(57) **CLAIM**

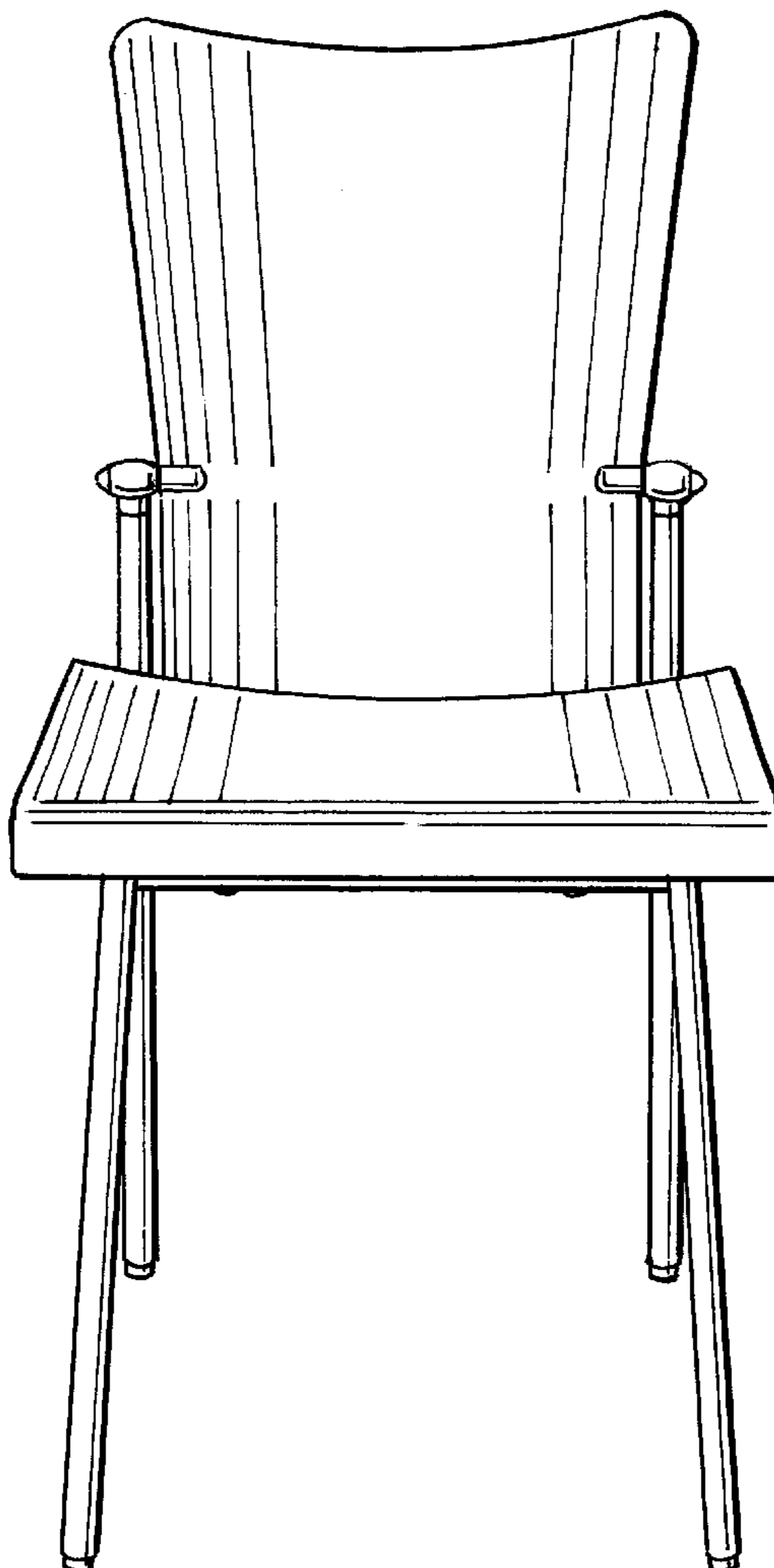
The ornamental design for a reclining chair, substantially as shown and described.

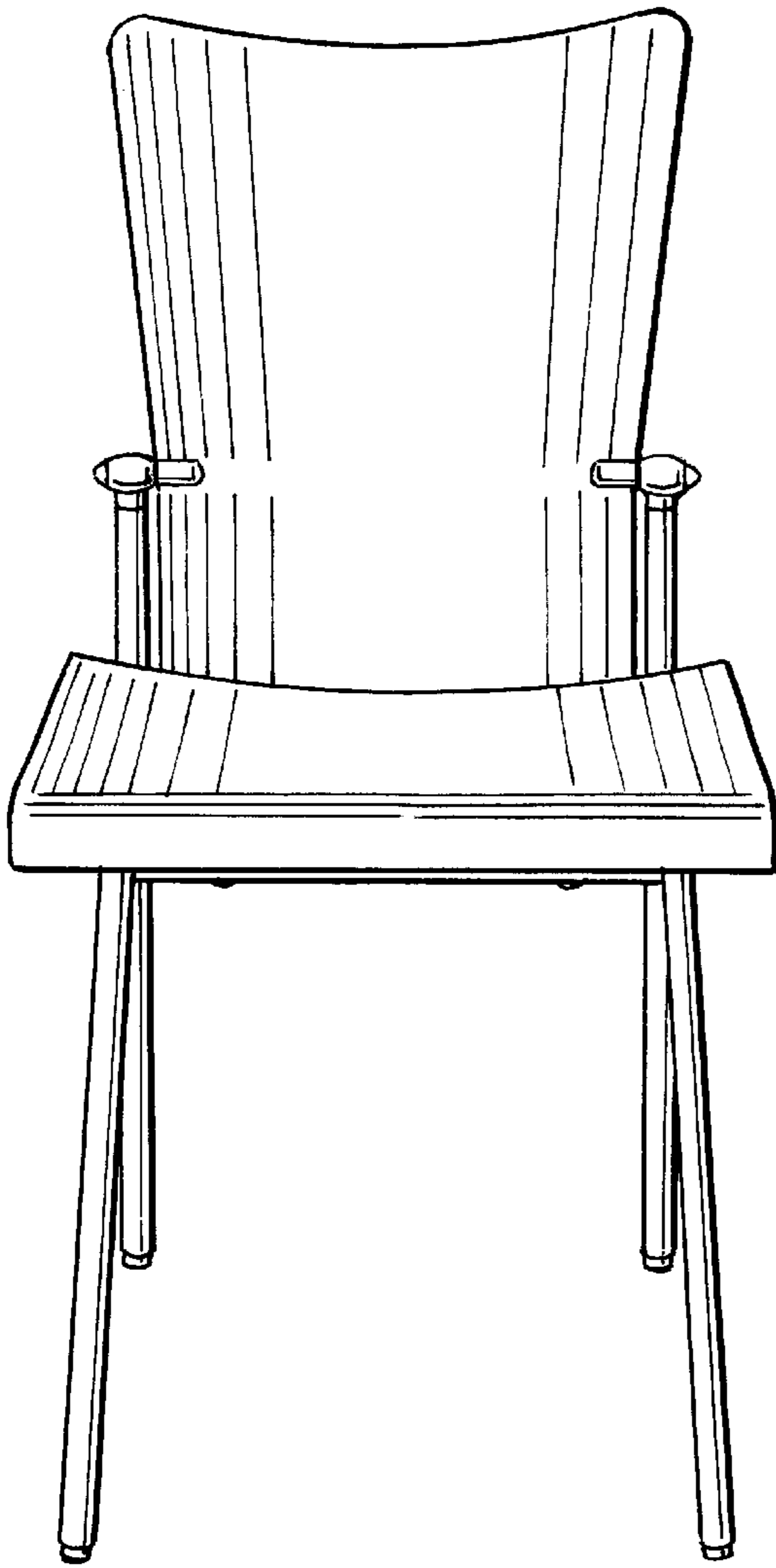

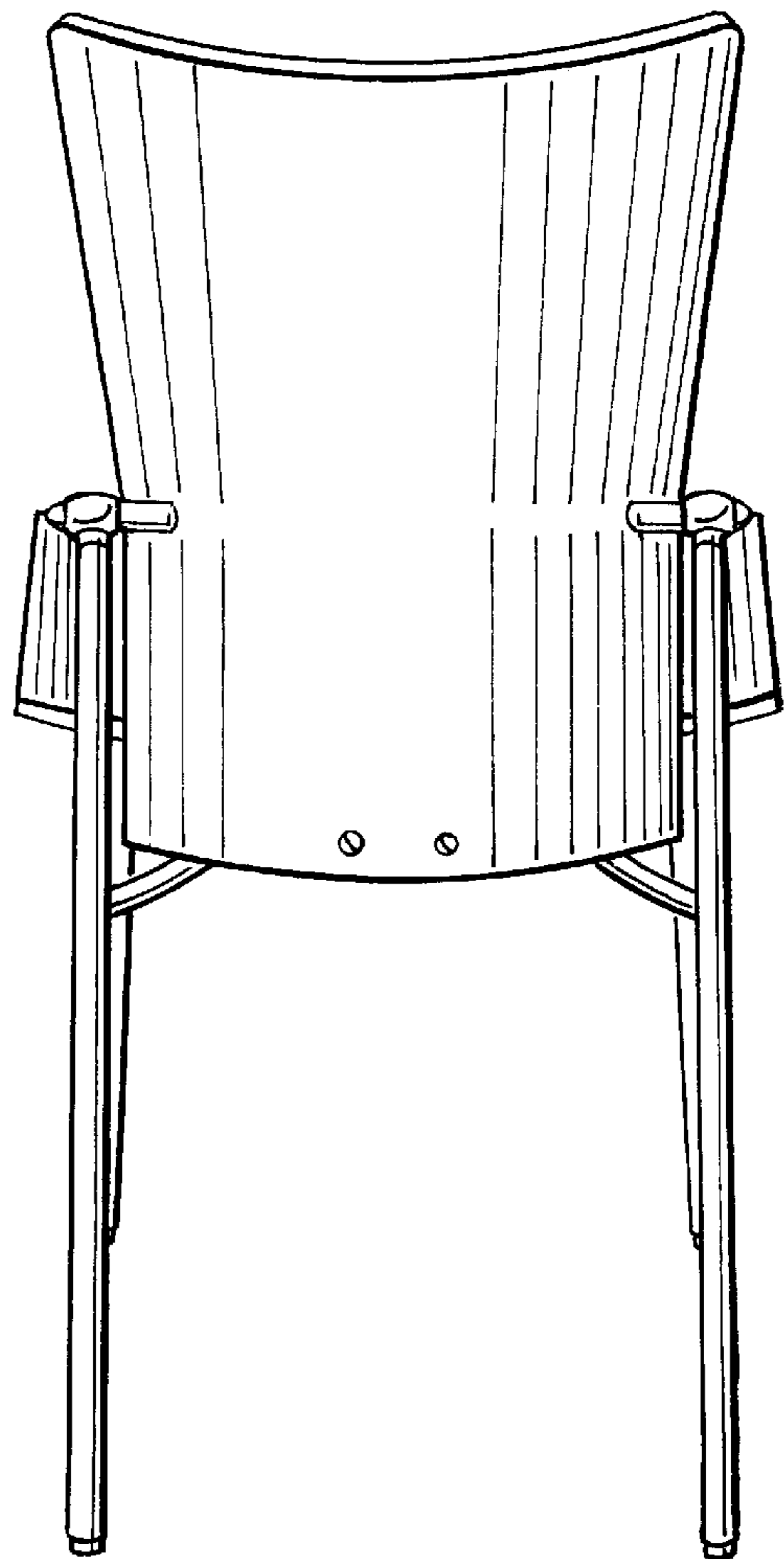

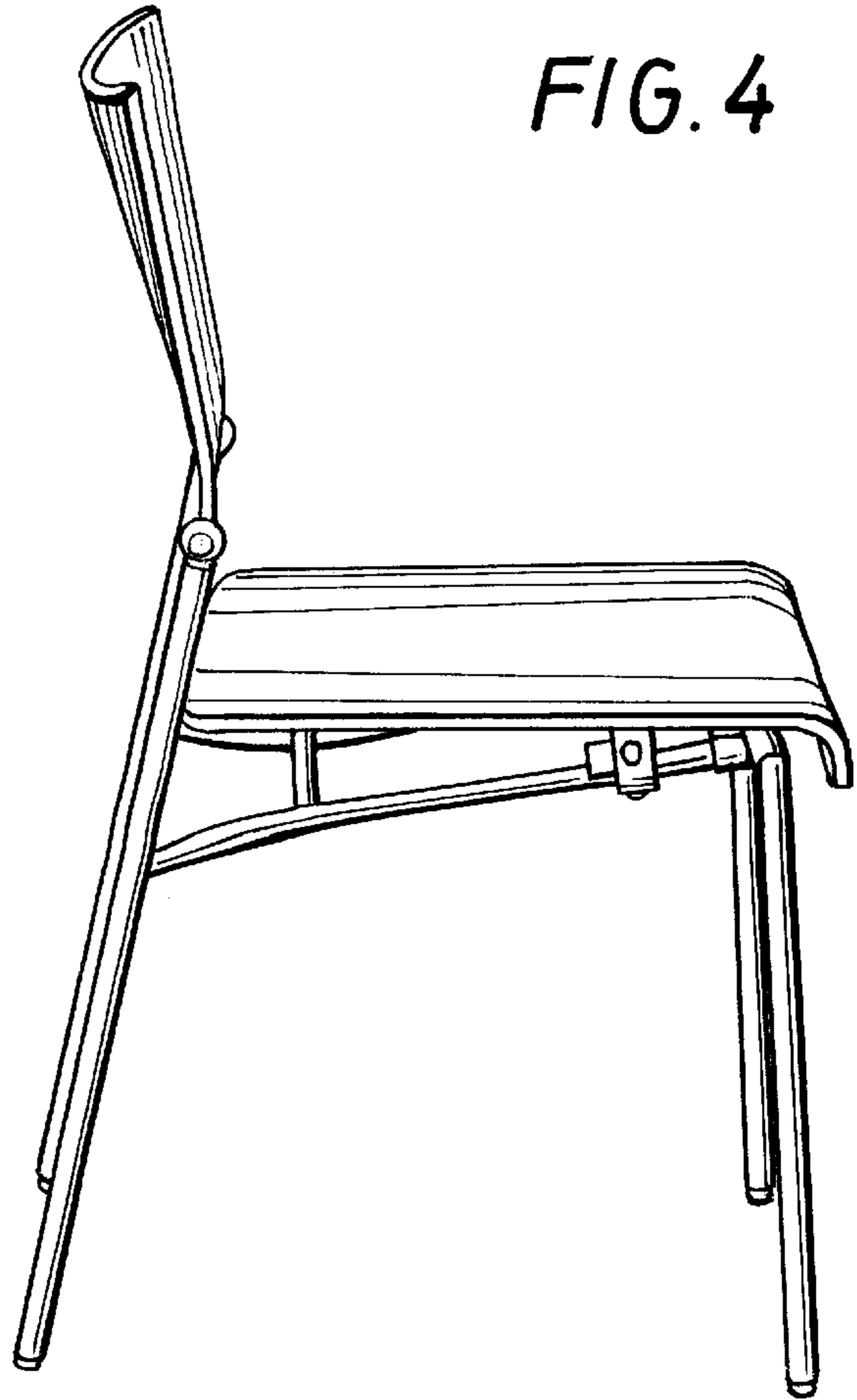
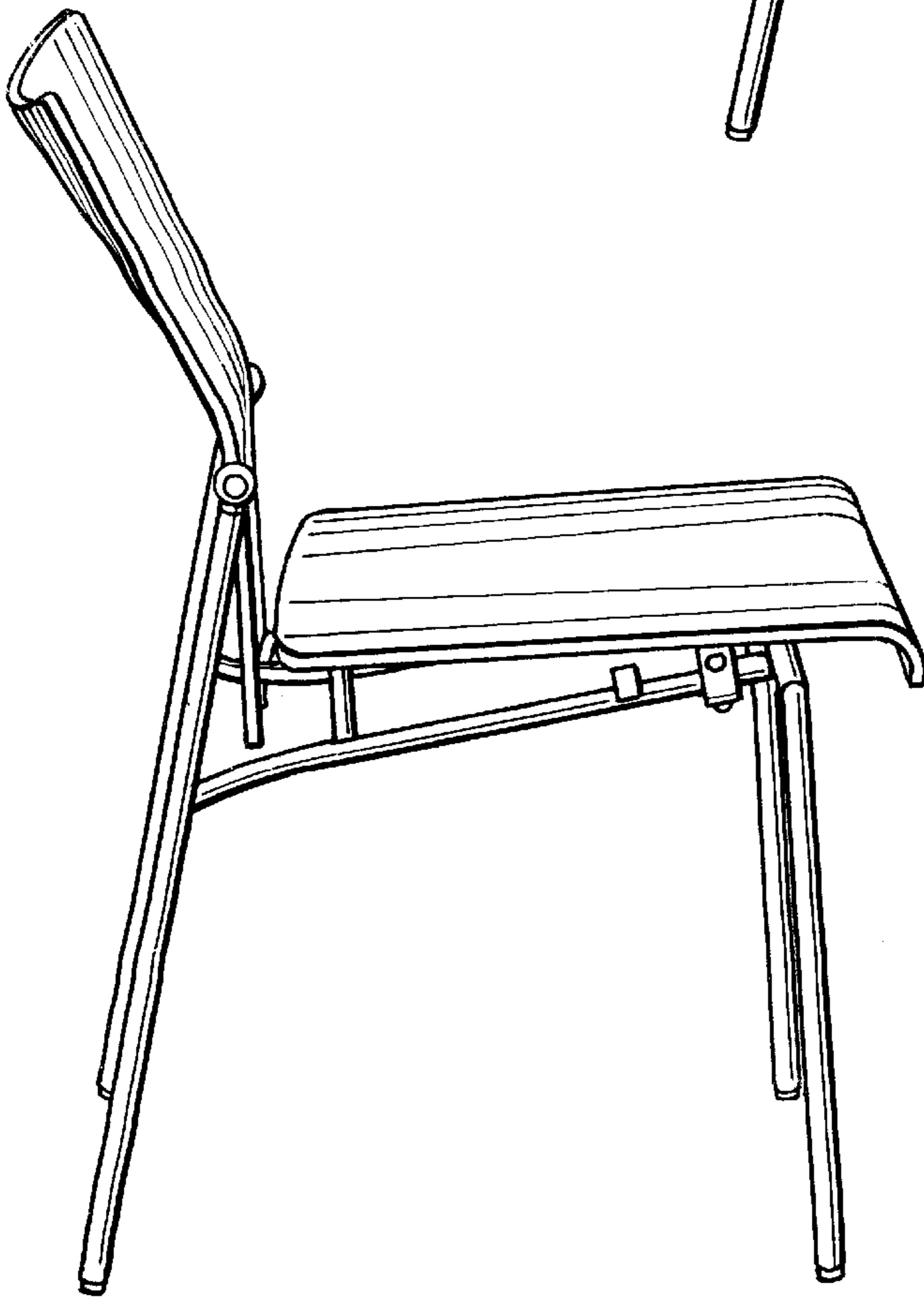
