**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;

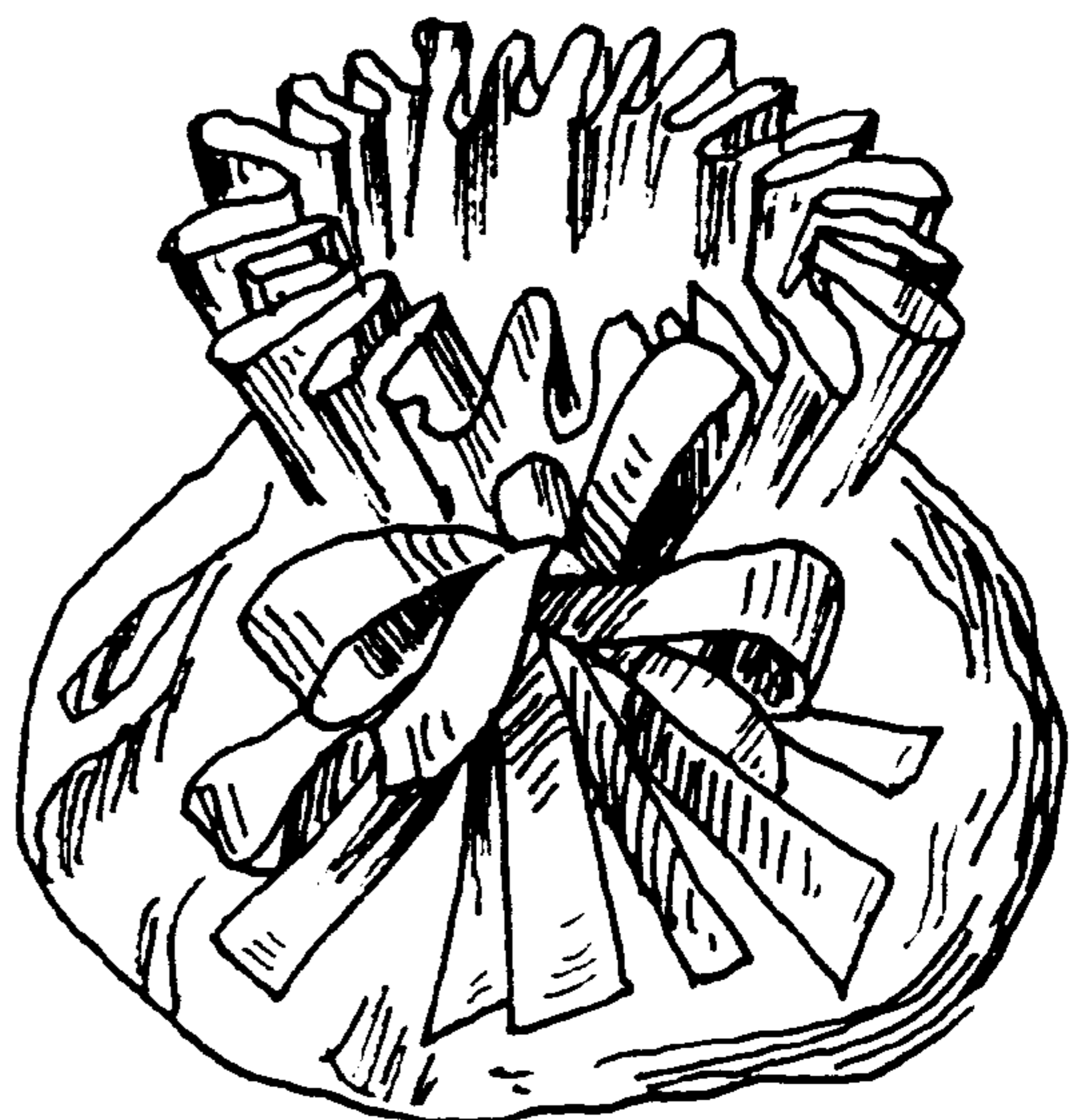
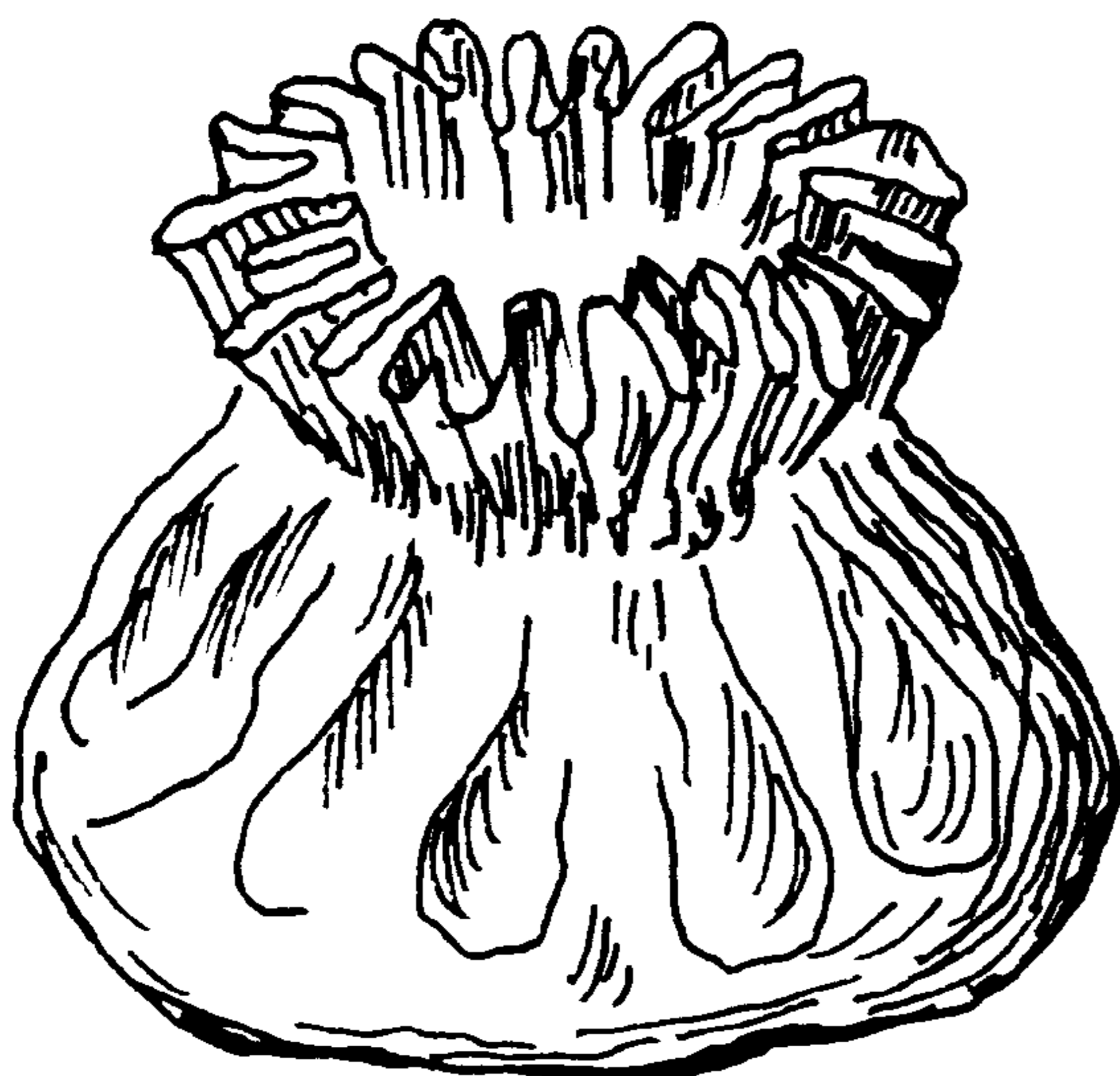
FIG. 4 is a perspective view of a glass holder showing my

no part of the present design) in the glass holder; and,

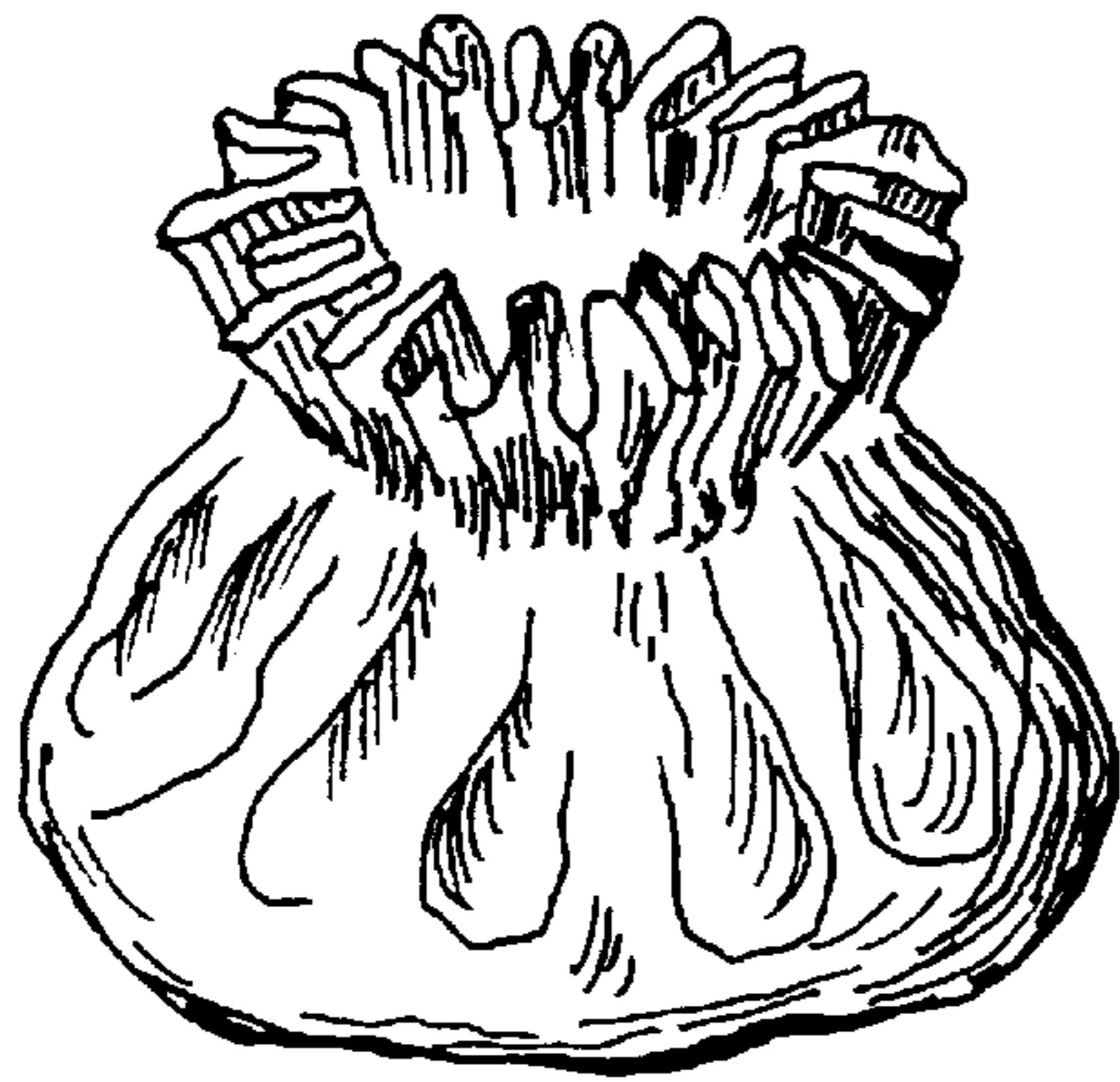
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of an alternative design of

iment.

substantially symmetrical about a vertical axis.

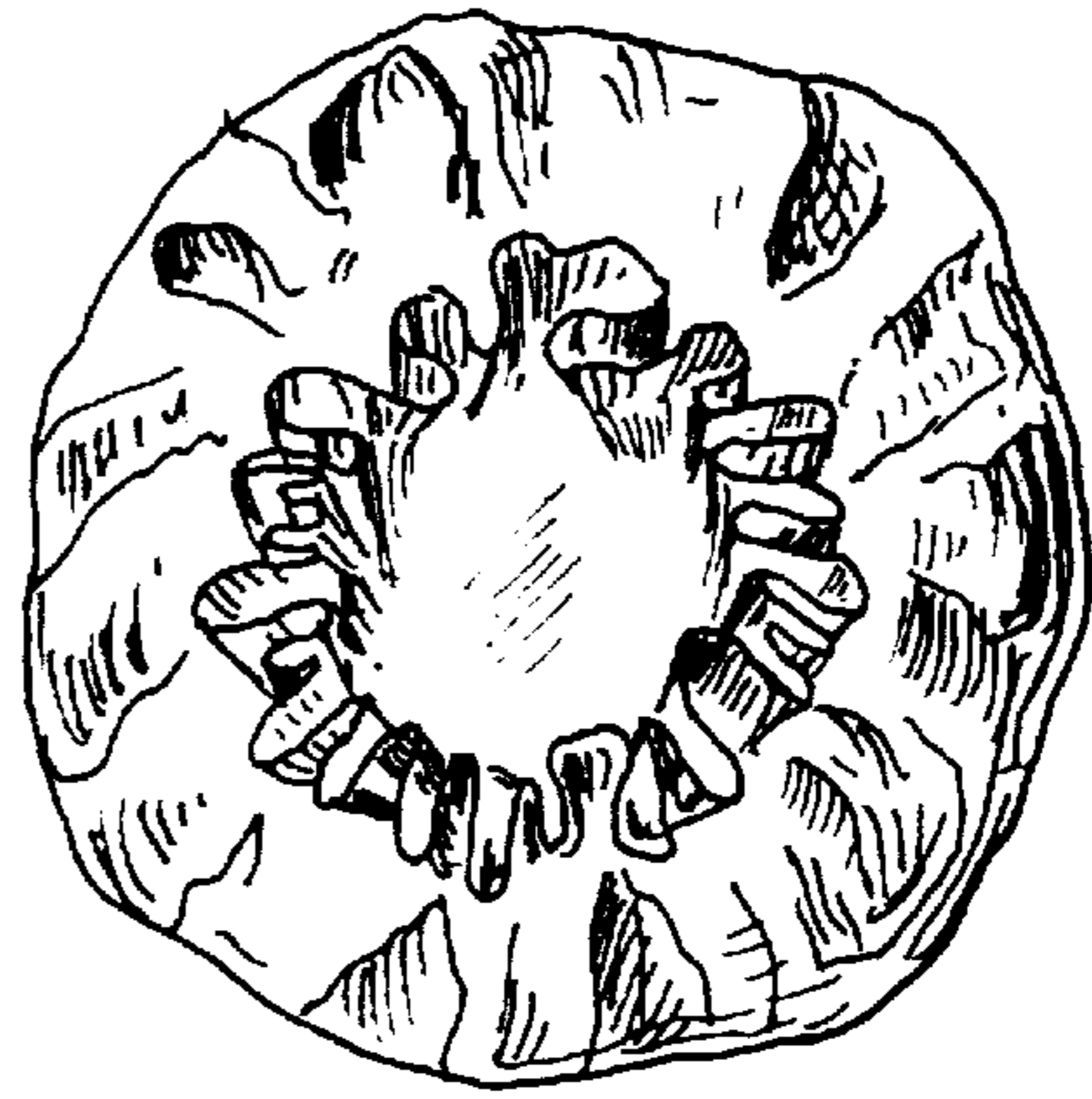
The surfaces or portions of the article not shown in the

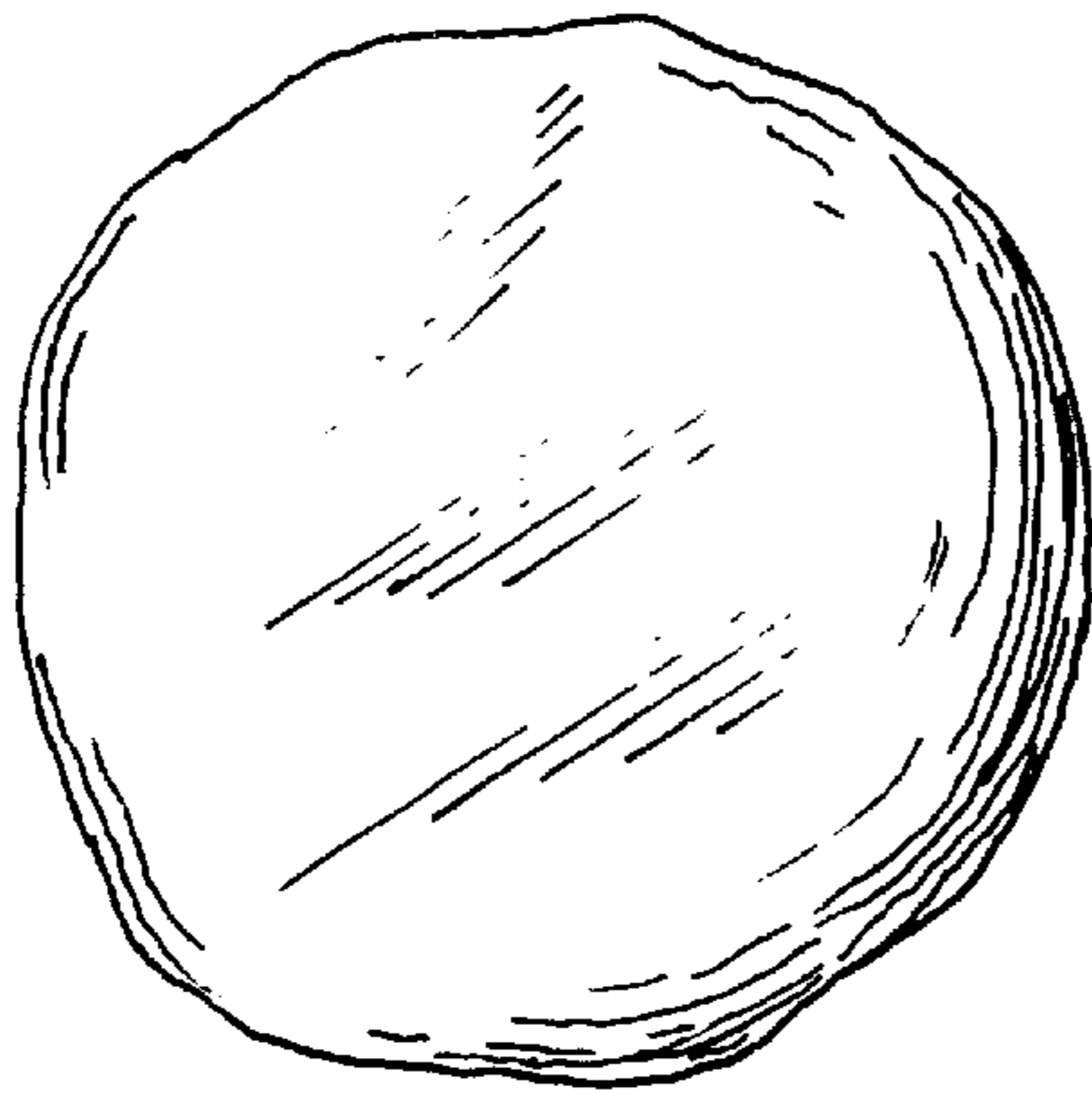




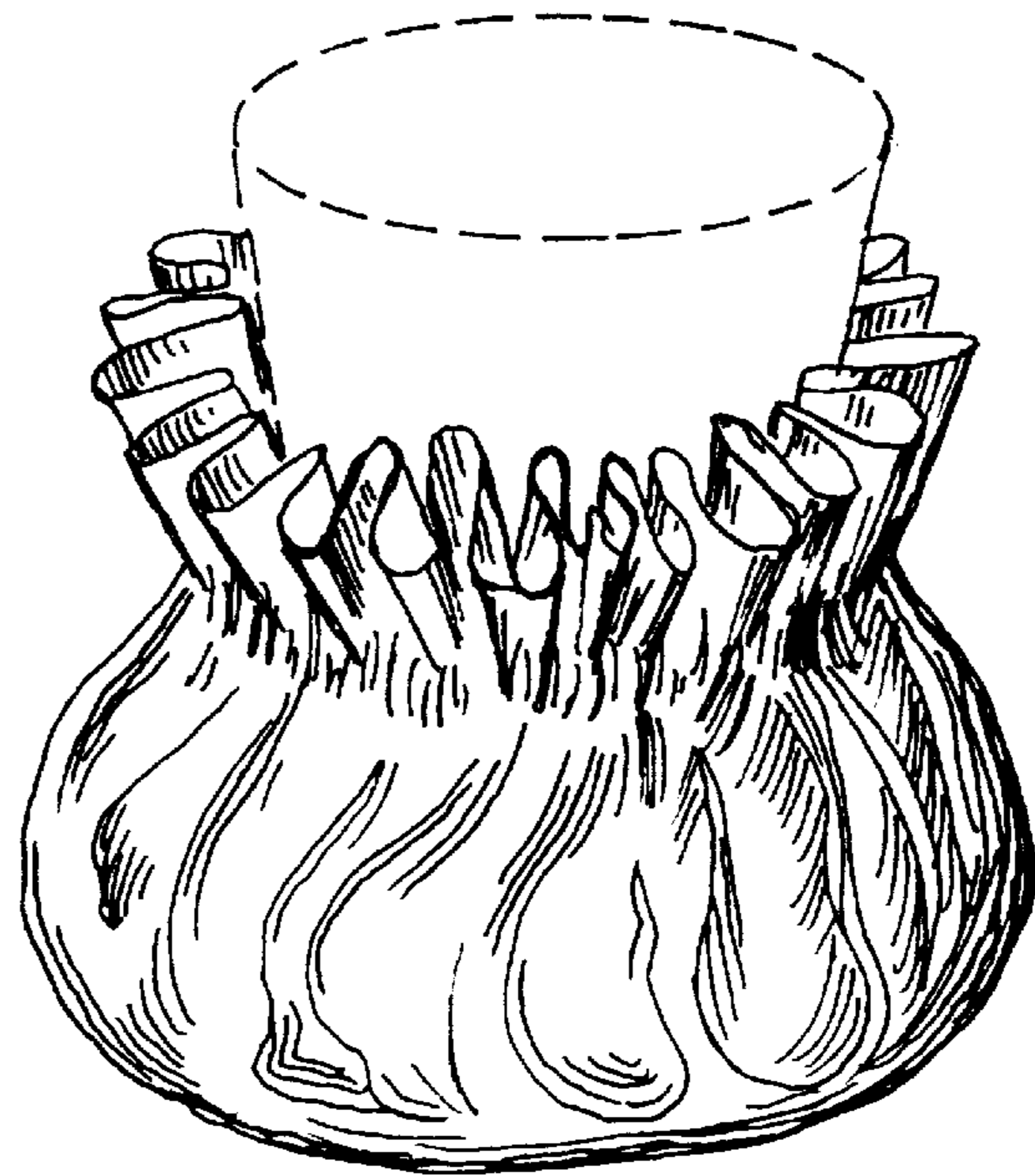

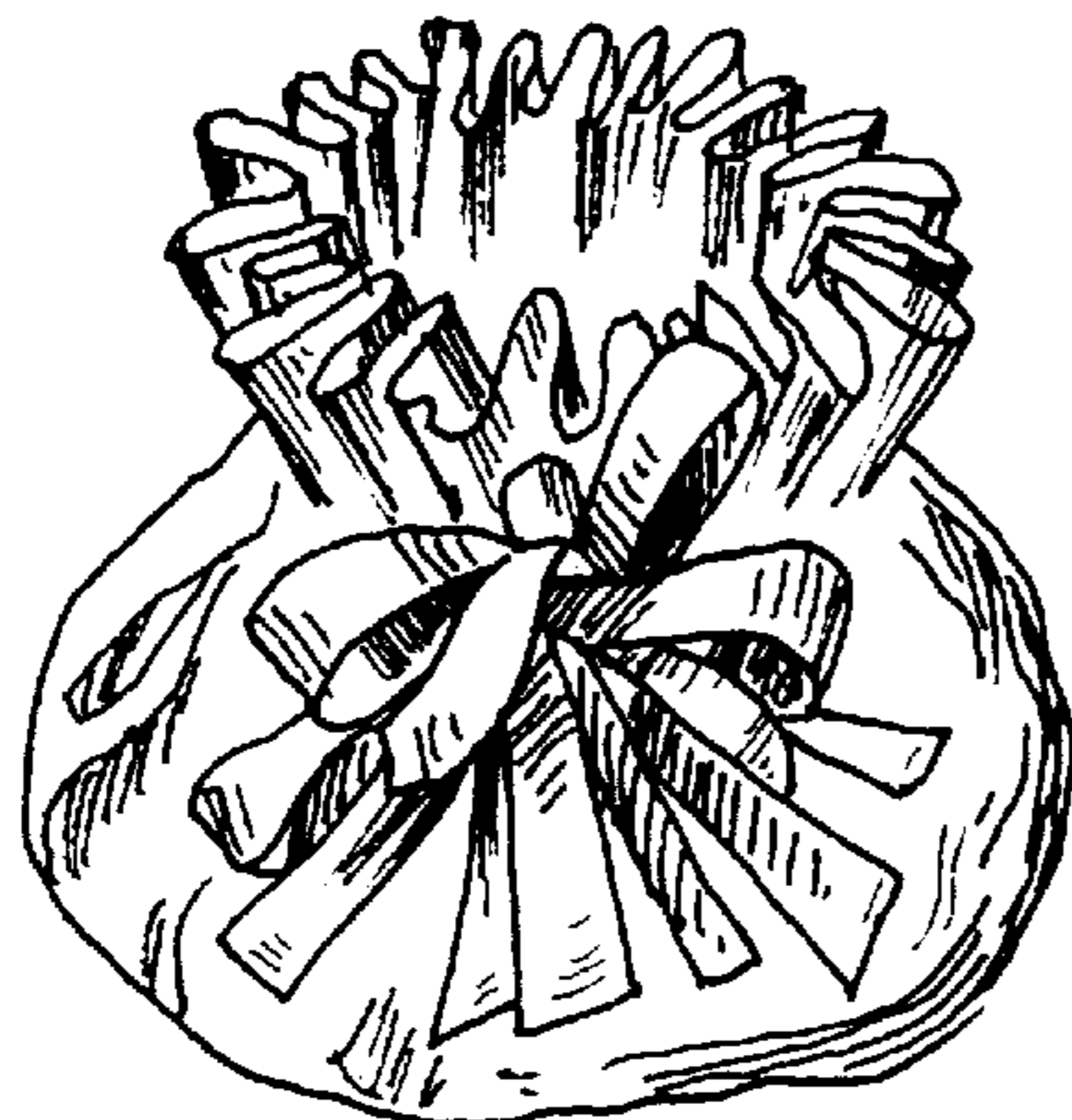
