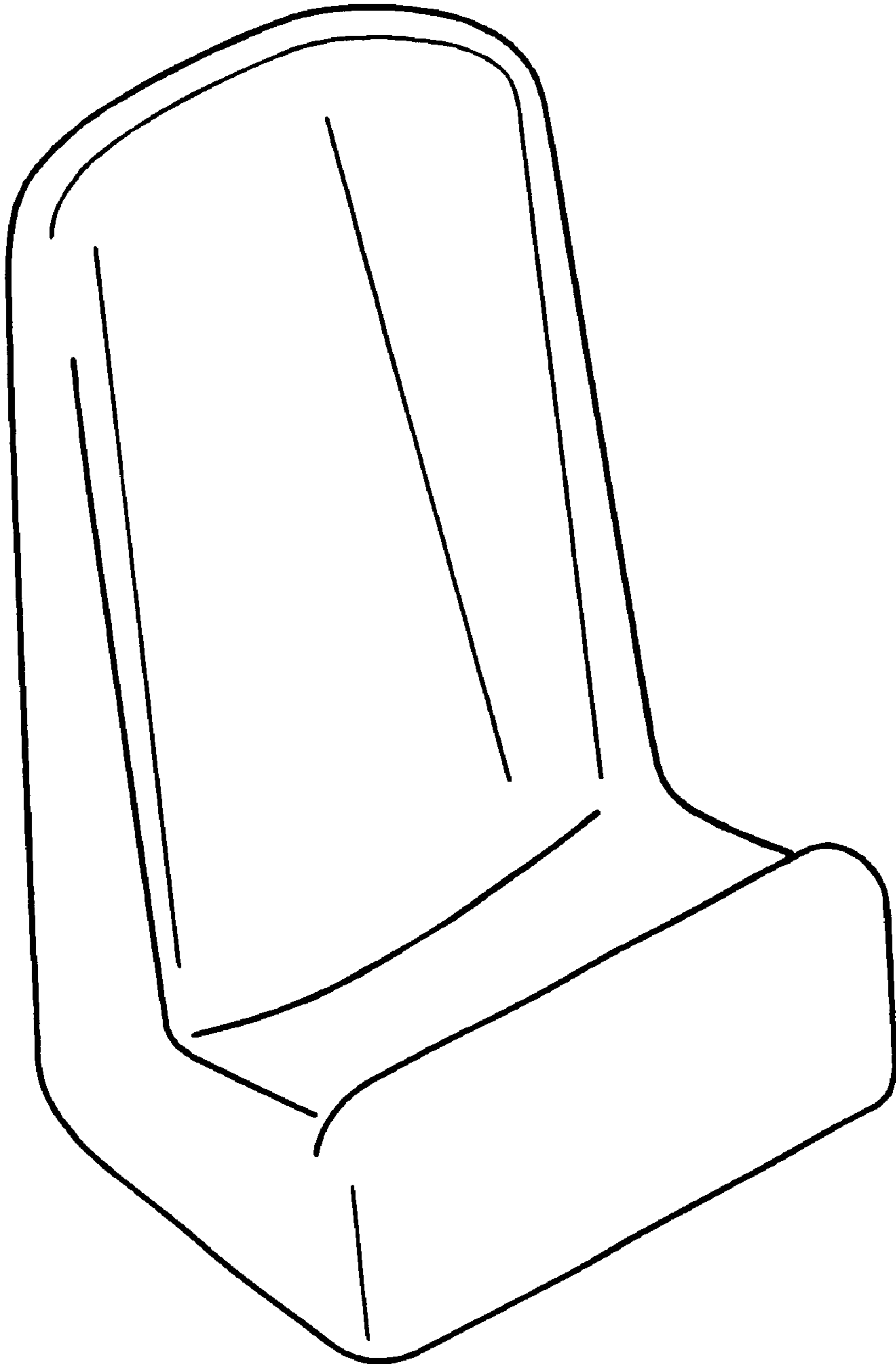

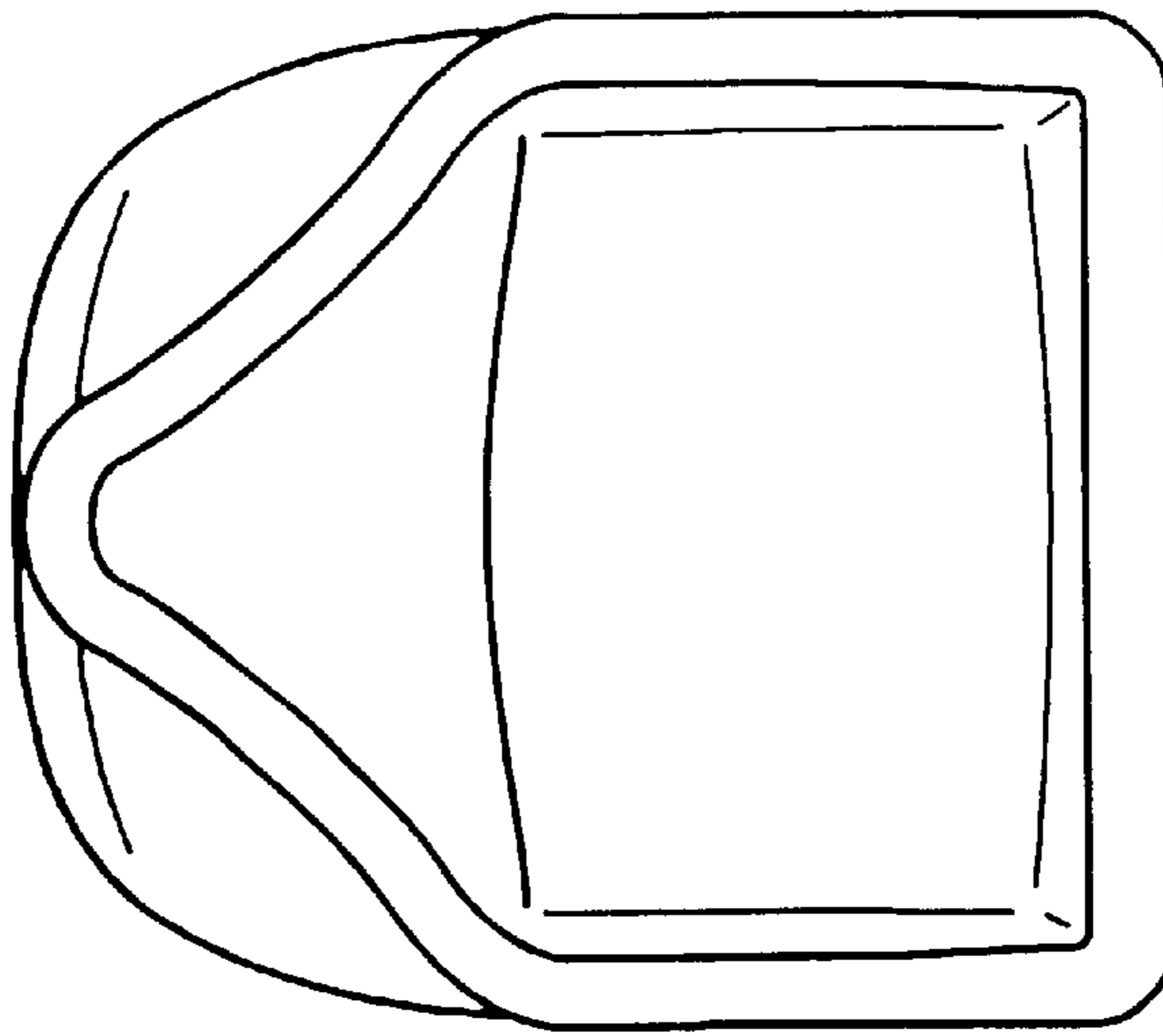

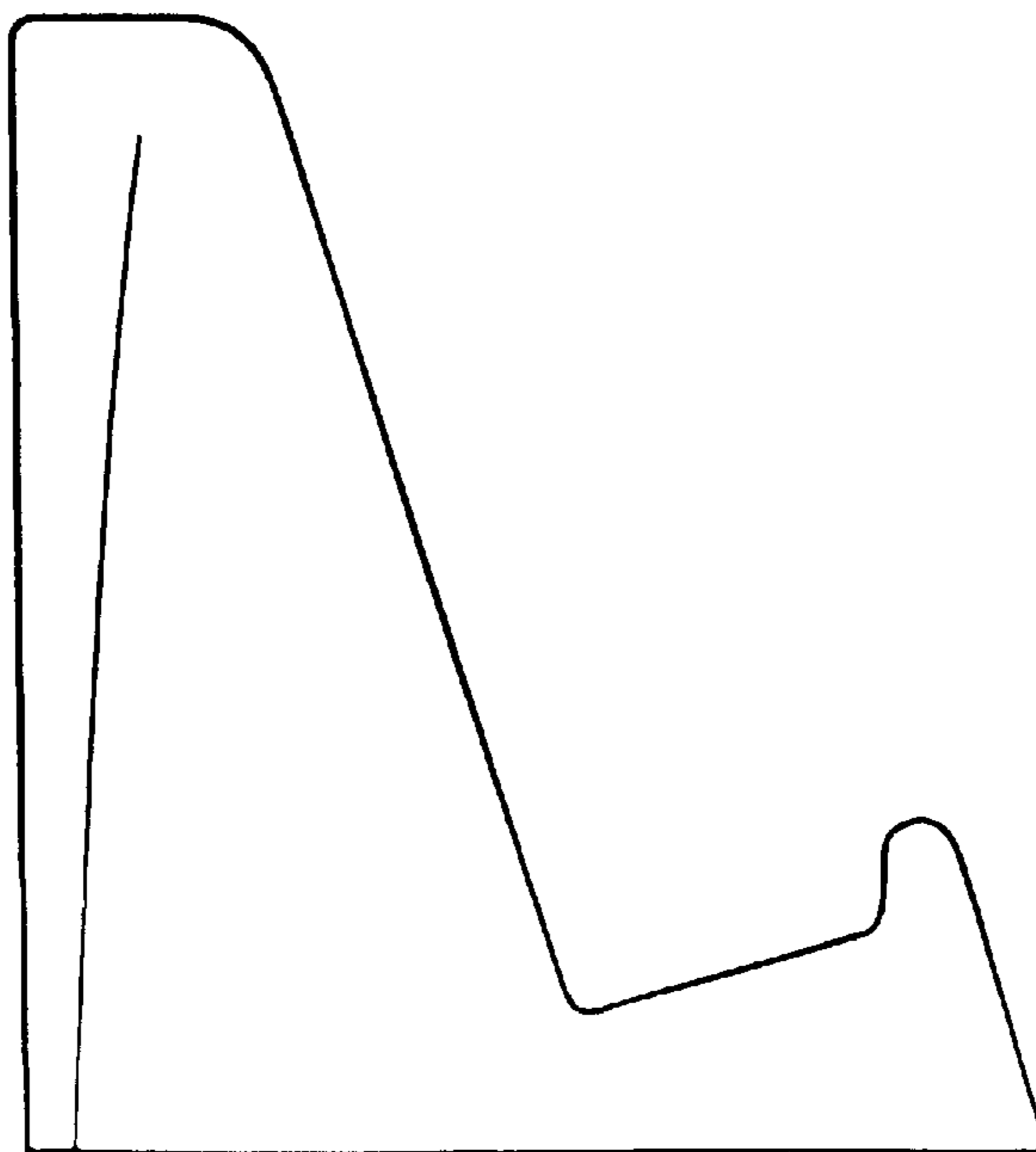

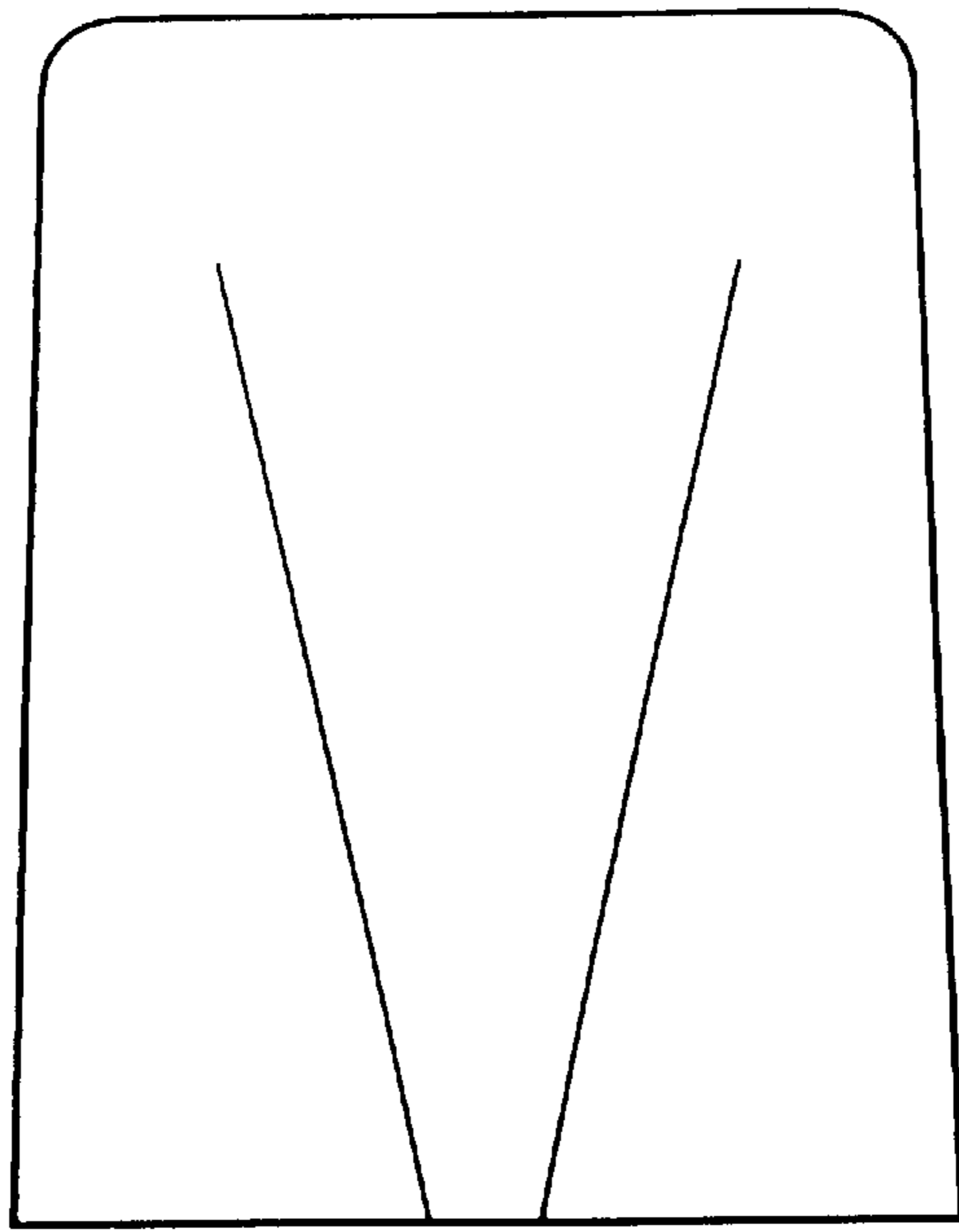

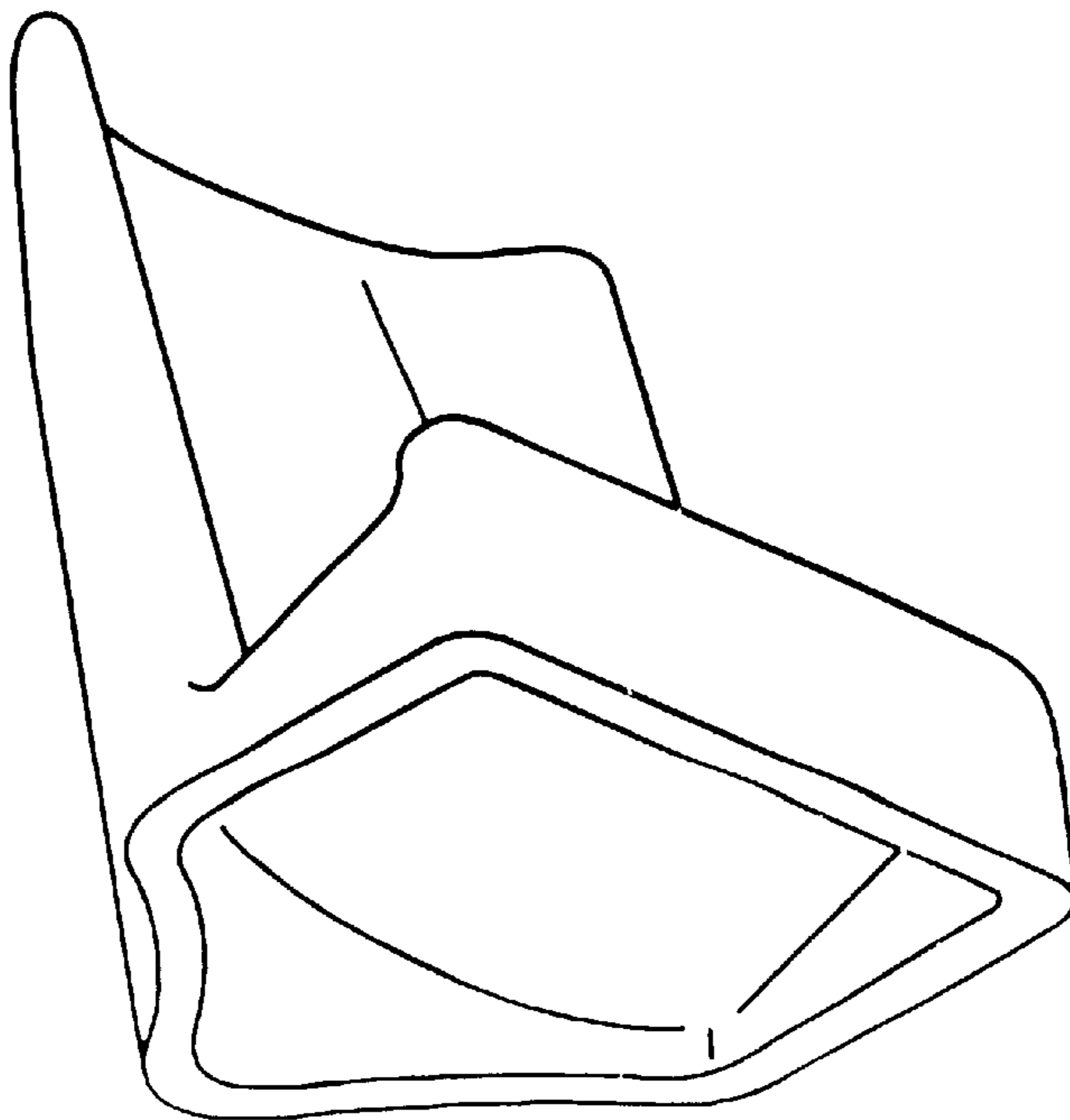

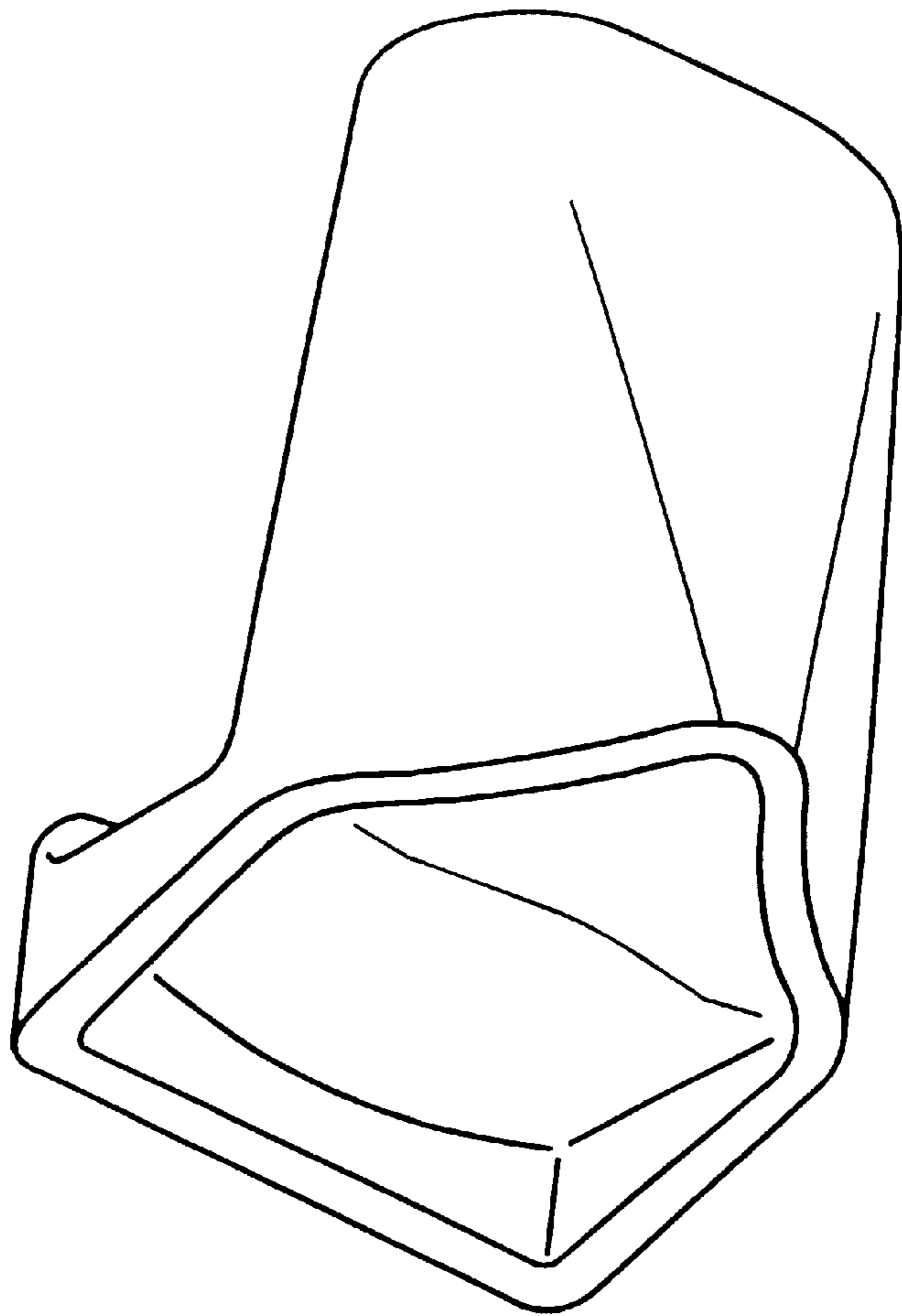

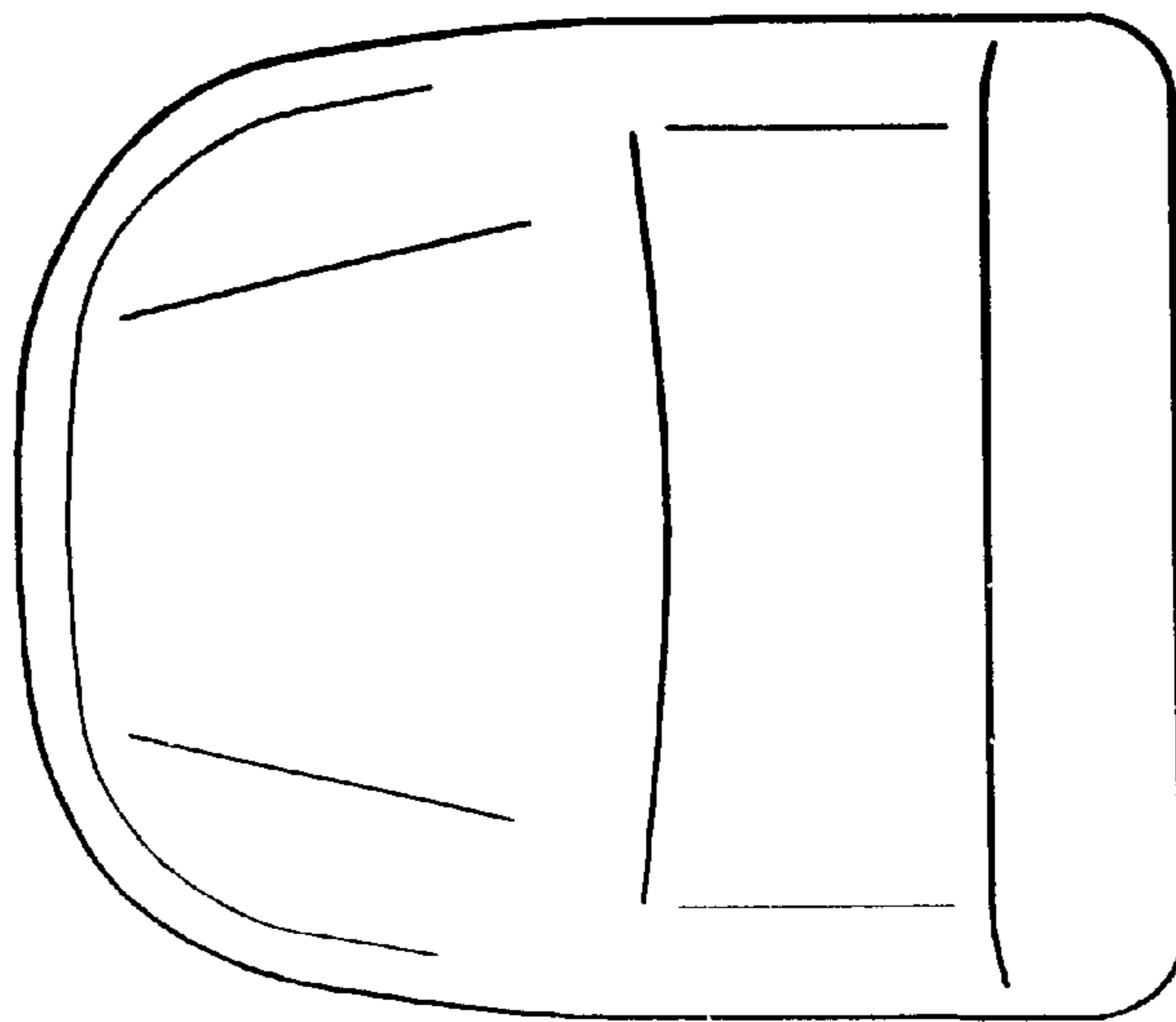

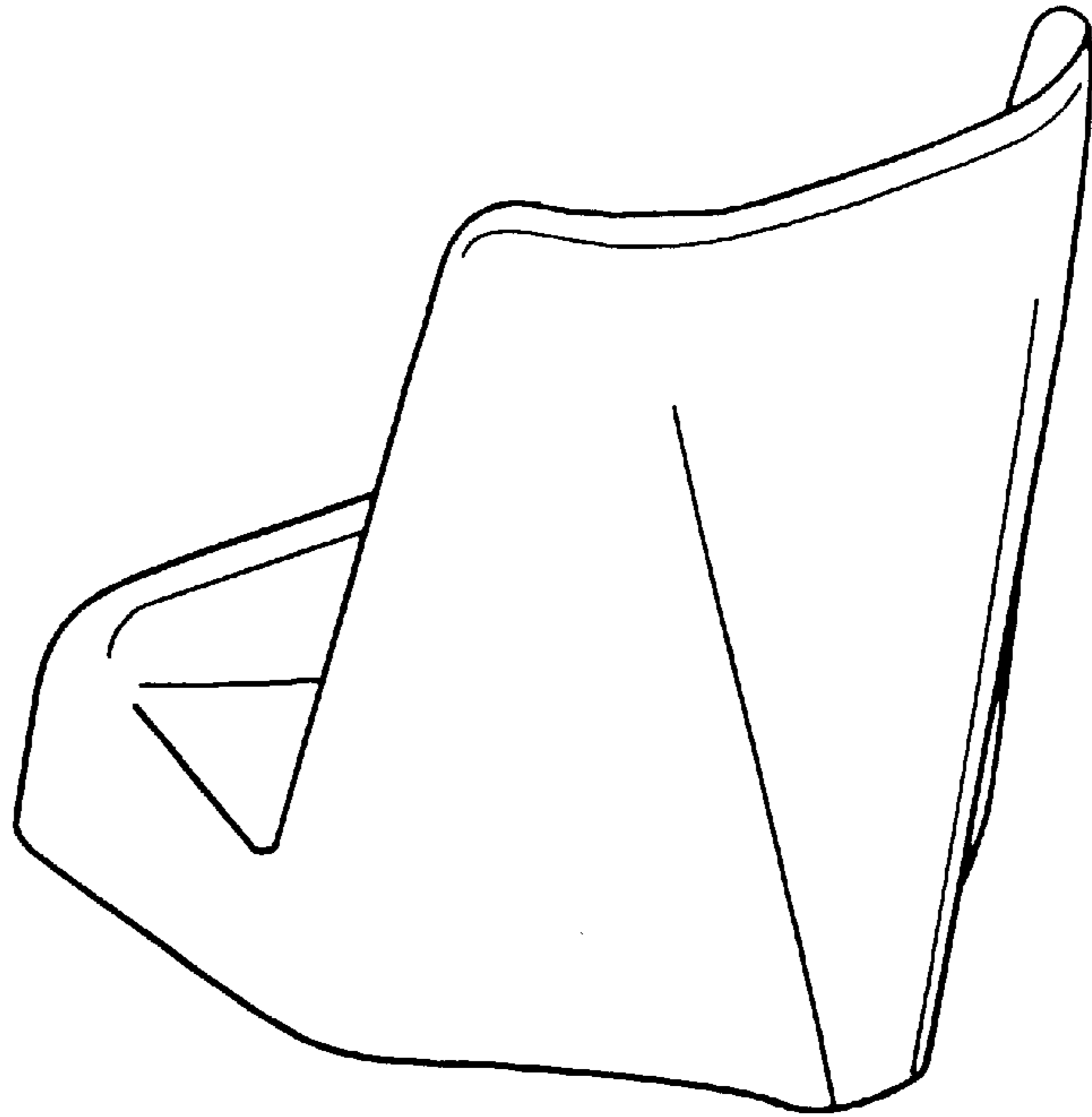
