FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

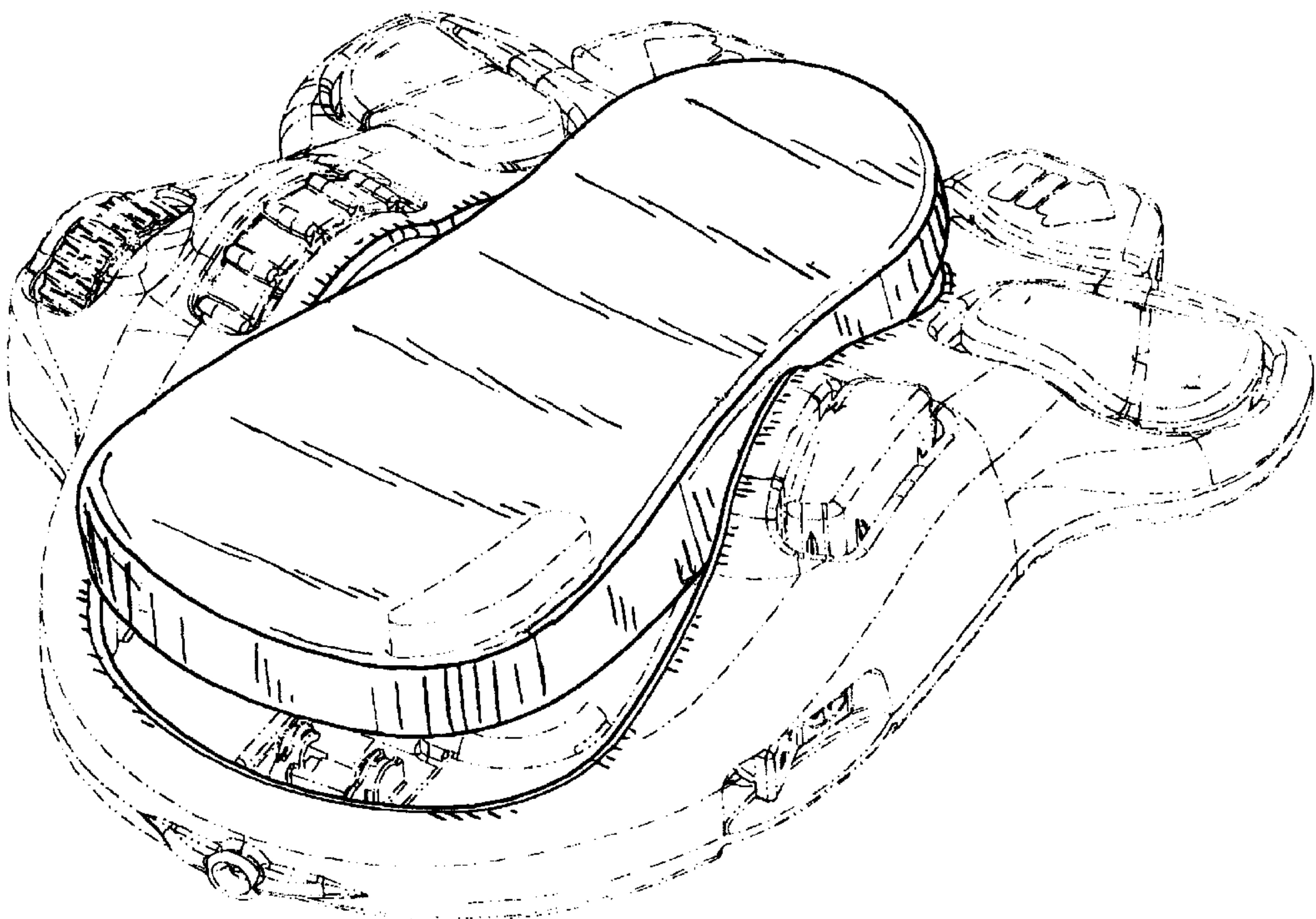

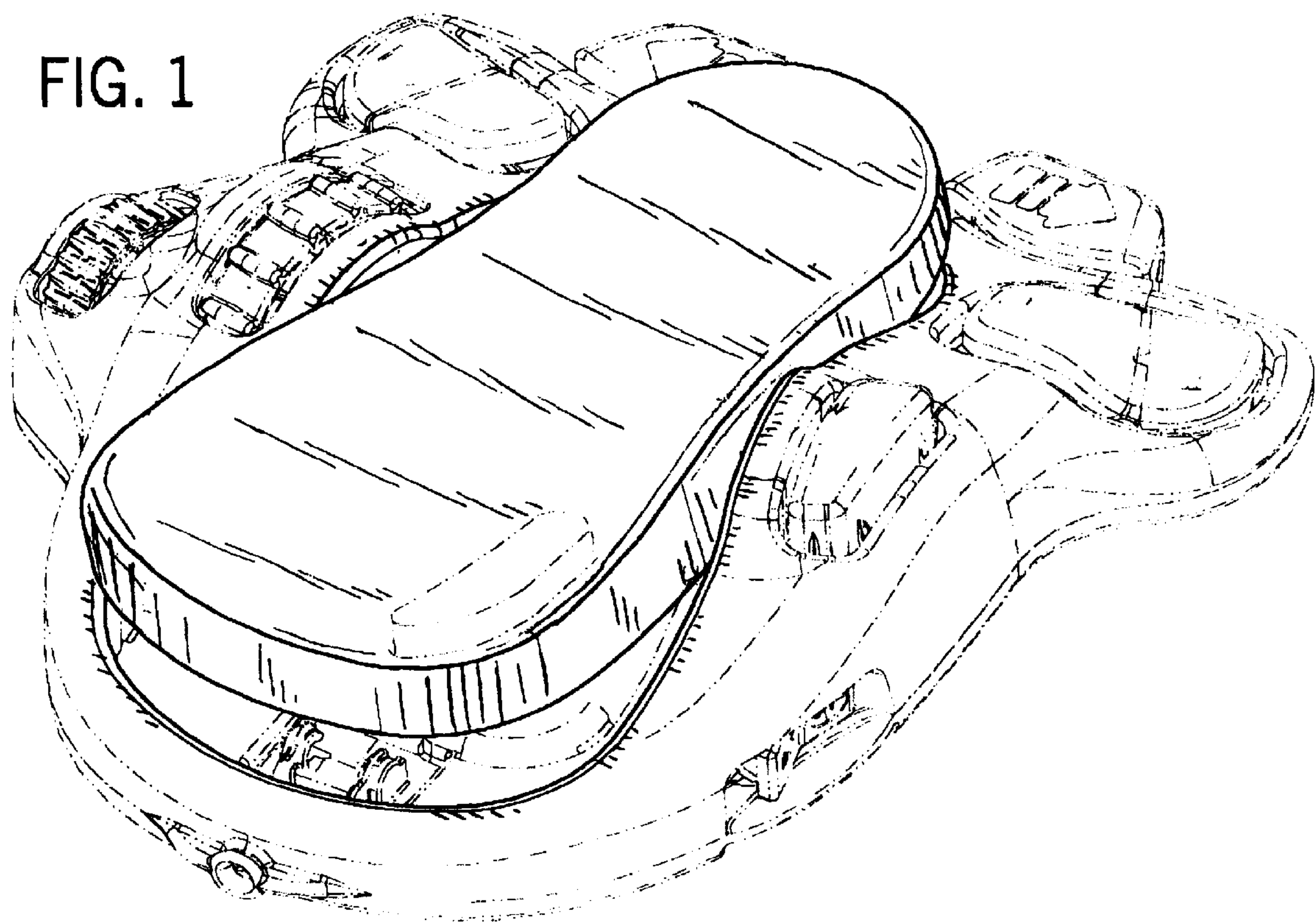

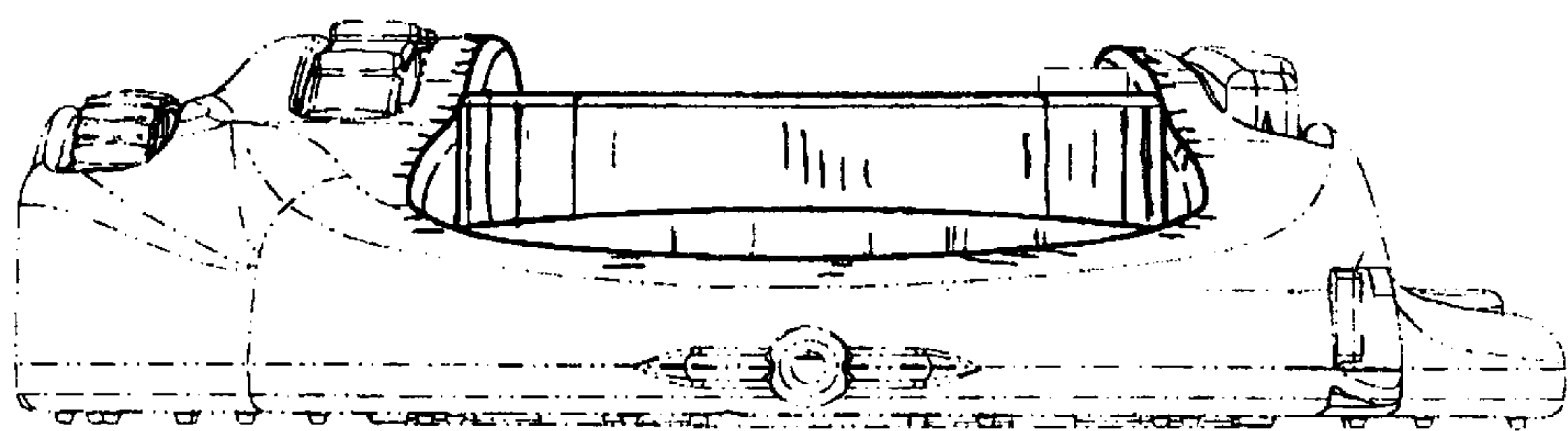

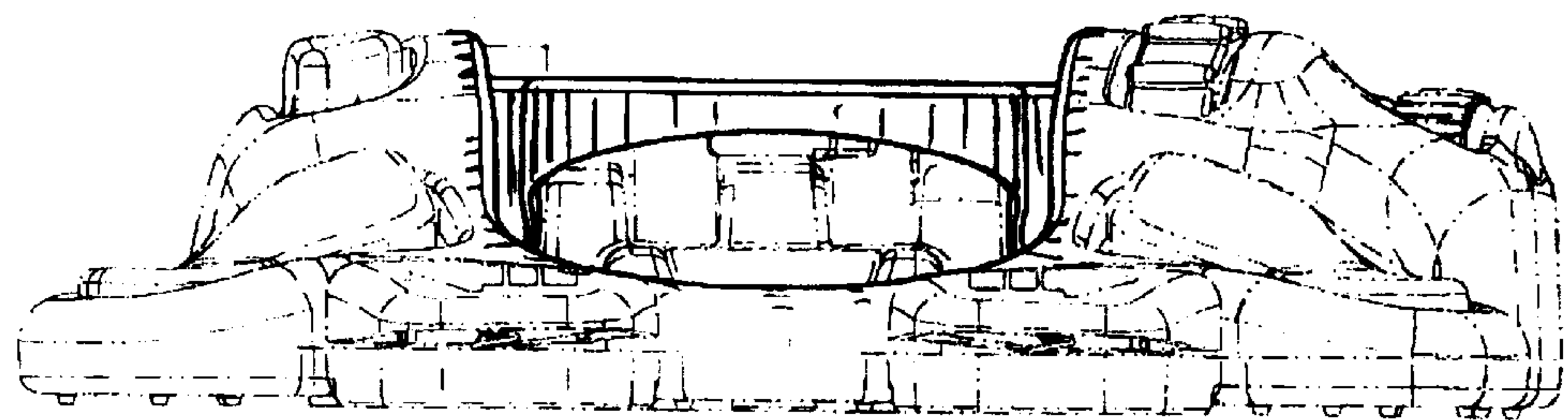

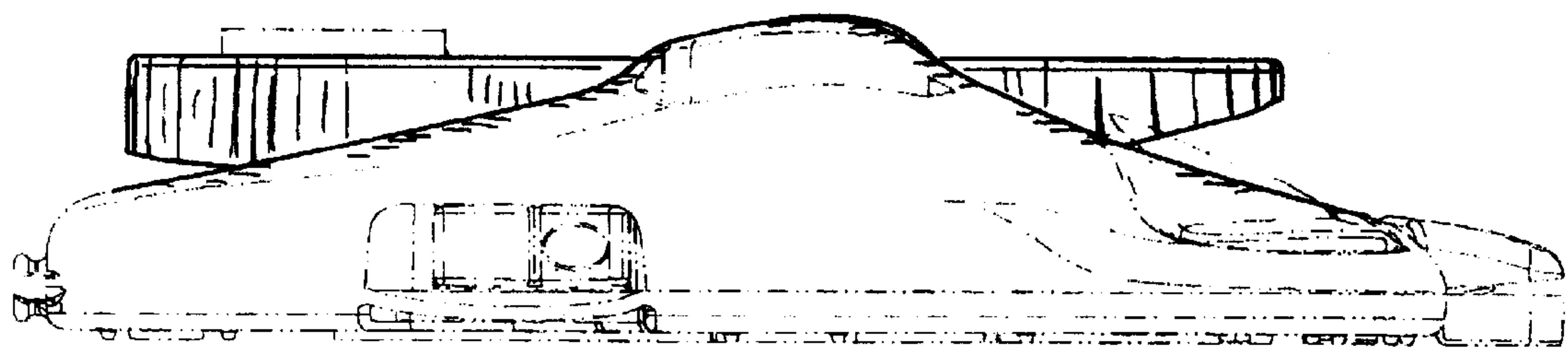

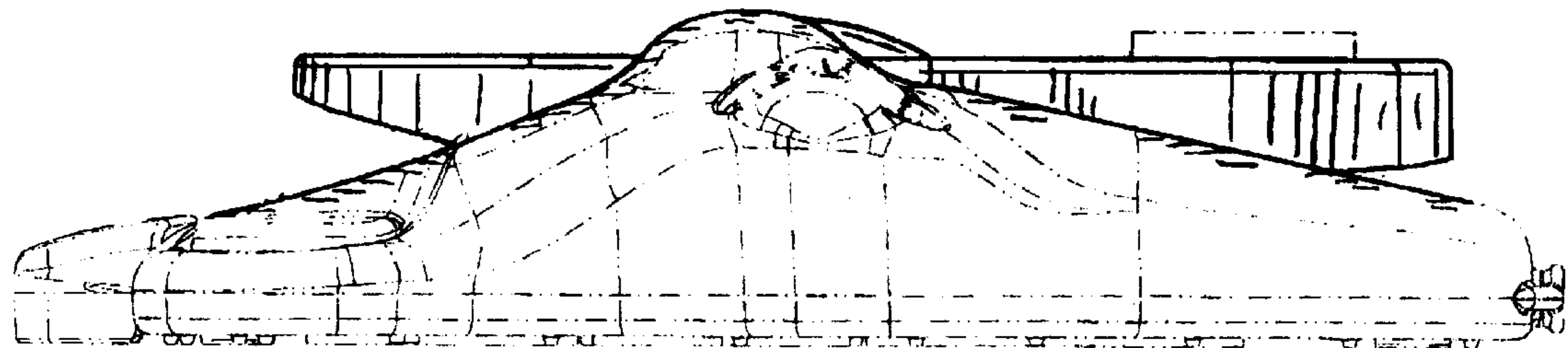
