FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

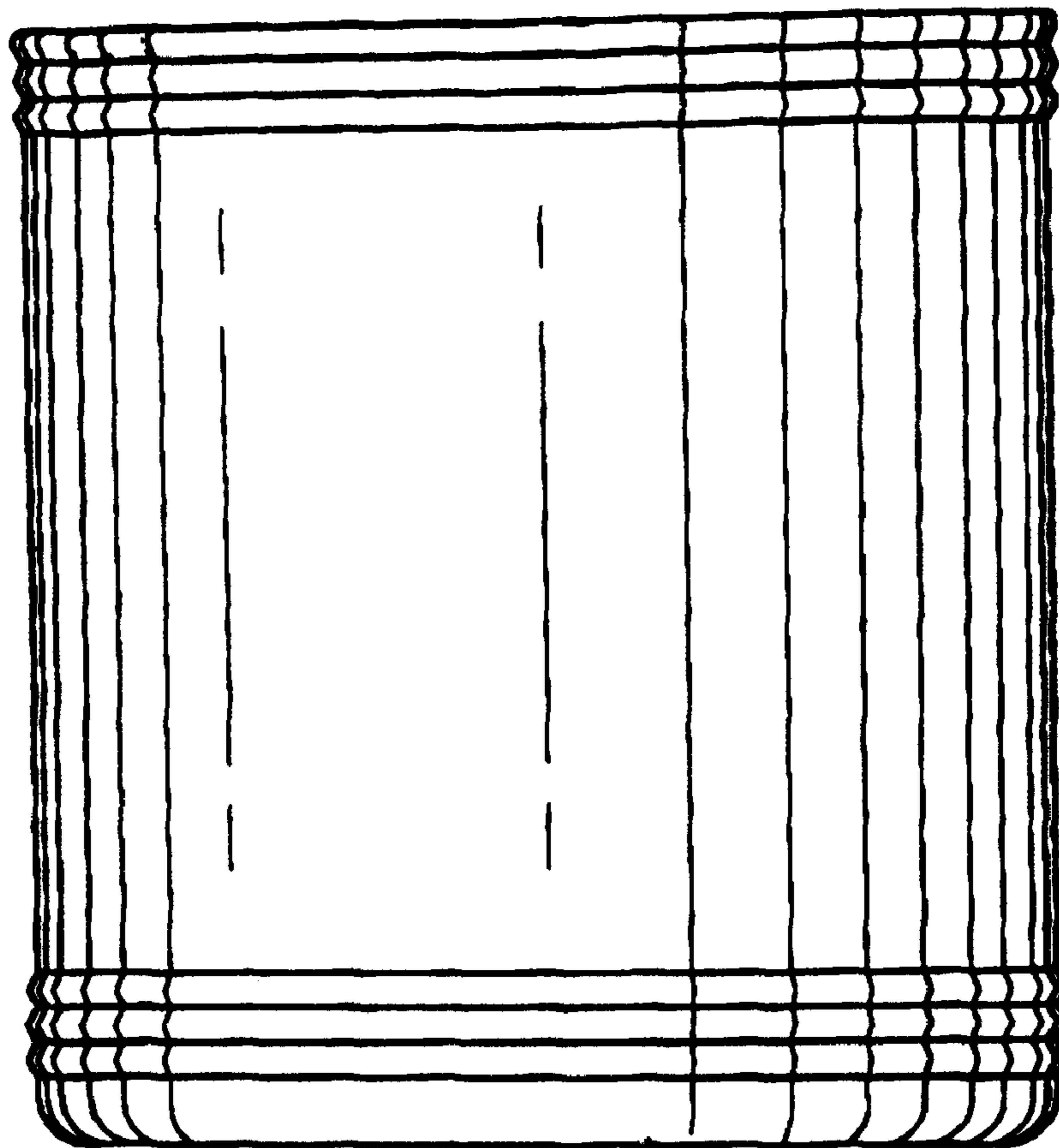
FIG. 4 is a cross-section view taken along line 4—4 of FIG.

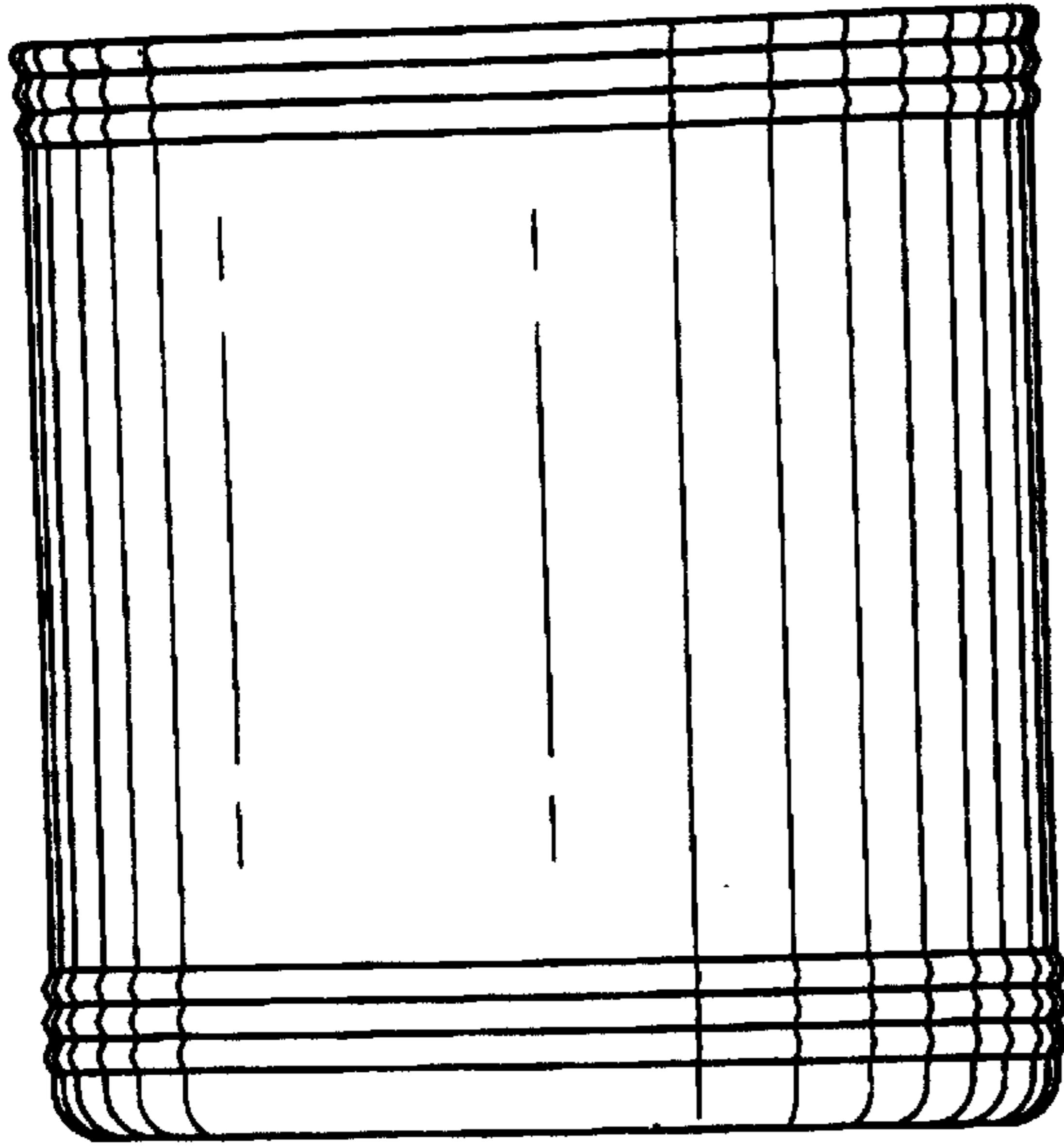

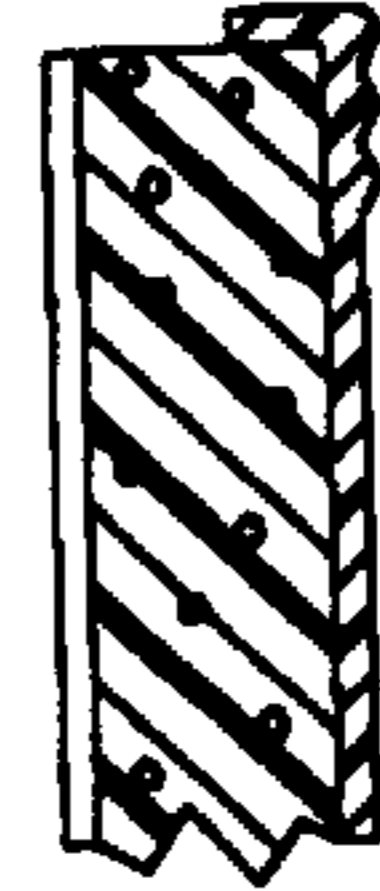

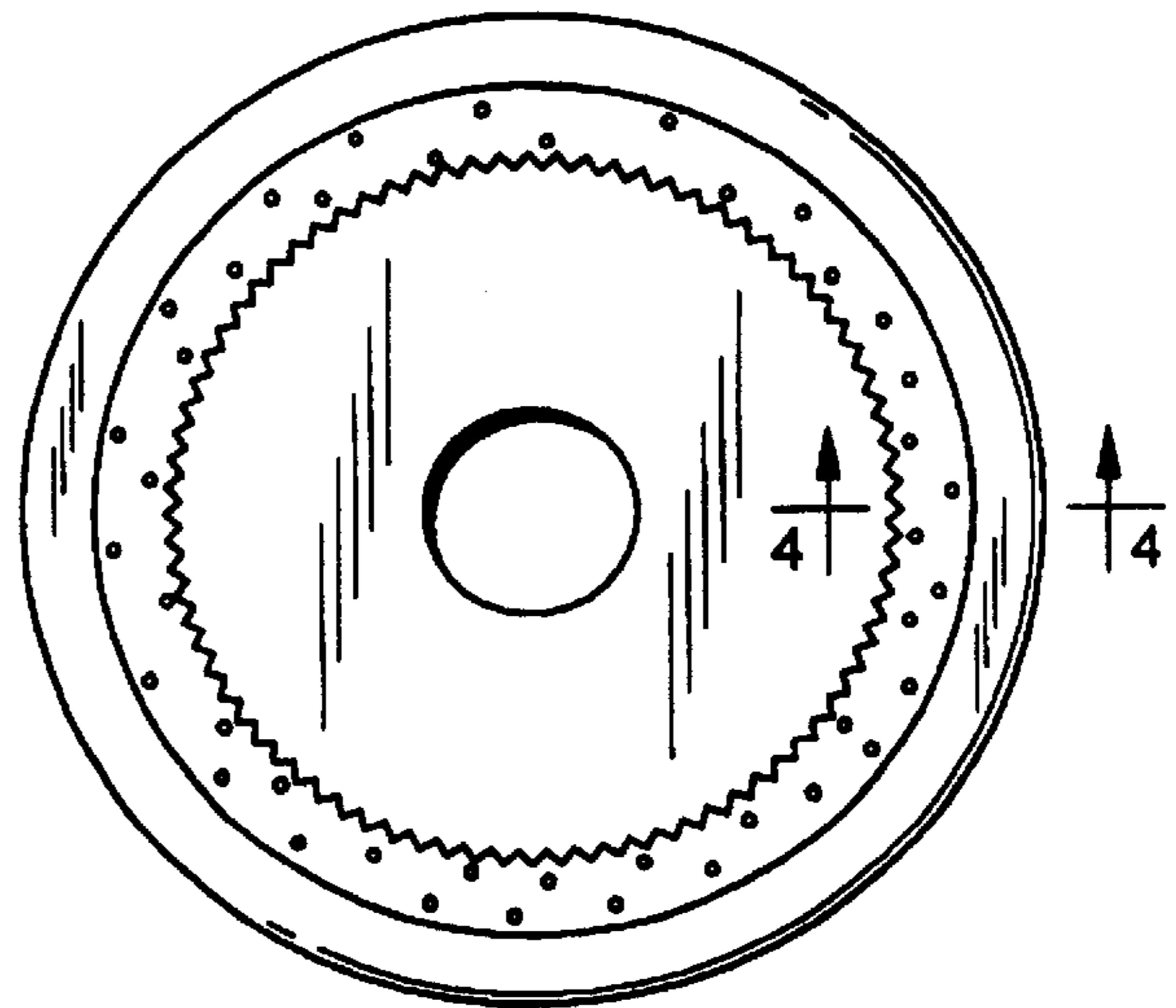

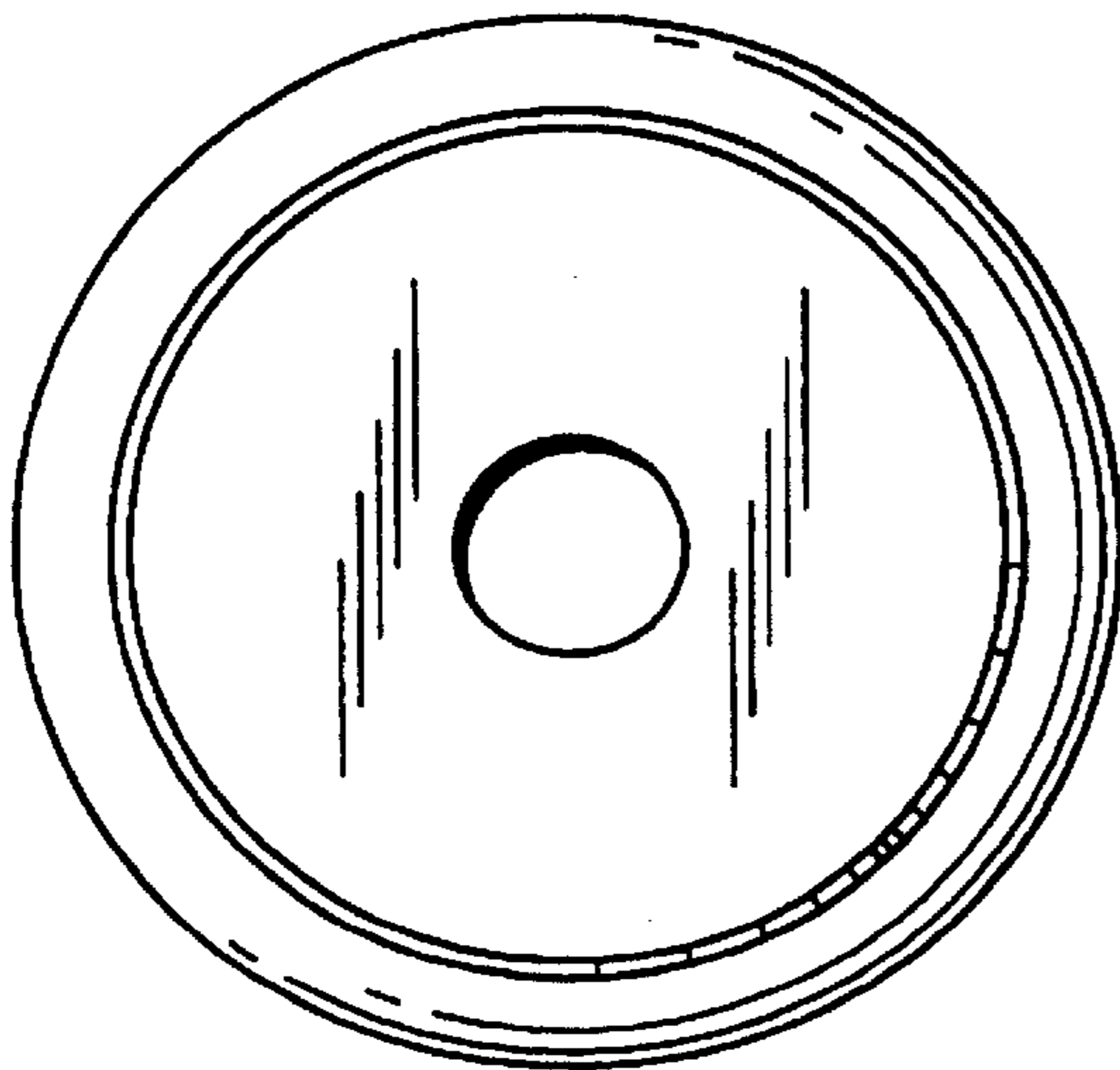
