and,

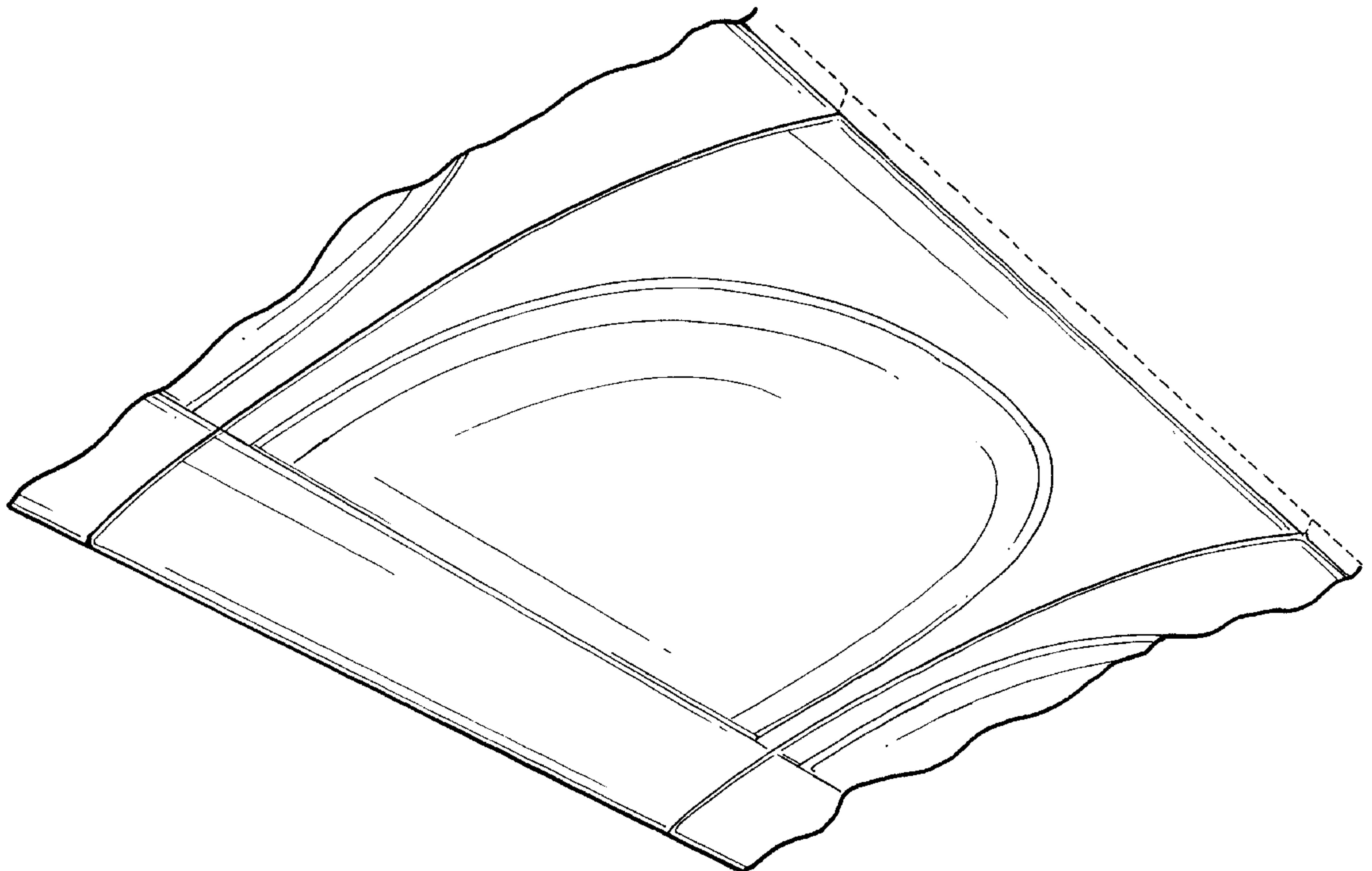
FIG. 2 is a front view of the surface configuration of a

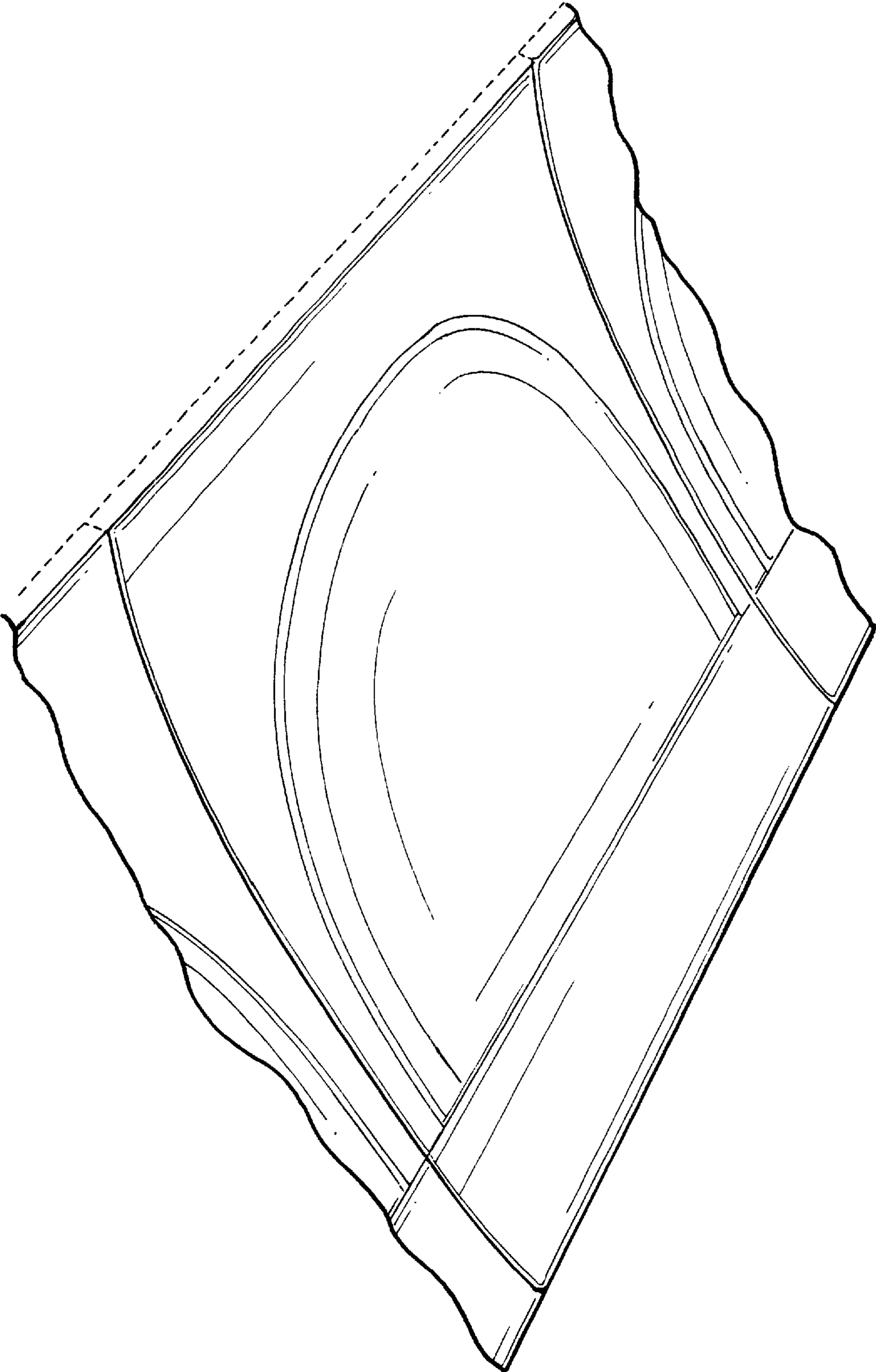

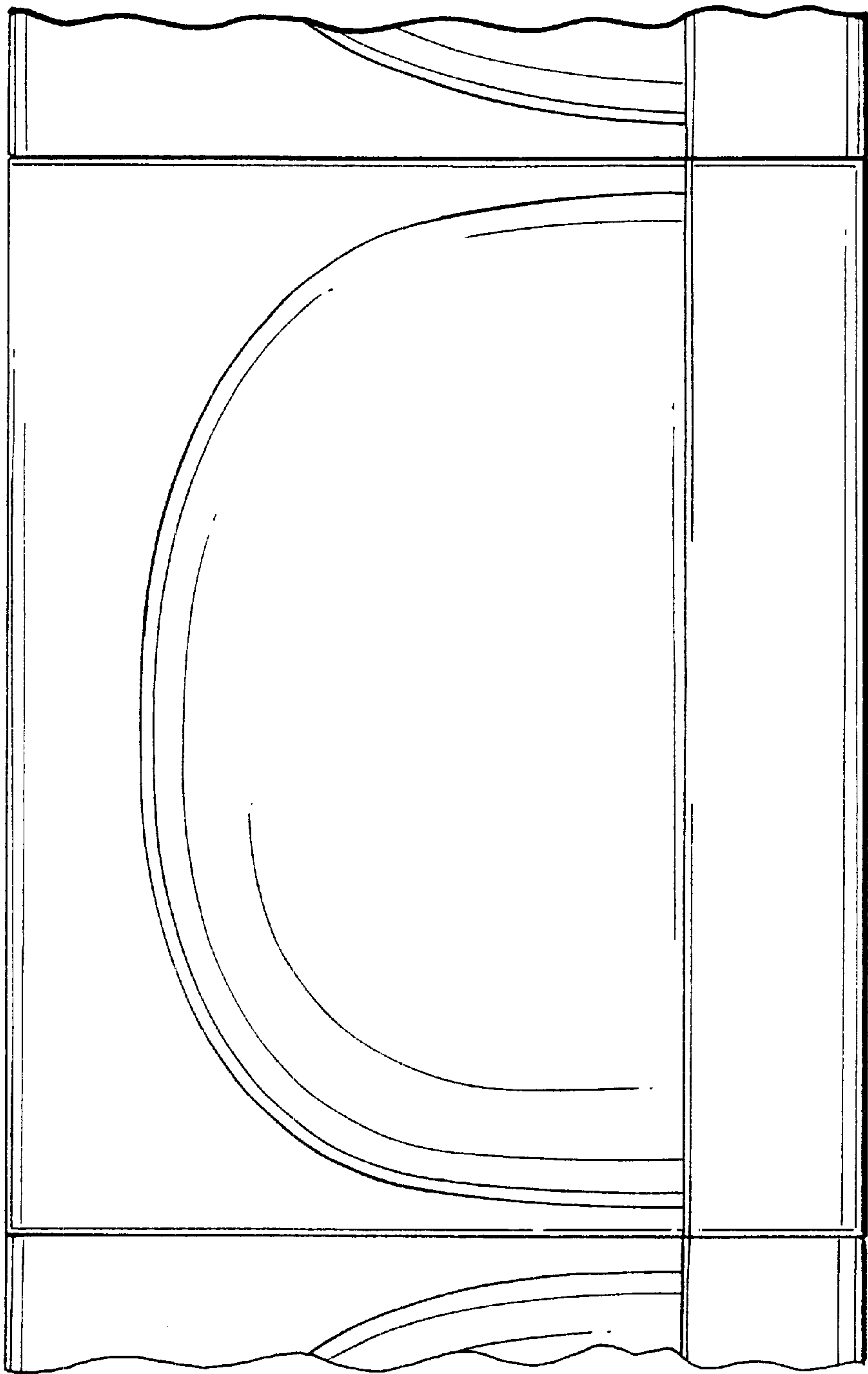
