An ornamental design for a combined blade medallion, support arm, and fan blade for a ceiling fan, as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of an ornamental design for a combined blade medallion, support arm, and fan blade for a ceiling fan;

FIG. 2 is a bottom view of the ornamental design of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 3 is a top view of the ornamental design of FIG. 1. The fan blade in FIGS. 1–3 has been shown broken away to indicate indeterminate length.
