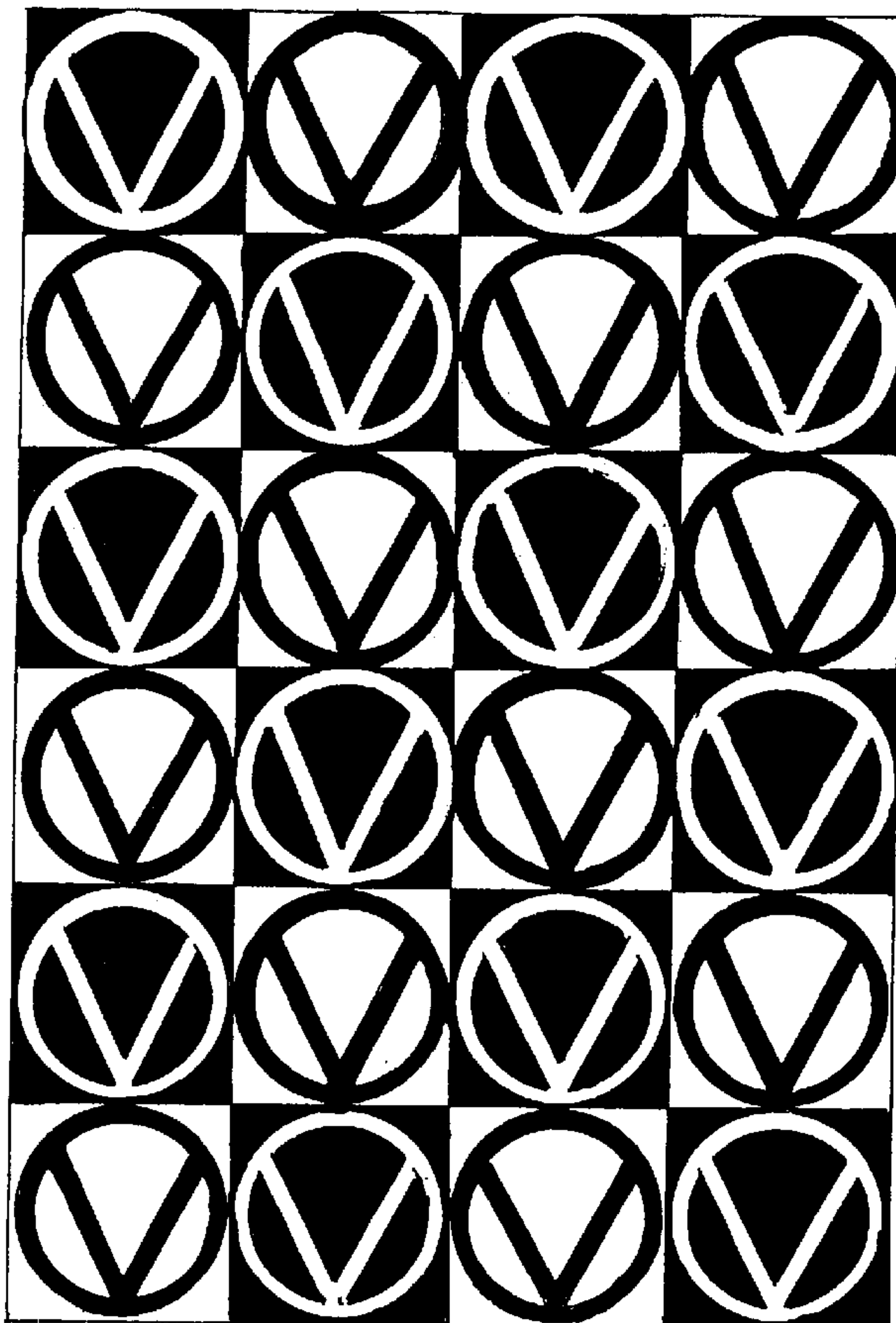

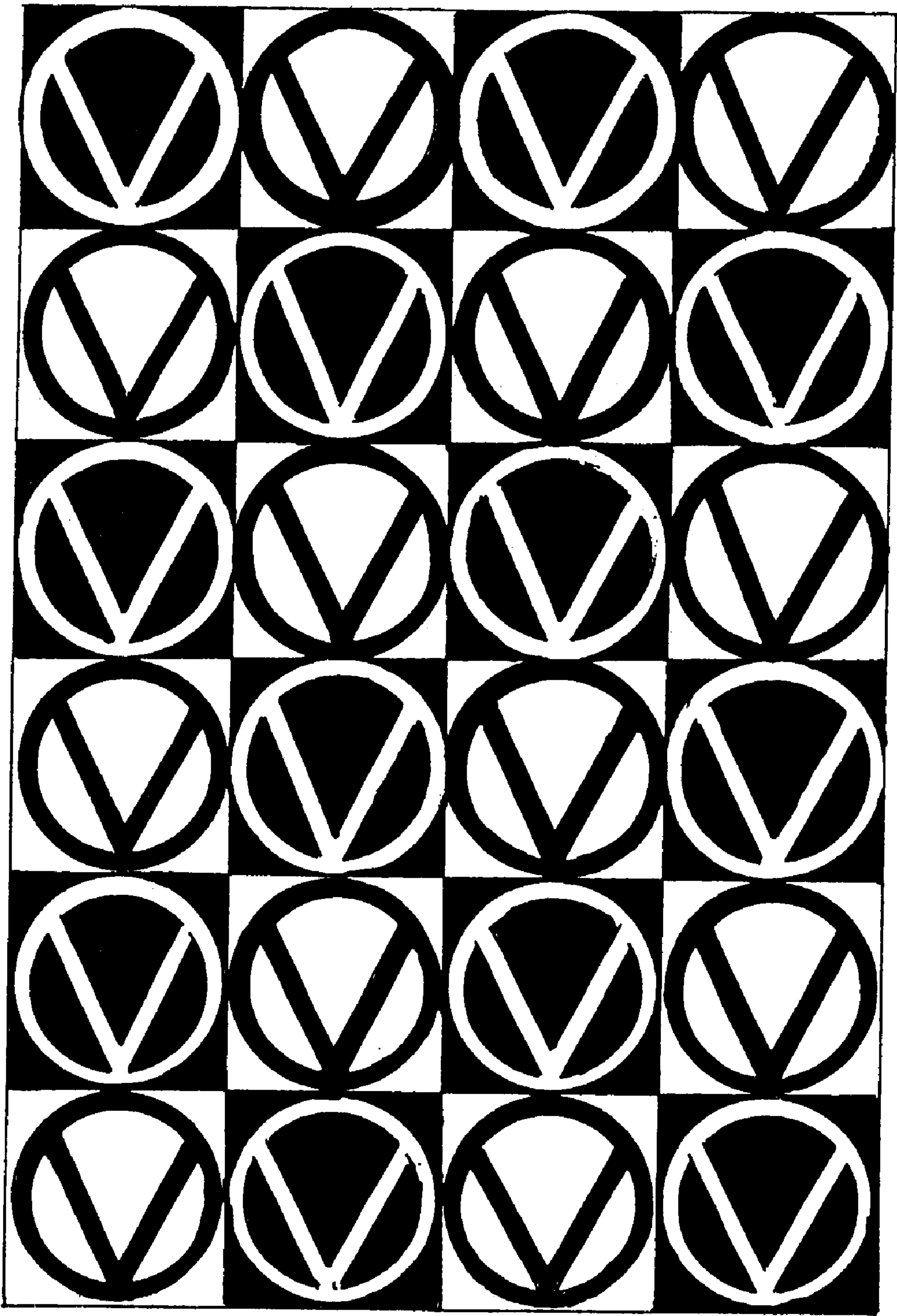
The ornamental design for textile comprising a repeated pattern formed by the combination of geometric elements, as shown.


