**DESCRIPTION**

side depicted in FIG. 2 of the subject amusement device.

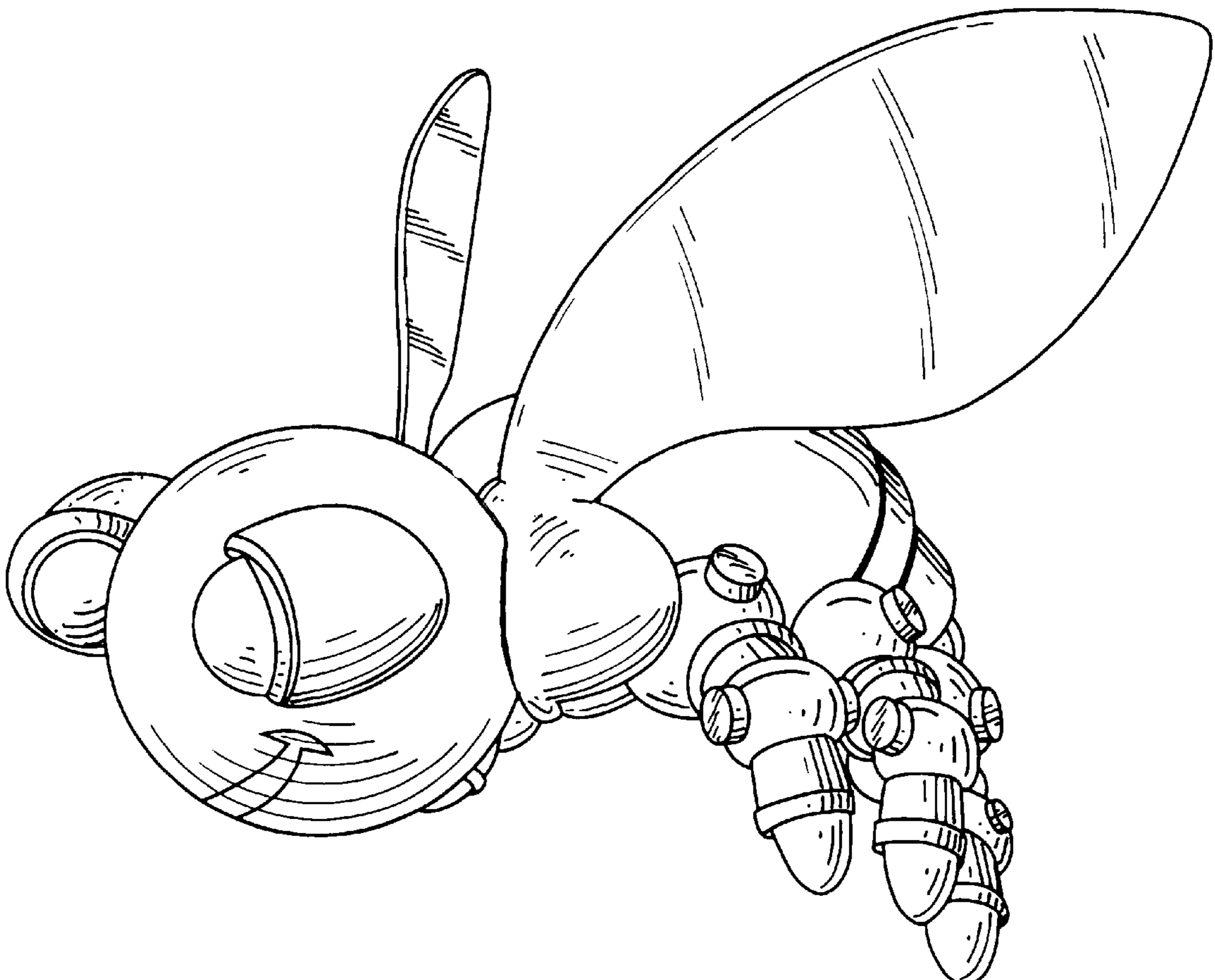
FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the front end of the

embodiment depicted in FIG. 1.

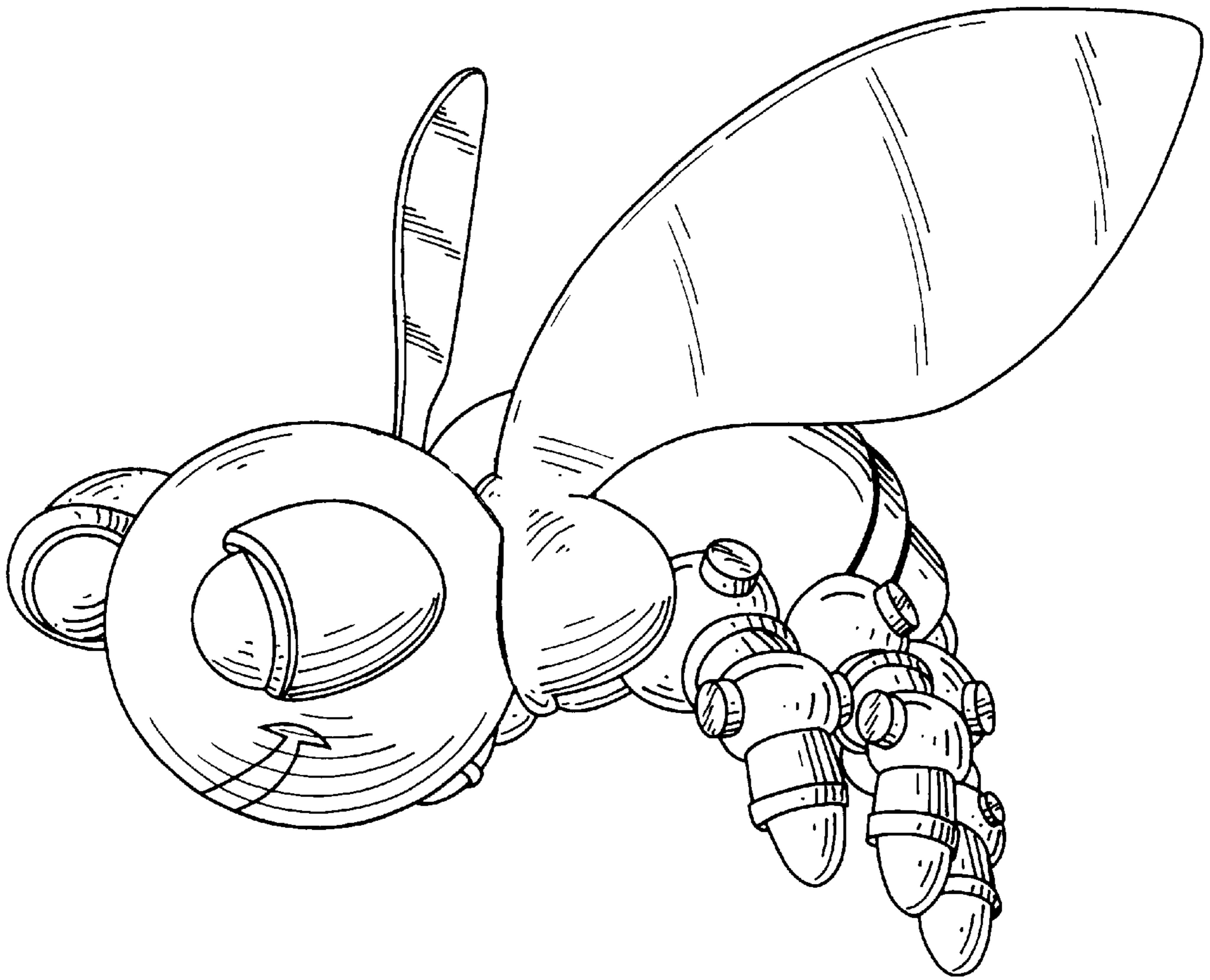
FIG. 6 is a top perspective view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom perspective view thereof.

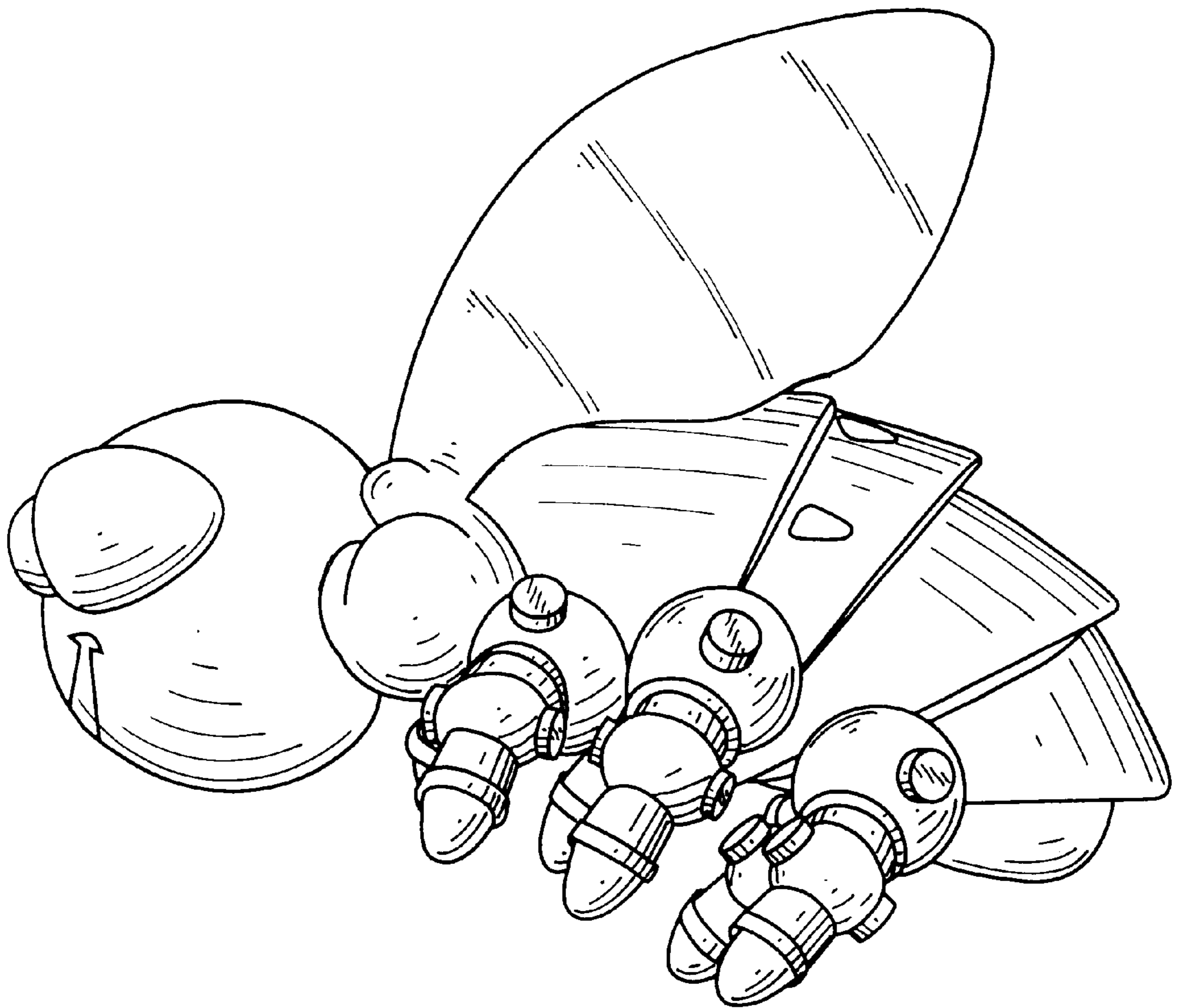

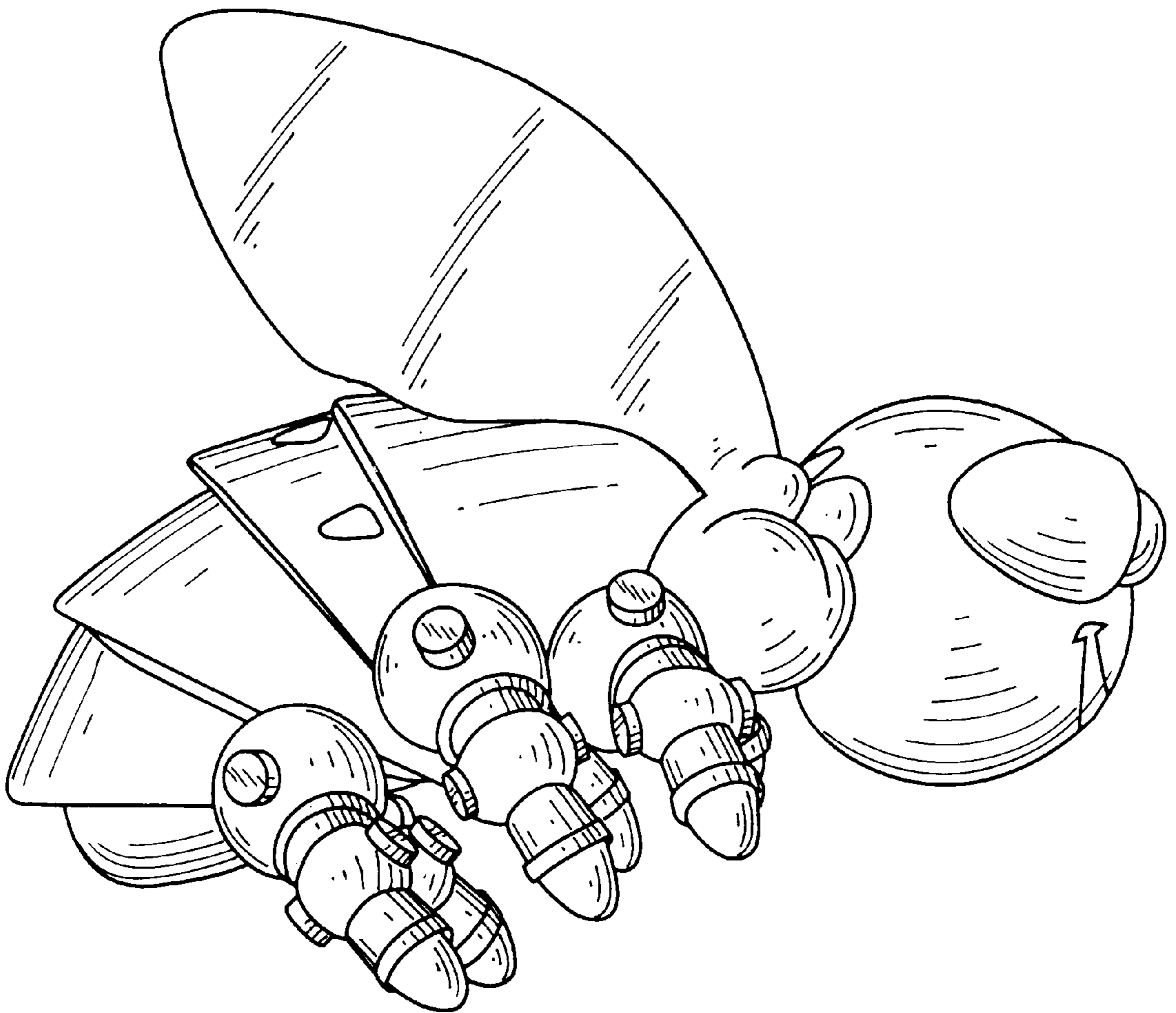

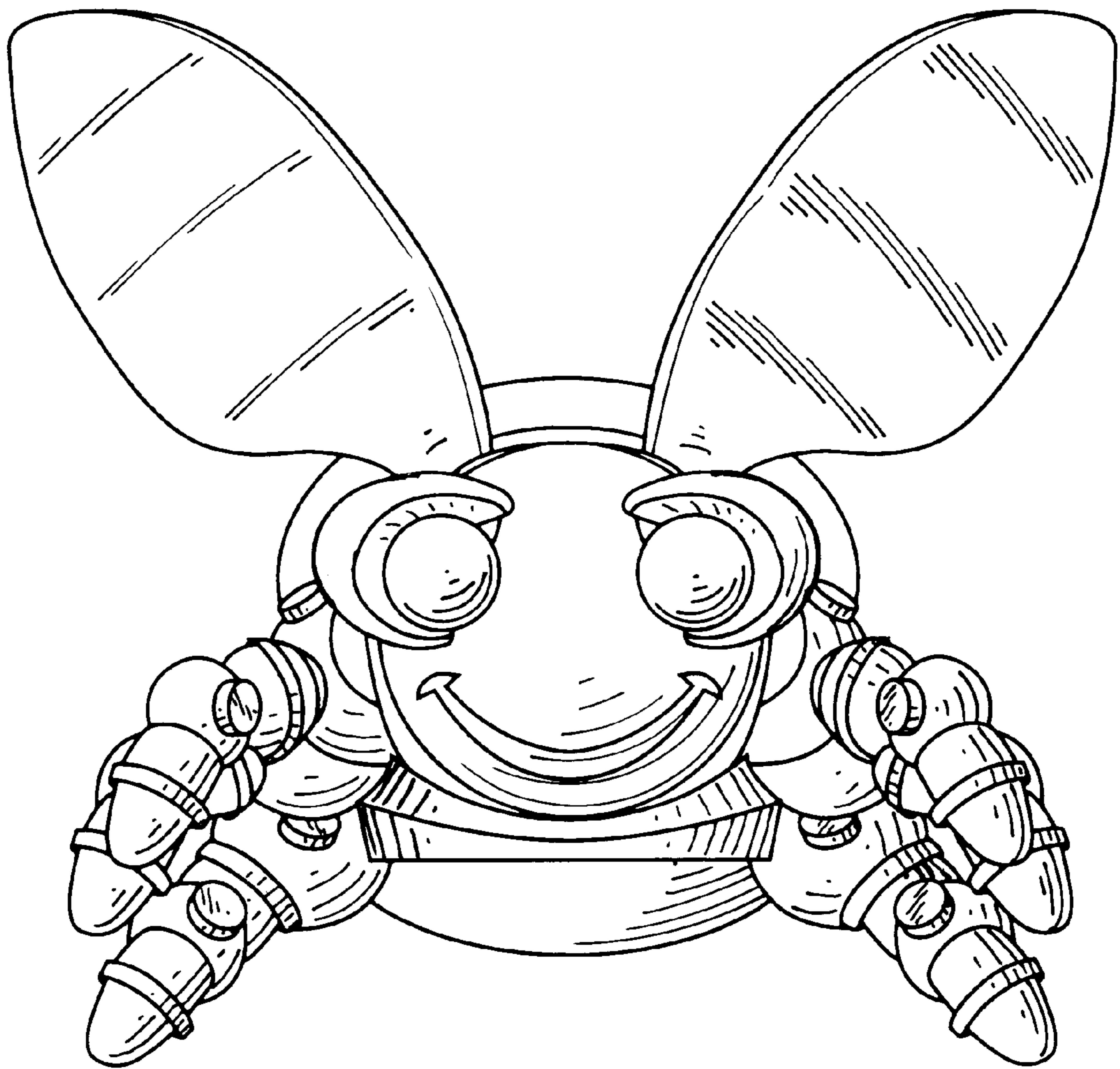

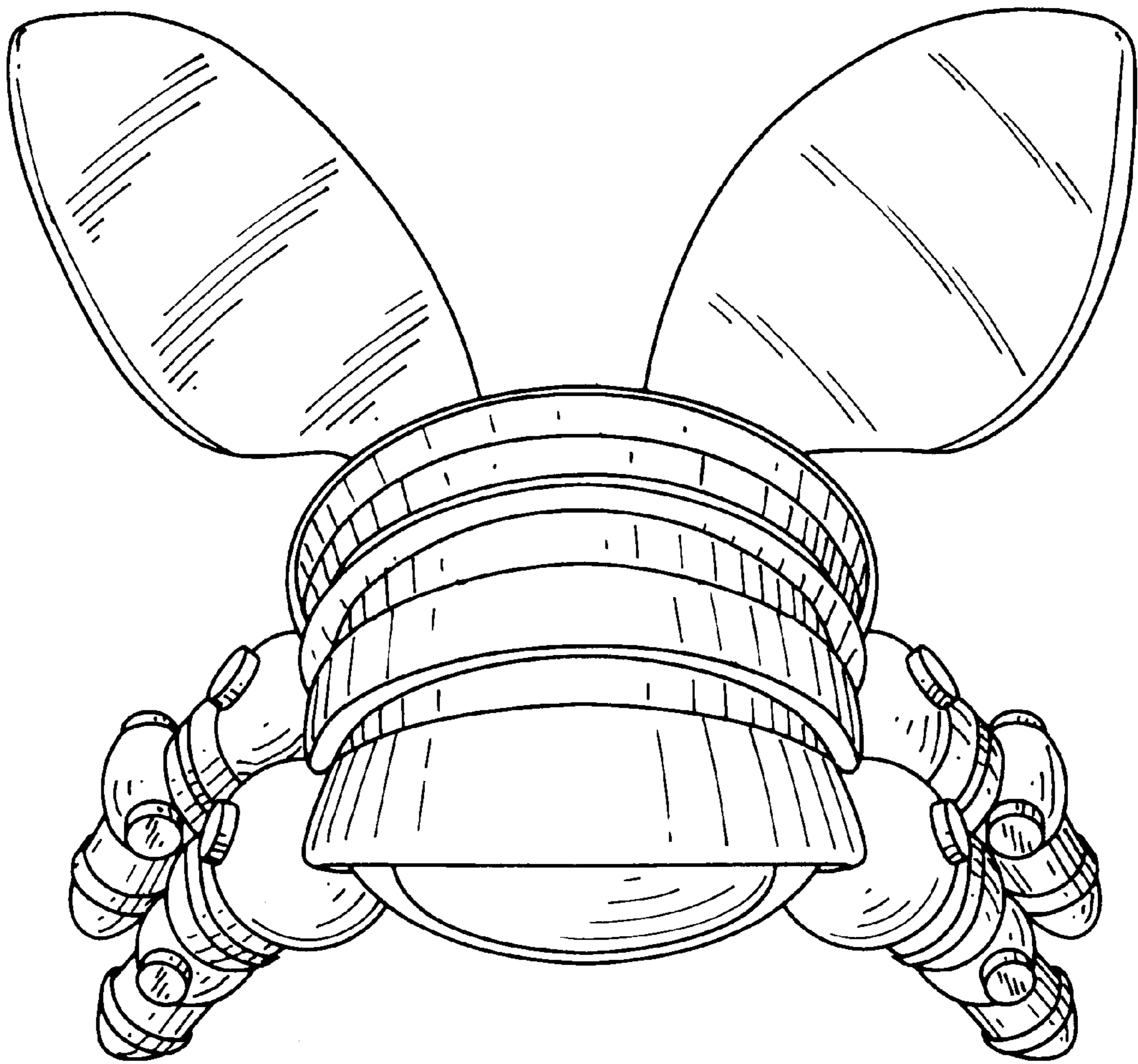

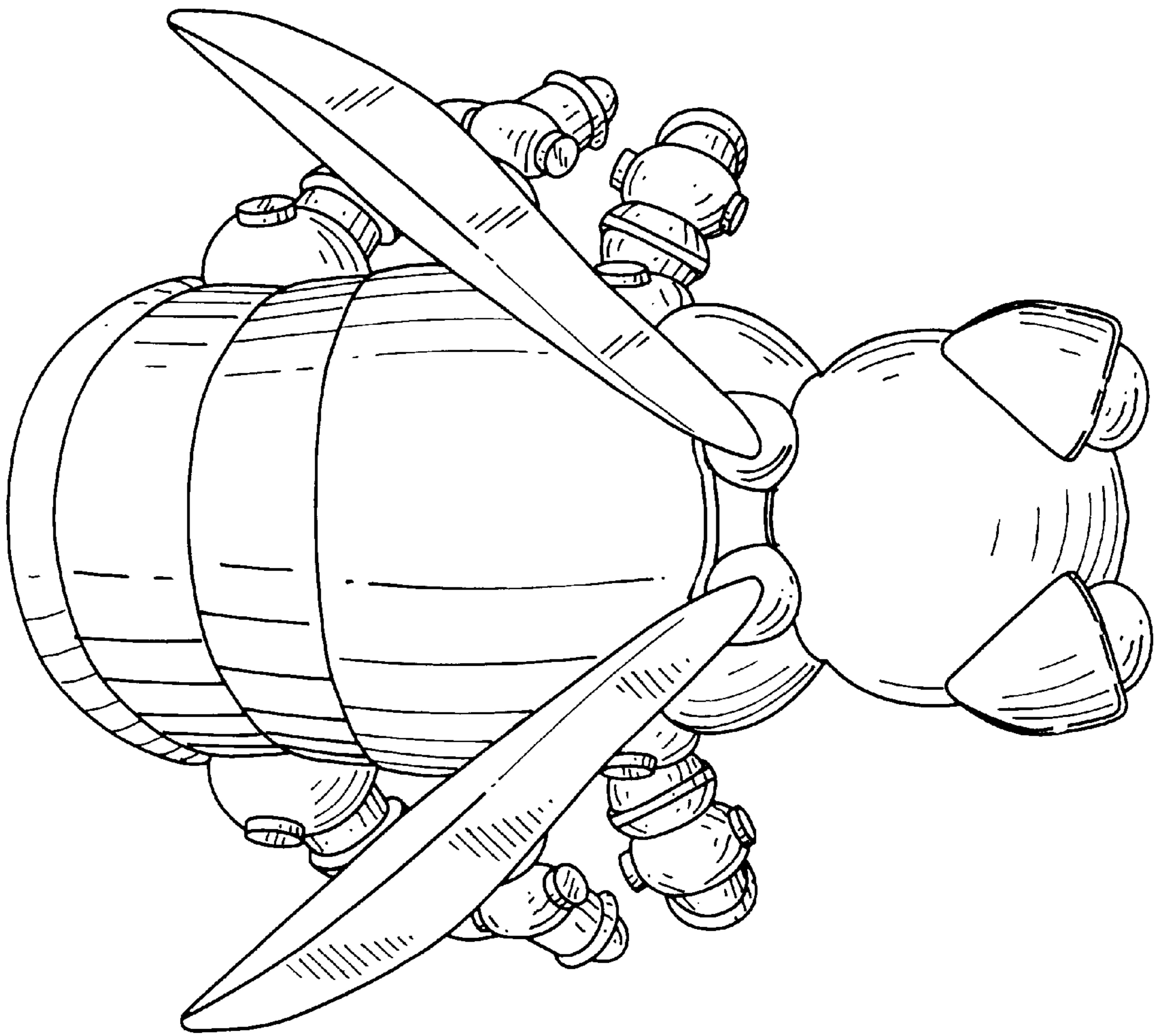
