FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof, with a container shown in broken lines.

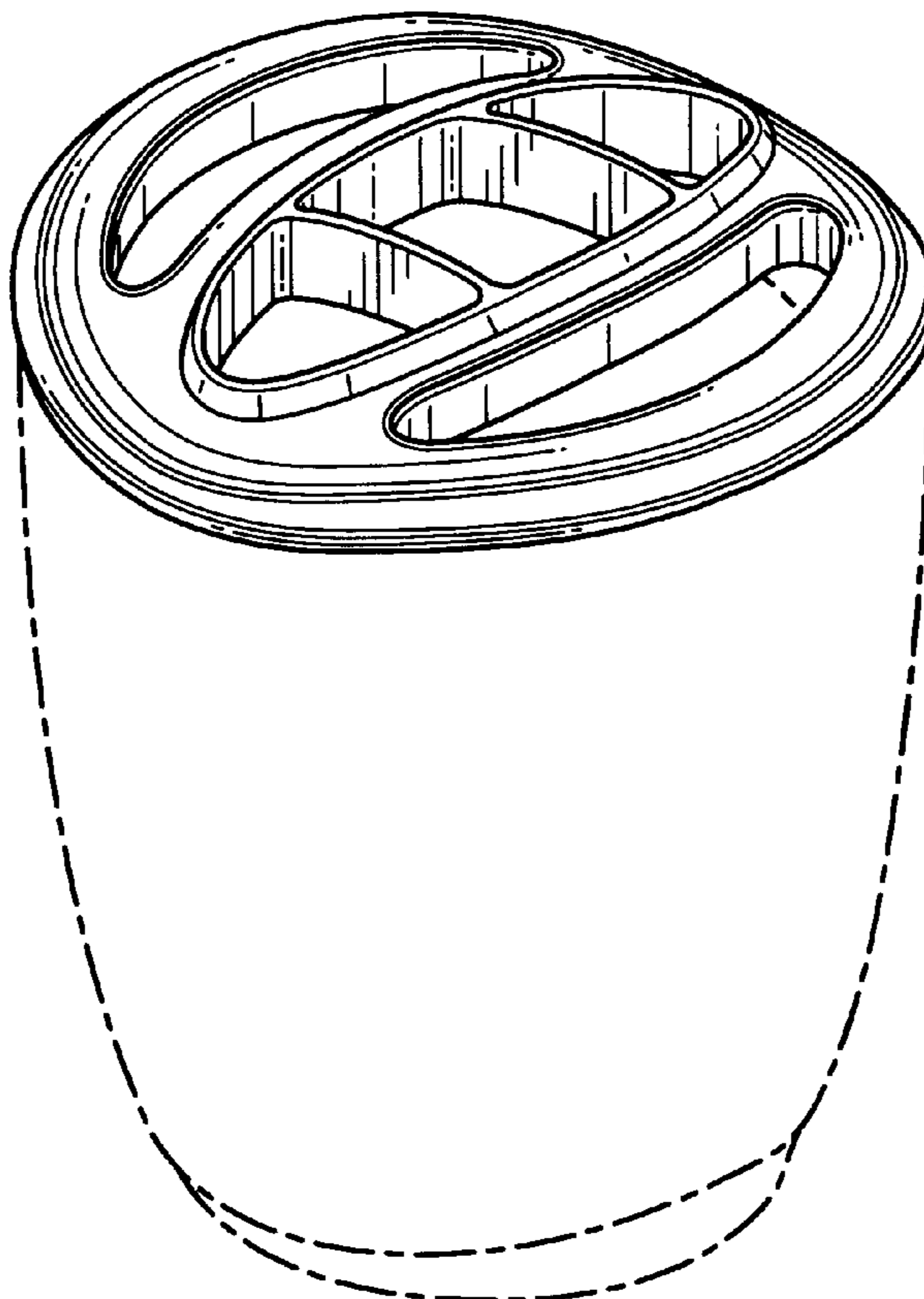

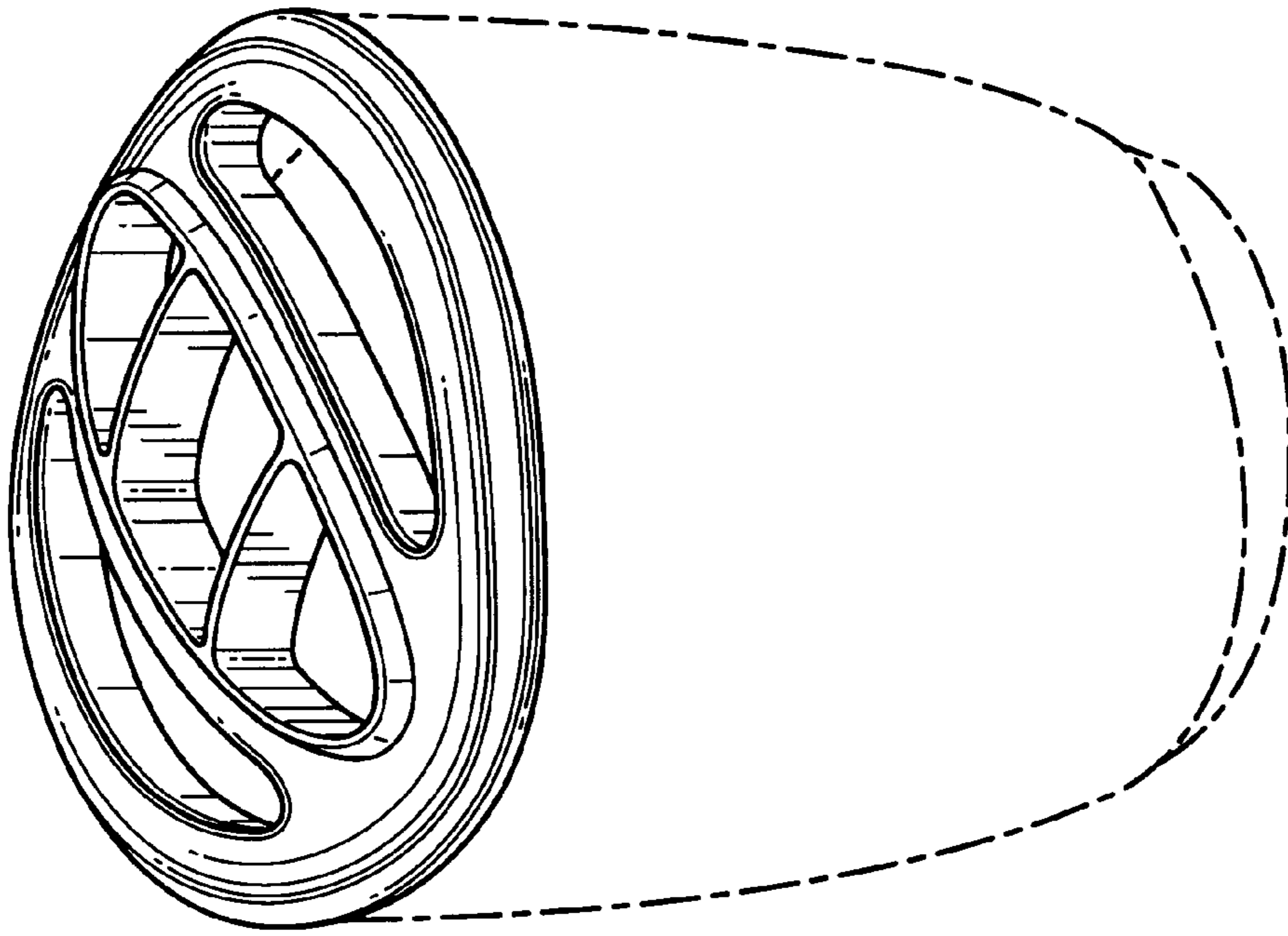

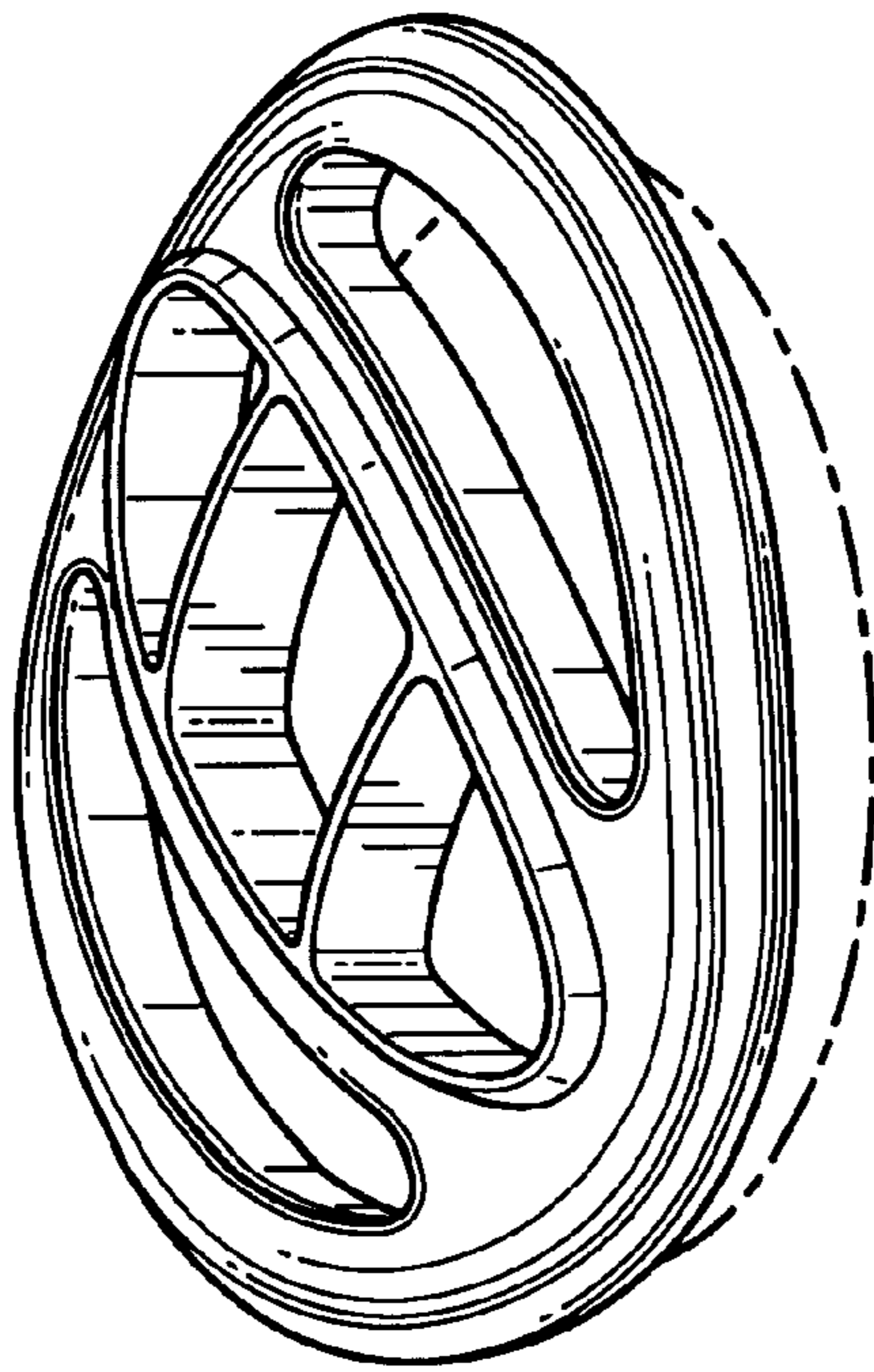

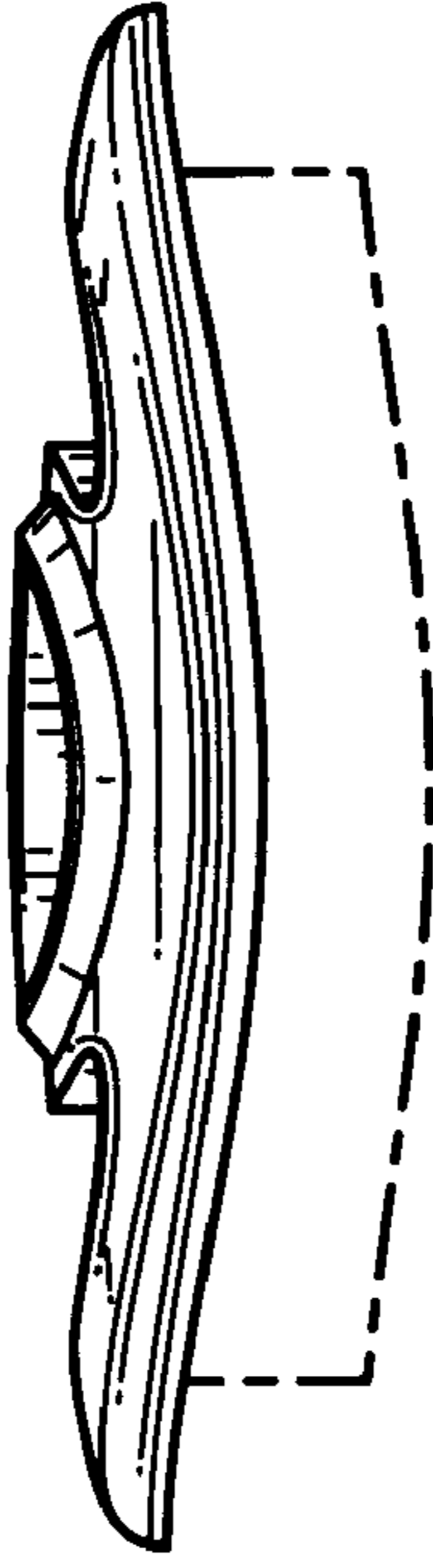

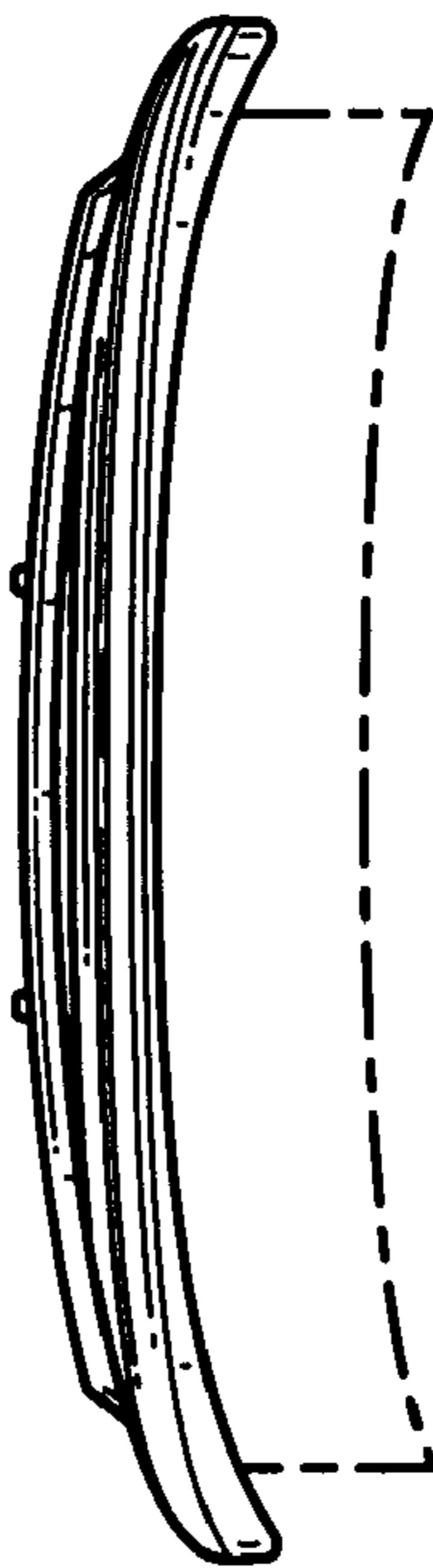

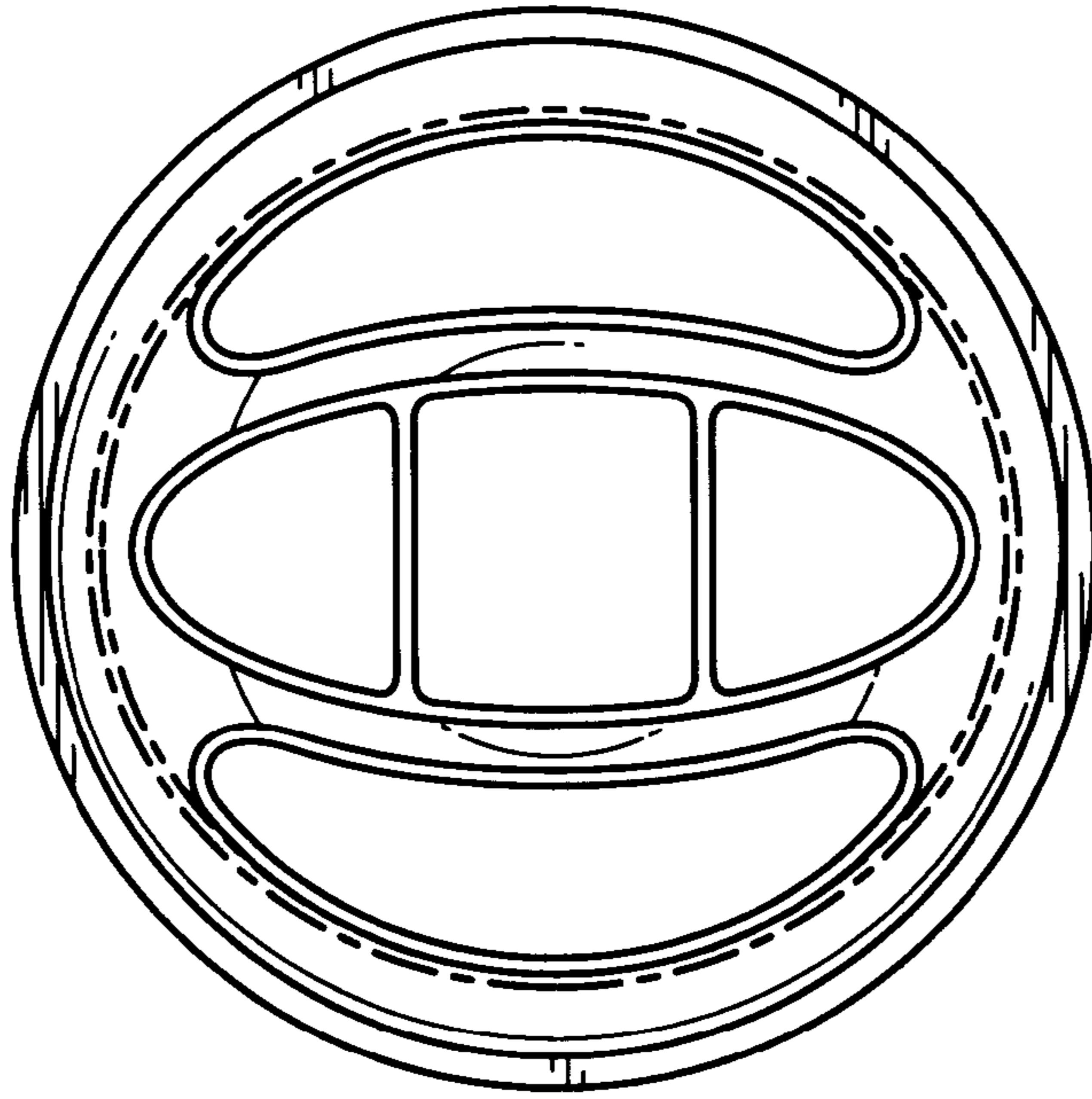

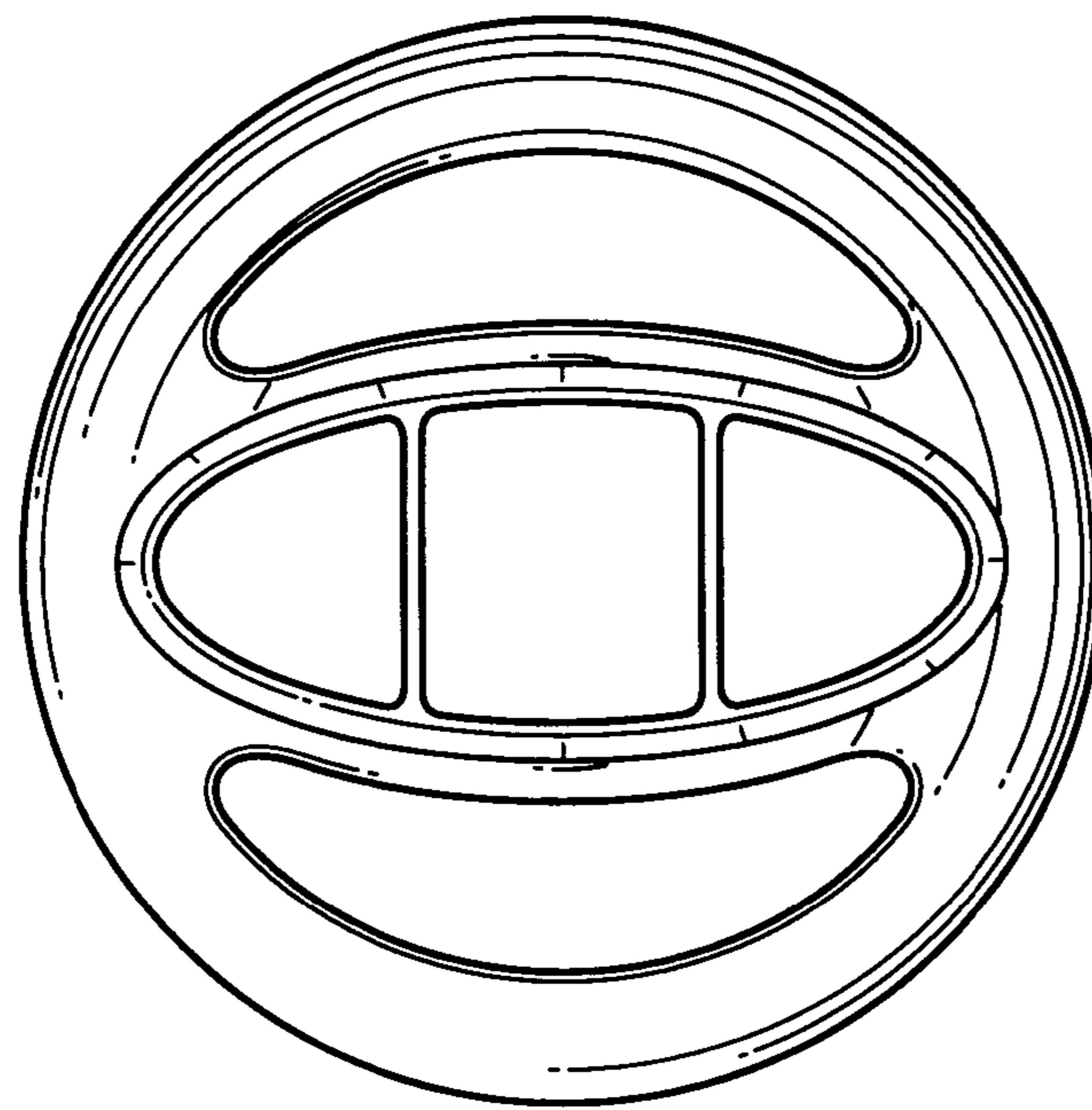
