FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; and,

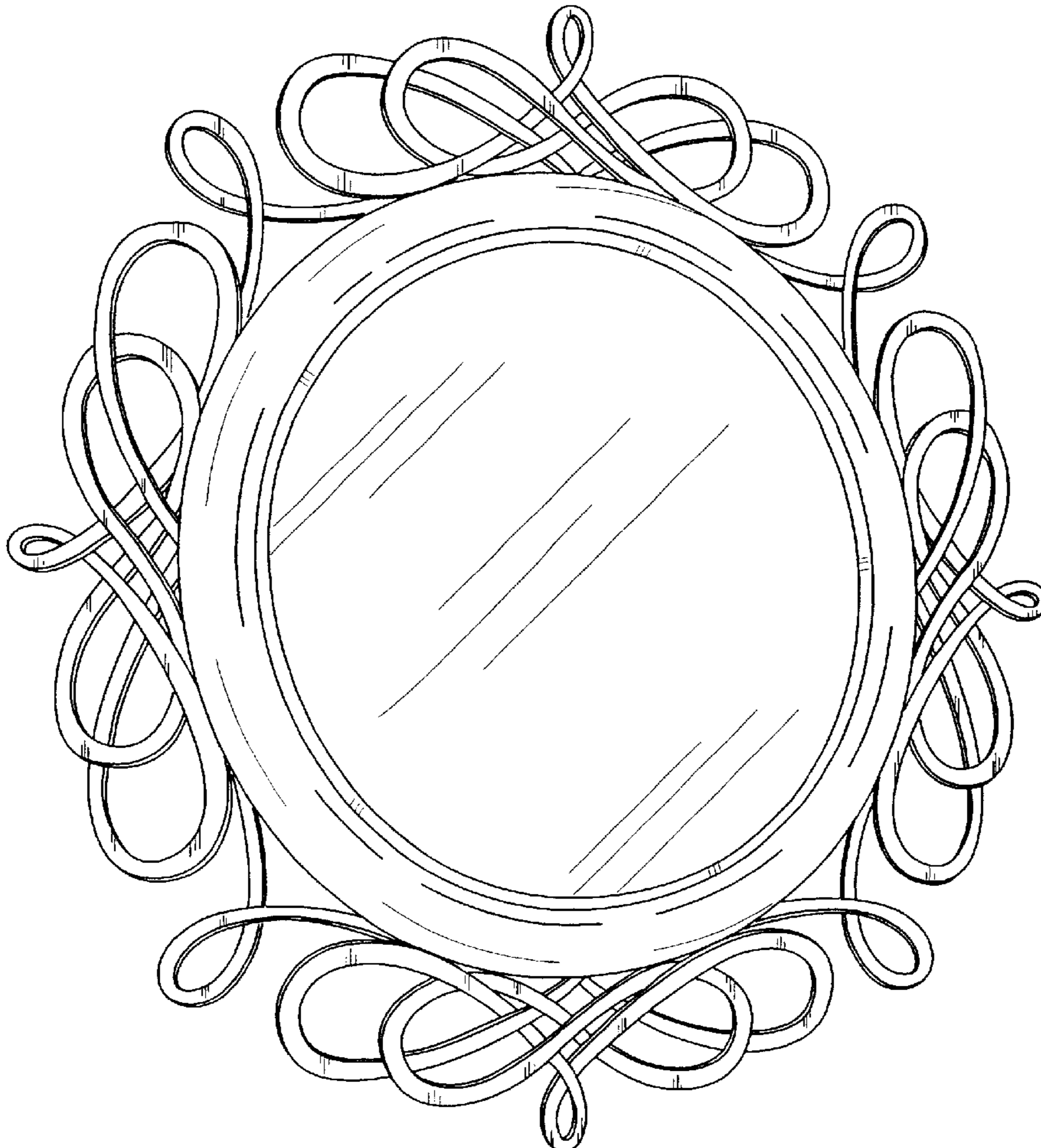
FIG. 3 is a side view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.

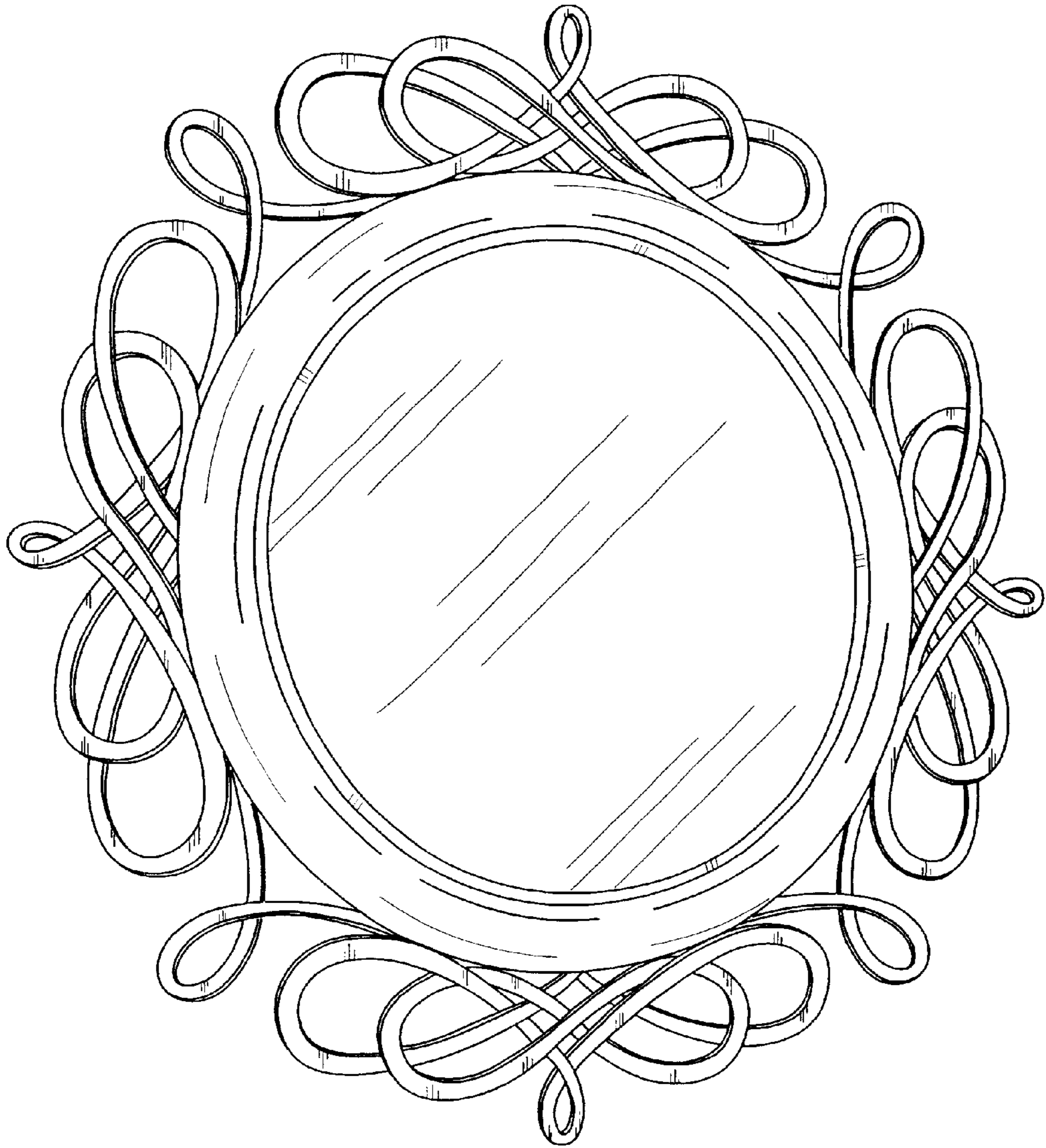

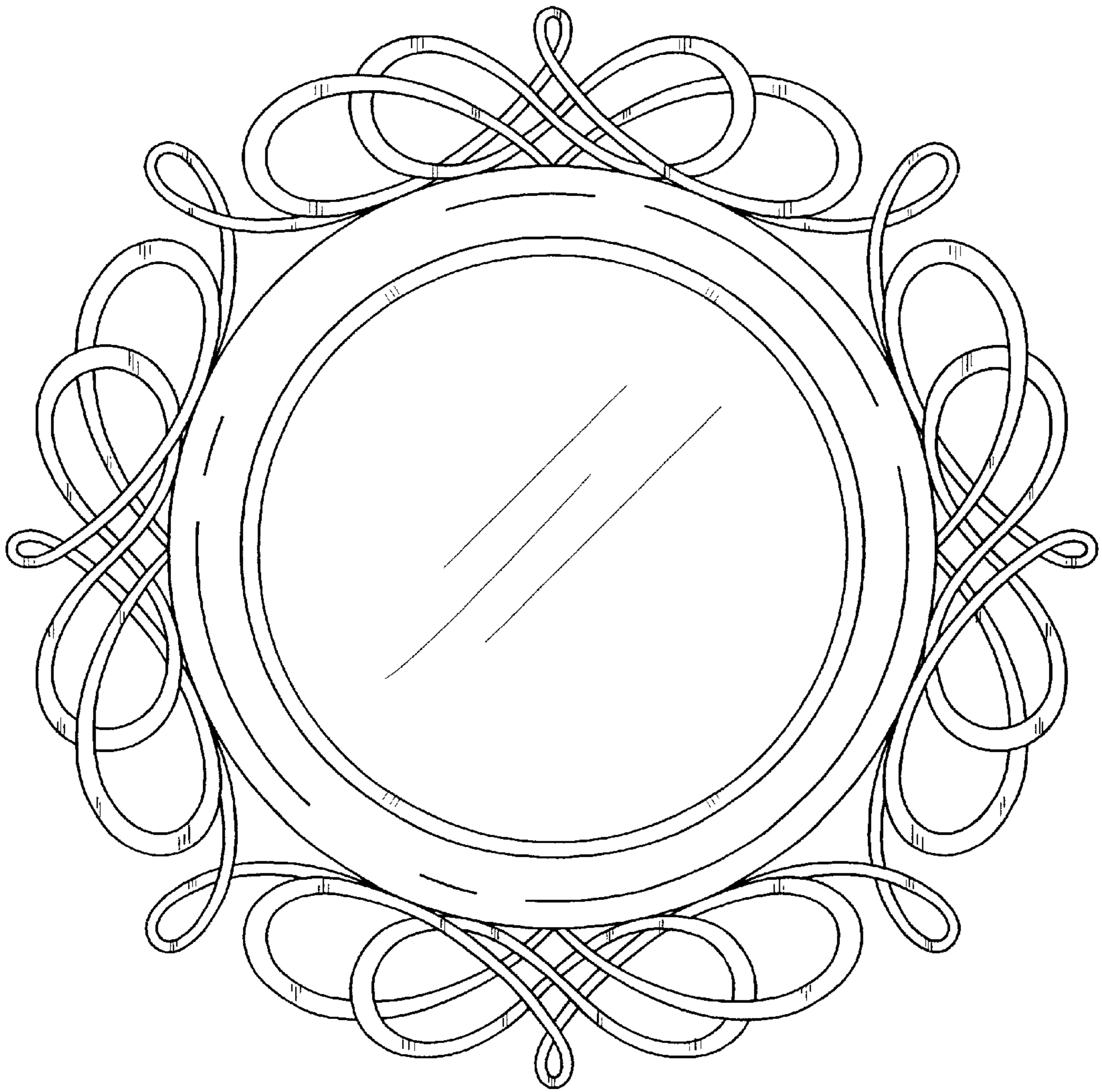
