(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an electronic memory card holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top and front perspective view of an electronic memory card holder showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side view being a mirror image of that shown;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 7 is a top and front perspective view of a second embodiment of the electronic memory card holder;
 FIG. 8 is a top plan view of FIG. 7;
 FIG. 9 is a side elevational view of FIG. 7, the opposite side view being a mirror image of that shown;
 FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 7;
 FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 7;
 FIG. 12 is a front elevational view of FIG. 7;
 FIG. 13 is a top and front perspective view of a third embodiment of the electronic memory card holder;
 FIG. 14 is a top plan view of FIG. 13;
 FIG. 15 is a side elevational view of FIG. 13, the opposite side view being a mirror image of that shown;
 FIG. 16 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 13;
 FIG. 17 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 13; and,
 FIG. 18 is a front elevational view of FIG. 13.

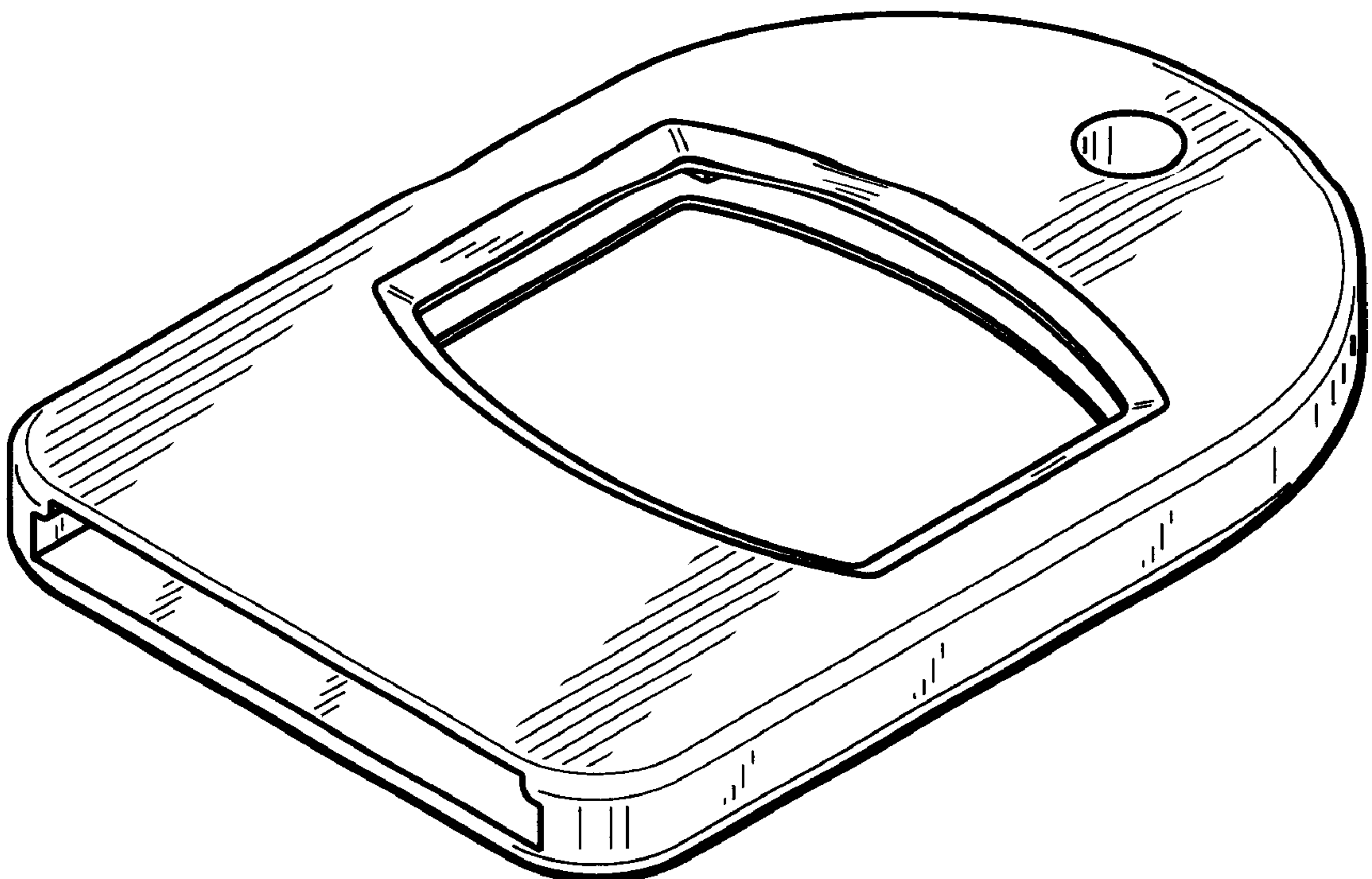

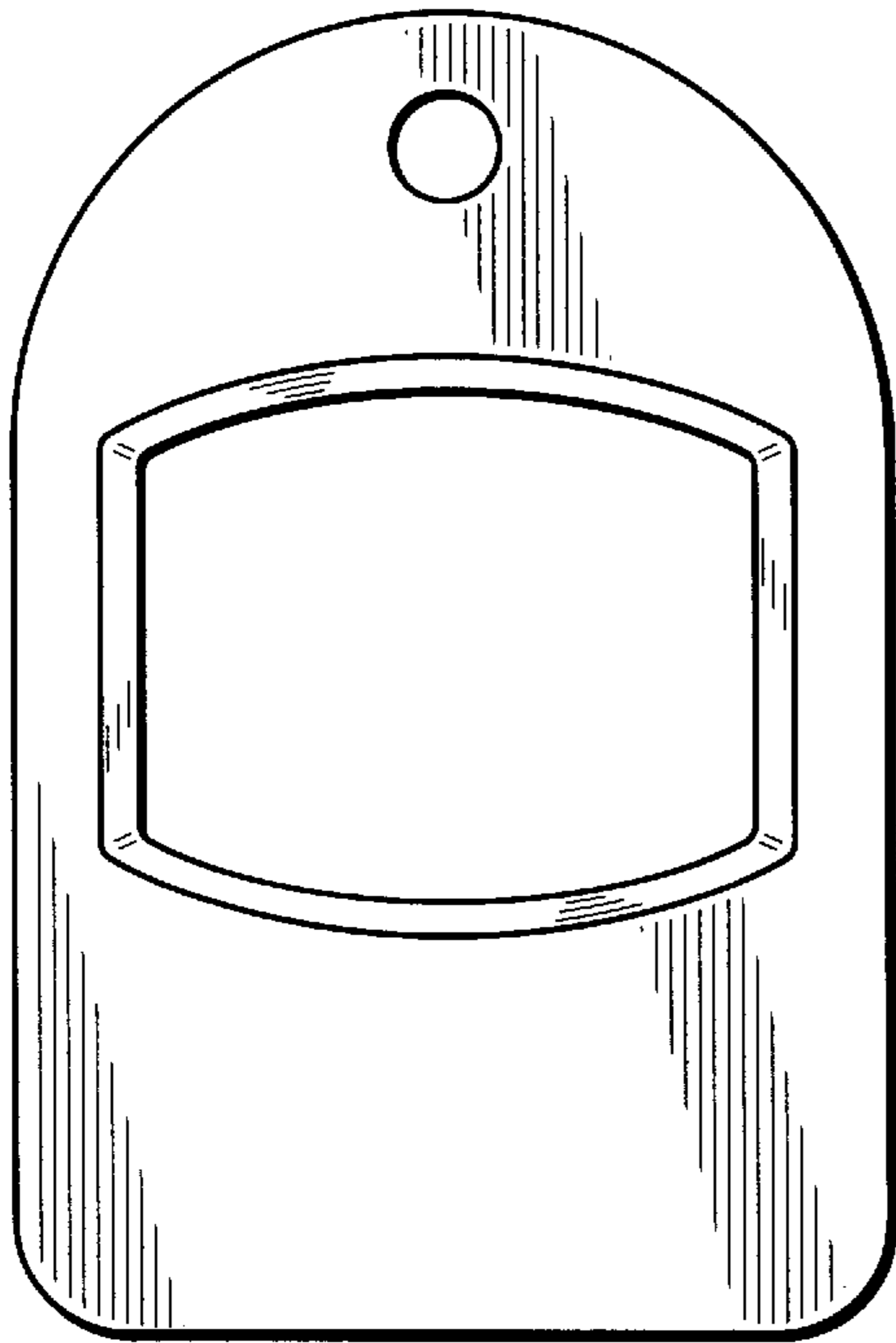
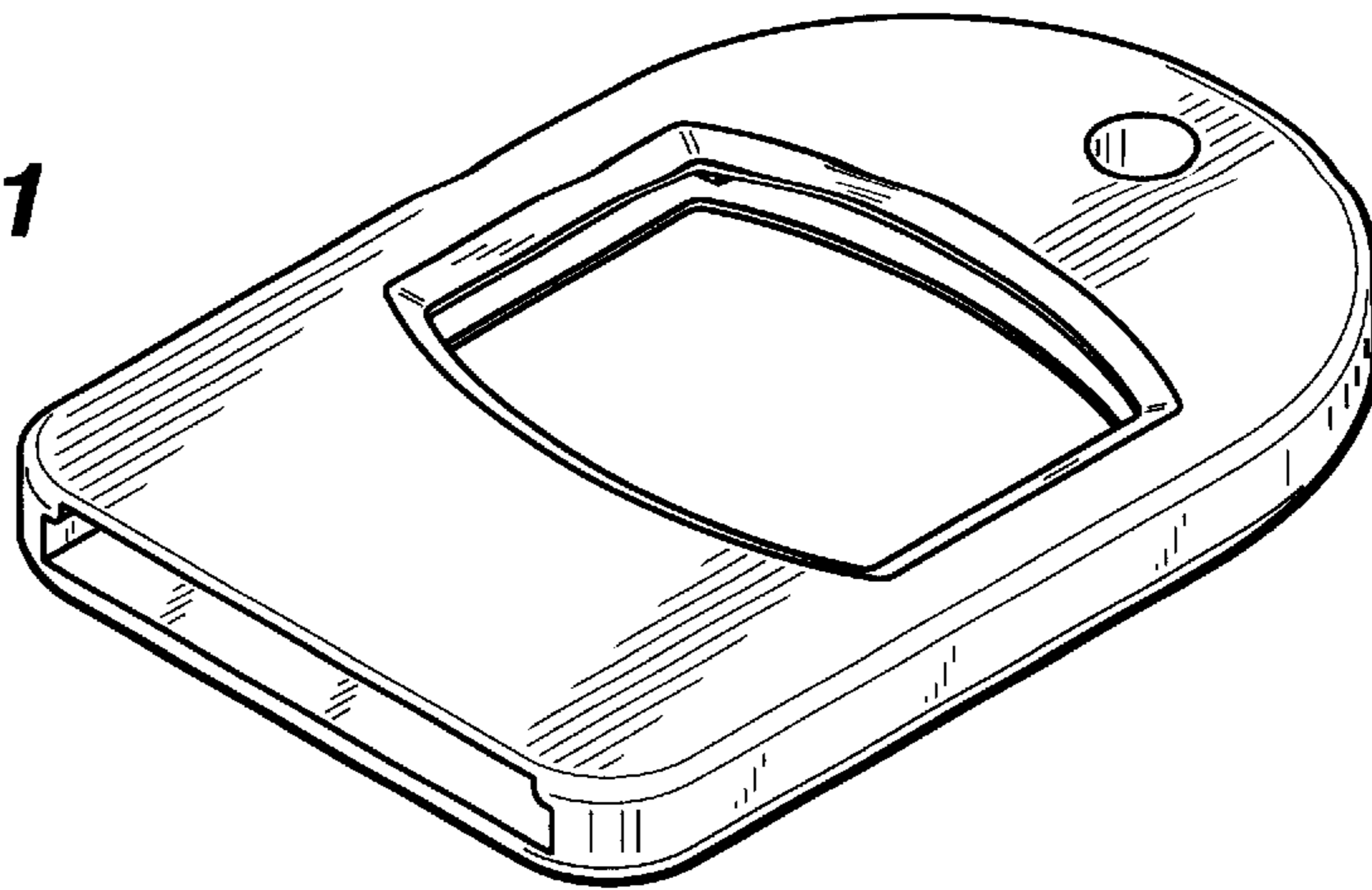

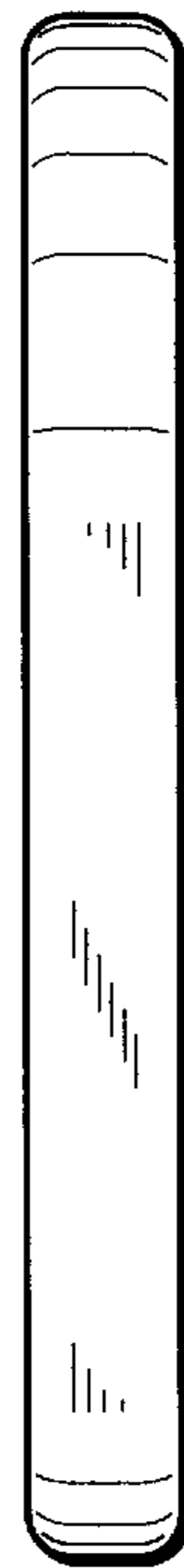

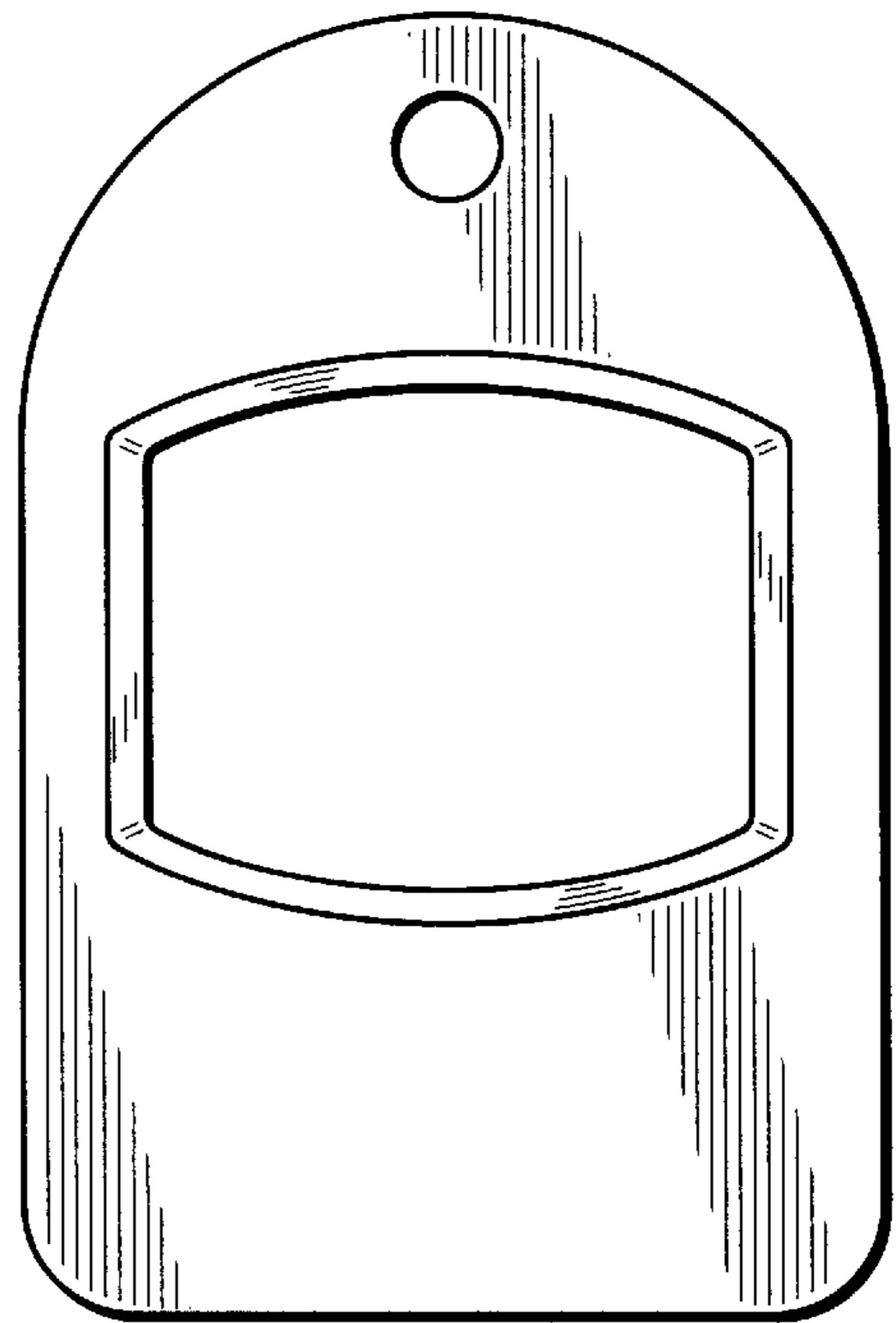

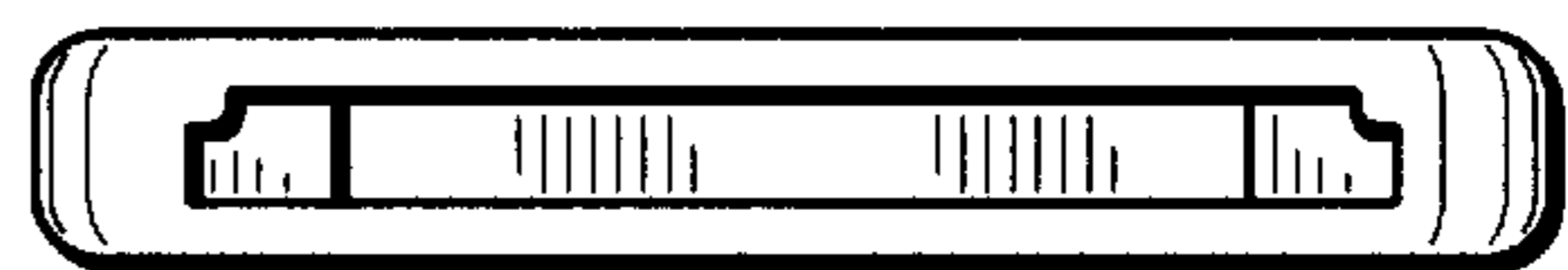

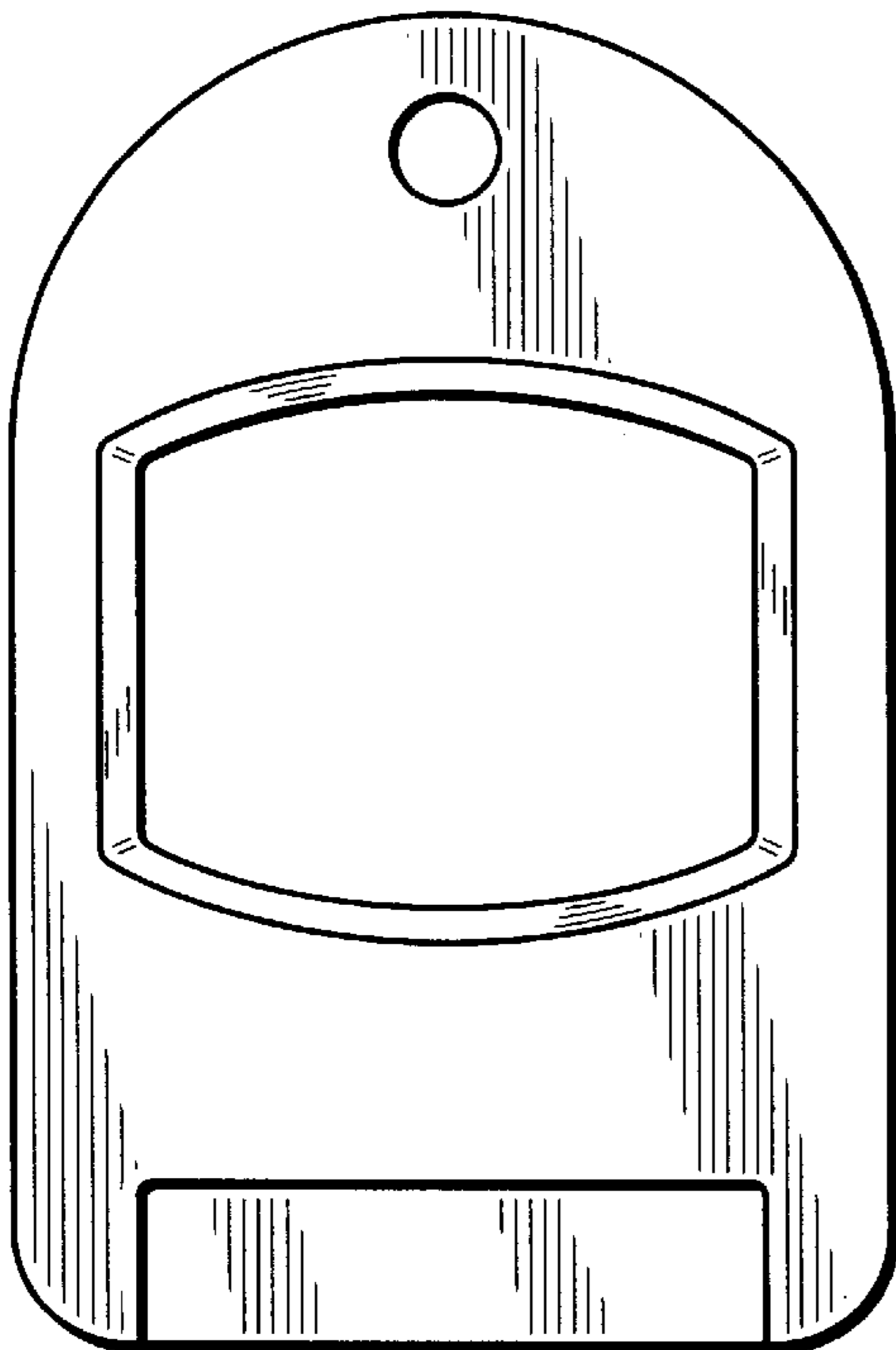
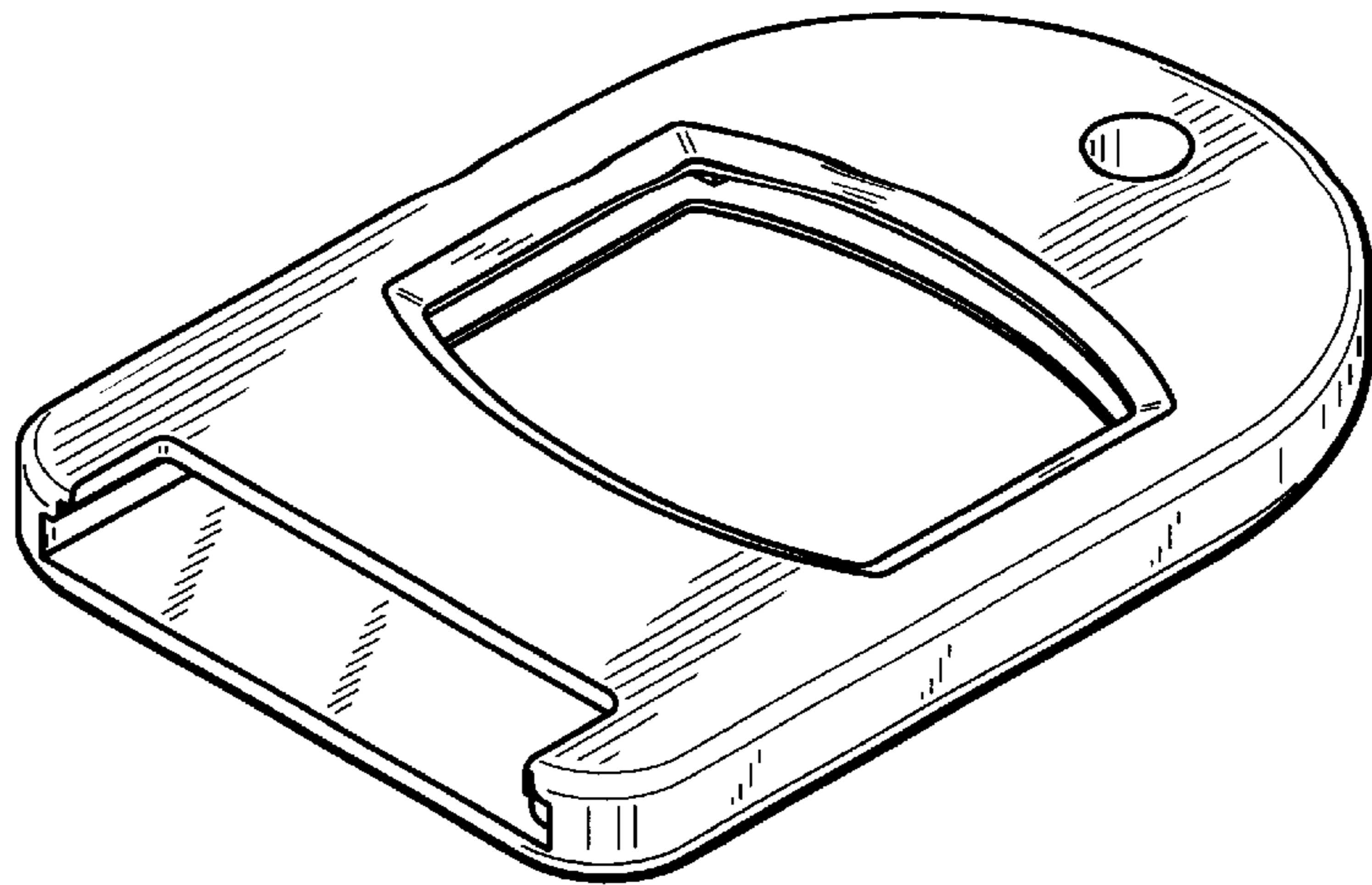

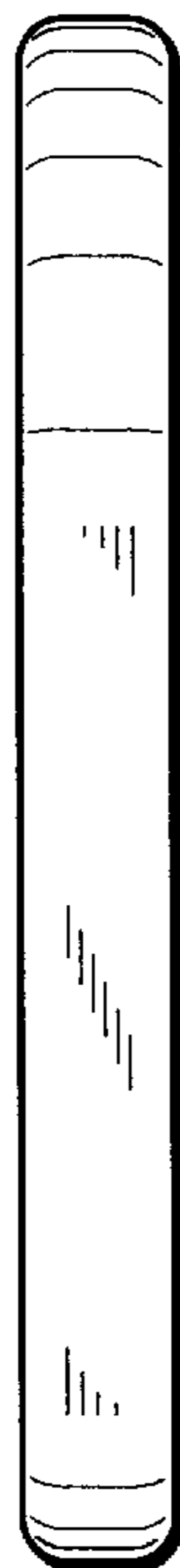

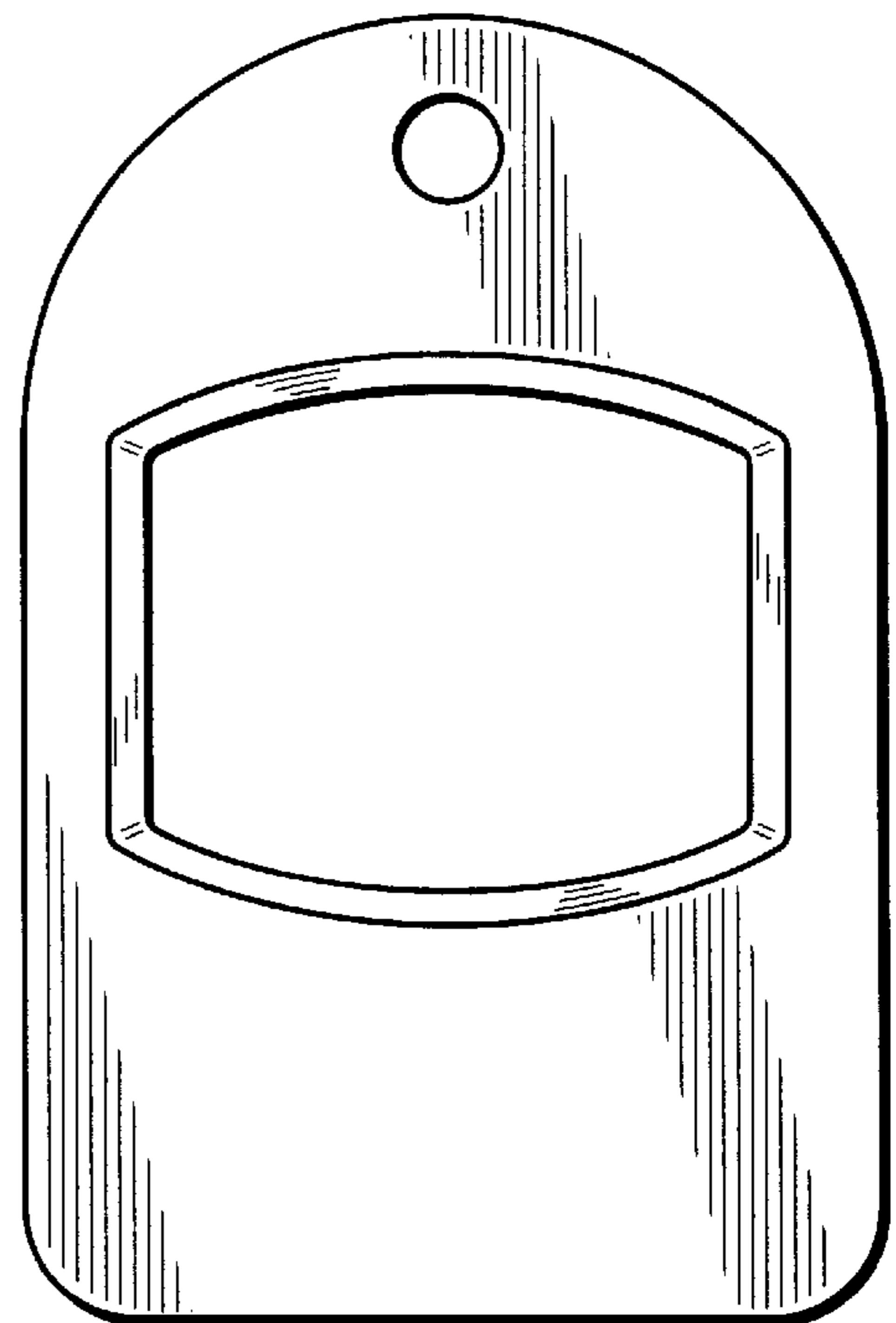

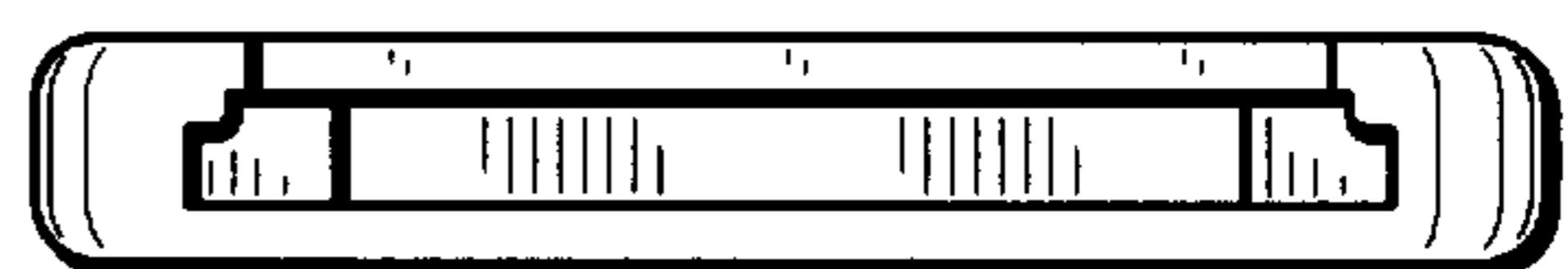

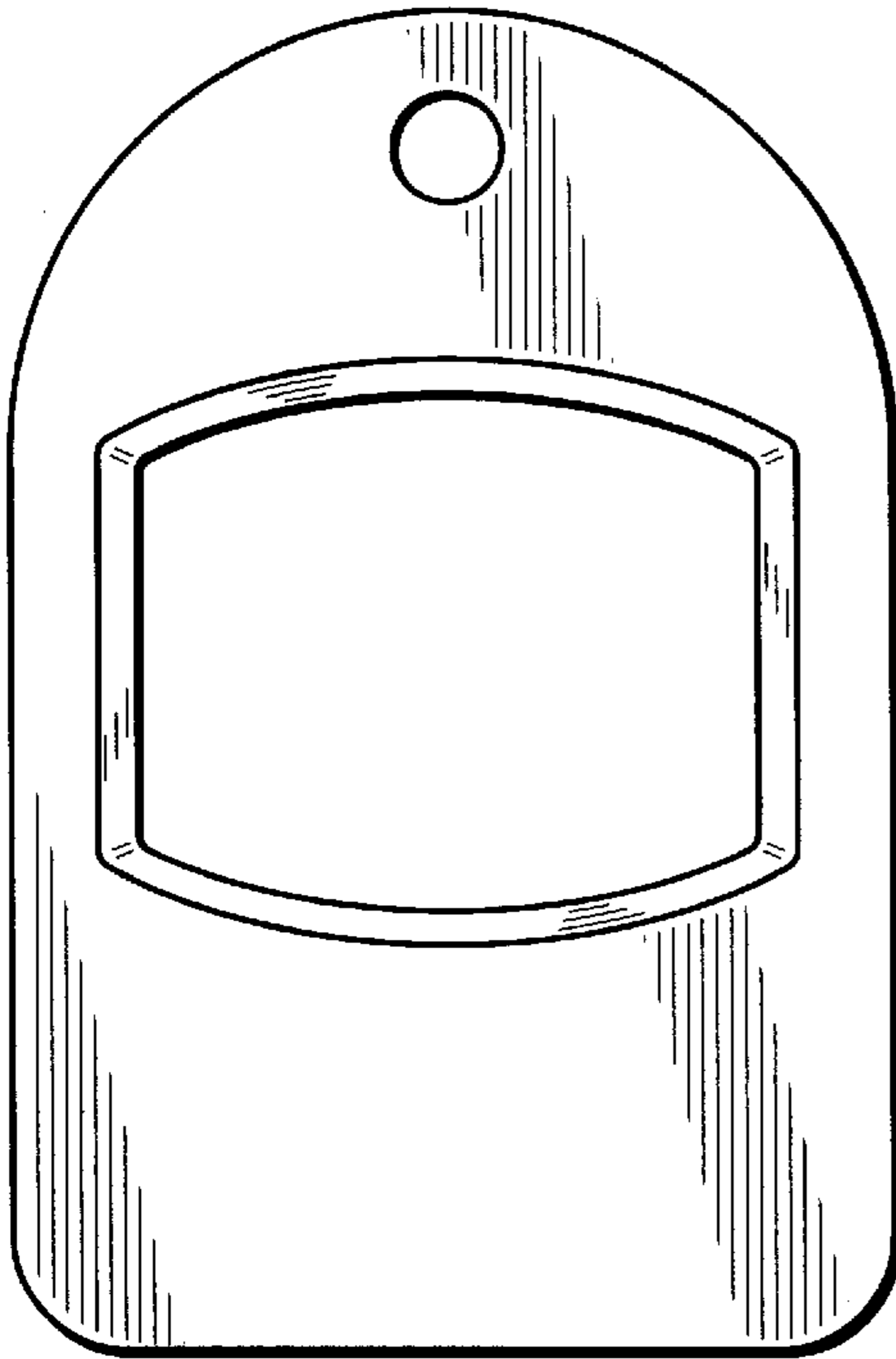
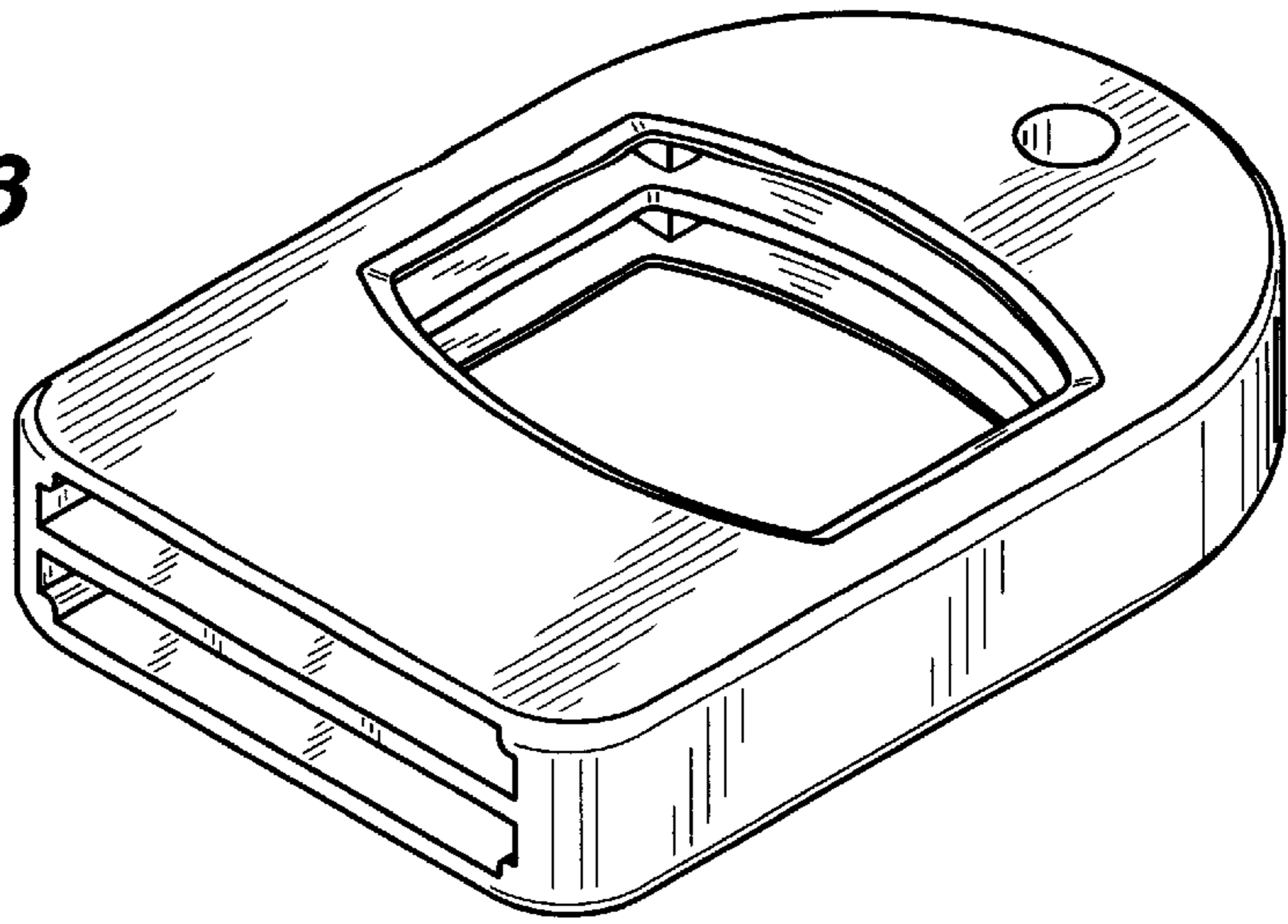

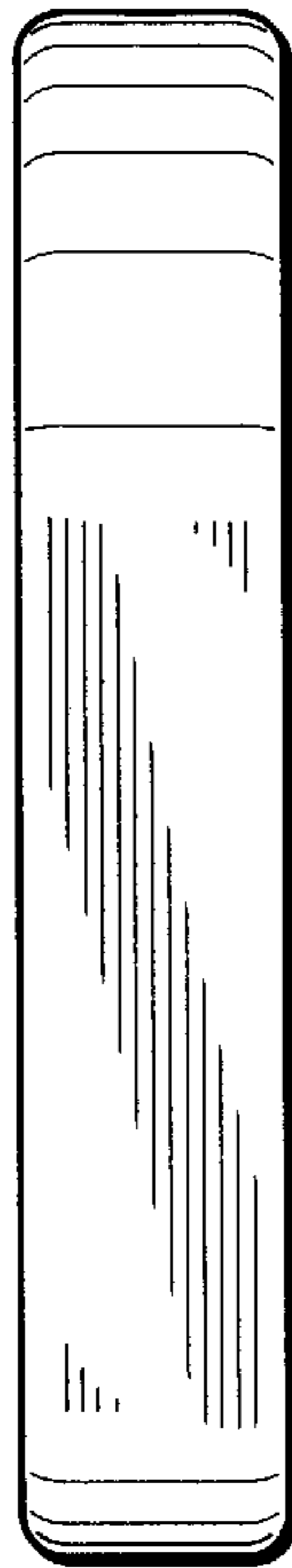

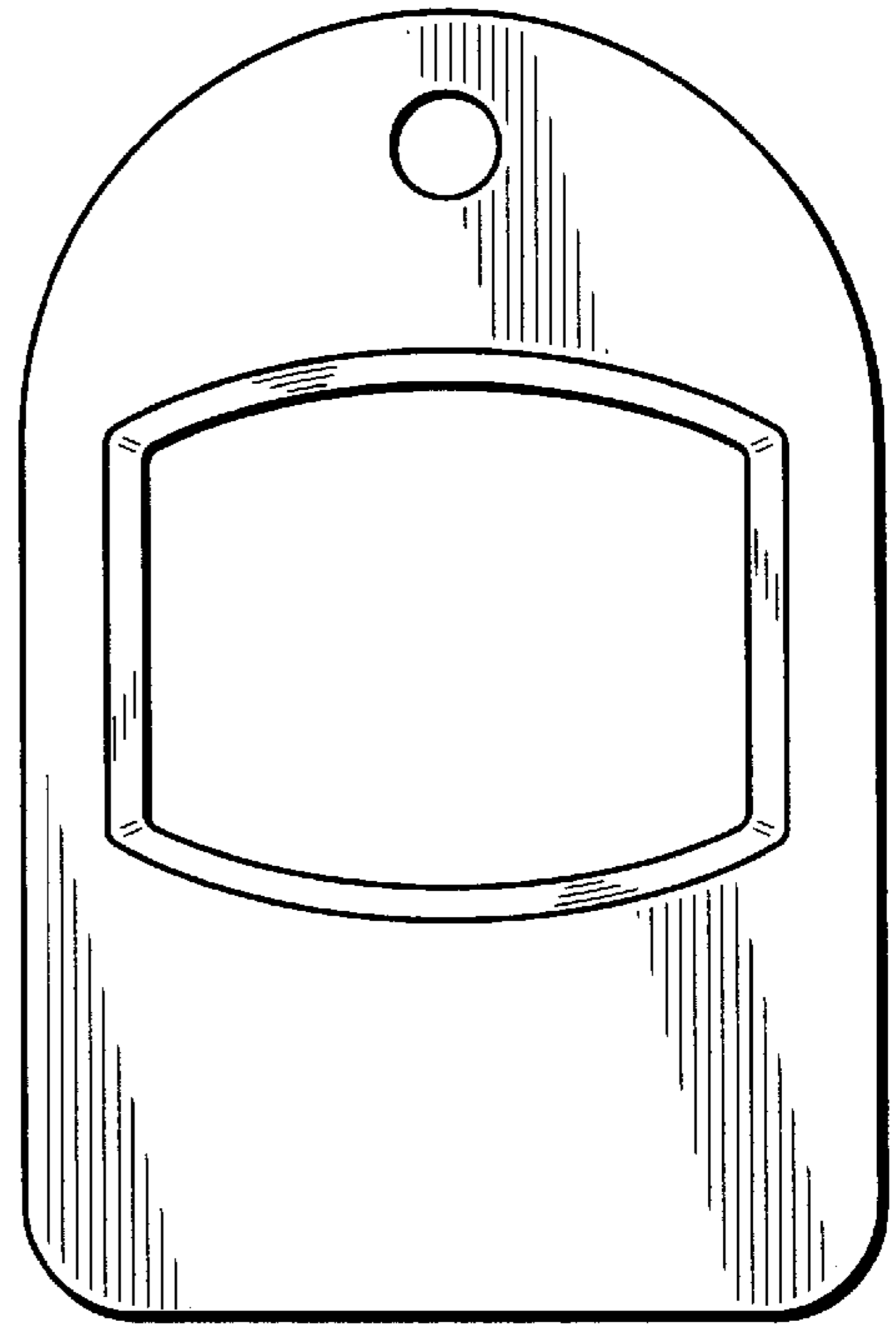

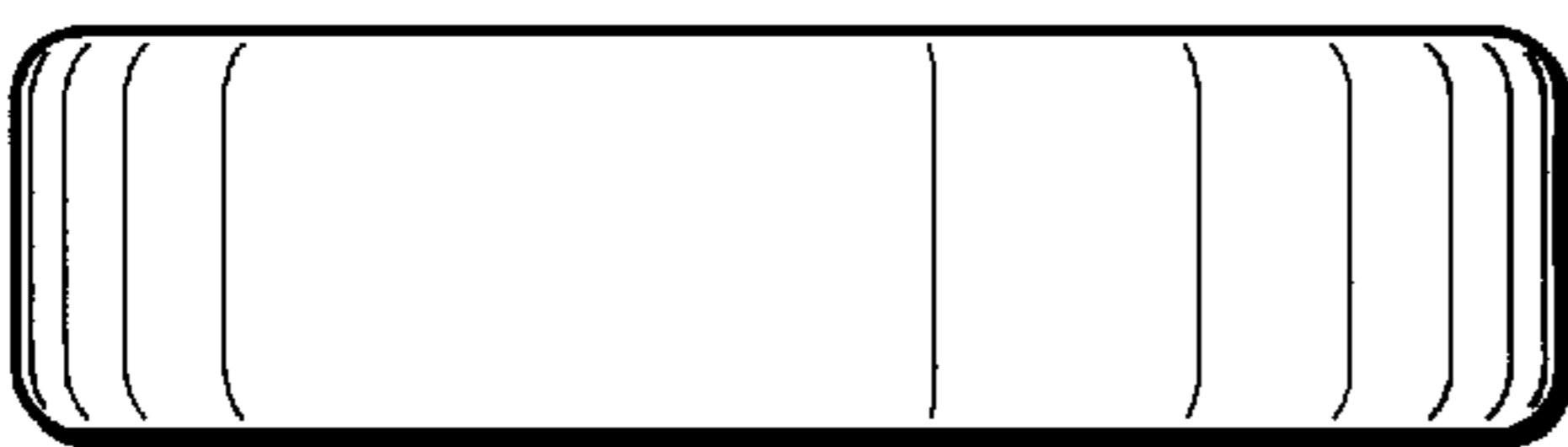

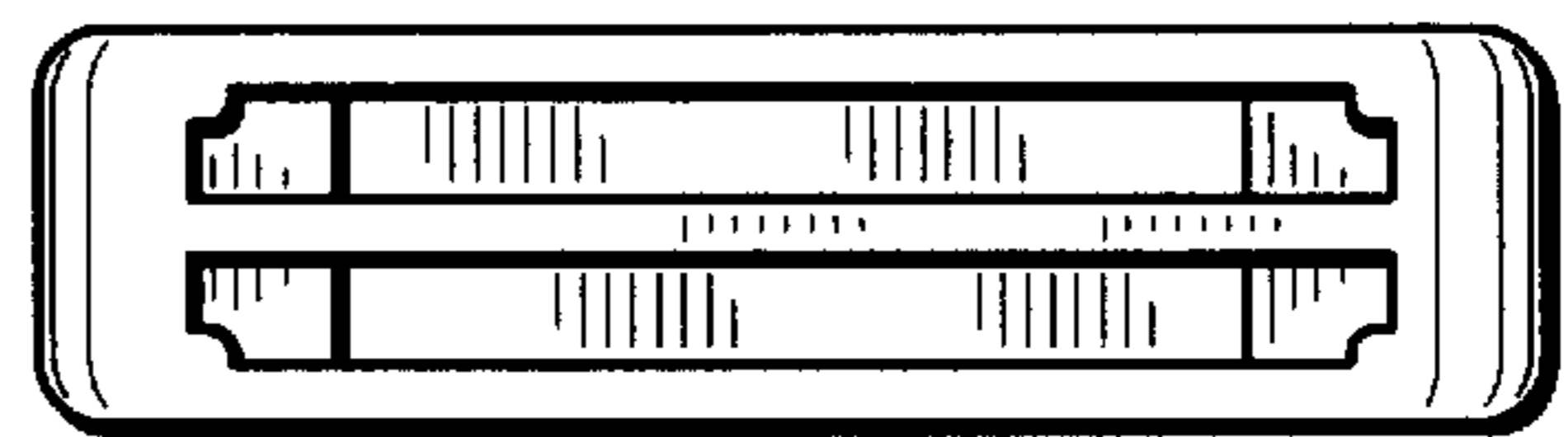
