## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top view of a first embodiment of a jewelry setting according to the present invention provided in an earing;

FIG. 2 is a side view of the jewelry setting of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of the jewelry setting of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a side view of a second embodiment of the jewelry setting according to the present invention;

FIG. 5 is a top view of the jewelry setting of FIG. 4;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the jewelry setting of FIG. 4.


FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the jewelry setting of FIG. 4 provided on a chain;

FIG. 8 is a top view of a third embodiment of the jewelry setting according to the present invention provided in a ring; FIG. 9 is a side view of the jewelry setting of FIG. 8 provided in the ring; and,


FIG. 10 is a perspective view of the jewelry setting of FIG. 8 provided in the ring.

















