(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an computer mouse cover, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective top view of the first embodiment of an apparatus for covering a hand operated computer control device;

FIG. 2 is a perspective bottom view of the apparatus of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a perspective top view of a second embodiment of an apparatus for covering a hand operated computer control device;

FIG. 4 is a perspective bottom view of the apparatus of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a perspective top view of a third embodiment of an apparatus for covering a hand operated computer control device;

FIG. 6 is a perspective vottom view of the apparatus of FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a perspective top view of a fourth embodiment of an apparatus for covering a hand operated computer control device;

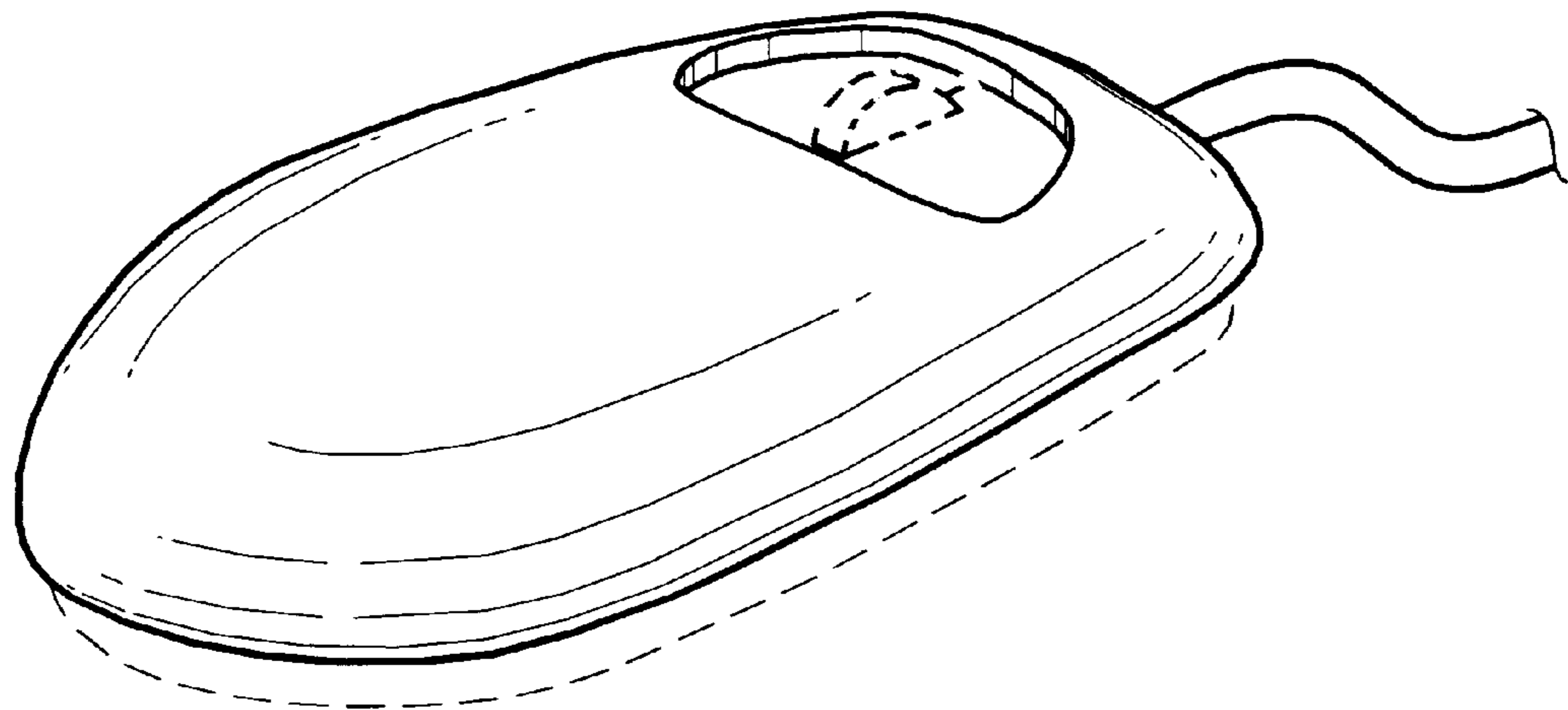
FIG. 8 is a perspective bottom view of the apparatus of FIG. 7;

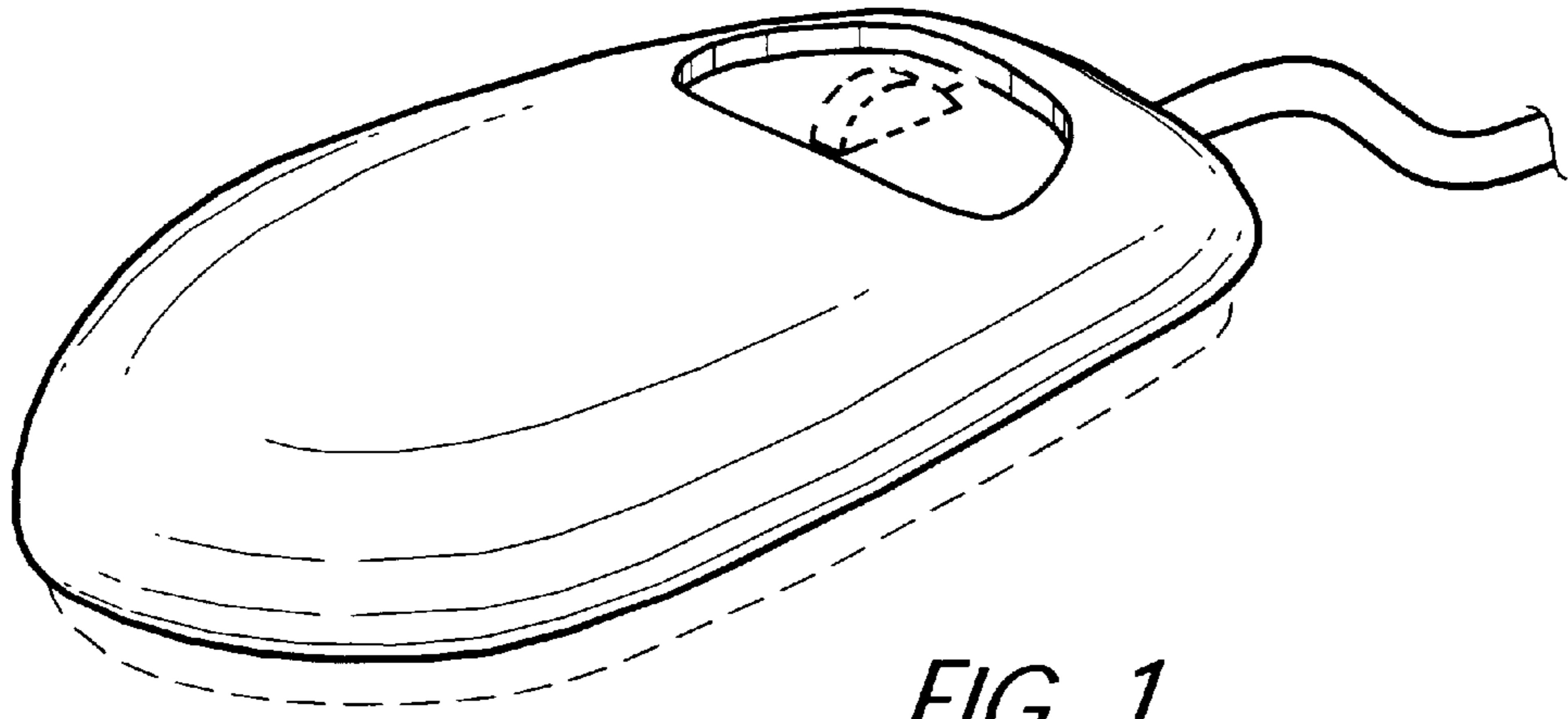

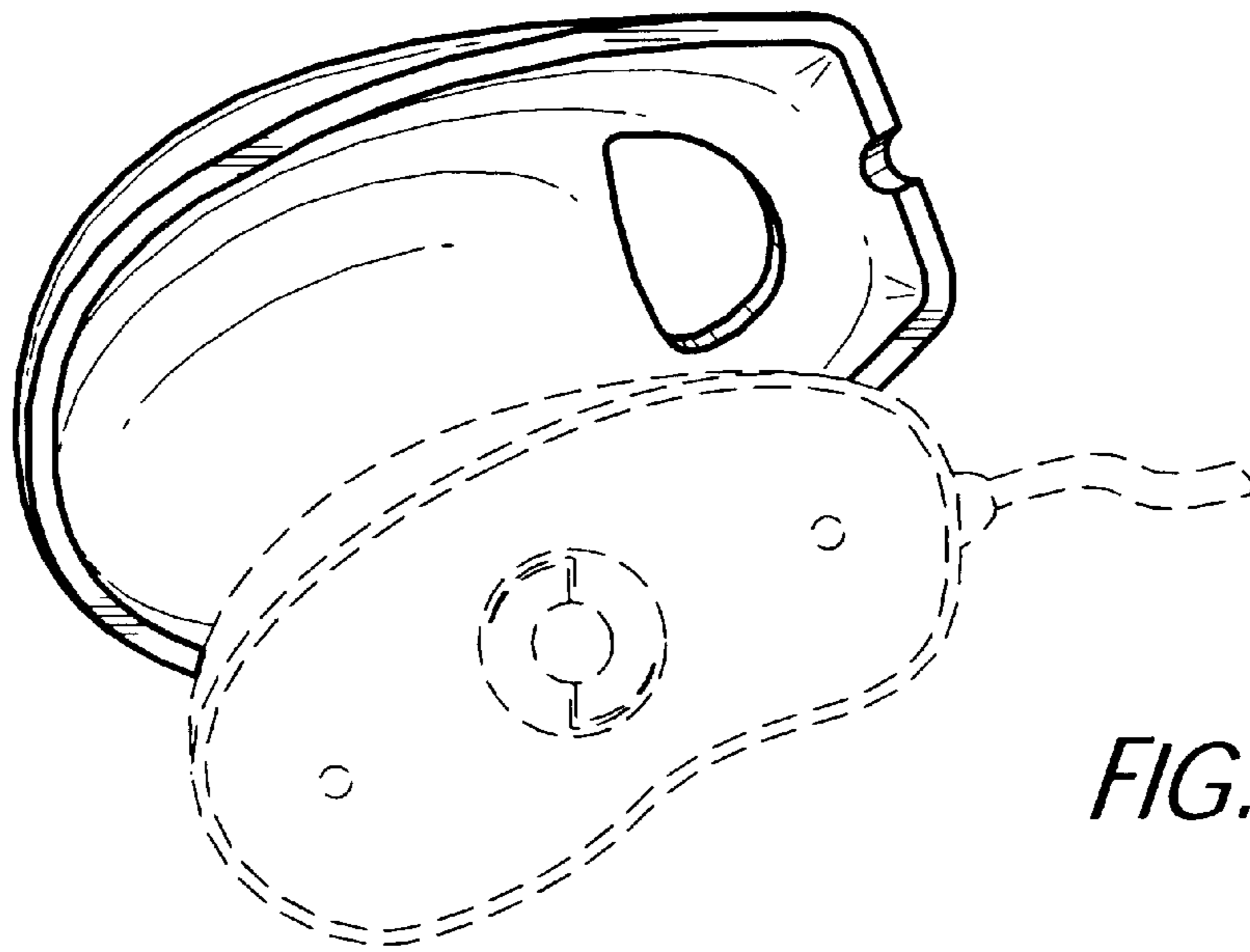

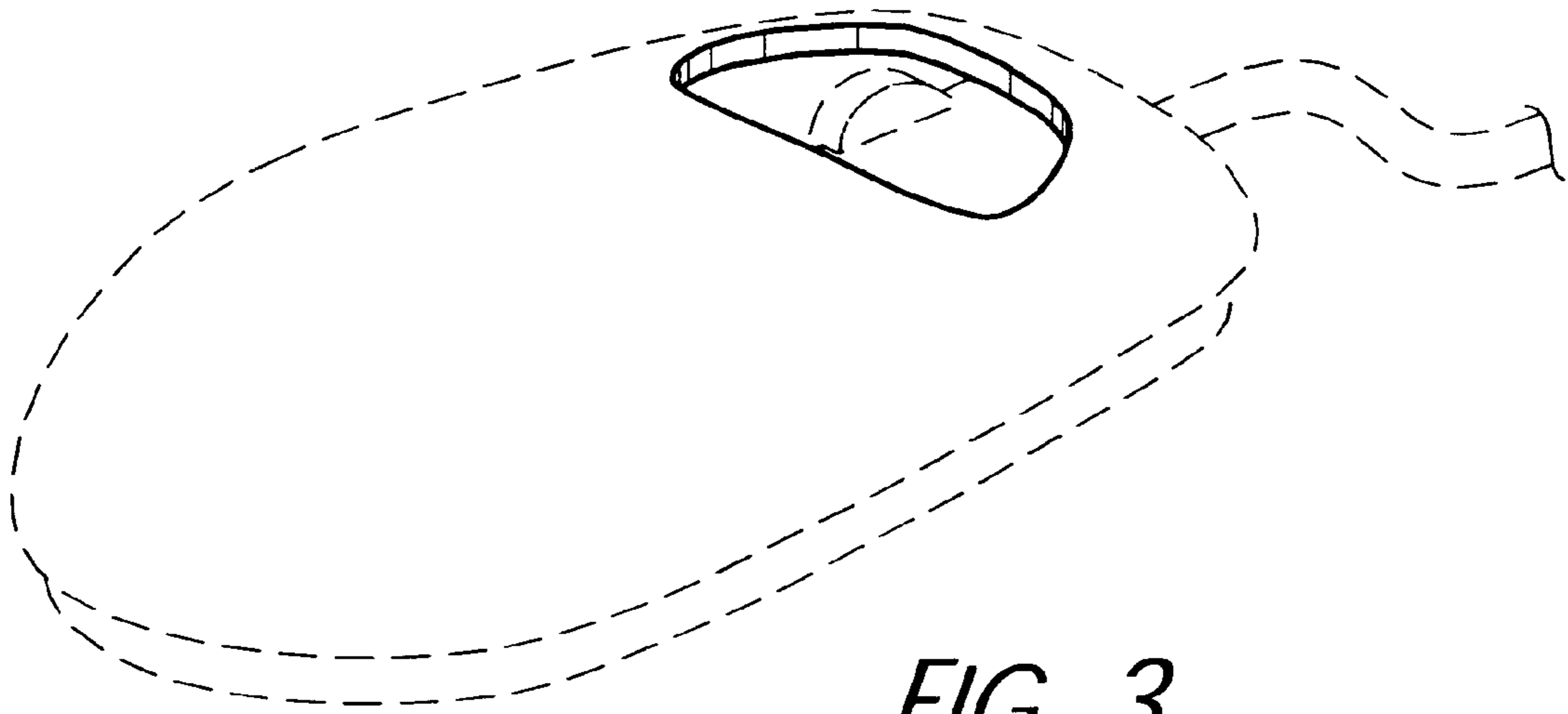

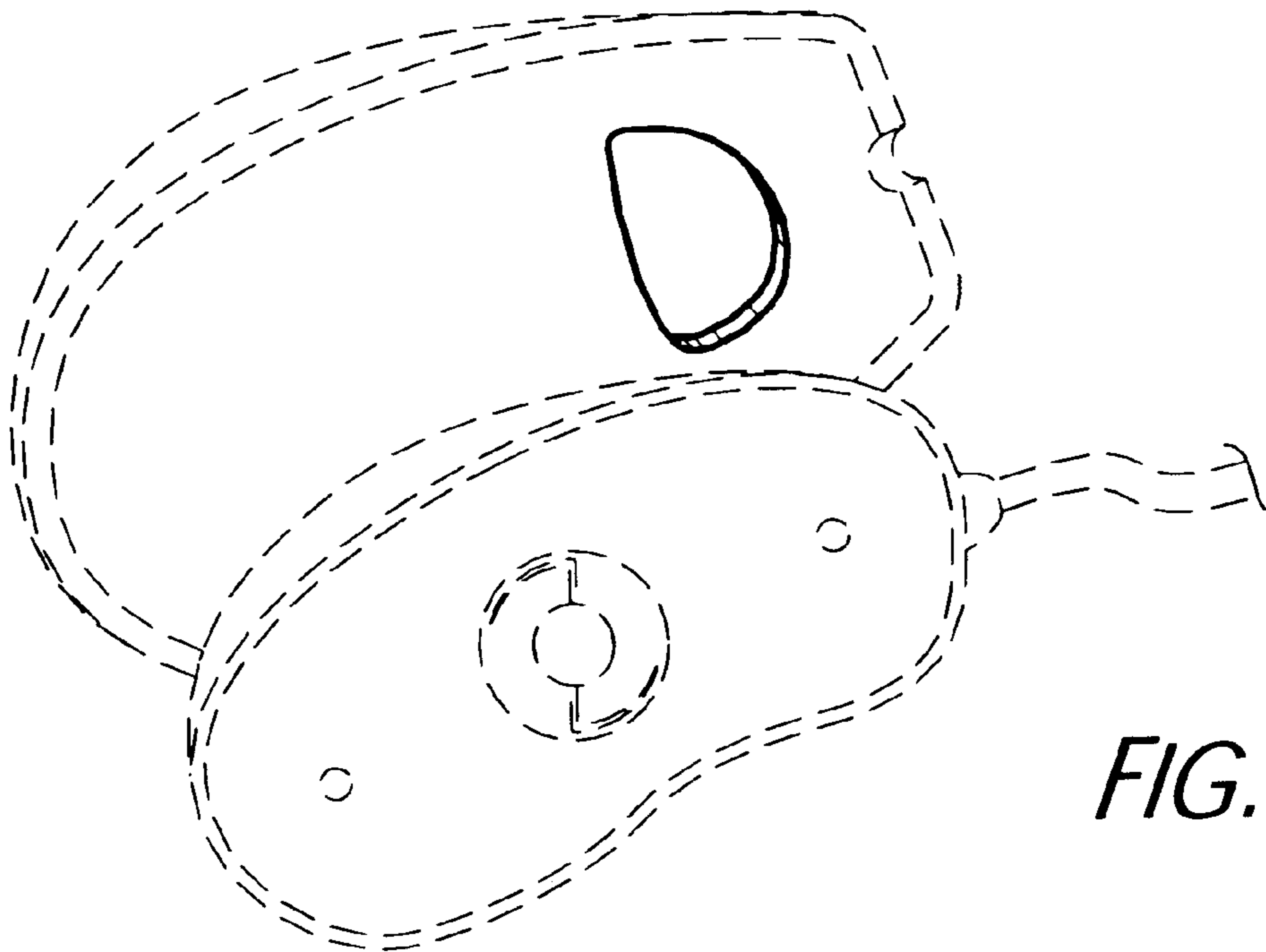

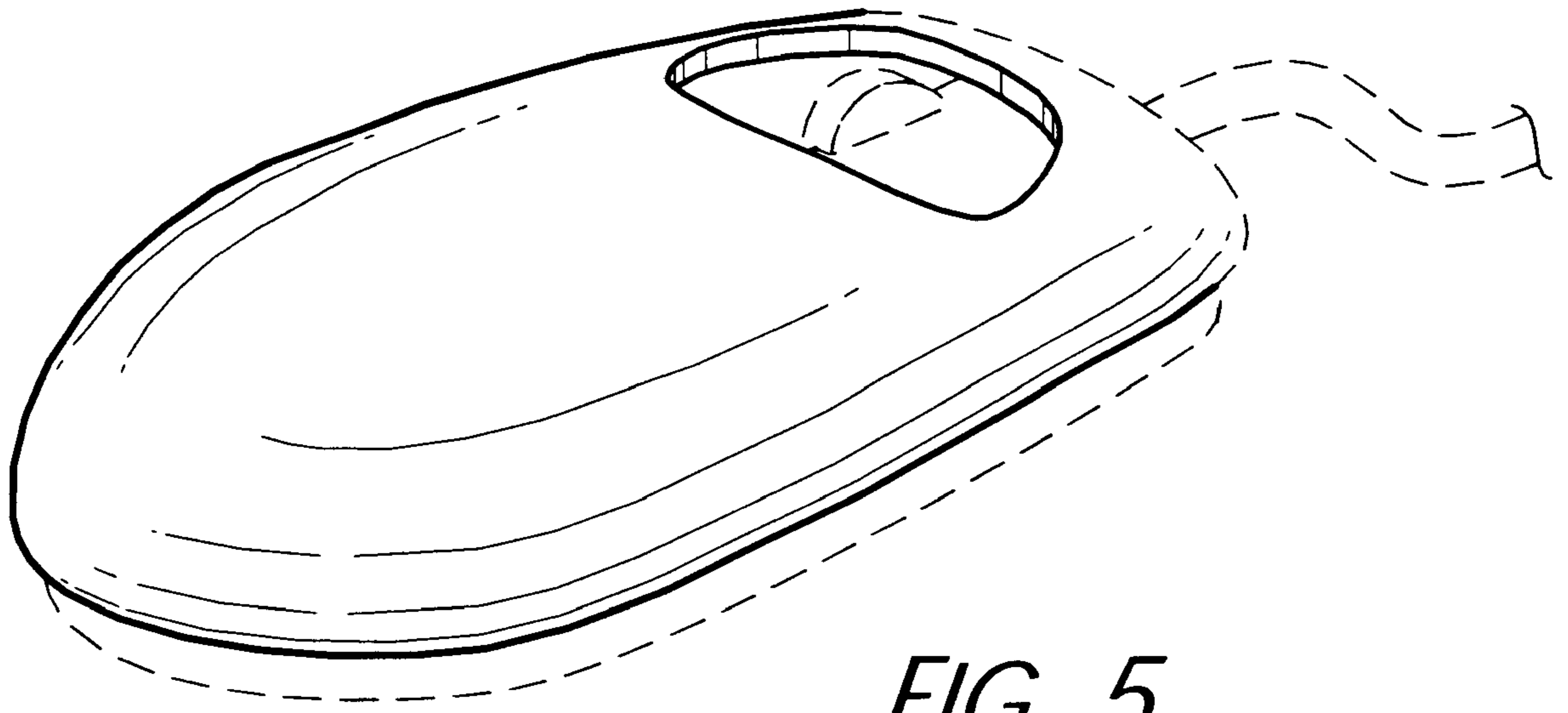

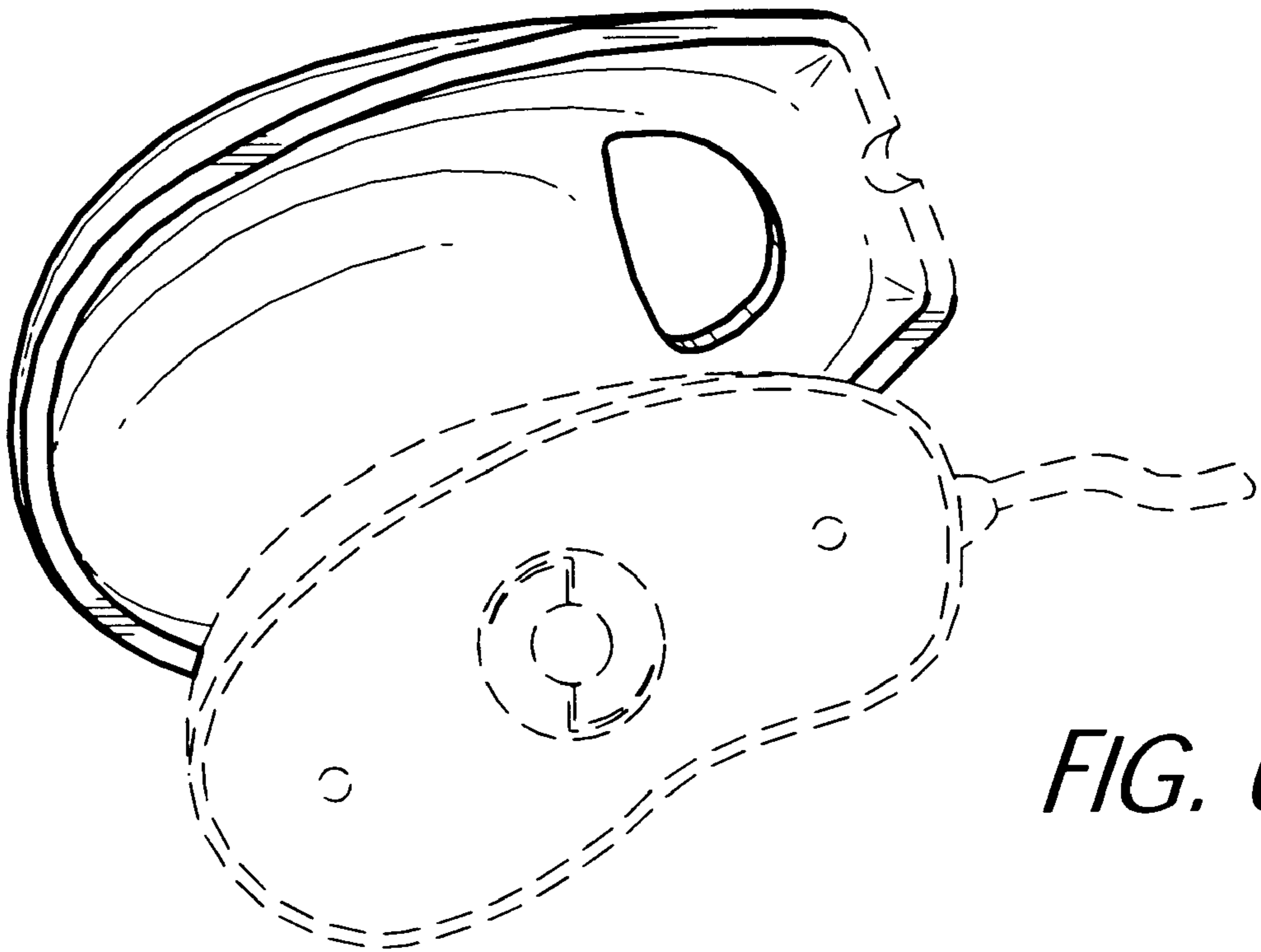

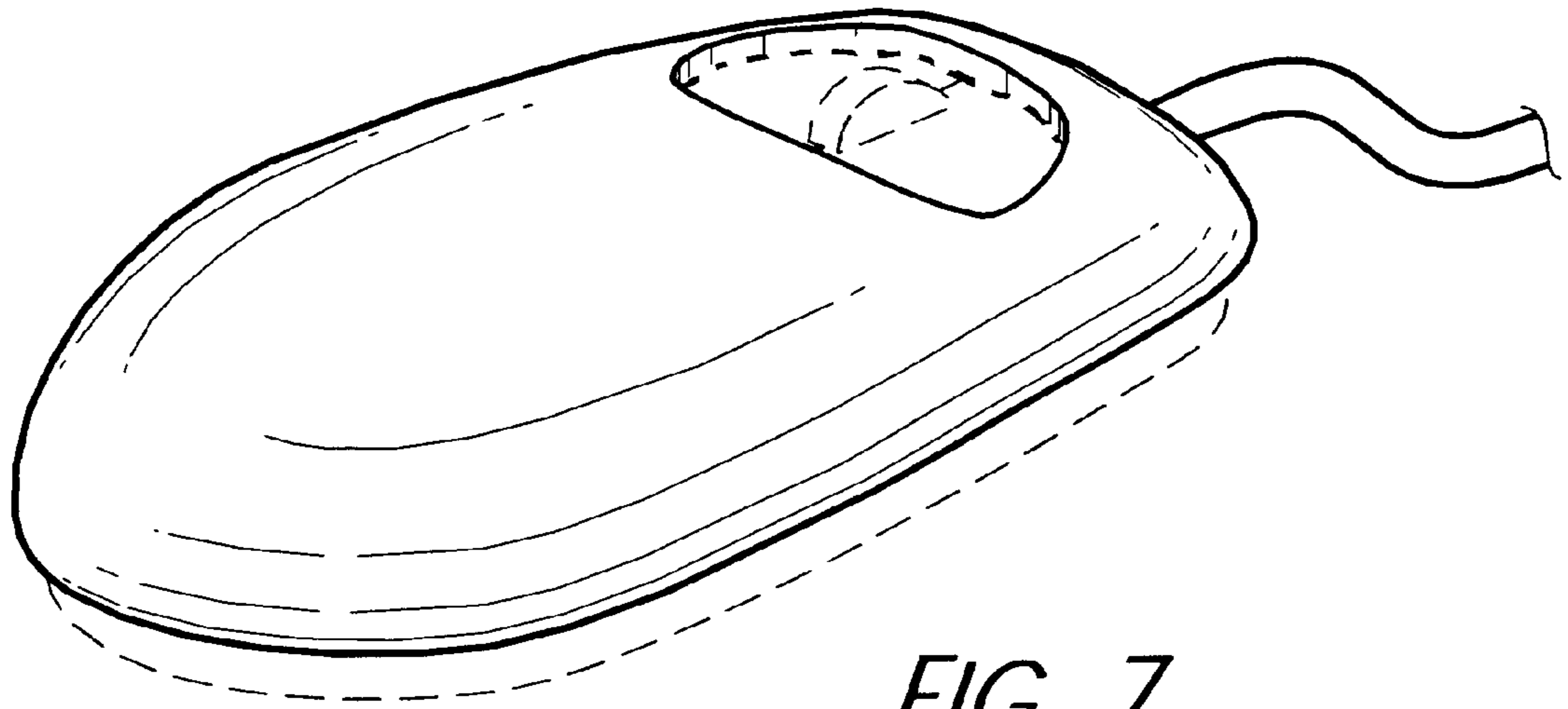

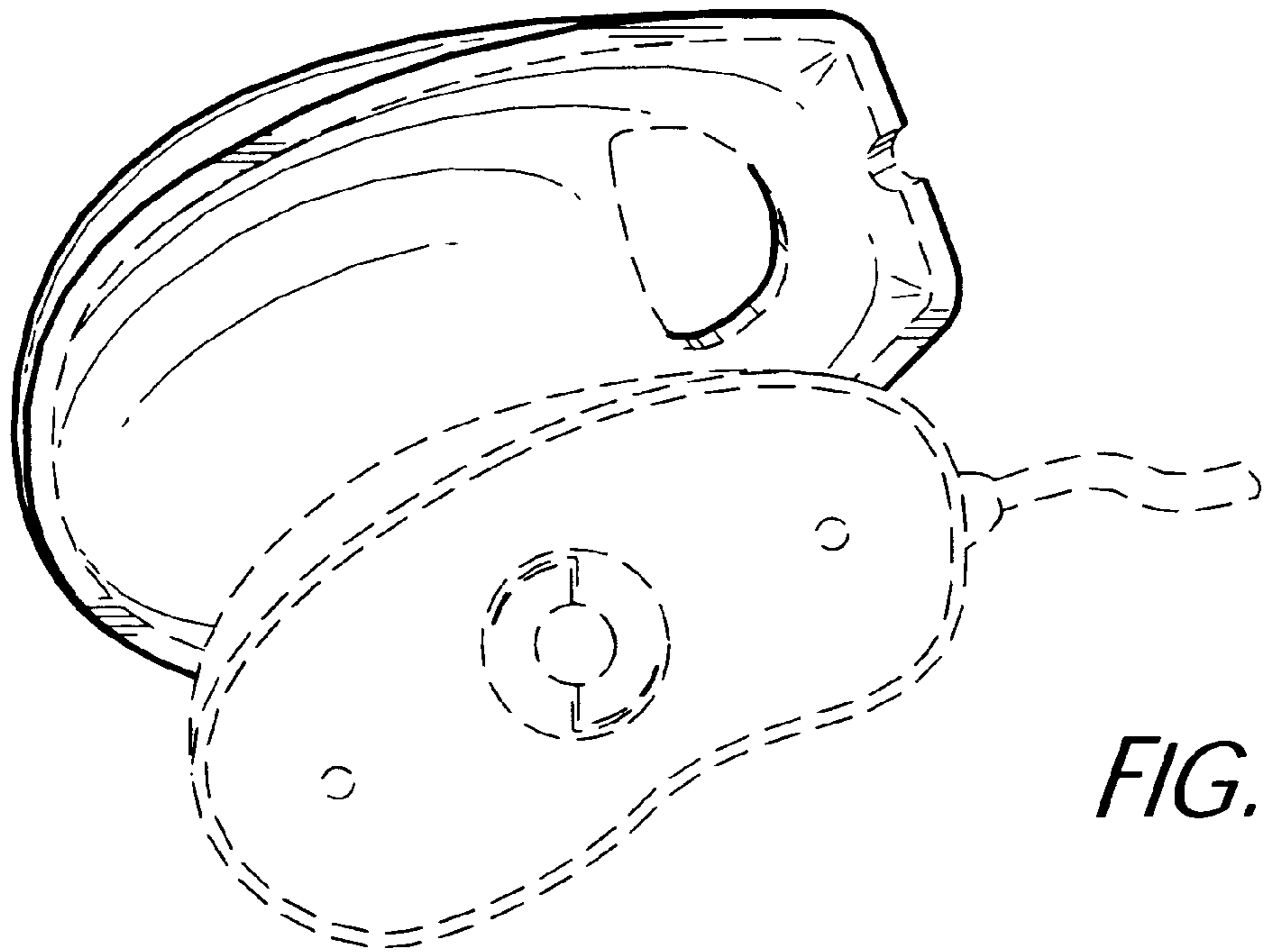

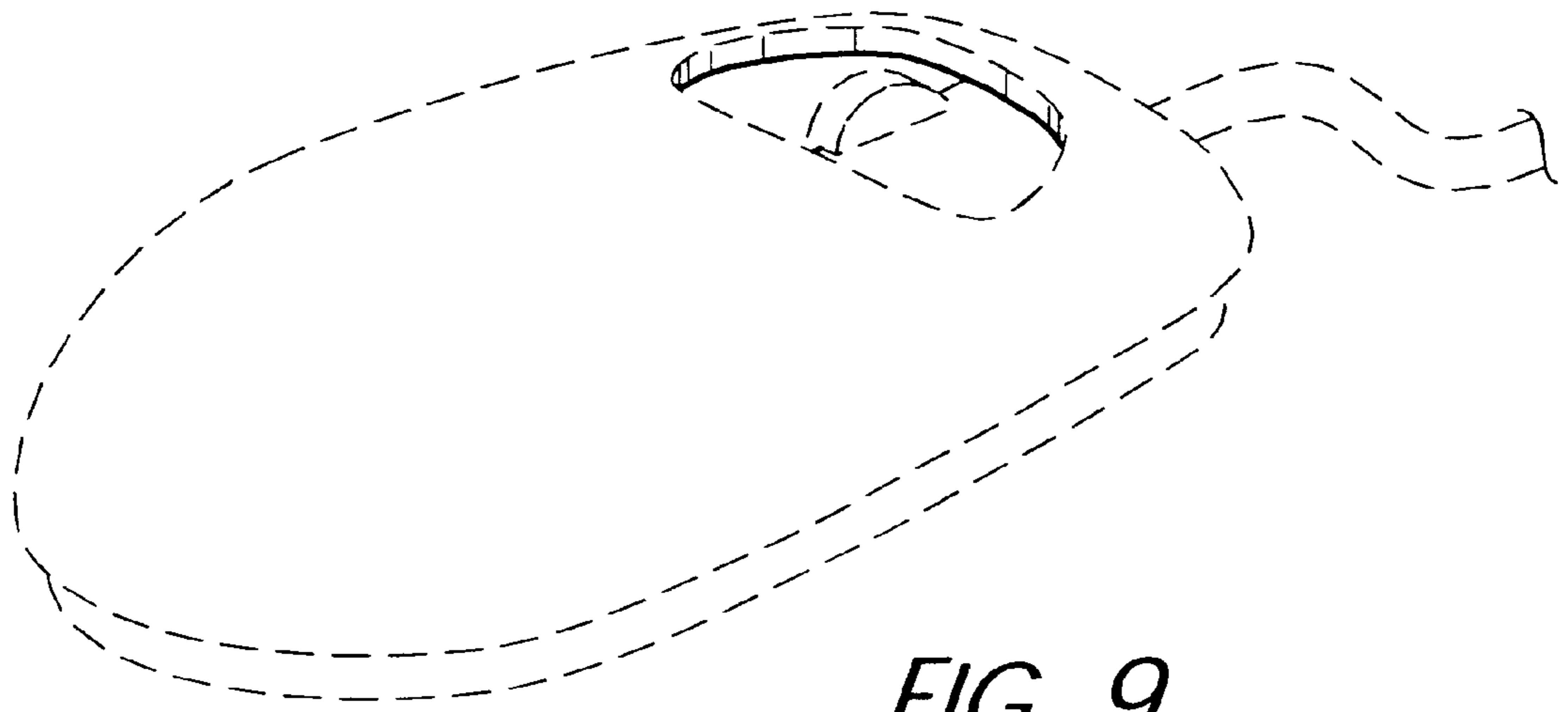

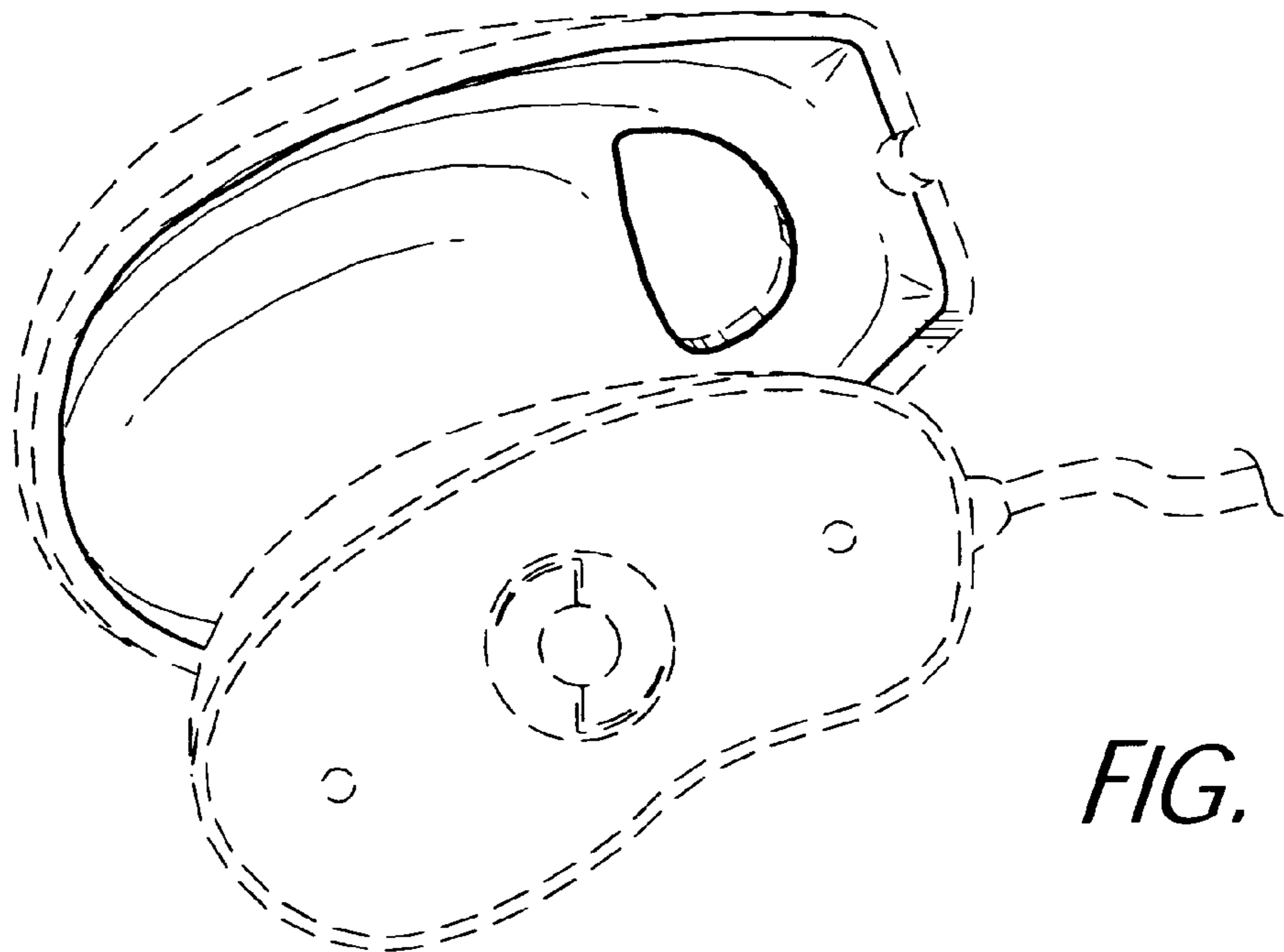
