FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view of the second embodiment of the new design.

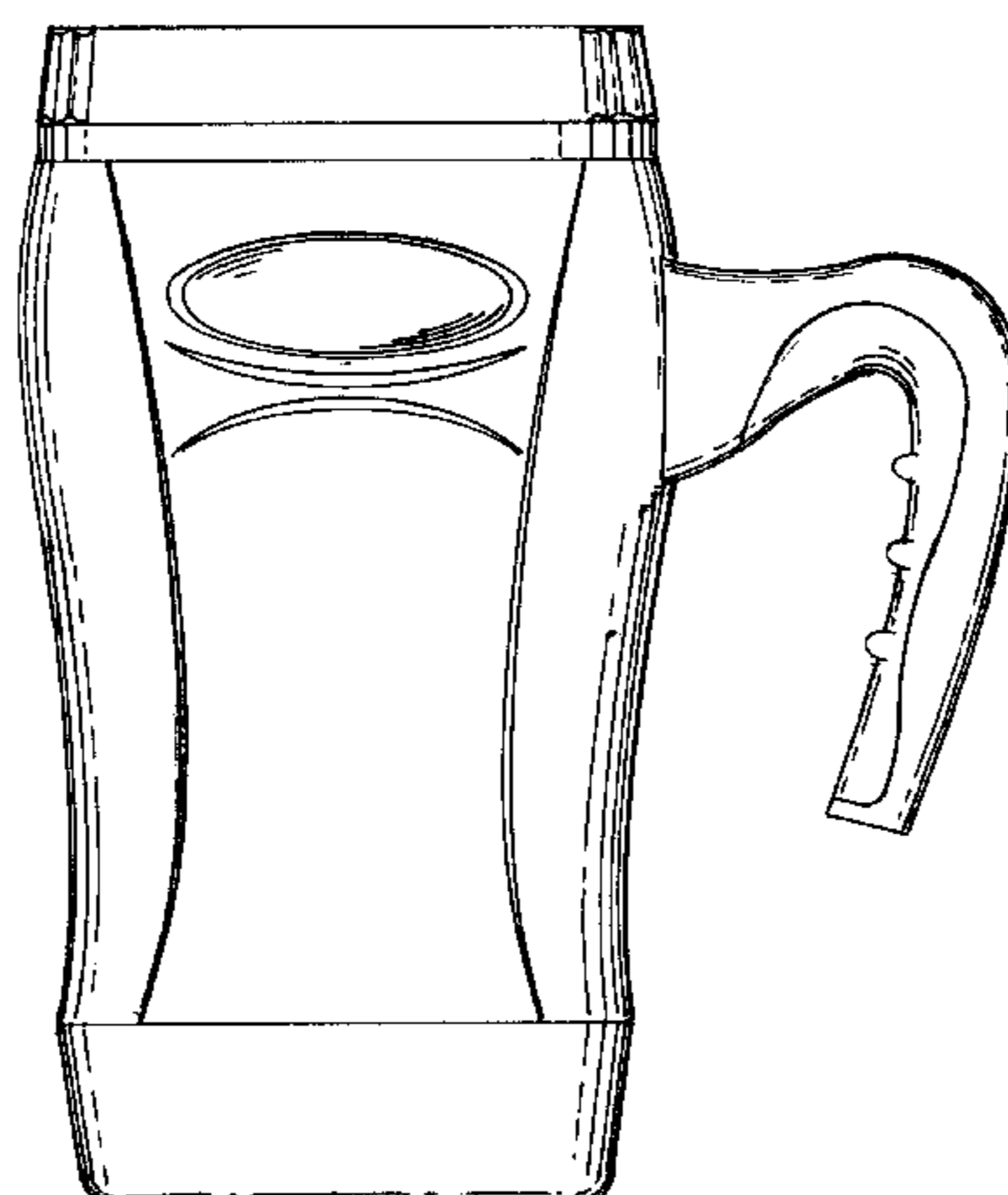
FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view of the second embodiment of the new design.

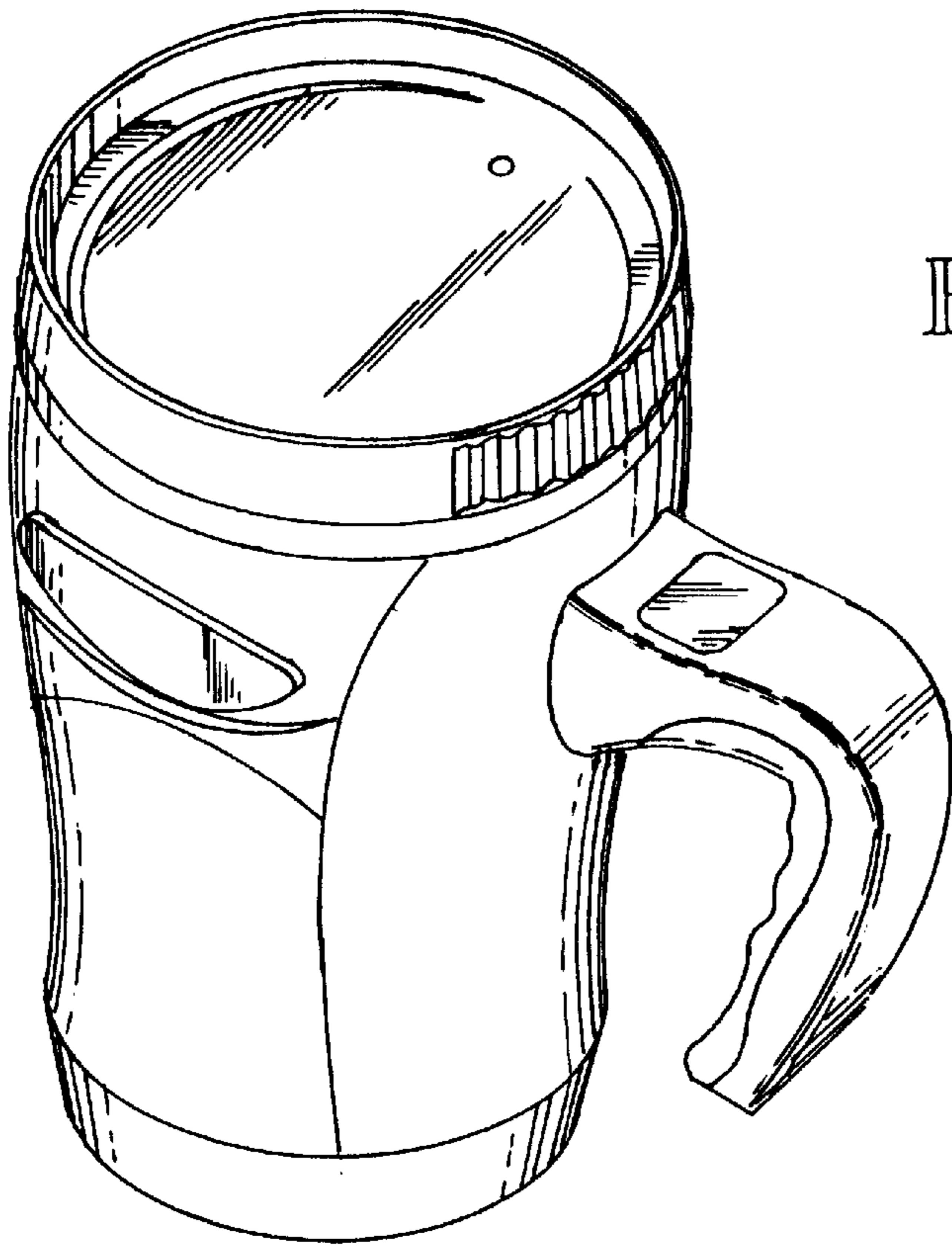

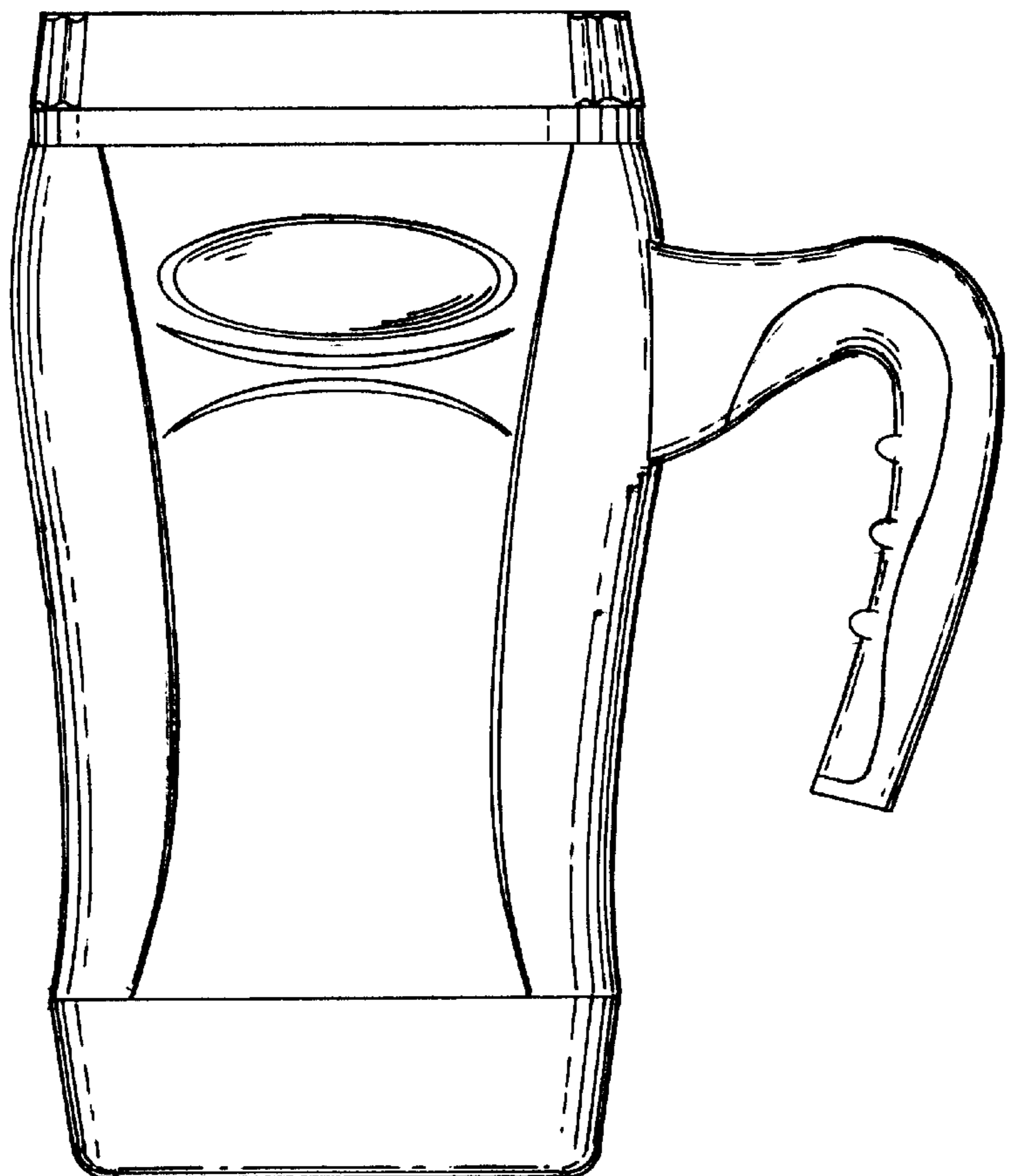

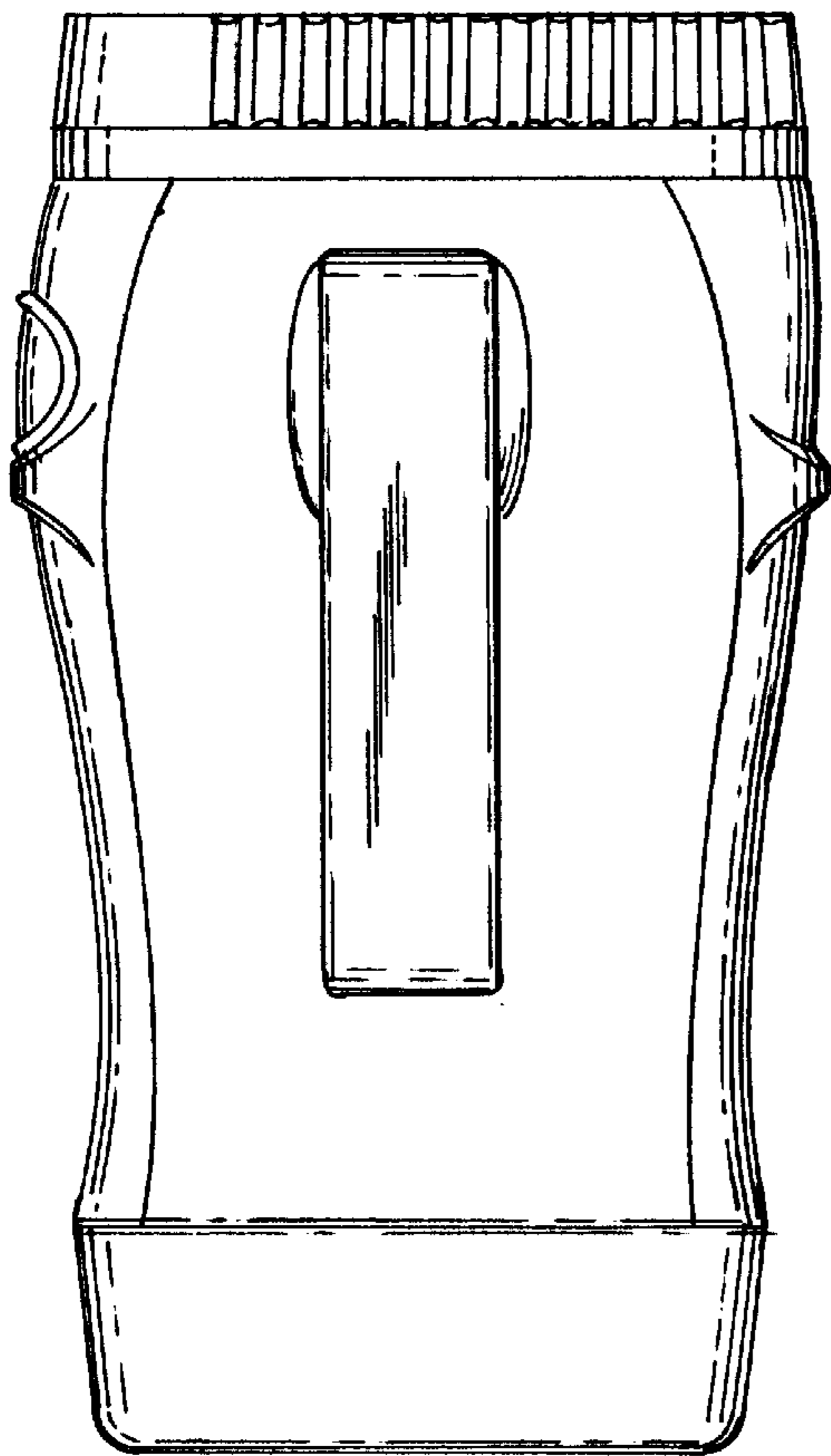

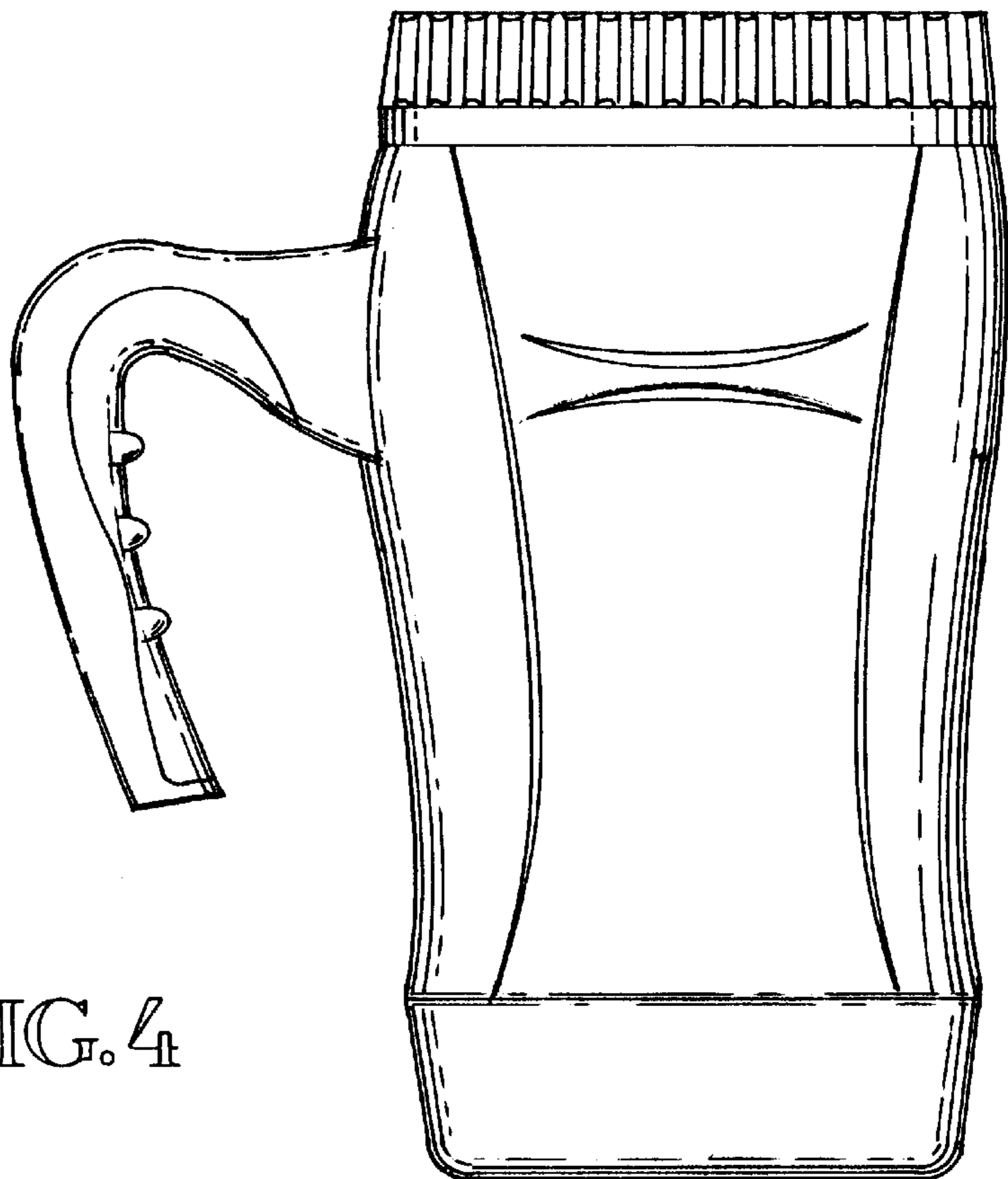

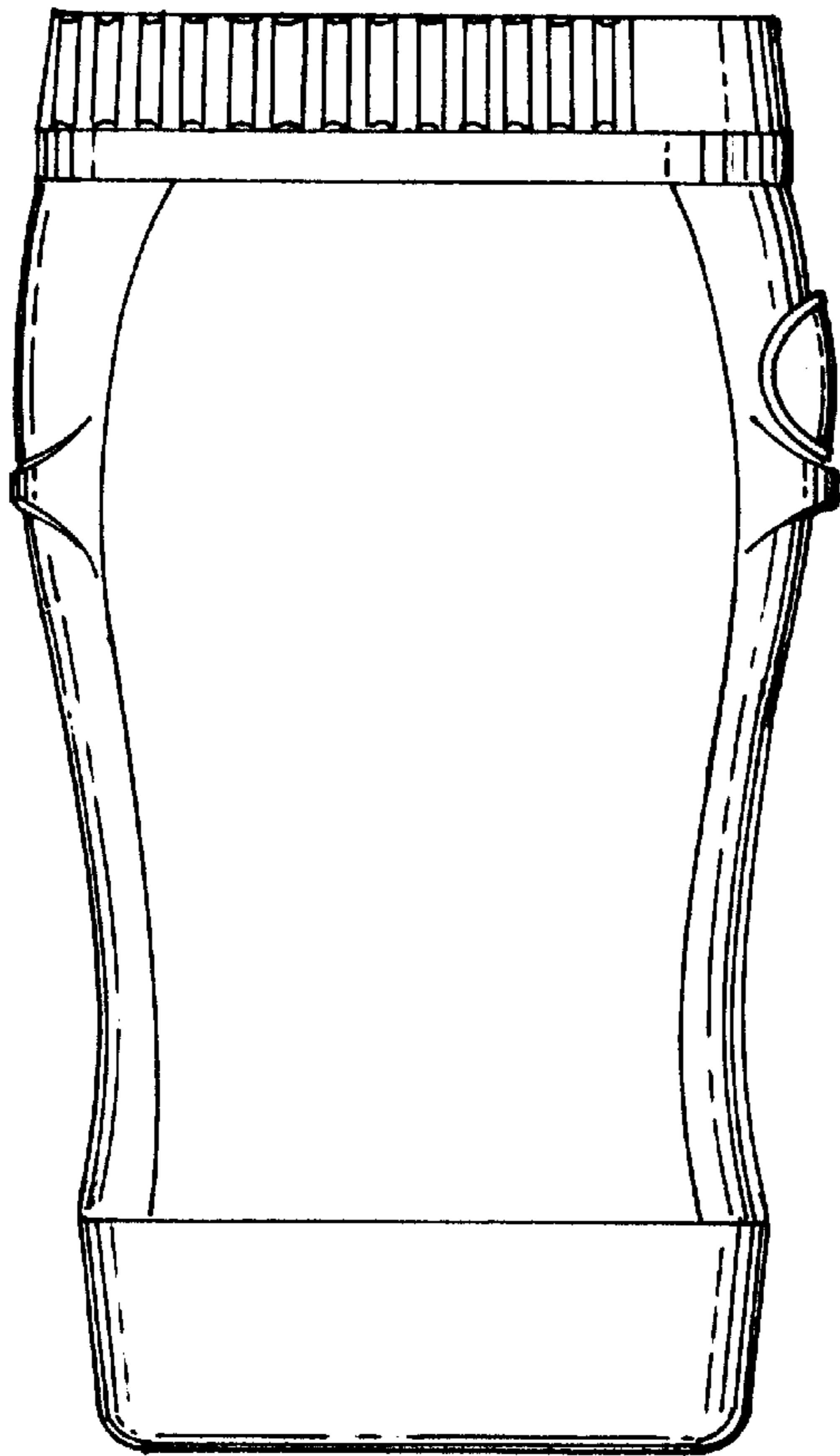

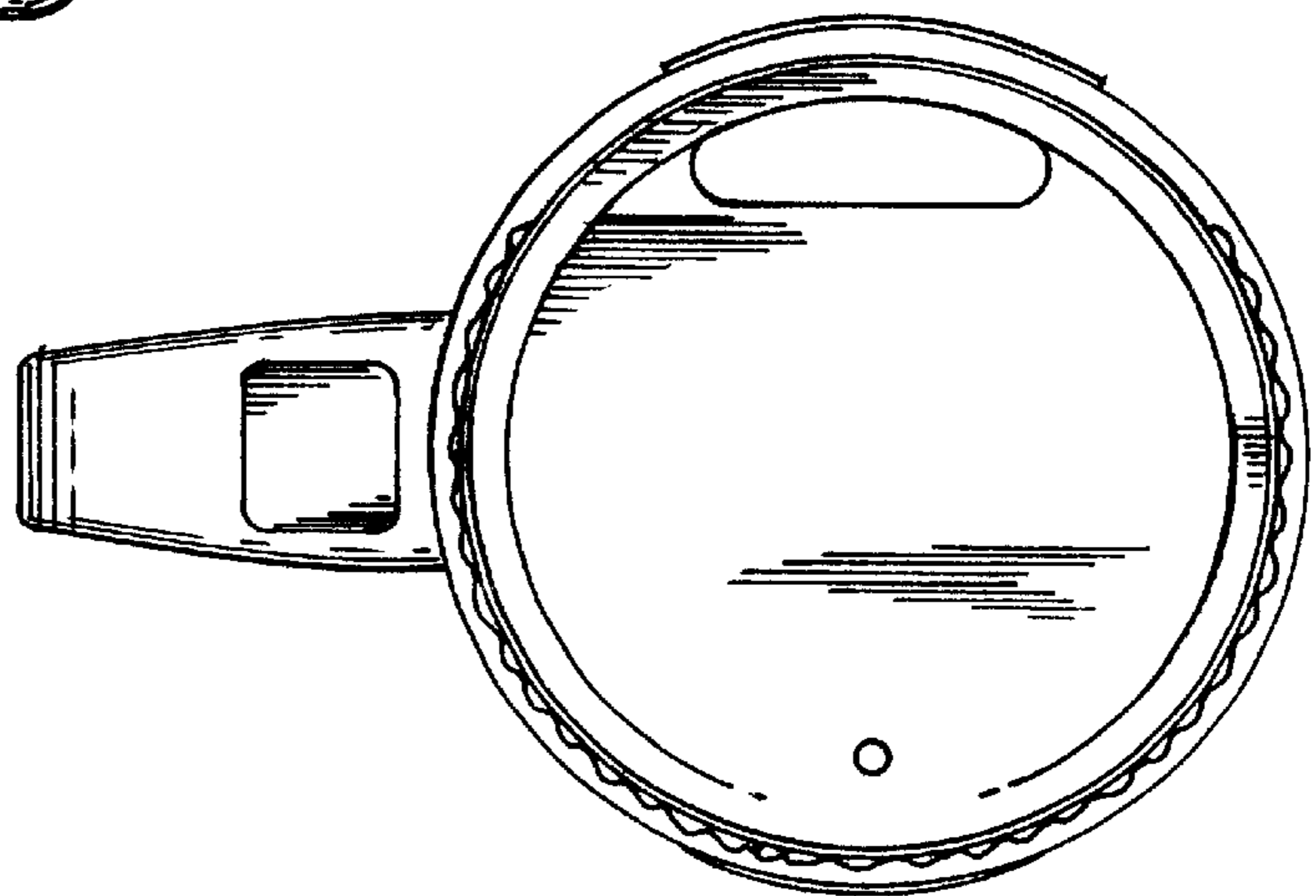

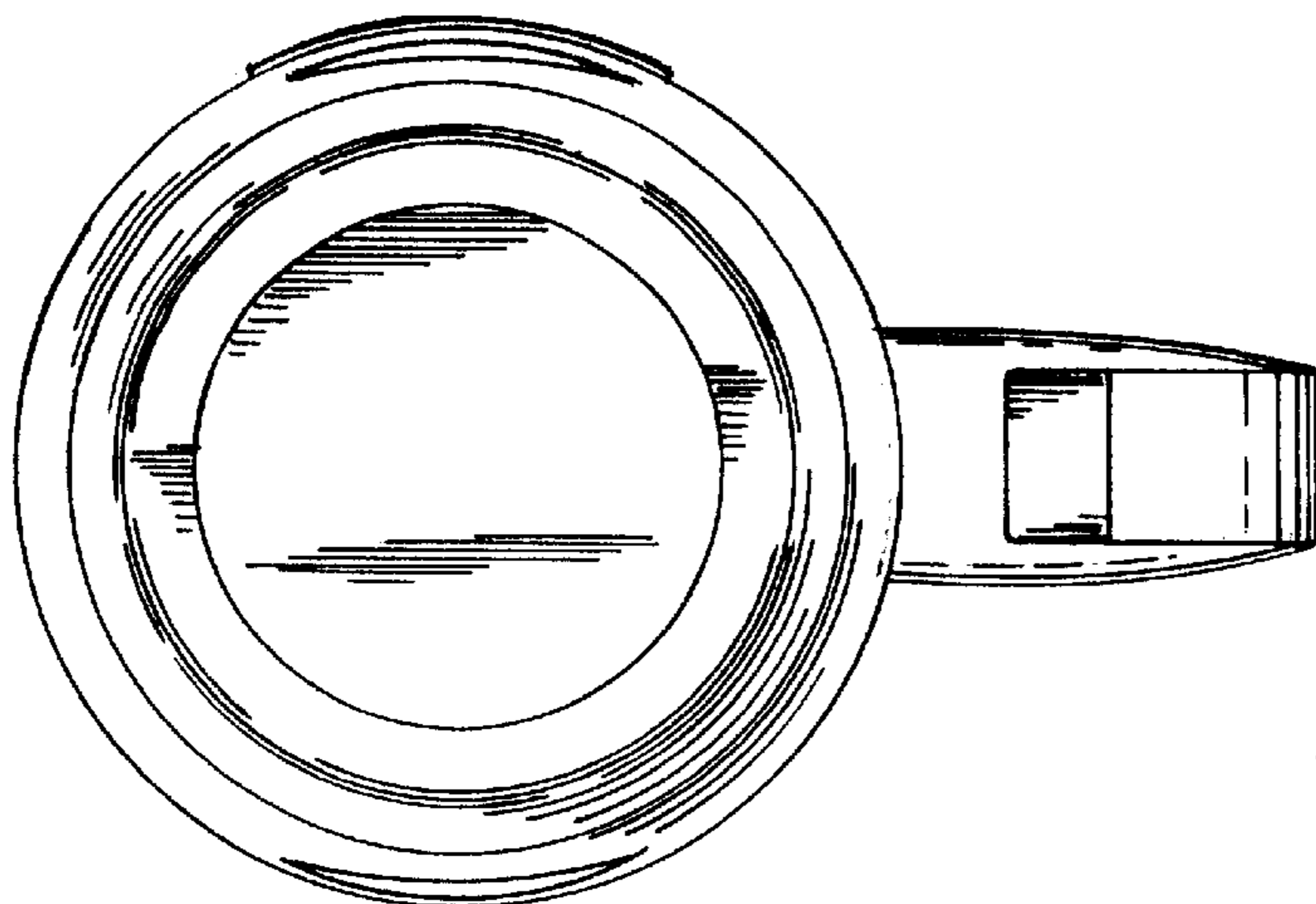

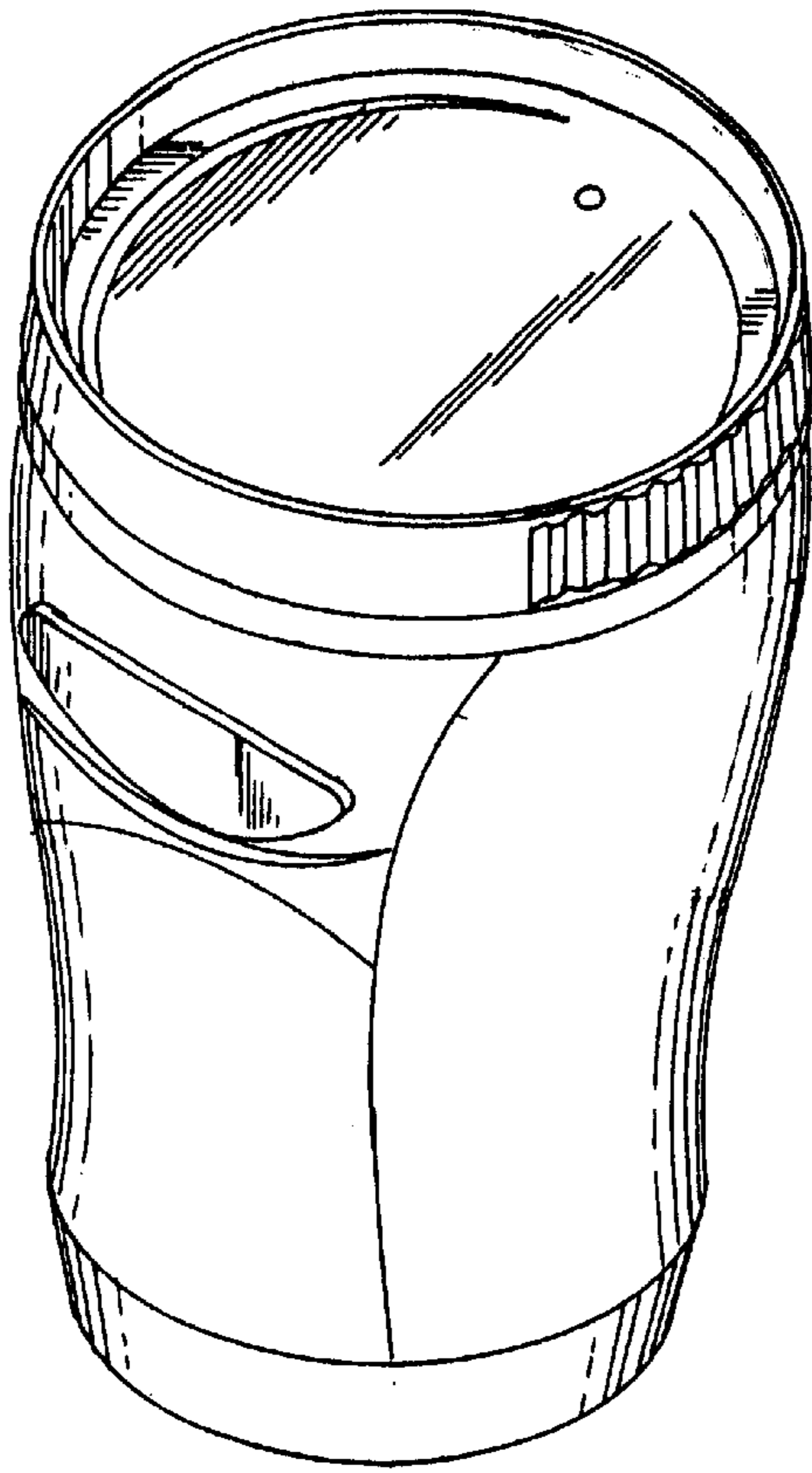

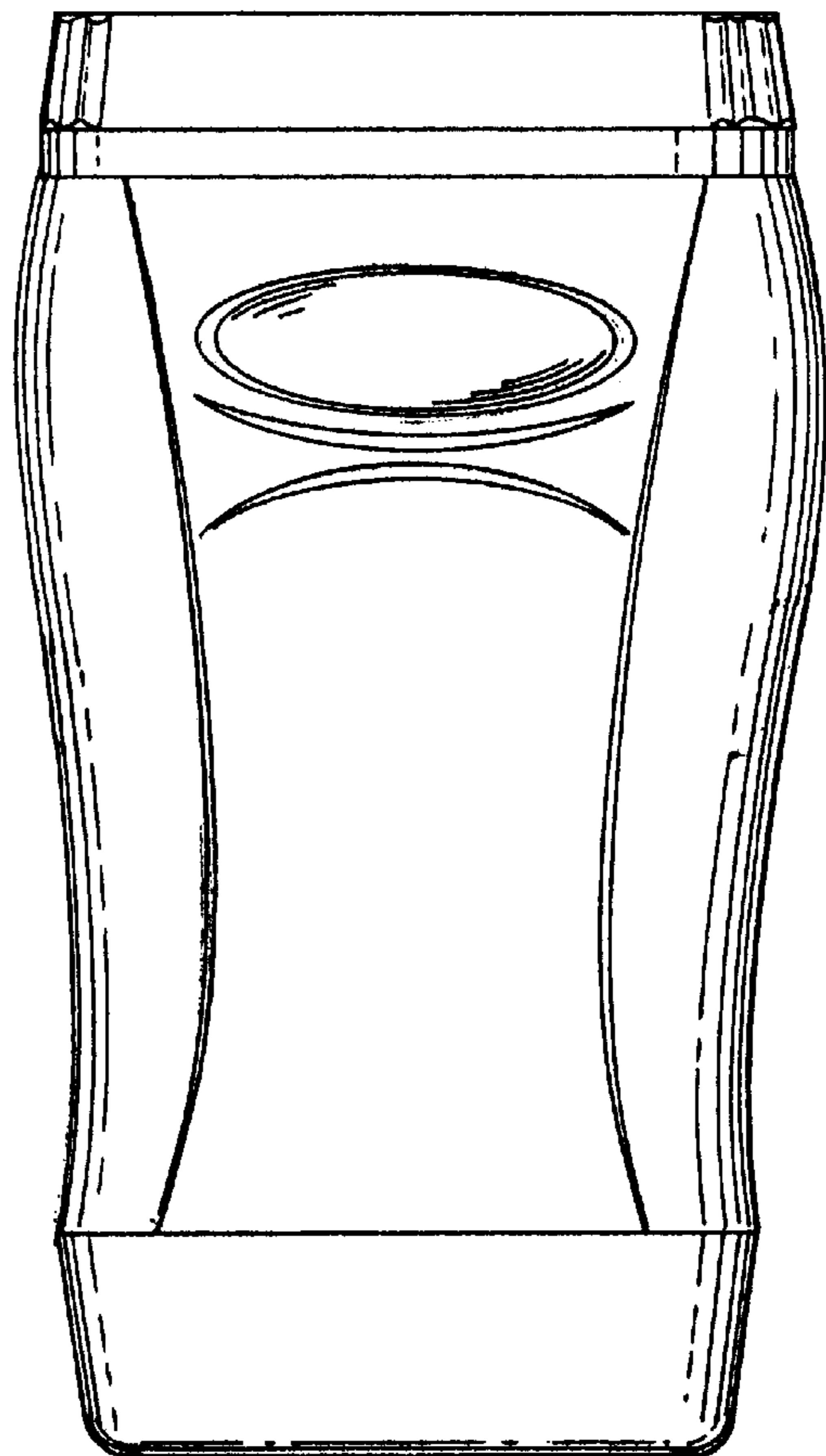

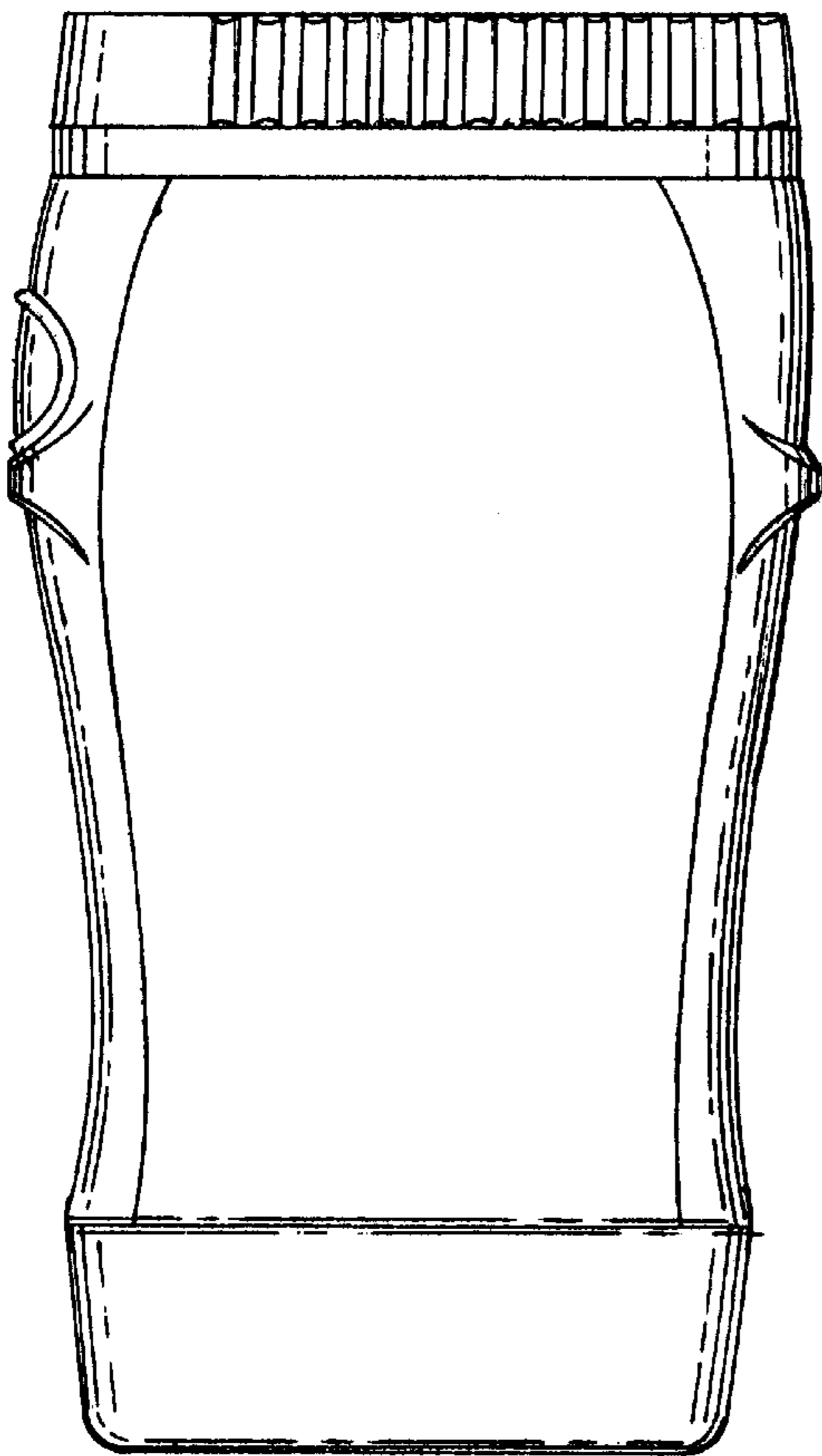

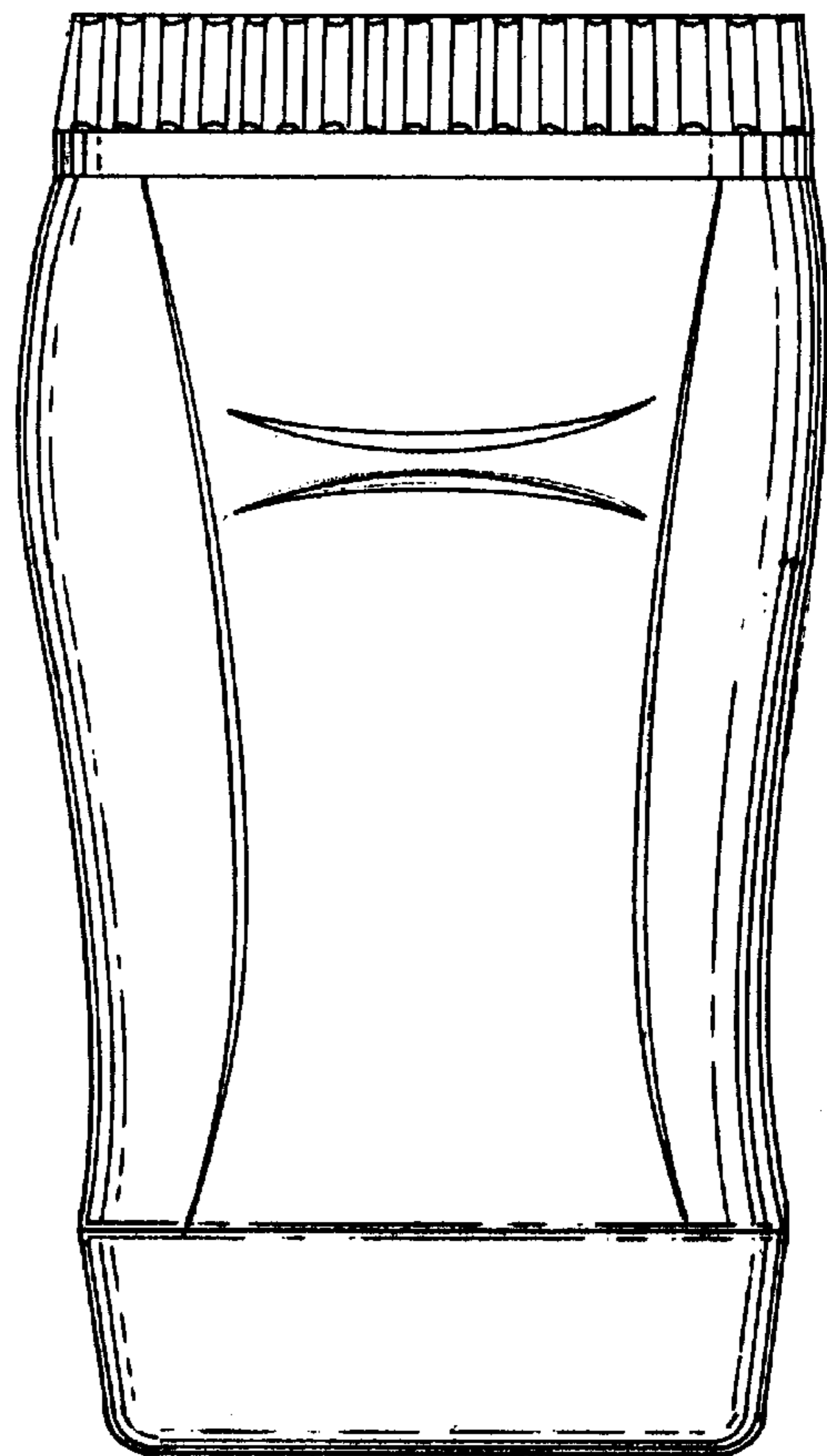

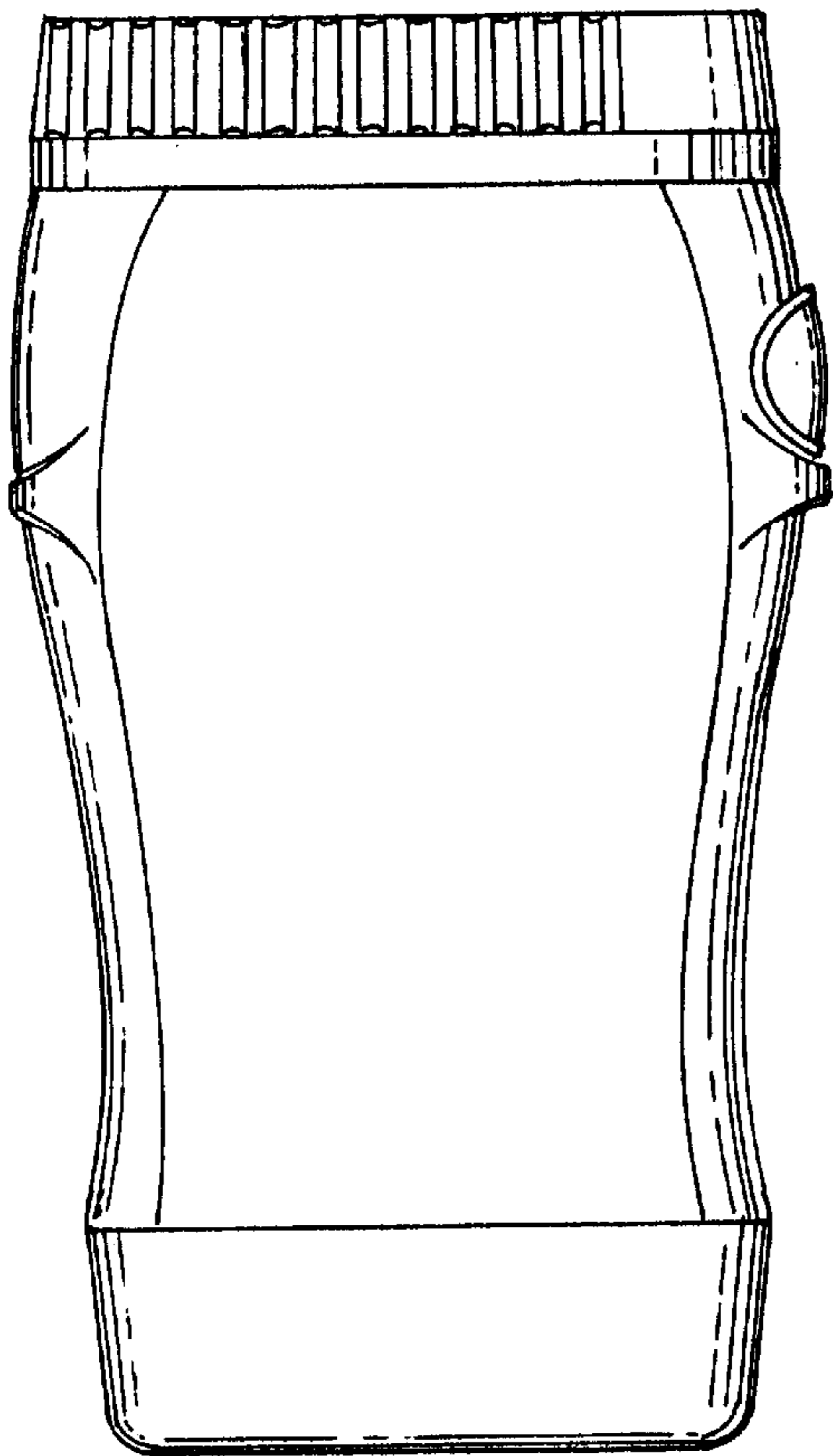

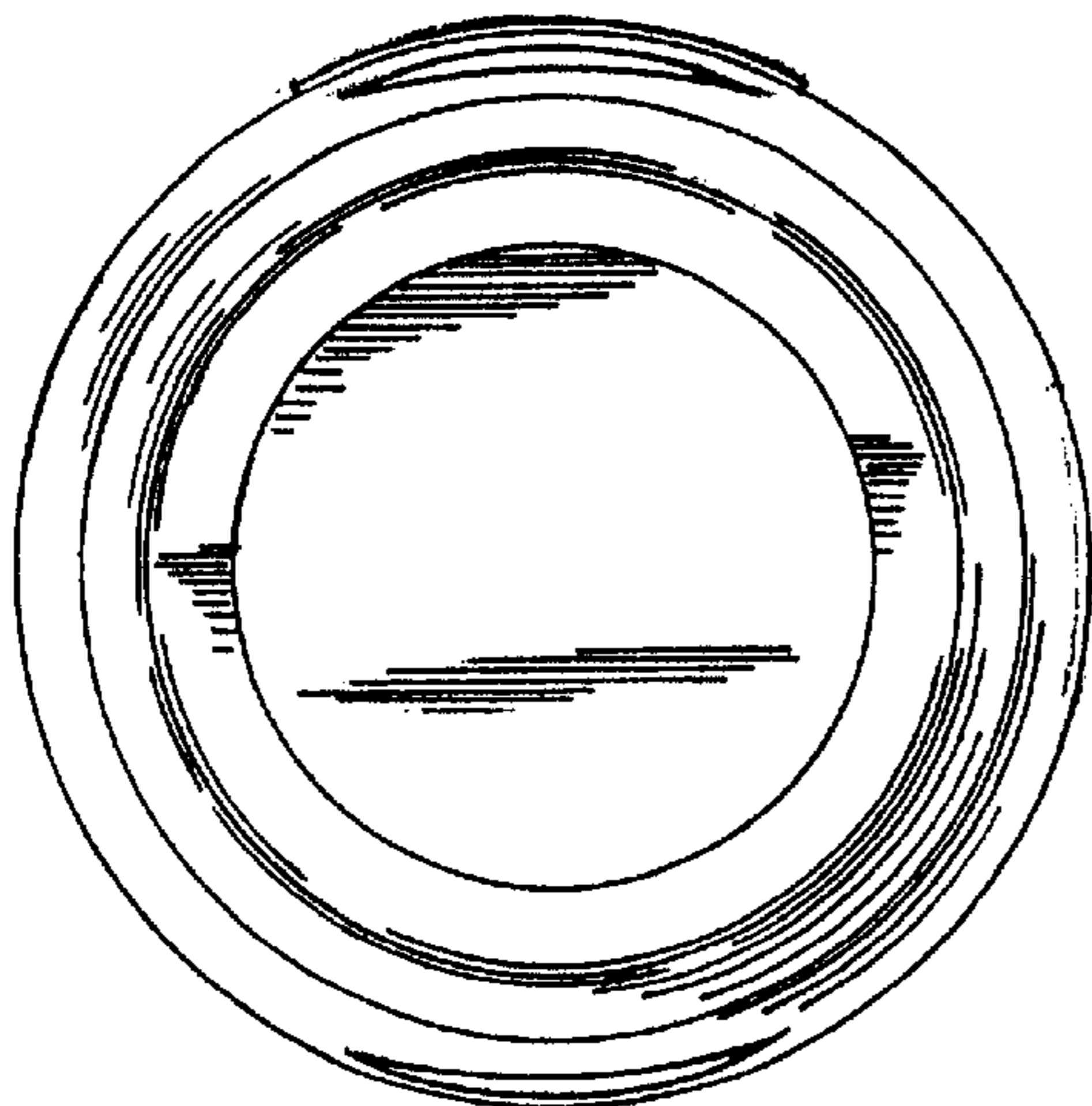
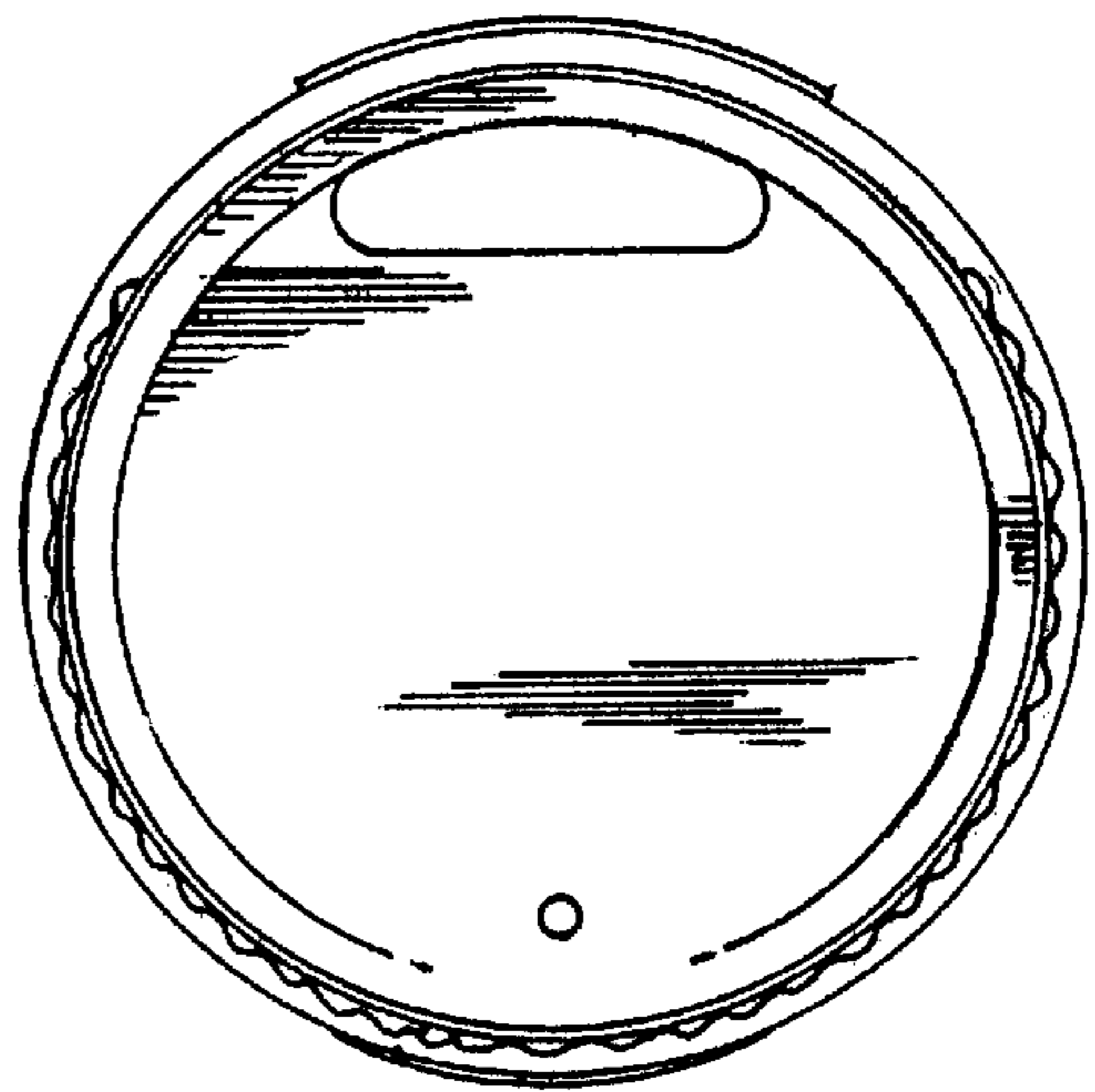
