CLAIM (57)

The ornamental design for a chair back, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair back showing my new design, it being understood that the broken line is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design; and,

FIG. 2 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof with the lower portion broken away for convenience of illustration. FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 3-3 of FIG.
