CLAIM (57)

The ornamental design for the roadway reflector post, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a roadway reflector post showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the post of FIG. 1, rotated by approximately 120° relative to FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the post of FIG. 1, rotated by approximately 120° relative to FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view of a support segment of the post of FIGS. 1-3, the section taken along the line IV—IV in FIG. 2 and viewed in the direction of the arrows; and,

FIG. 5 is a sectional view of an upper segment of the post of FIGS. 1-3, the section taken along the line V—V in FIG. 2 and viewed in the direction of the arrows.





