FIG. 3 is a front view of the cleaning implement of our invention.

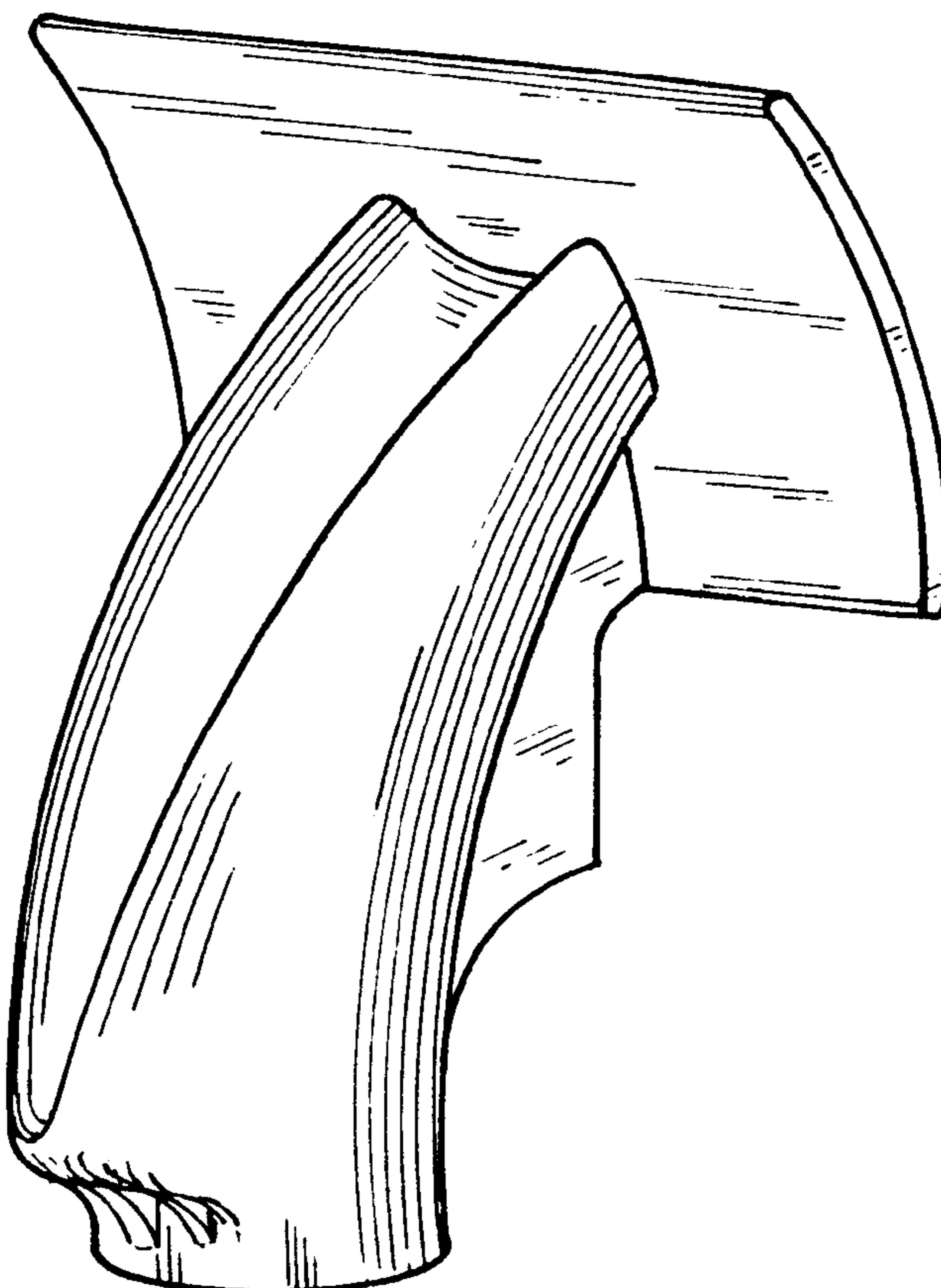
FIG. 4 is a back view of the cleaning implement of our invention.

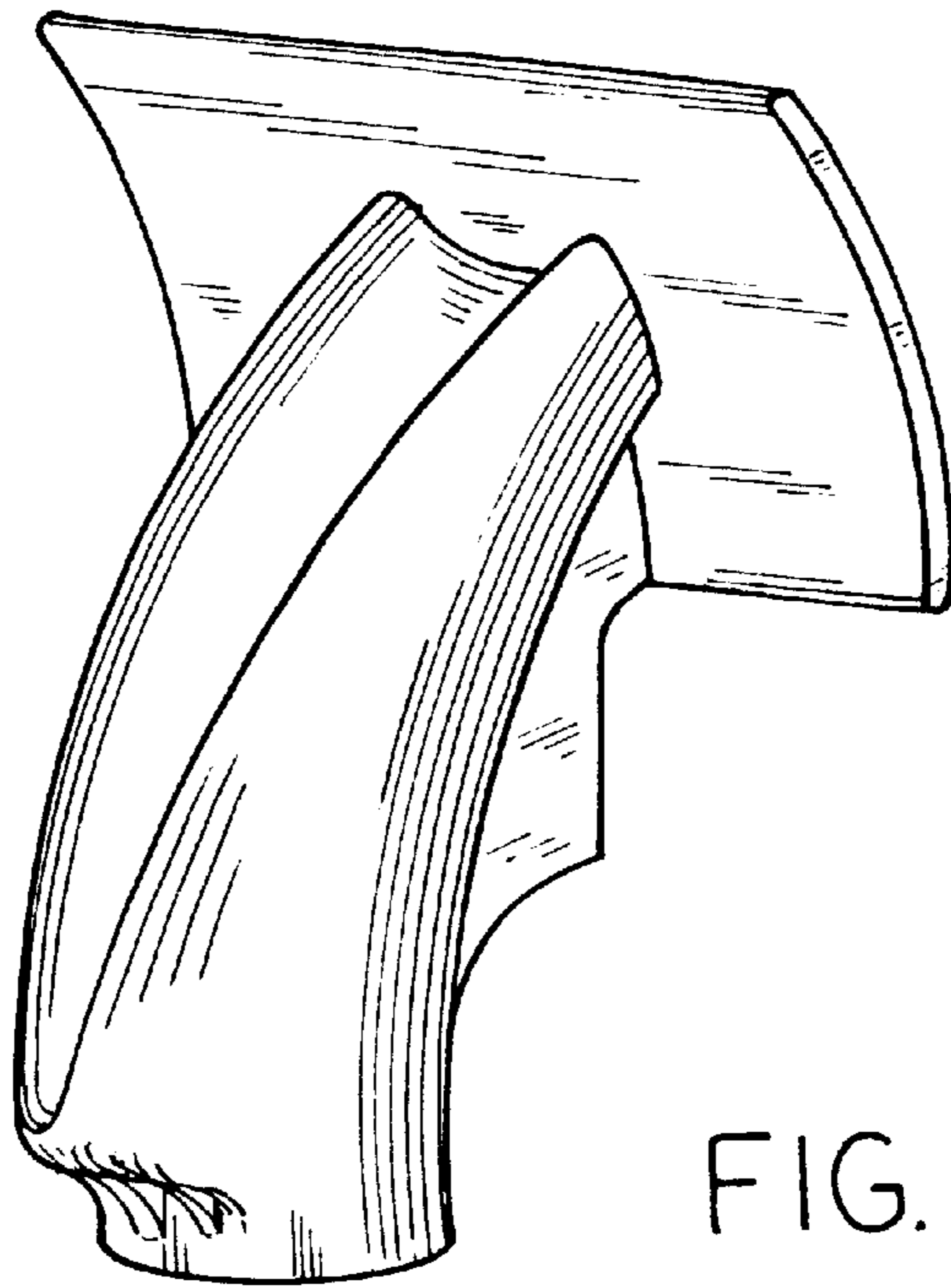

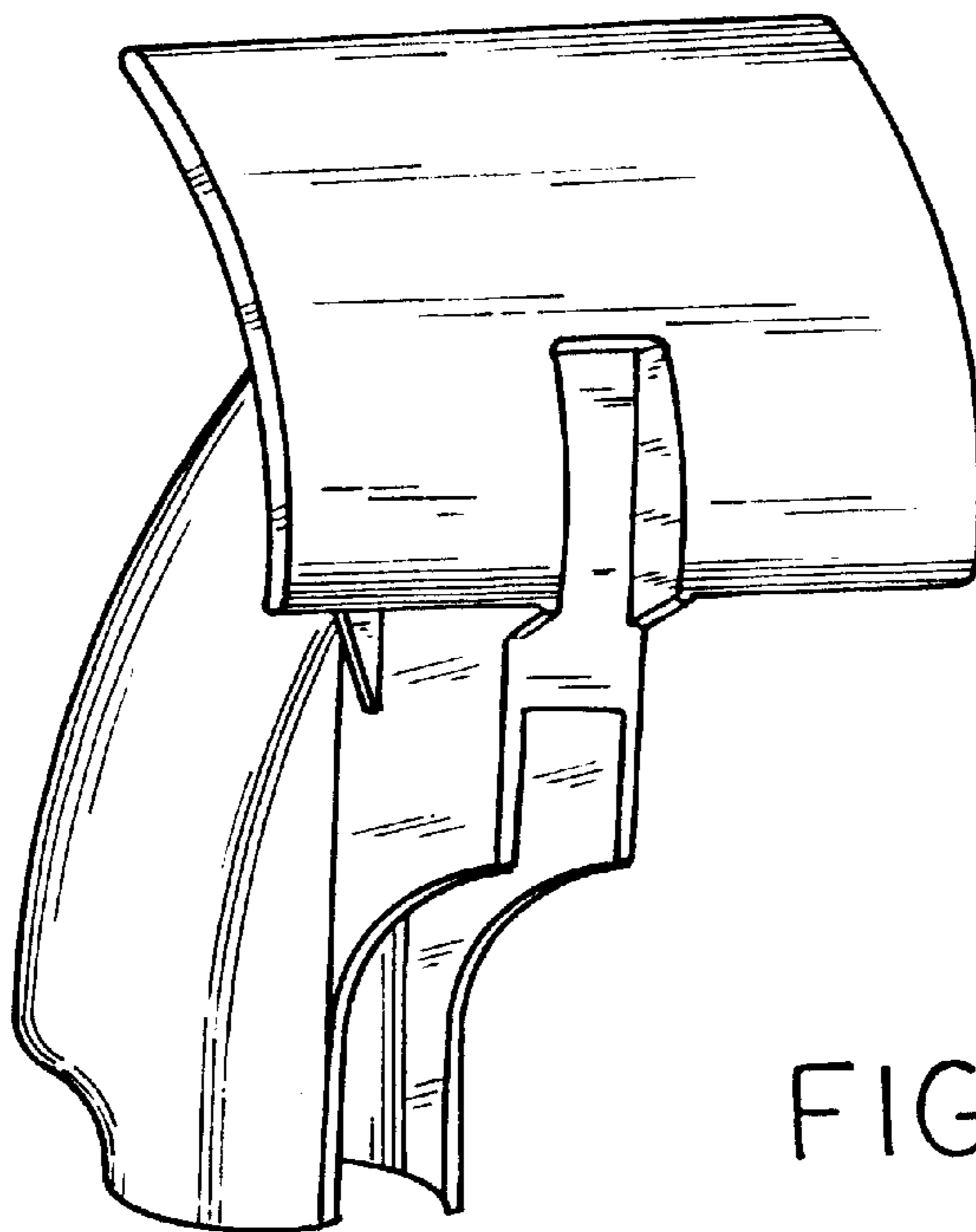

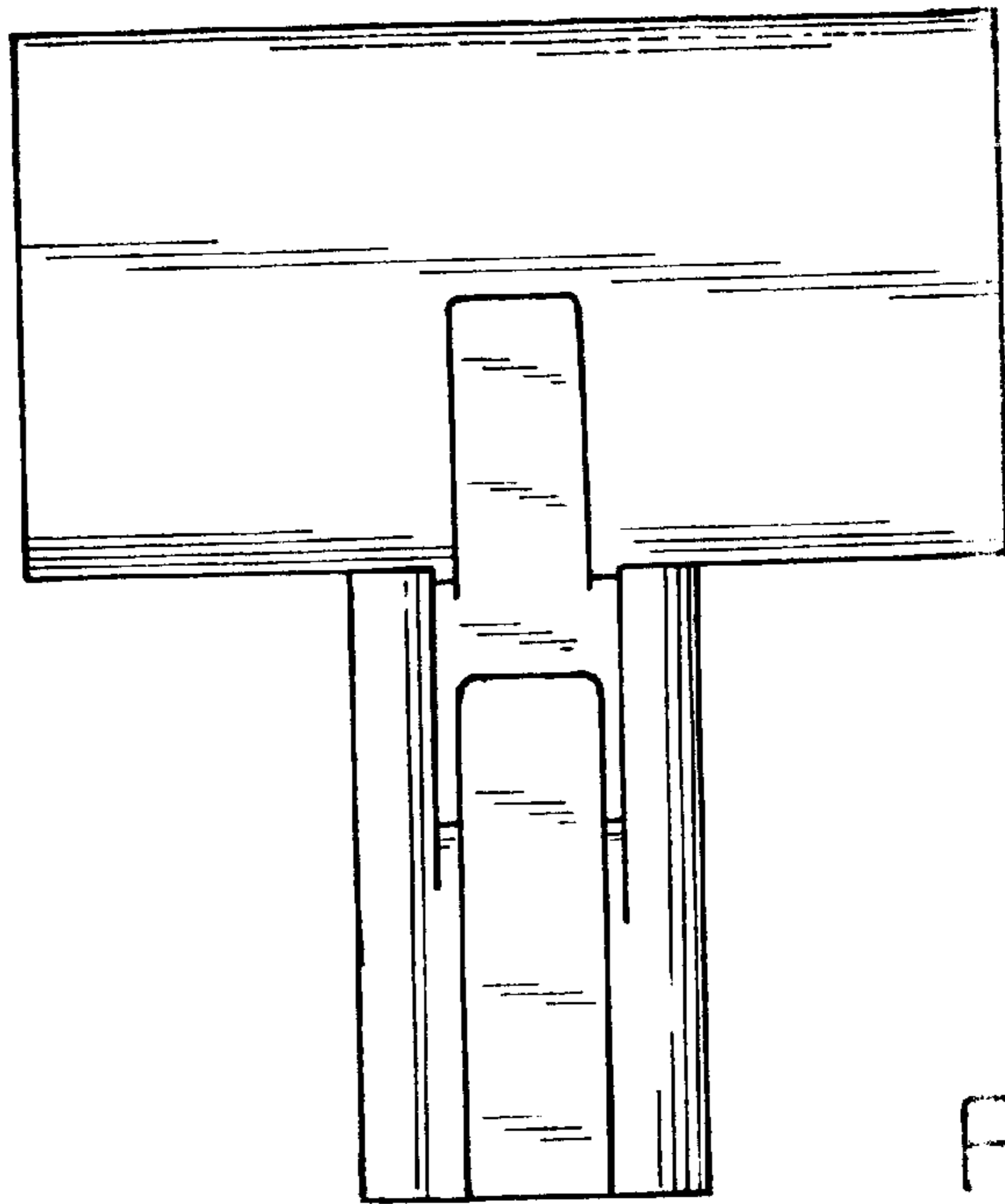

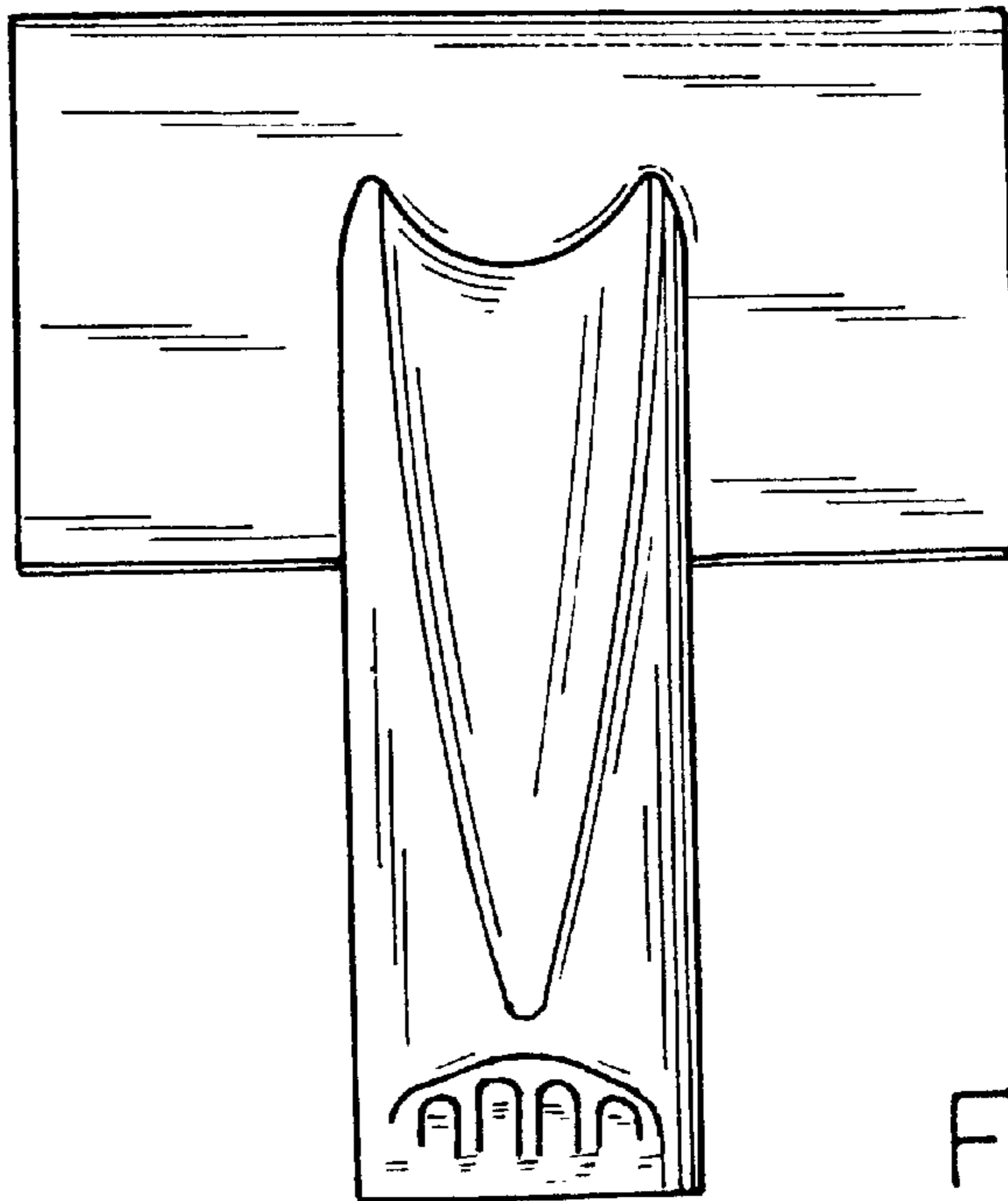

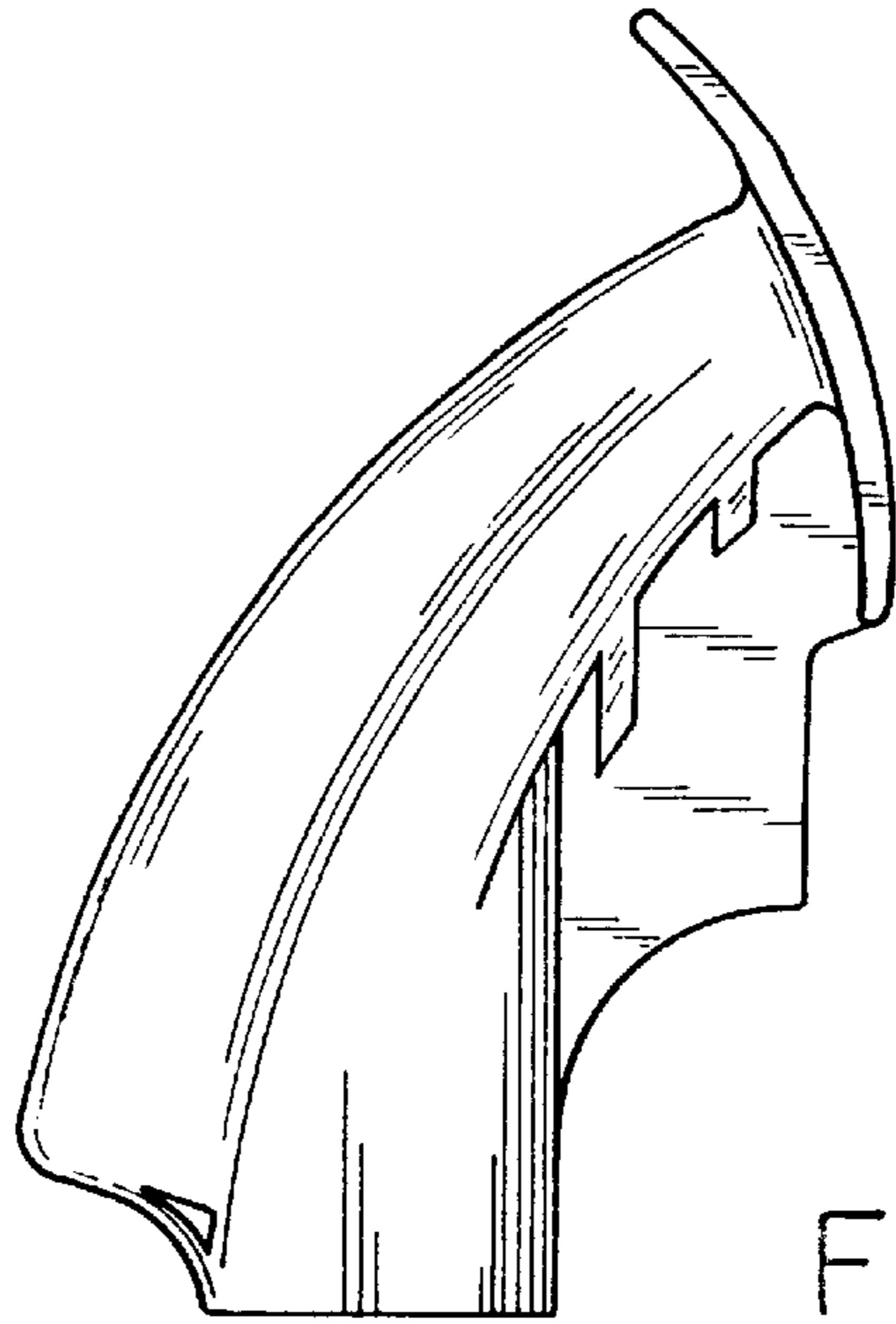

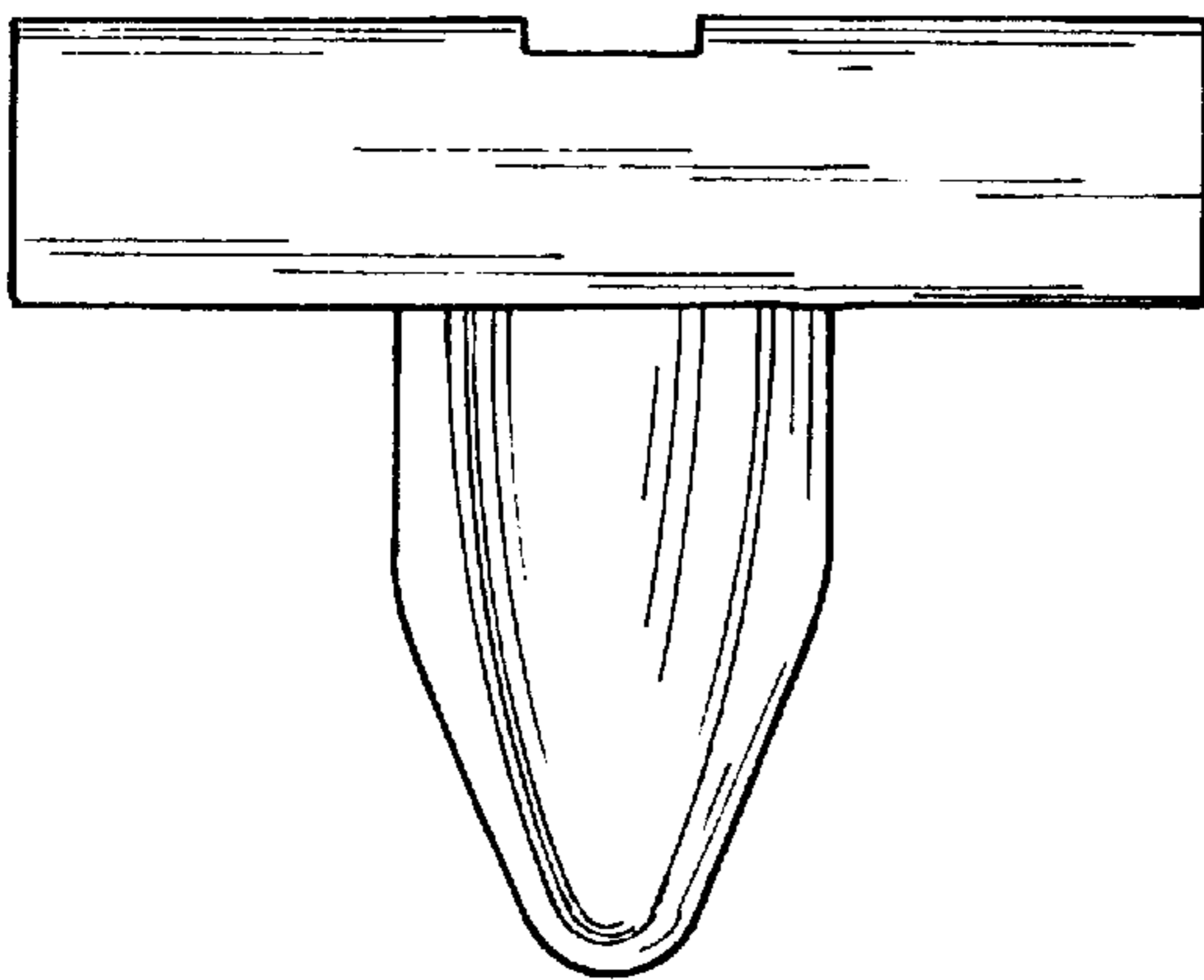

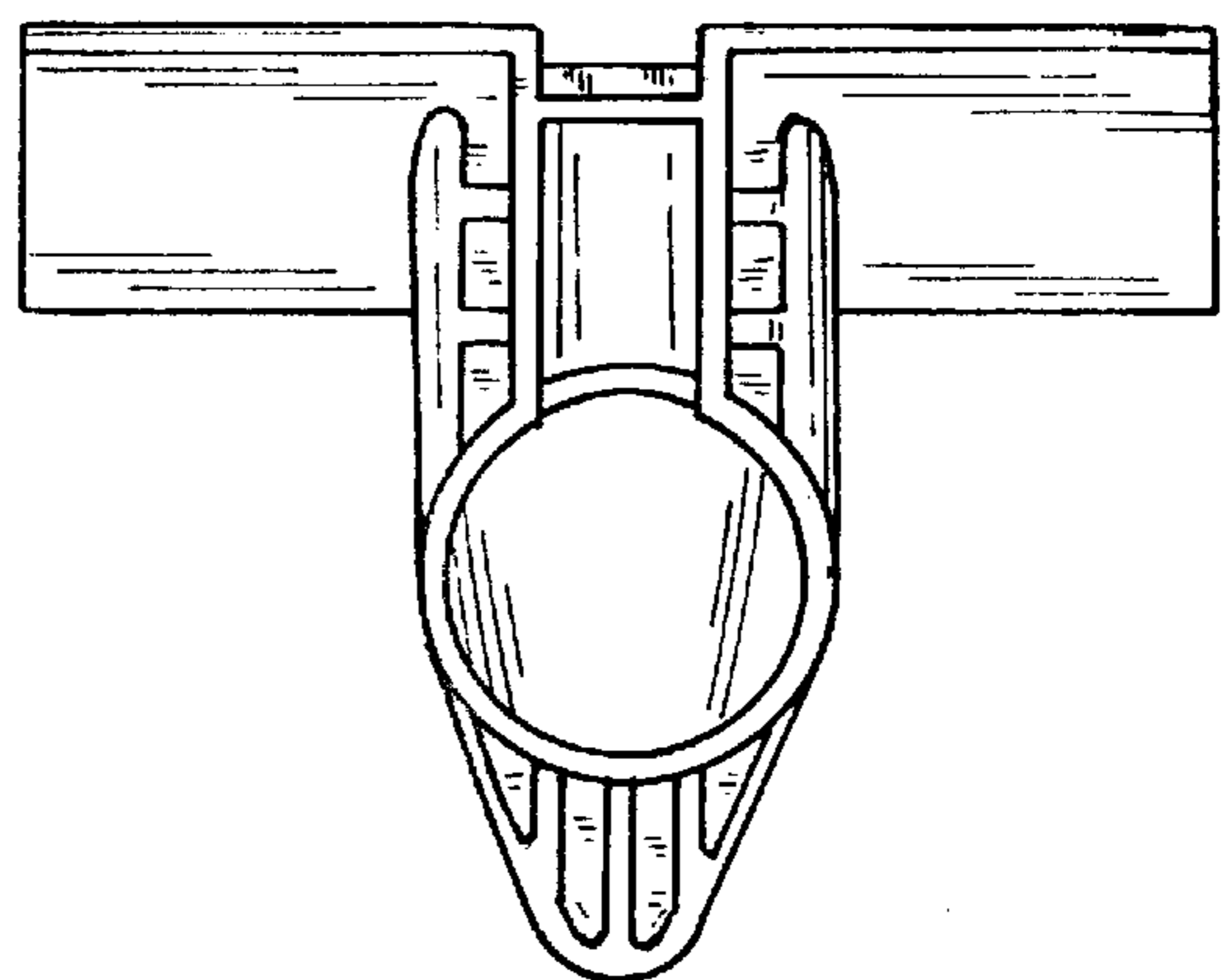
