FIG. 12 is an enlarged, fragmentary perspective view of a corner of the picture frame door of FIG. 8;

FIG. 13 is a view, taken along line 13-13 of FIG. 9; and,

FIG. 14 is another view, taken along line 19—19 of FIG. 9.

Neither the bottom nor the back of either picture frame door have been illustrated. They are unadorned and are not part of the design.

(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design of a picture frame door, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a picture frame door in accordance with the present invention;

The picture frame door has been broken vertically and horizontally for ease of illustration.
