(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pair of tool handles, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing a plier tool in phantom and perspective views of the pair of tool handles of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an elevational view as viewed from the underside of FIG. 2 showing the external surface of the left hand handle, the right hand handle being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is an elevational view thereof as seen from the left in FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is an elevational view thereof as seen from the right of FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of an alternate embodiment;

FIG. 7 is a plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 6;

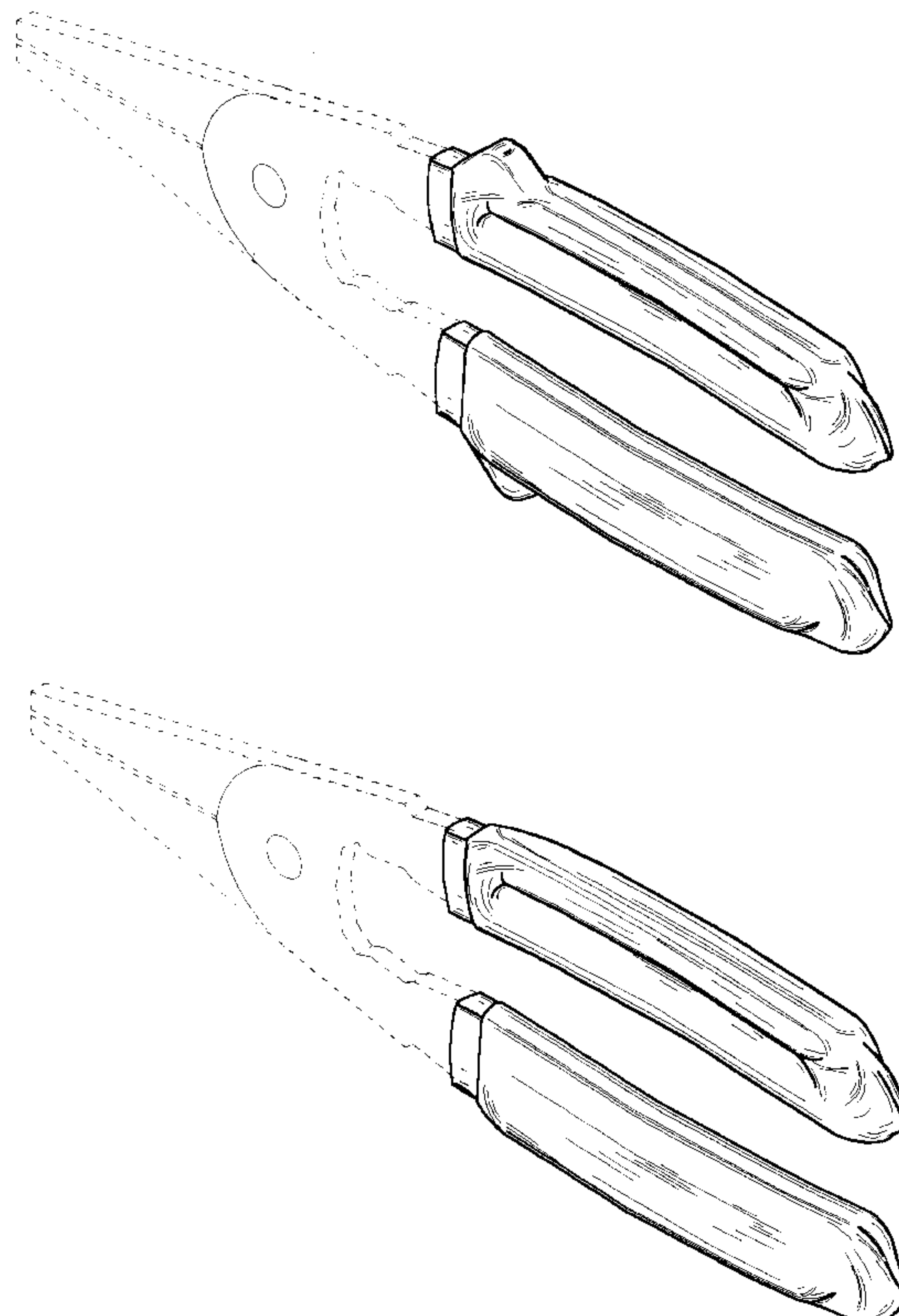
FIG. 8 is an elevational view as viewed from the underside of FIG. 6 showing the external surface of the left hand handle, the right hand handle being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 9 is an elevational view thereof as seen from the left in FIG. 6; and,

FIG. 10 is an elevational view thereof as seen from the right of FIG. 6.

The broken line showing of the plier tool is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

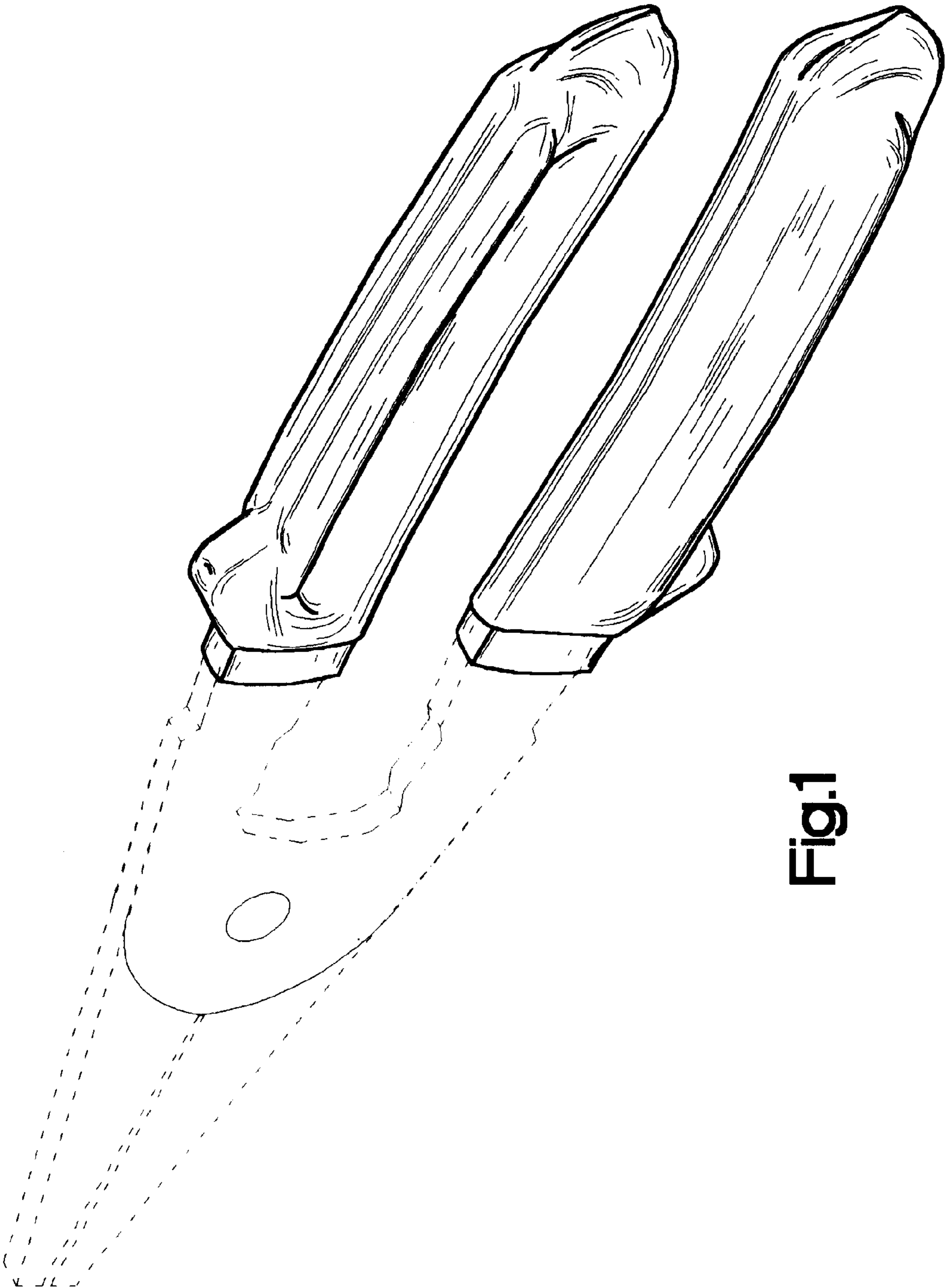

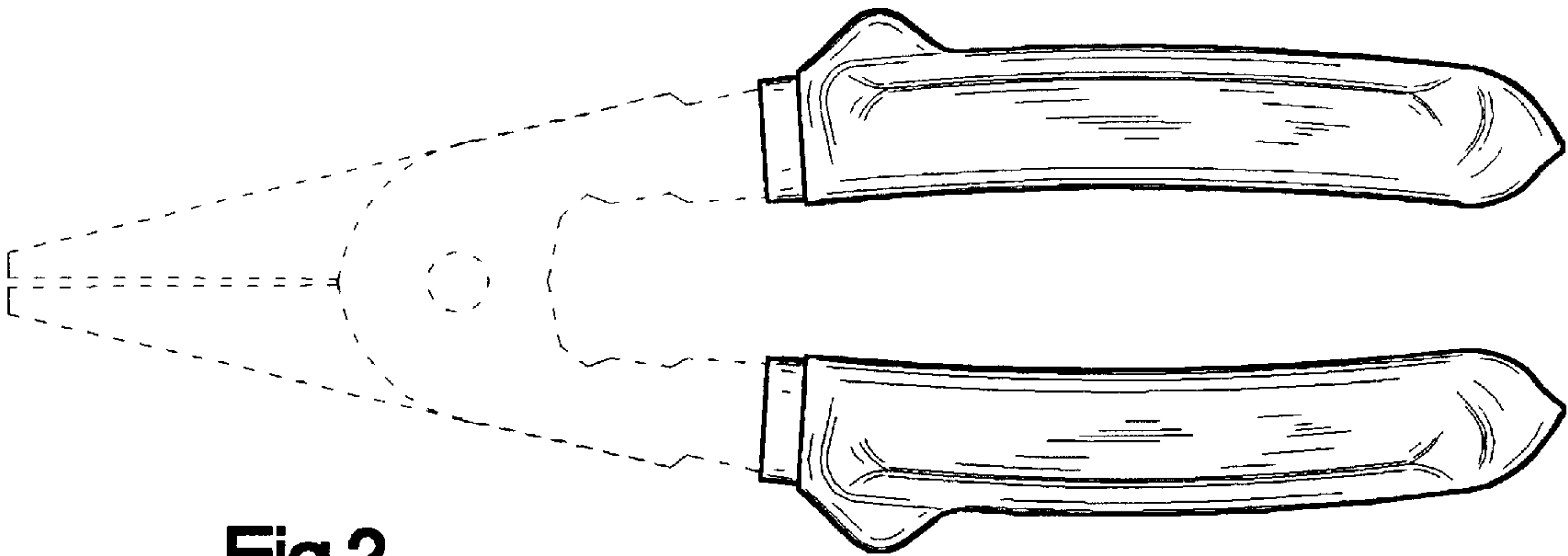

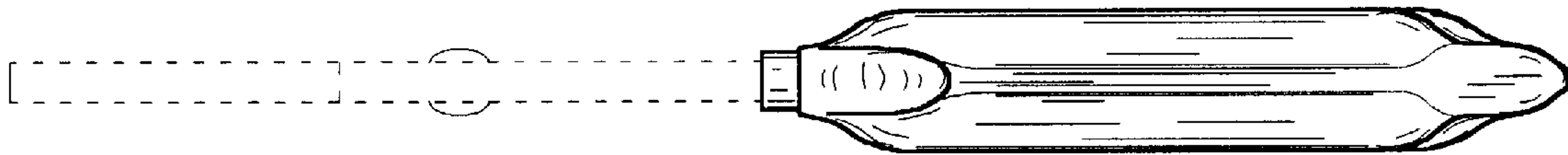

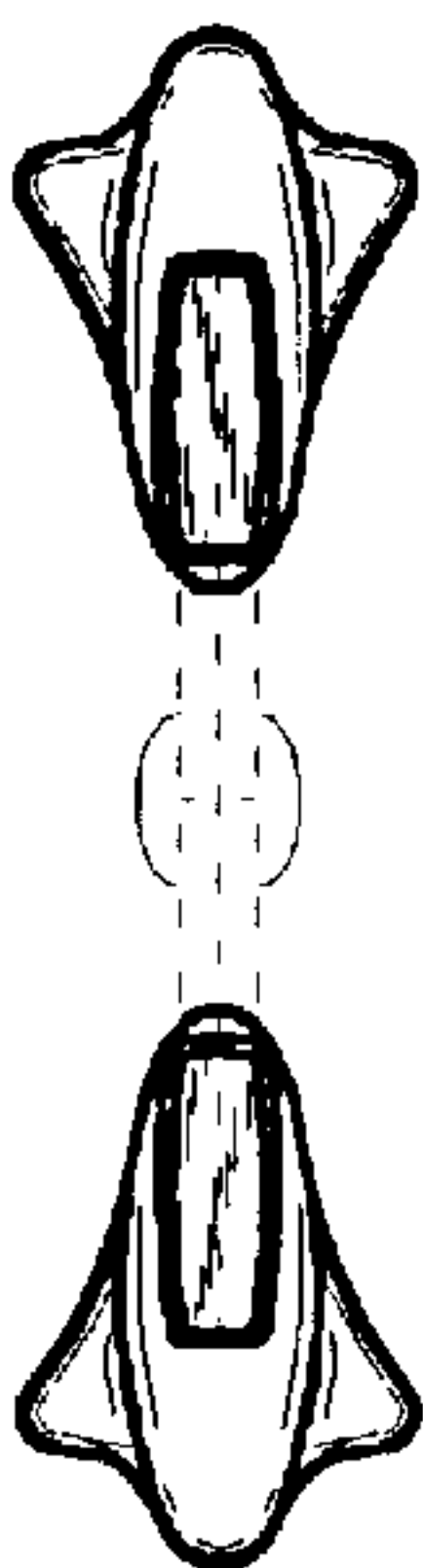

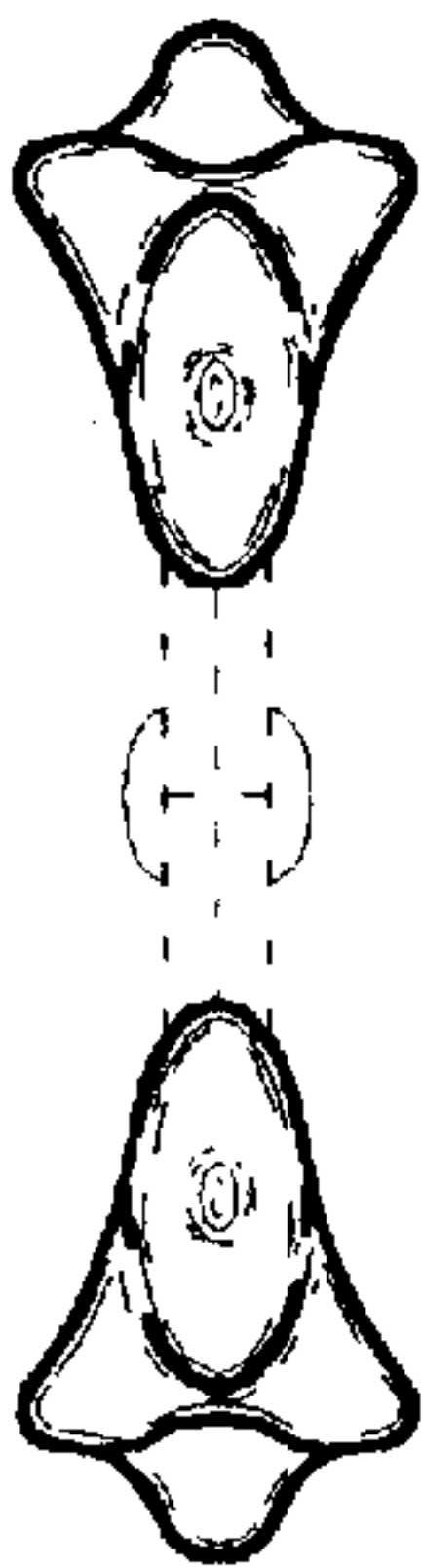

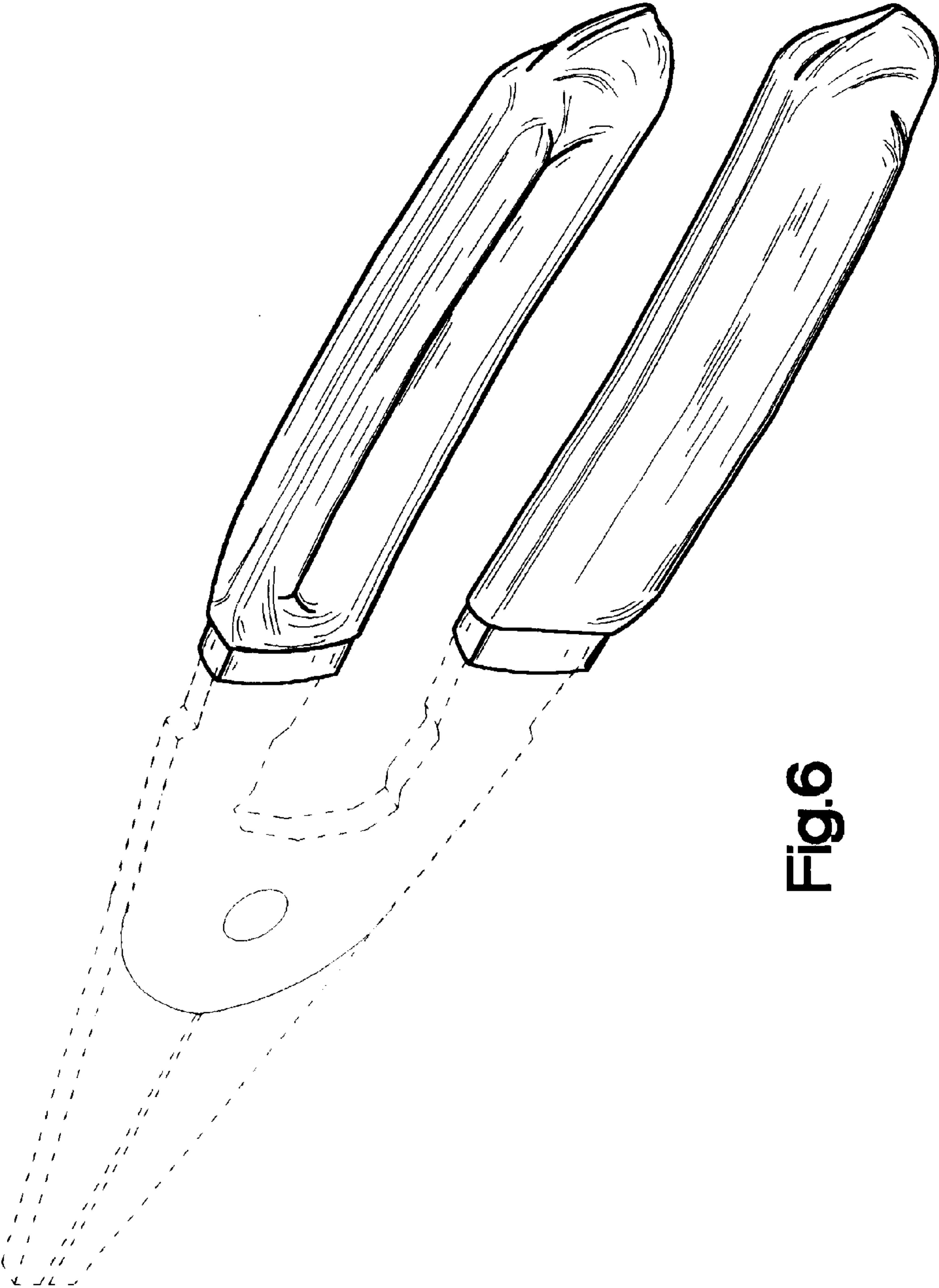

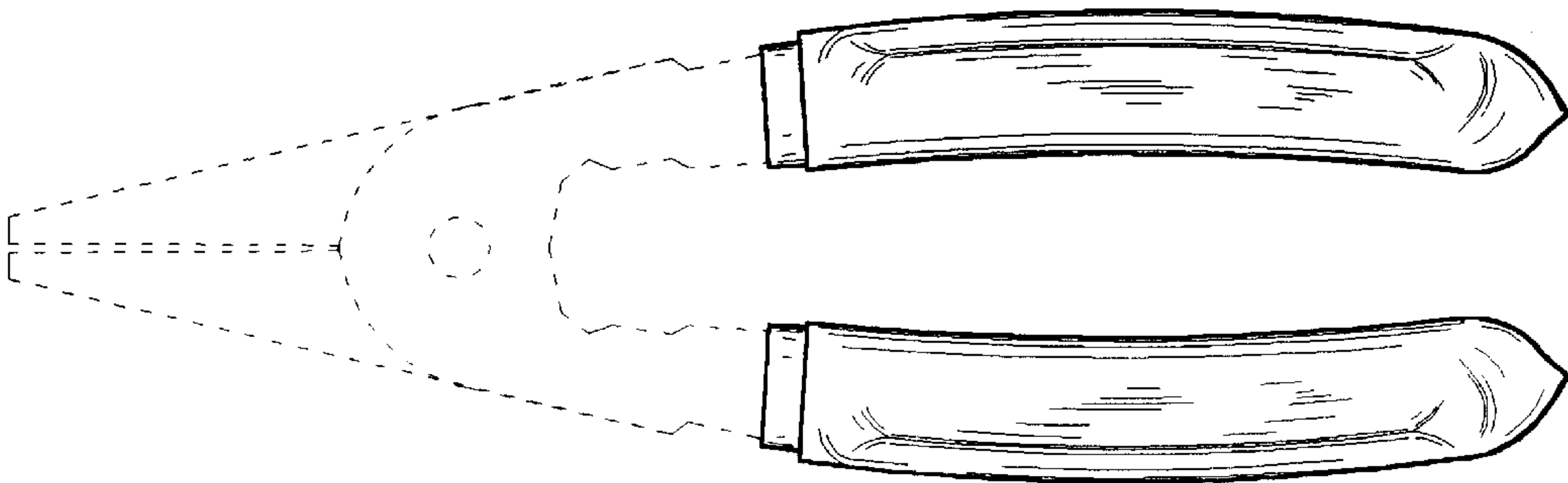

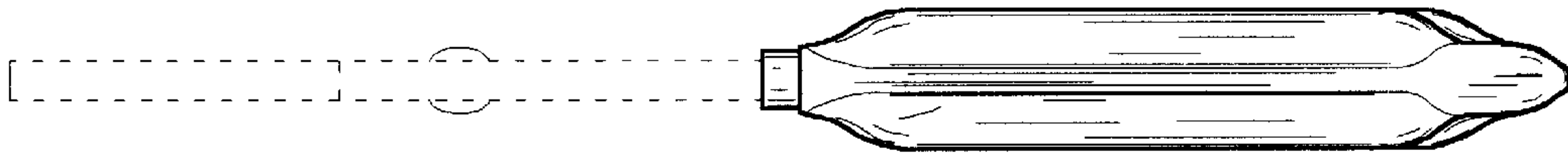

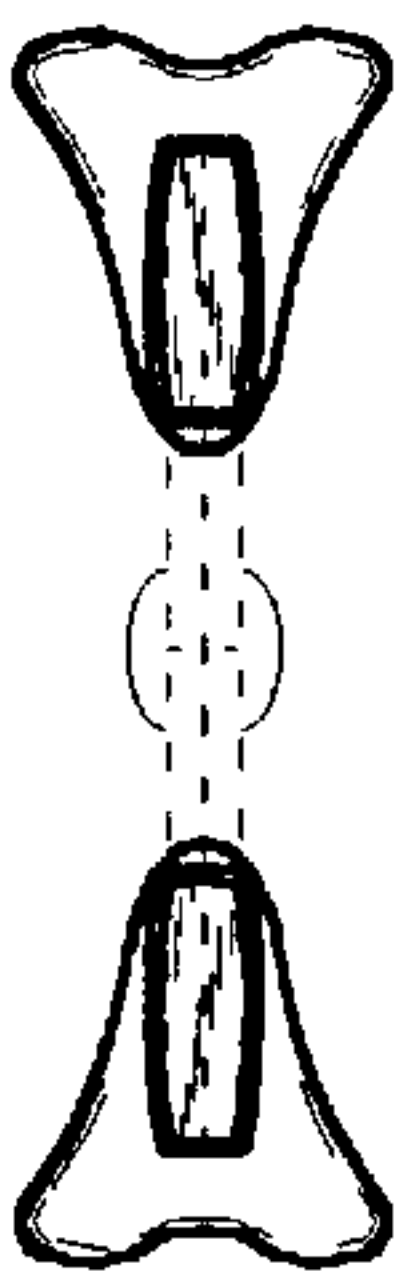

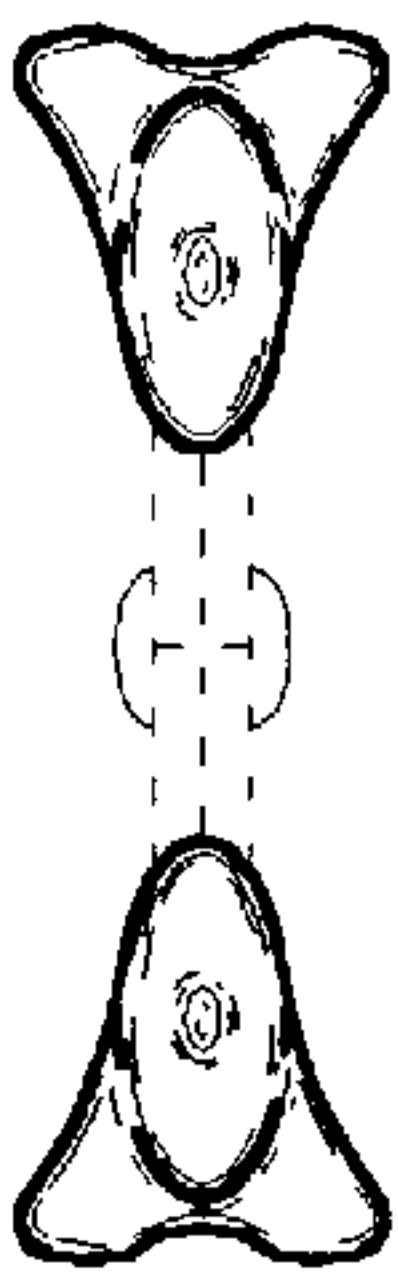
