The ornamental design for a room divider, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a room divider showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an elevational view thereof as shown by sight line 2—2 on FIG. 3;

FIG. 3 is an enlarged top plan view thereof;

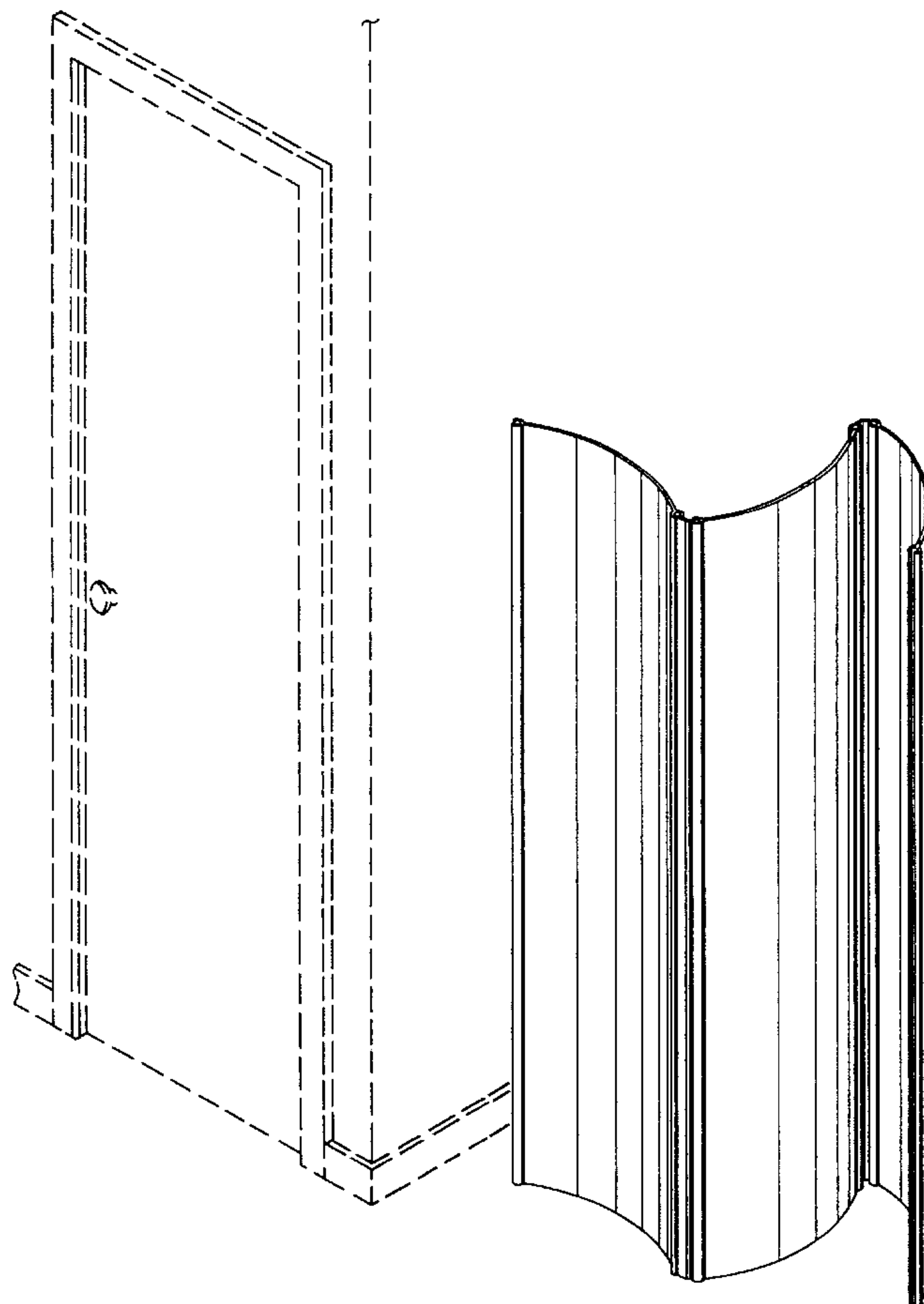
FIG. 4 is a fragmentary detail view thereof, shown separately for clarity of illustration; and,

FIG. 5 is an elevational view thereof as shown by sight line 5—5 on FIG. 3.

Surface indicia, including wood graining, for example, that may be shown in the drawing figures is disclaimed as not being a part of the claimed ornamental design.

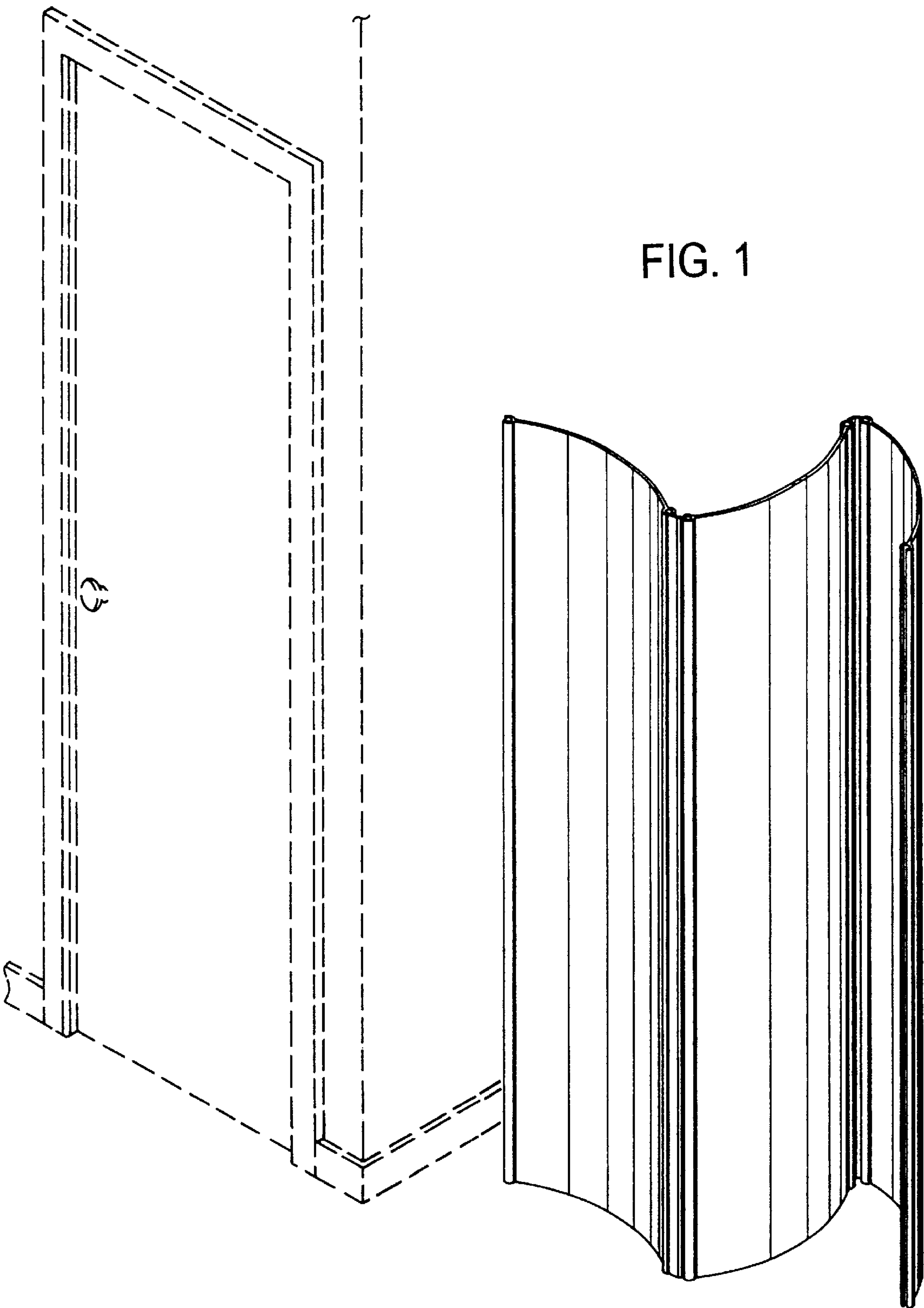
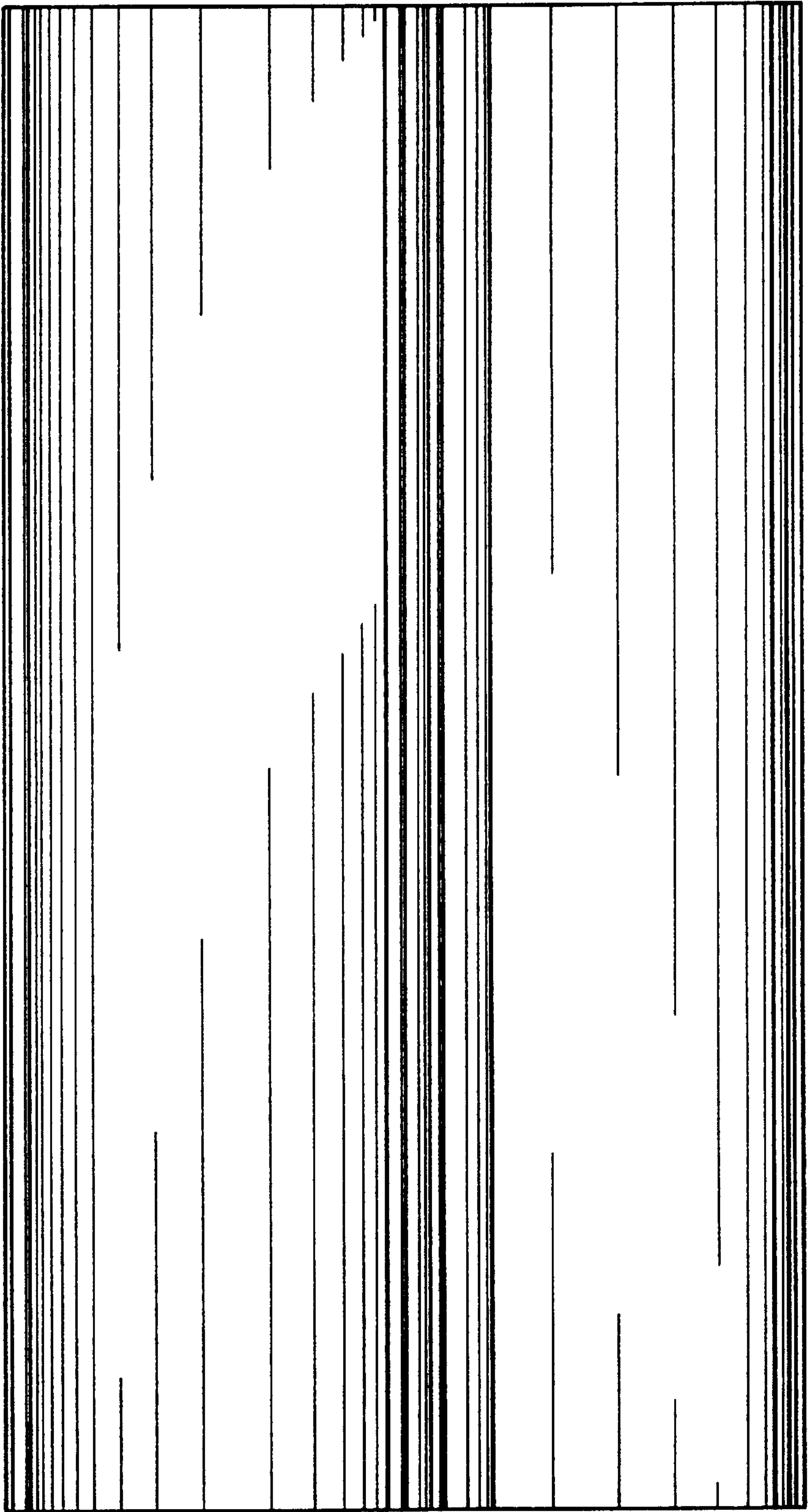

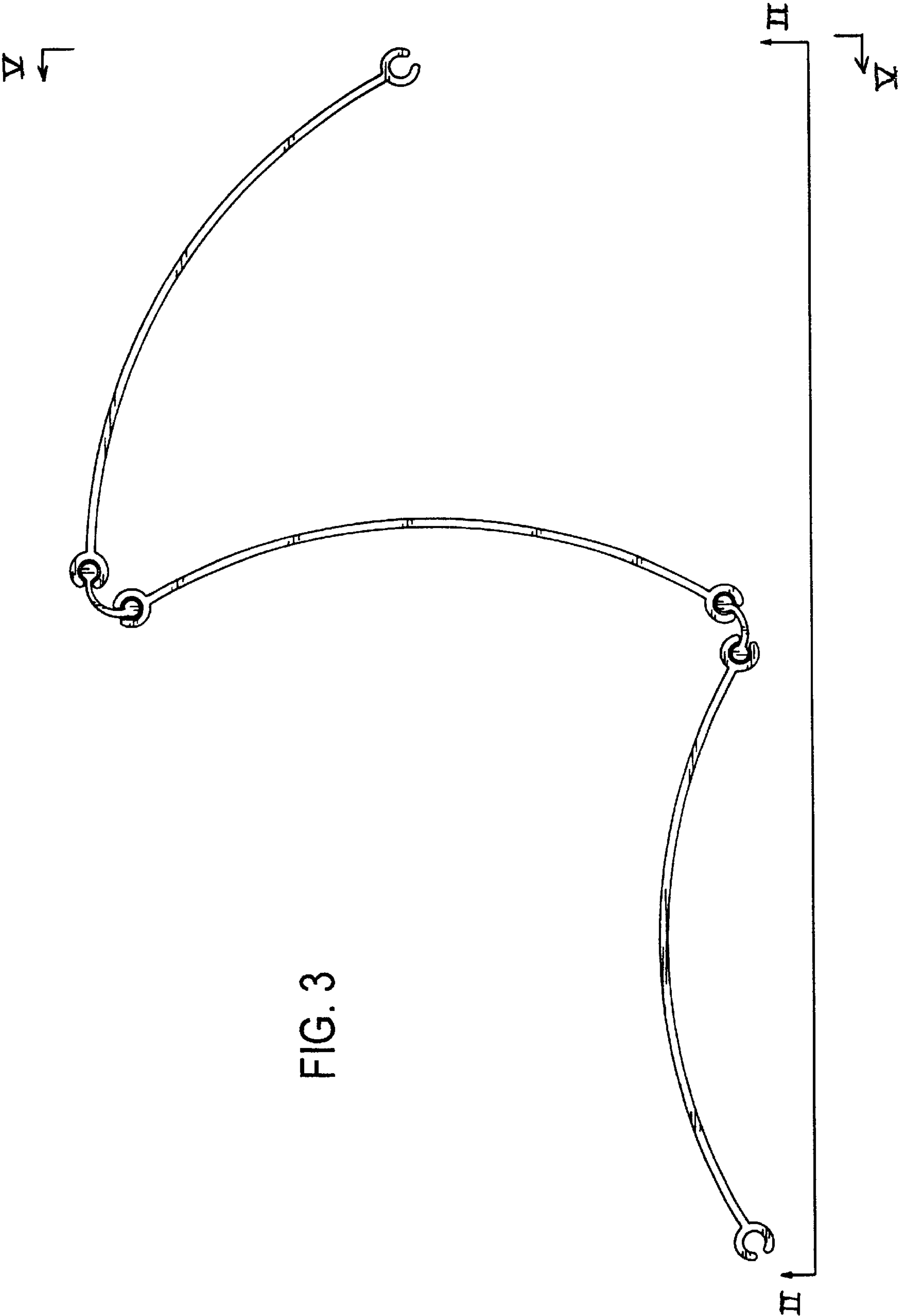

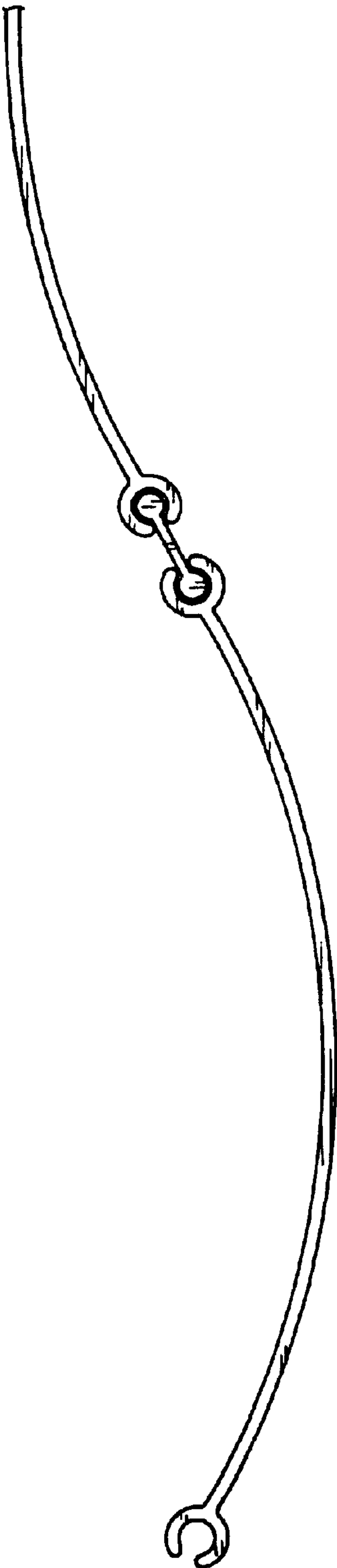
