FIG. 2 is a side elevation view thereof, the opposite side plan view being identical;

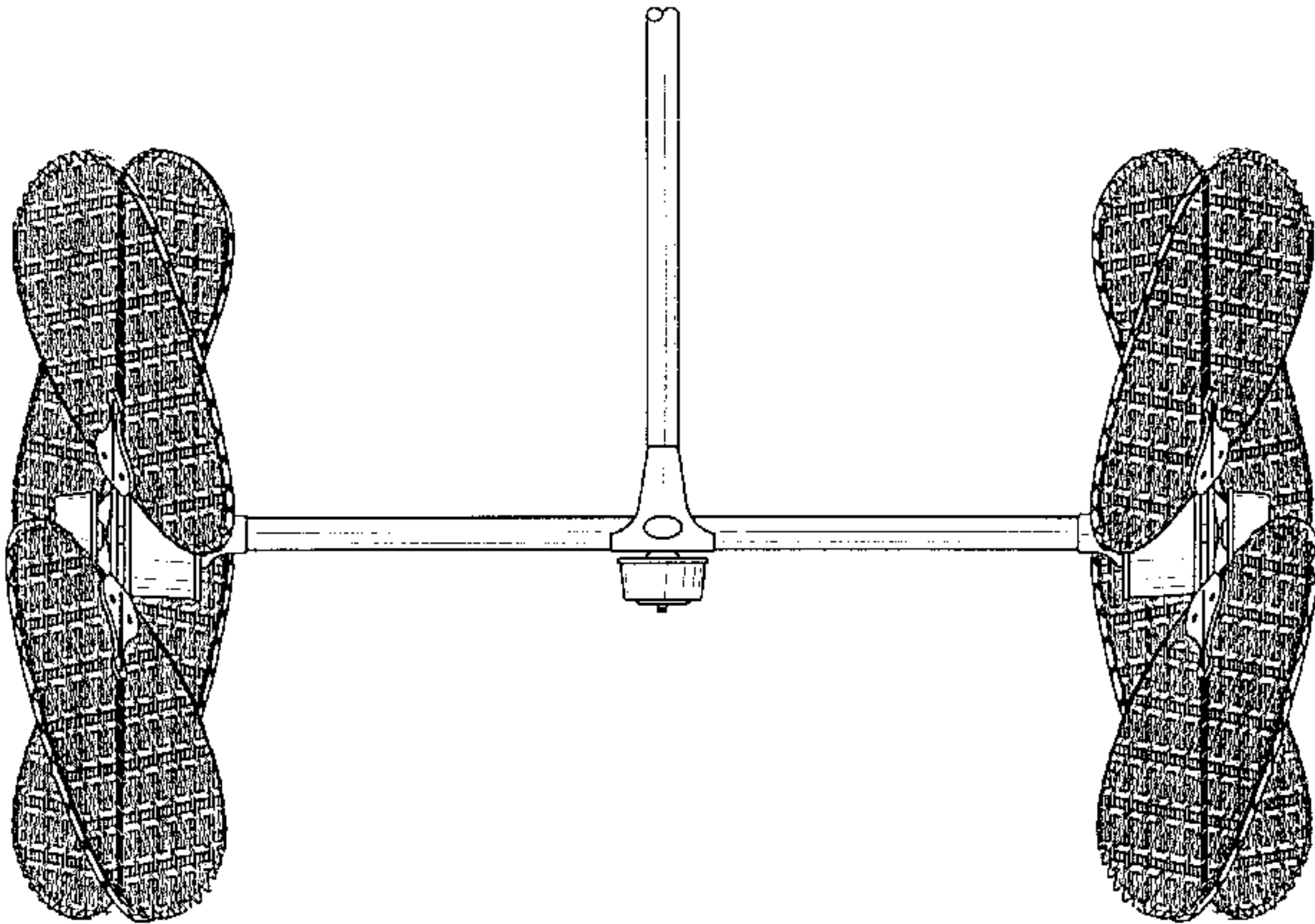
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

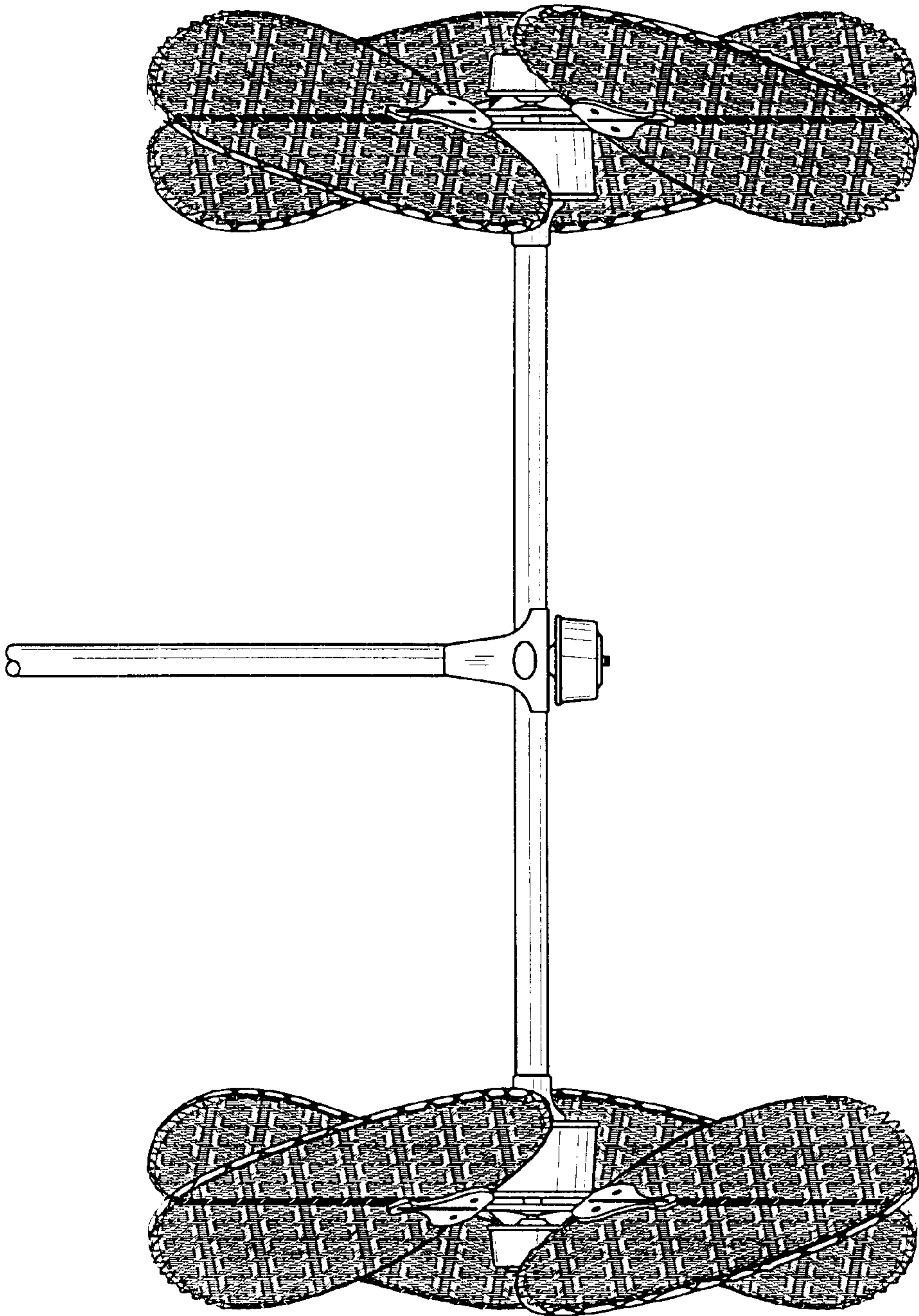

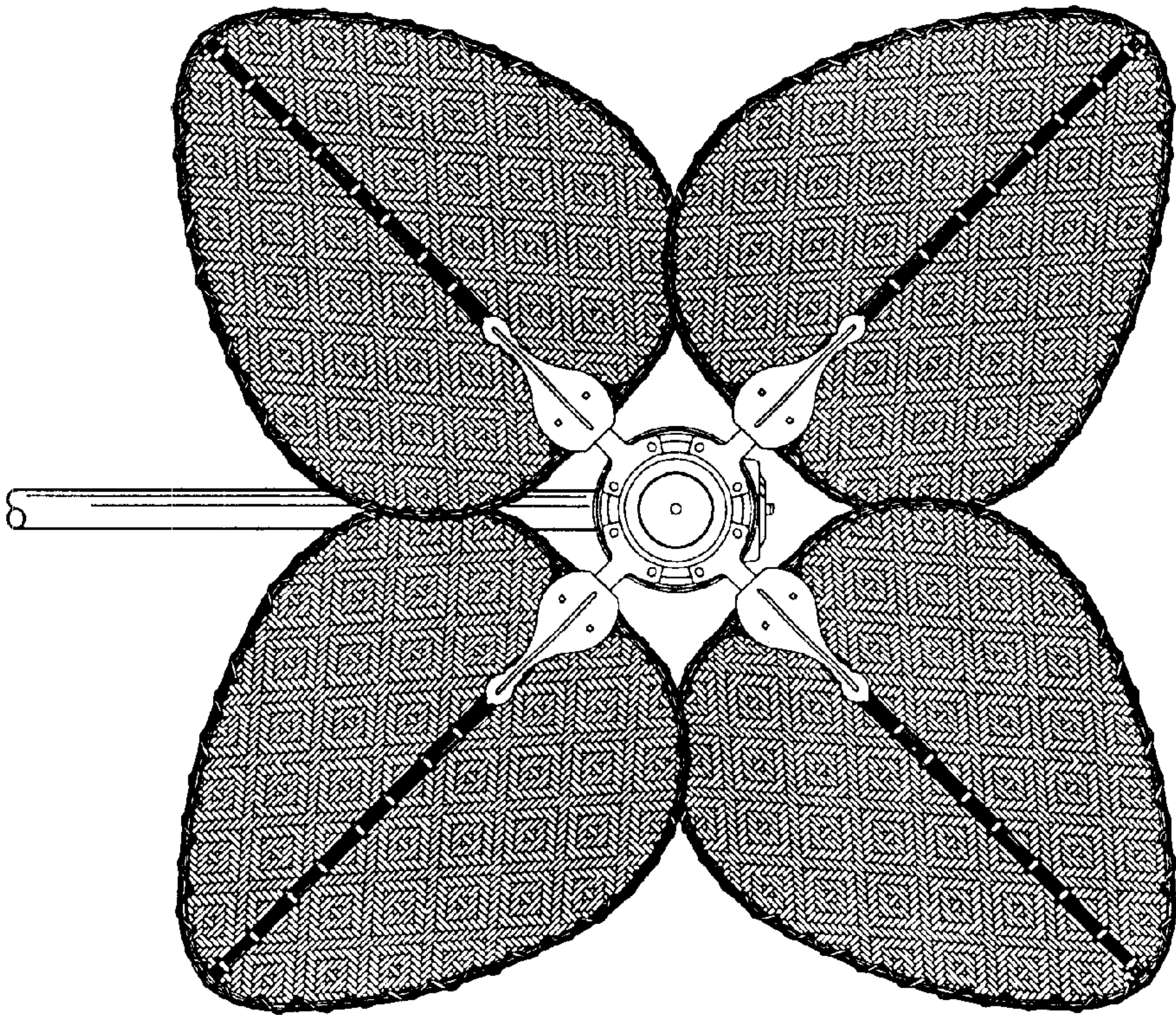

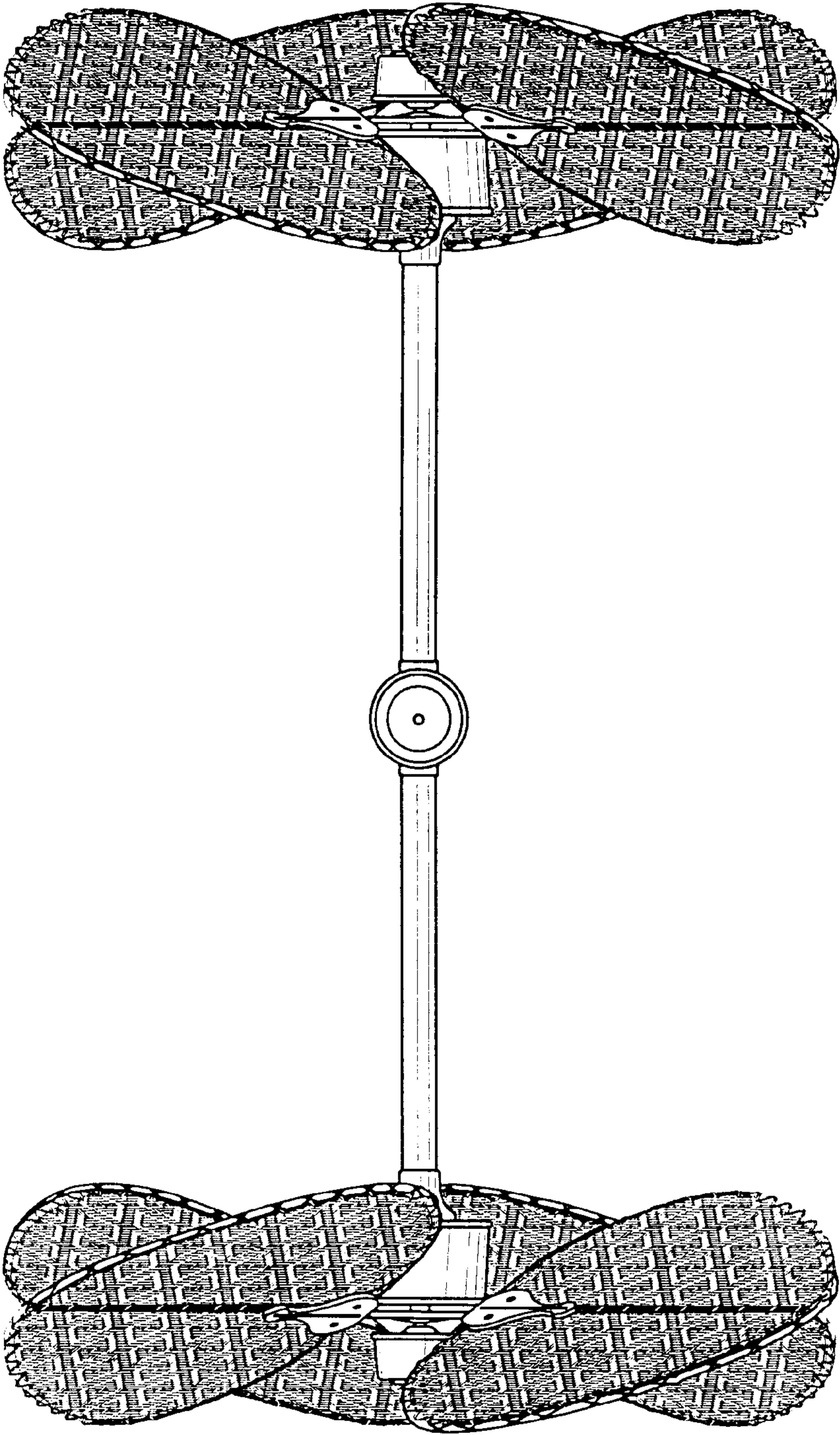

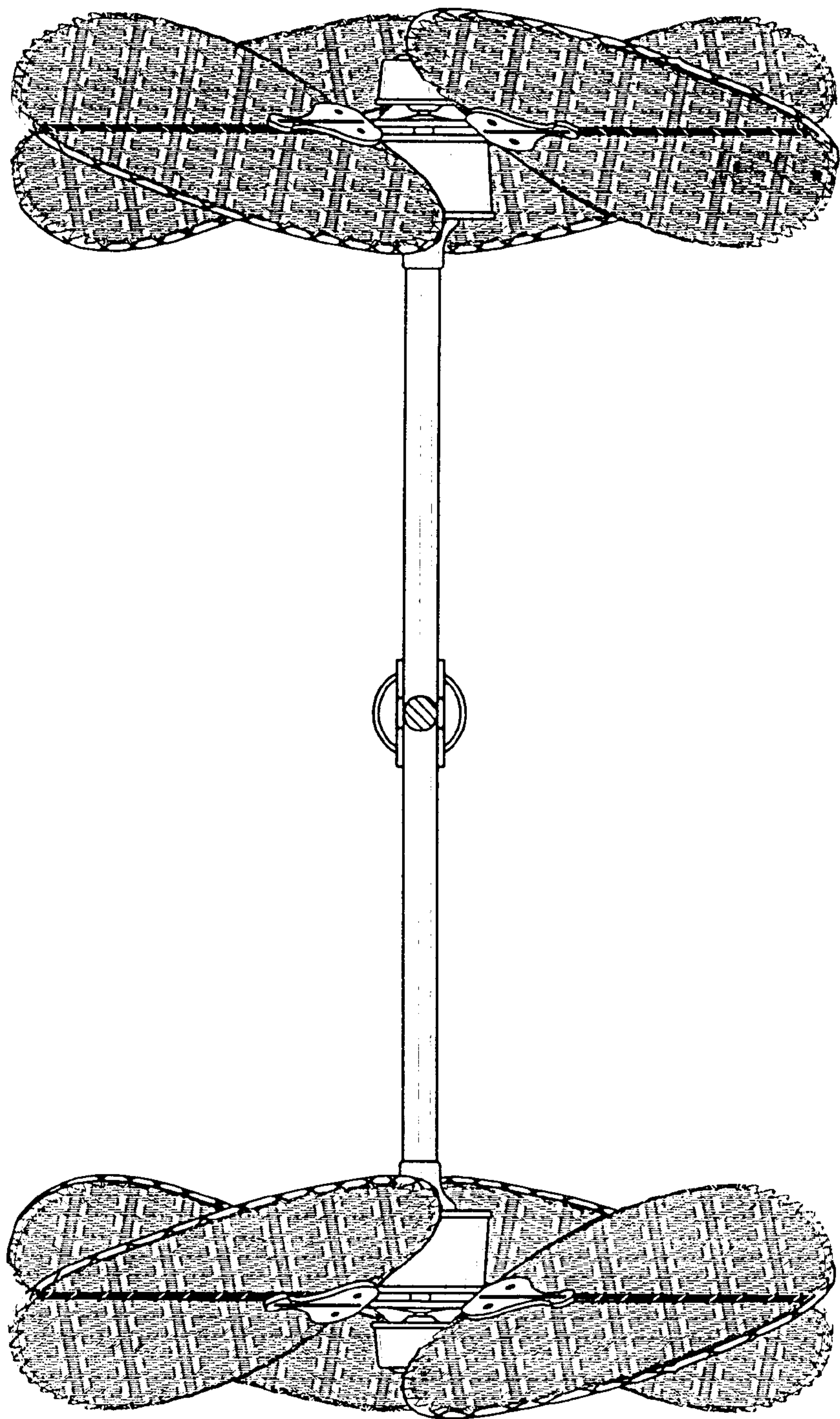

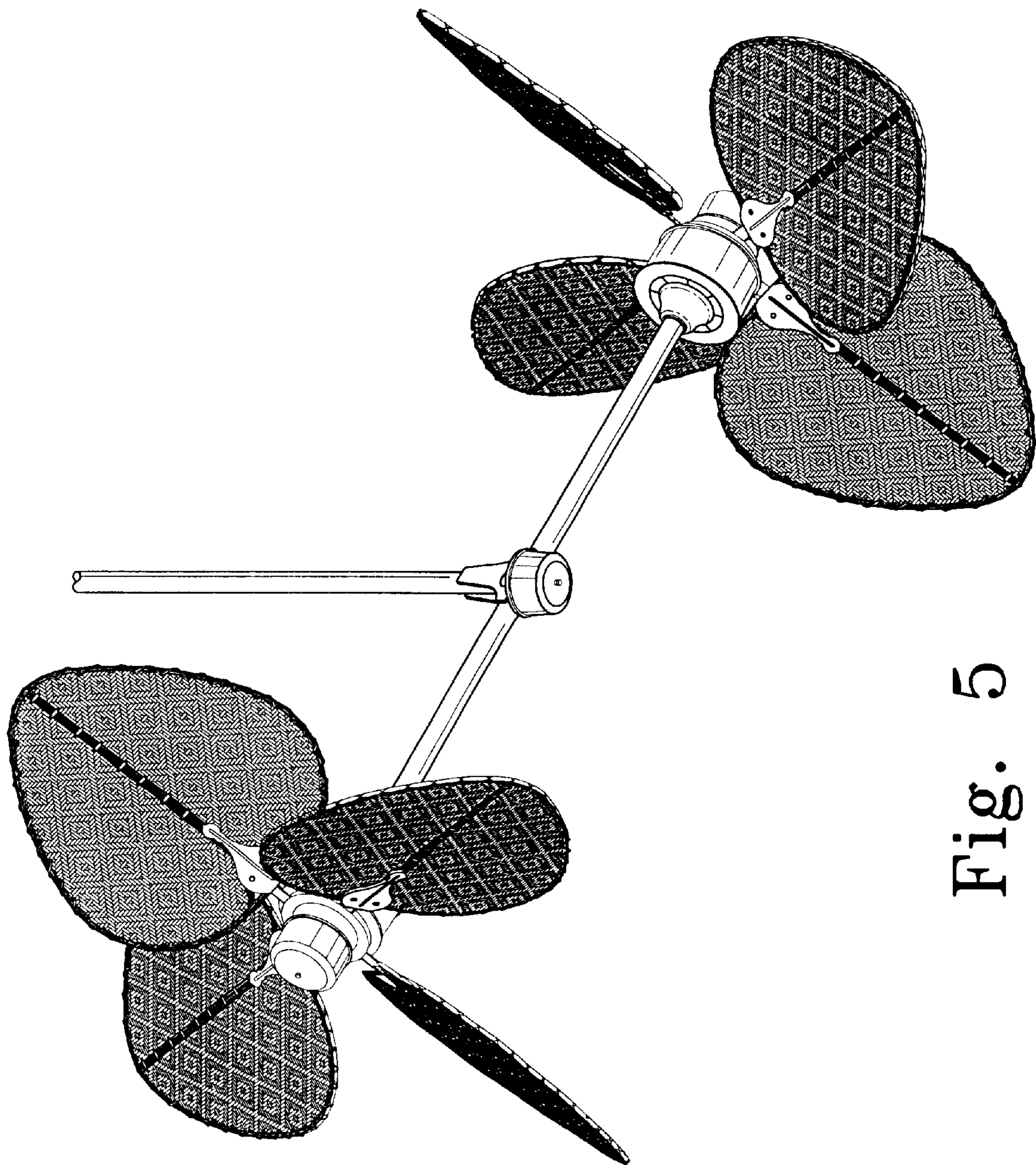
