(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an embossed non-woven fabric,  
as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the embossed non-woven fabric  
showing the design, the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1  
being the mirror image thereof; and,  
FIG. 2 is an edge view of the lower edge of the view shown  
in FIG. 1.

The dotted lines define a portion of the embossed non-  
woven fabric and indicate that it continues indeterminately  
in one or more directions and the surface pattern is under-  
stood to repeat uniformly throughout the length and width of  
the embossed non-woven fabric. The dotted lines form no  
part of the claimed design.

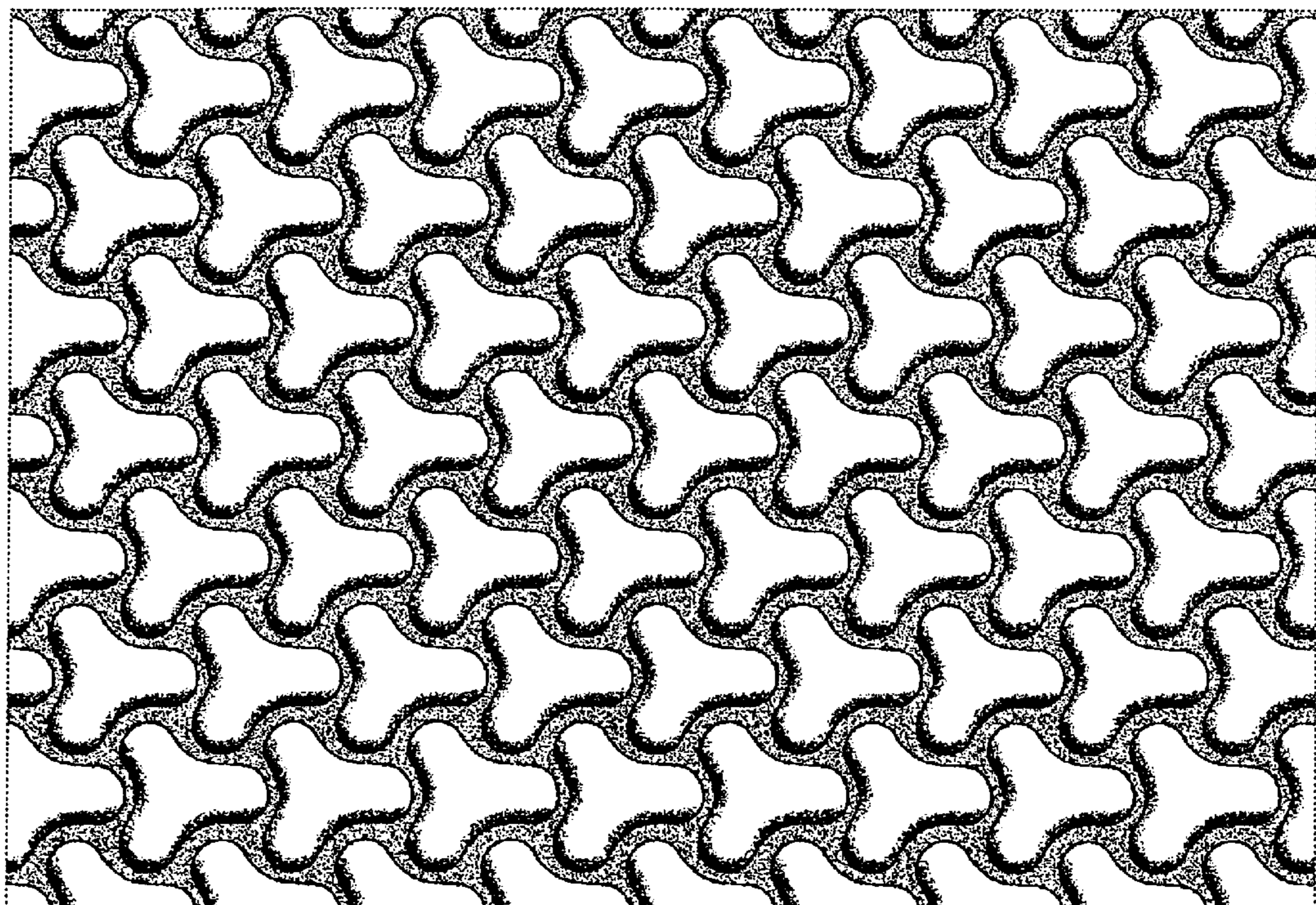

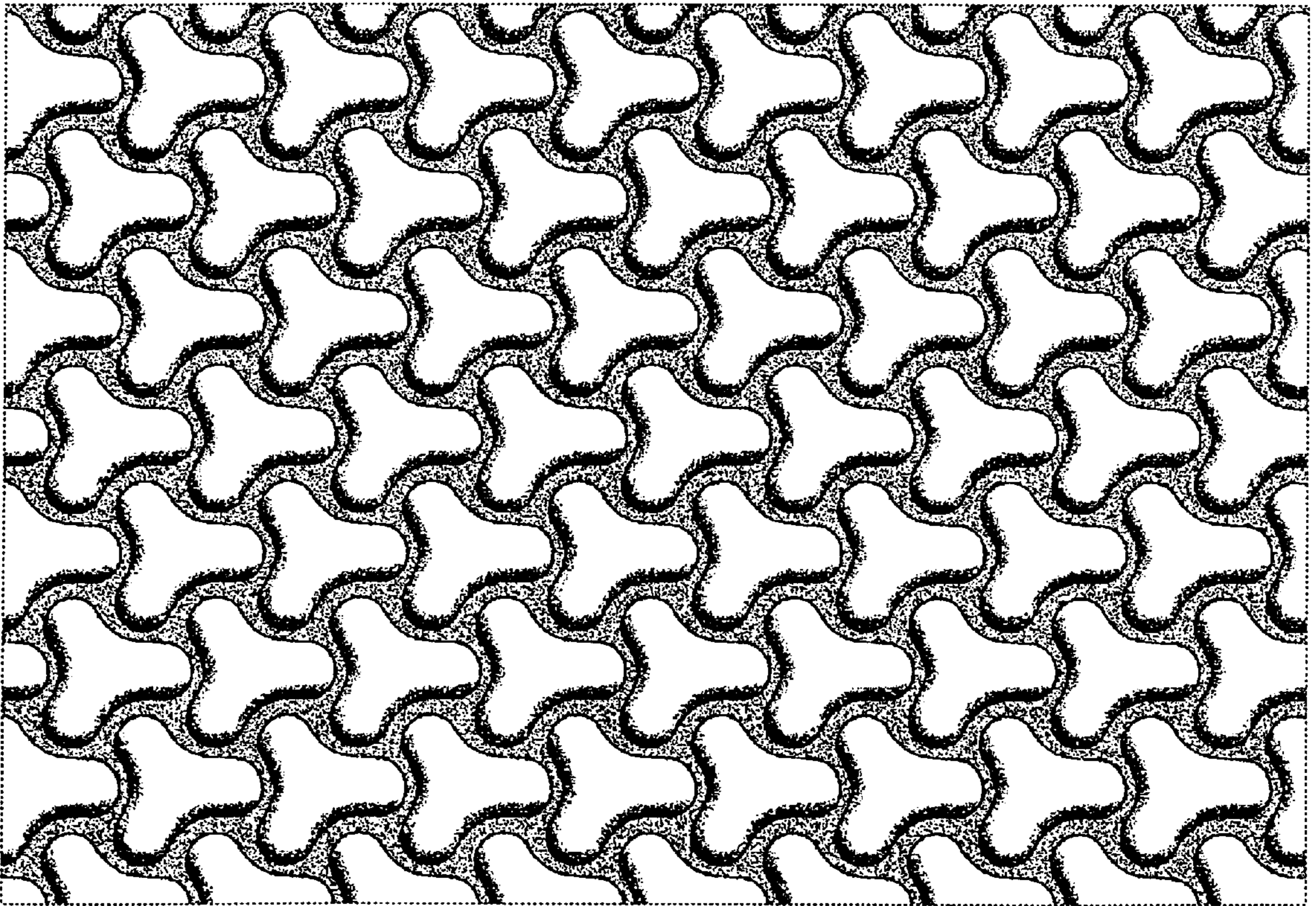
